(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a paint brush handle, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a paint brush handle showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a reduced top, front perspective view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a reduced bottom, rear perspective view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of the paint brush handle;

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of FIG. 5;

FIG. 7 is a top, front perspective view of FIG. 5;

FIG. 8 is a bottom, rear perspective view of FIG. 5;

FIG. 9 is a top plan view of a third embodiment of the paint brush handle;

FIG. 10 is a side elevational view of FIG. 9;

FIG. 11 is a top, front perspective view of FIG. 9;

FIG. 12 is a bottom, rear perspective view of FIG. 9;

FIG. 13 is a top plan view of a fourth embodiment of the paint brush handle;

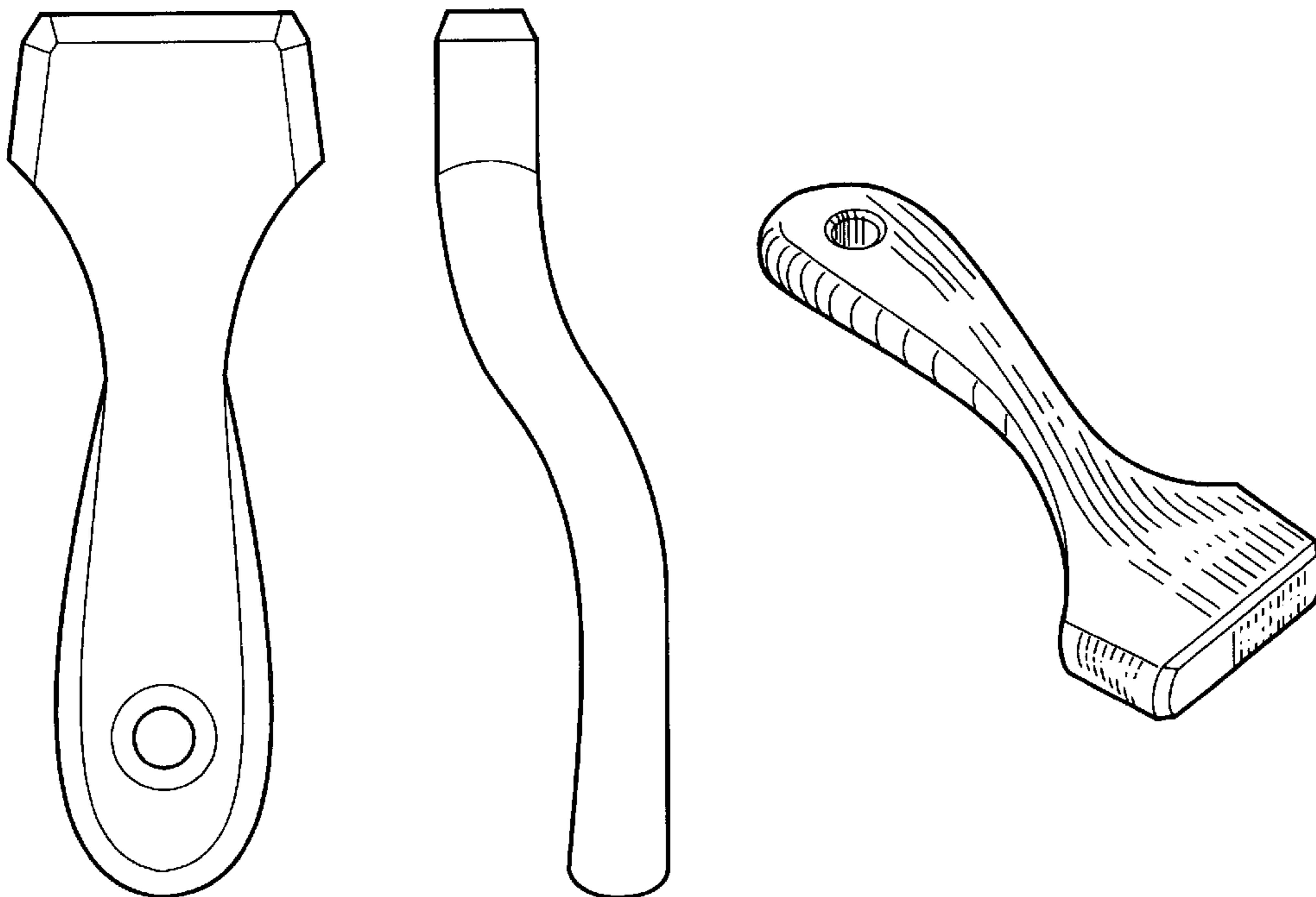

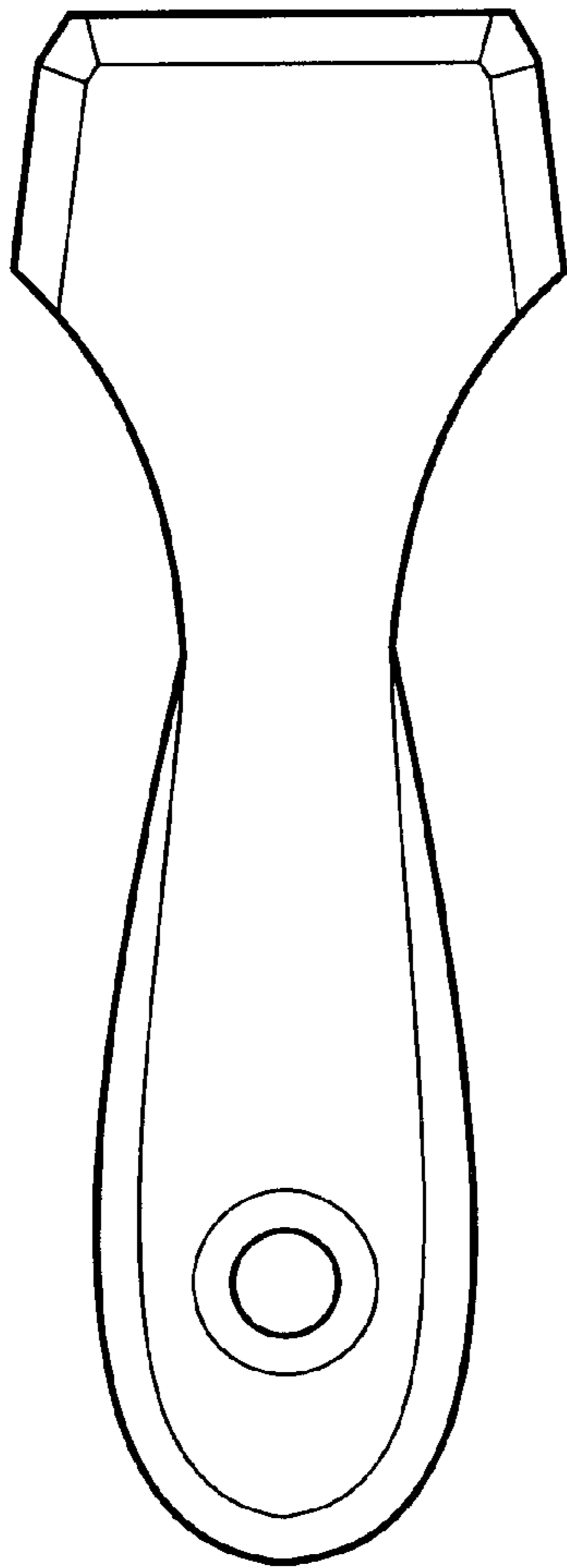

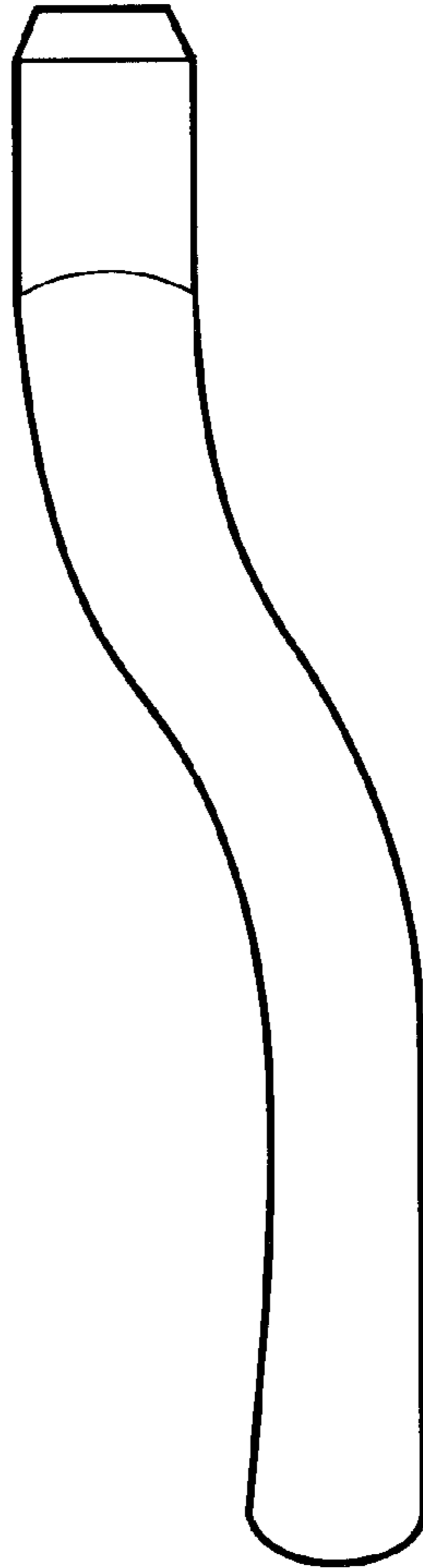

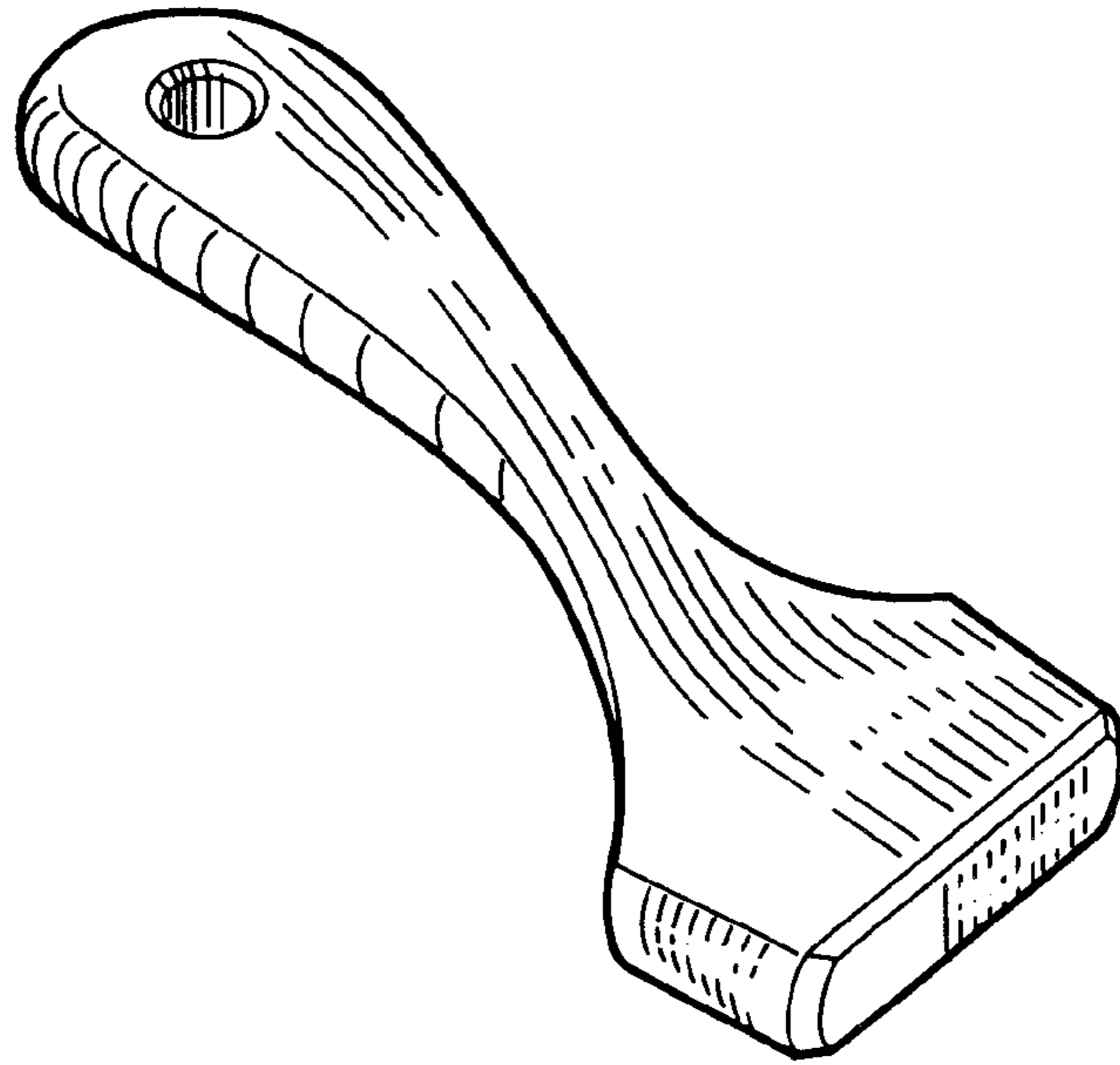

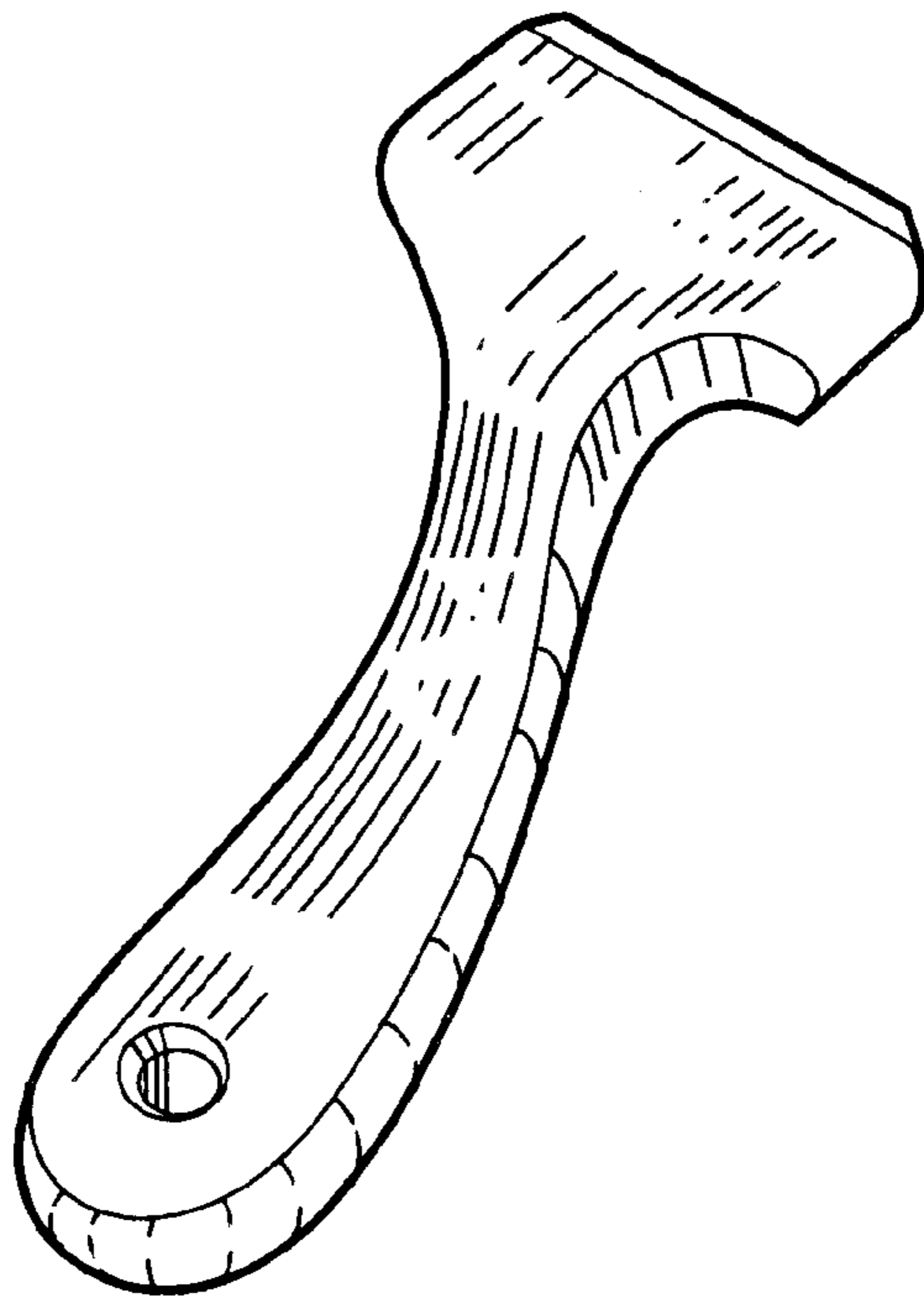

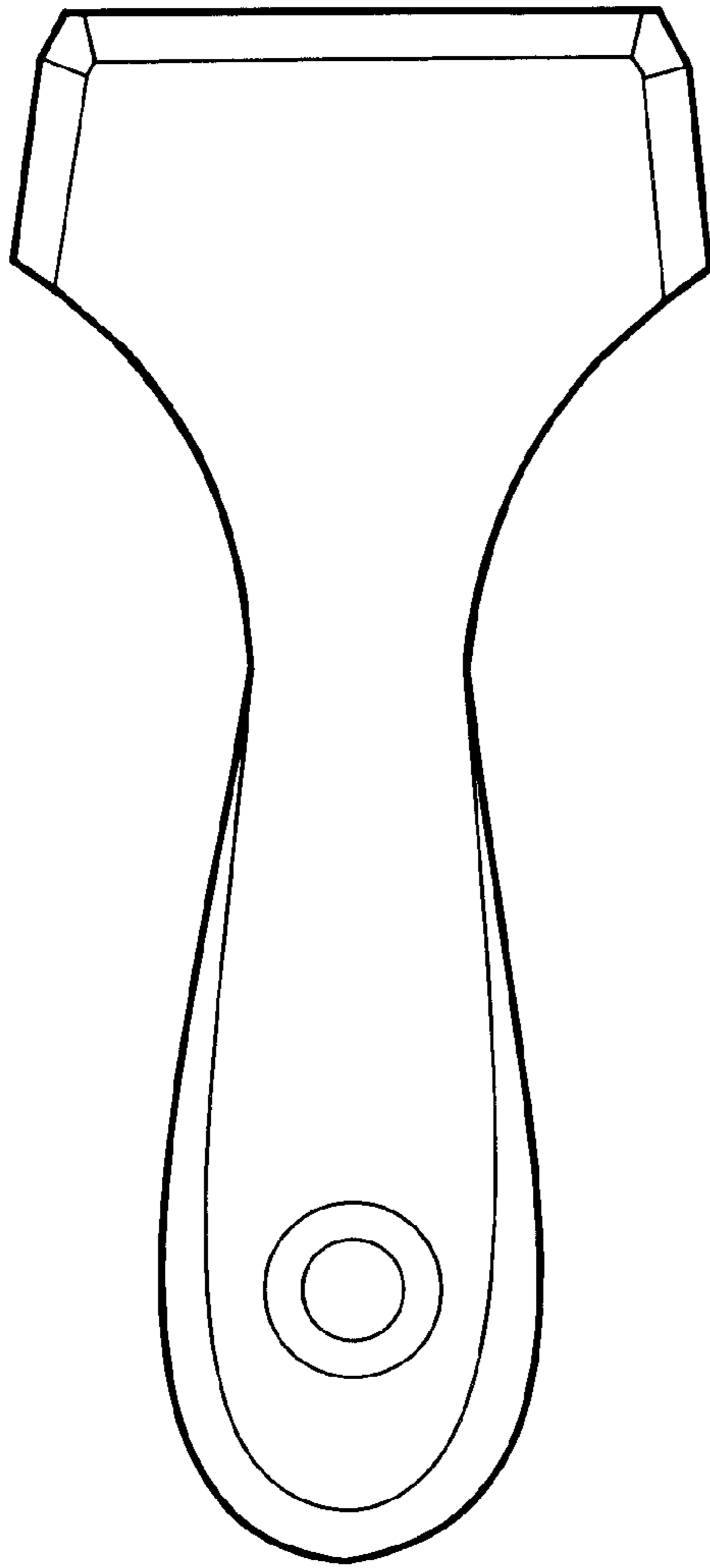

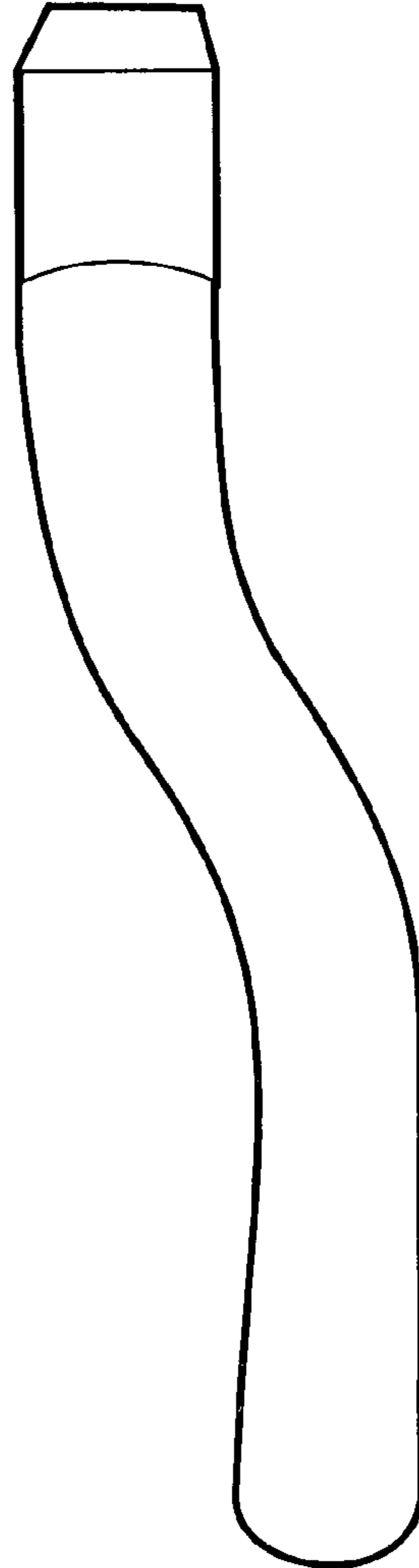

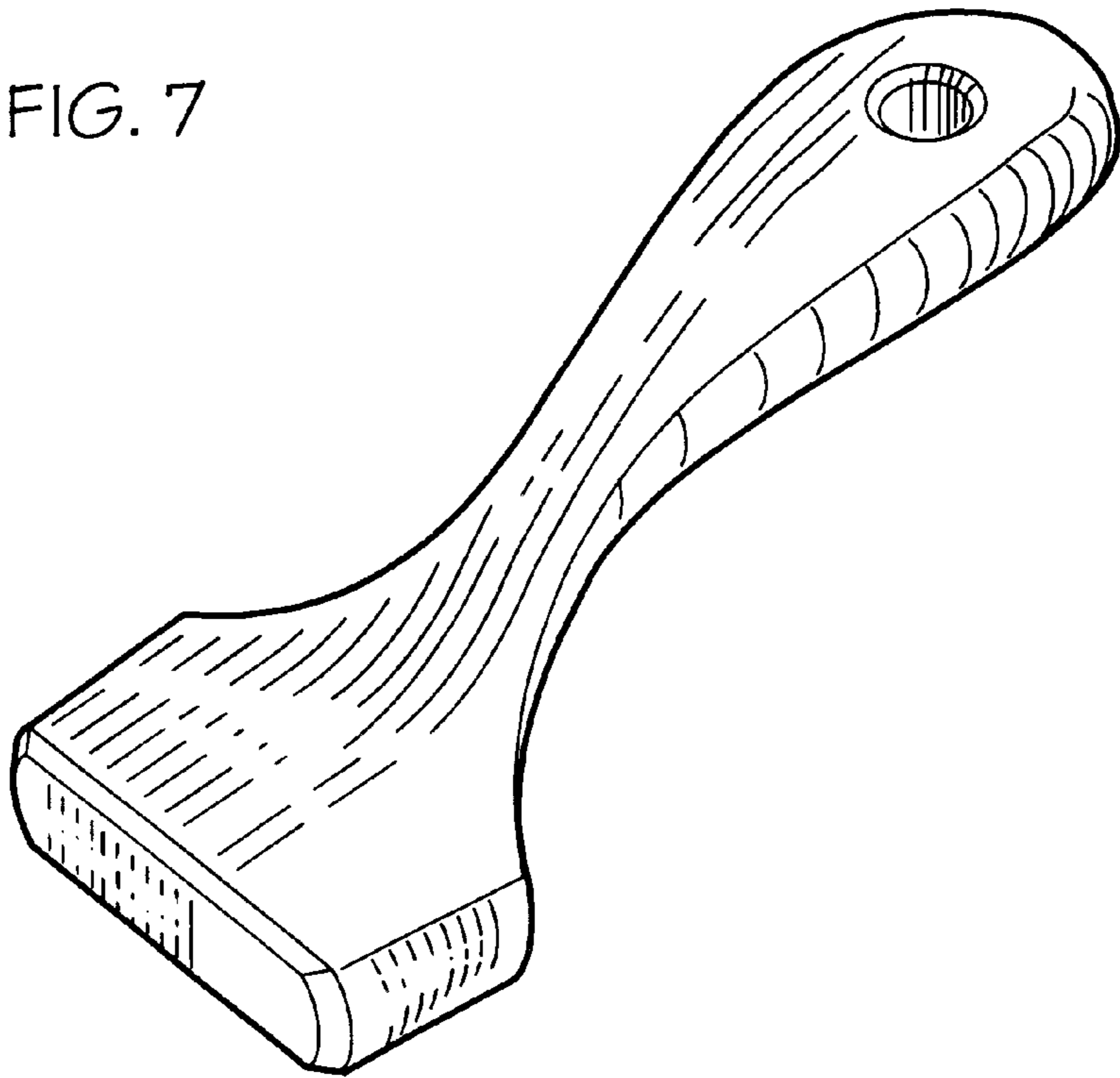

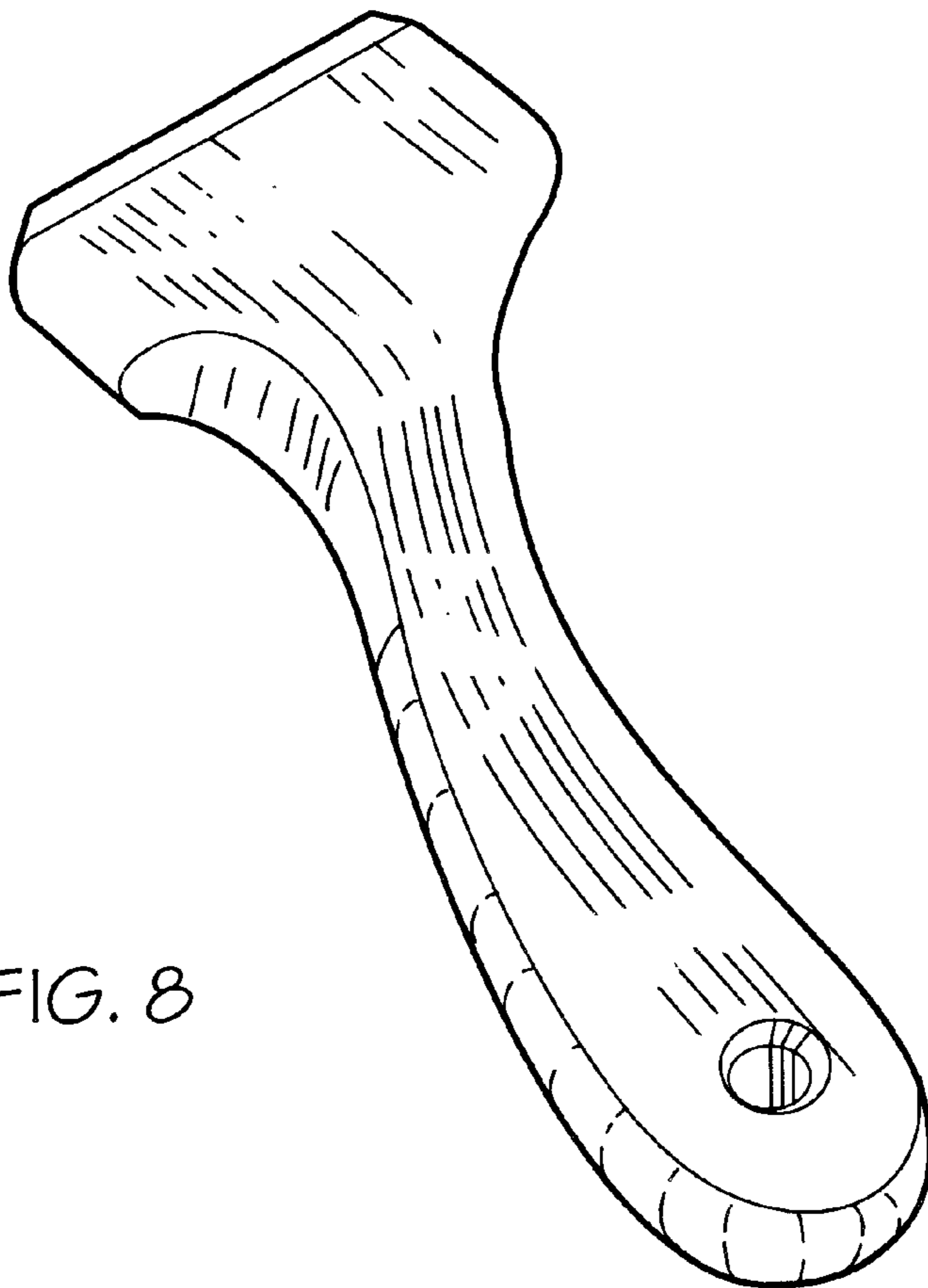

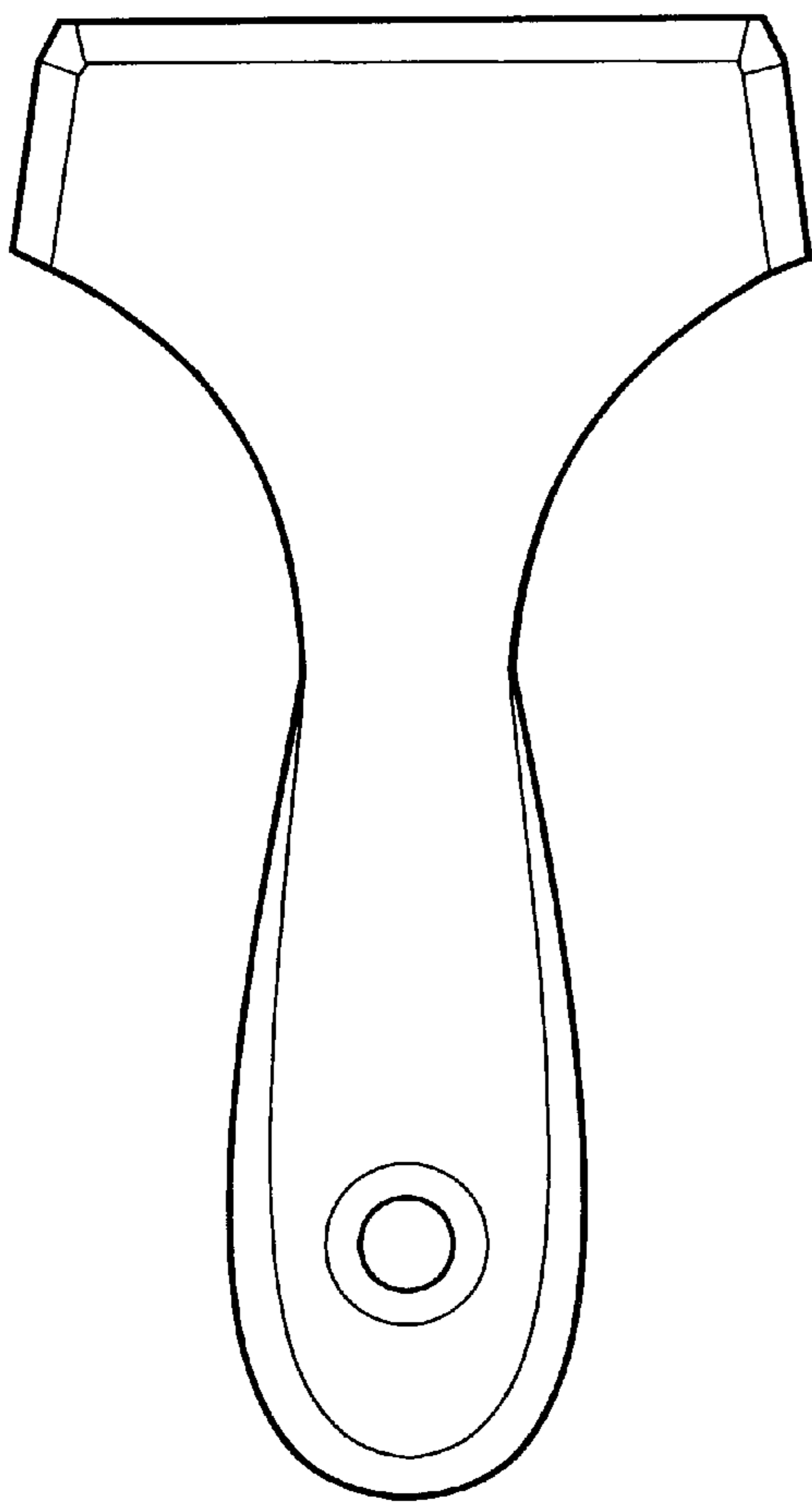

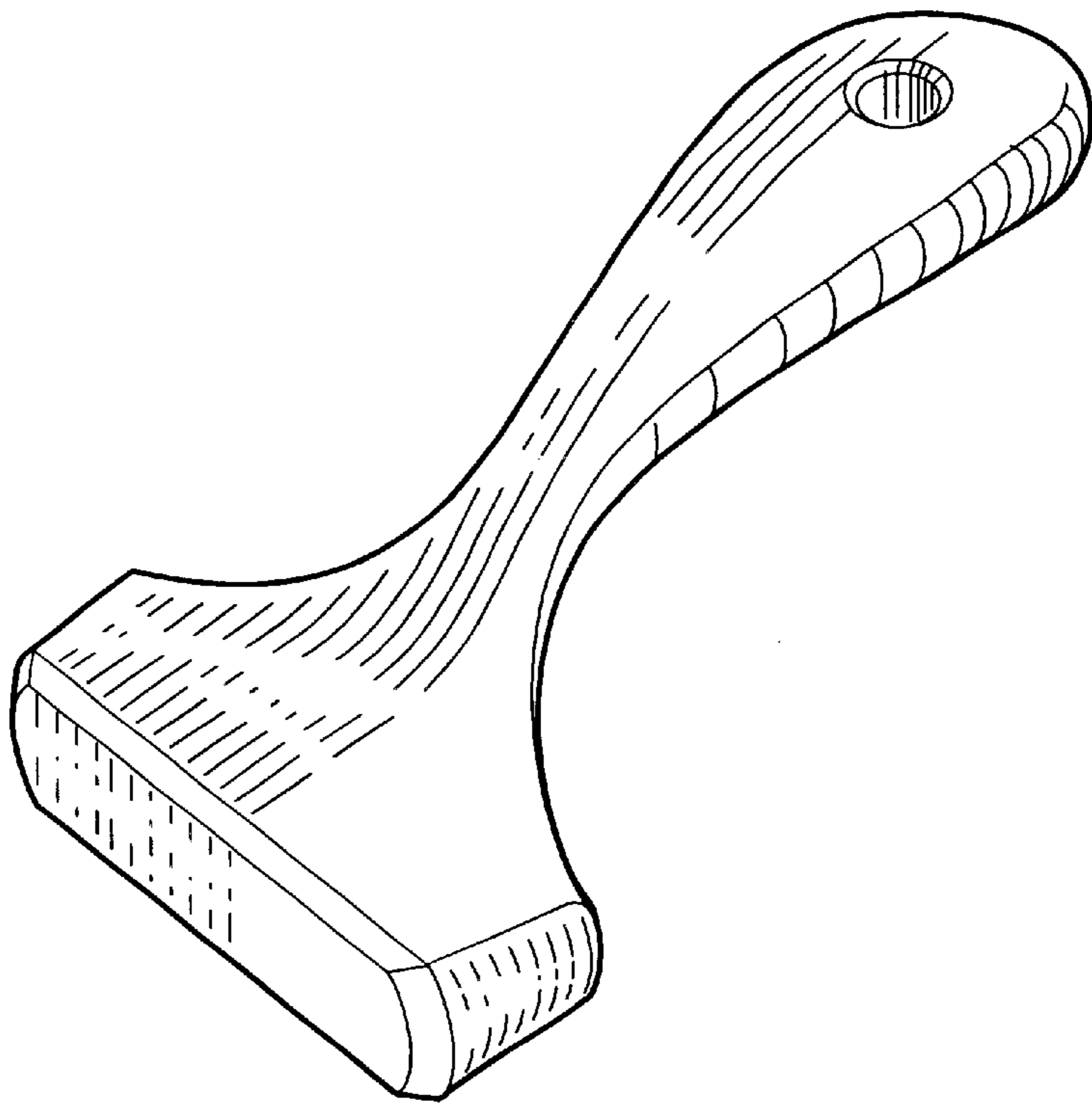

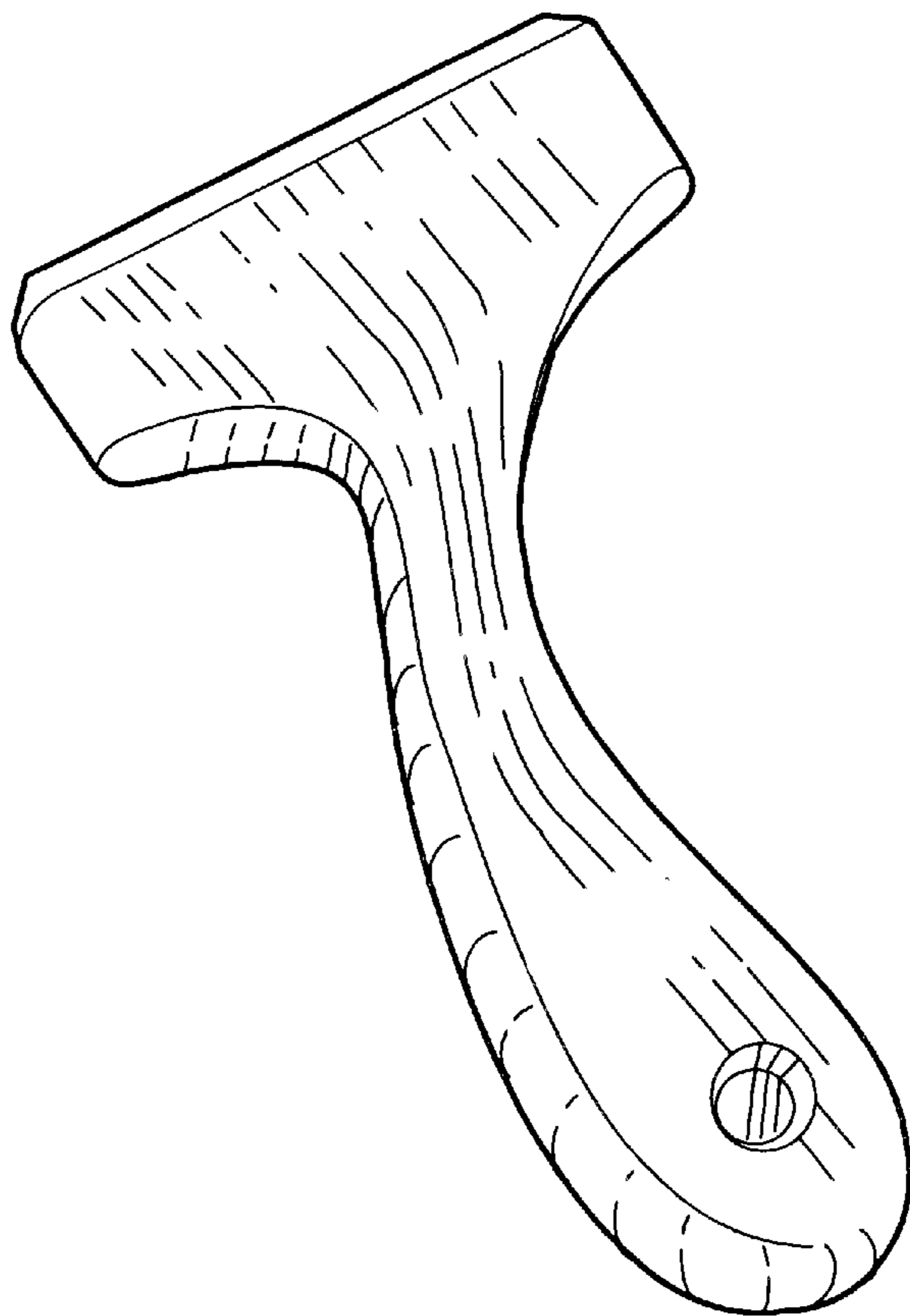

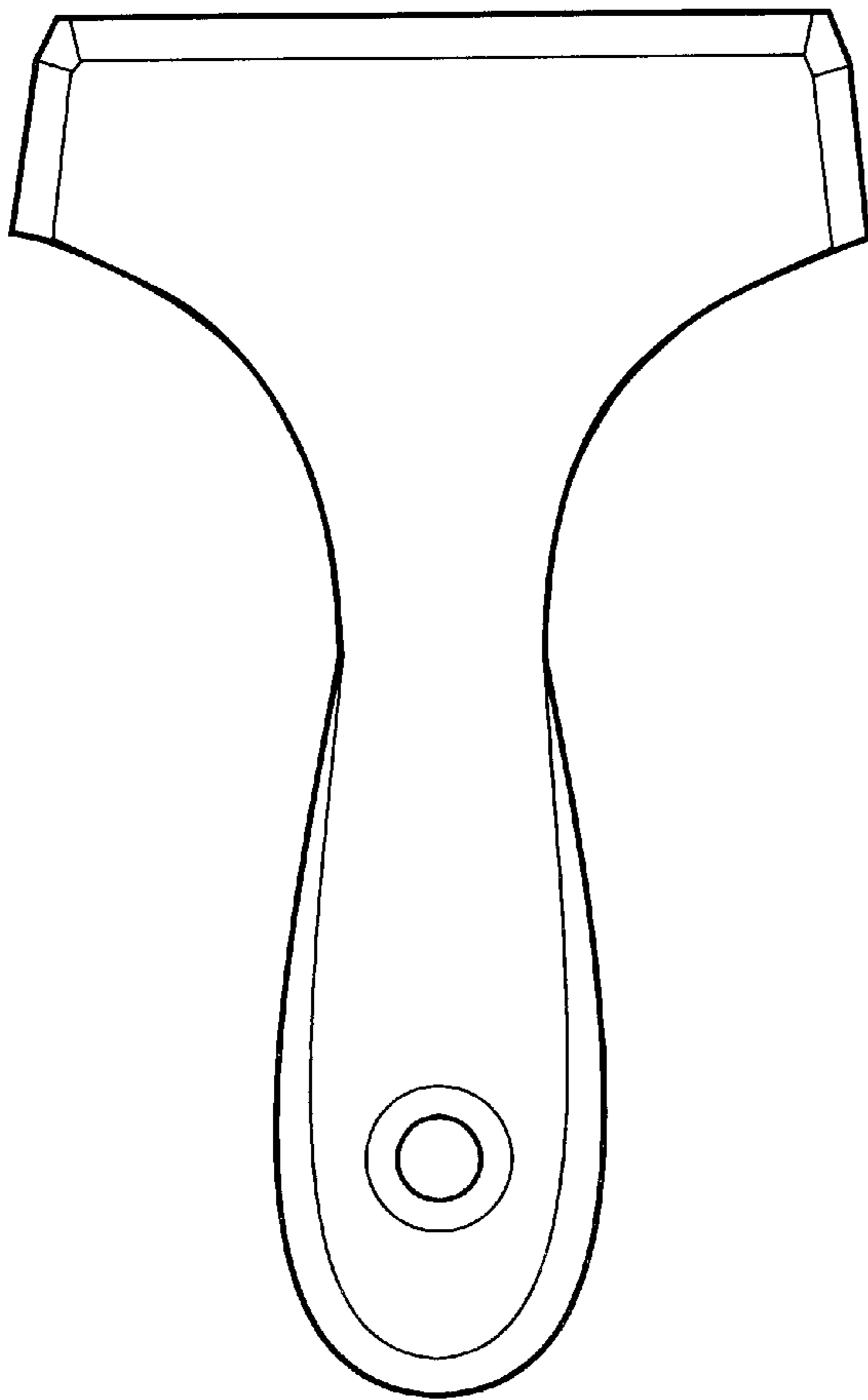

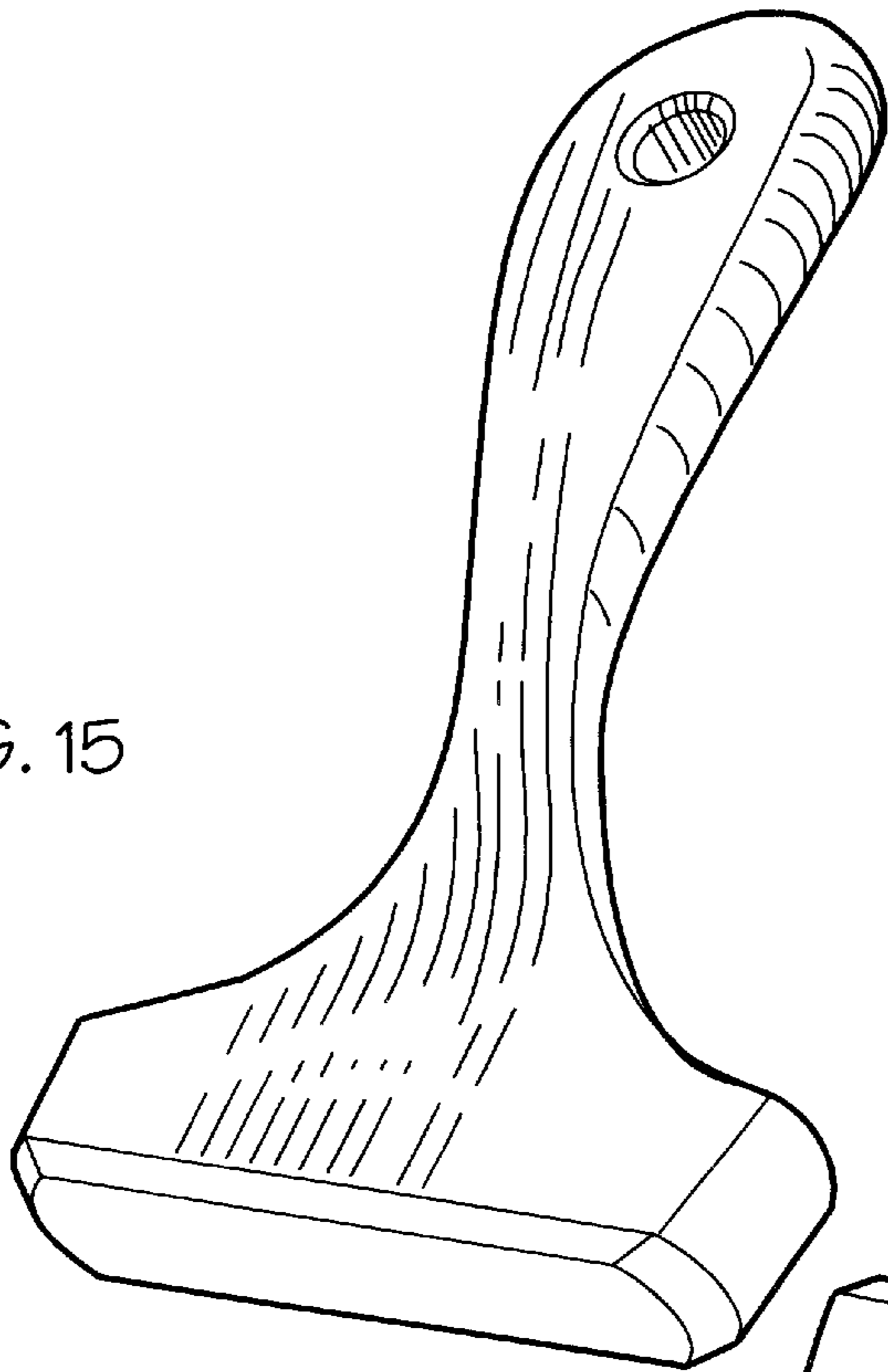

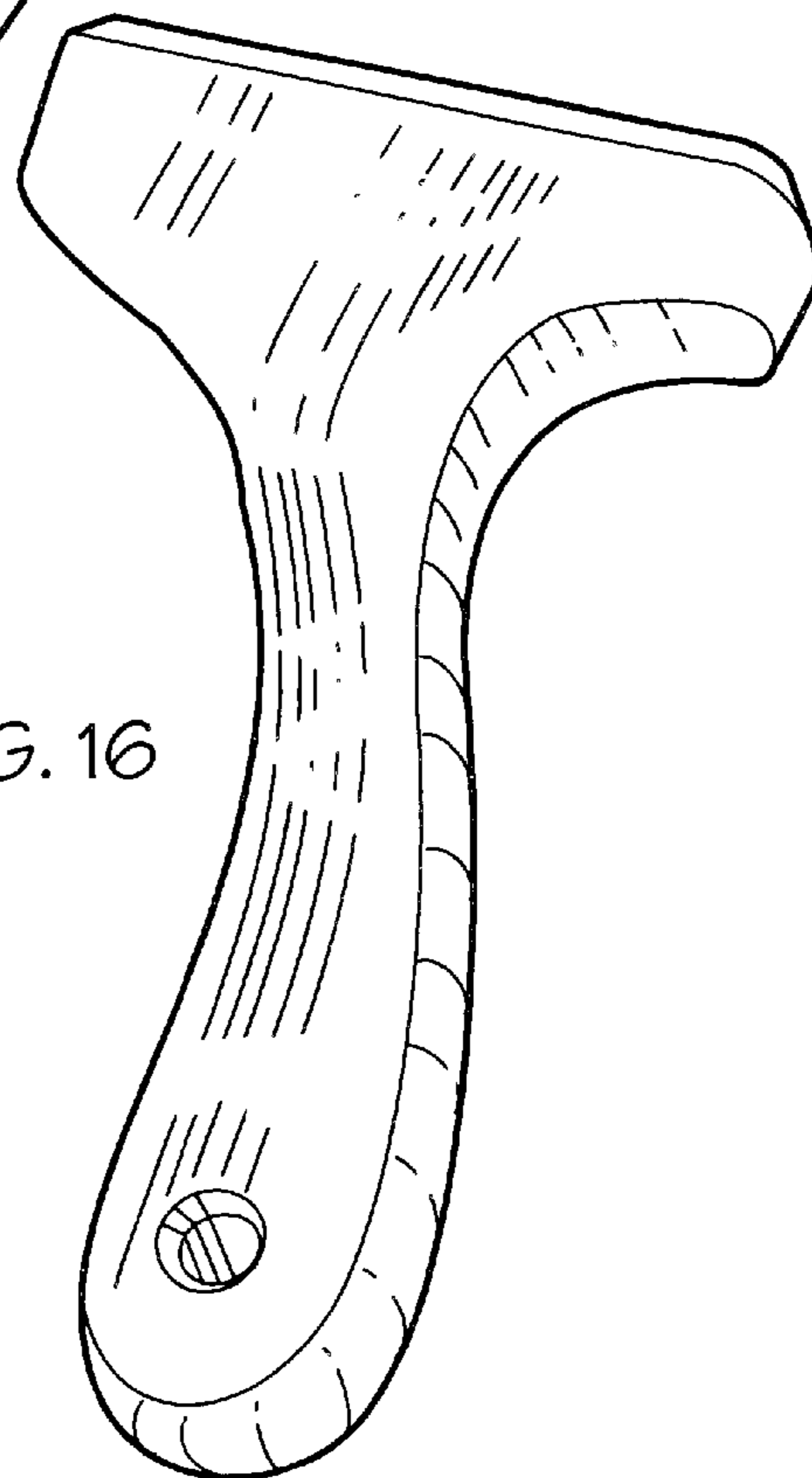

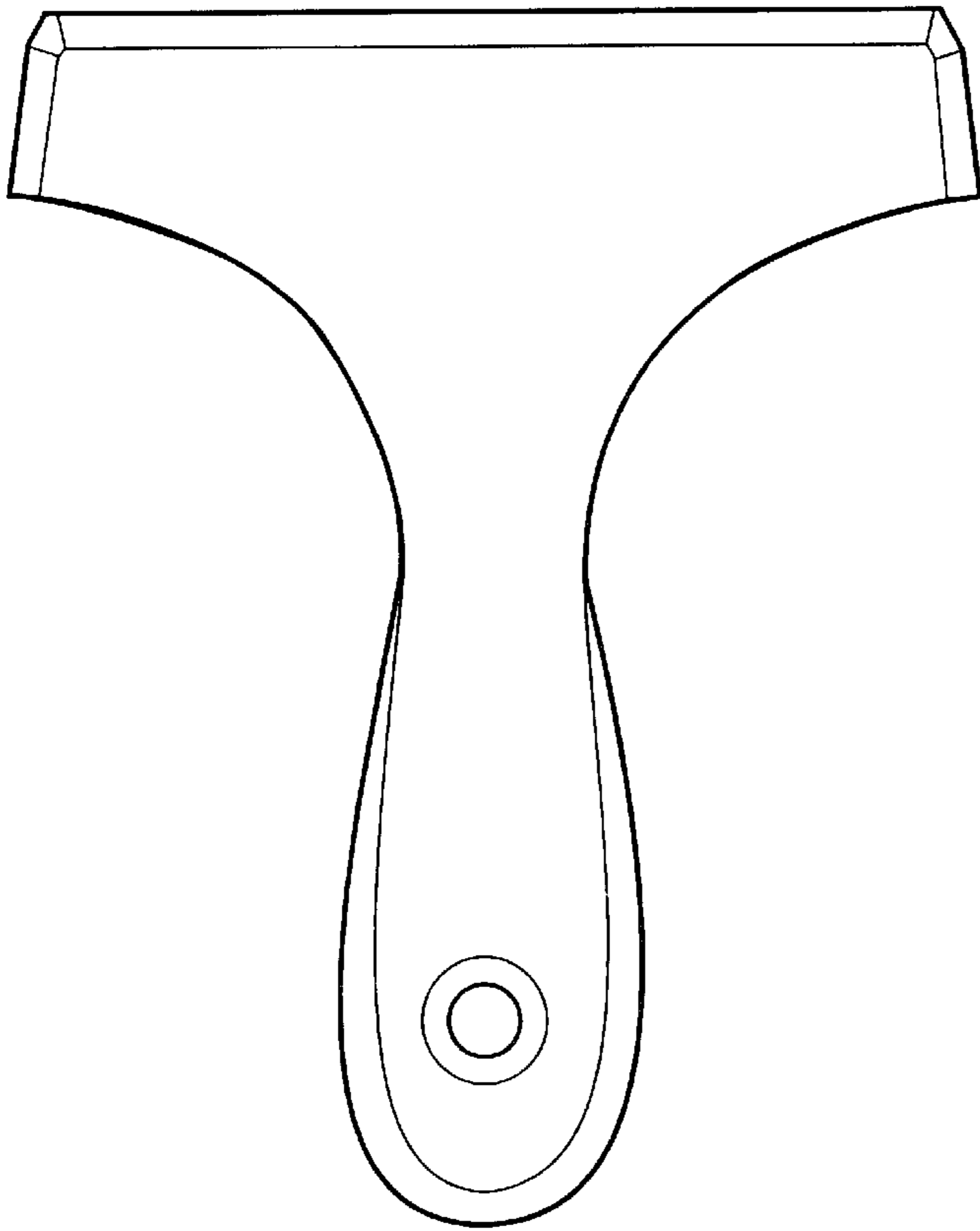

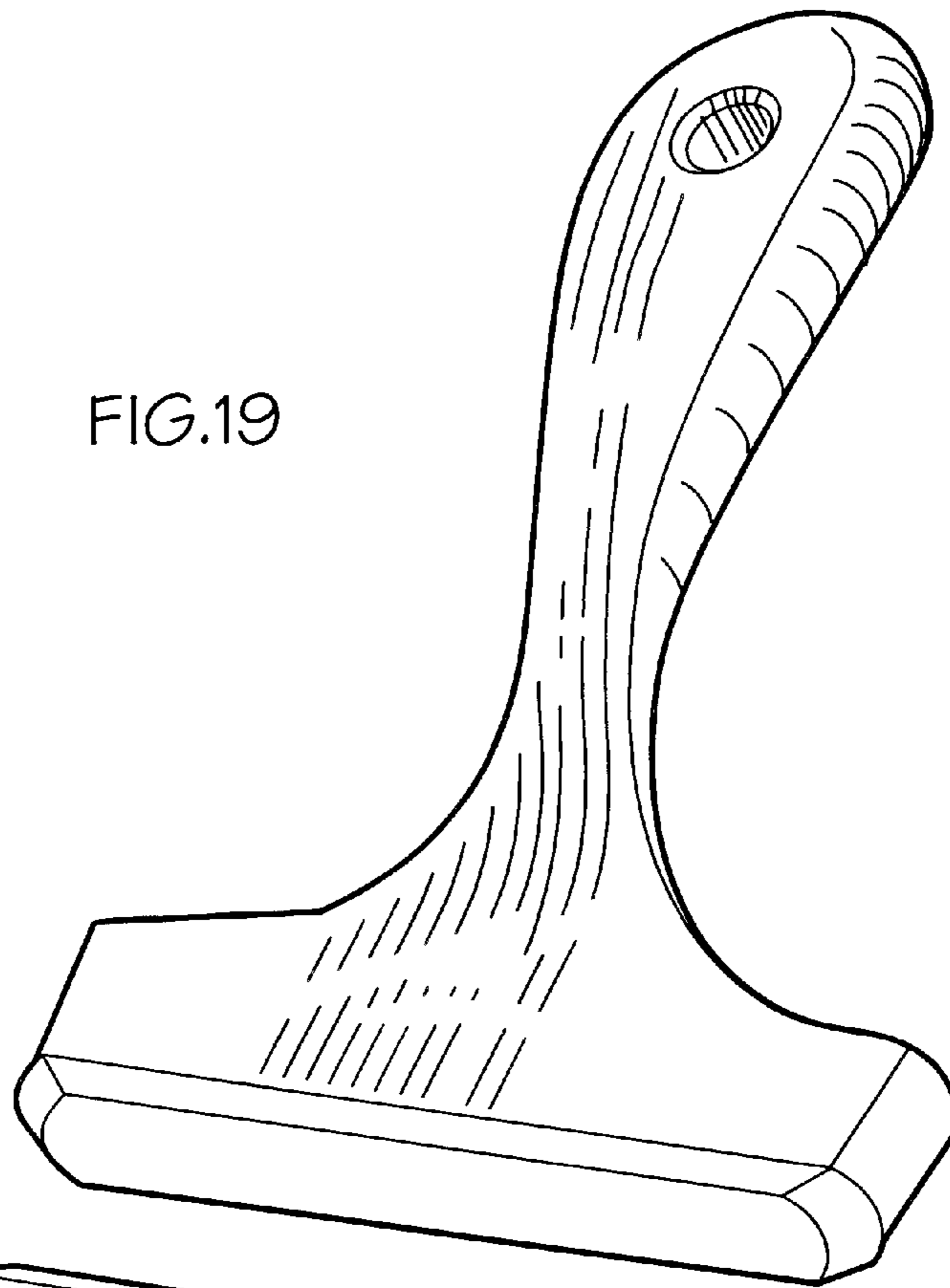
