(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a sanitary napkin having an intergluteal strip, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

intergluteal strip showing my new design.

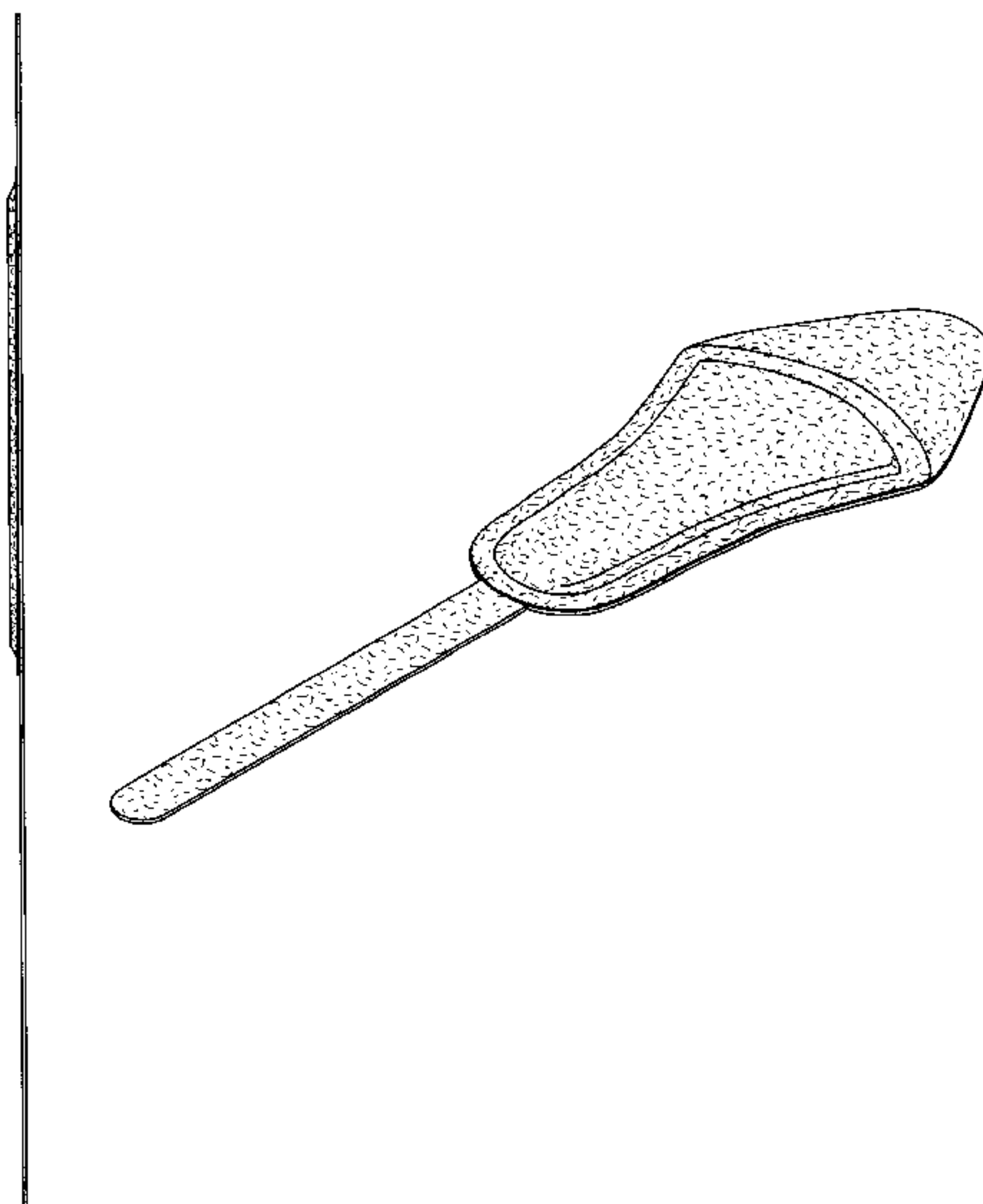

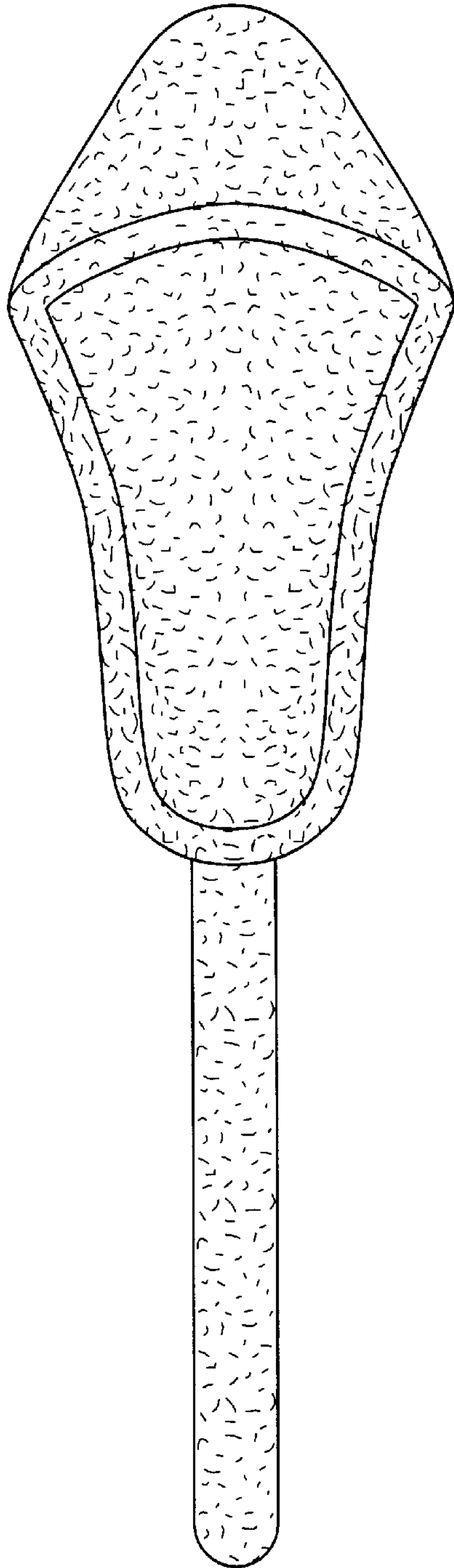

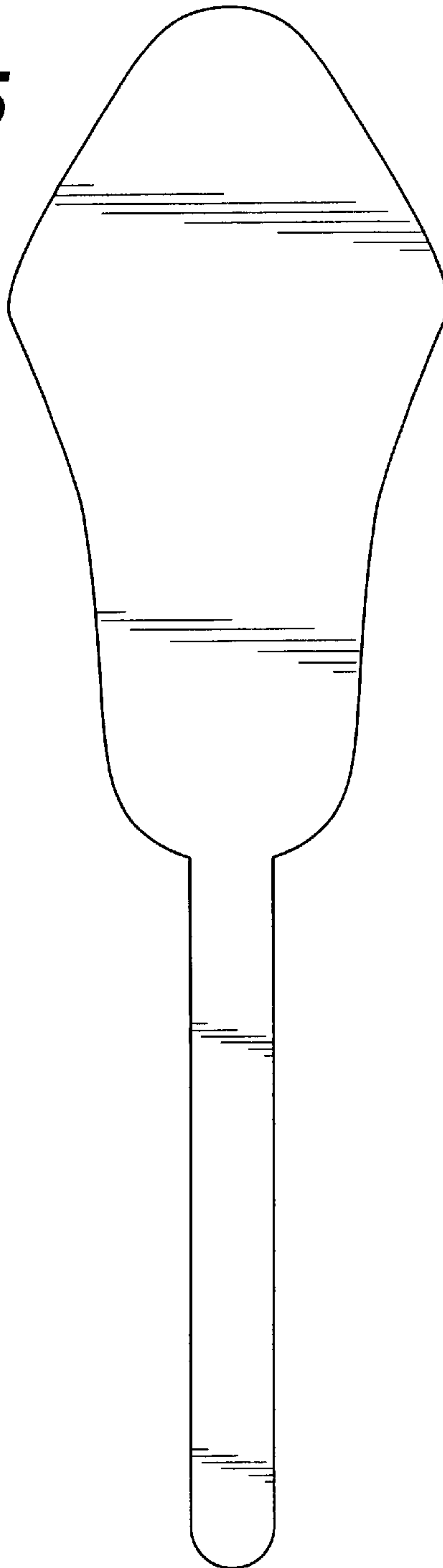

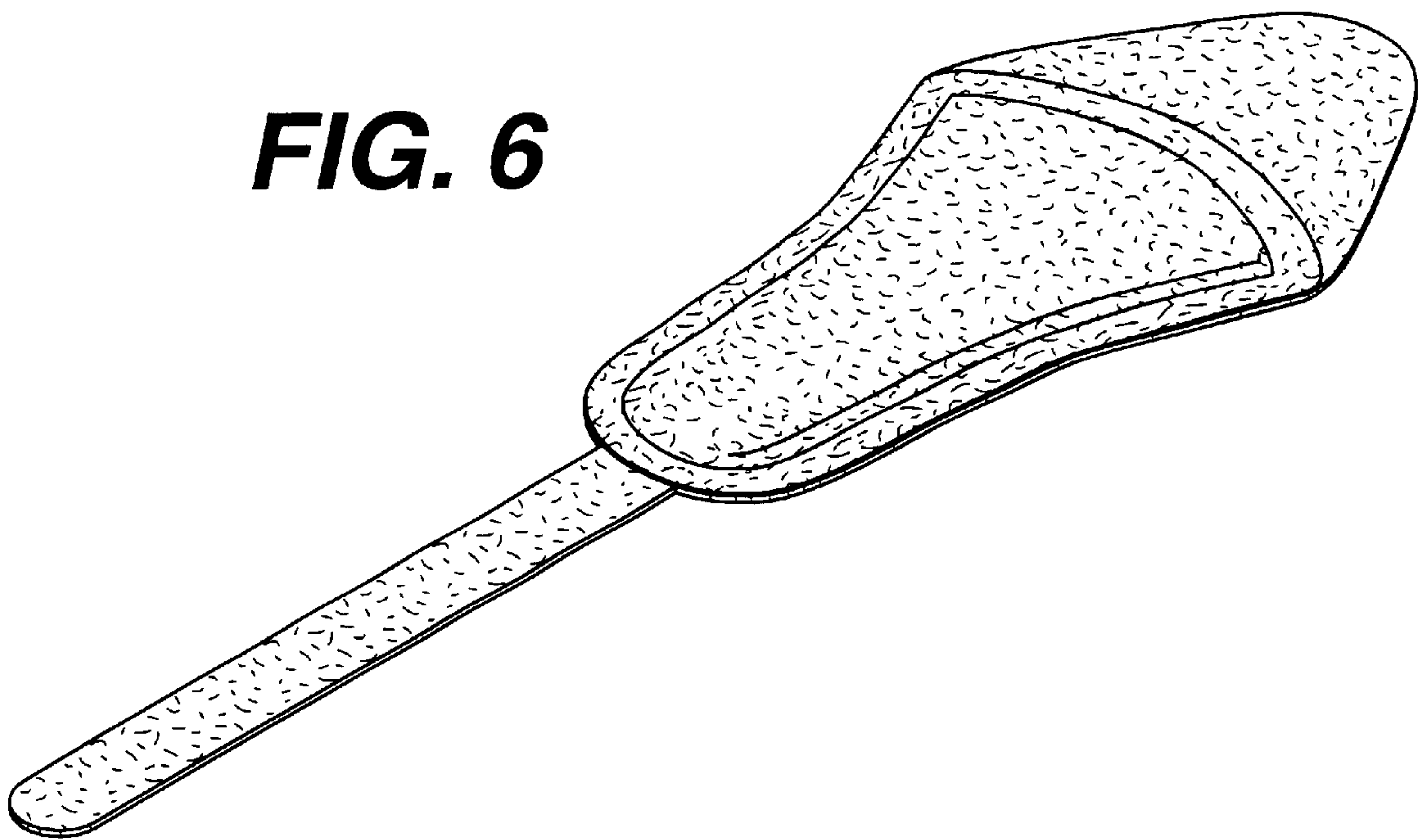

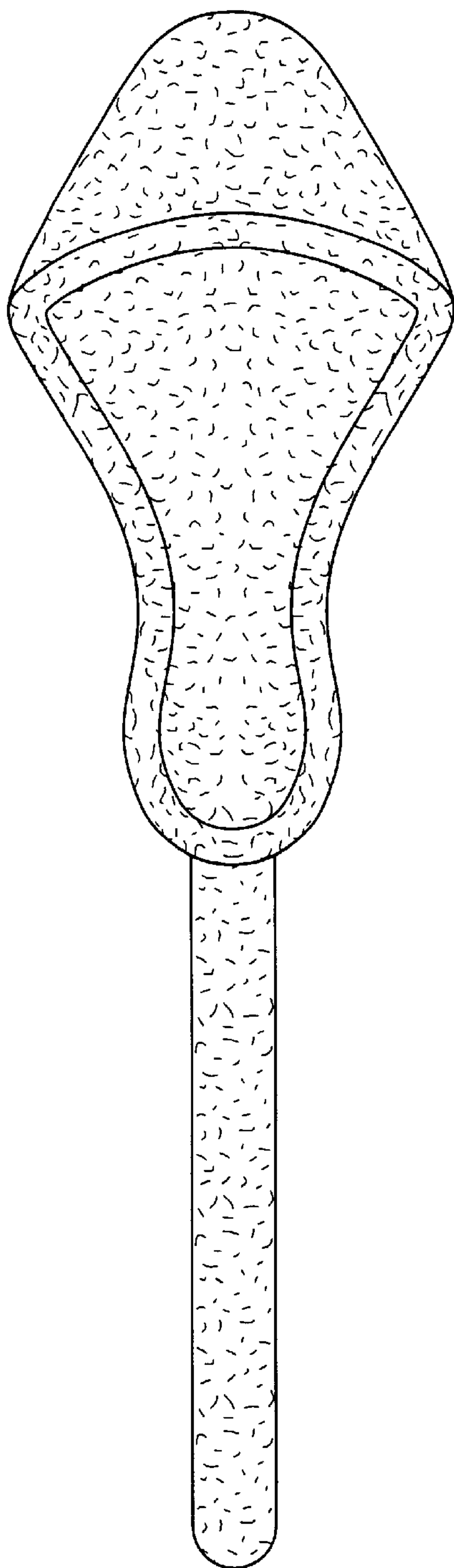

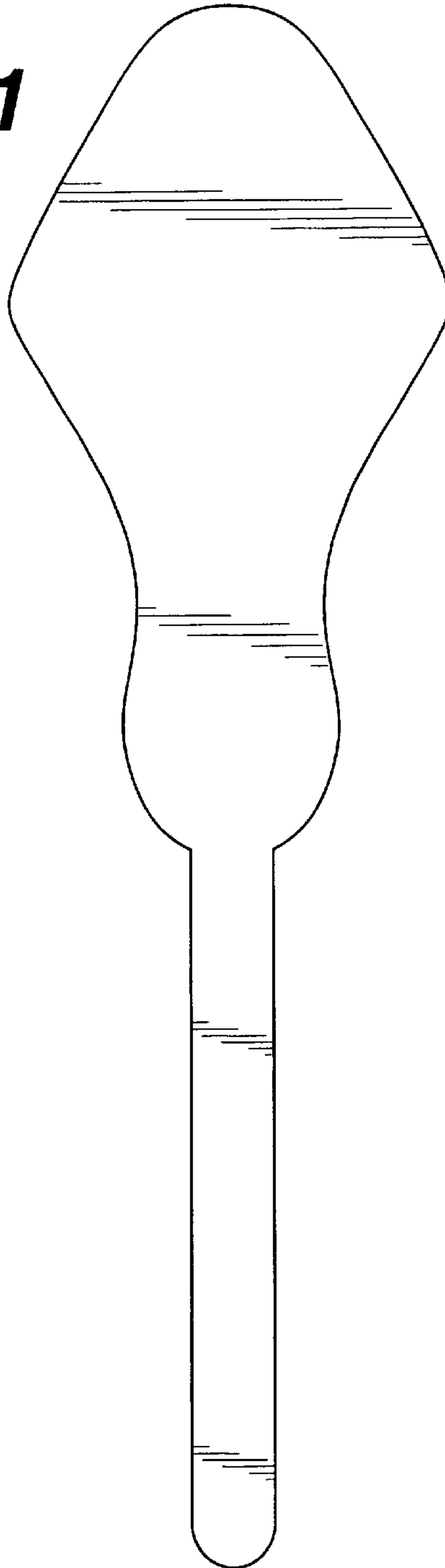

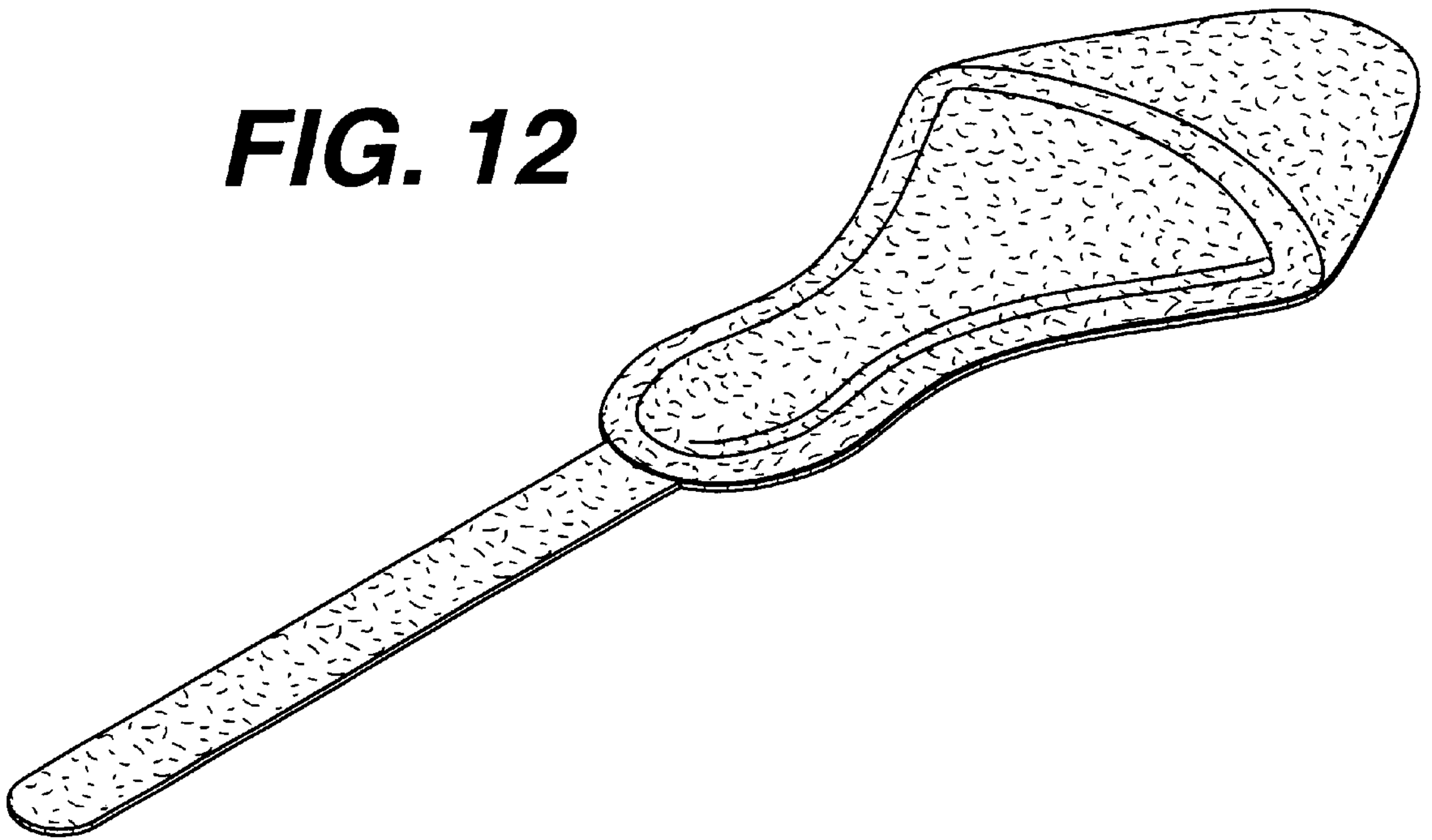

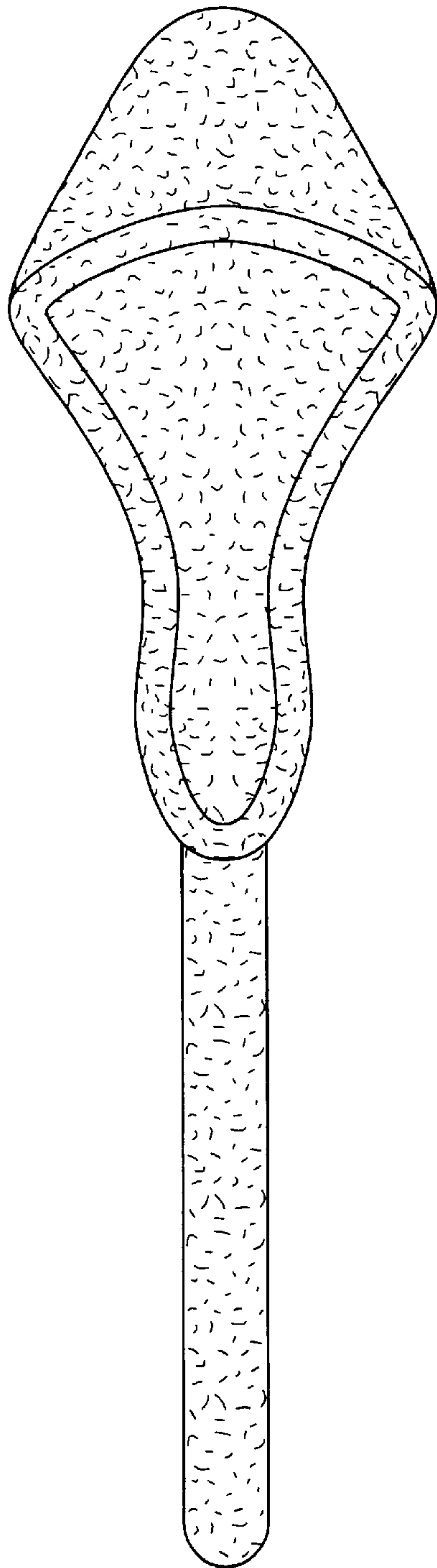

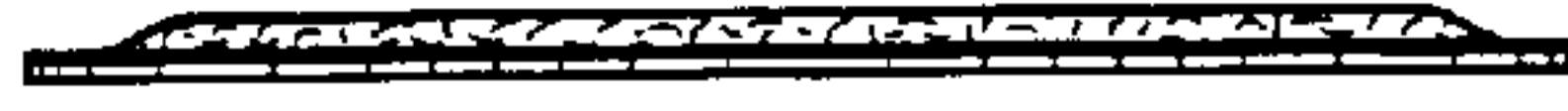

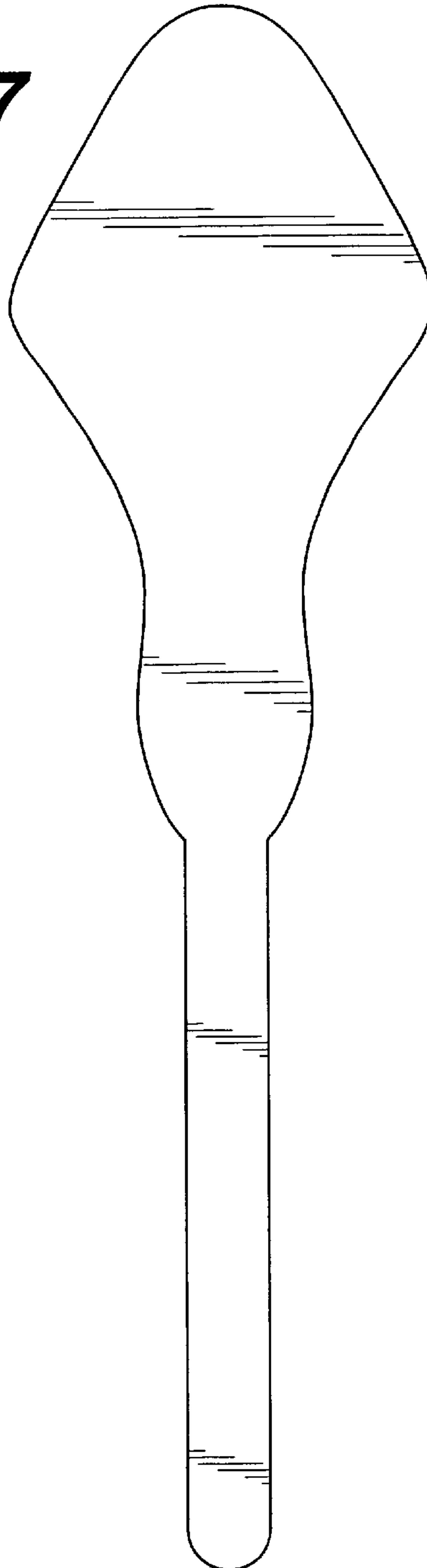

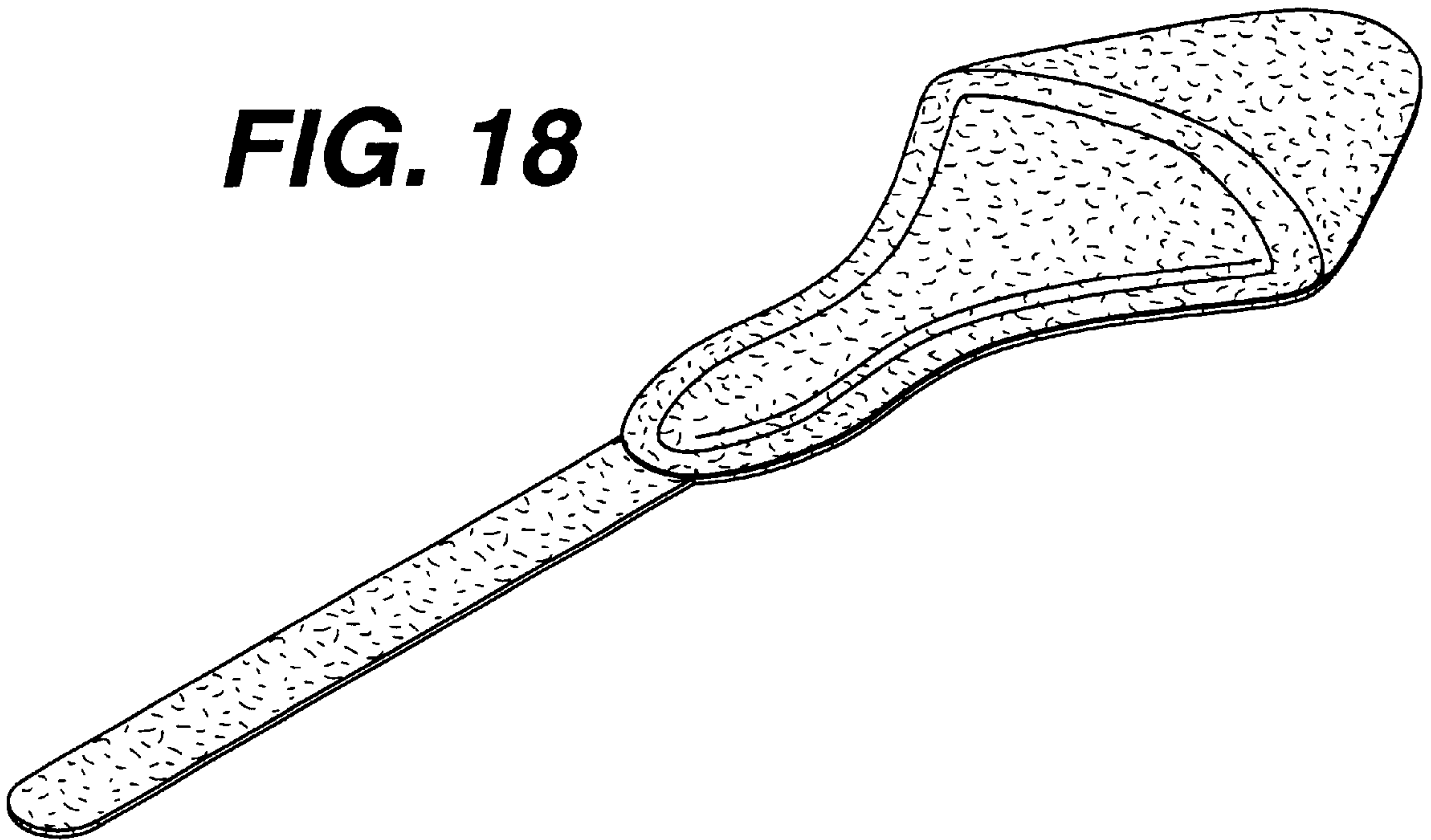

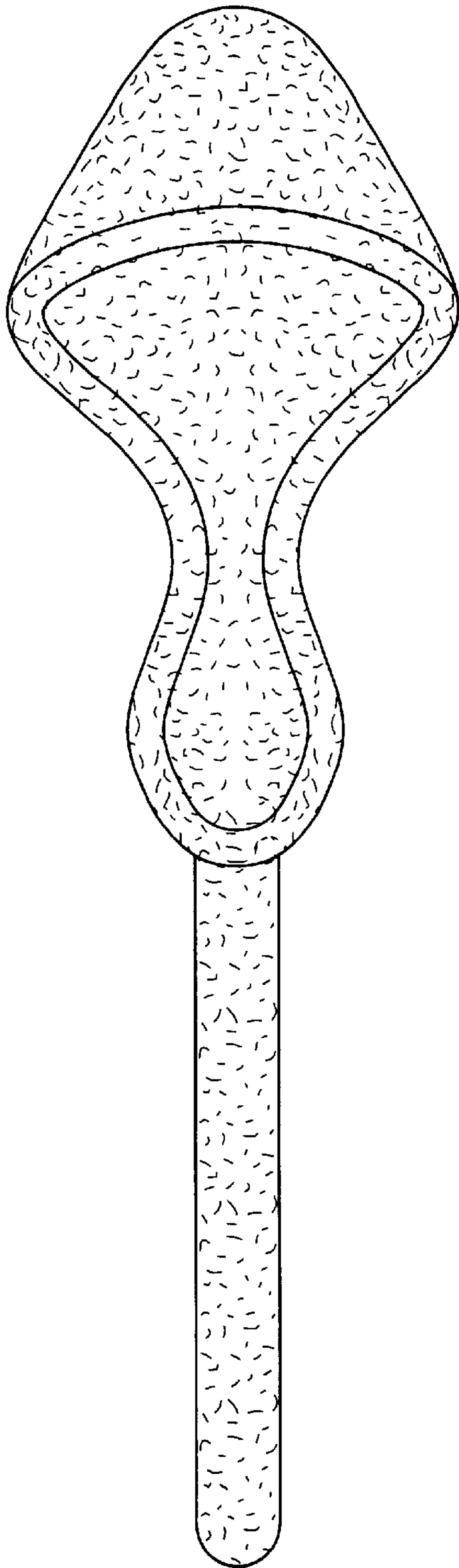

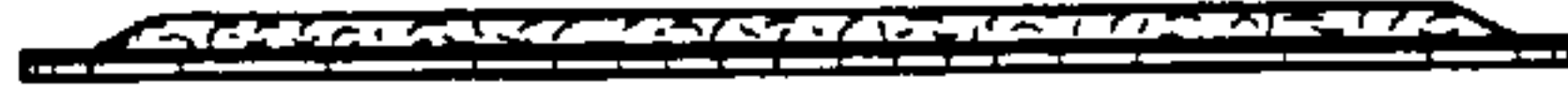

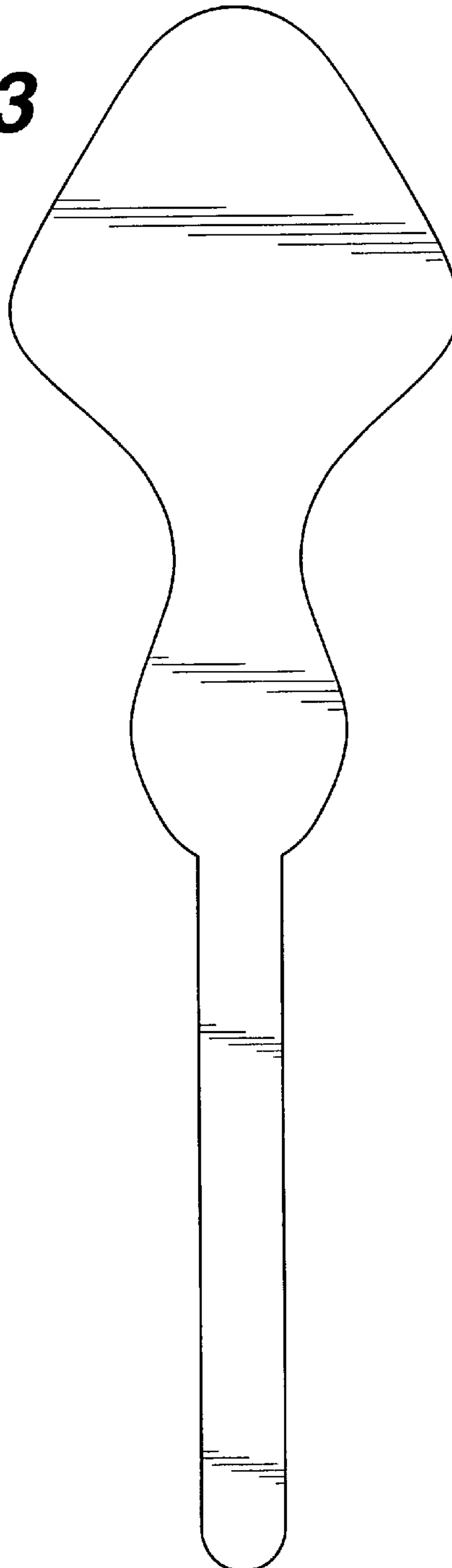
