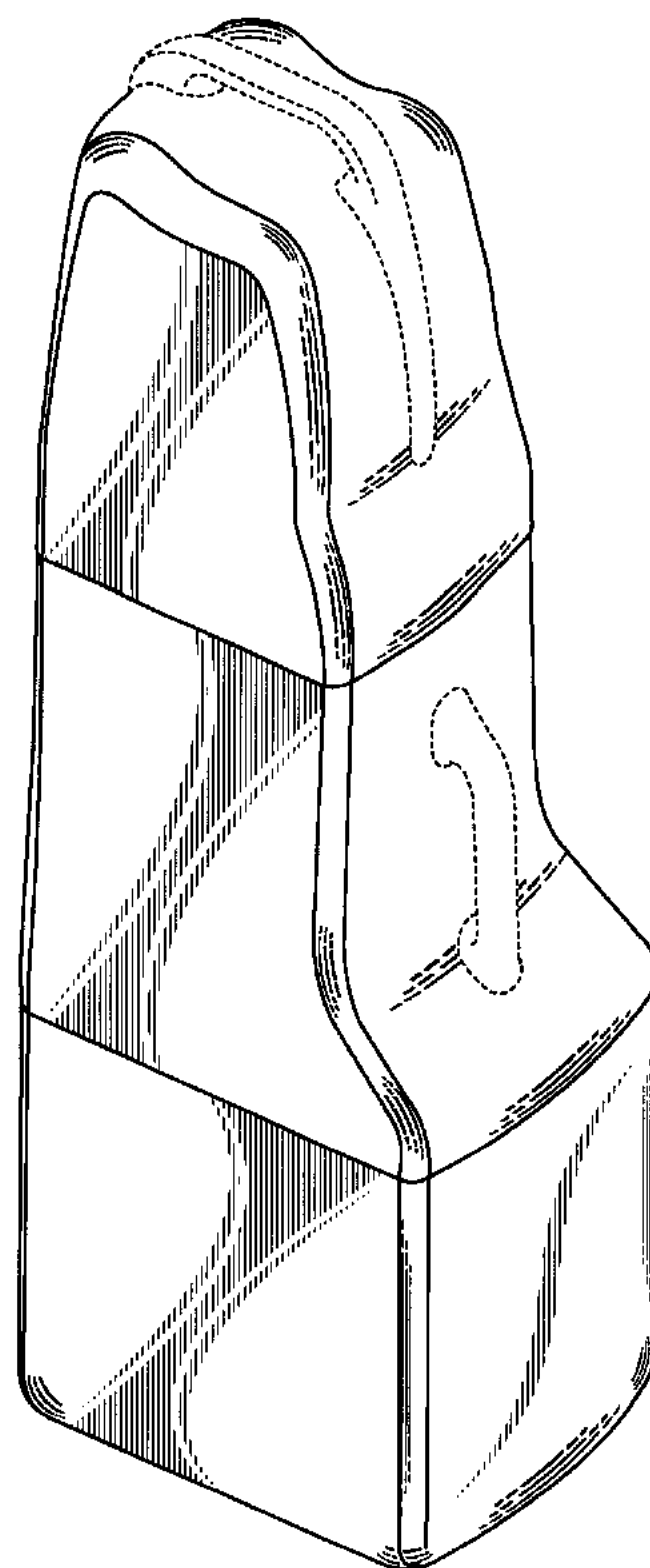

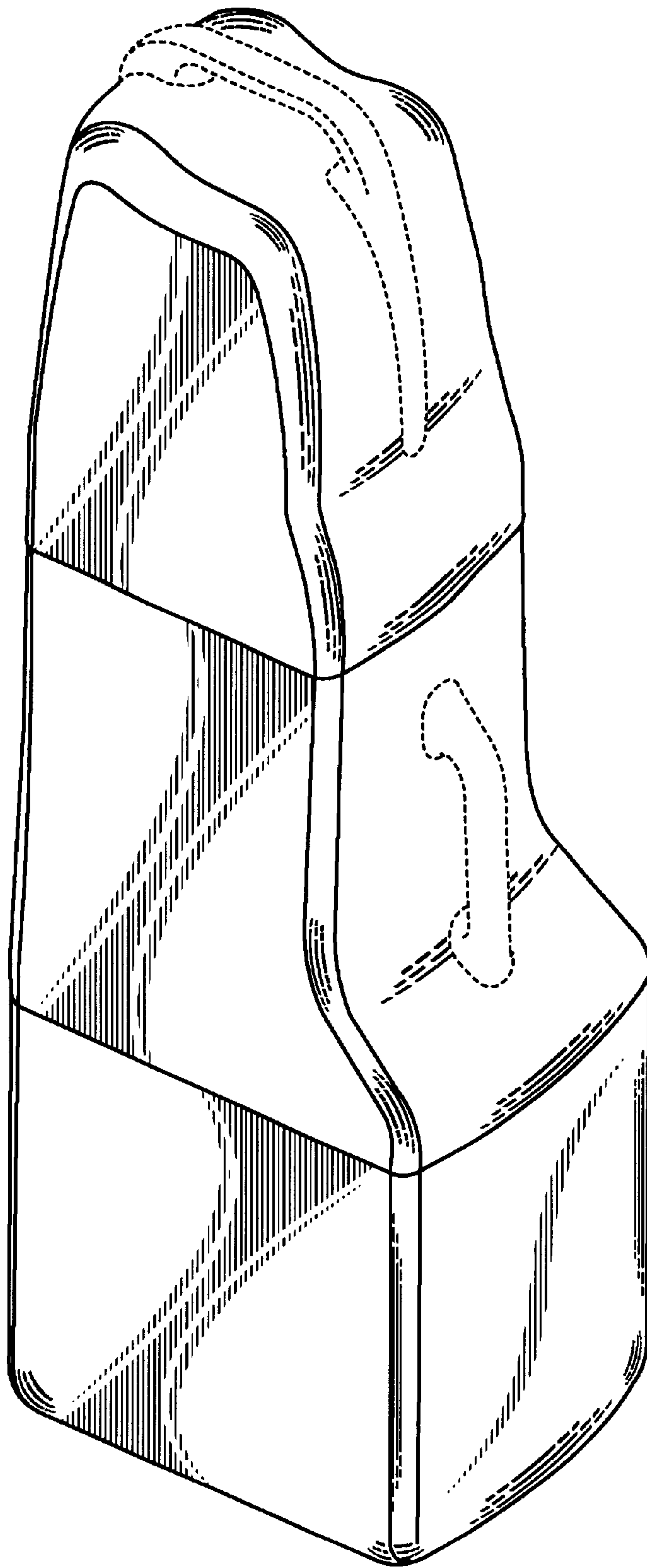

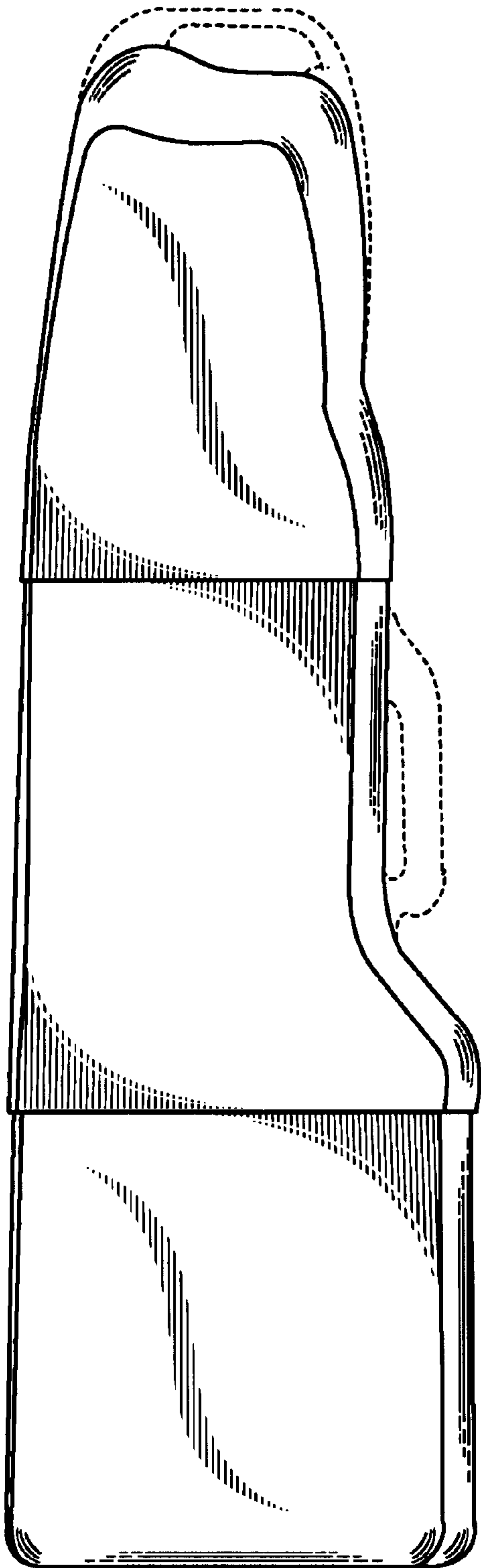
FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing the front and left side

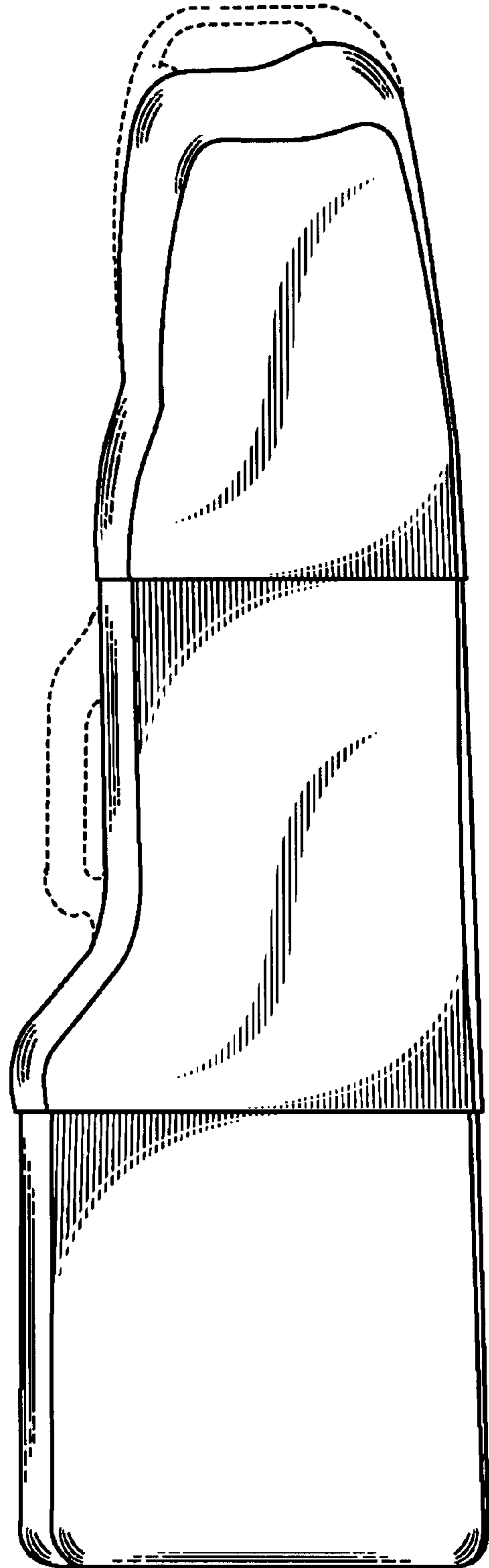




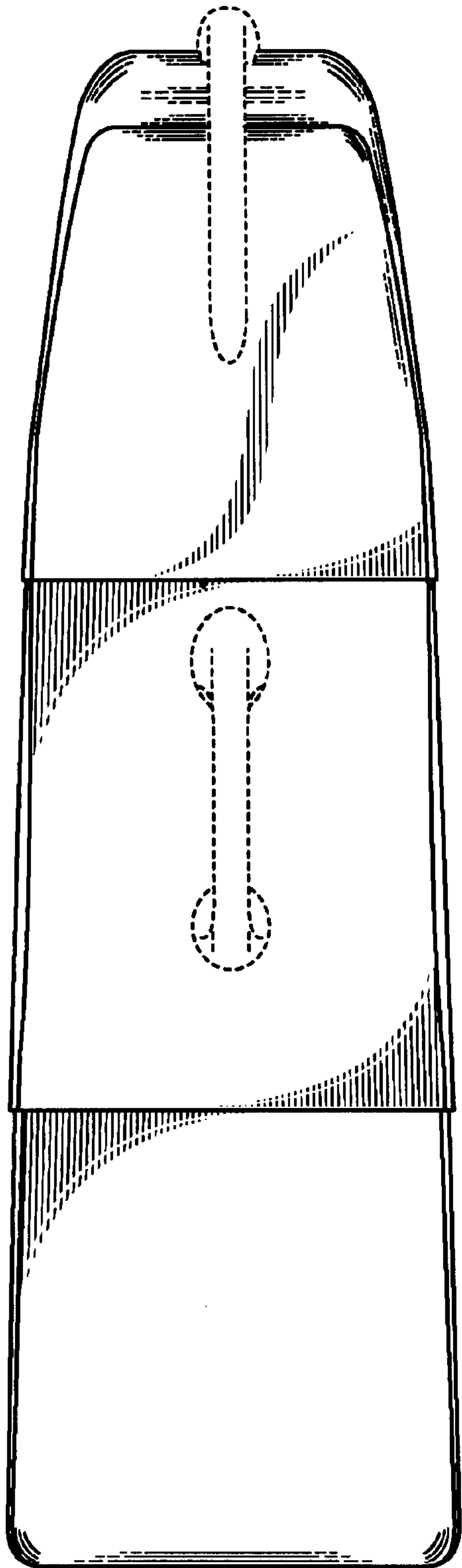

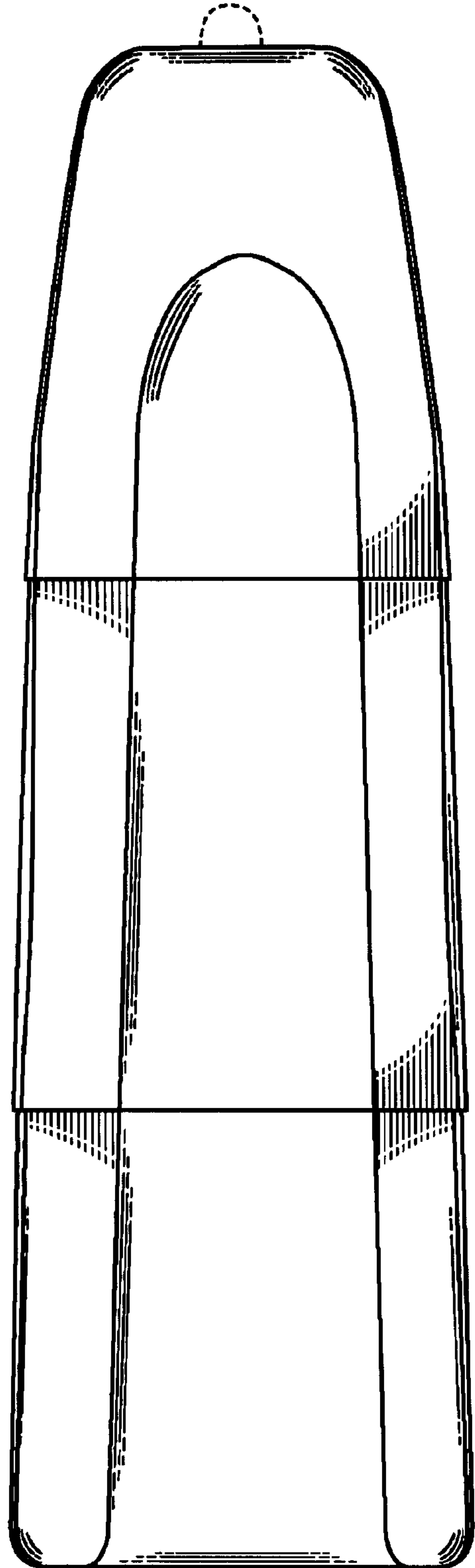

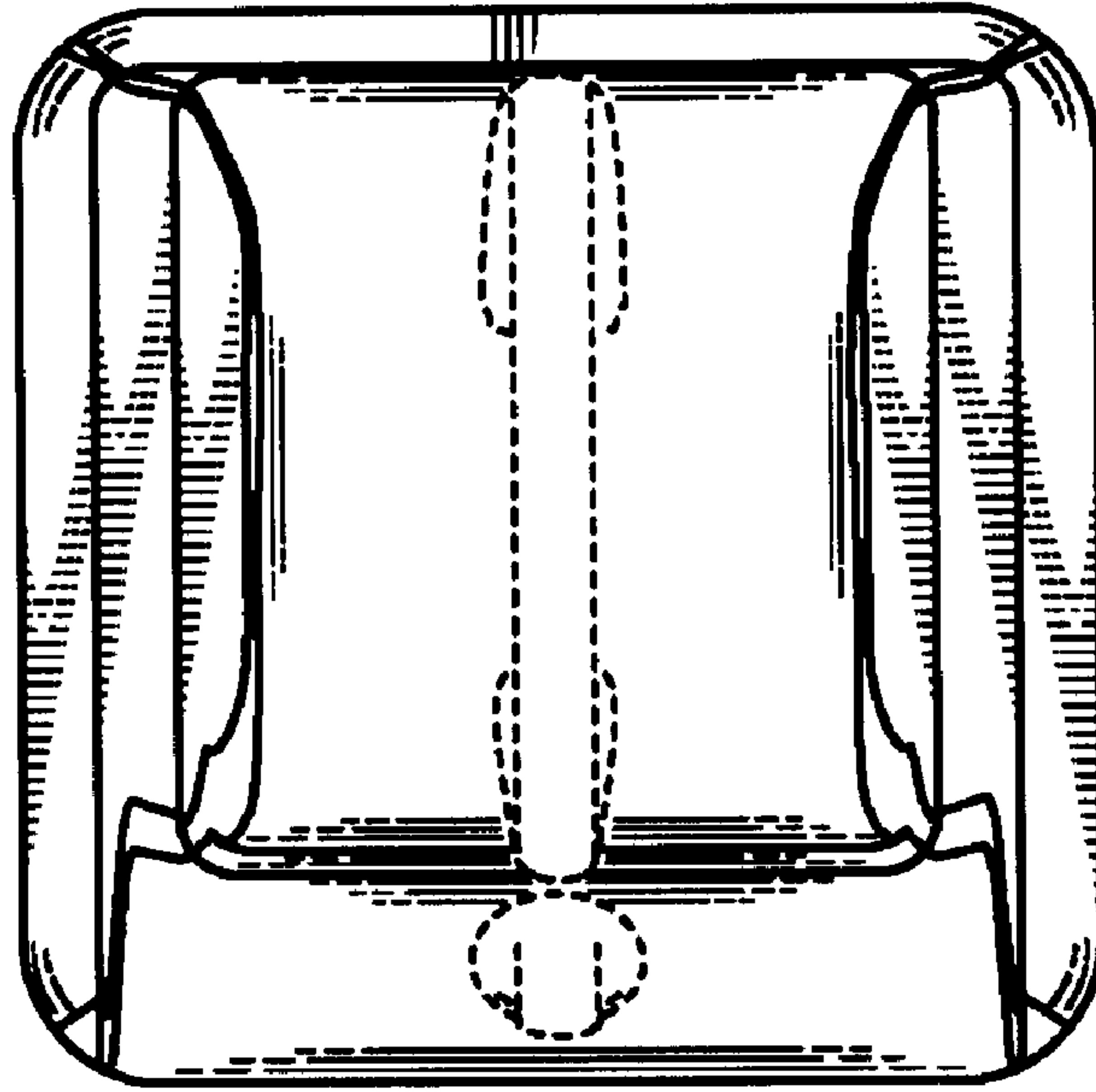

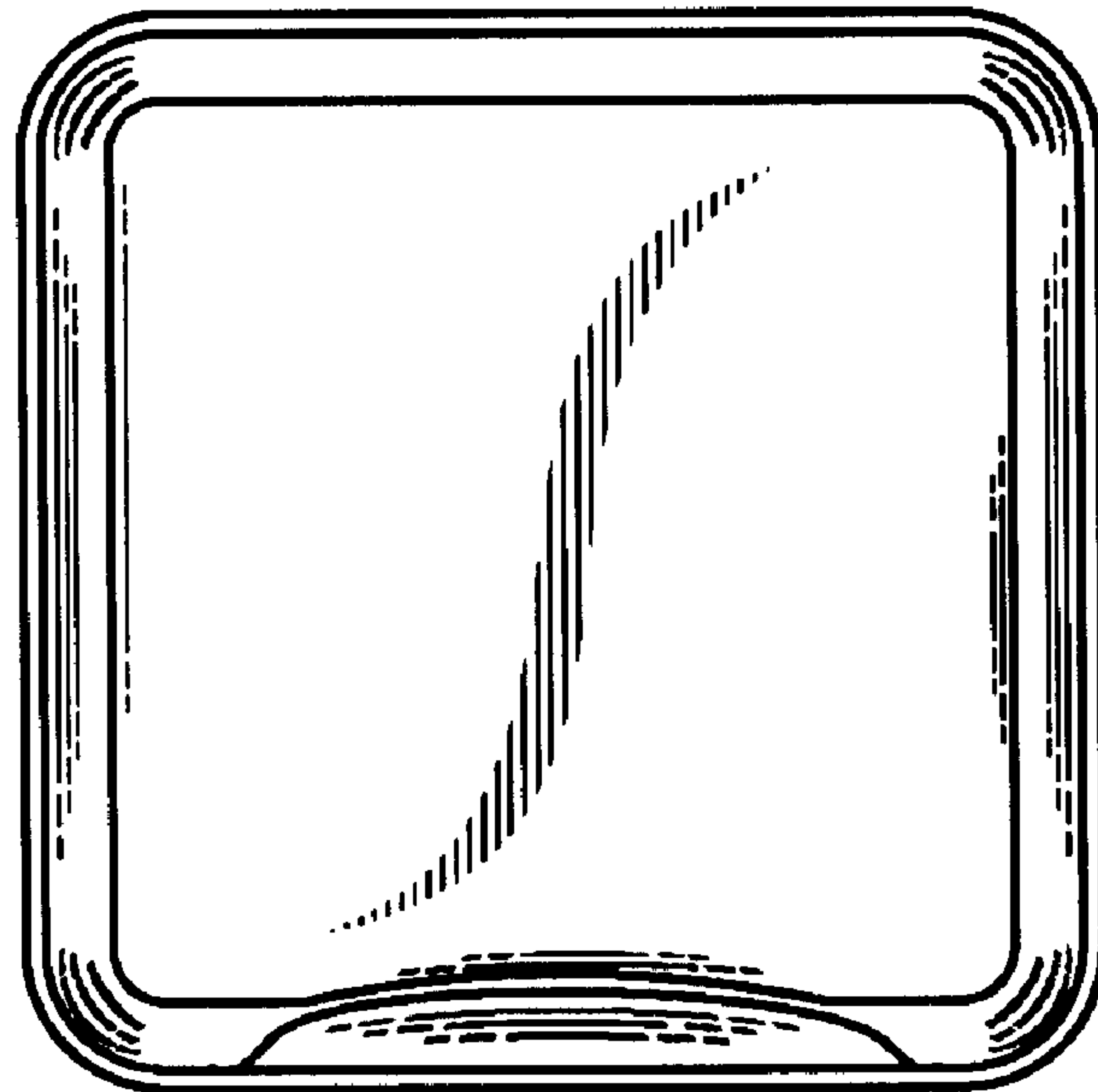
