(57) **CLAIM**

FIG. 4 is a view thereof, taken from above;

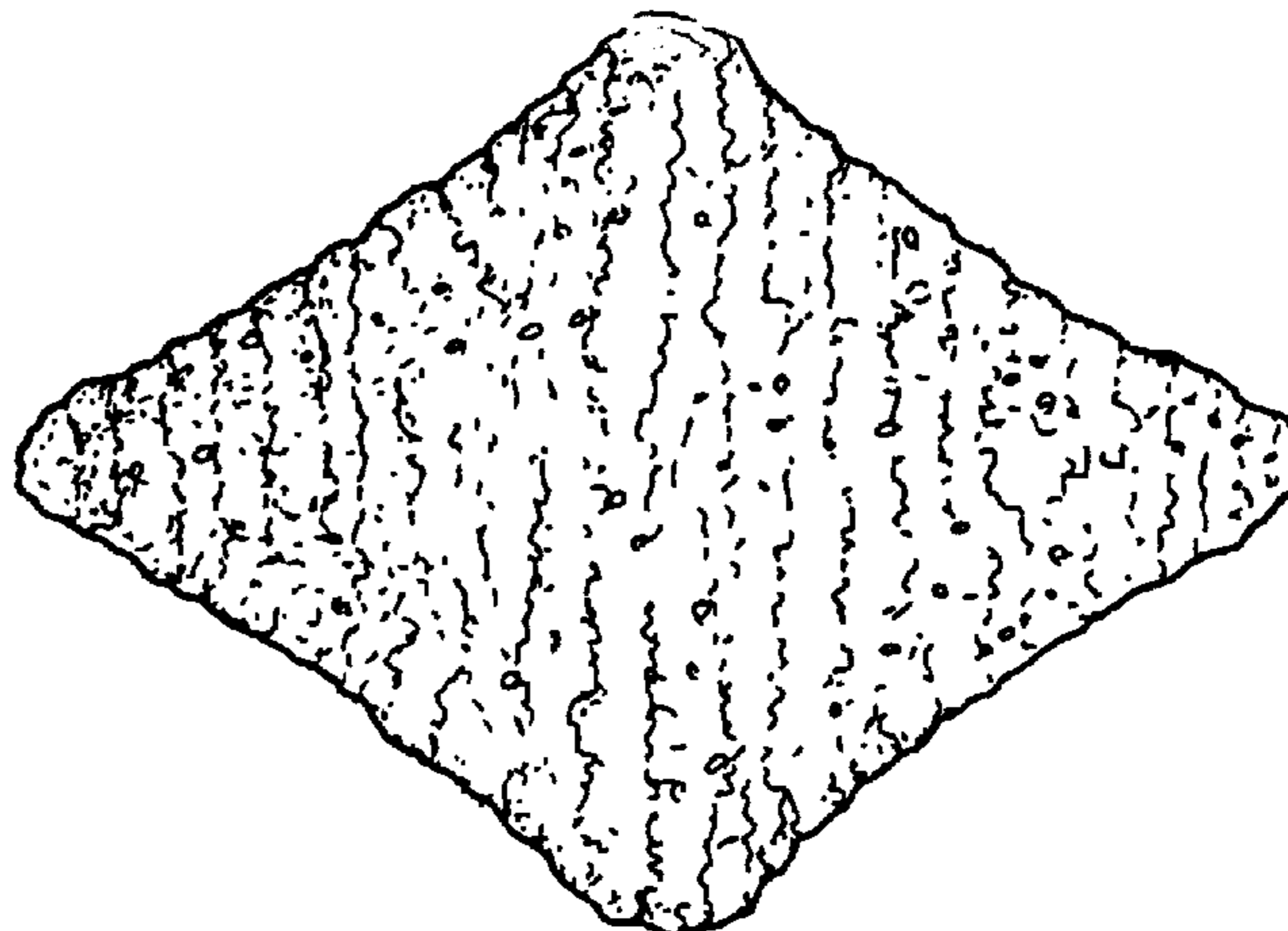
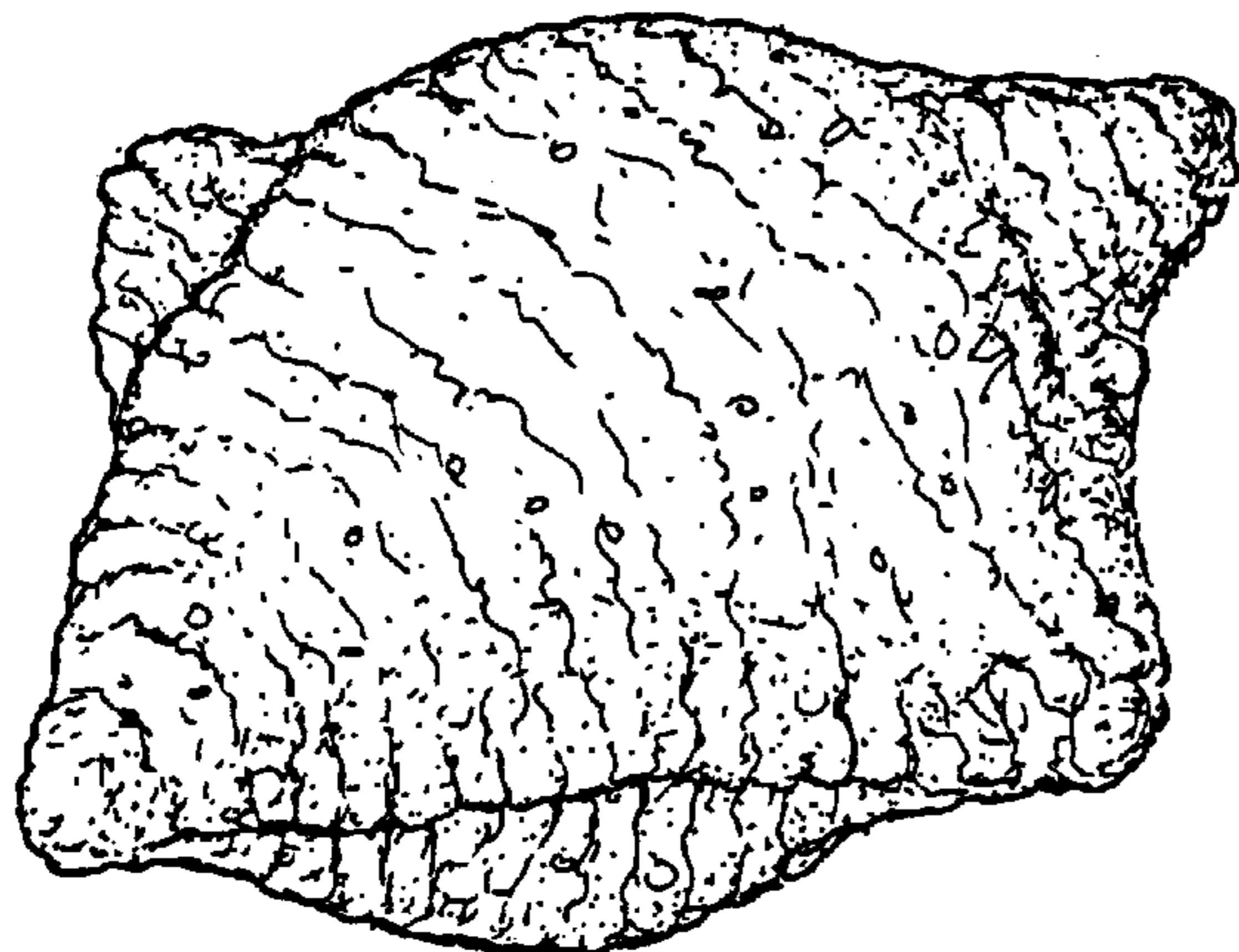
FIG. 5 is a view thereof, taken from below;

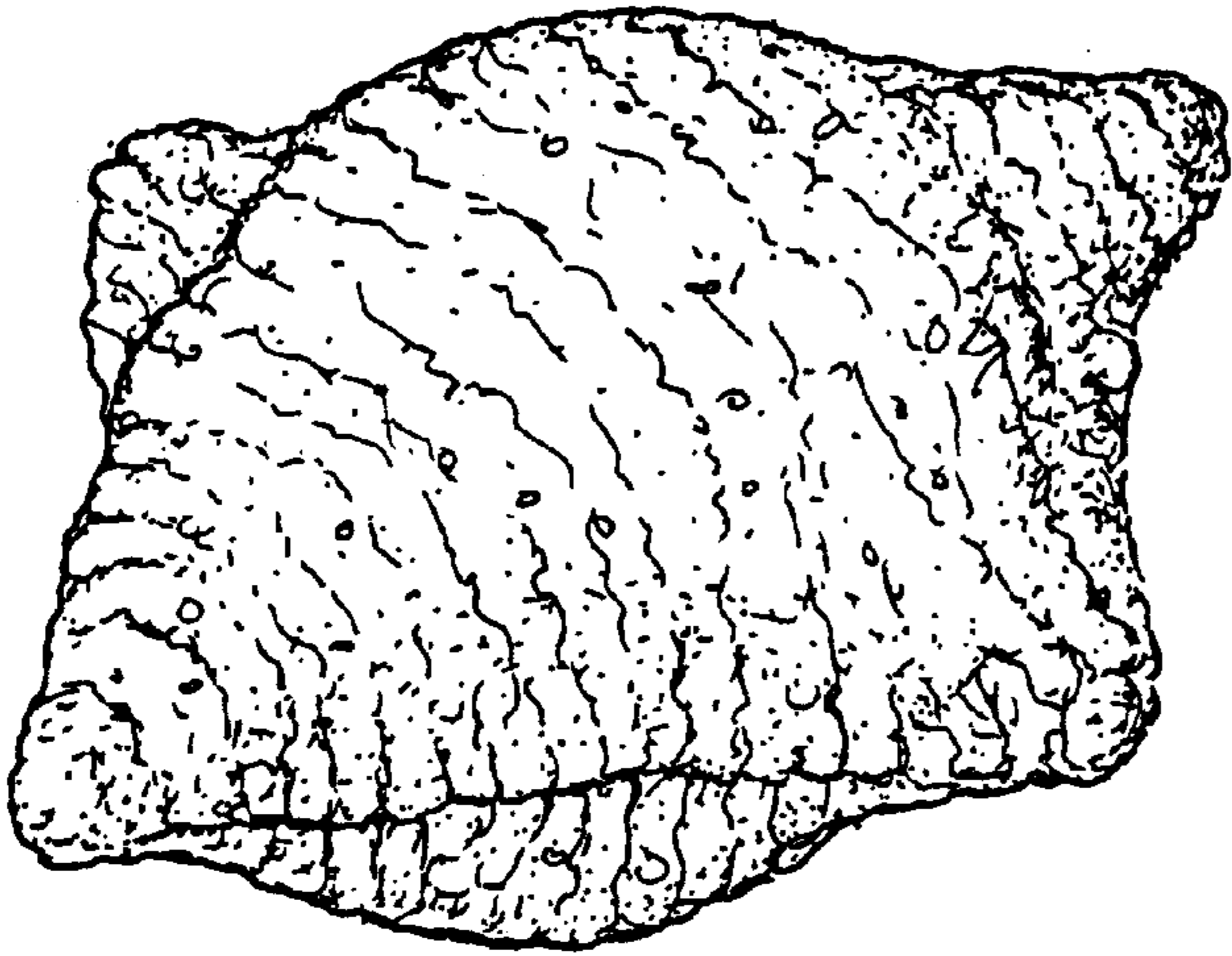

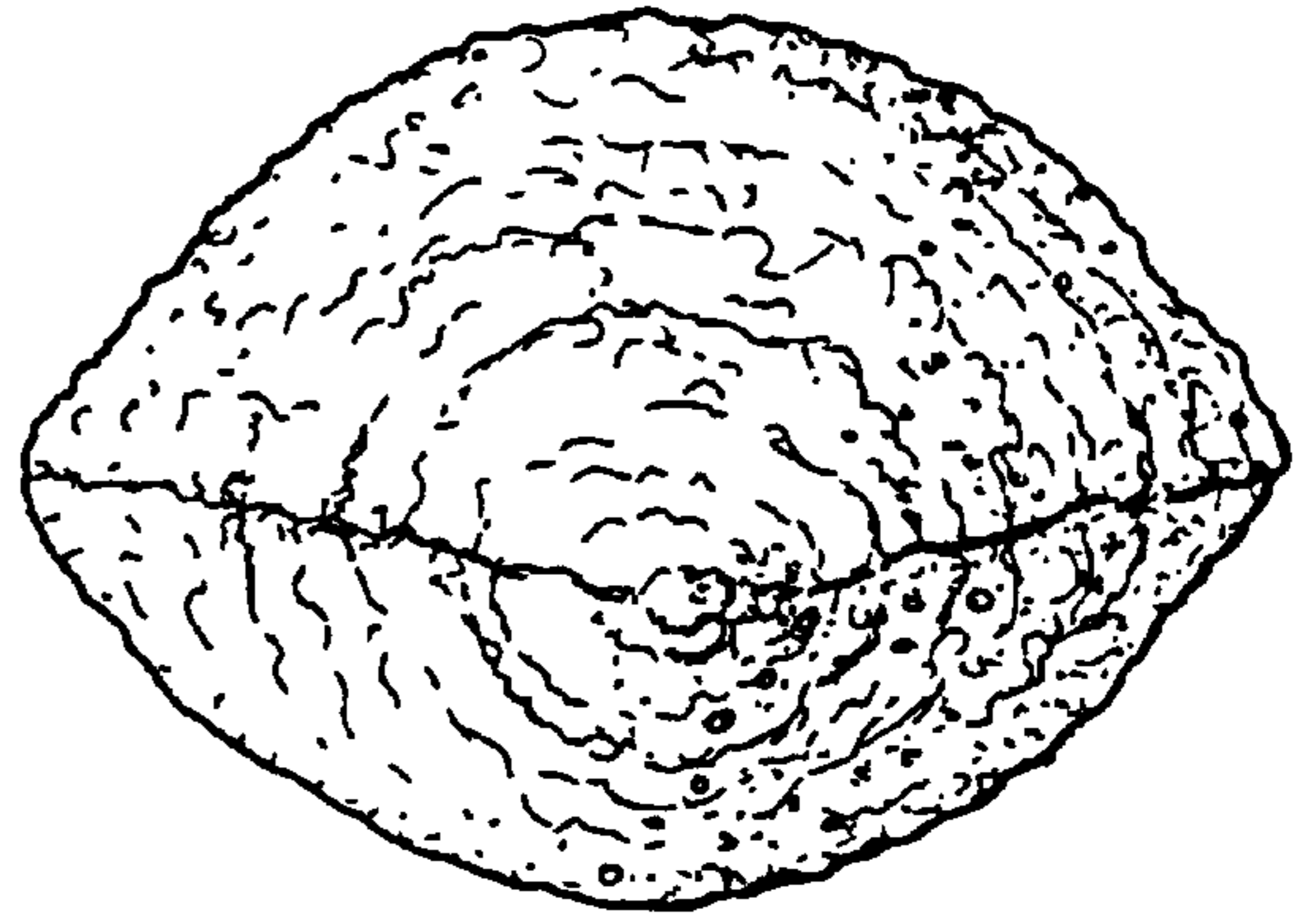

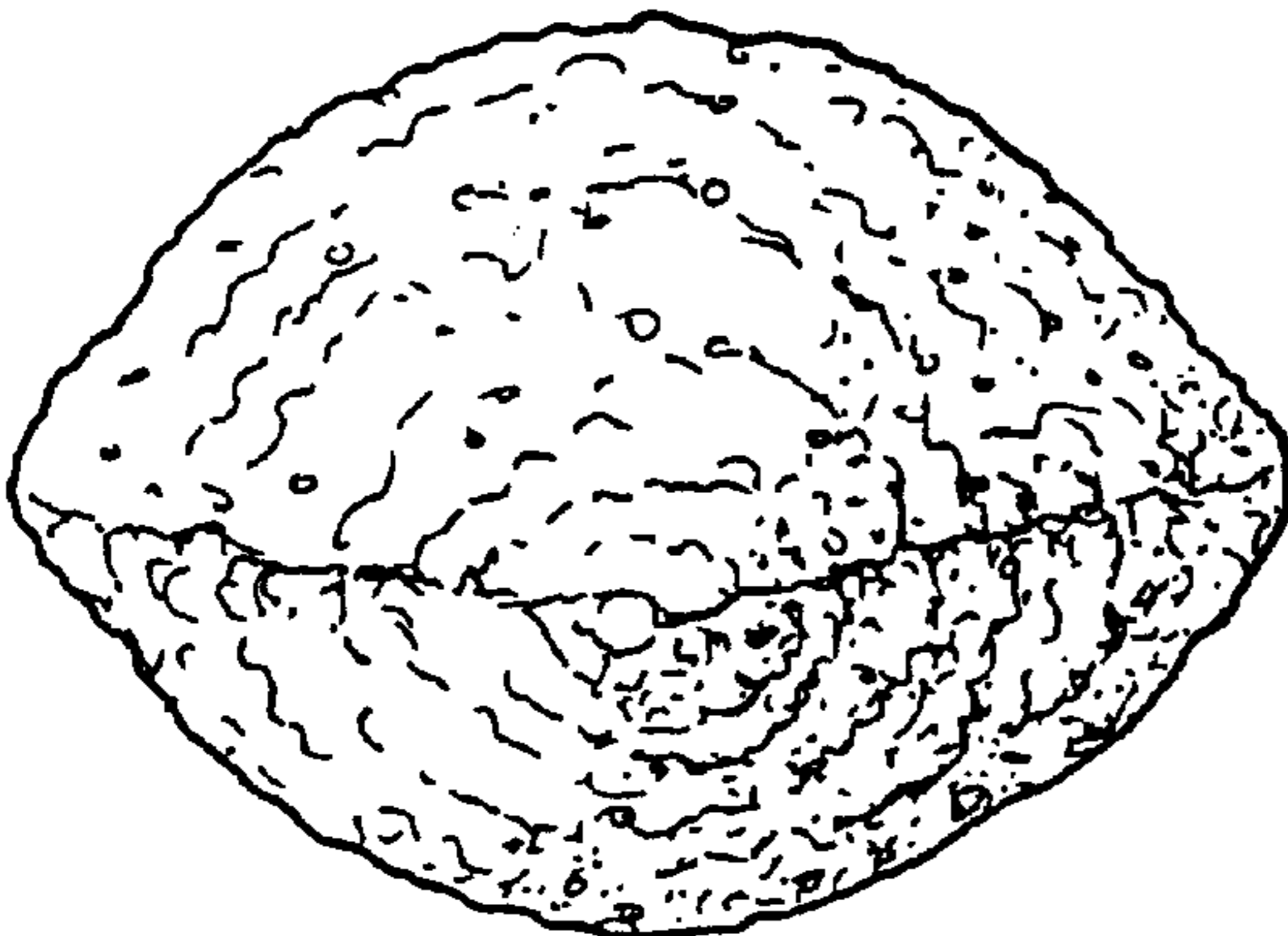

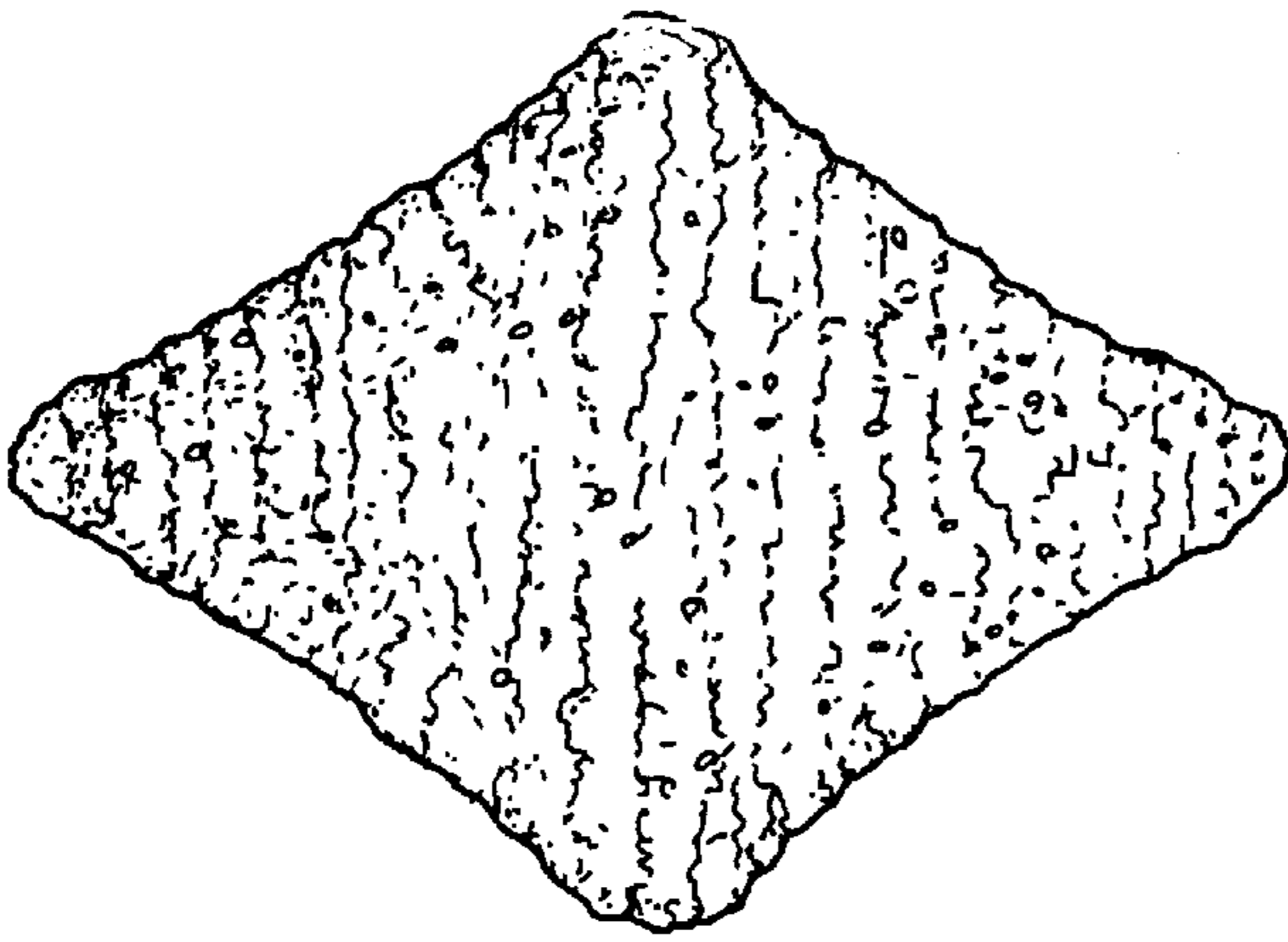

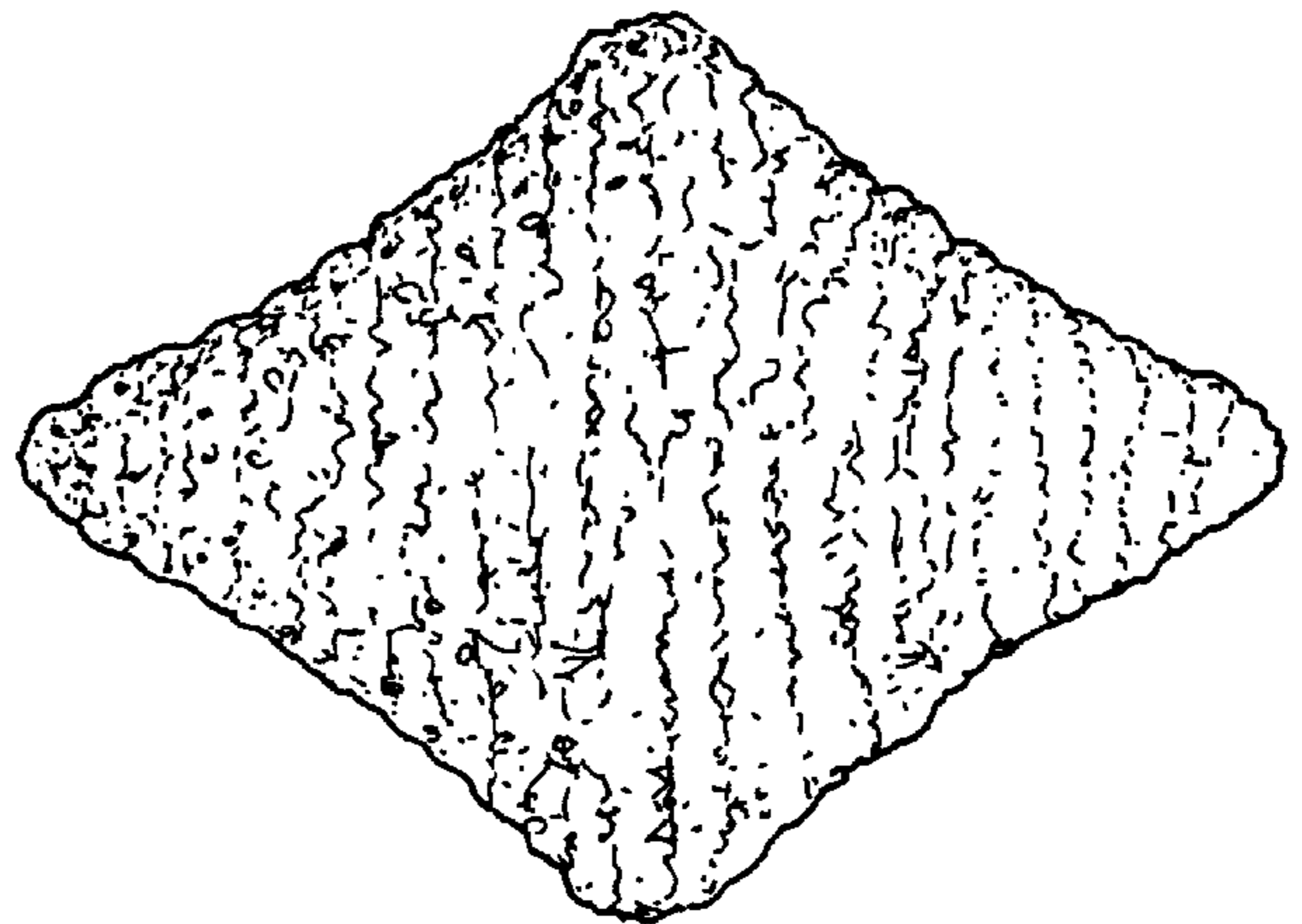

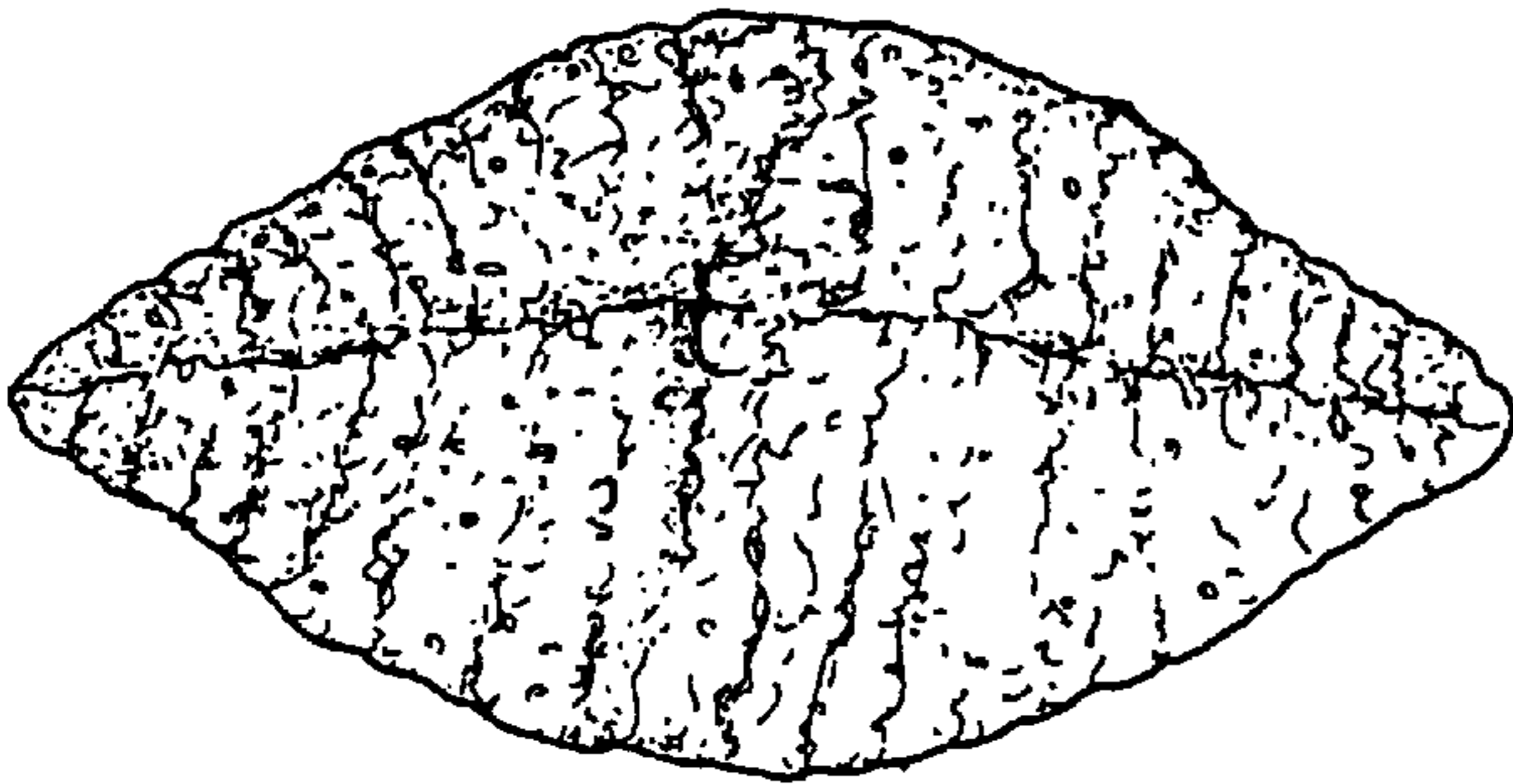

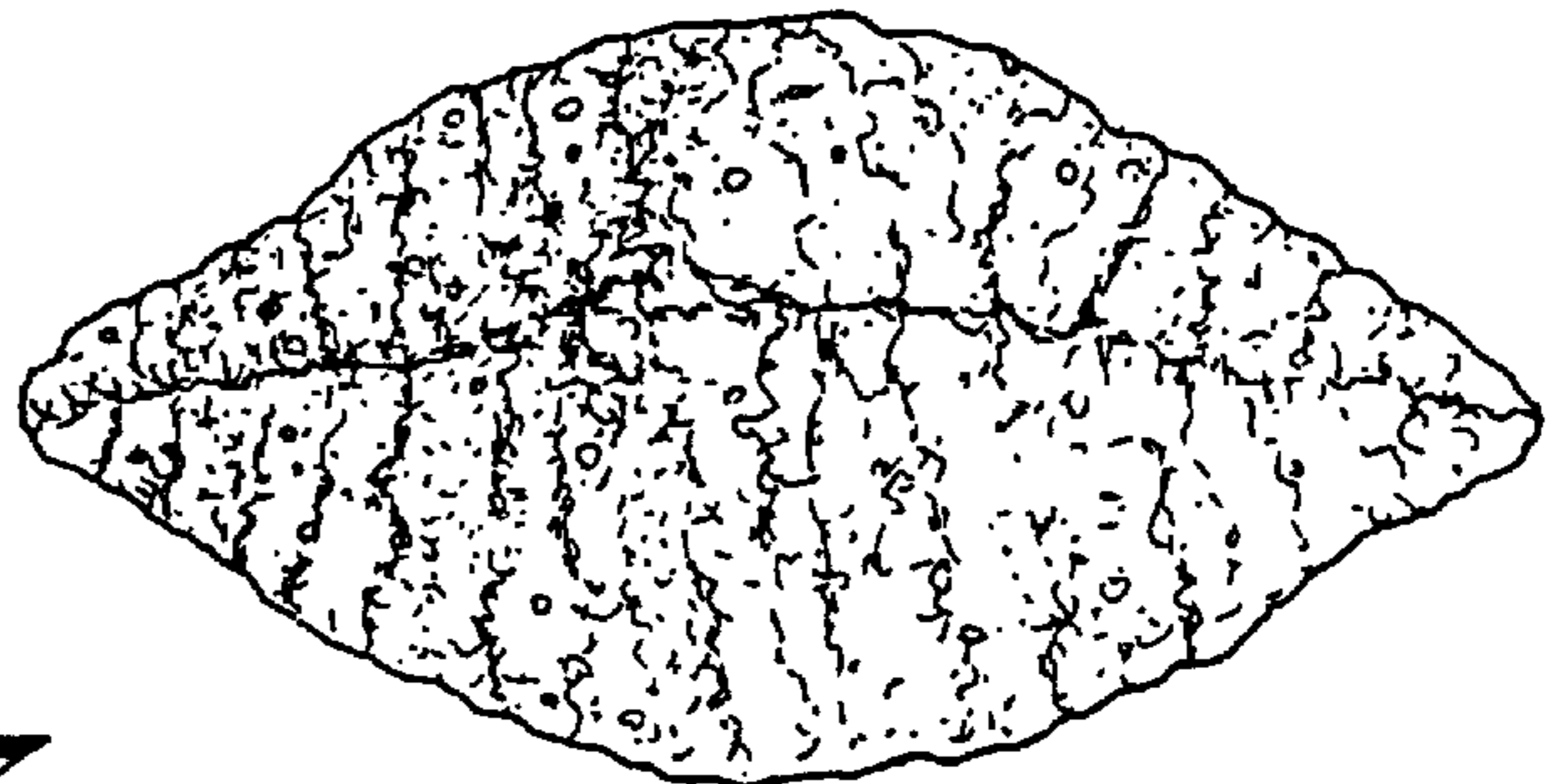
