**DESCRIPTION**

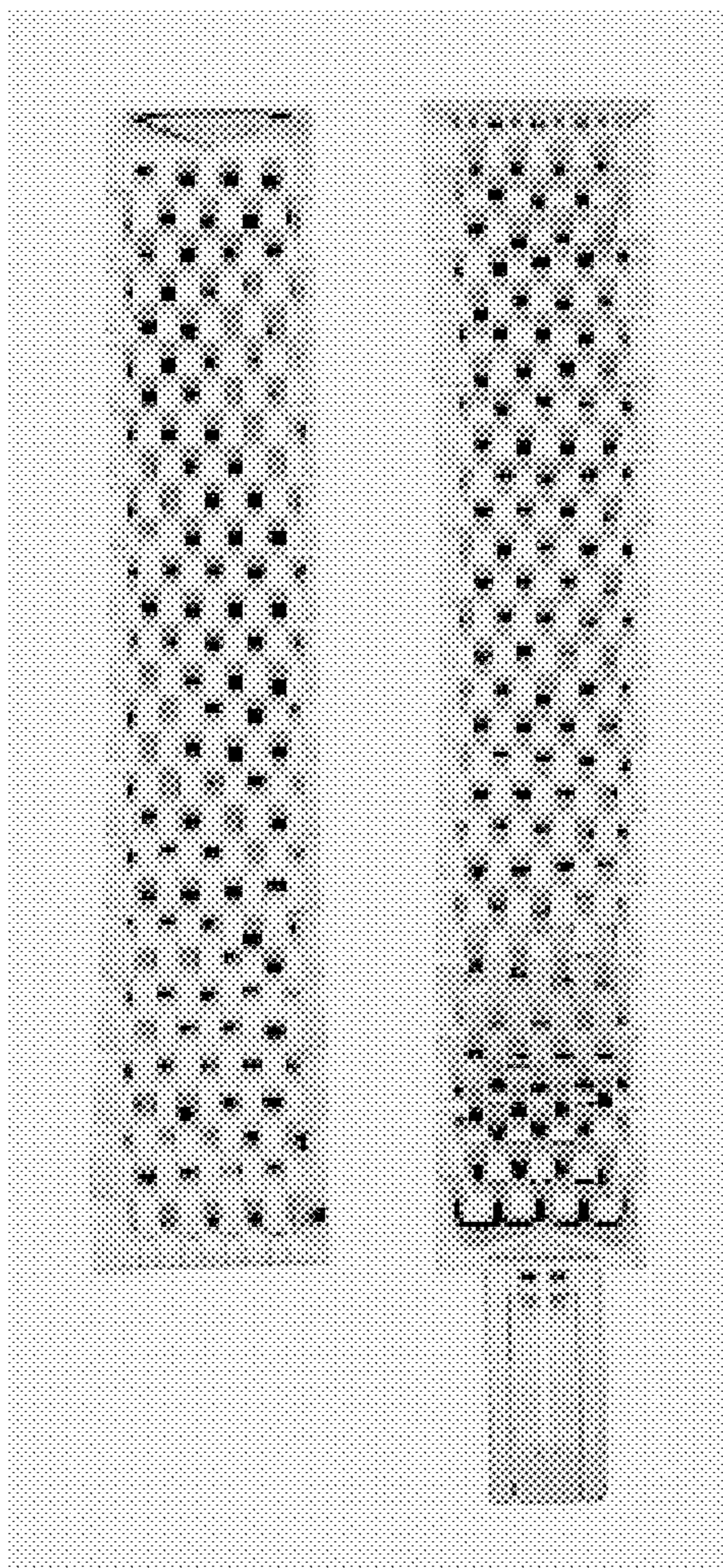
FIG. 1 is a Front view of my new and ornamental design for a watch strap;

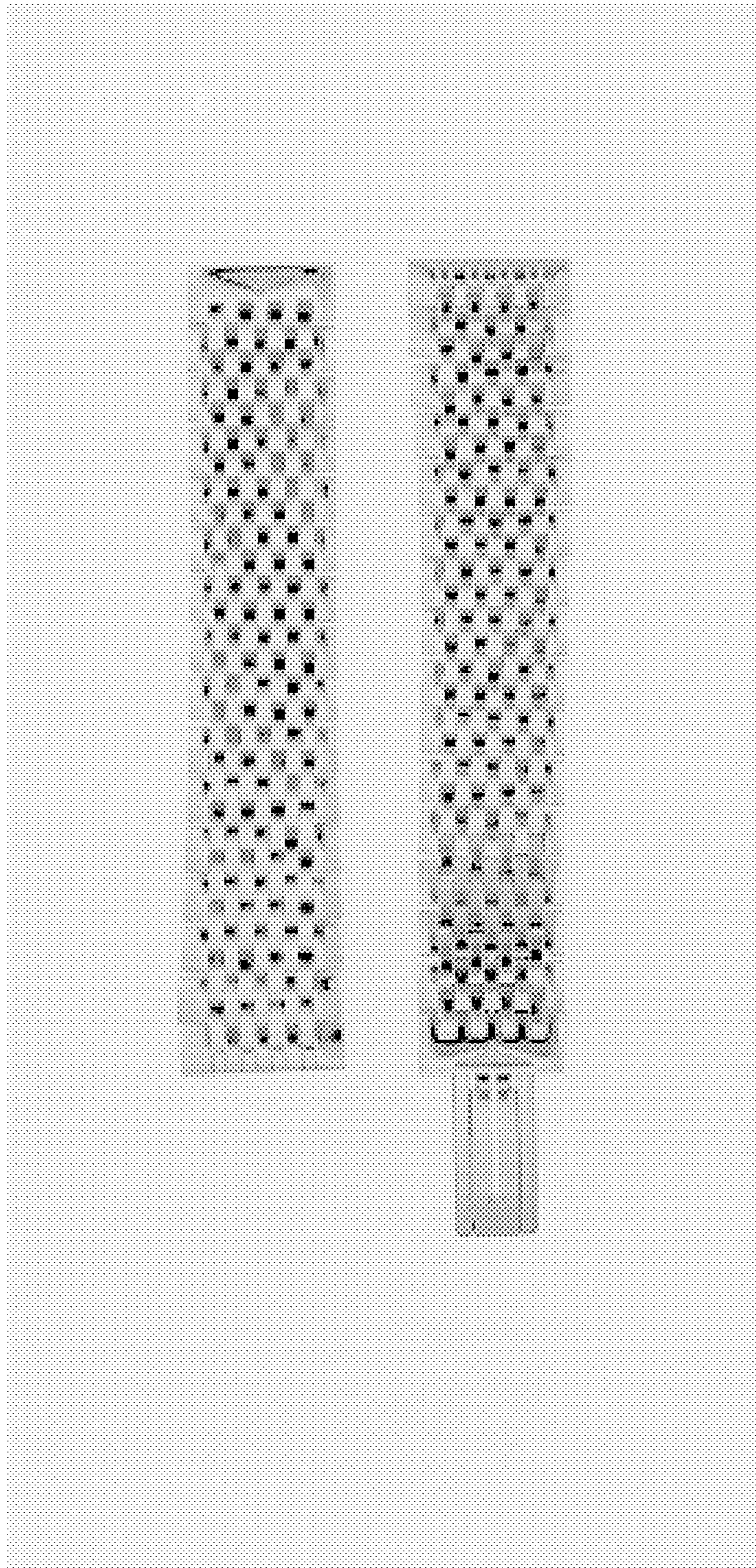

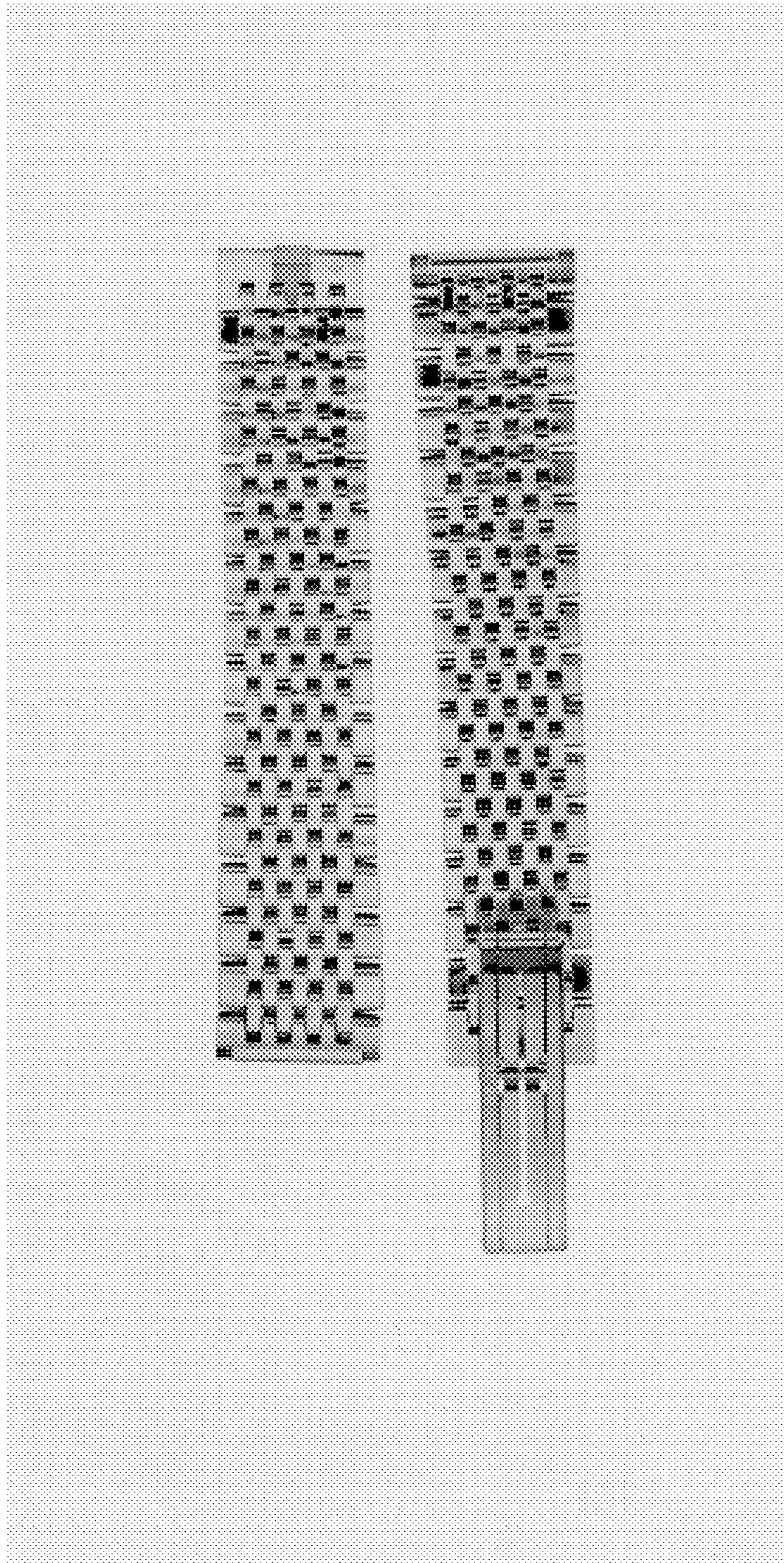

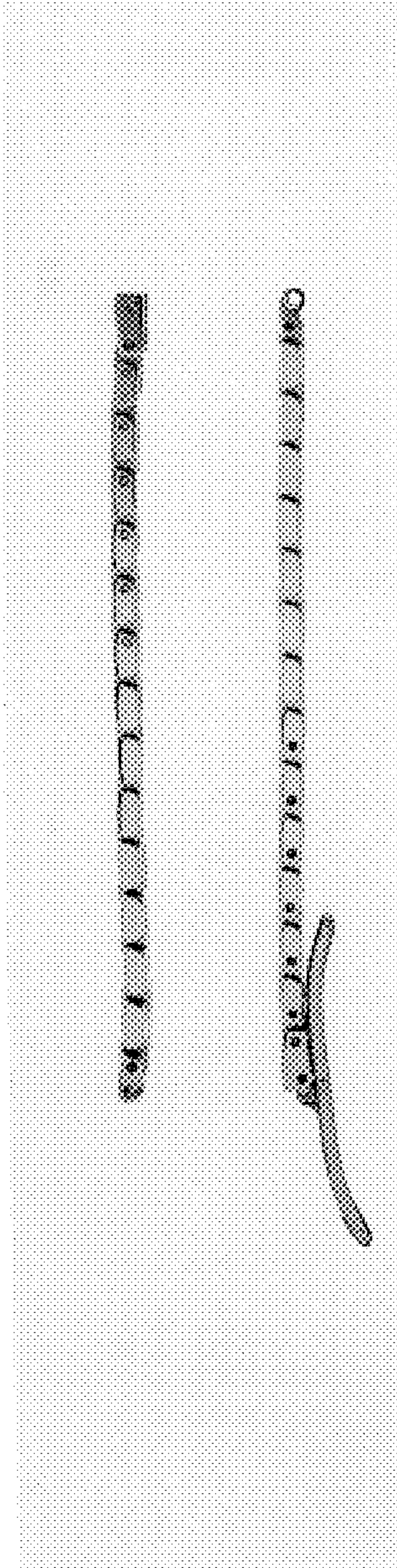

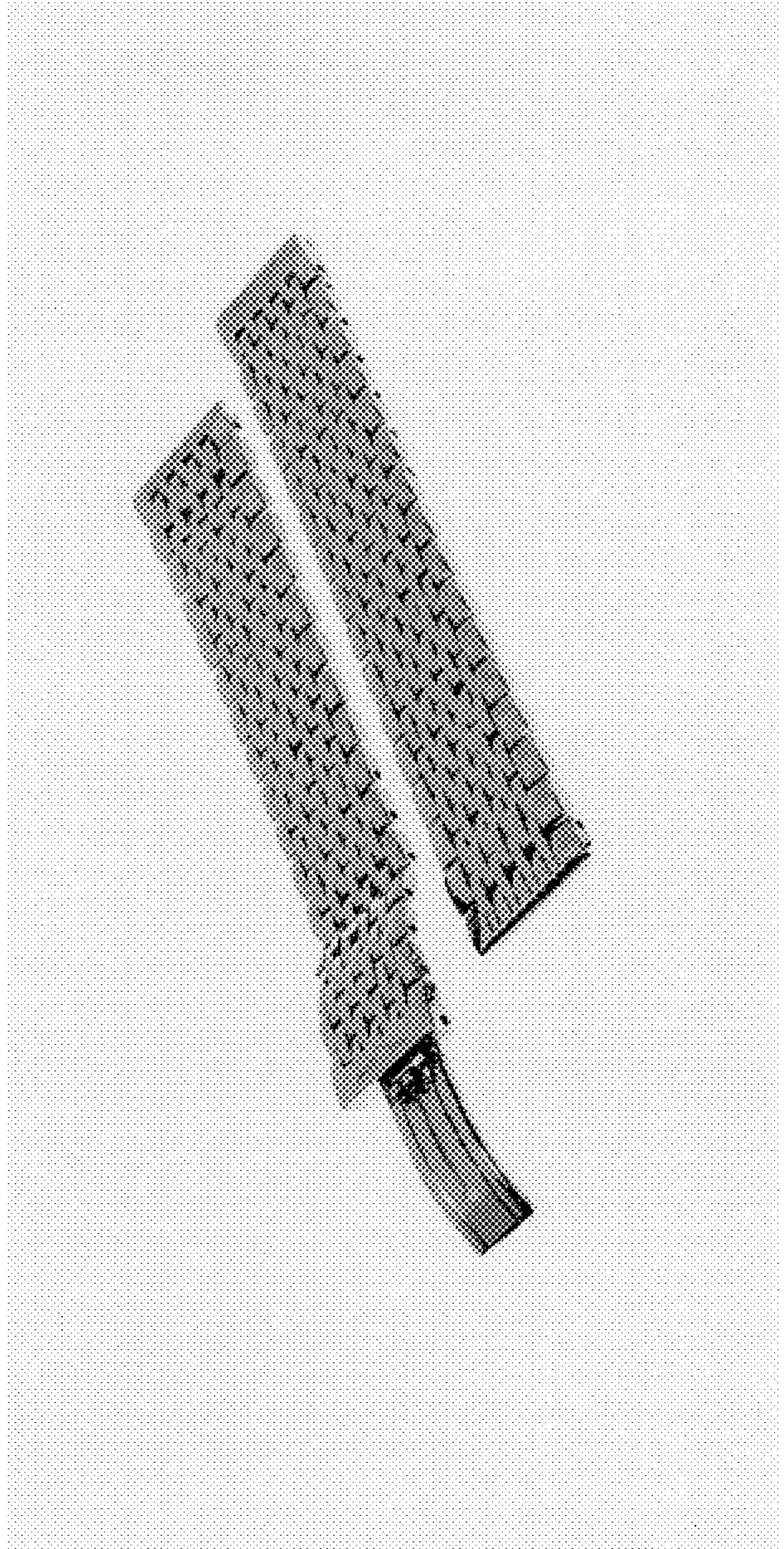
