I claim the ornamental Design for a puzzle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective front view of a puzzle showing my new design in the closed position;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the puzzle of FIG. 1., the bottom view being identical thereto;

FIG. 3 is an elevation front view of the puzzle of FIG. 1, the rear view, right side view and the left side views being mirror images thereof;

FIG. 4 is an isometric front view showing my new design in the partially open position;

FIG. 5 is an elevation rear view of FIG. 4 on a reduced scale;

FIG. 6 is an elevation front view of FIG. 4 on a reduced scale;

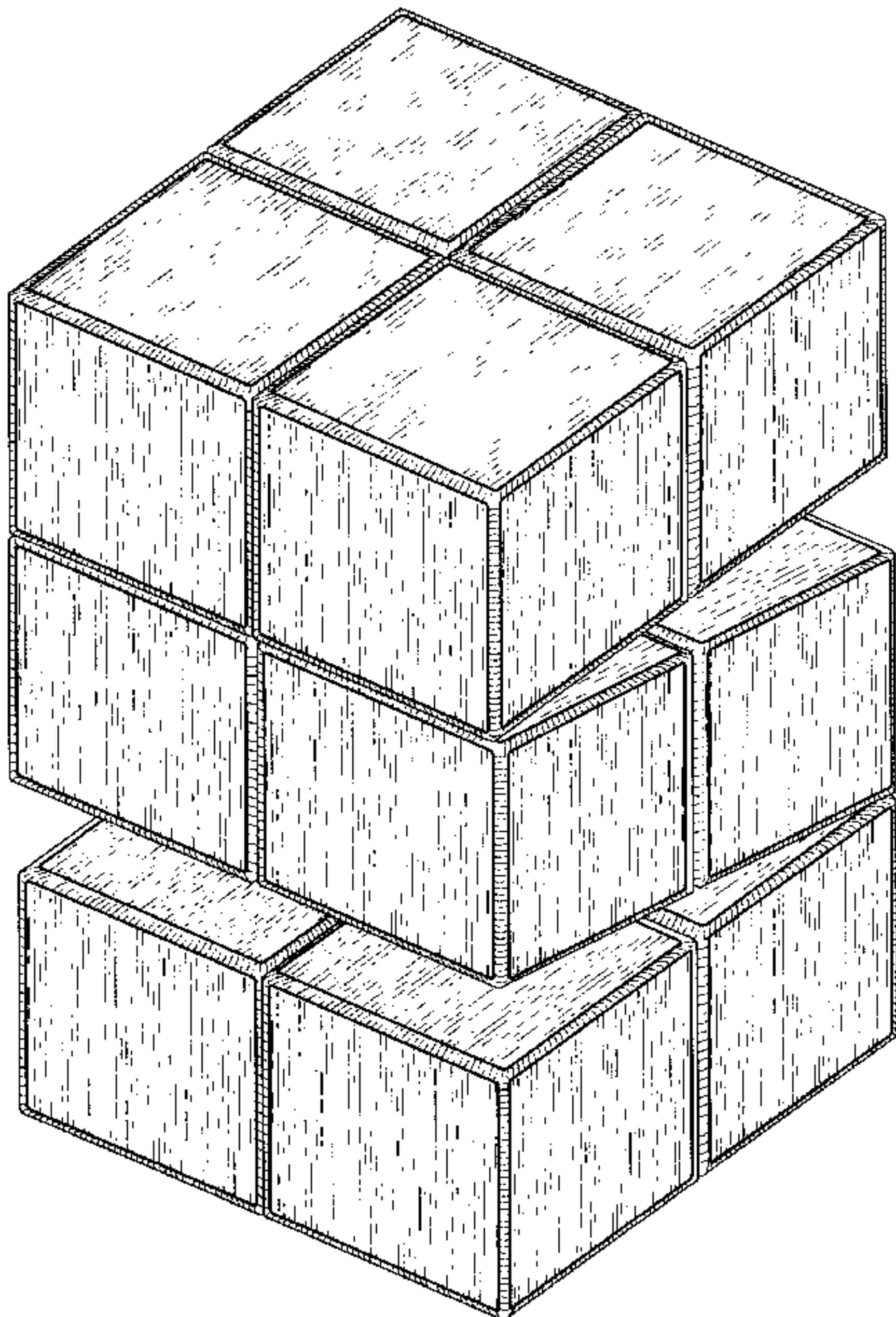
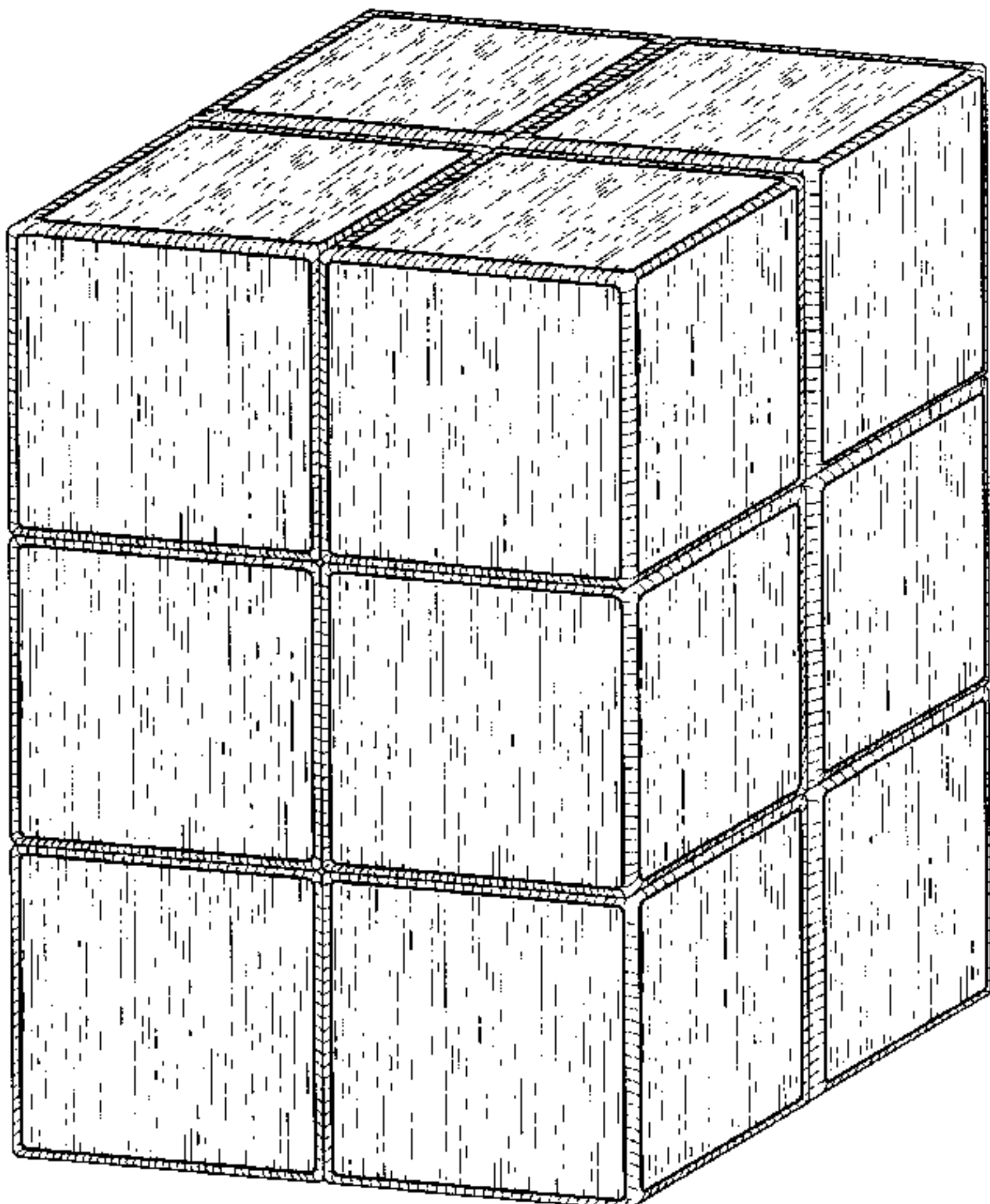
FIG. 7 is an elevation right side view of FIG. 4;

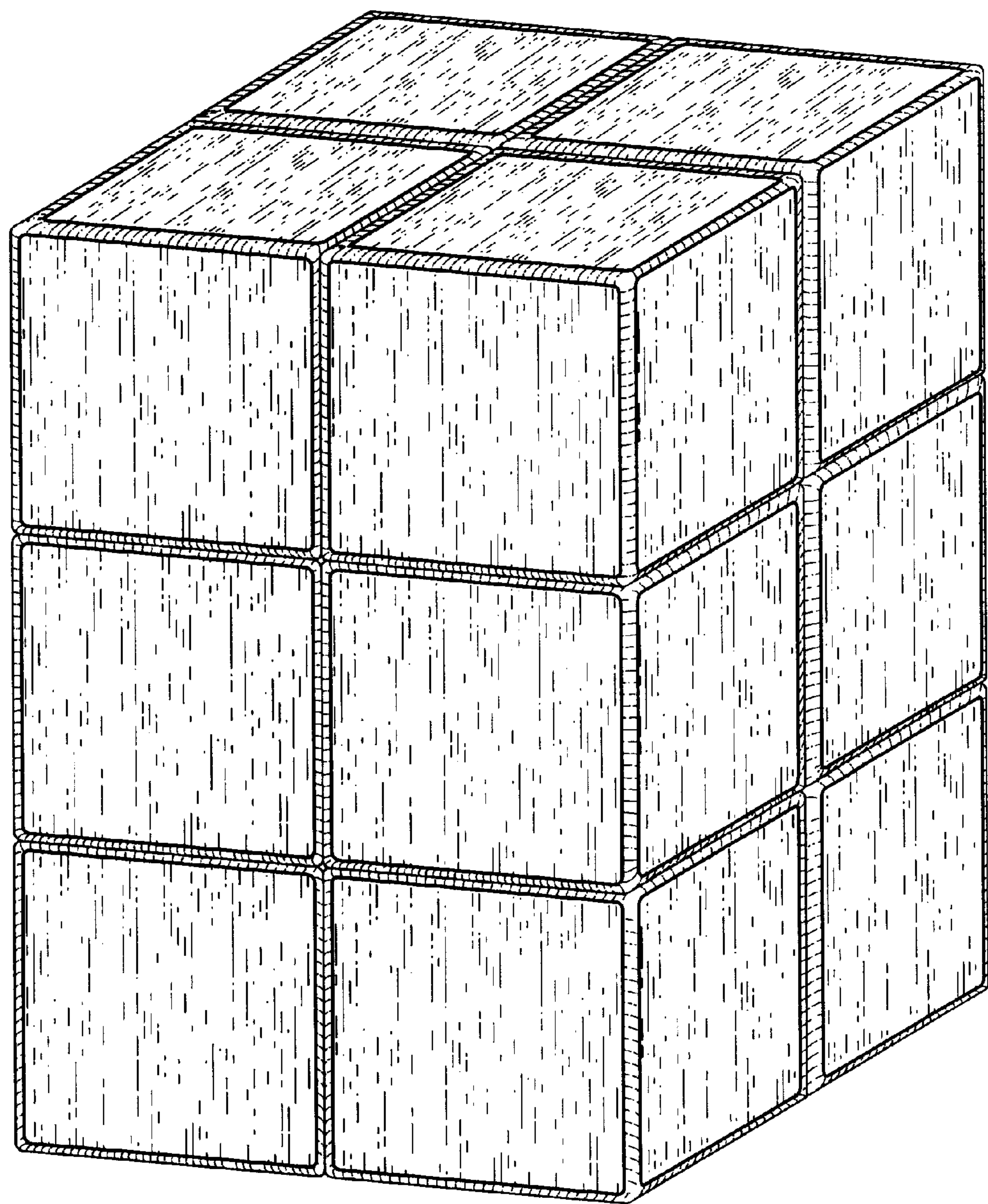

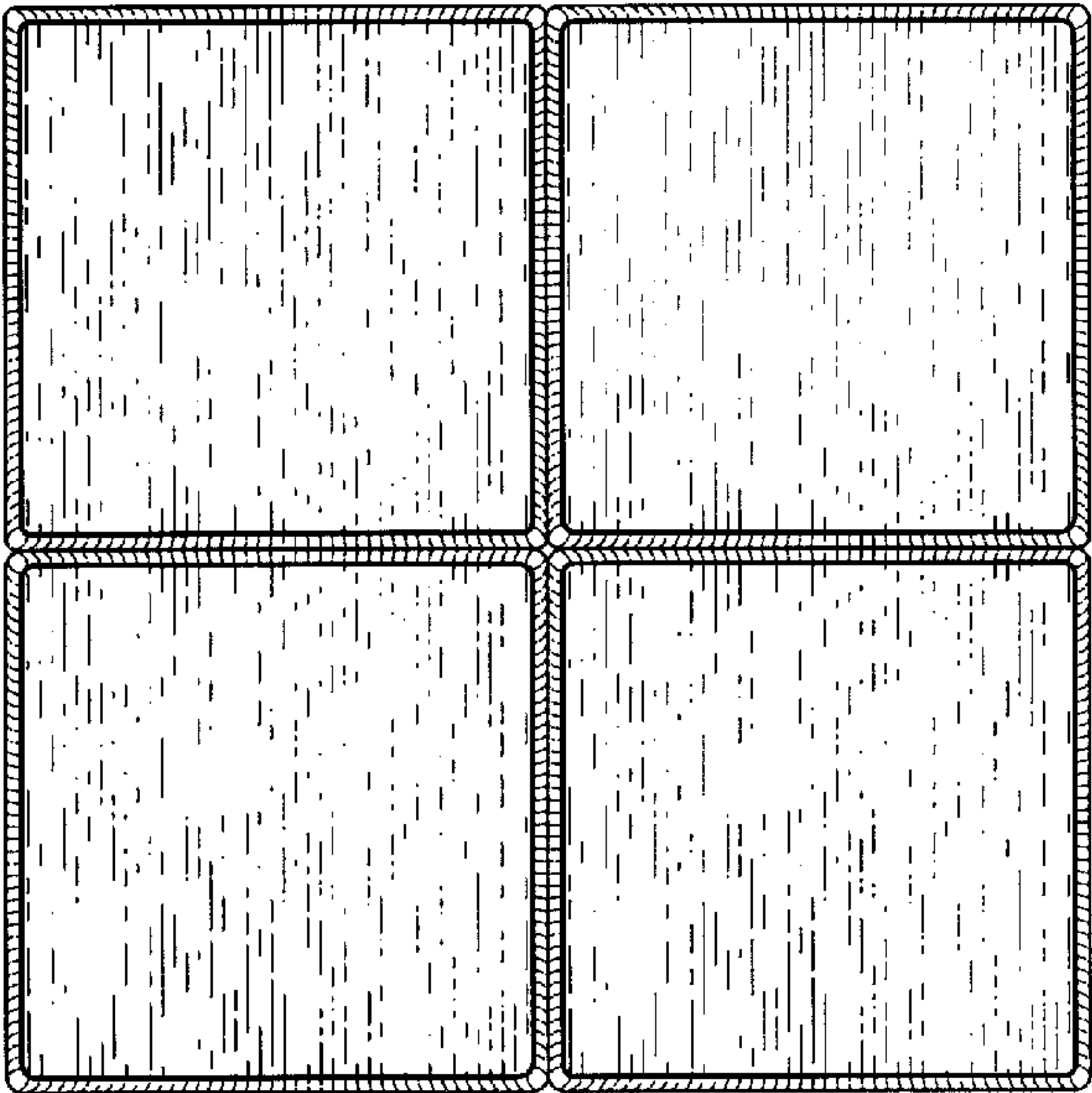

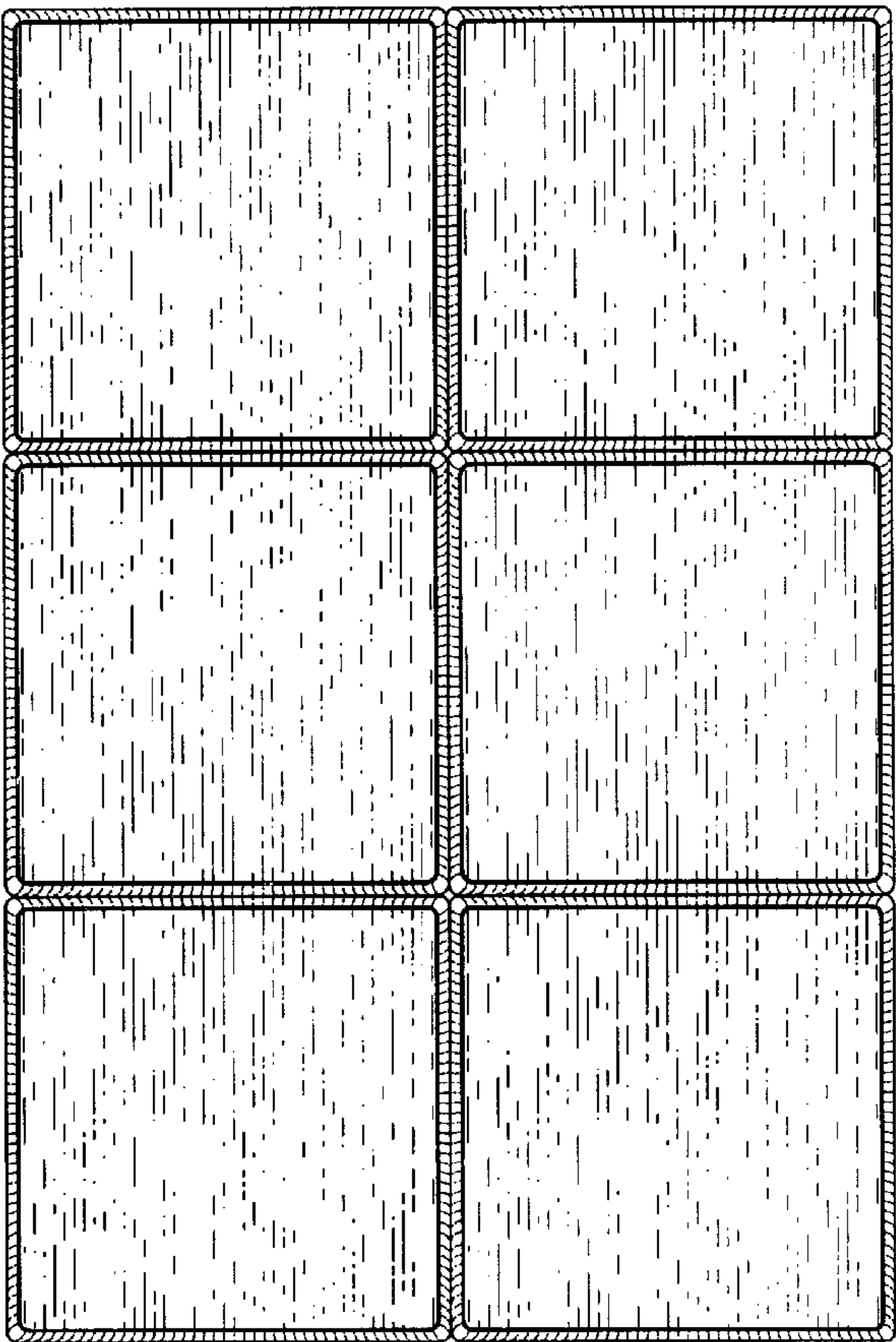

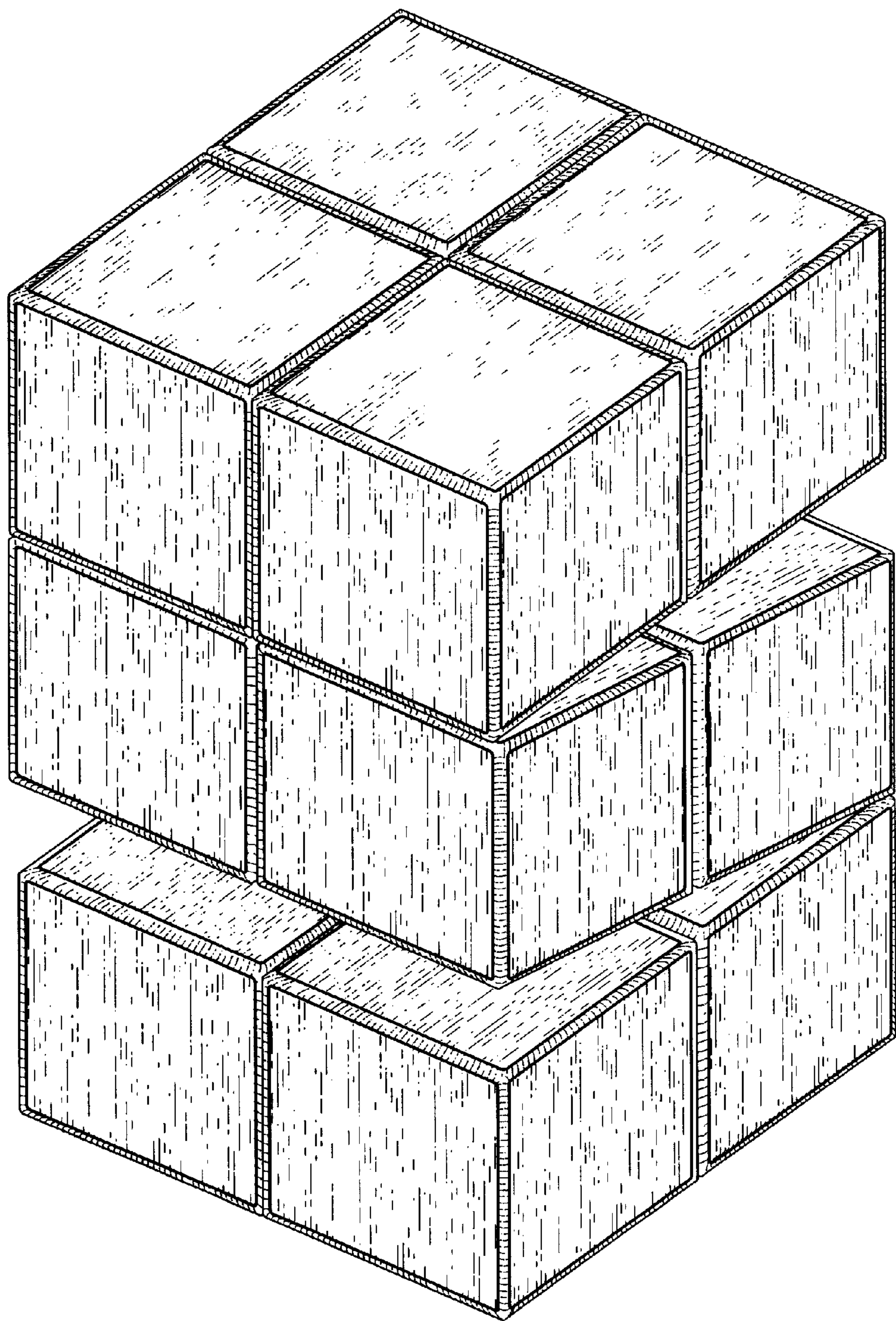

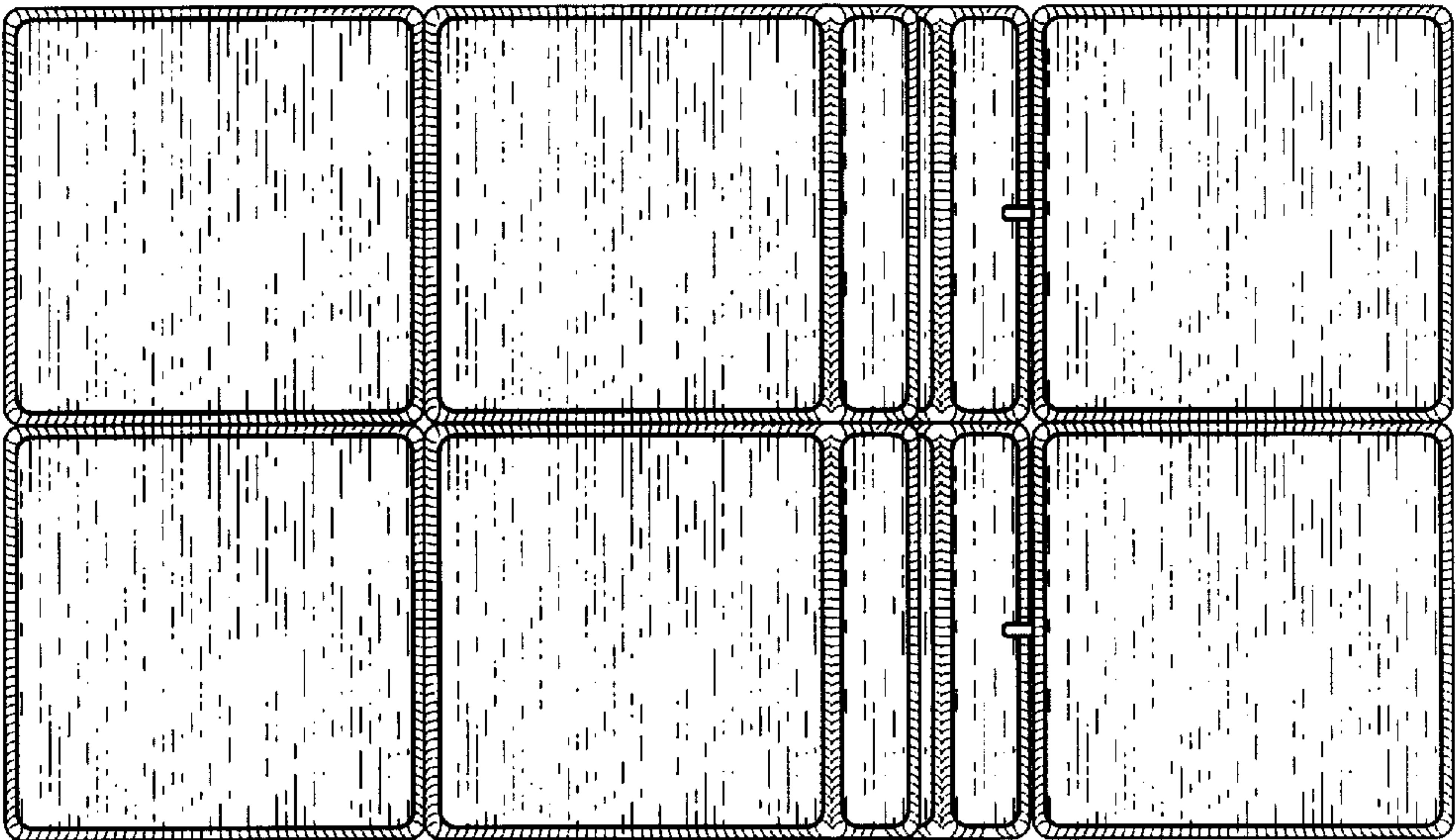

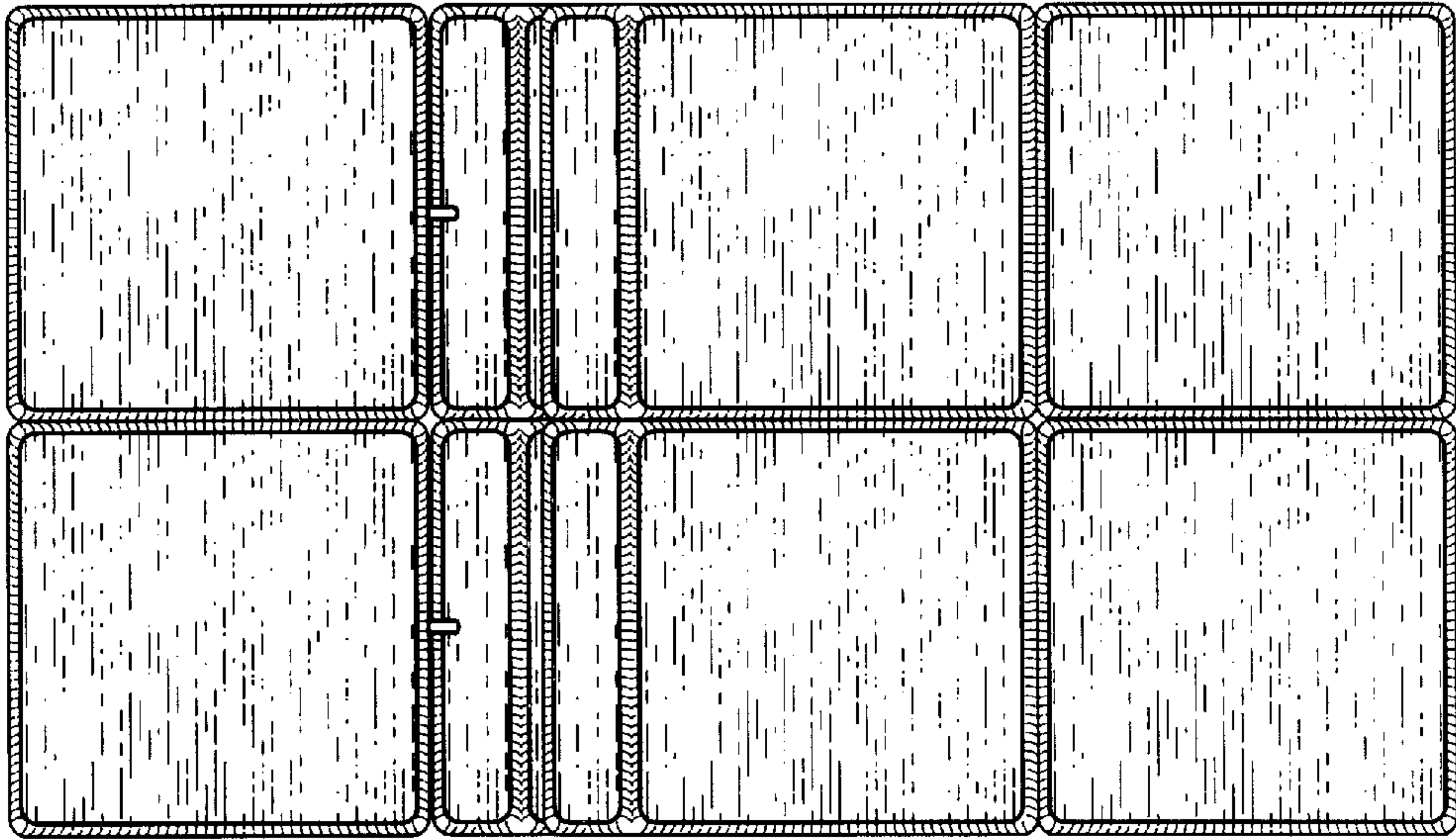

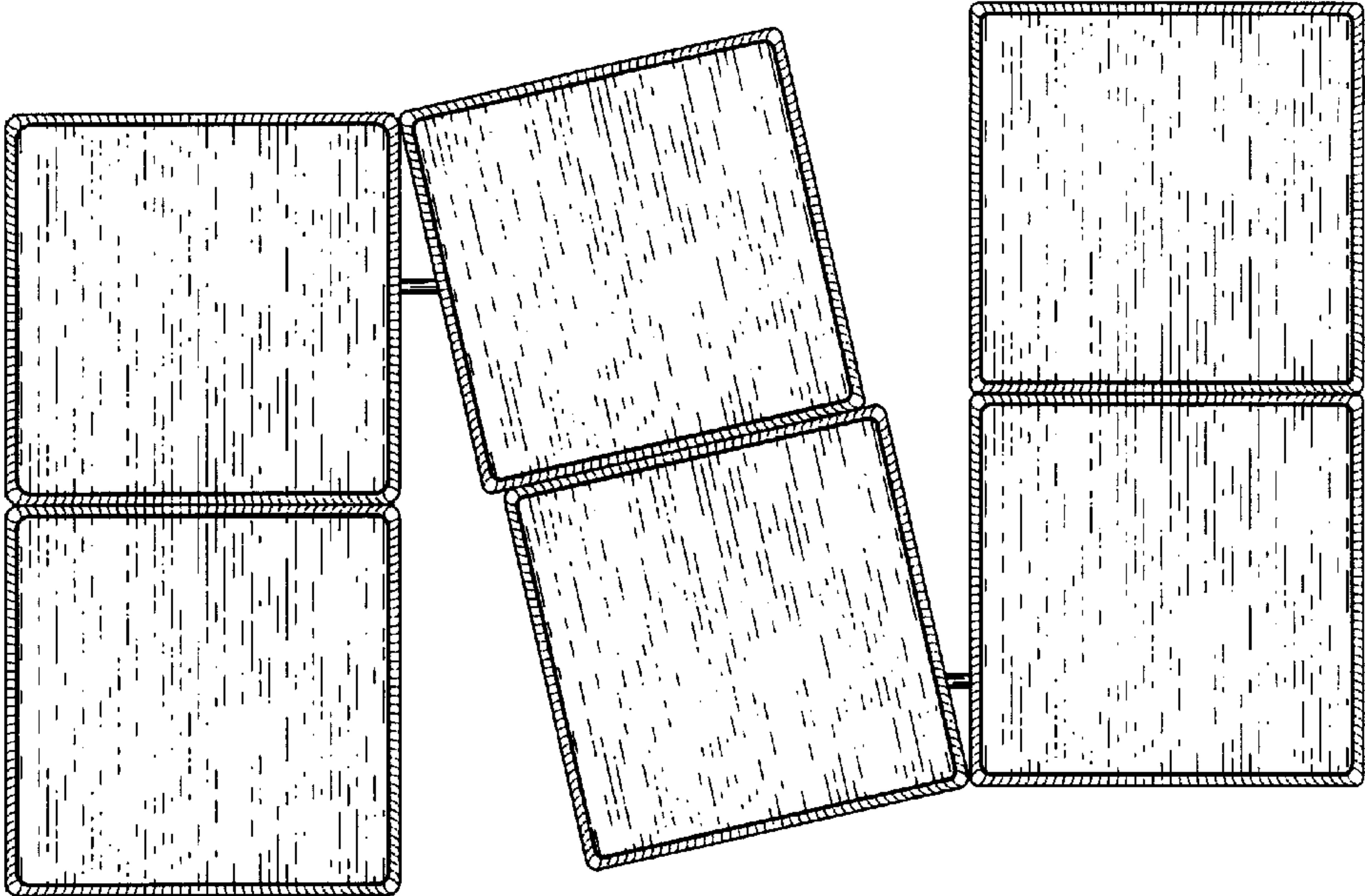

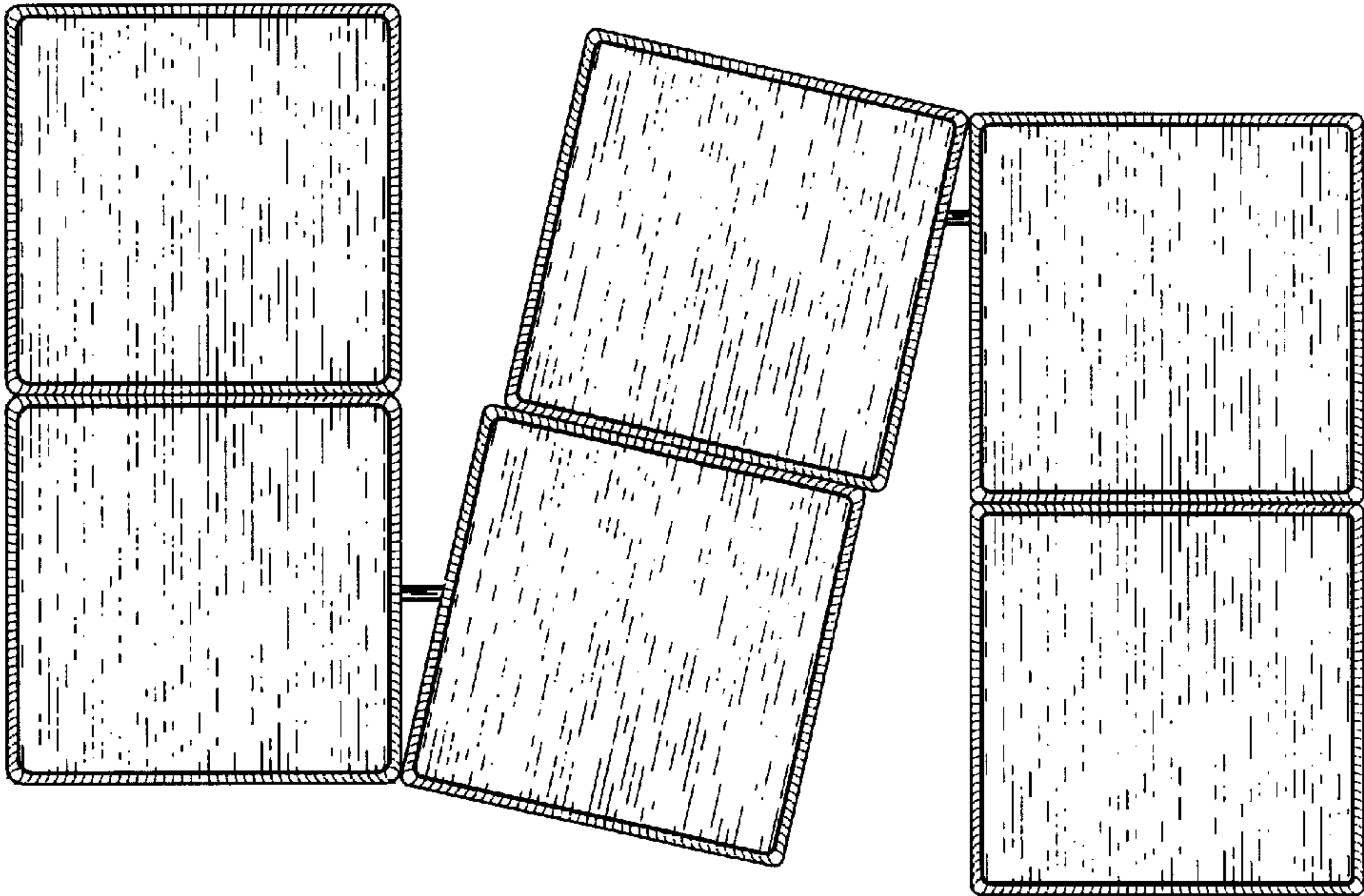

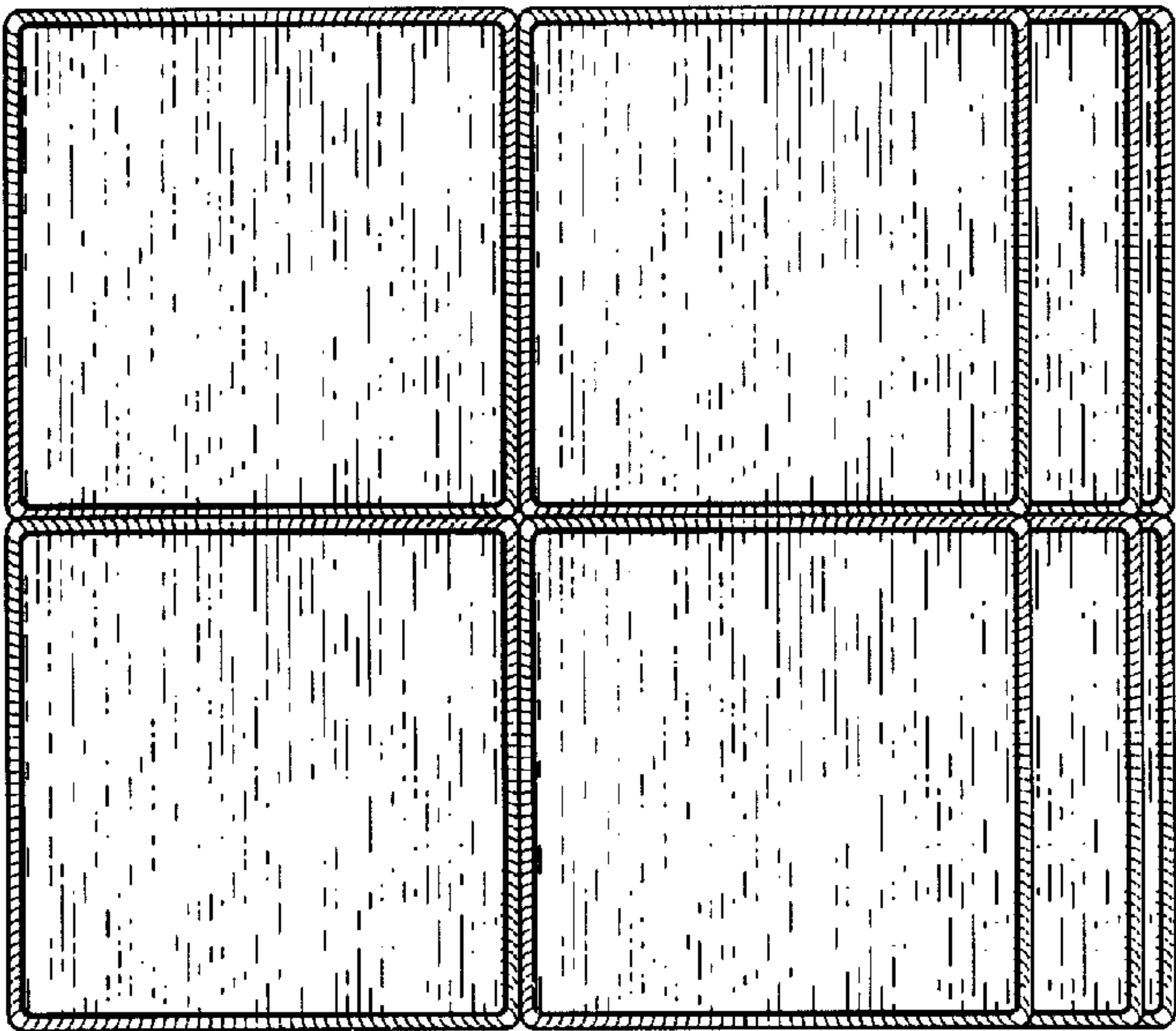

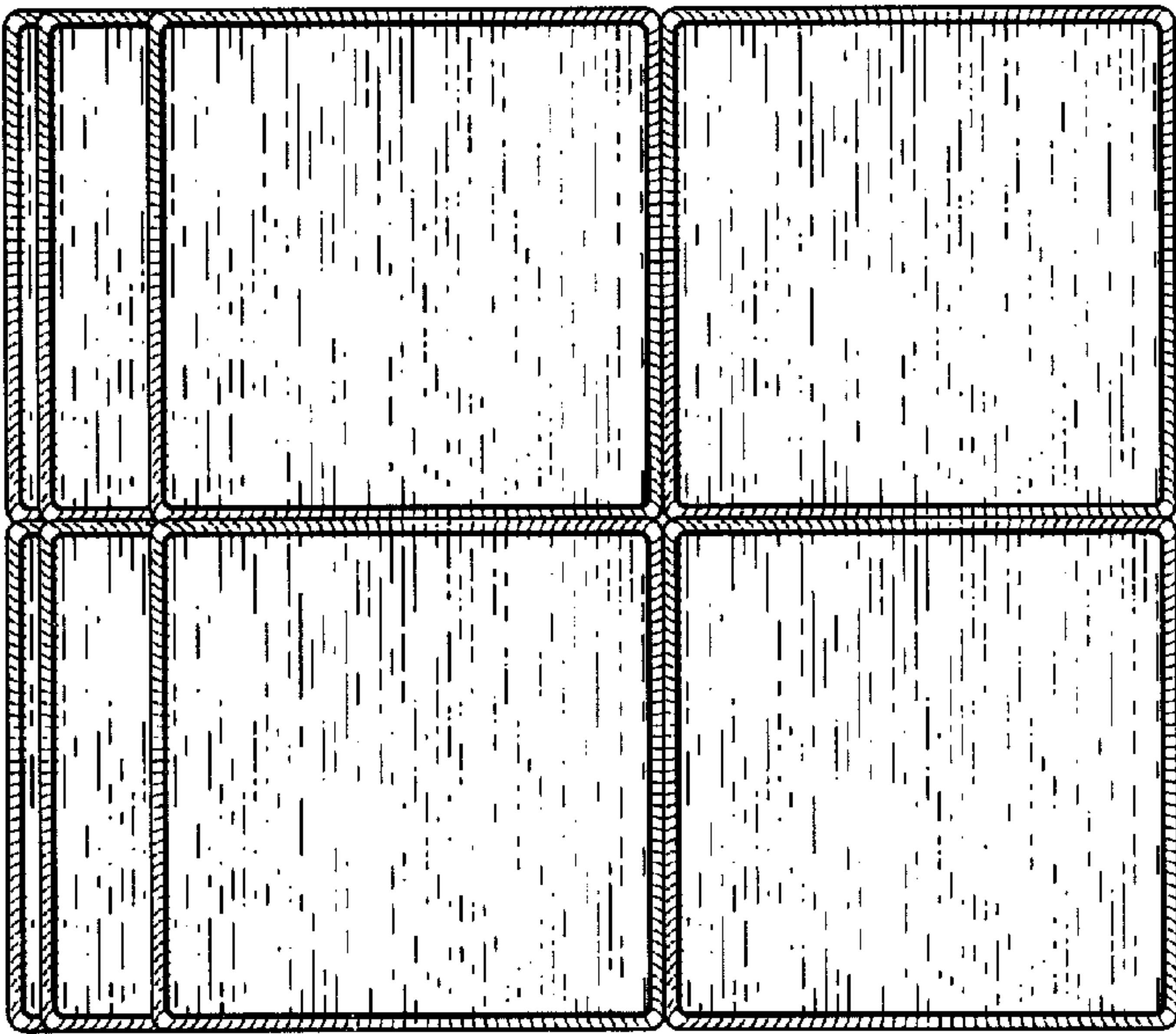
