DESCRIPTION

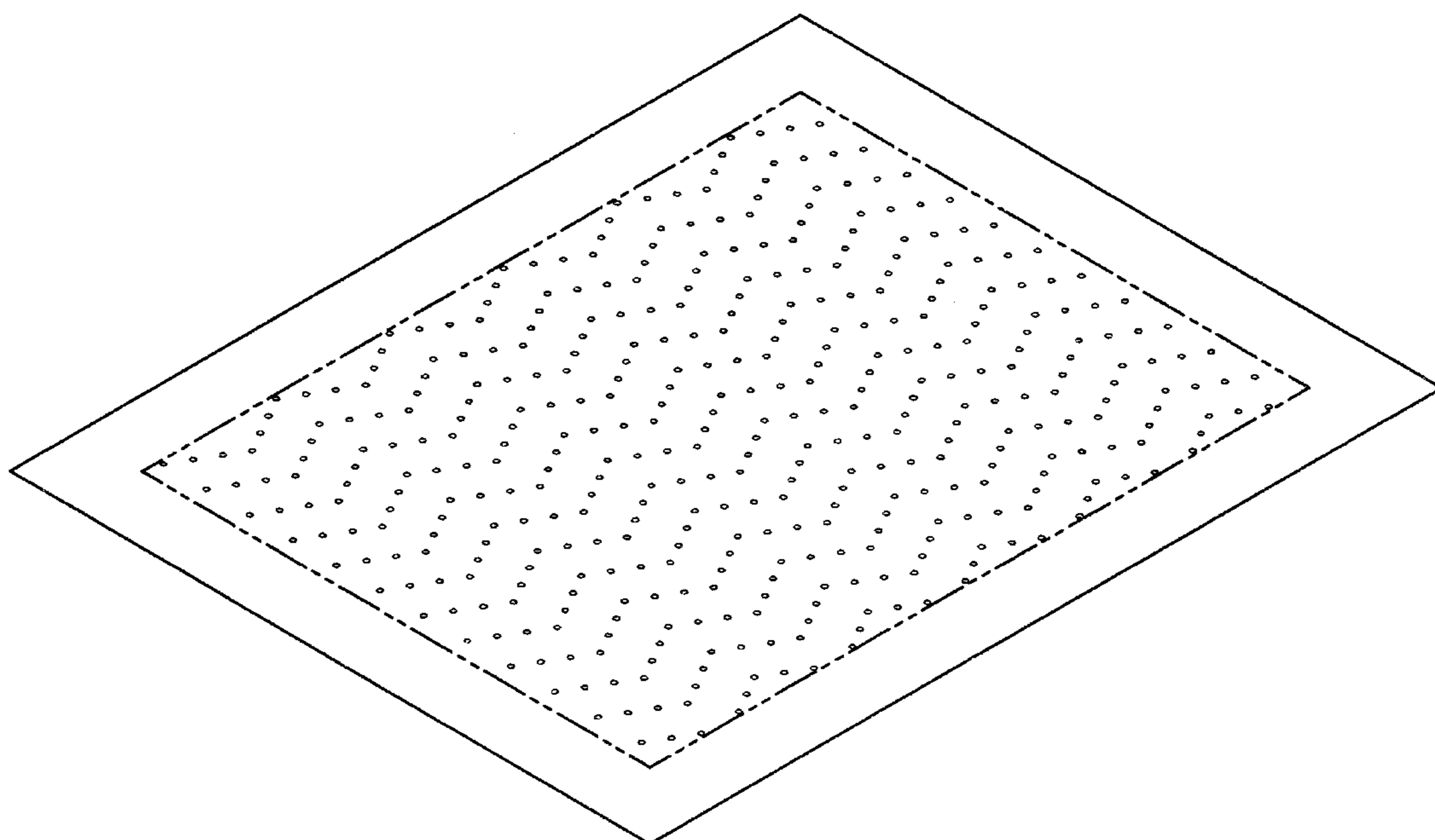
FIG. 1 is a perspective view illustrating the disposable sheet, constructed in accordance with the teachings of the present invention.

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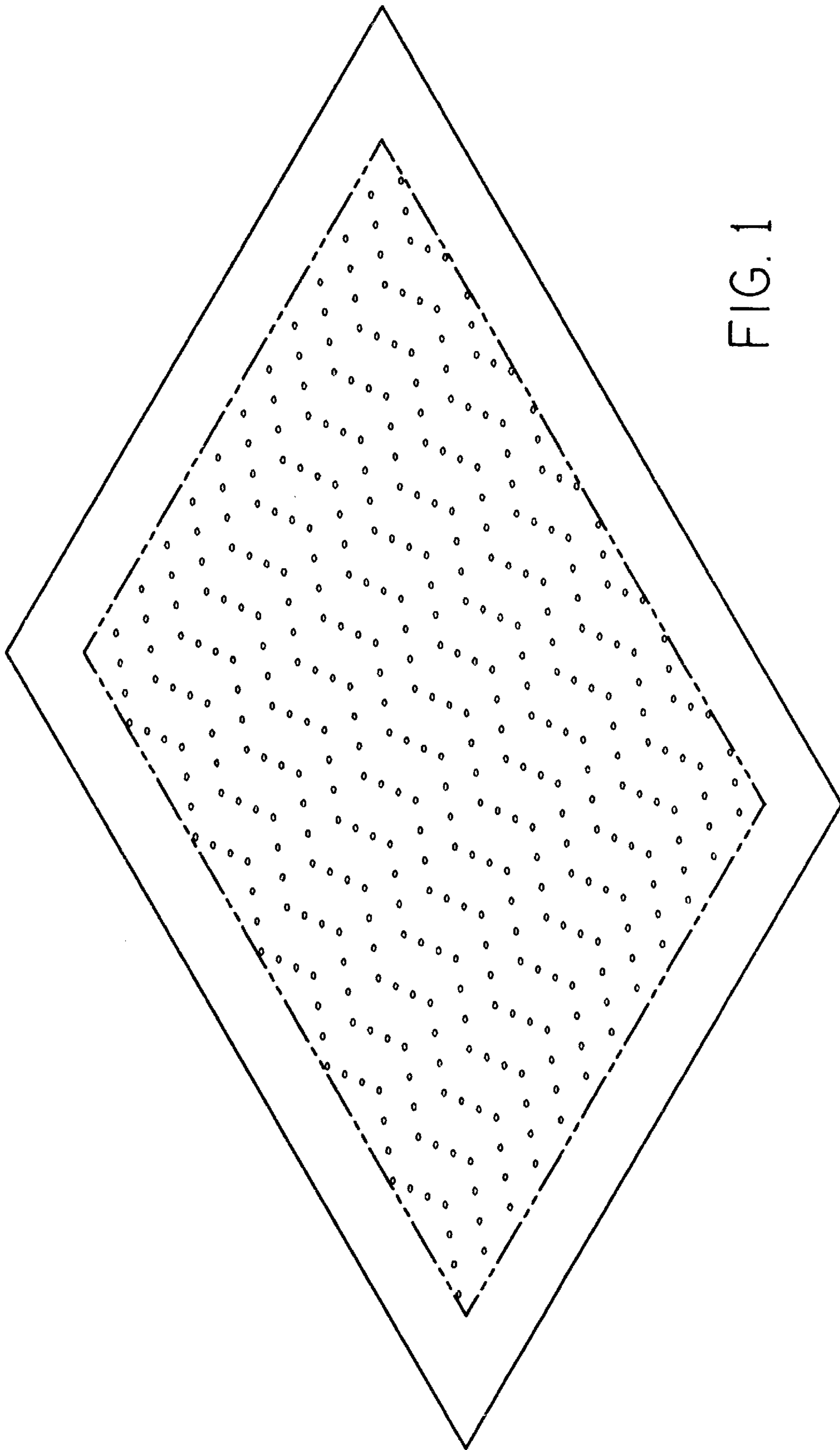

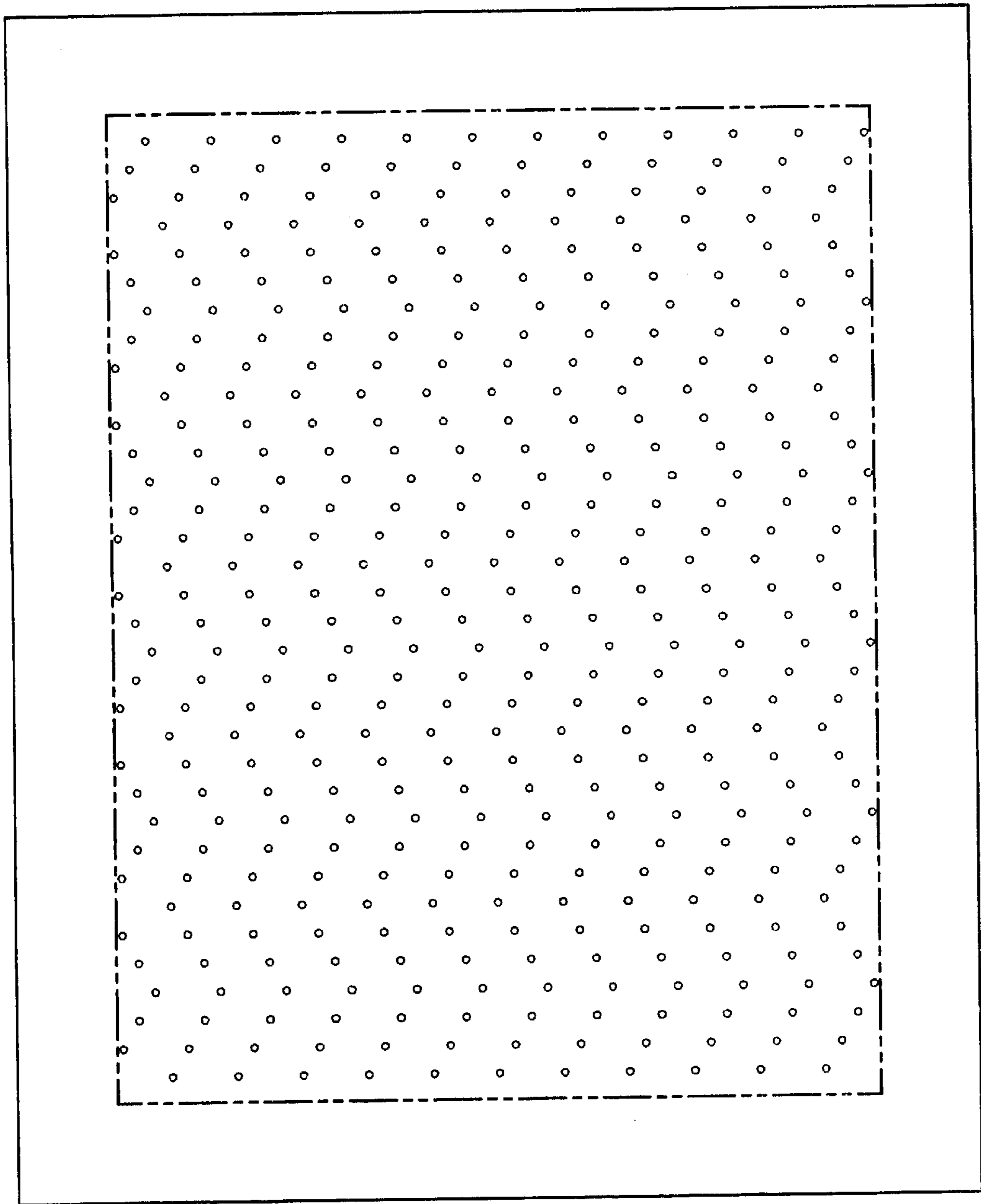

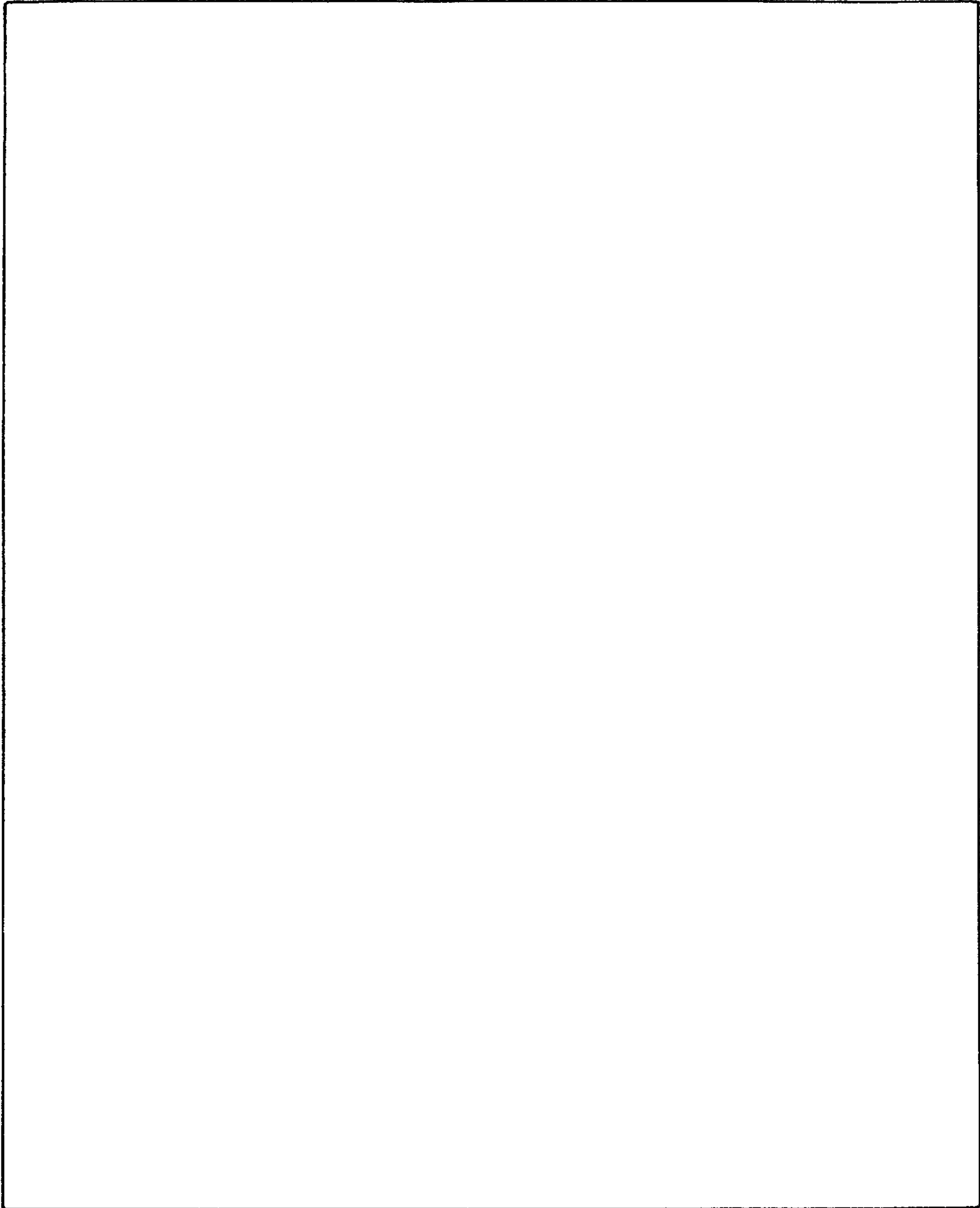
