The ornamental design for a stapler combined with a base, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a stapler embodying the present invention.

FIG. 2 is a top view of the stapler.

FIG. 3 is a side view of the stapler.

FIG. 4 is a front view of the stapler.

FIG. 5 is a rear view of the stapler.

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of the stapler received in a base.

FIG. 7 is a top view of the stapler received in the base.

FIG. 8 is a side view of the stapler received in the base.

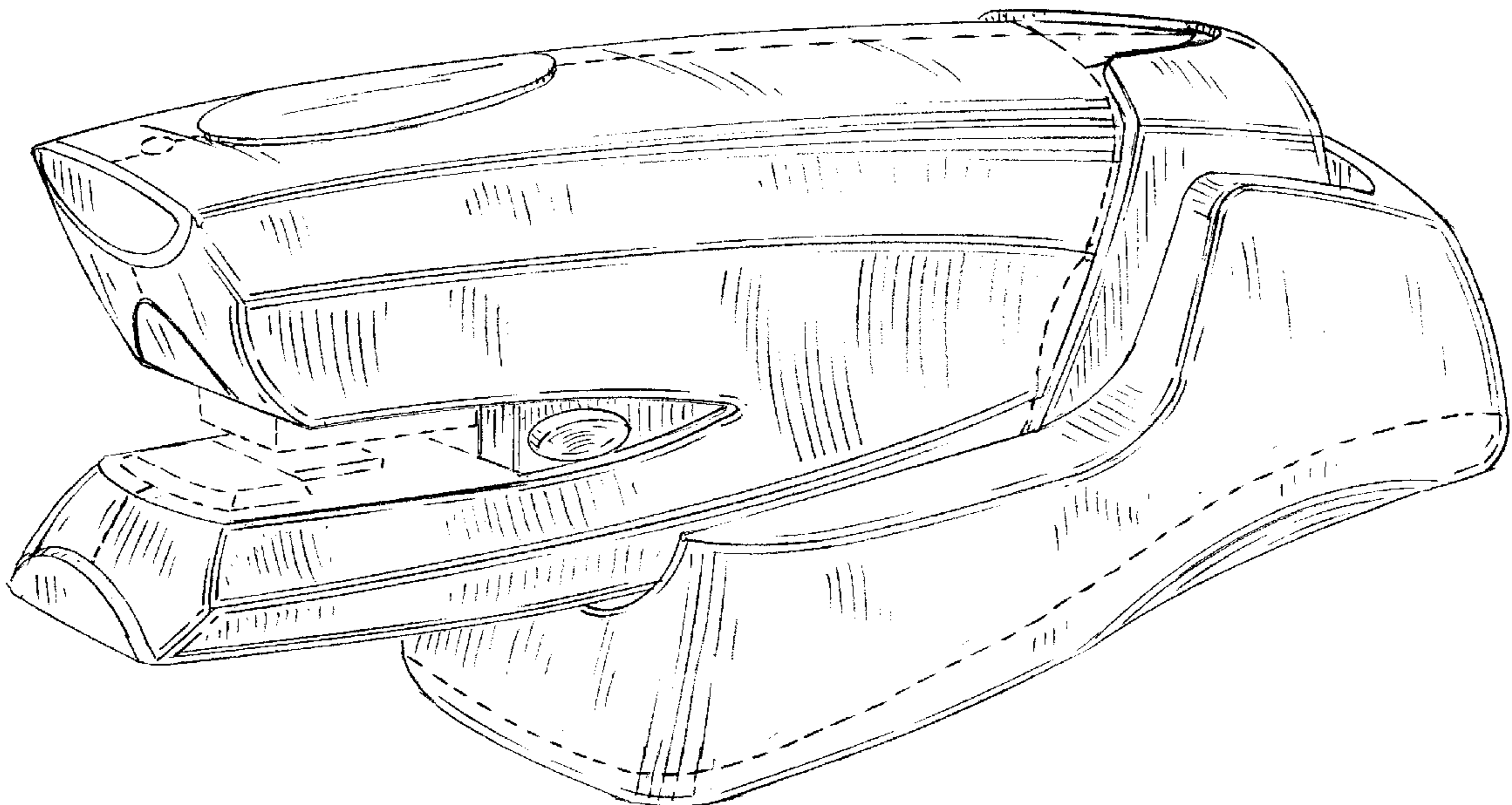
FIG. 9 is a front view of the stapler received in the base; and,

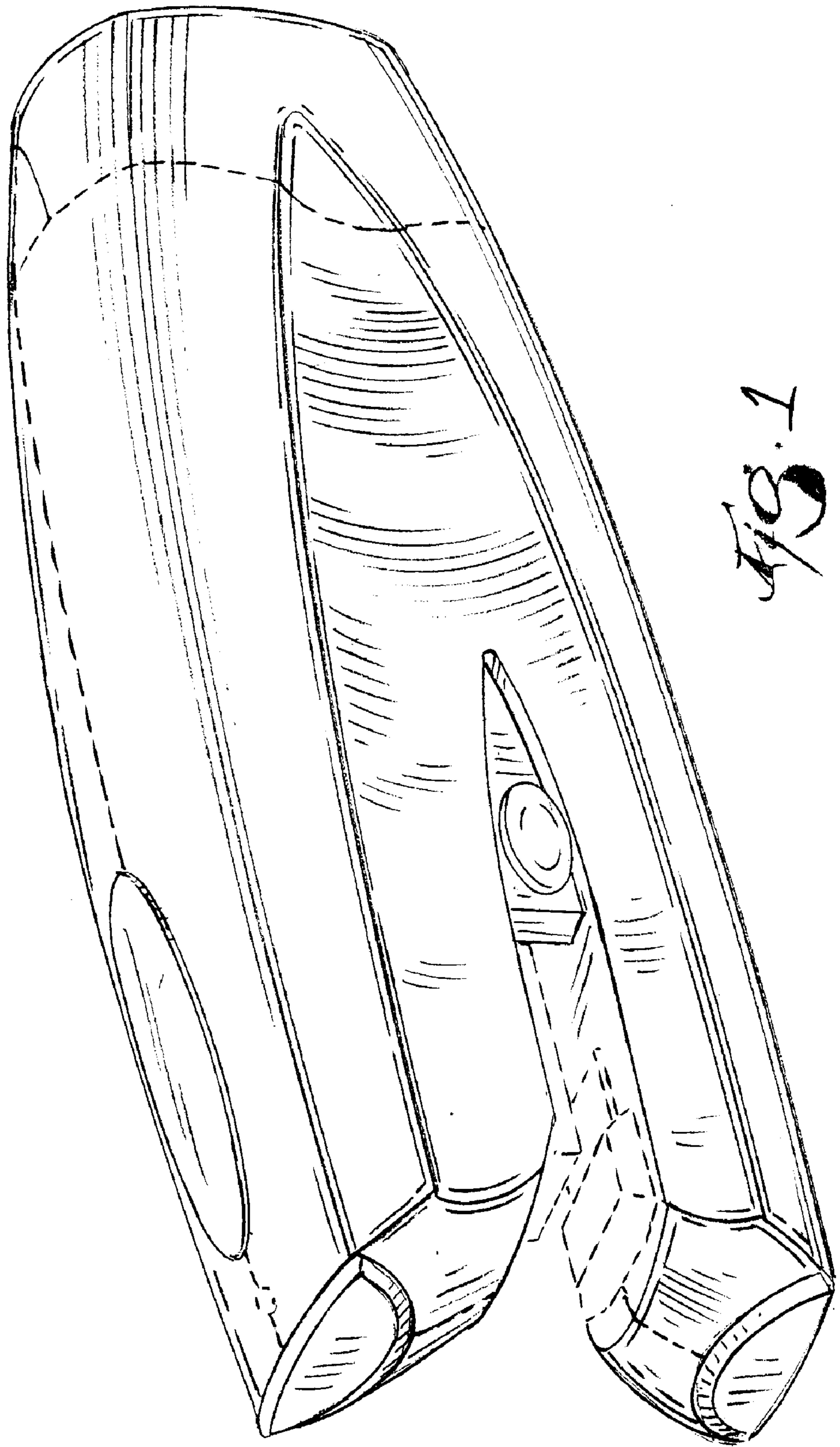
FIG. 10 is a rear view of the stapler received in the base.

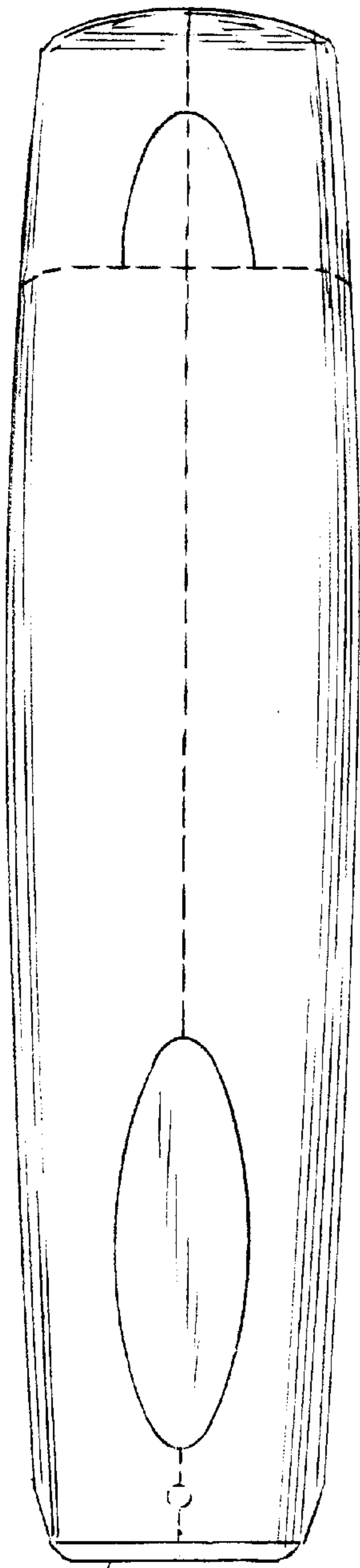

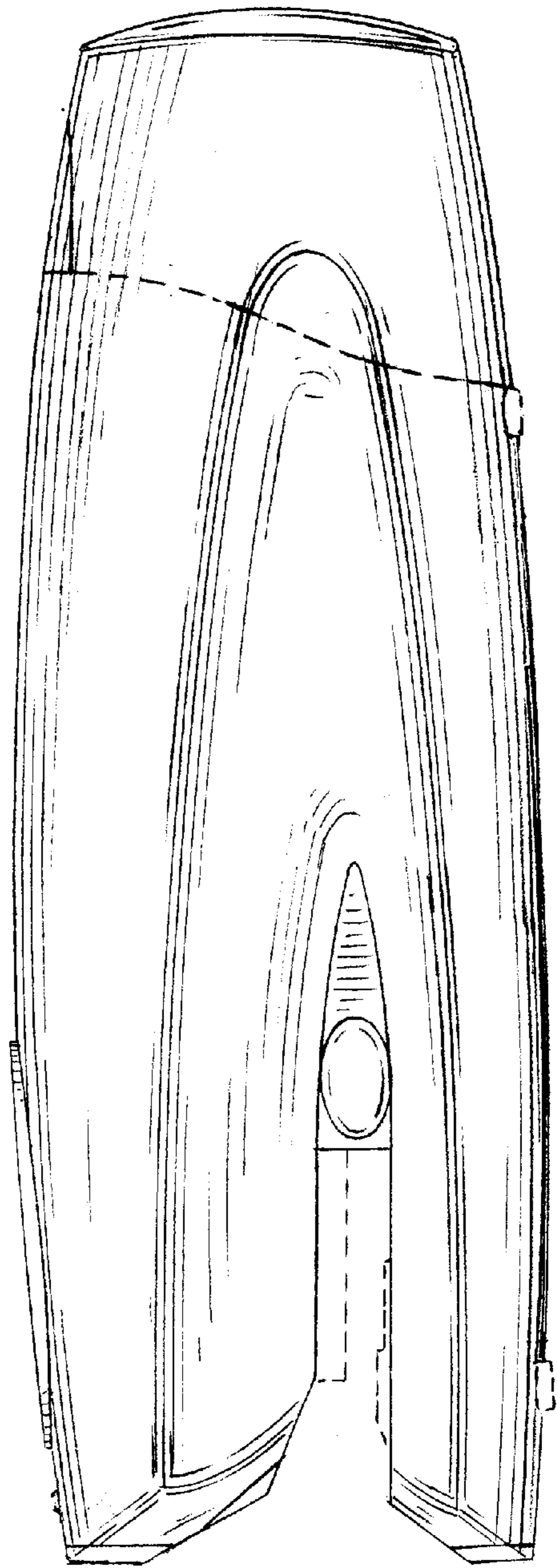

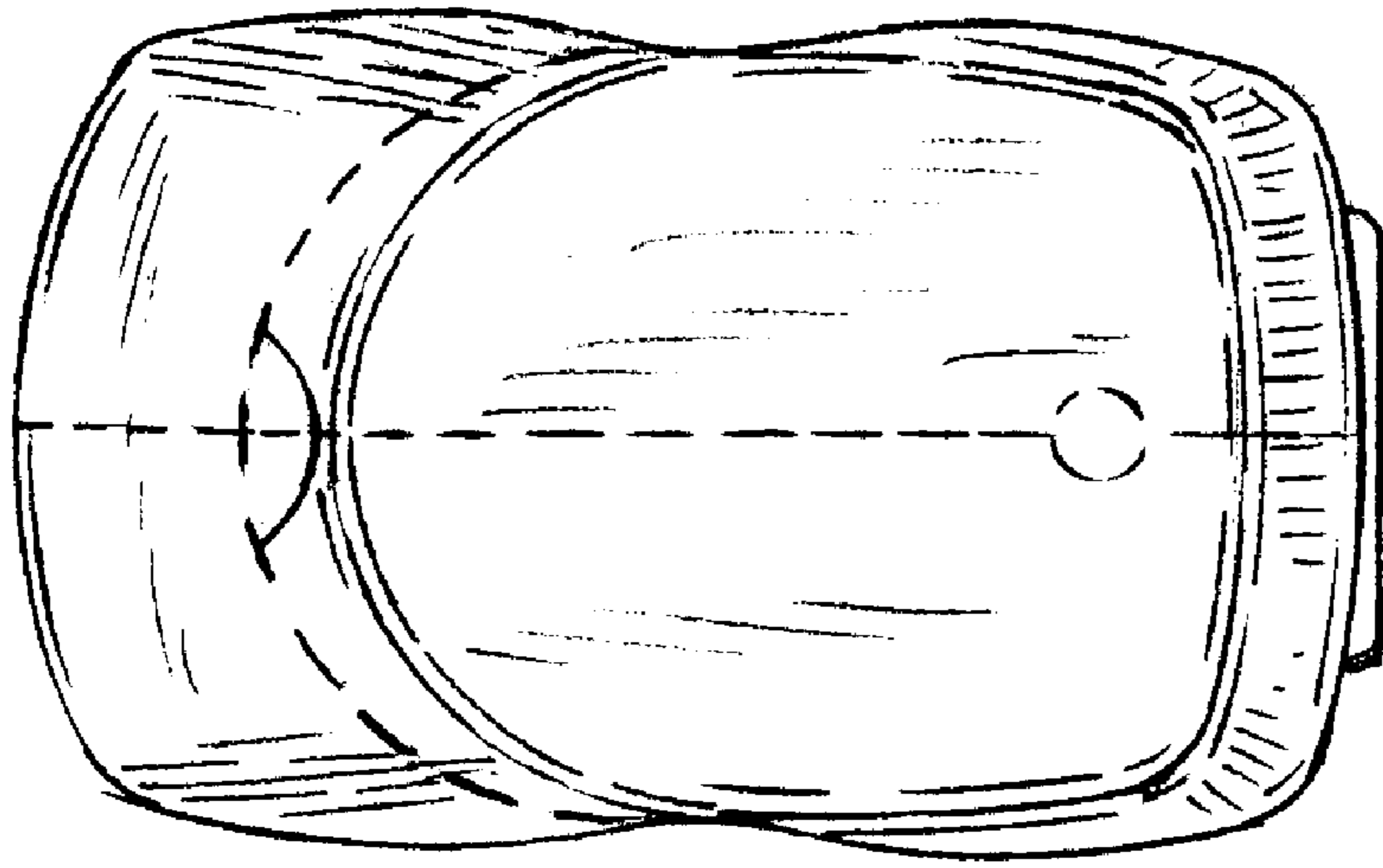

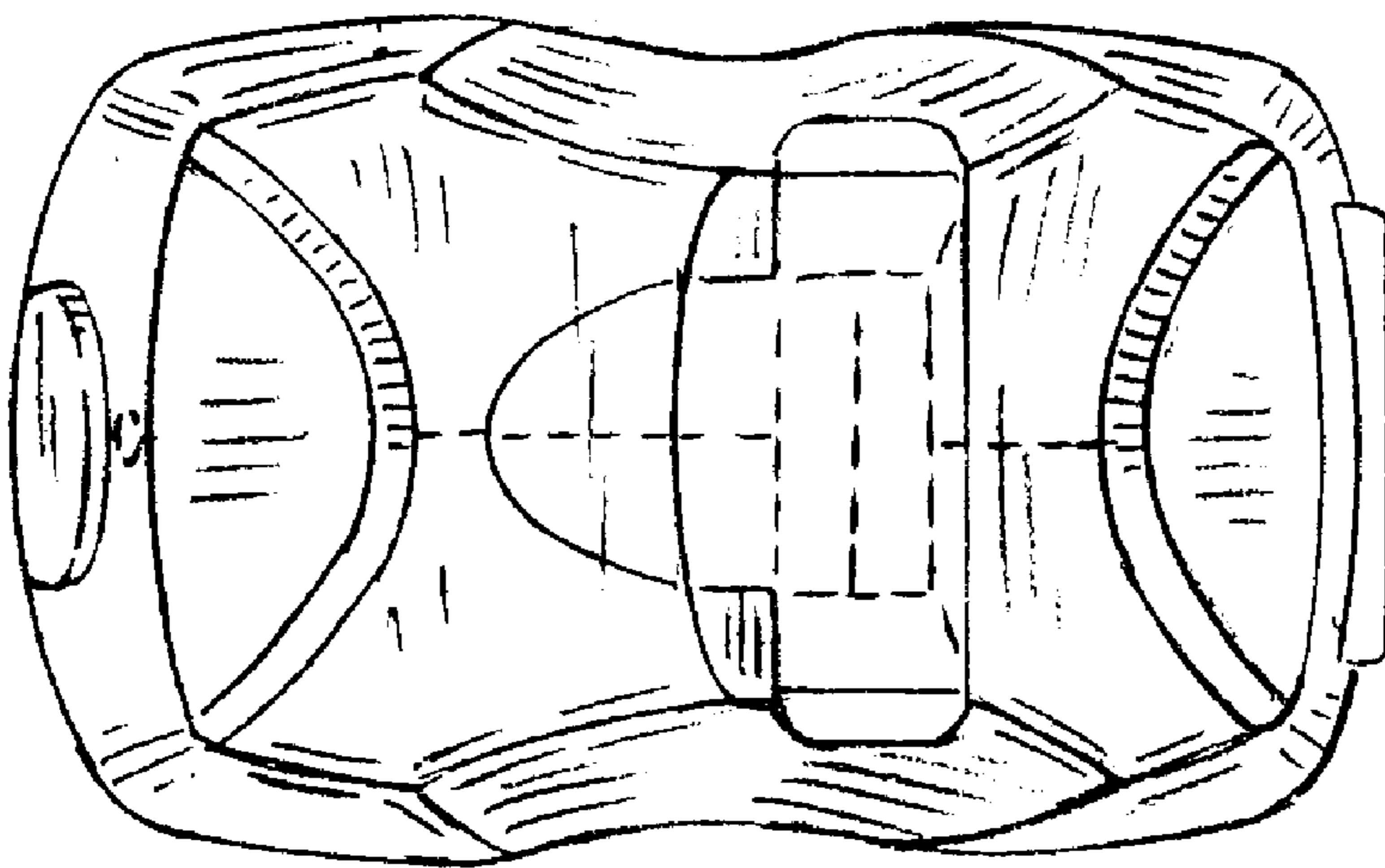

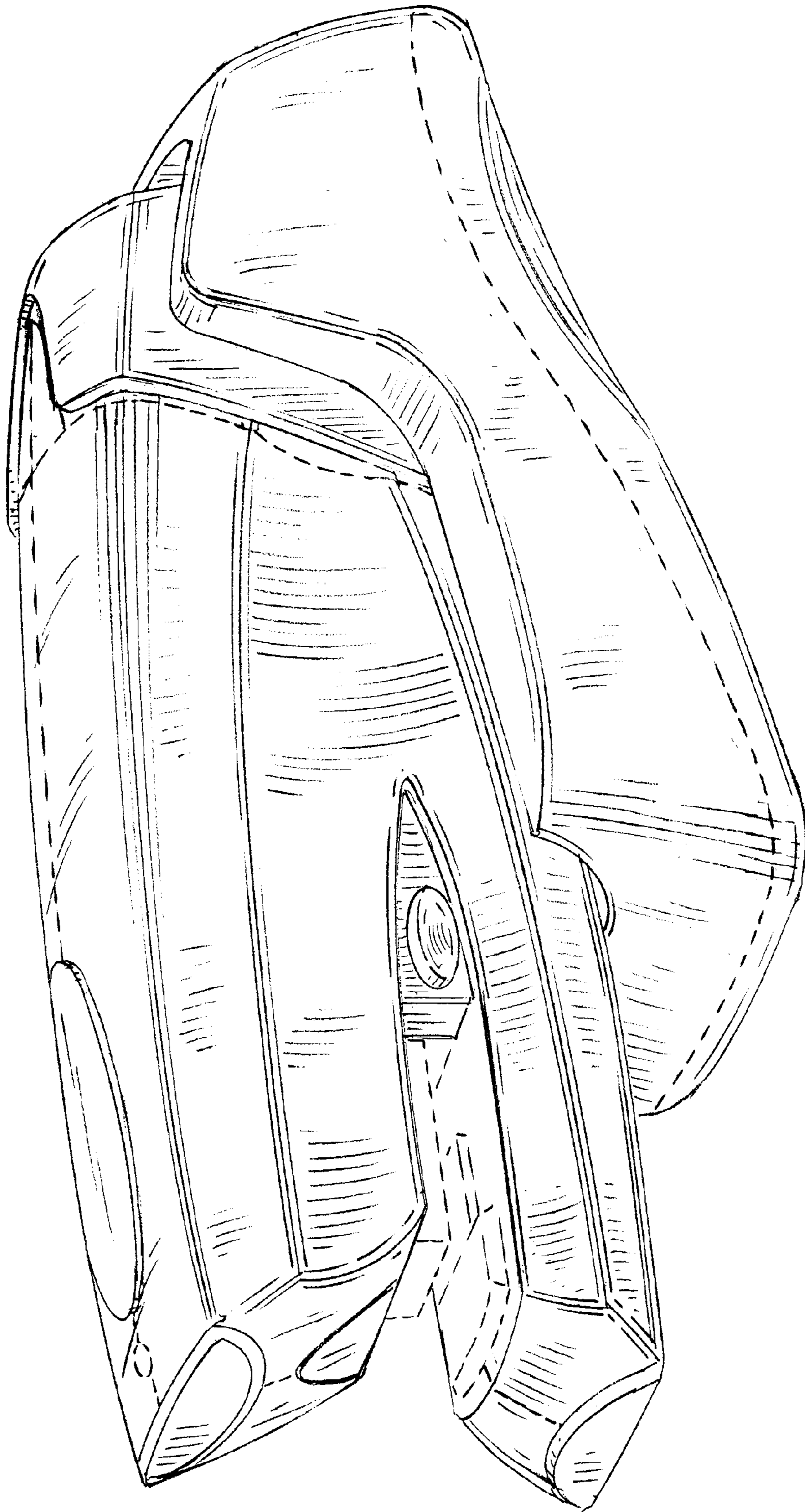

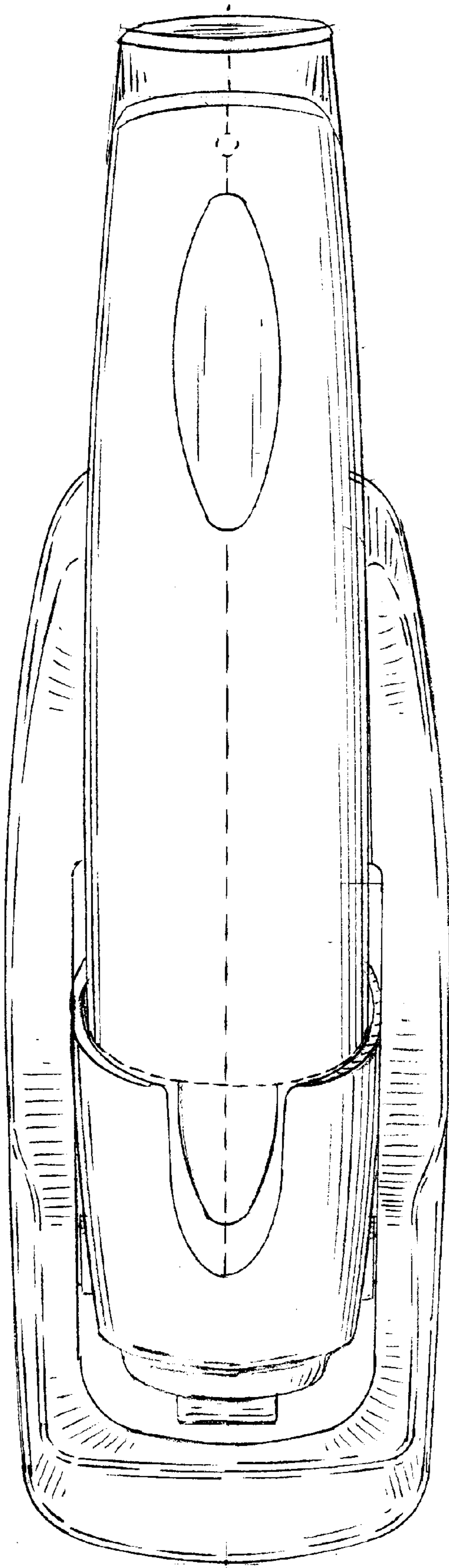

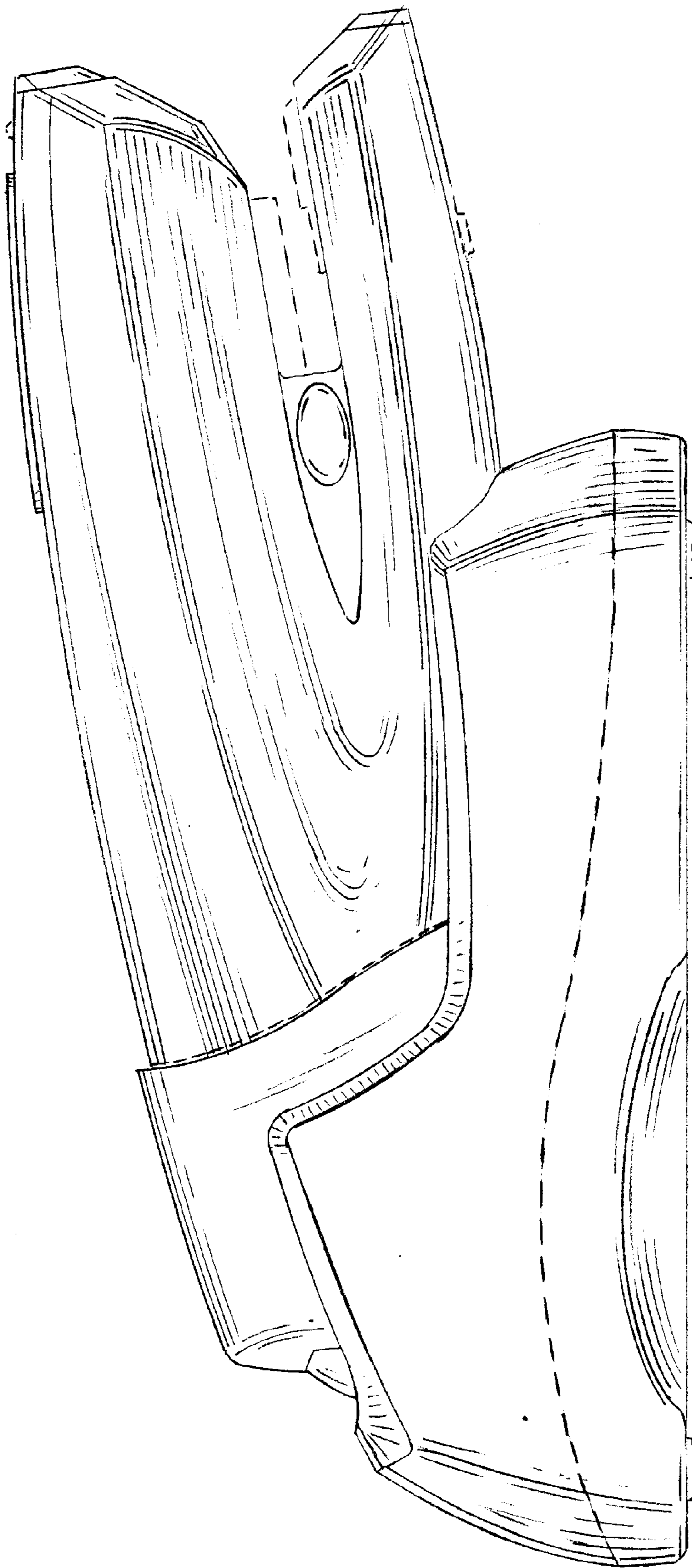

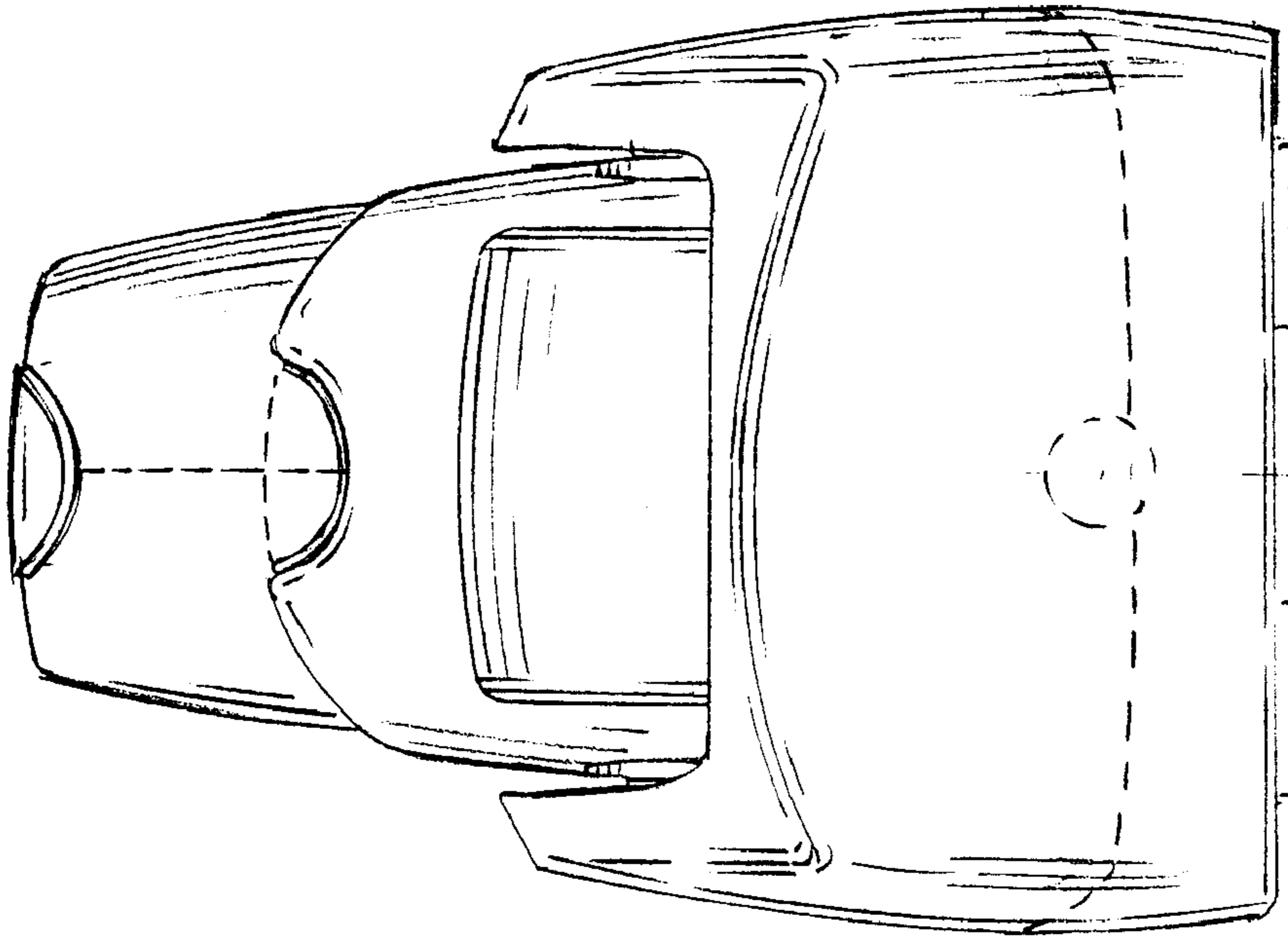

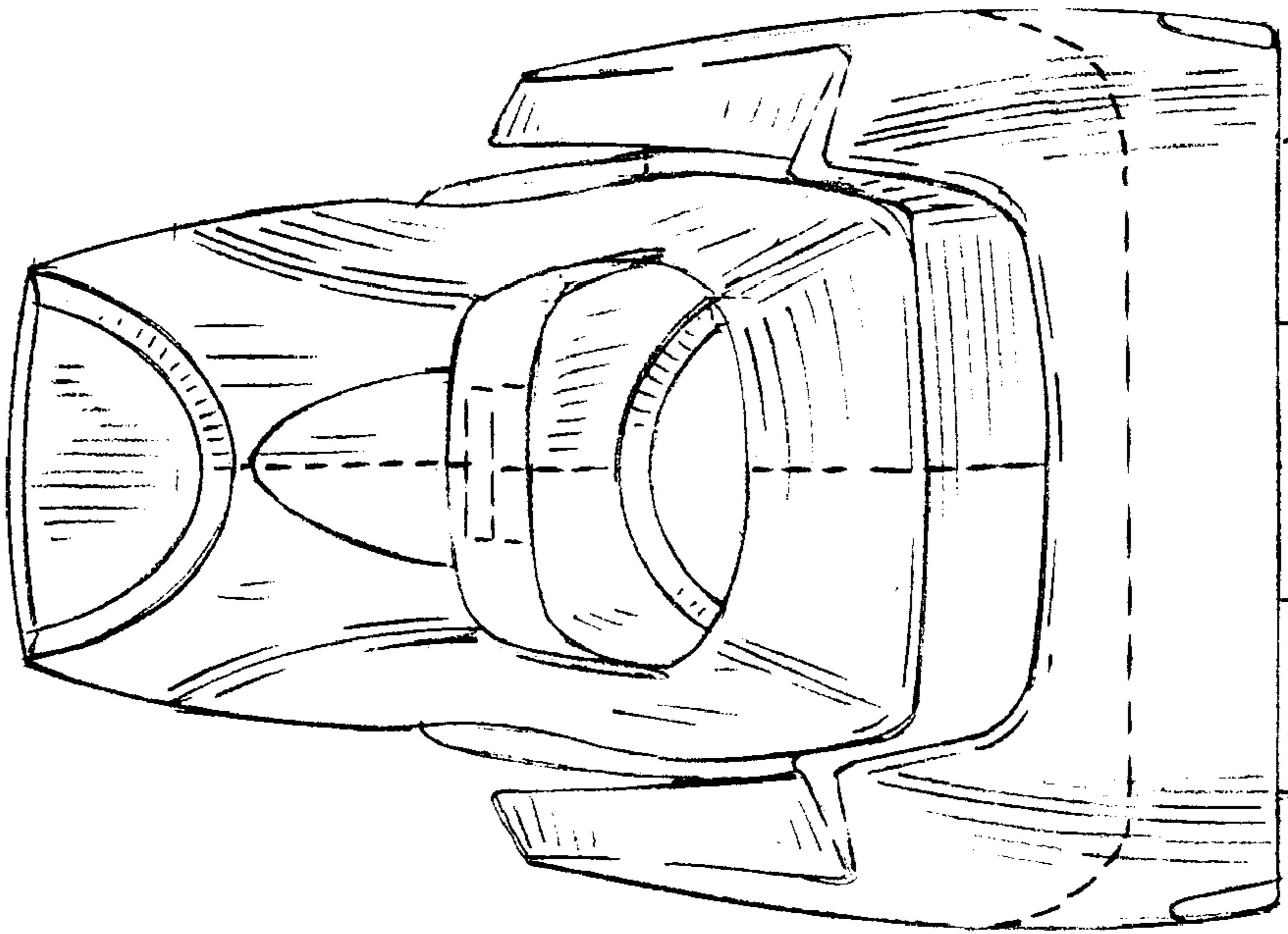

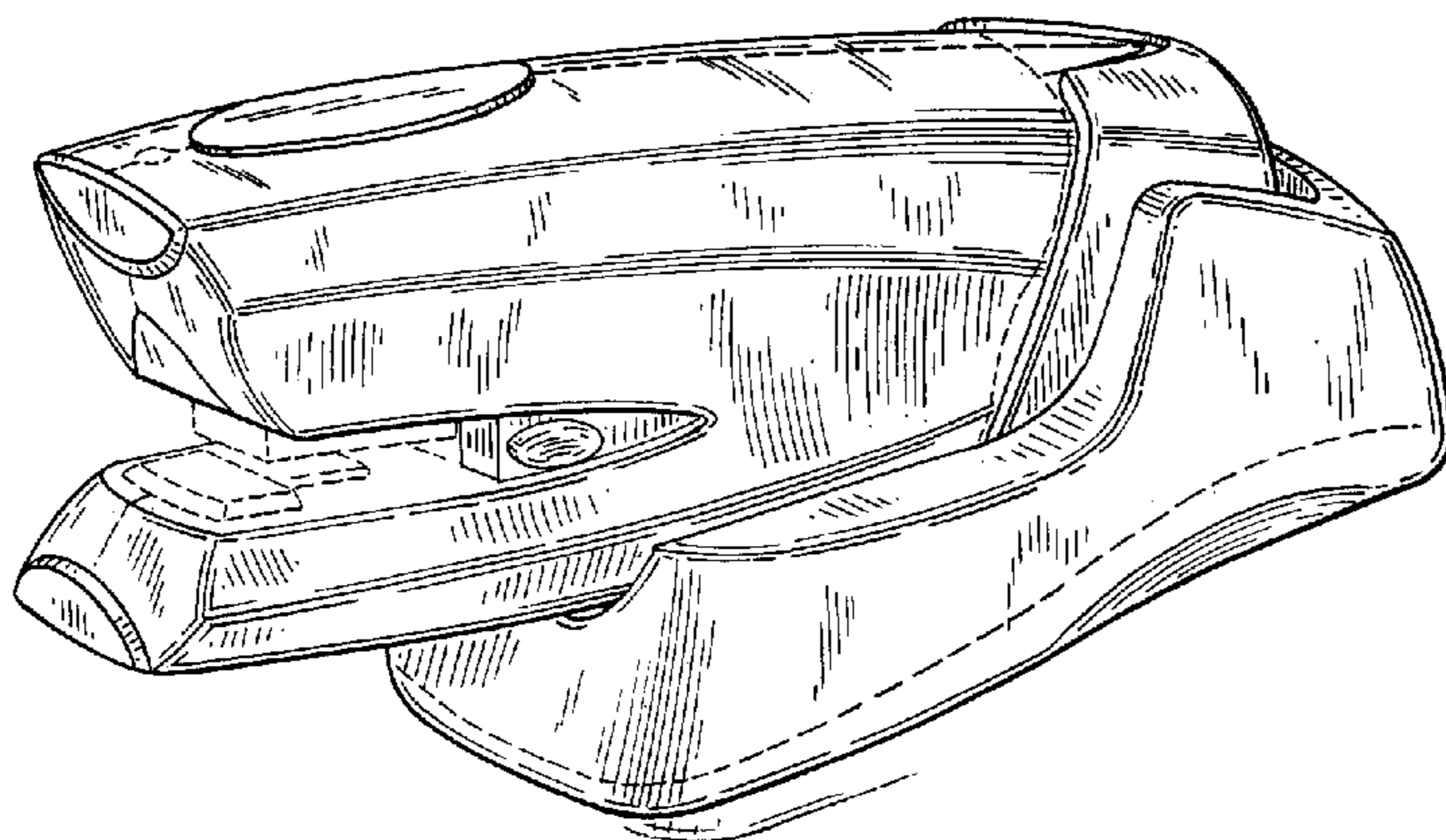
DESCRIPTION

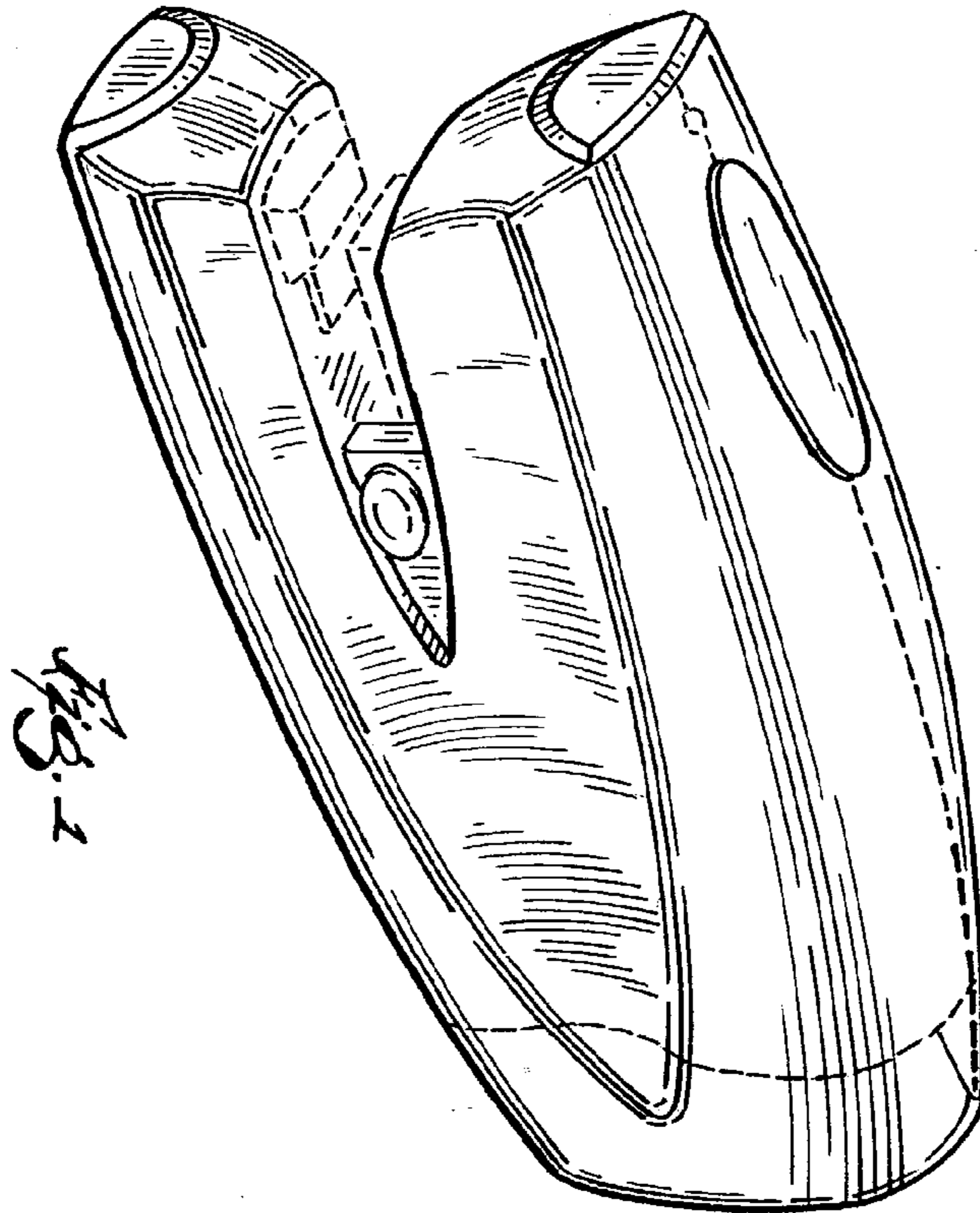

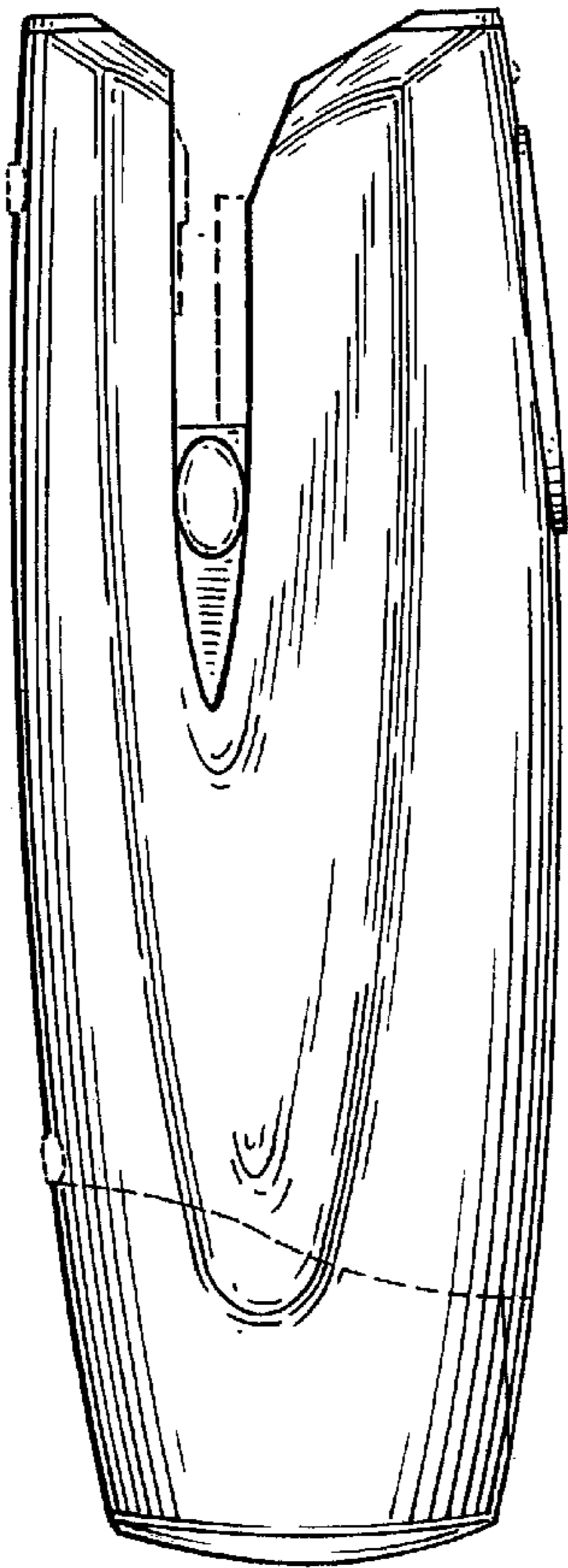

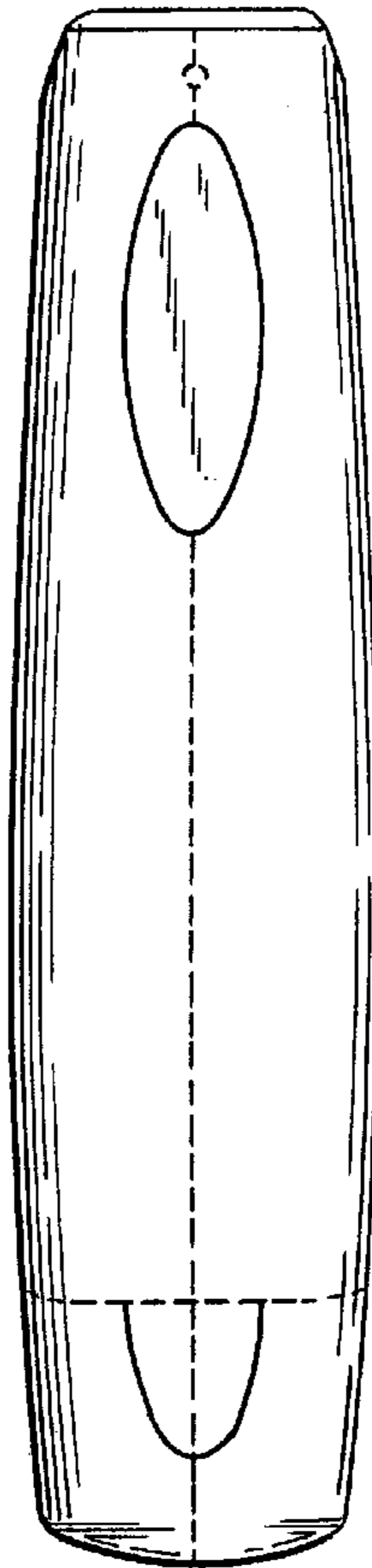

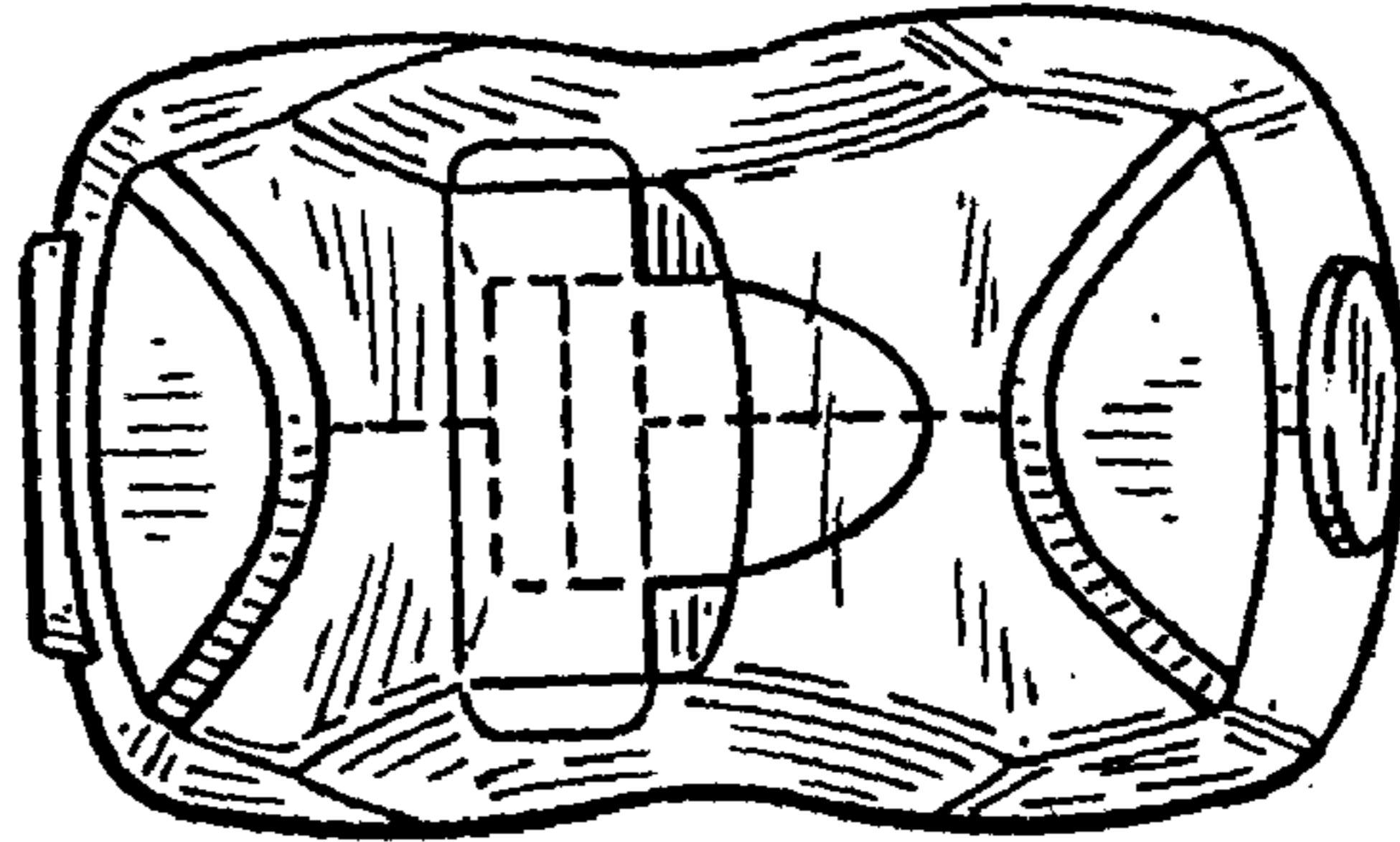
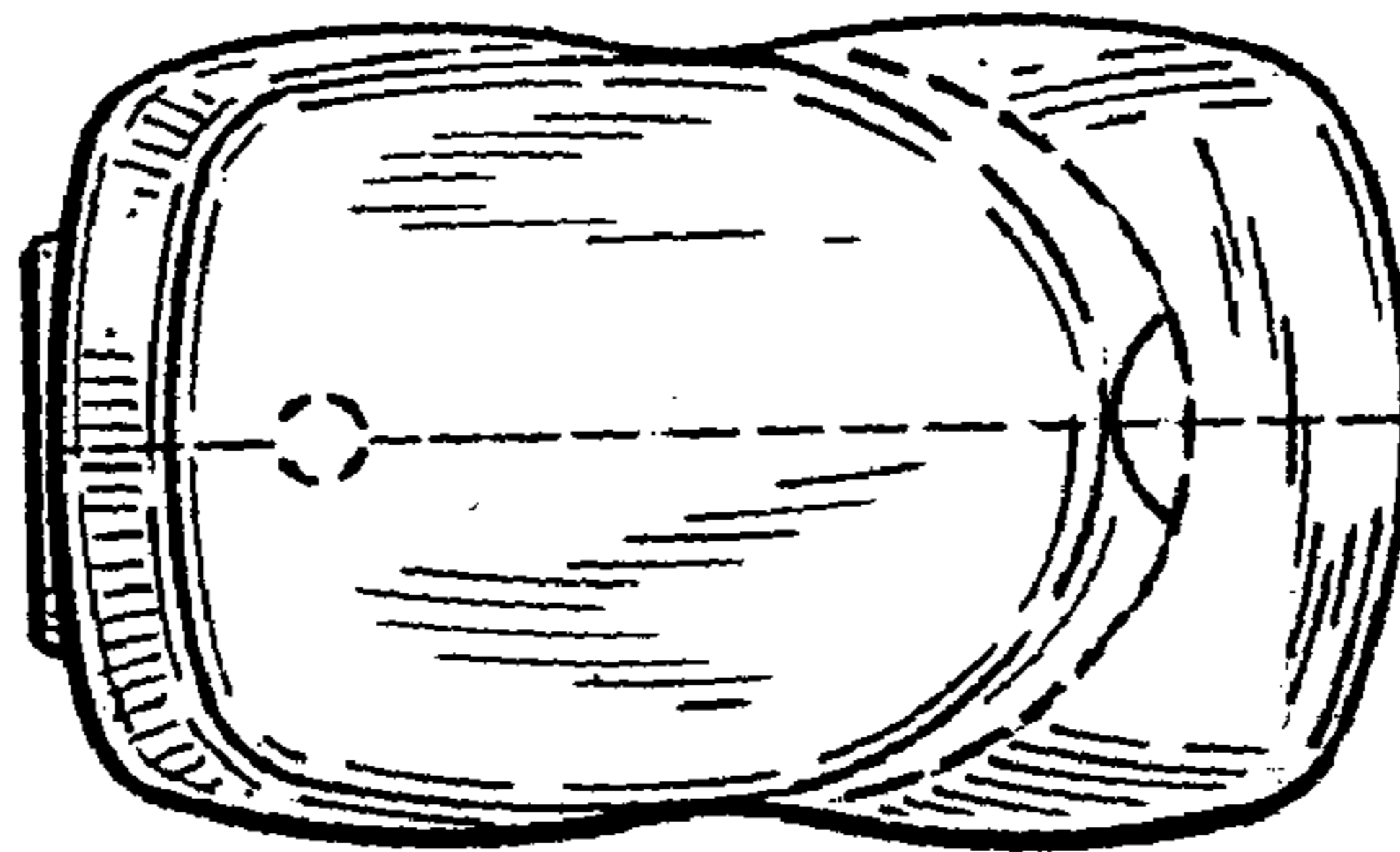

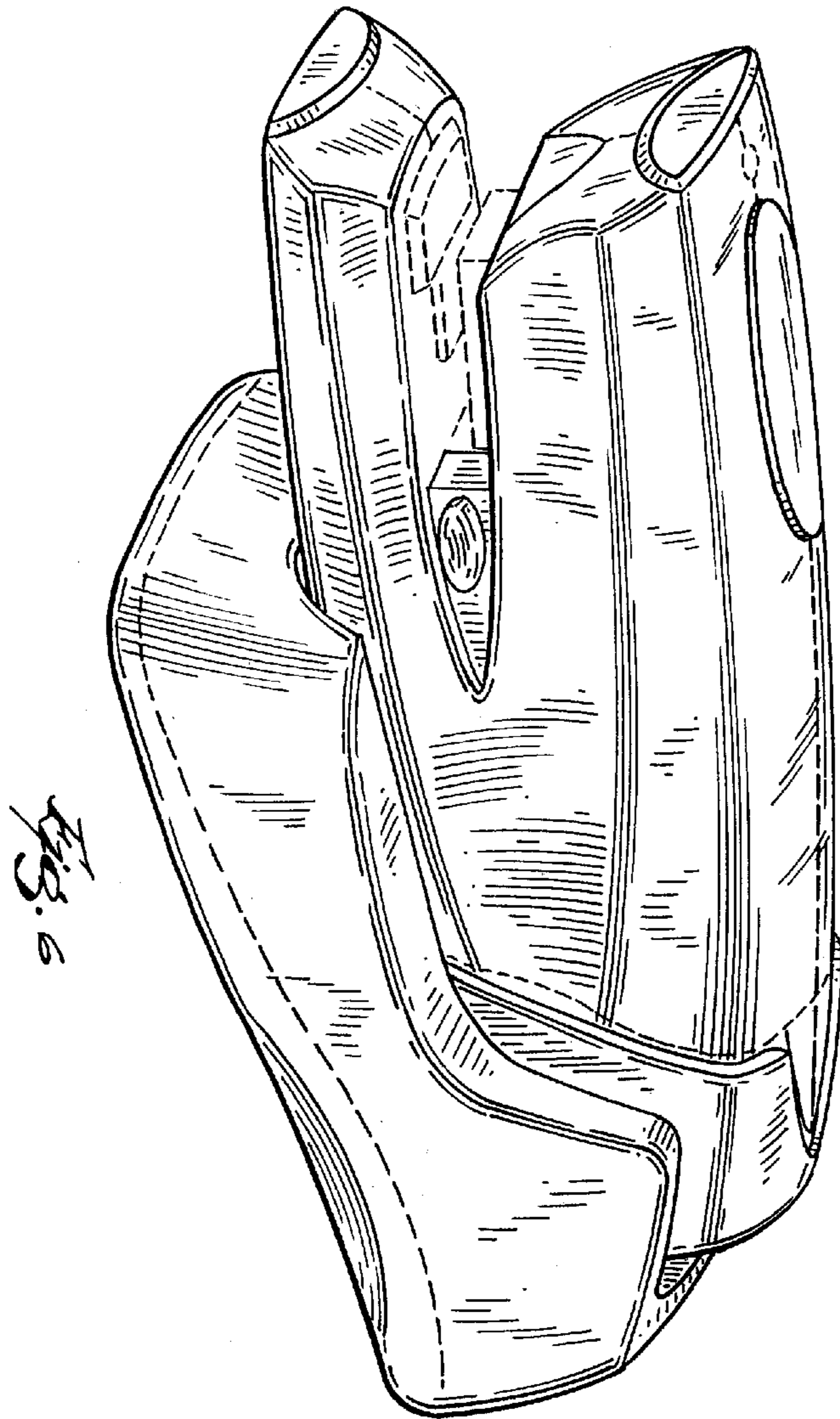
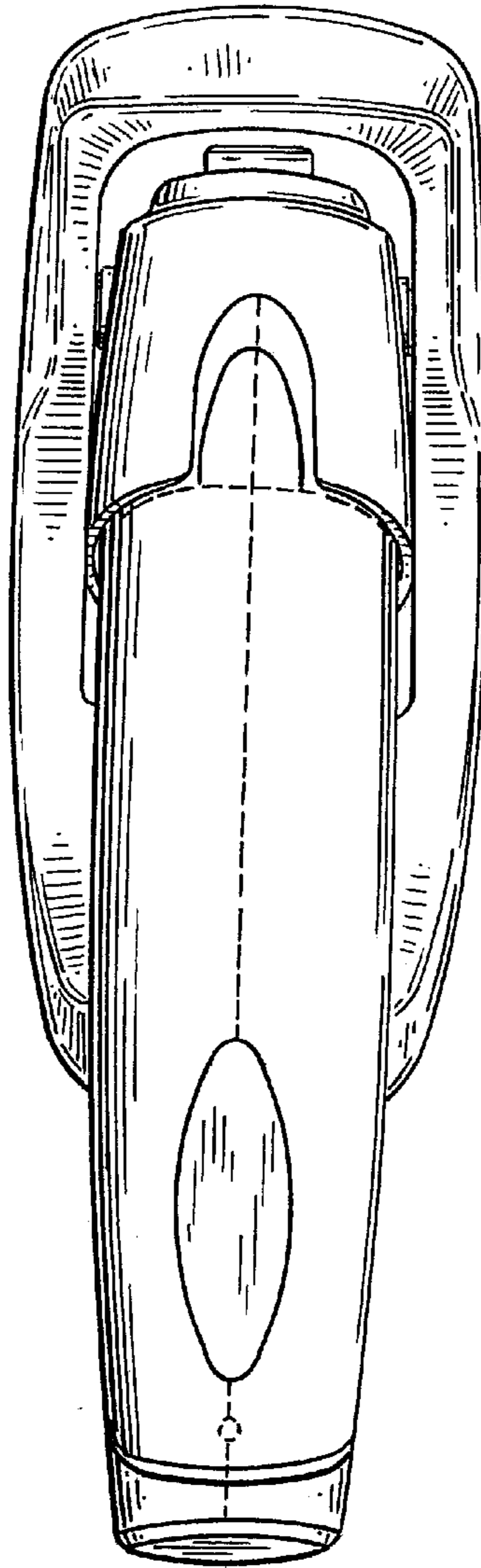

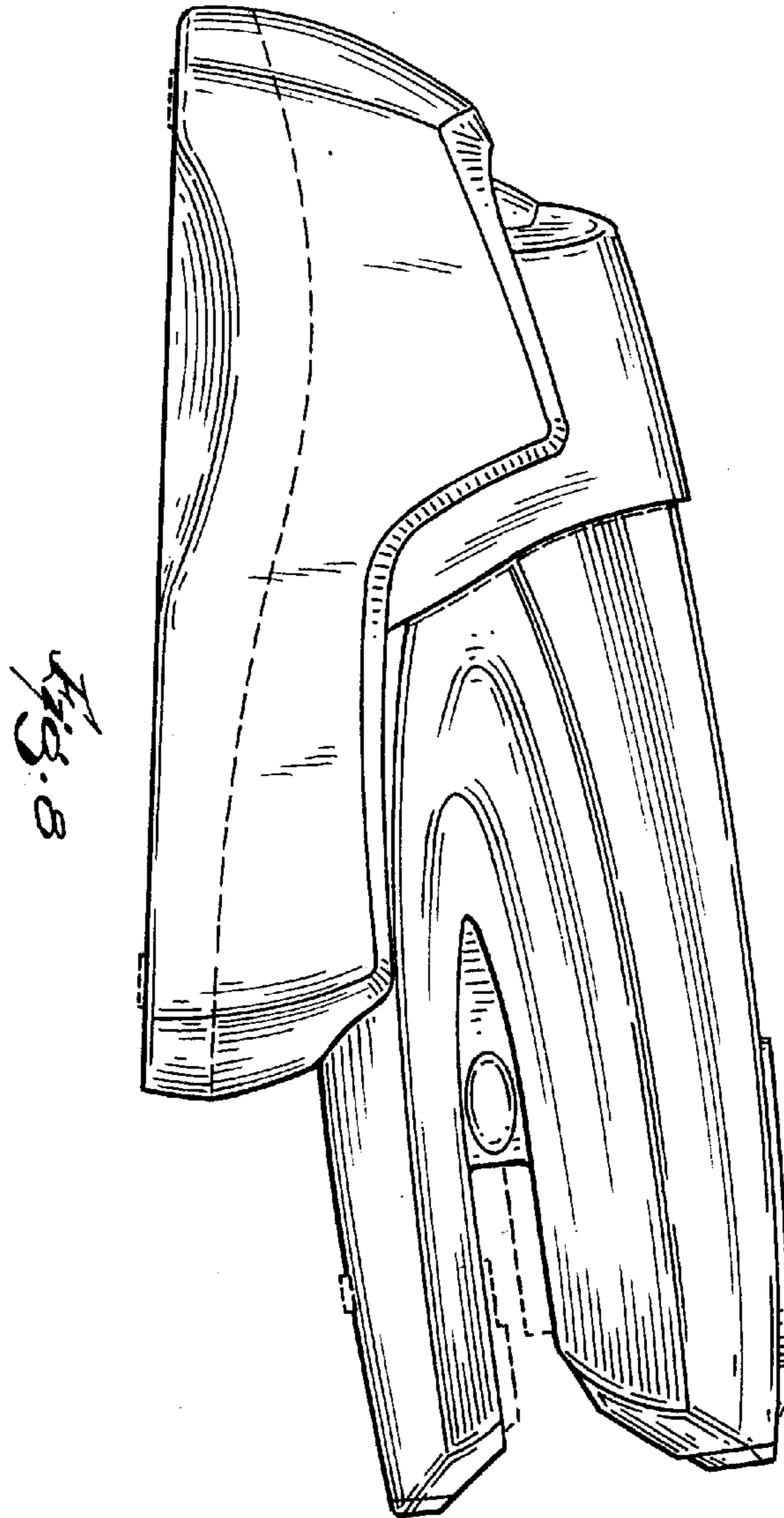

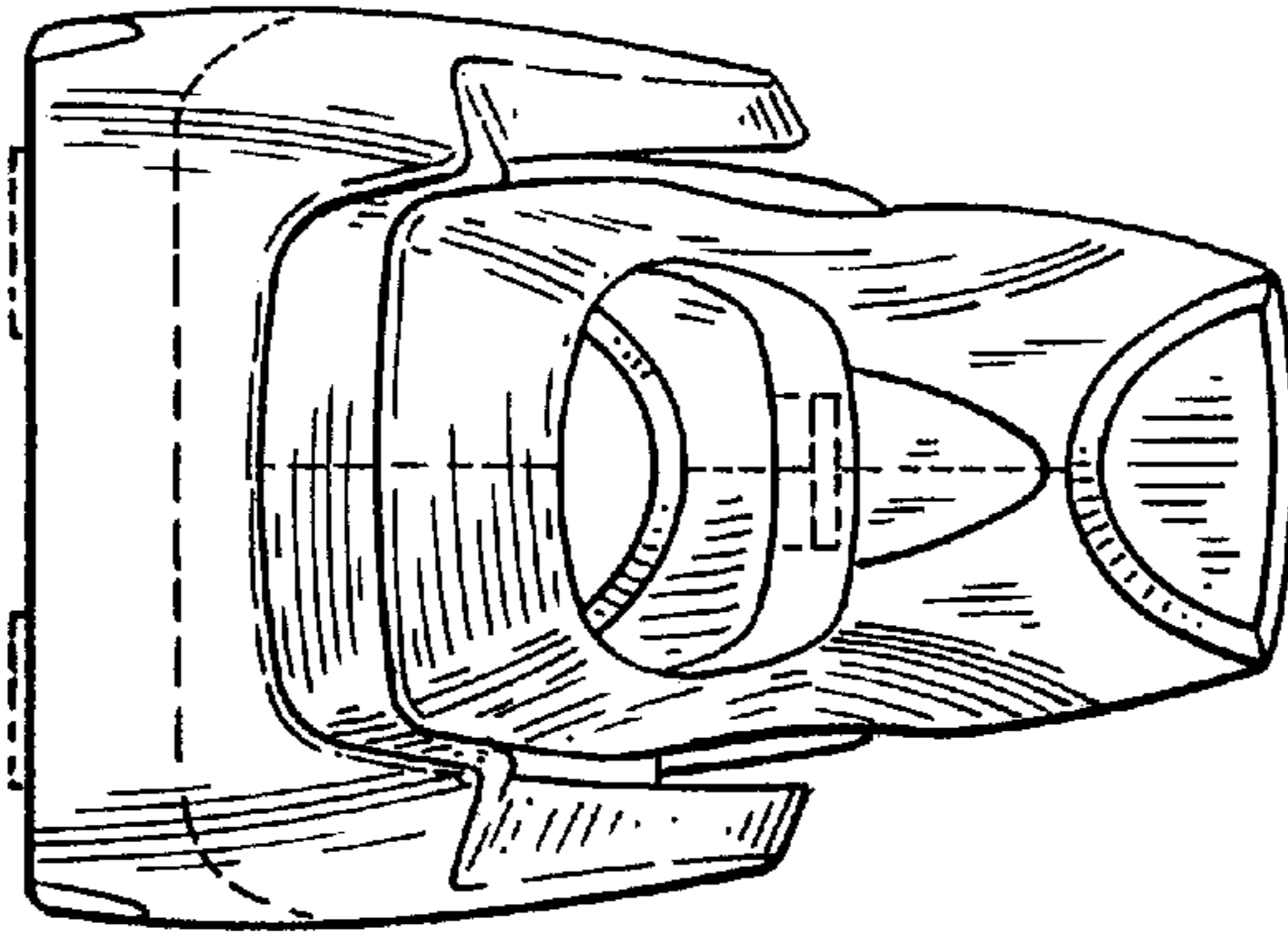
