DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a furniture leg showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of a furniture leg of my new design;

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a third embodiment of a furniture leg of my new design;

FIG. 7 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a fourth embodiment of a furniture leg of my new design; and,

FIG. 9 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image.

The views of the furniture leg not shown form no part of the claimed design. The additional views of the second, third and fourth embodiments depicted in FIGS. **4–9**, are proportionally equivalent to those shown in FIGS. **1–3**.
