FIG. 17 is a view from the handle end thereof; and,
FIG. 18 is a perspective view from the left side thereof.

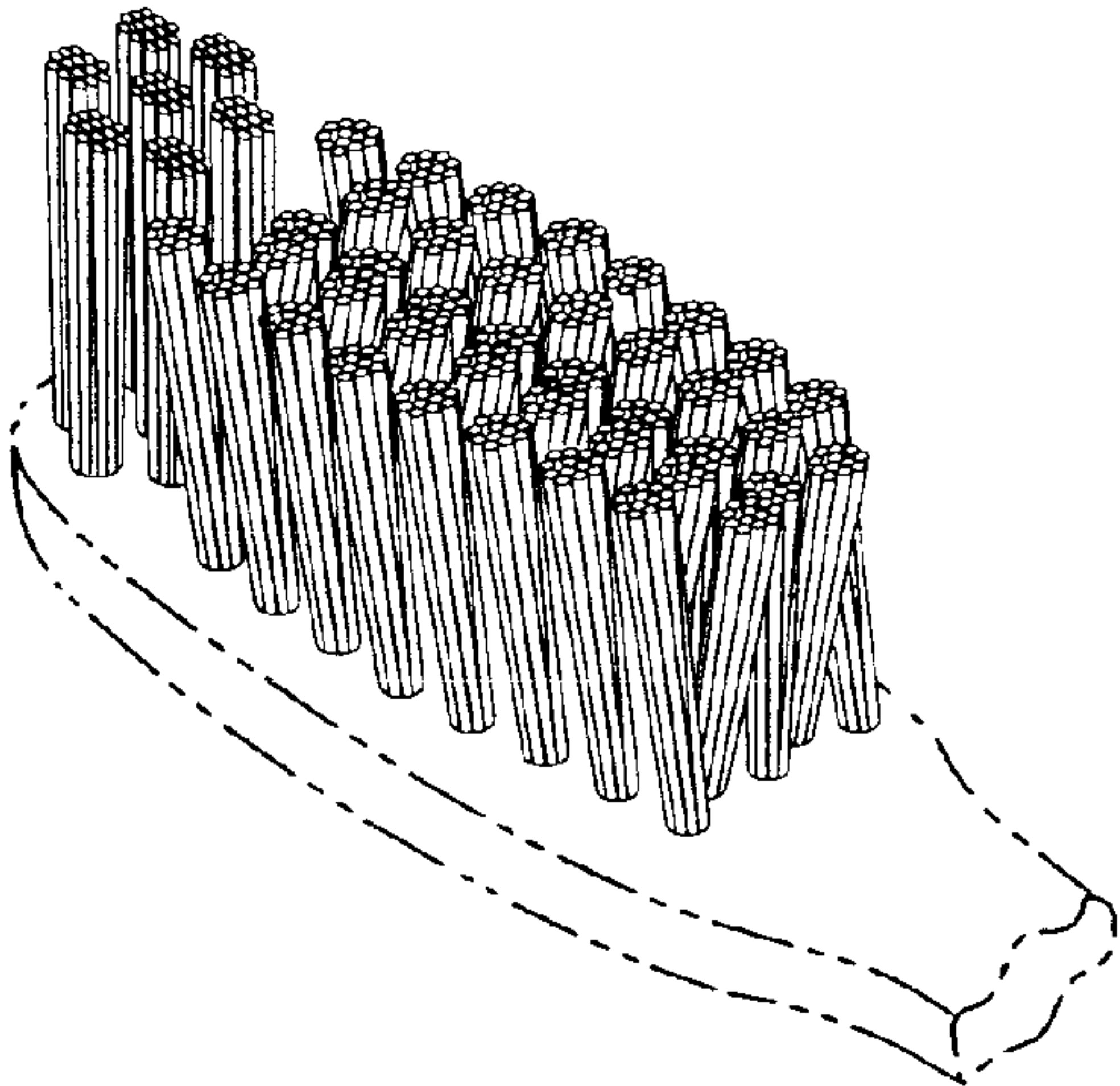

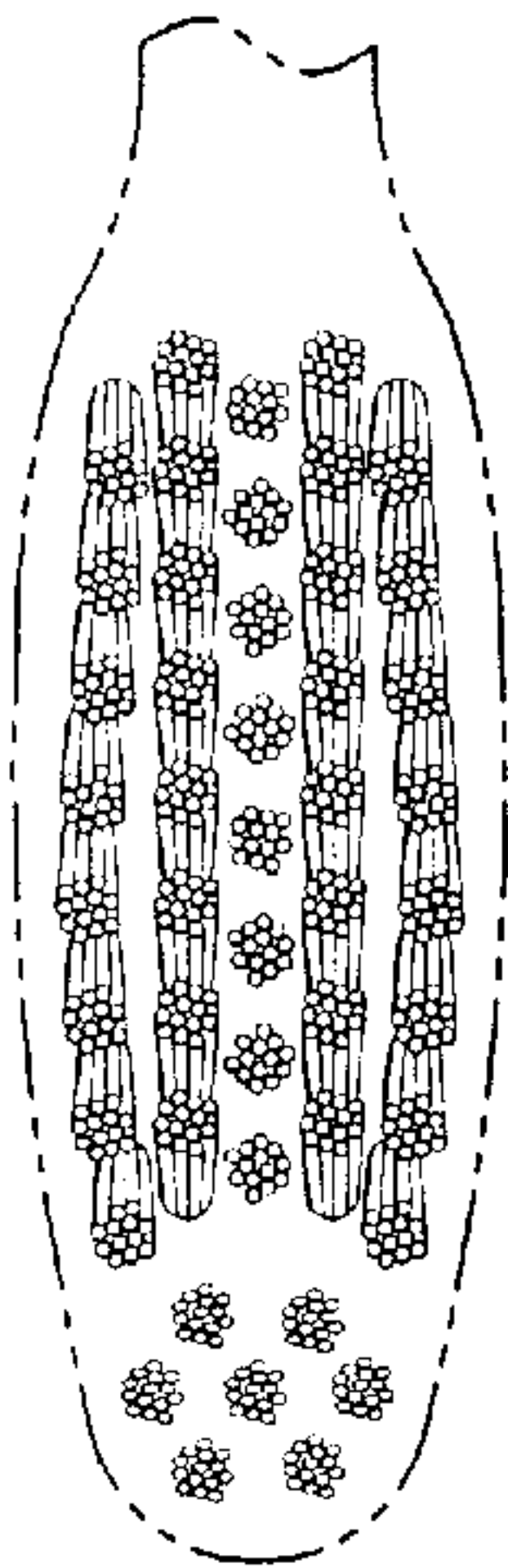

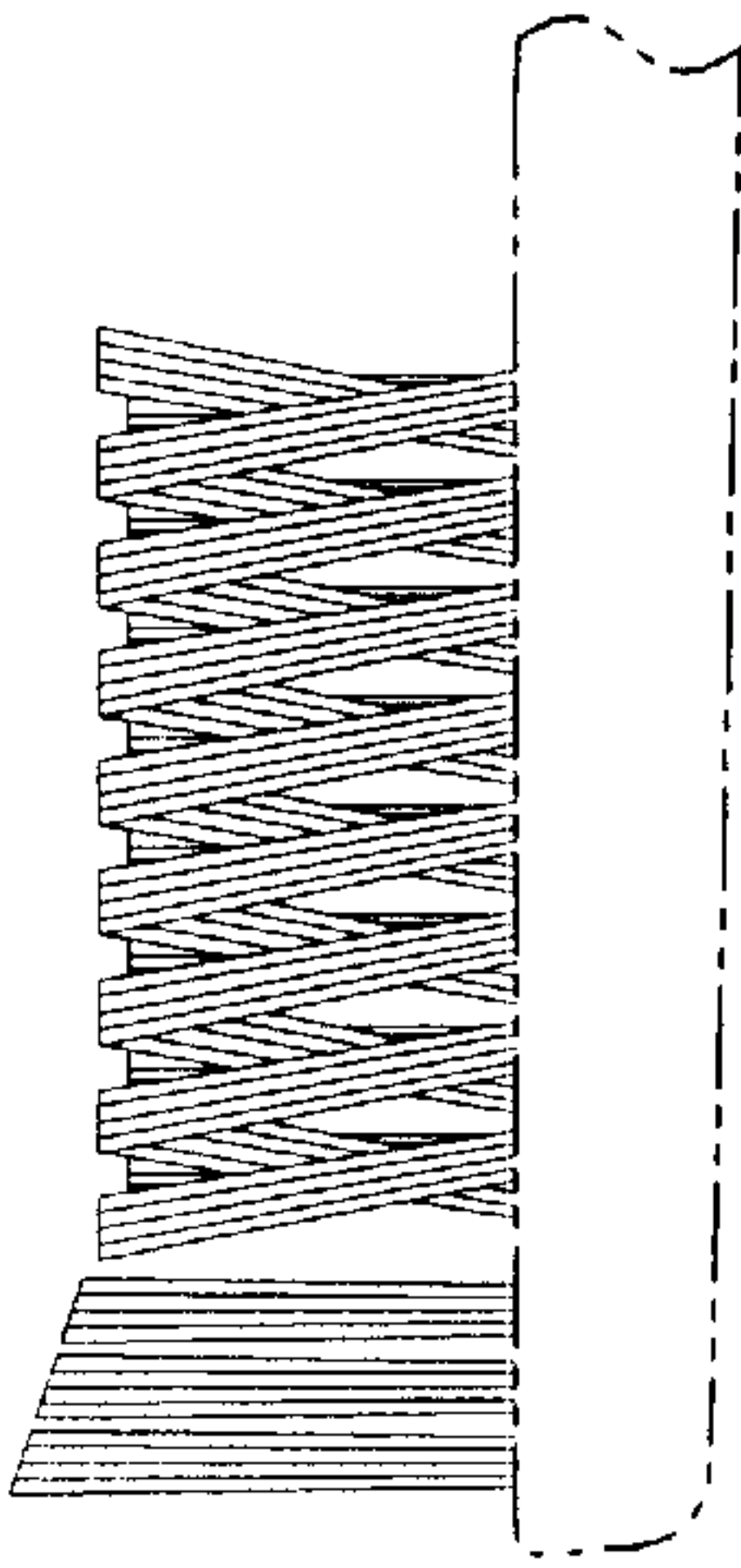

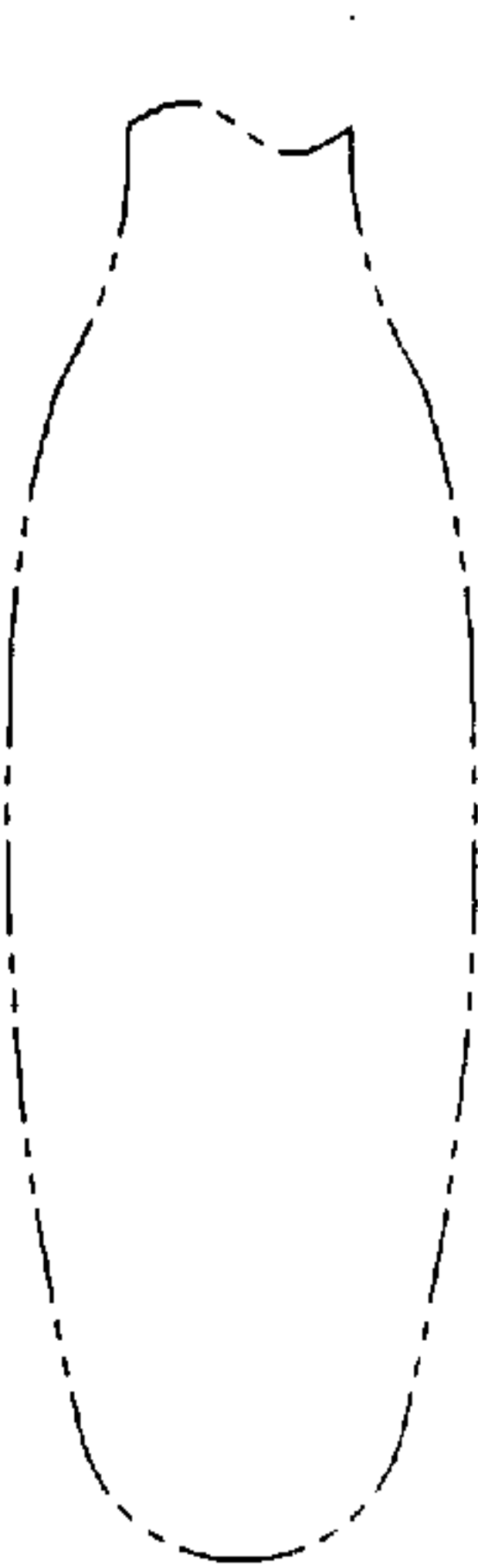

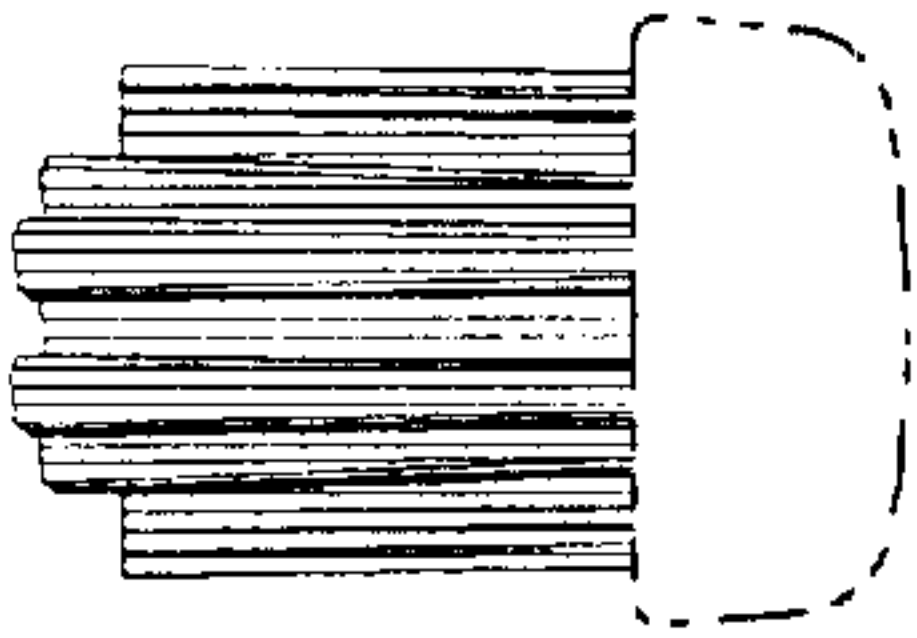

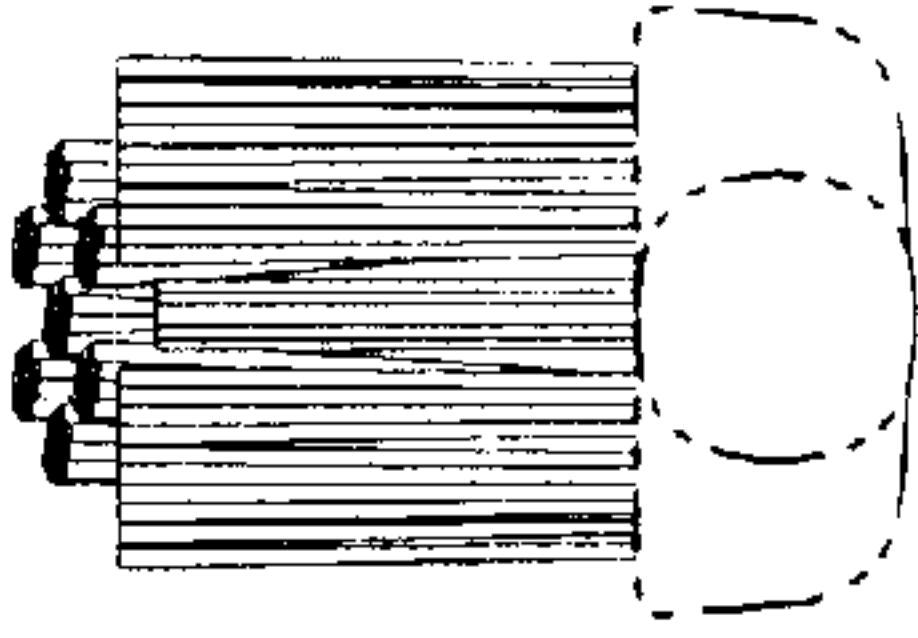

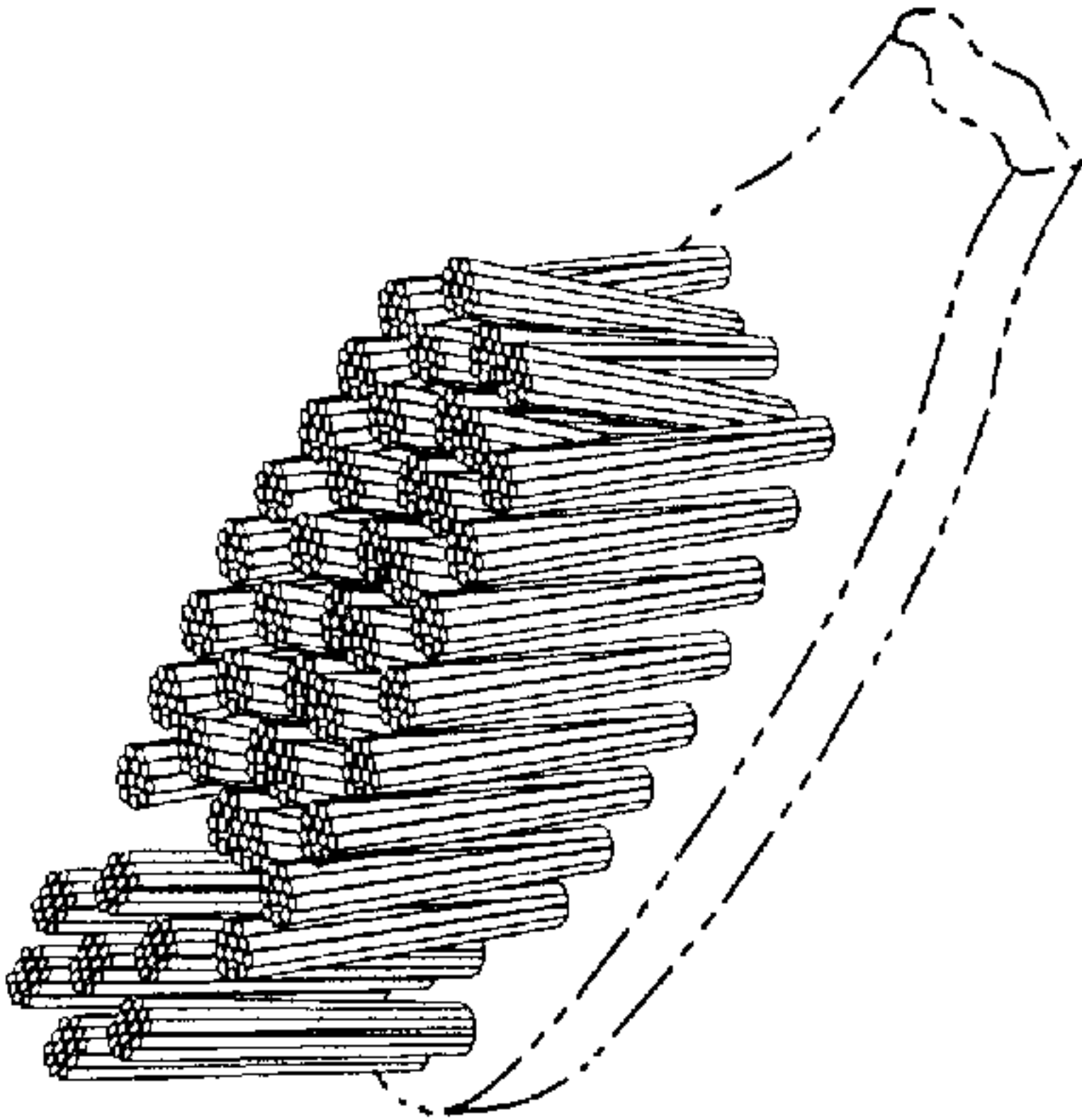

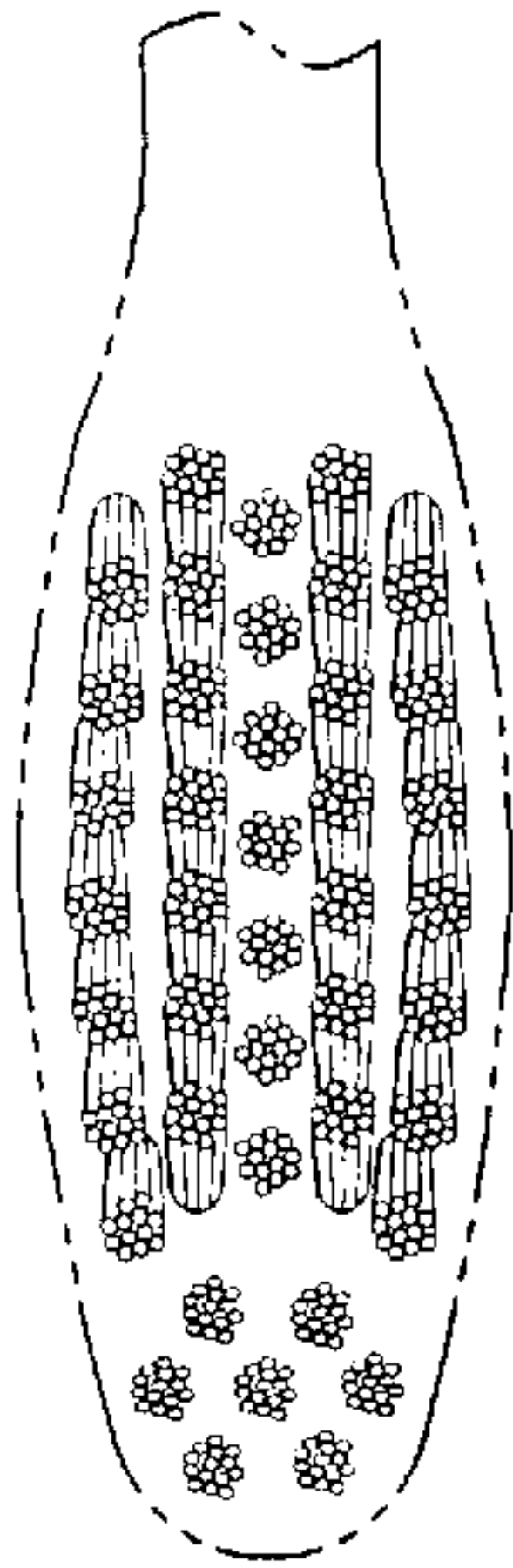

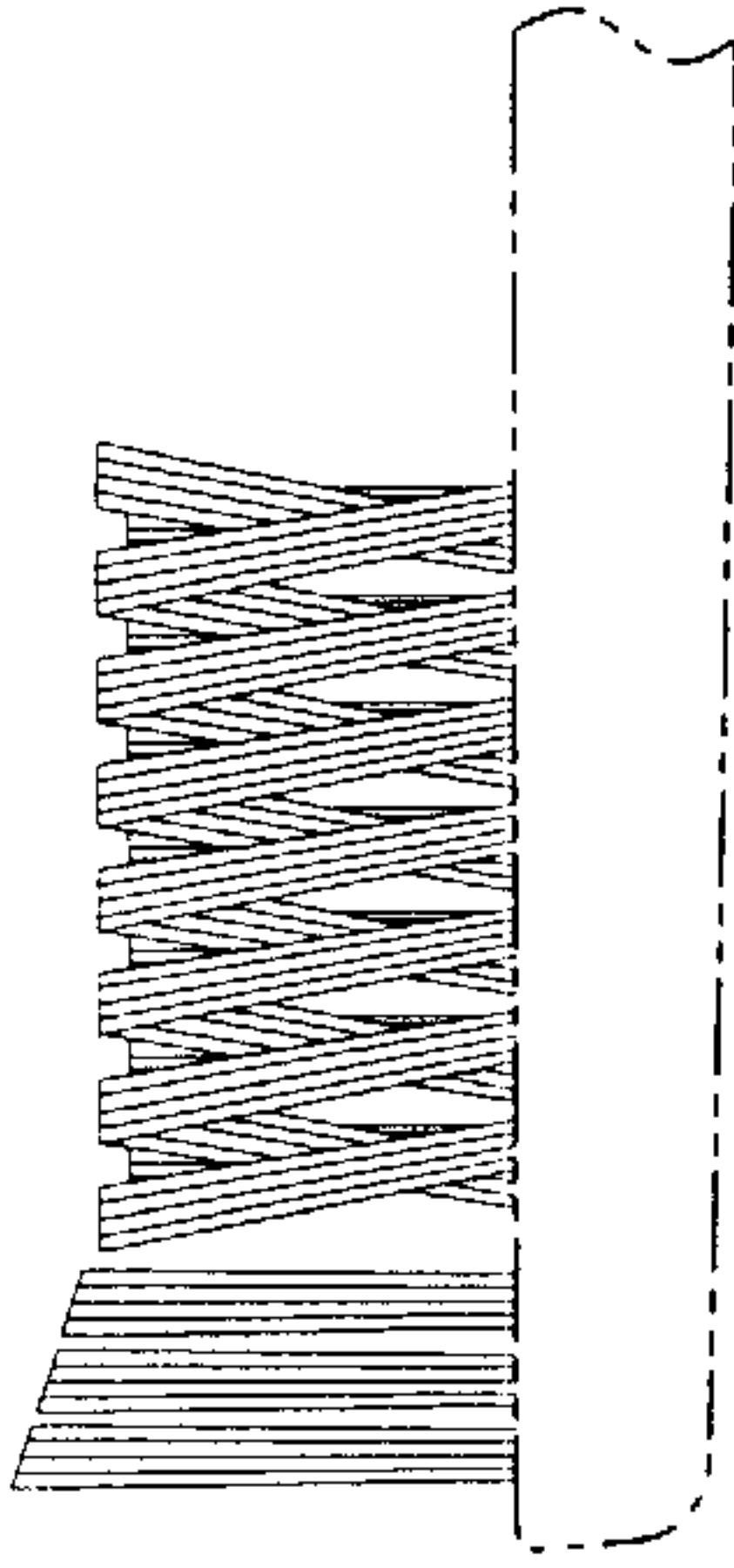

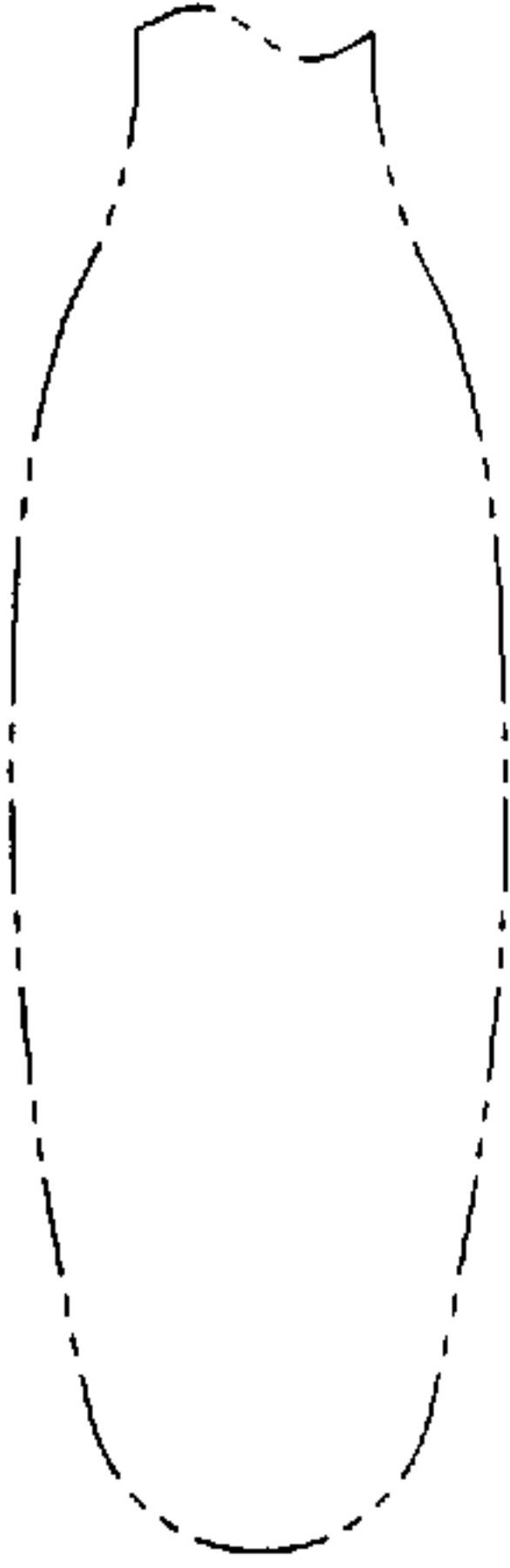

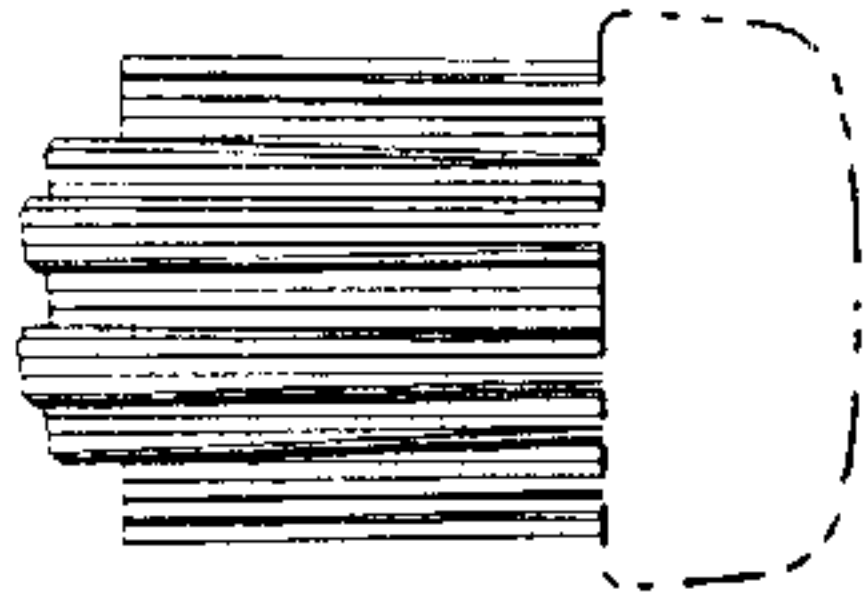

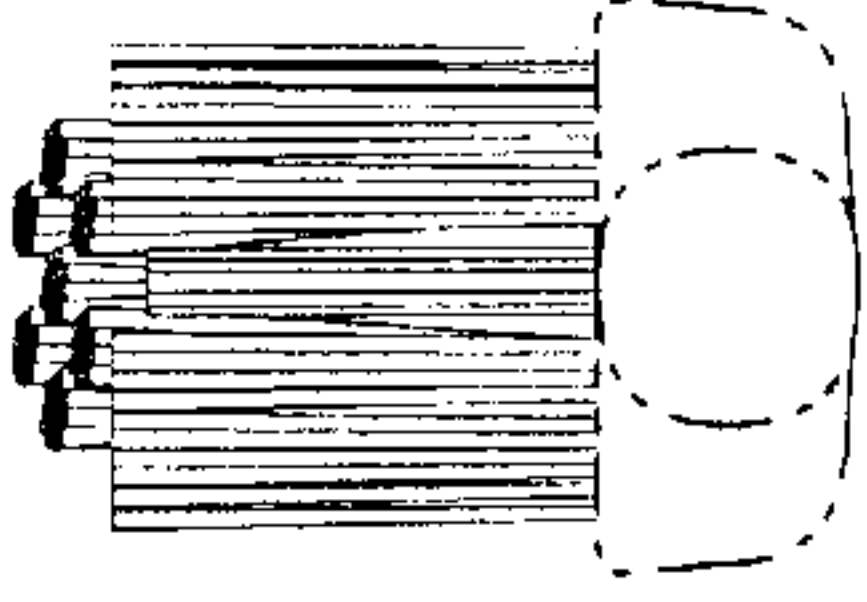

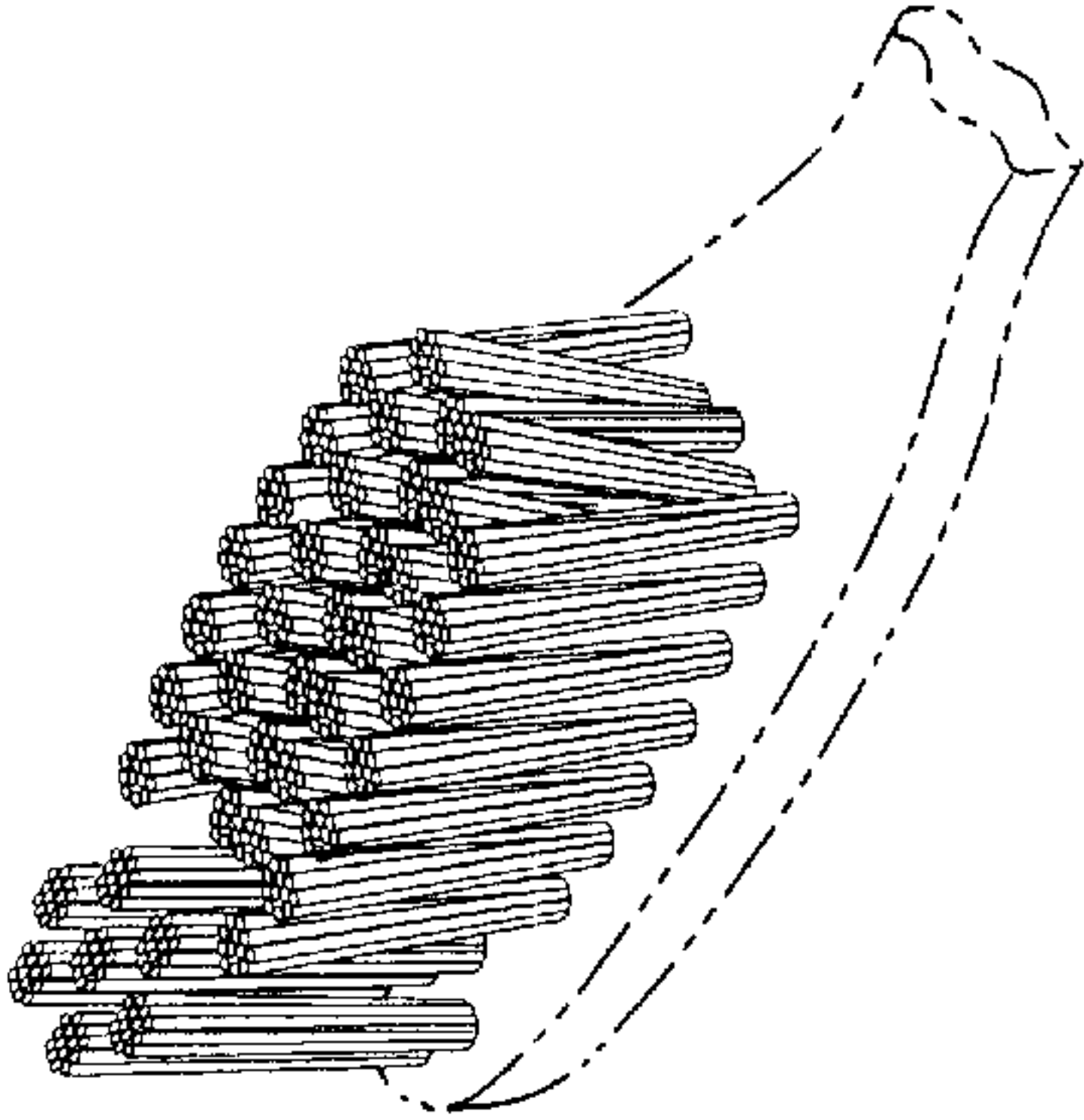

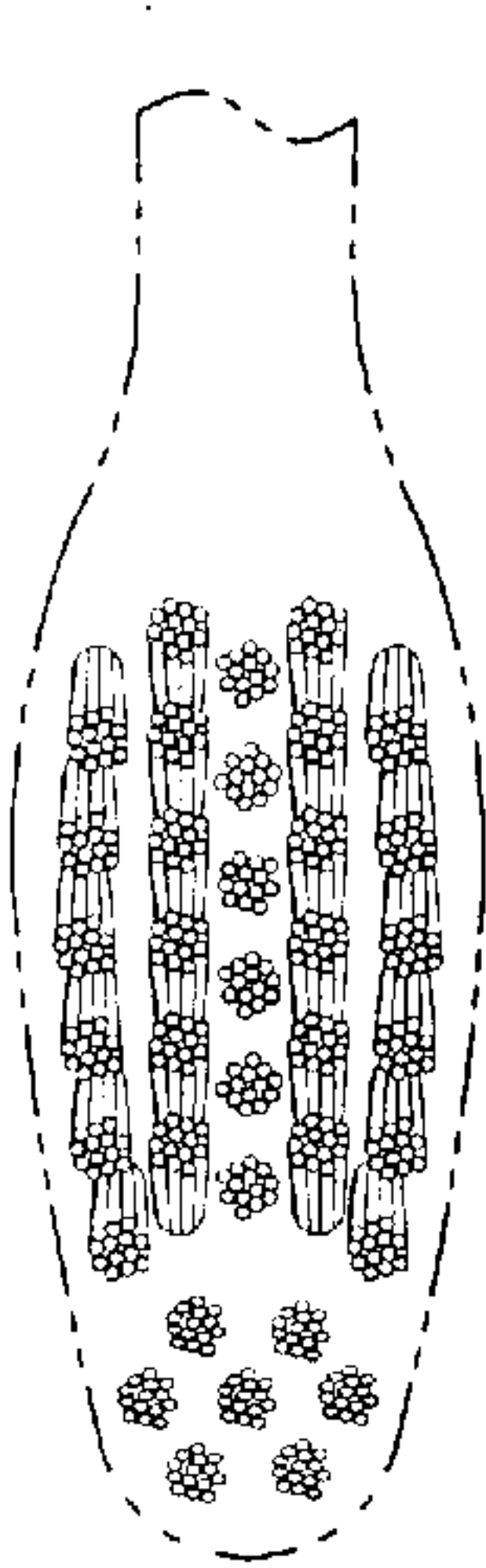

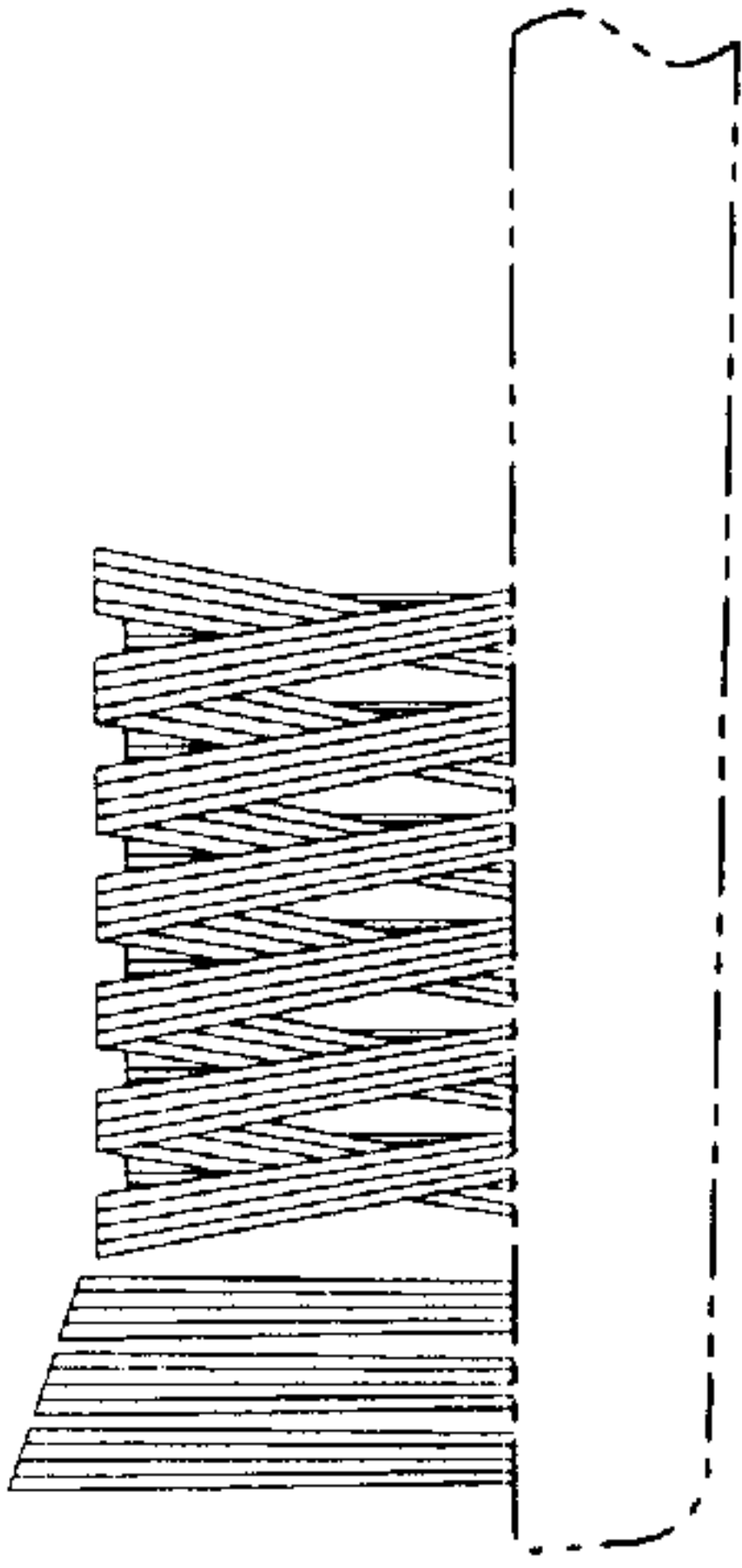

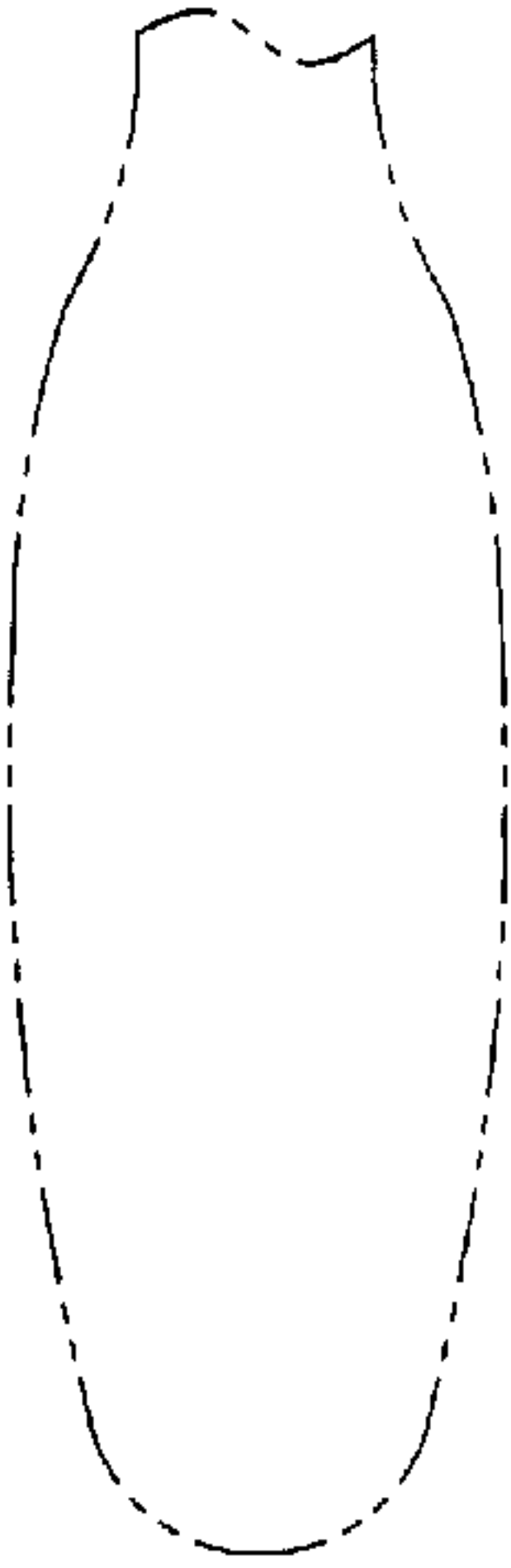

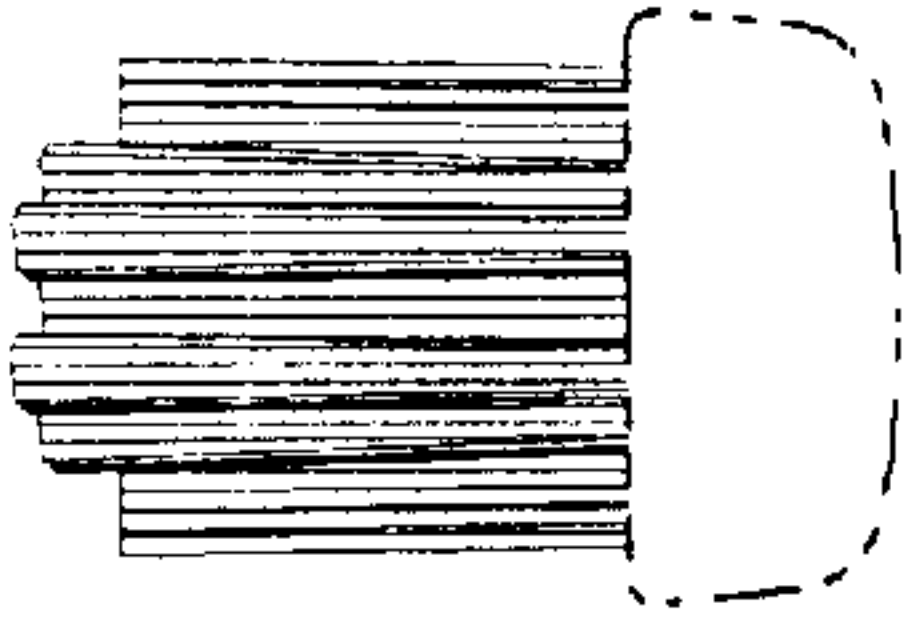

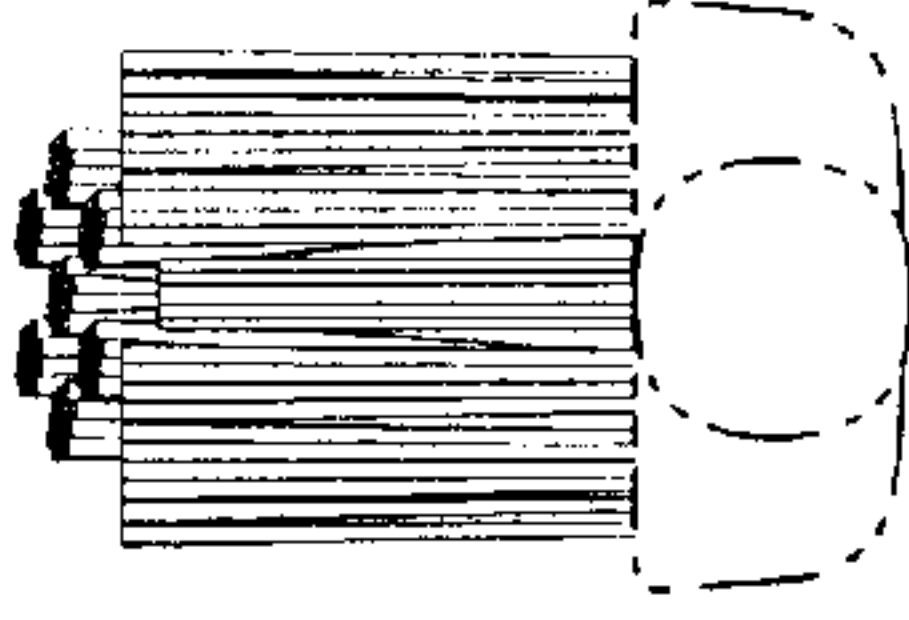

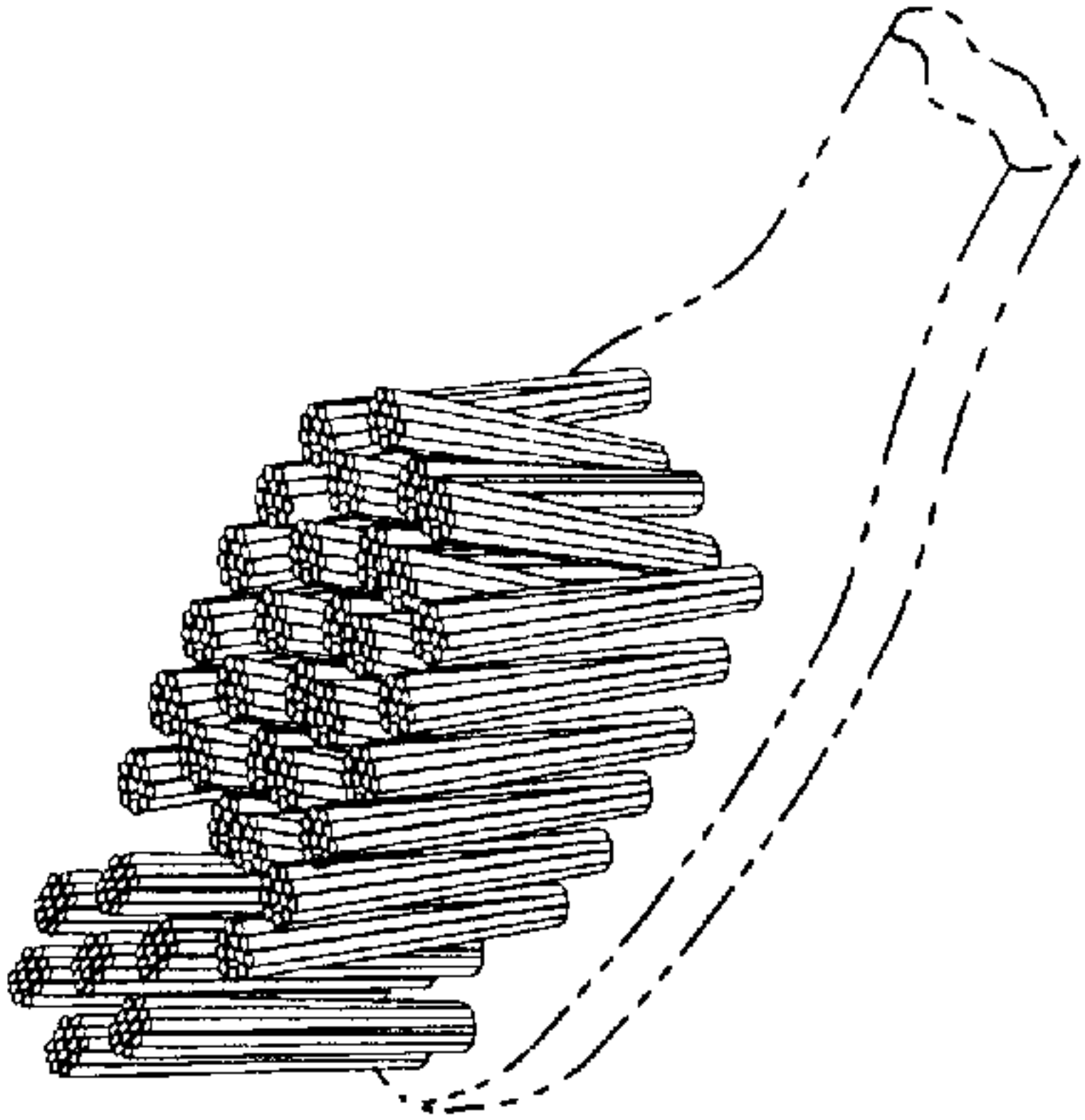
