(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a child's blanket, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a child's blanket, with portions shown in dotted lines for environmental purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a left side view thereof (the right side is a mirror image);

FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a child's blanket of a second embodiment of my new design, with portions shown in dotted lines for environmental purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 7 is a left side view thereof of the second embodiment (the right side is a mirror image);

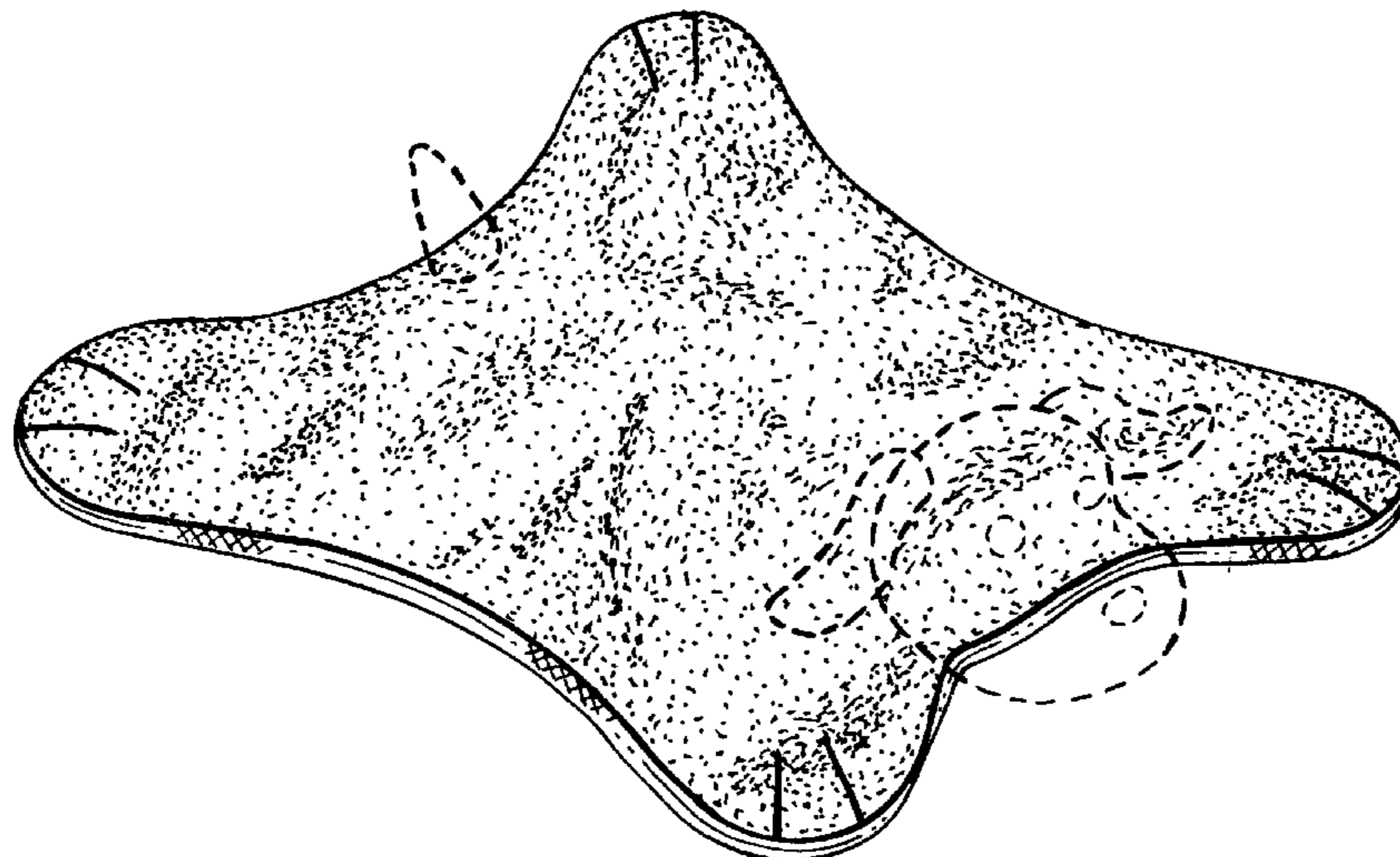
FIG. 8 is a front view thereof of the second embodiment;

FIG. 9 is a rear view thereof of the second embodiment; and,

FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view thereof of the second embodiment.

The stippling shown on the top of the blanket in FIG. 1, and in other figures, denotes a loose fabric surface with folds.

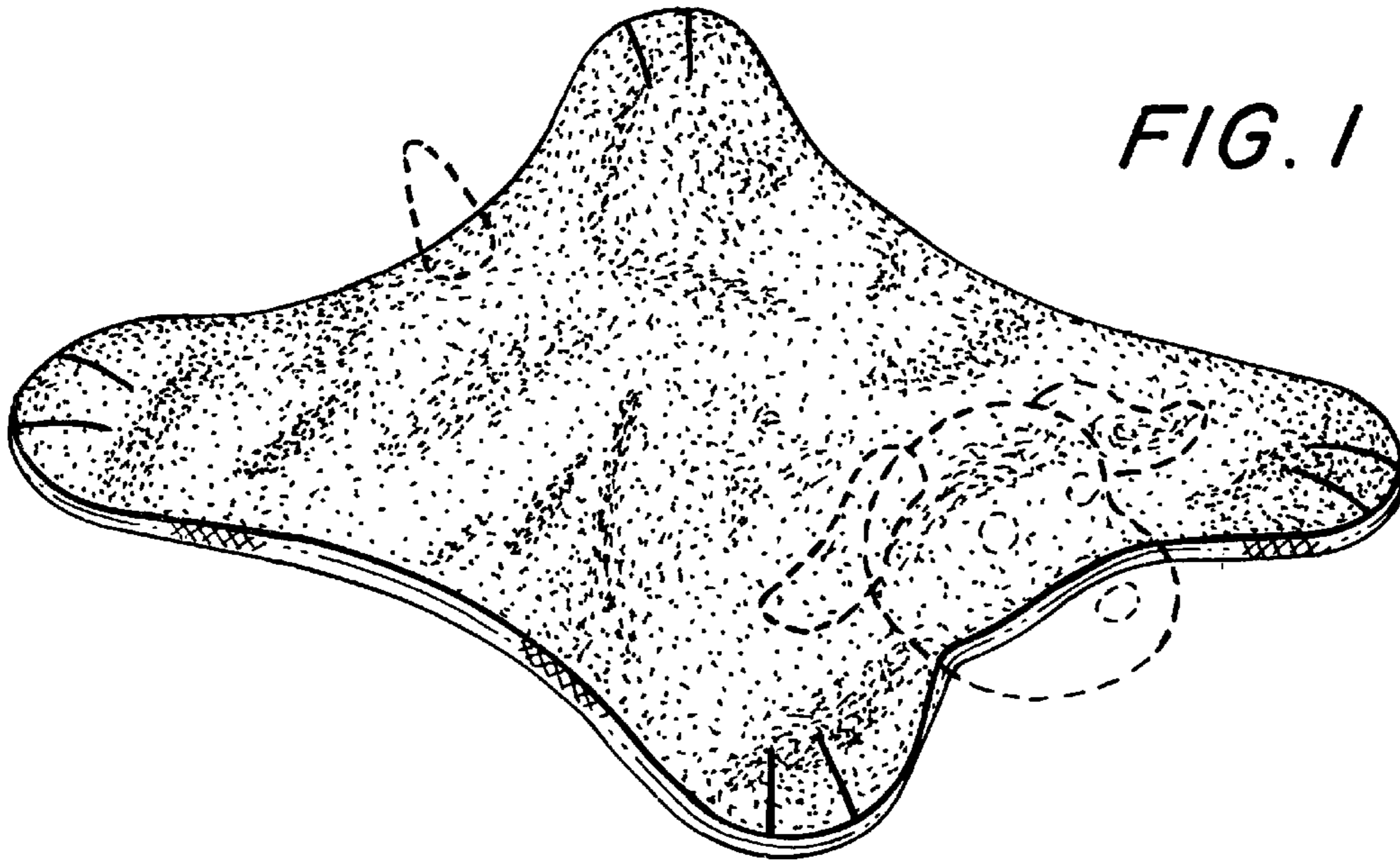

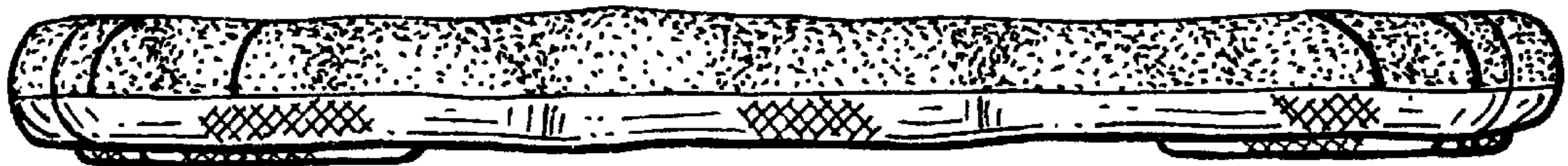

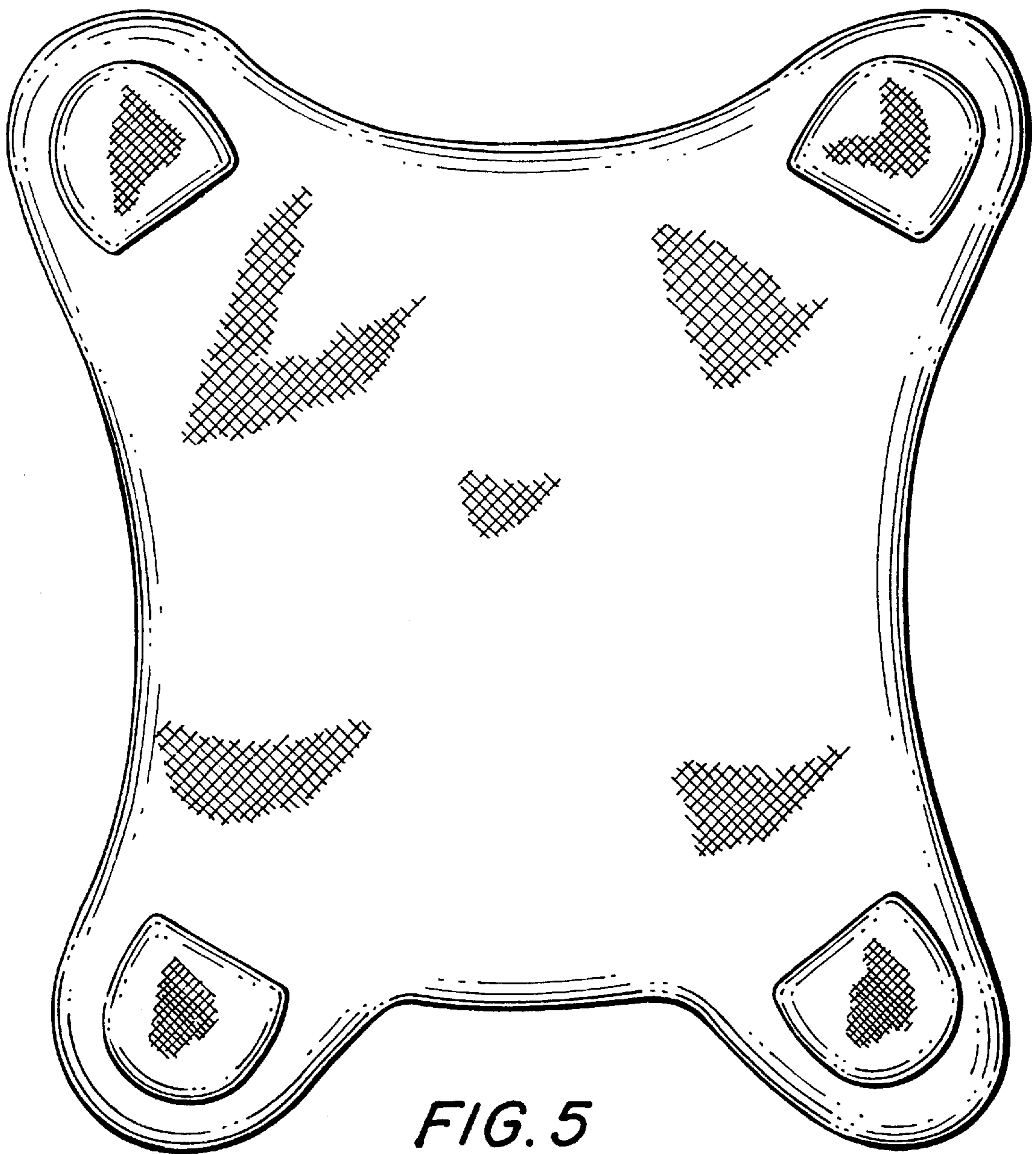

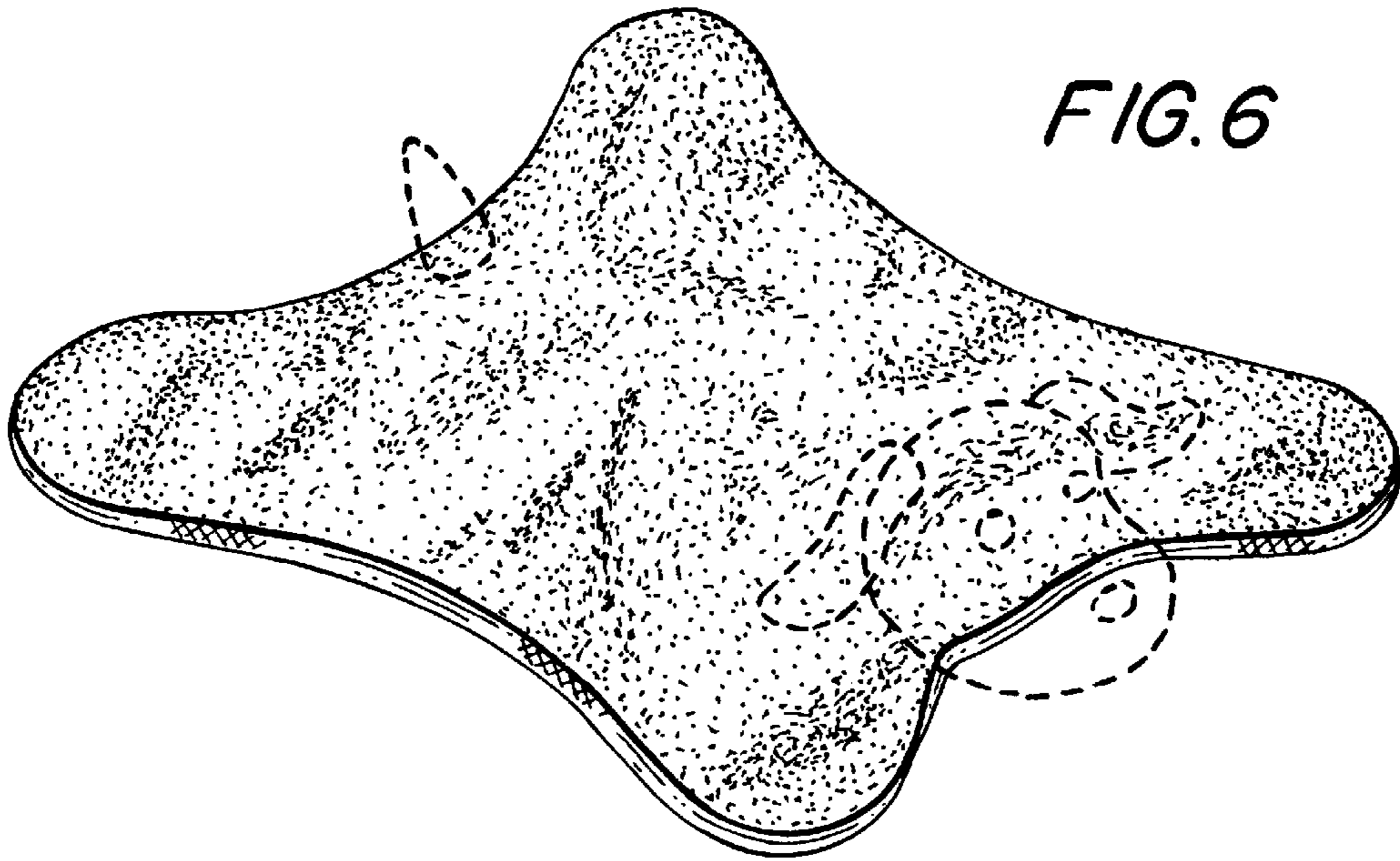

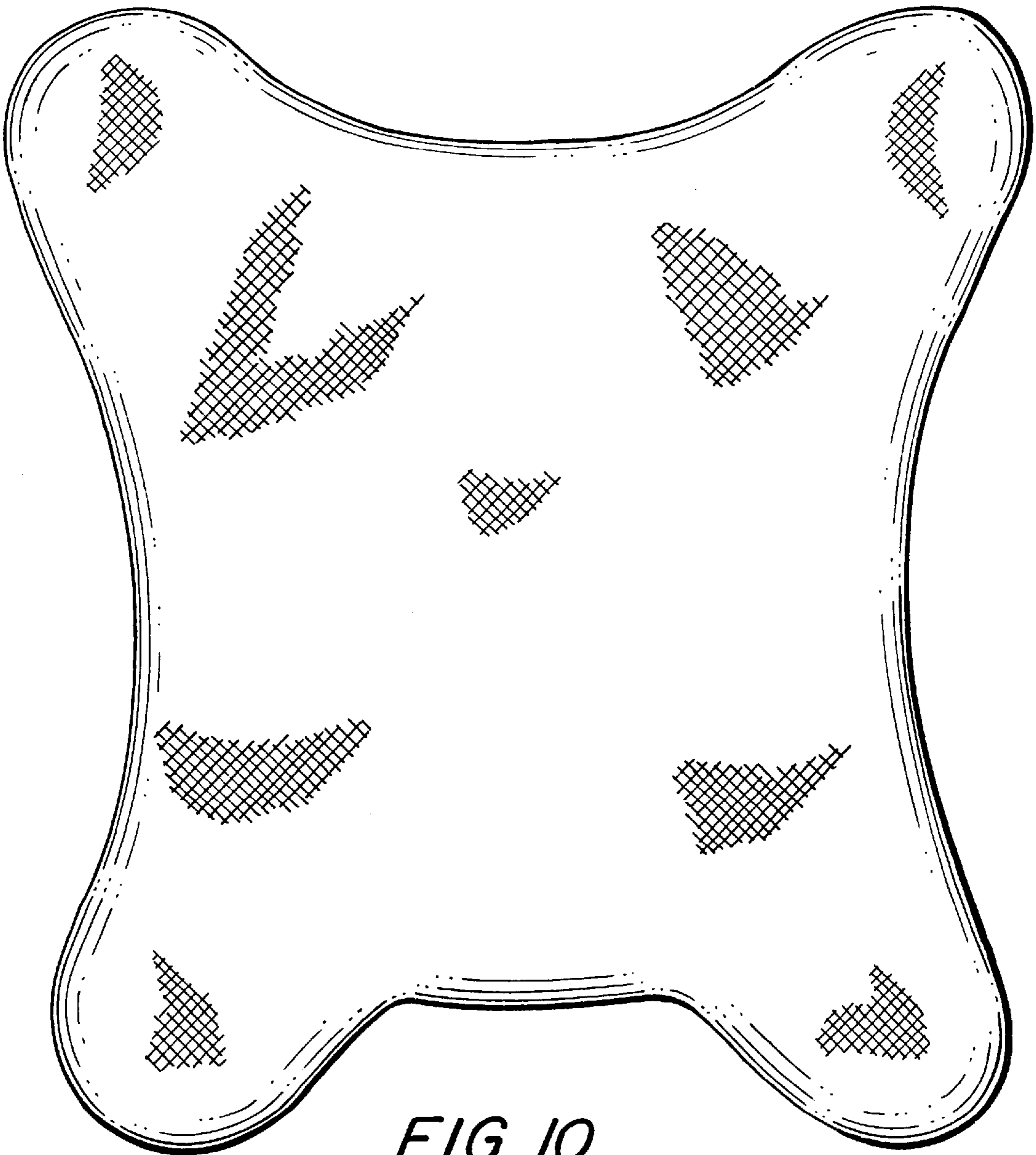
