FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a table showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 4 is a top view thereof.

The views of the table not shown form no part of the claimed design. The separation and bracket in FIGS. 1, 2, and 3 indicate, for ease of illustration, that the precise height of the table is not claimed. The lines on the top and sides indicate surface shading.
