FIG. 2 is an enlarged top plan view thereof.

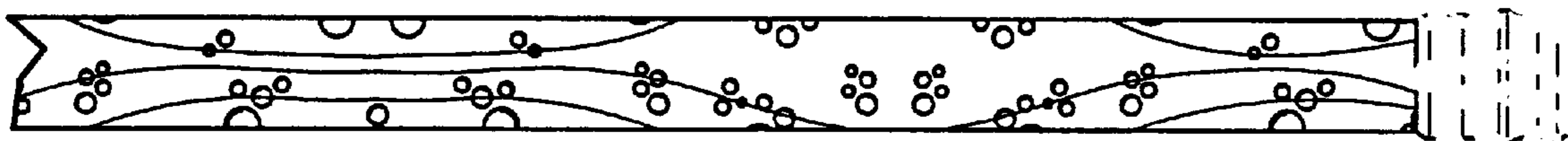
In view of FIG. 1, it is understood that the claimed article is of indeterminate length.

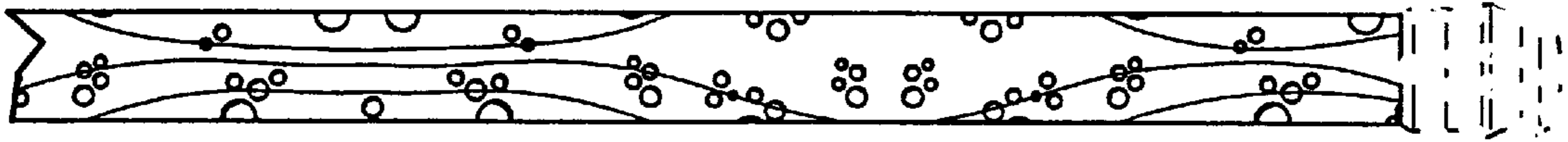

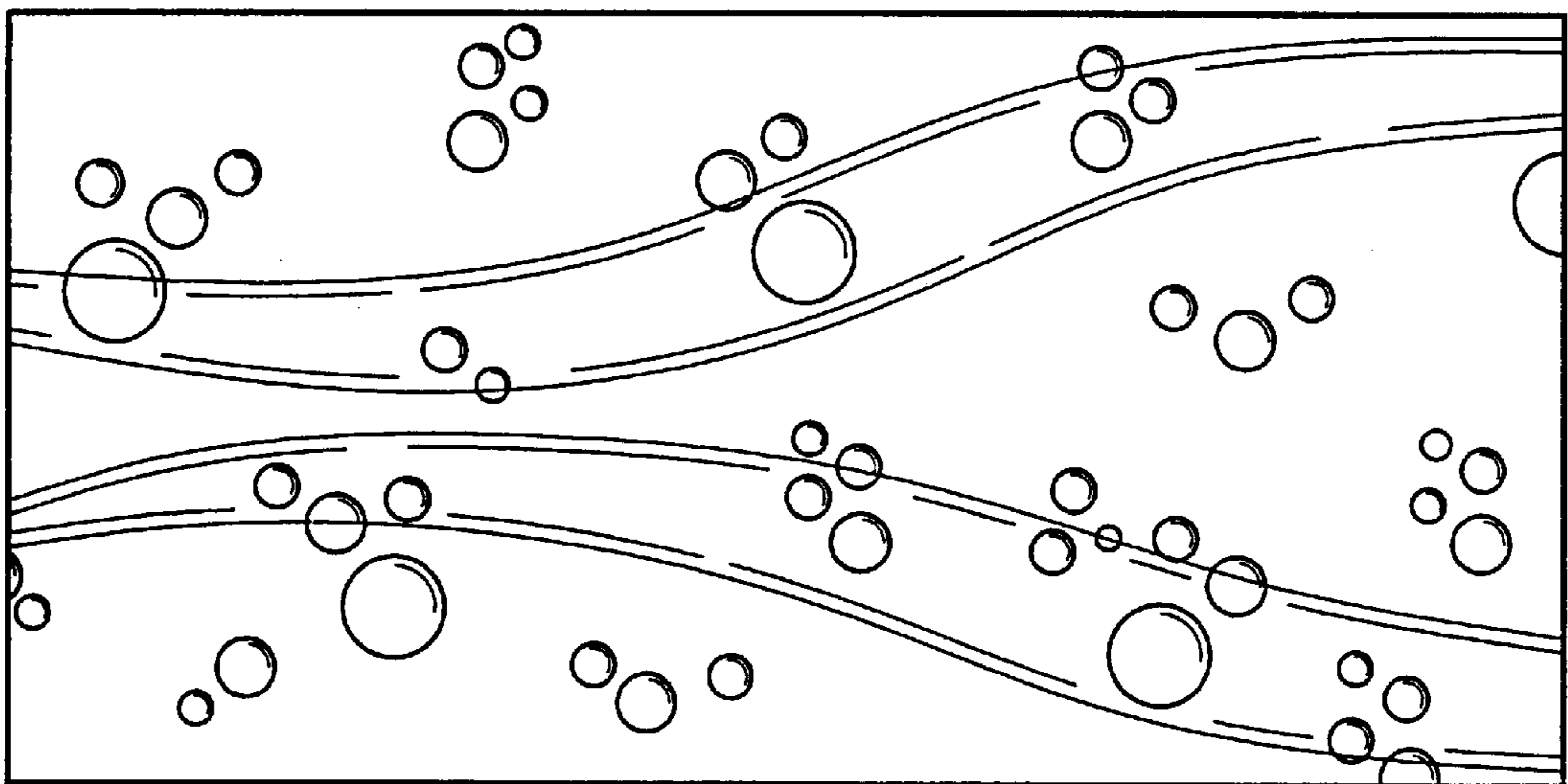
