(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a raised or embossed texture, imitative of reptile skin, applied to a cigarette packet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first preferred embodiment of a raised or embossed texture, imitative of reptile skin, applied to a cigarette packet;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the first preferred embodiment of the present invention;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view of the first preferred embodiment of the present invention;

FIG. 4 is a left side view of the first preferred embodiment of the present invention;

FIG. 5 is a right side view of the first preferred embodiment of the present invention;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the first preferred embodiment of the present invention;

FIG. 7, is a bottom plan view of the first preferred embodiment of the present invention;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a second preferred embodiment of a raised or embossed texture, imitative of reptile skin, applied to a cigarette packet;

FIG. 9 is a front elevation view of the second preferred embodiment of the present invention;

FIG. 10 is a rear elevation view of the second preferred embodiment of the present invention;

FIG. 11 is a left side view of the second preferred embodiment of the present invention;

FIG. 12 is a right side view of the second preferred embodiment of the present invention;

FIG. 13 is a top plan view of the second preferred embodiment of the present invention;

FIG. 14, is a bottom plan view of the second preferred embodiment of the present invention; and

FIG. 15 is a perspective view of a third preferred embodiment of a raised or embossed texture, imitative of reptile skin, applied to a cigarette packet;

FIG. 16 is a front elevation view of the third preferred embodiment of the present invention;

FIG. 17 is a rear elevation view of the third preferred embodiment of the present invention;


FIG. 18 is a left side view of the third preferred embodiment of the present invention;






































