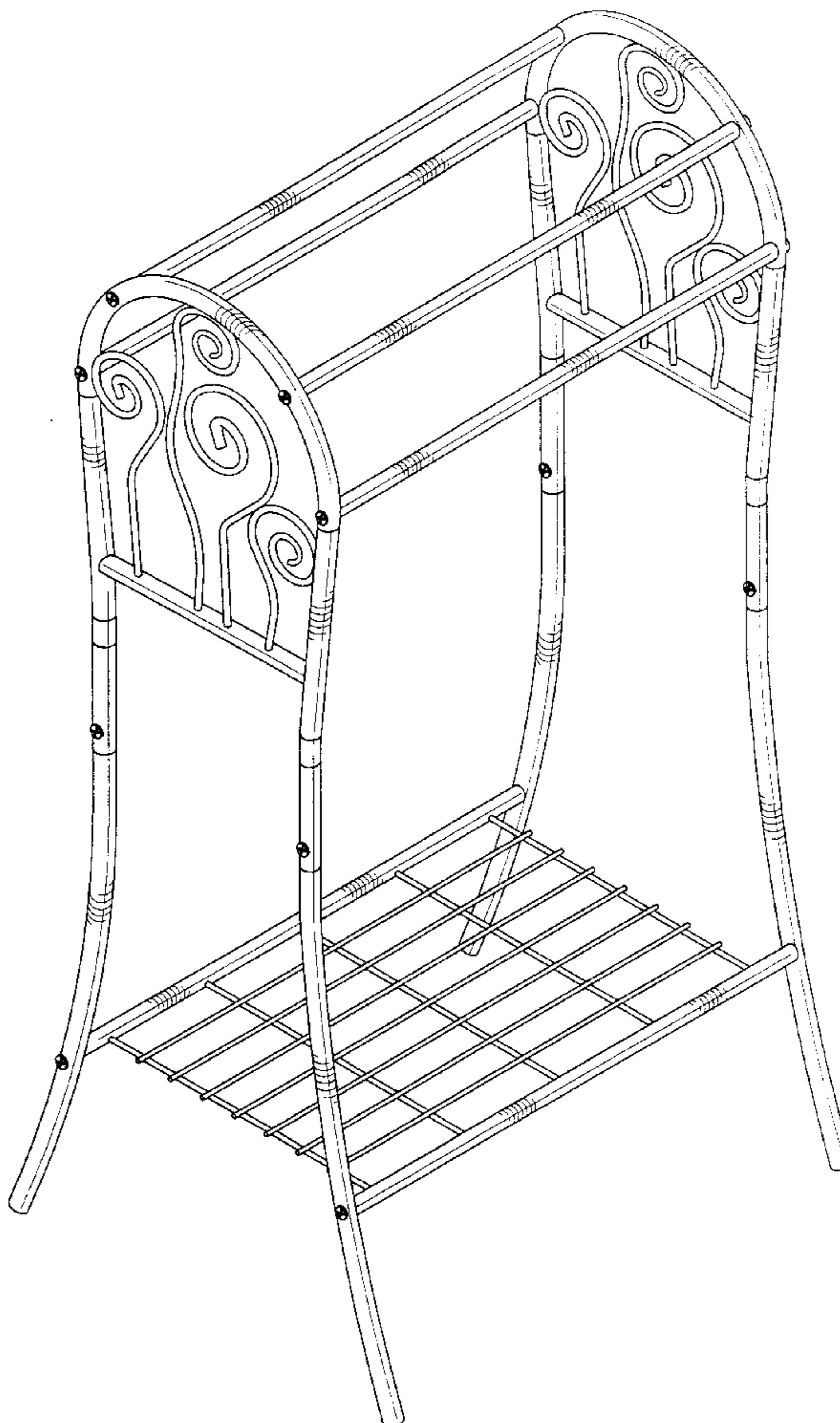
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a towel stand, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a towel stand showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown;  
FIG. 3 is an end view thereof, the opposite end being a mirror image of the end shown;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and  
FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof.

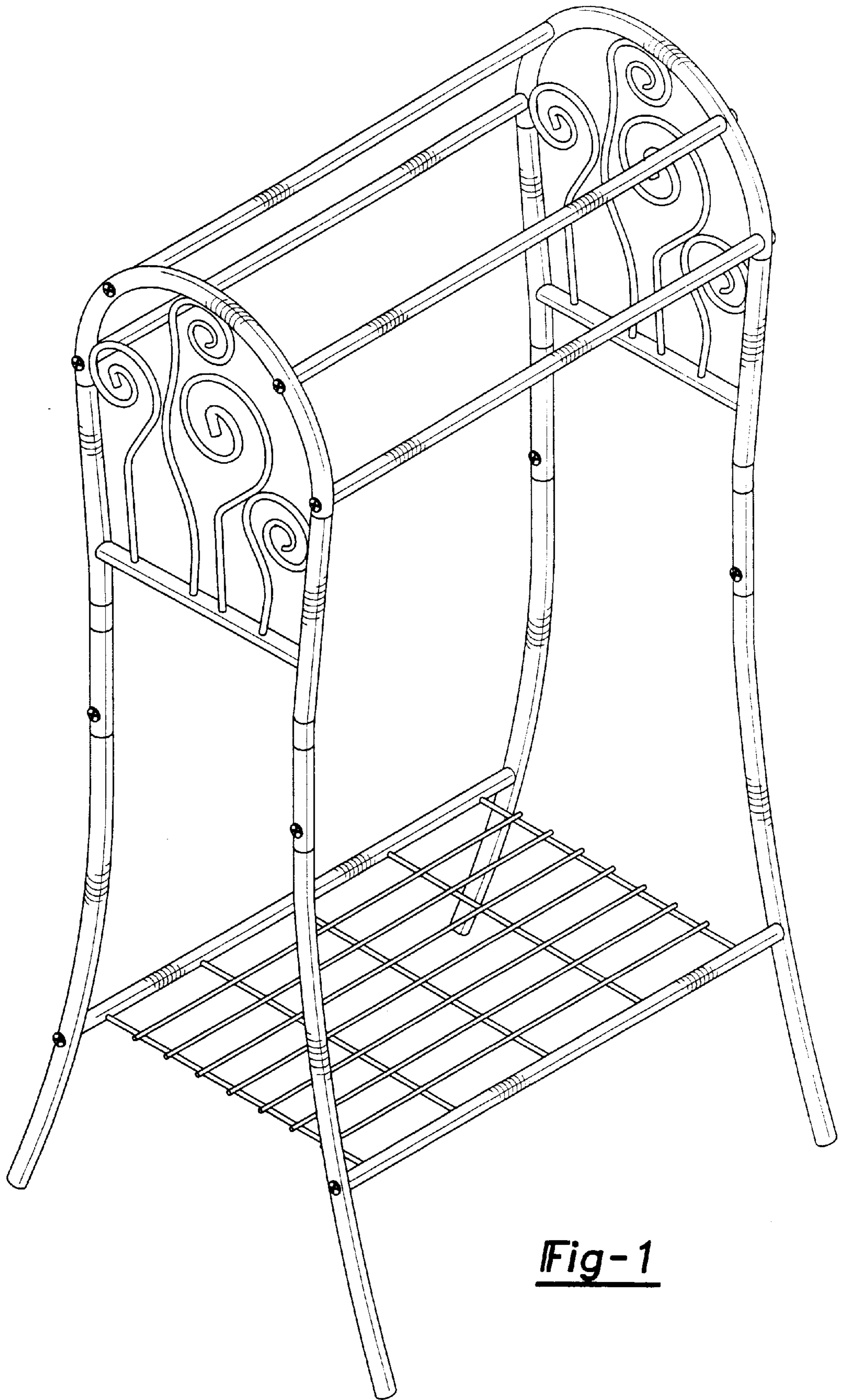

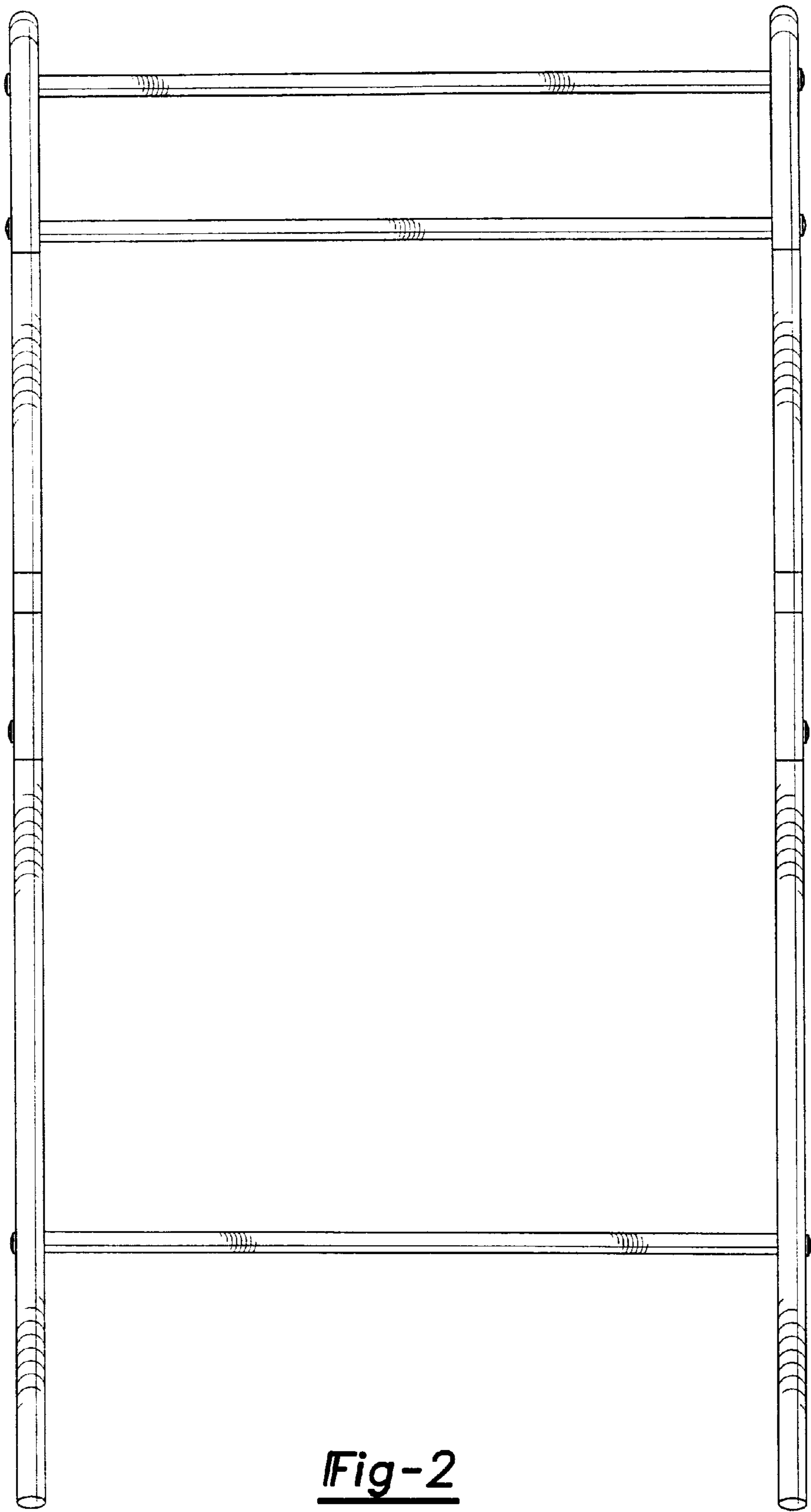

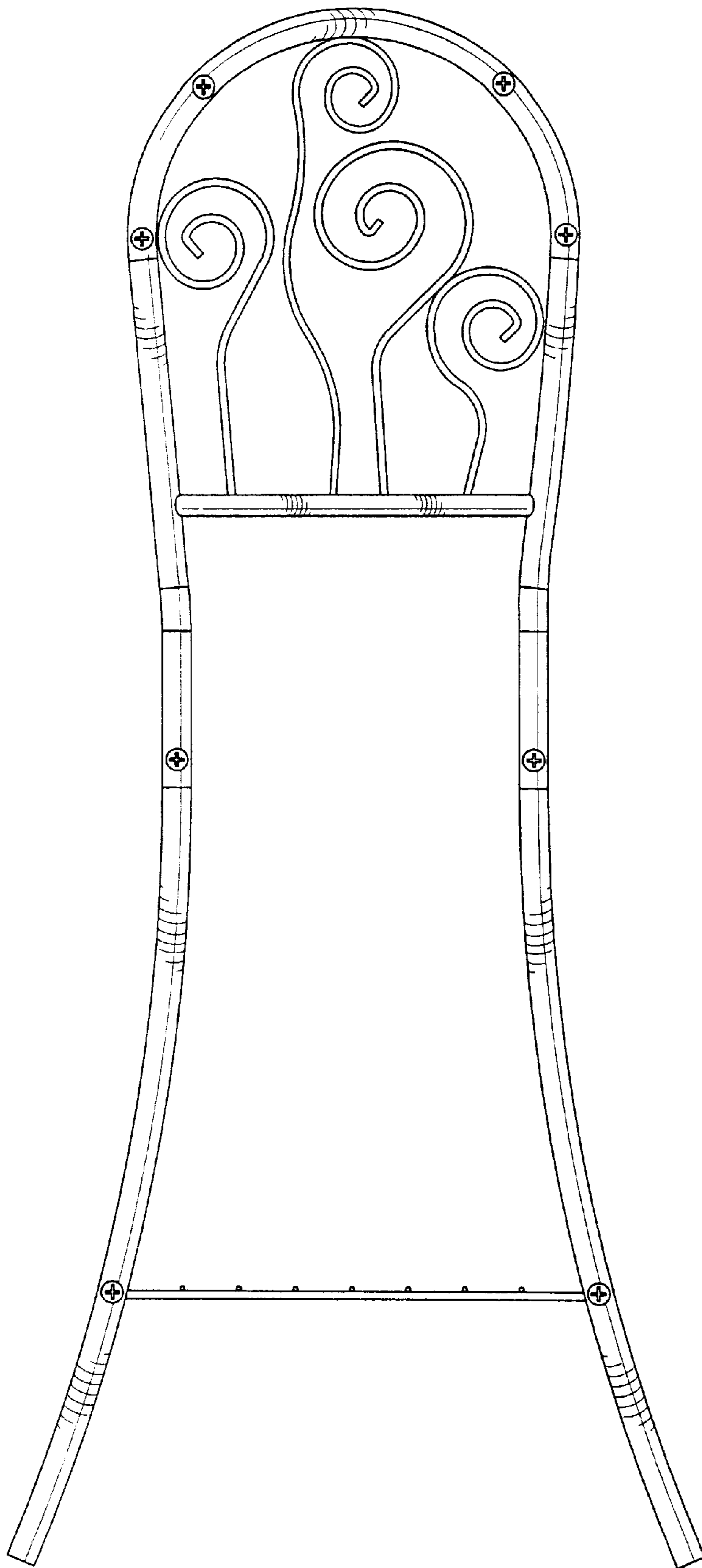

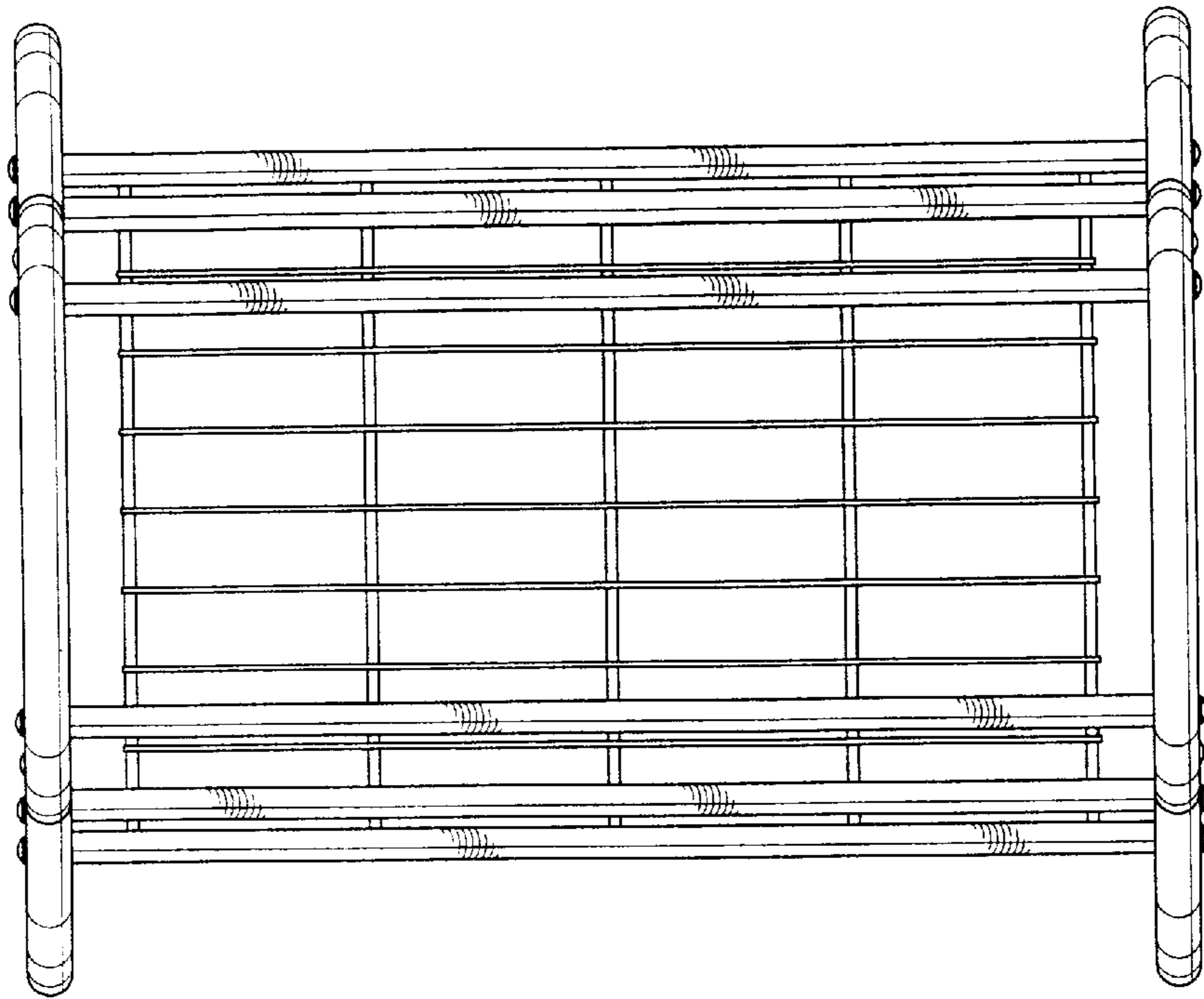

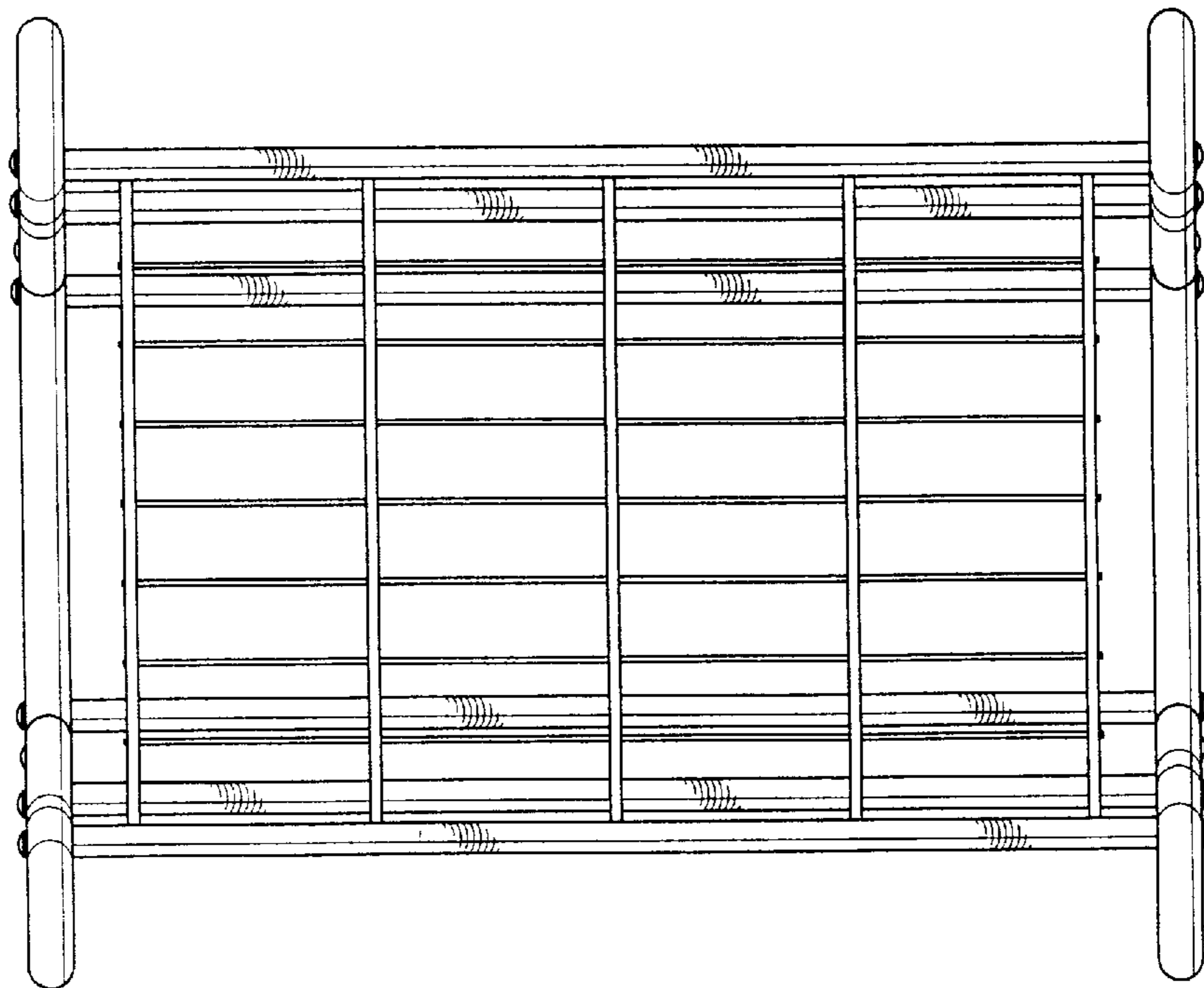
