(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chair having arms showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of our new design with the seat tilted up in a folded position;

FIG. 9 is a right side elevational view of our new design with the seat tilted up in a folded position;

FIG. 10 is a right side elevational view of our new design including an additional chair, shown in phantom, to illustrate a nesting position;

FIG. 11 is a perspective view of an alternate embodiment of a chair without arms showing our new design;

FIG. 12 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 13 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 14 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 15 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 16 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 17 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 18 is a perspective view of the alternate embodiment with the seat tilted up in a folded position;

FIG. 19 is a right side elevational view of the alternate embodiment with the seat tilted up in a folded position; and,

FIG. 20 is a right side elevational view of the alternate embodiment including an additional chair, shown in phantom, to illustrate a nesting position.

The phantom lines depicted in FIGS. 10 and 20 are to illustrate the environment in which the chair may be used. The phantom lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the design.

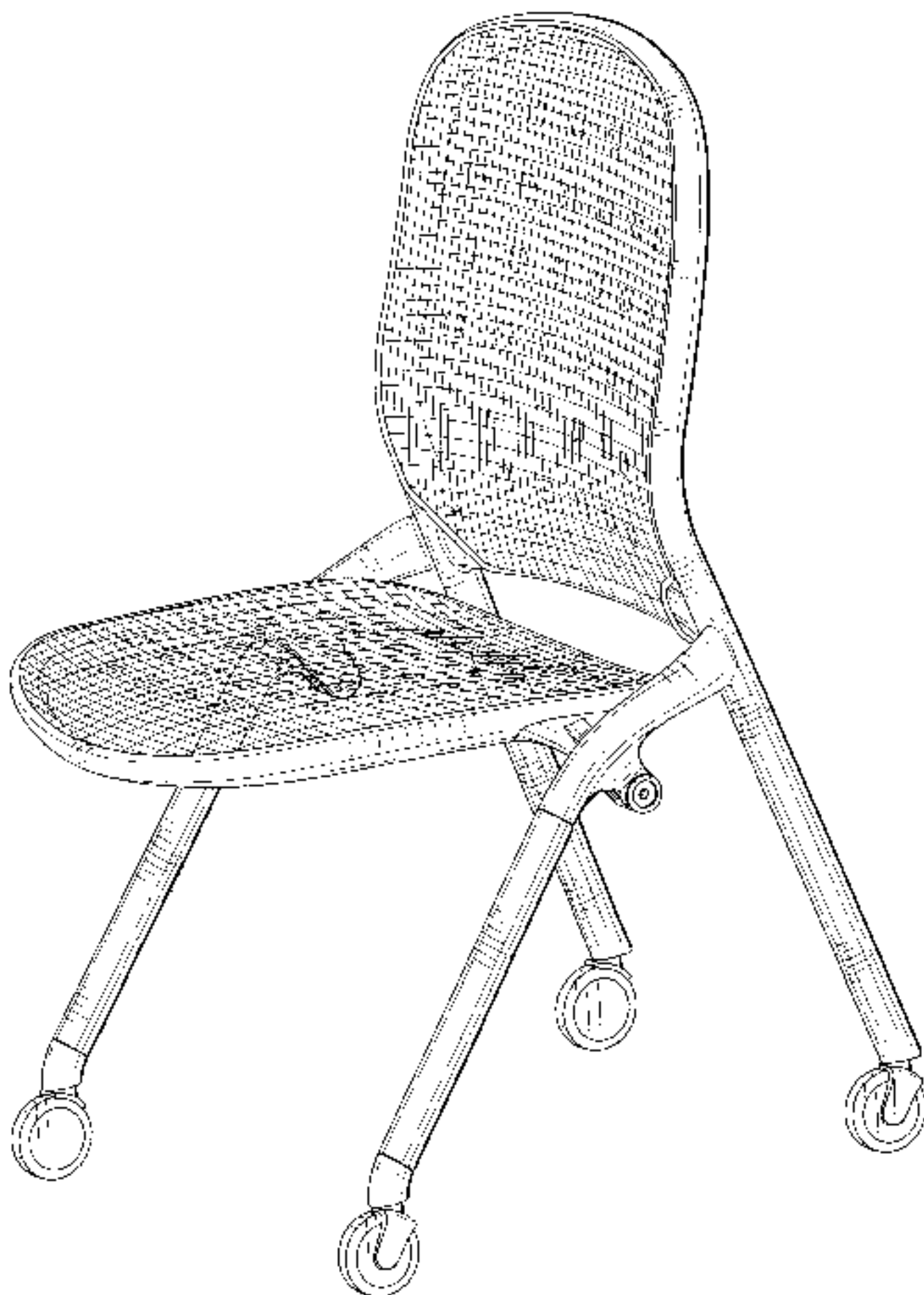
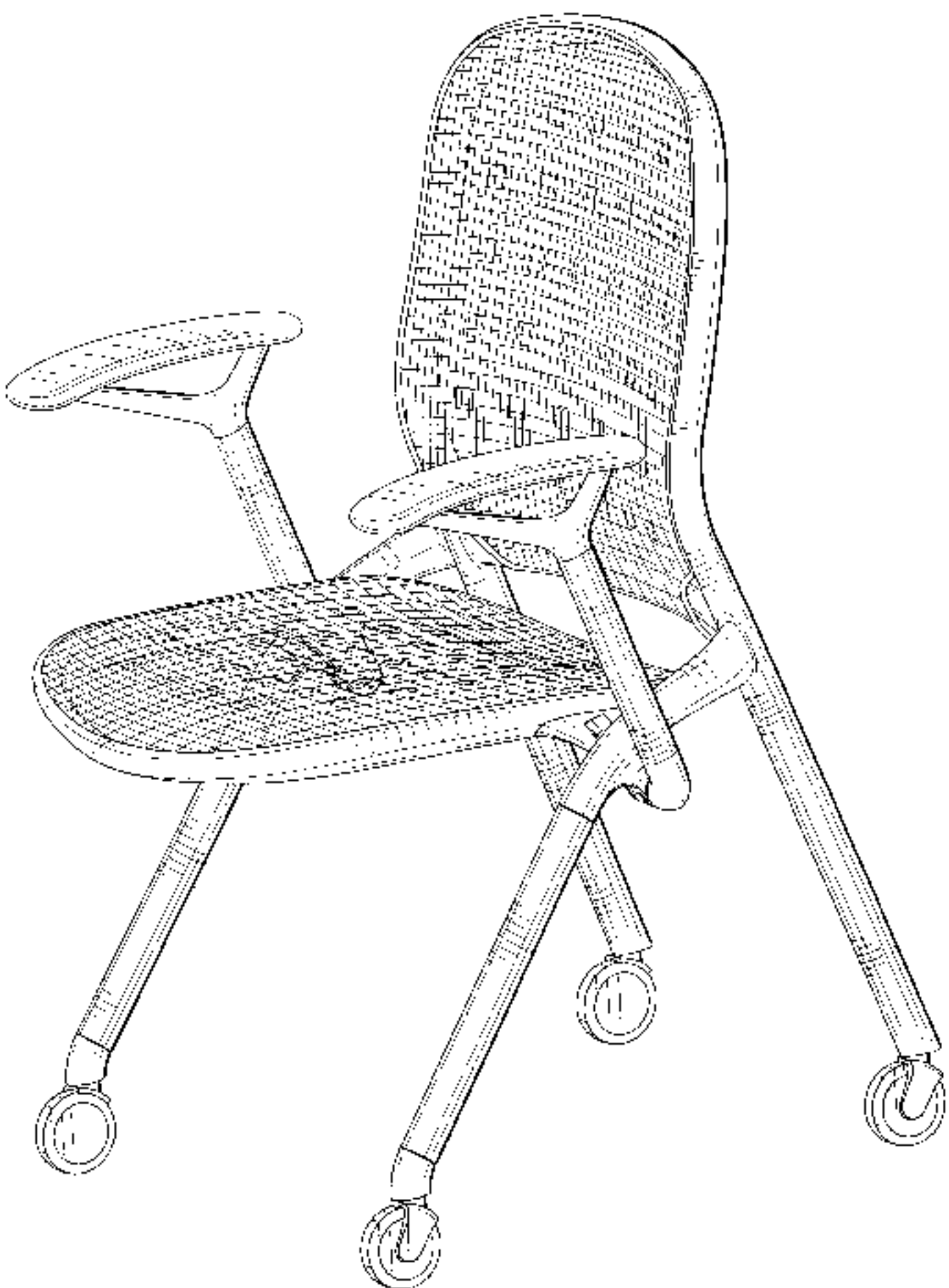

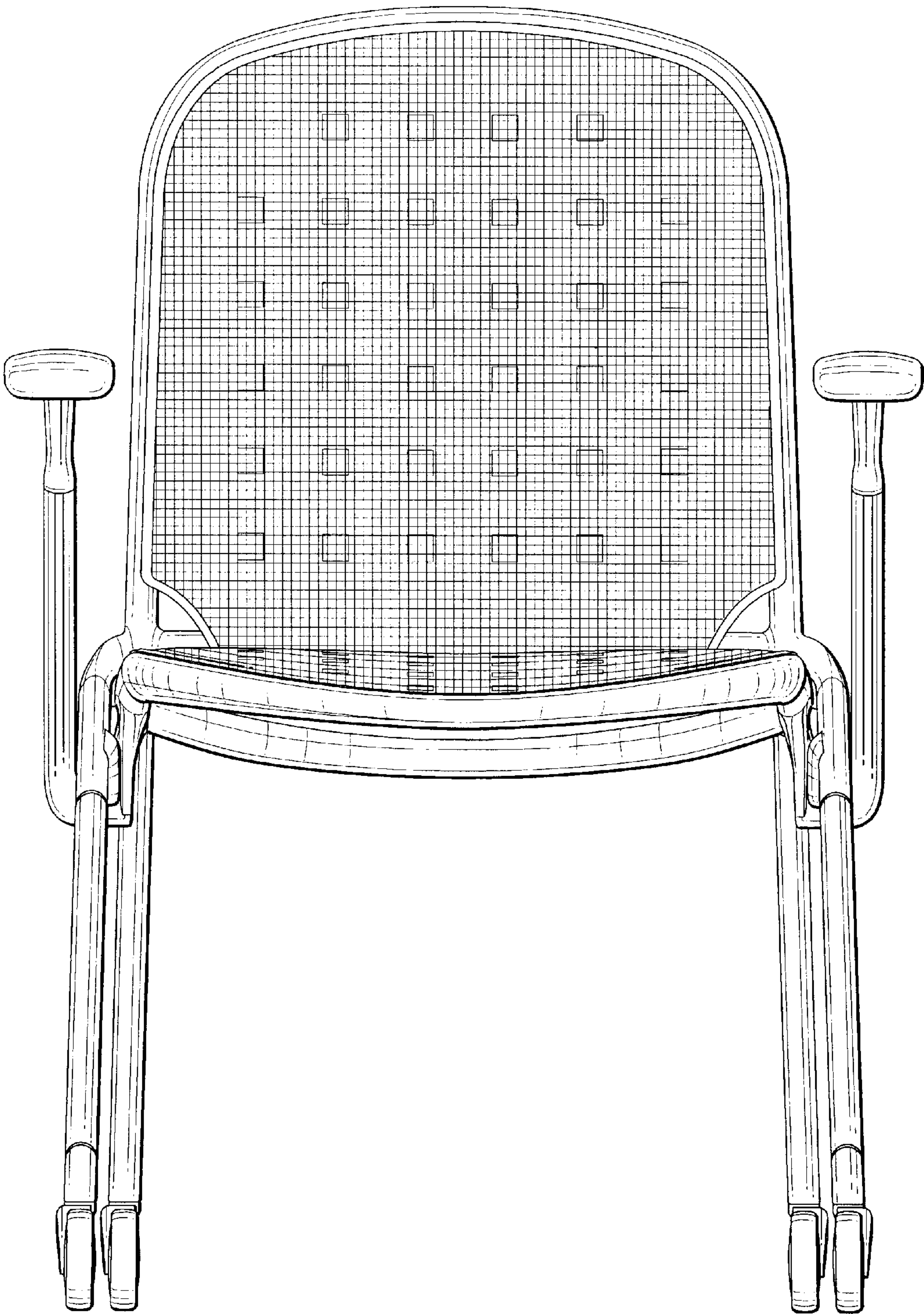

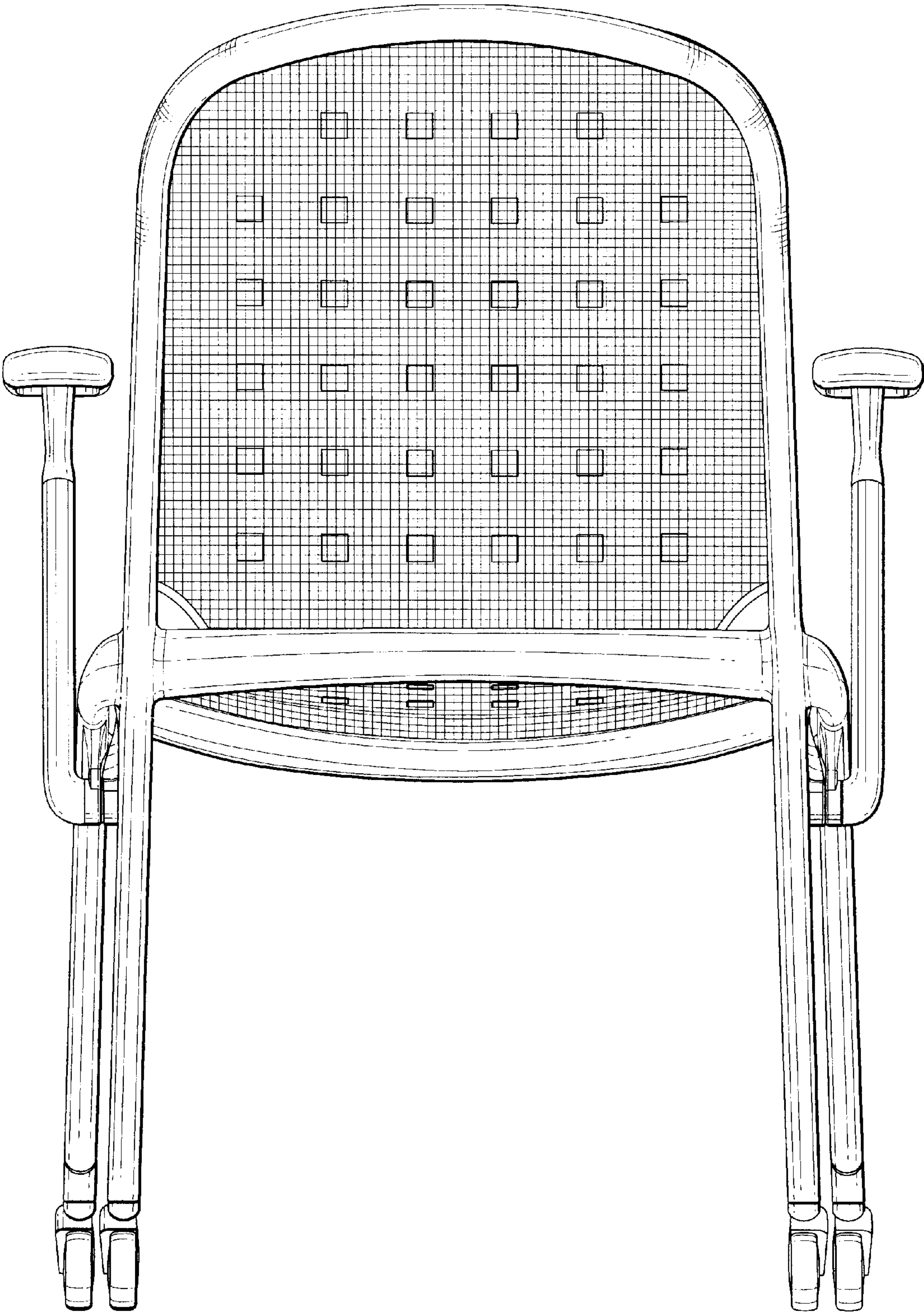

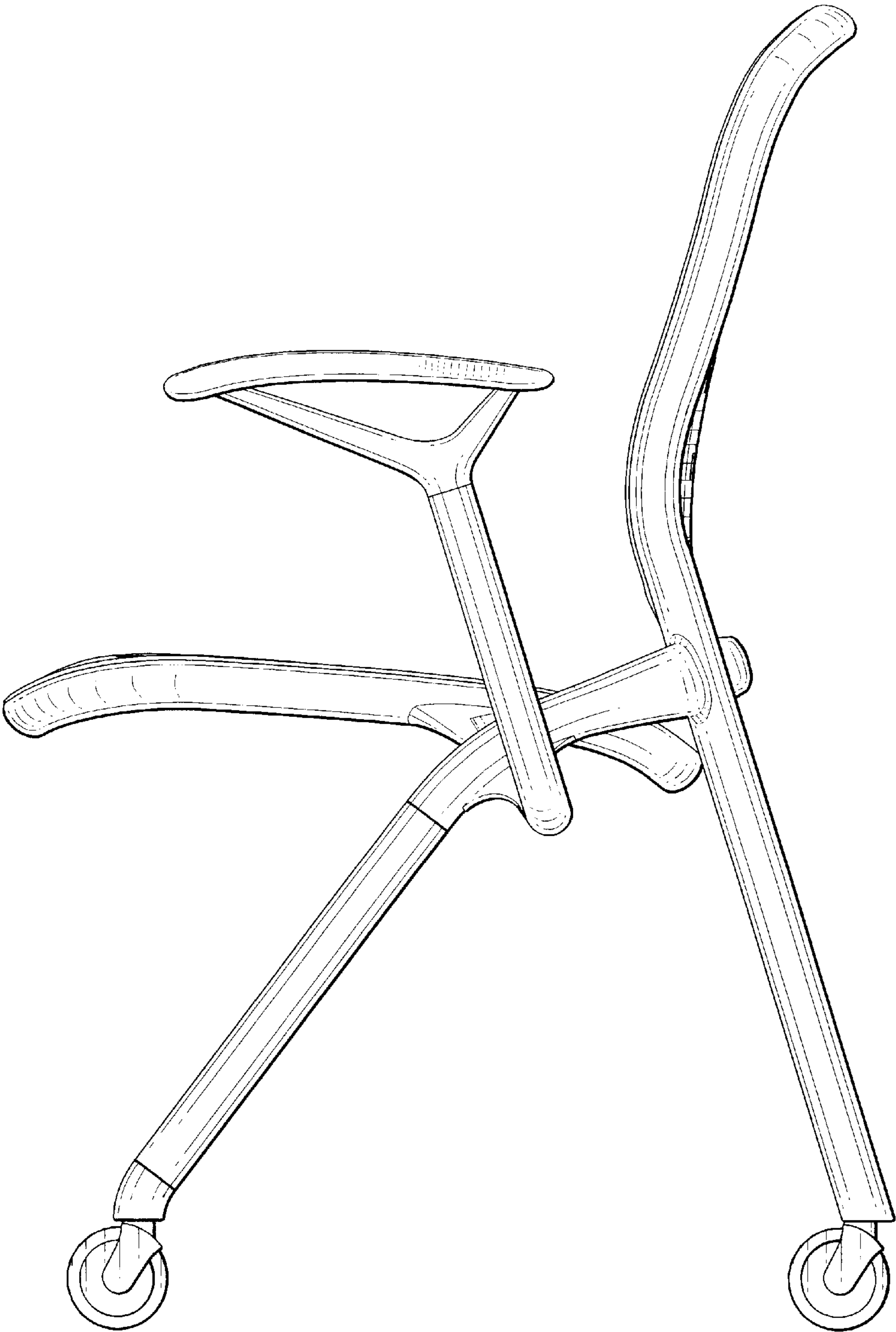

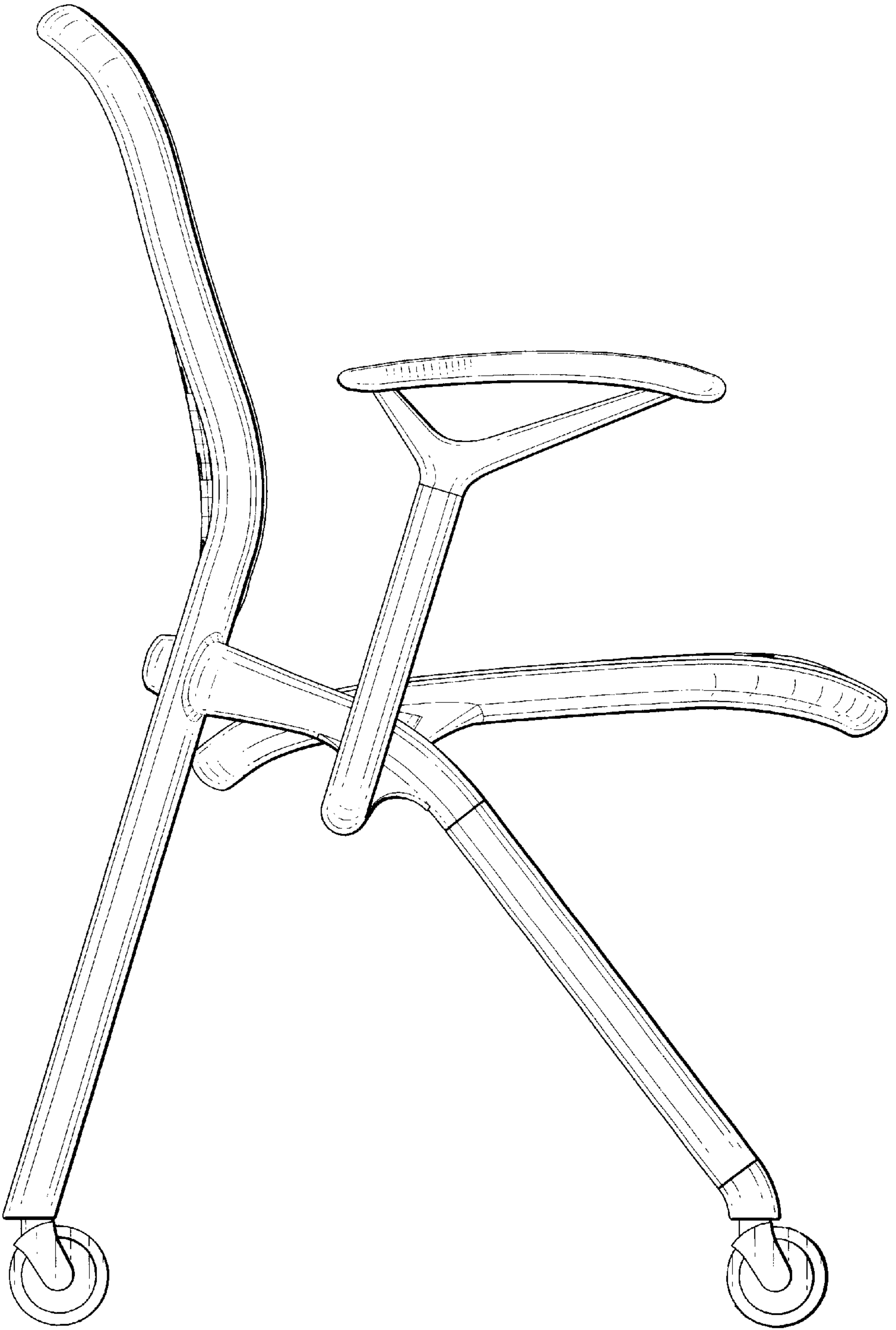

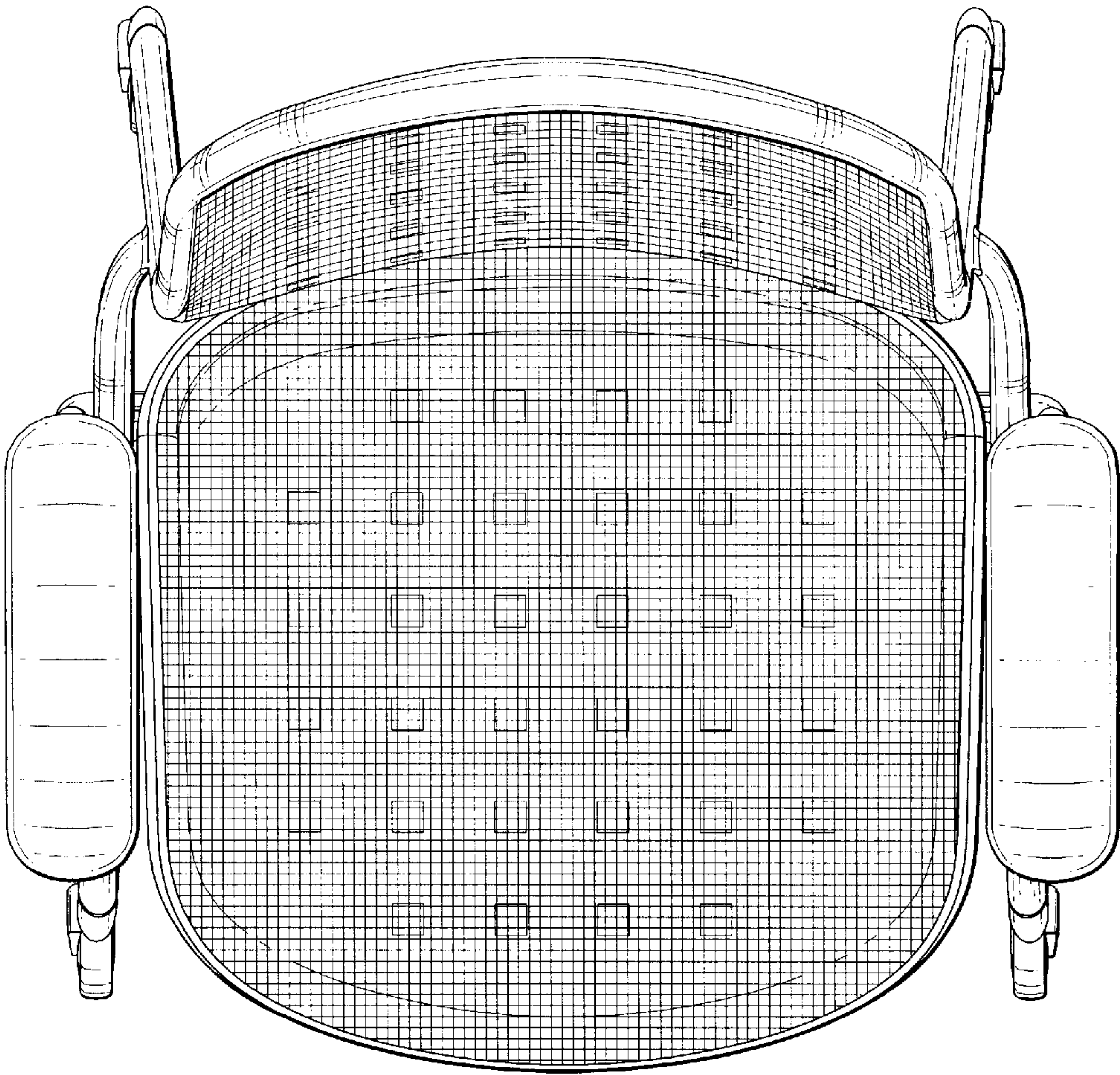

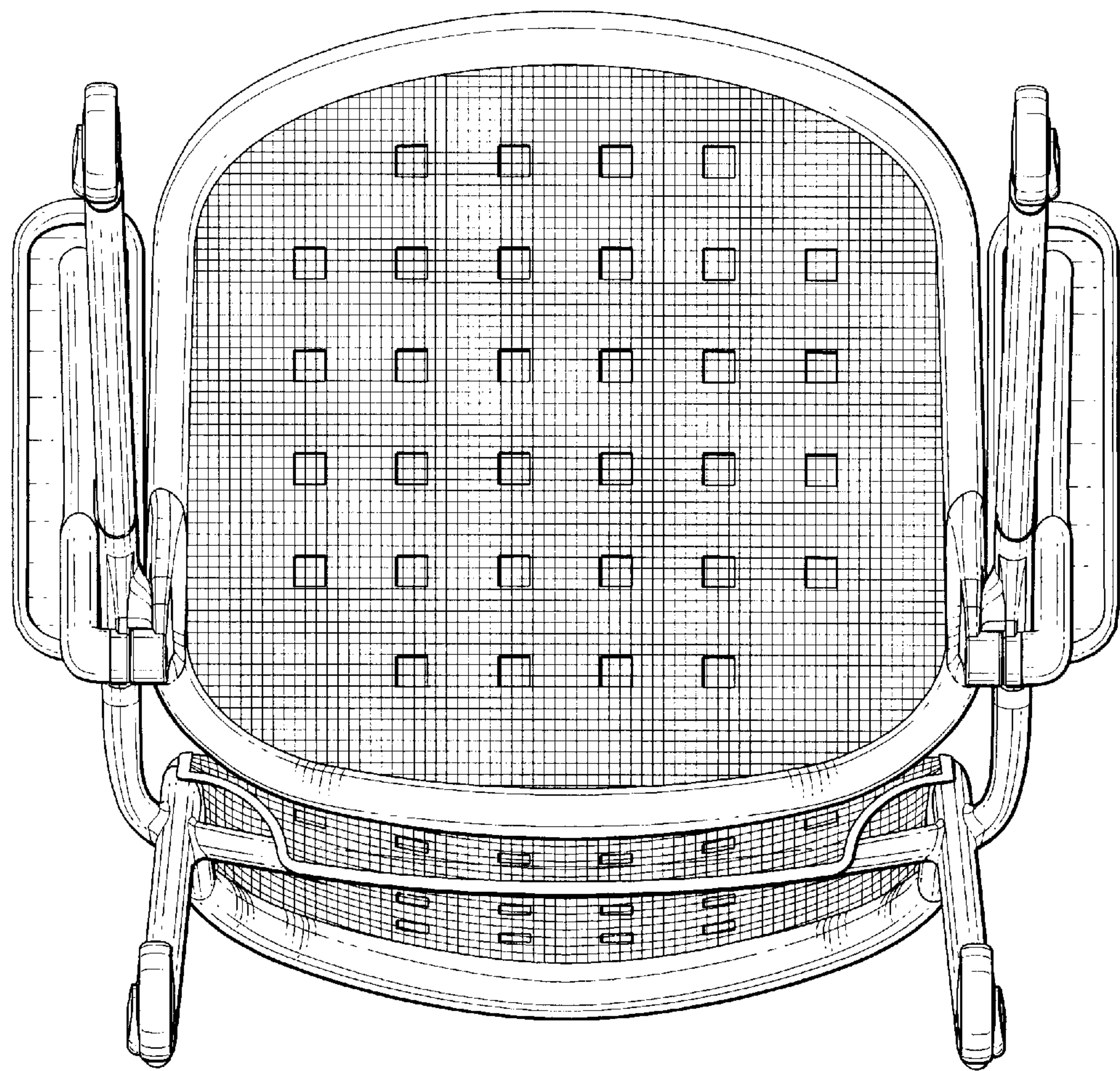

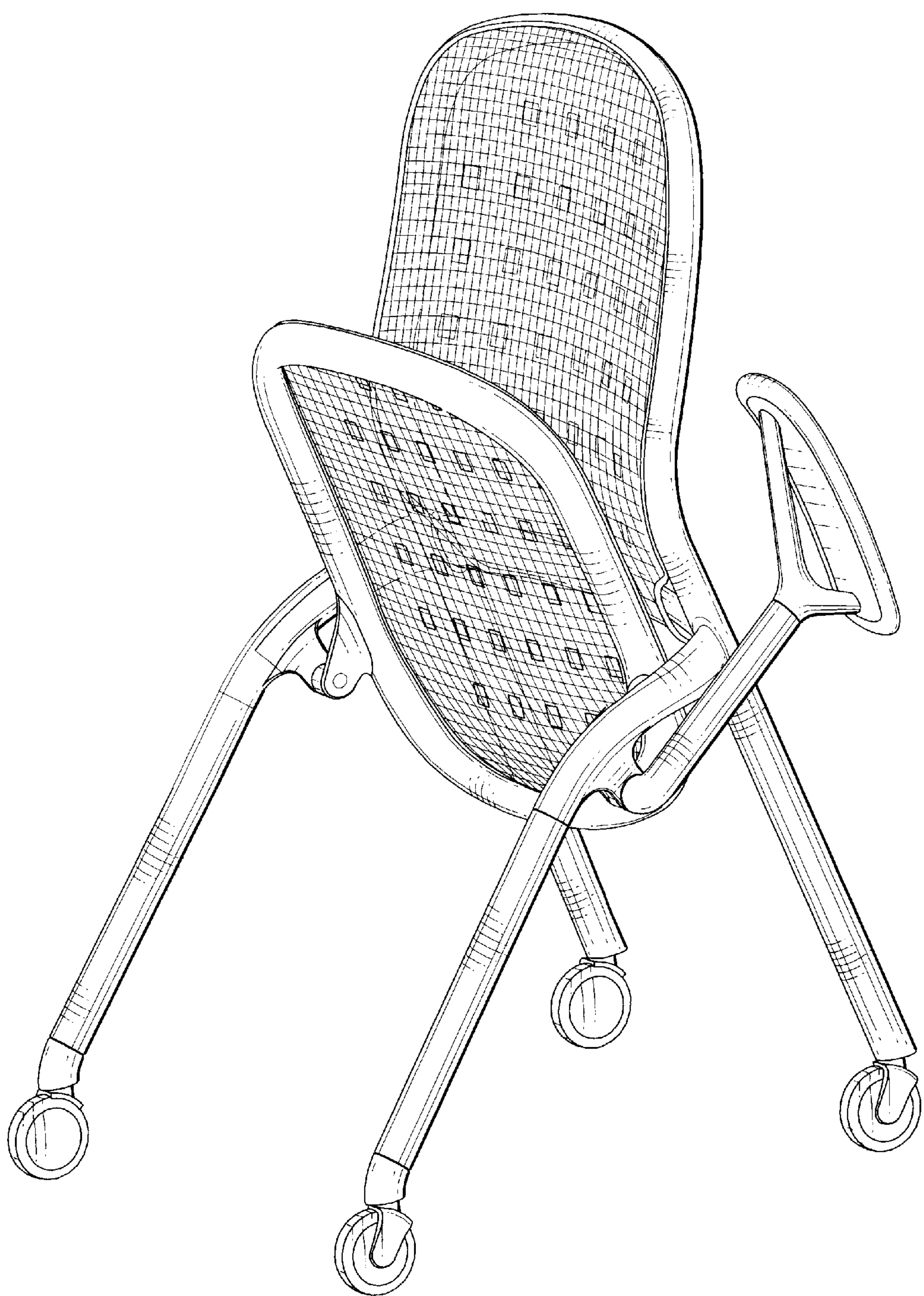

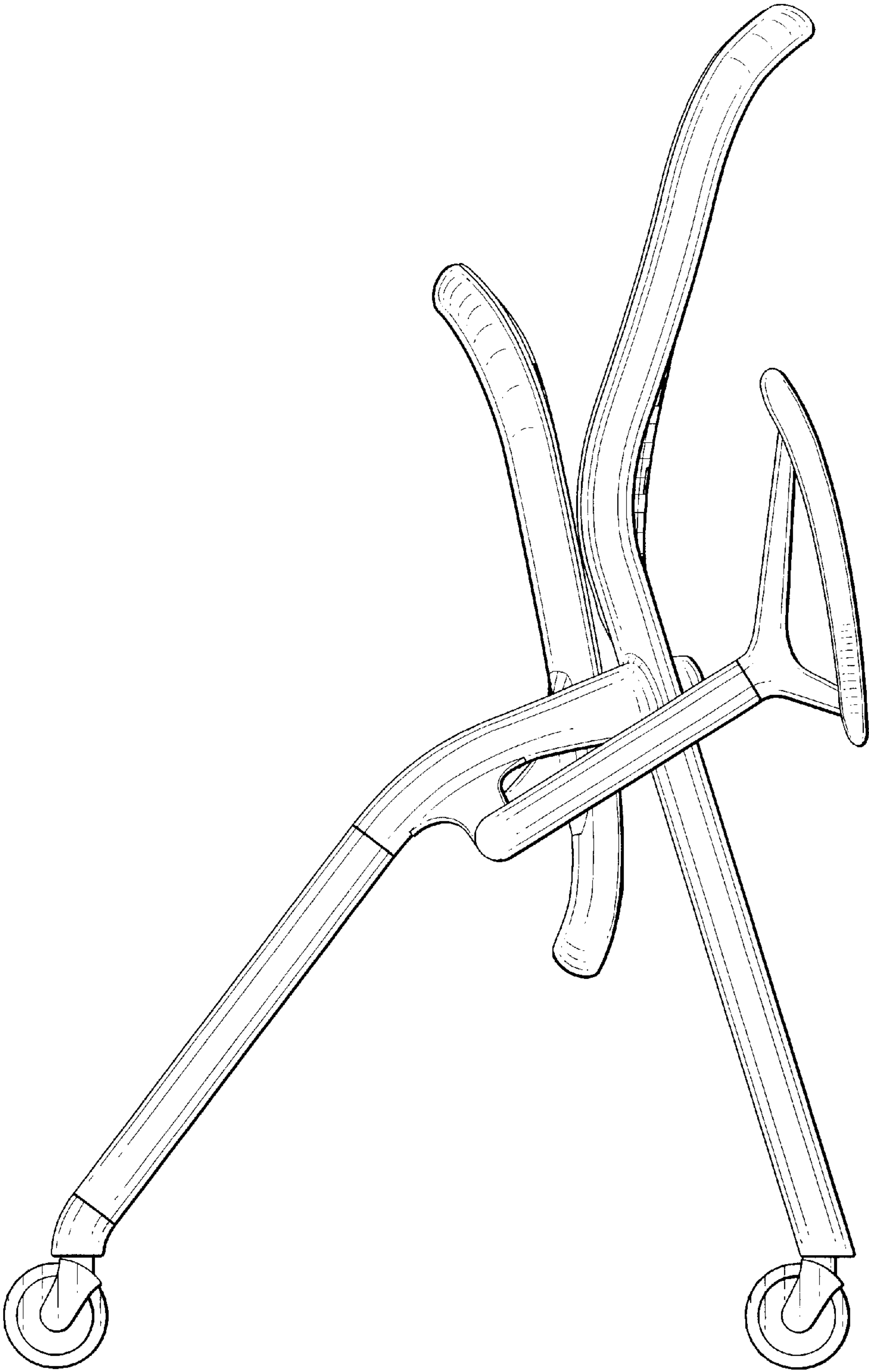

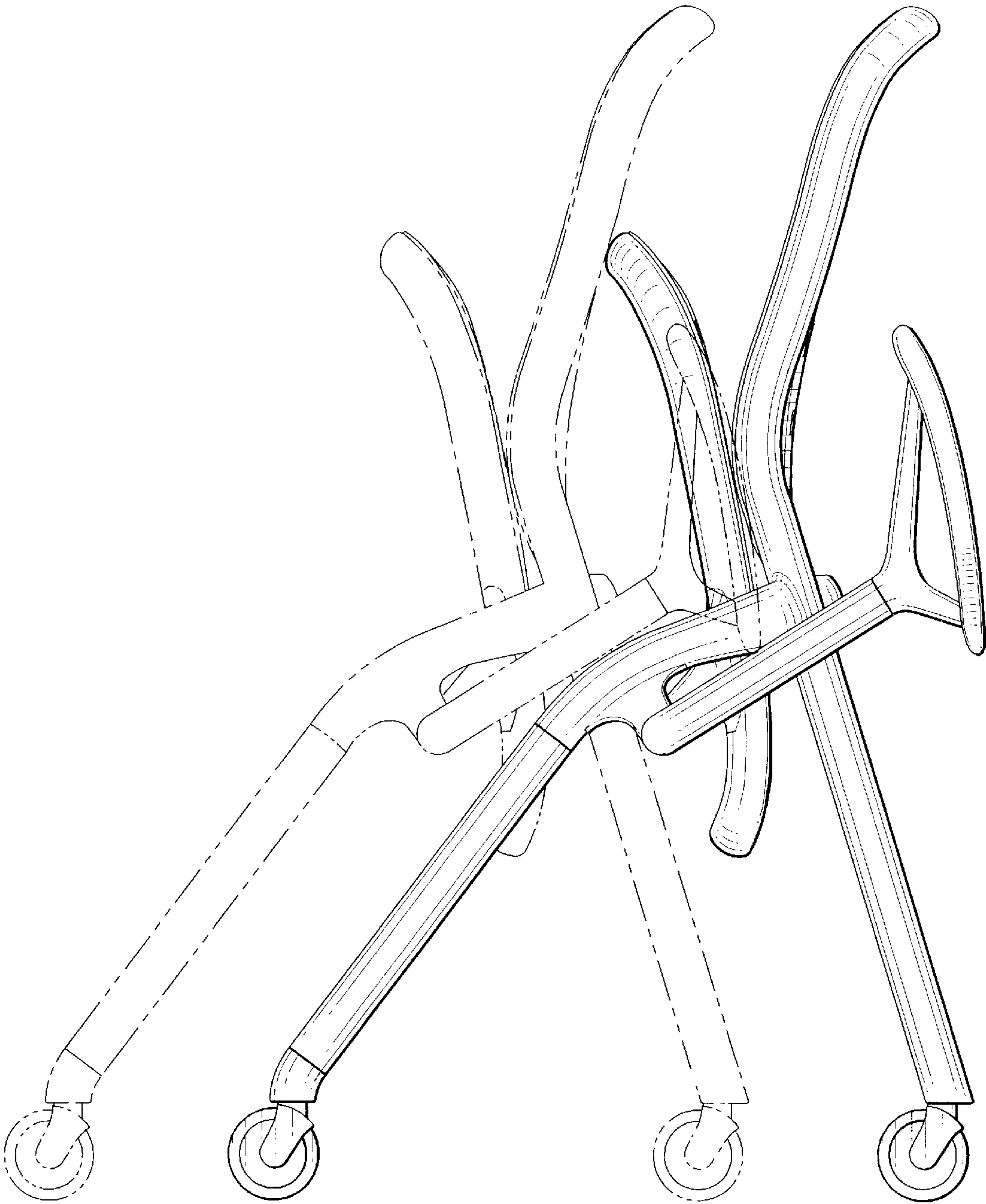

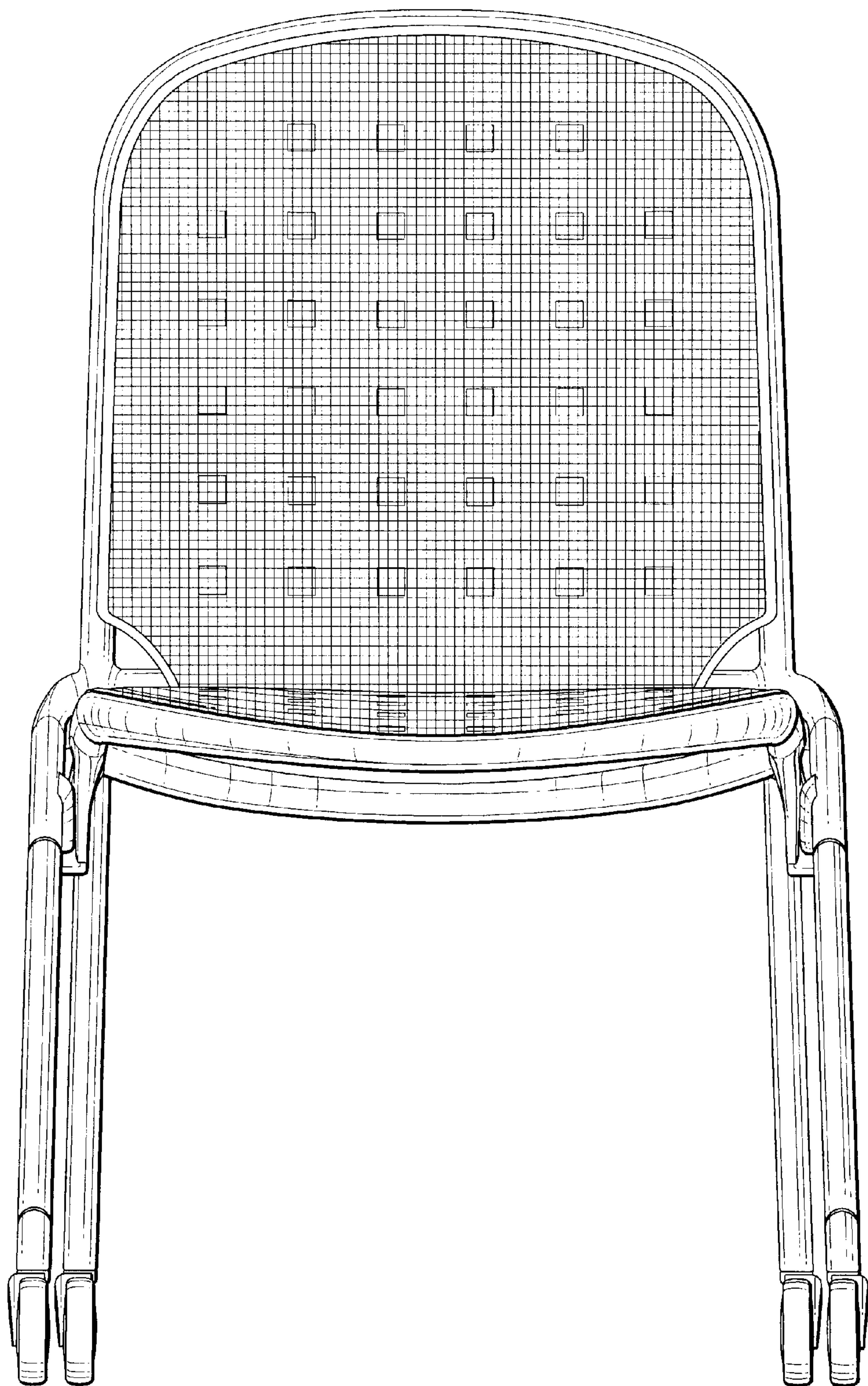

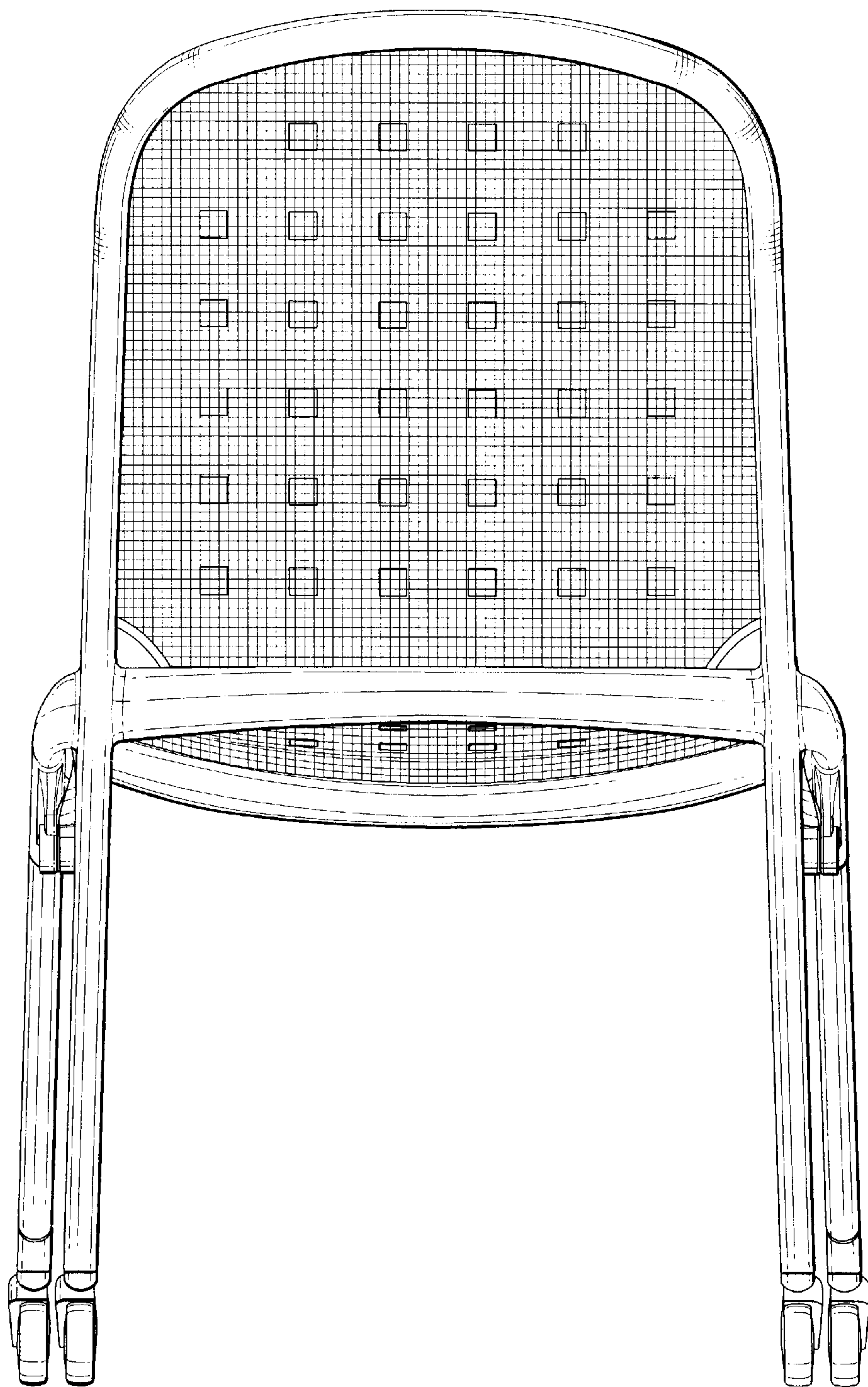

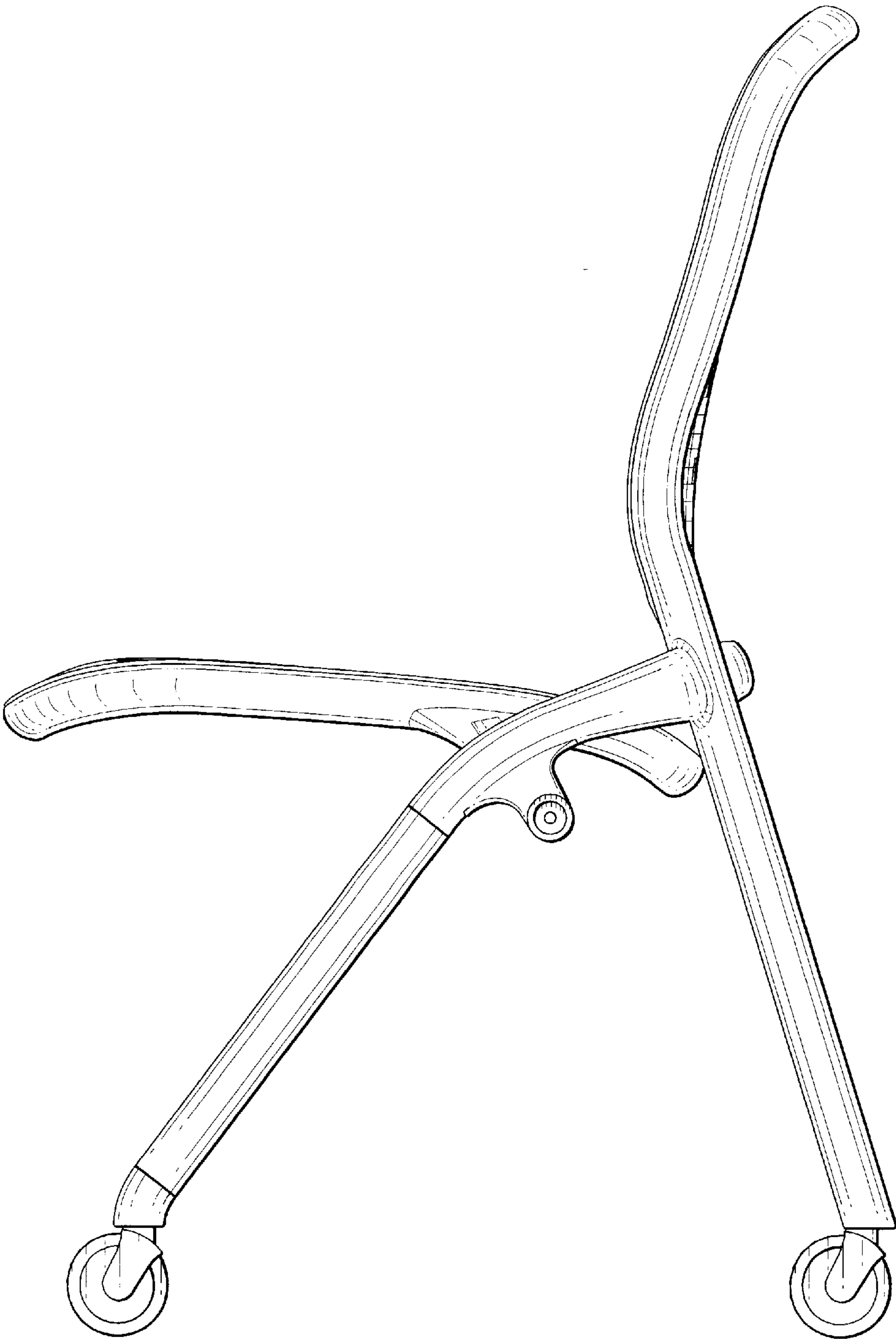

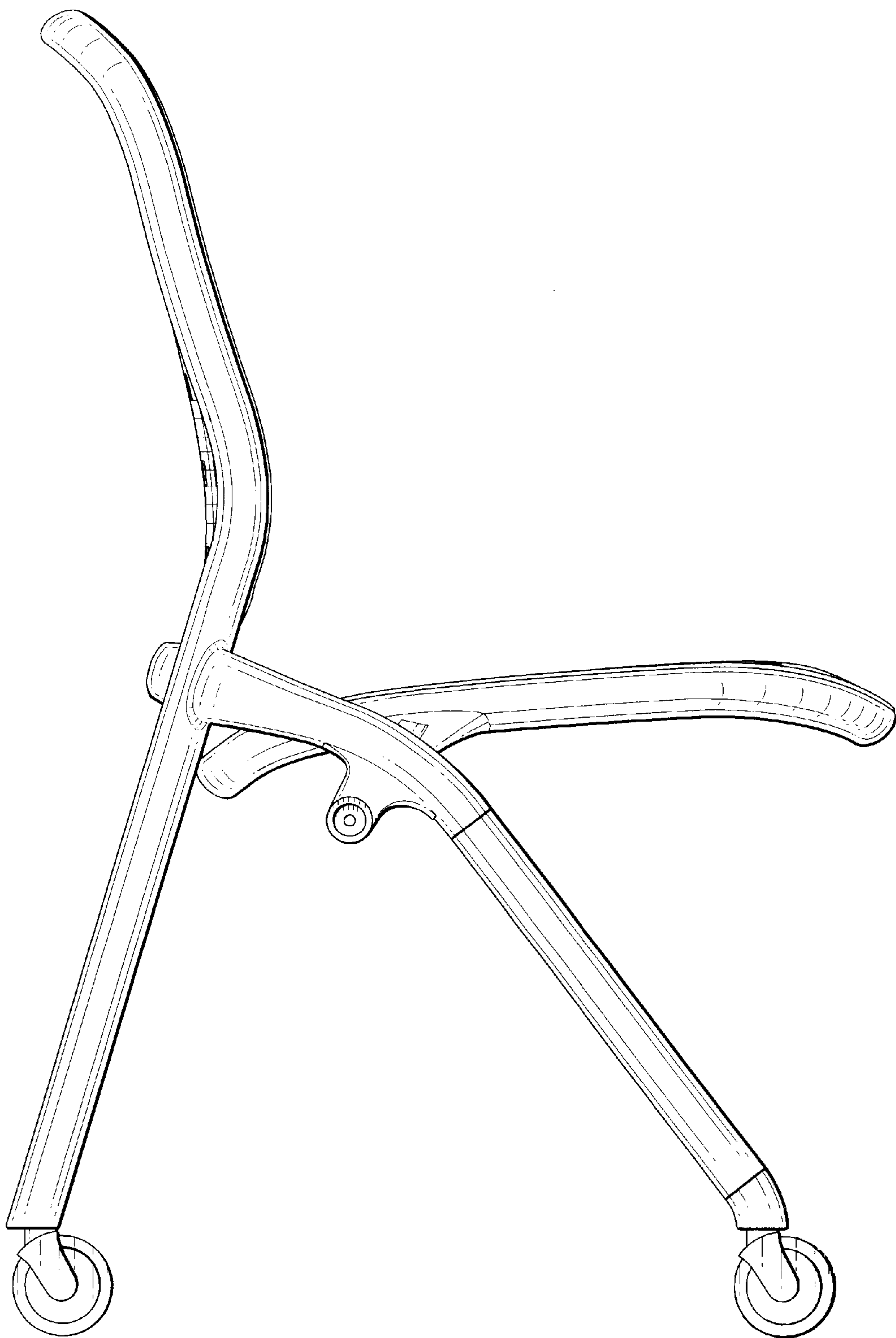

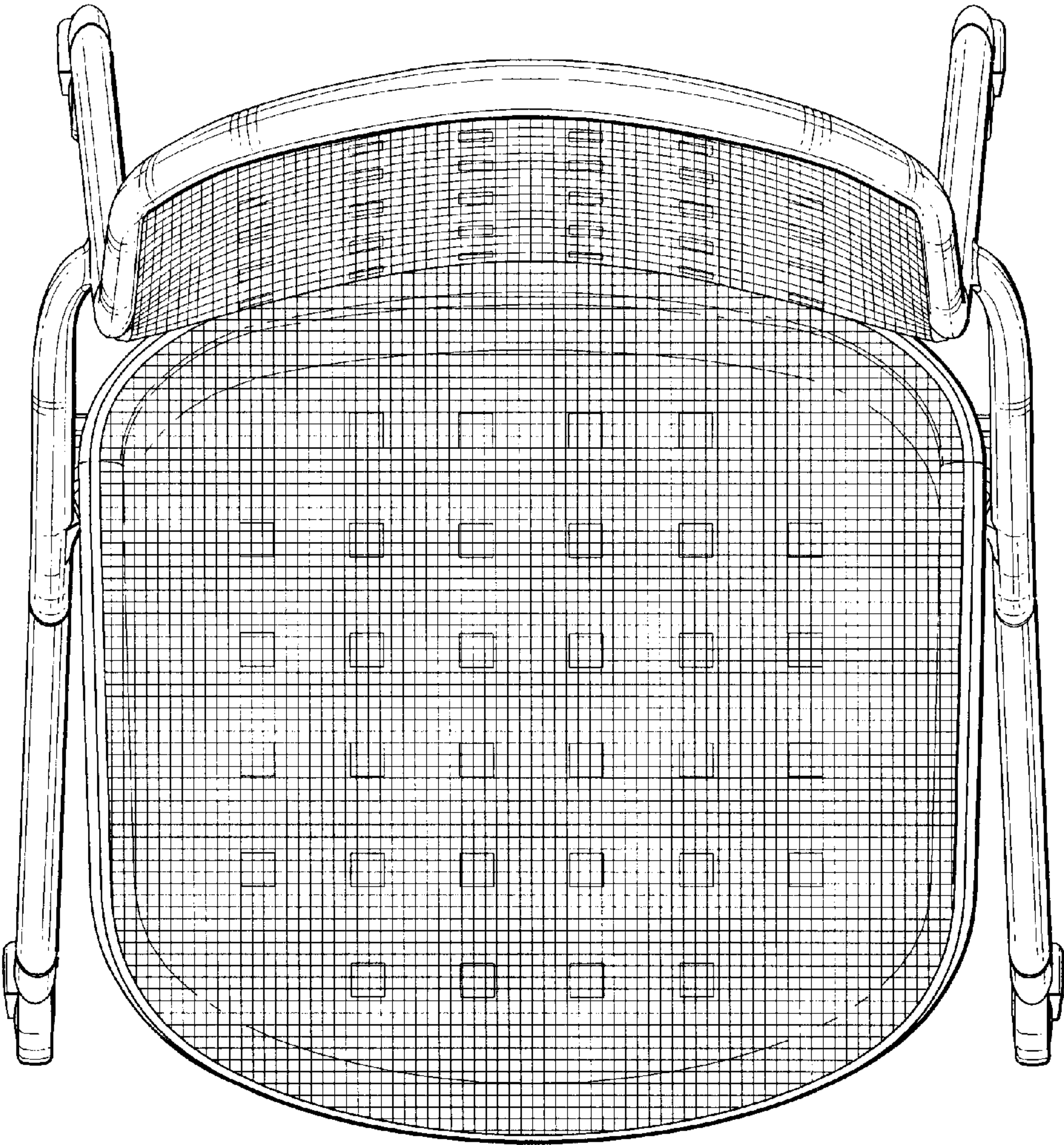

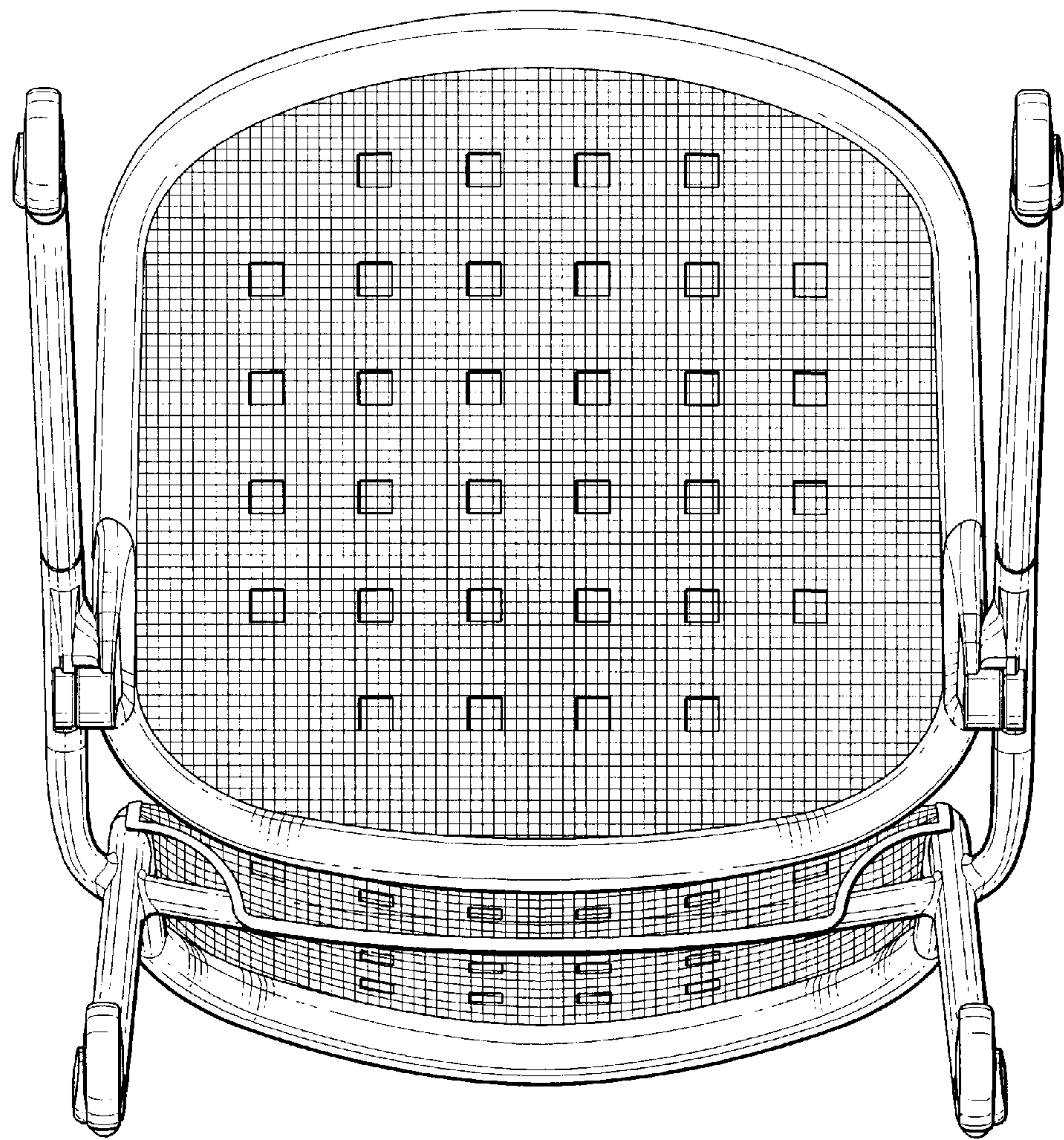

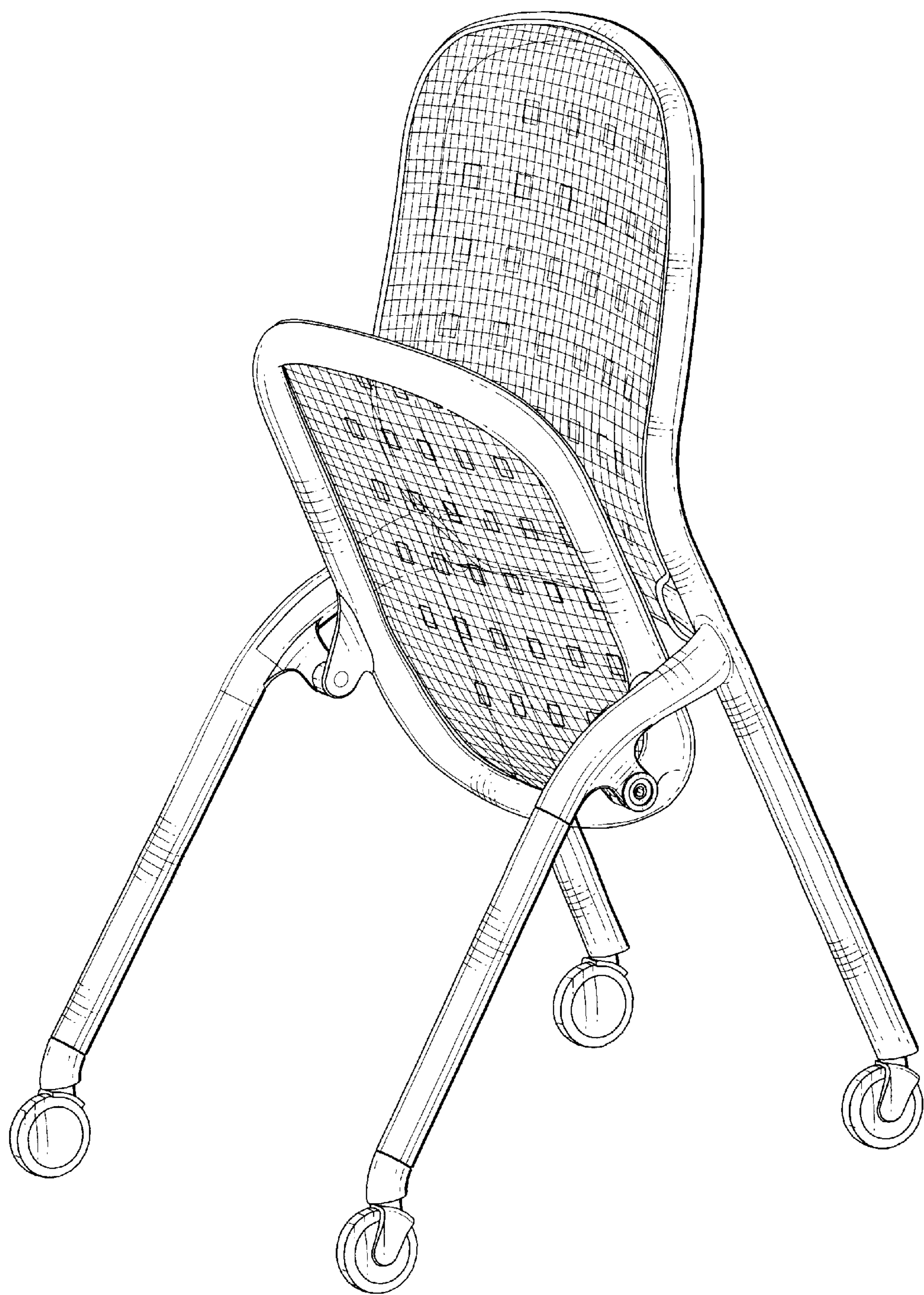

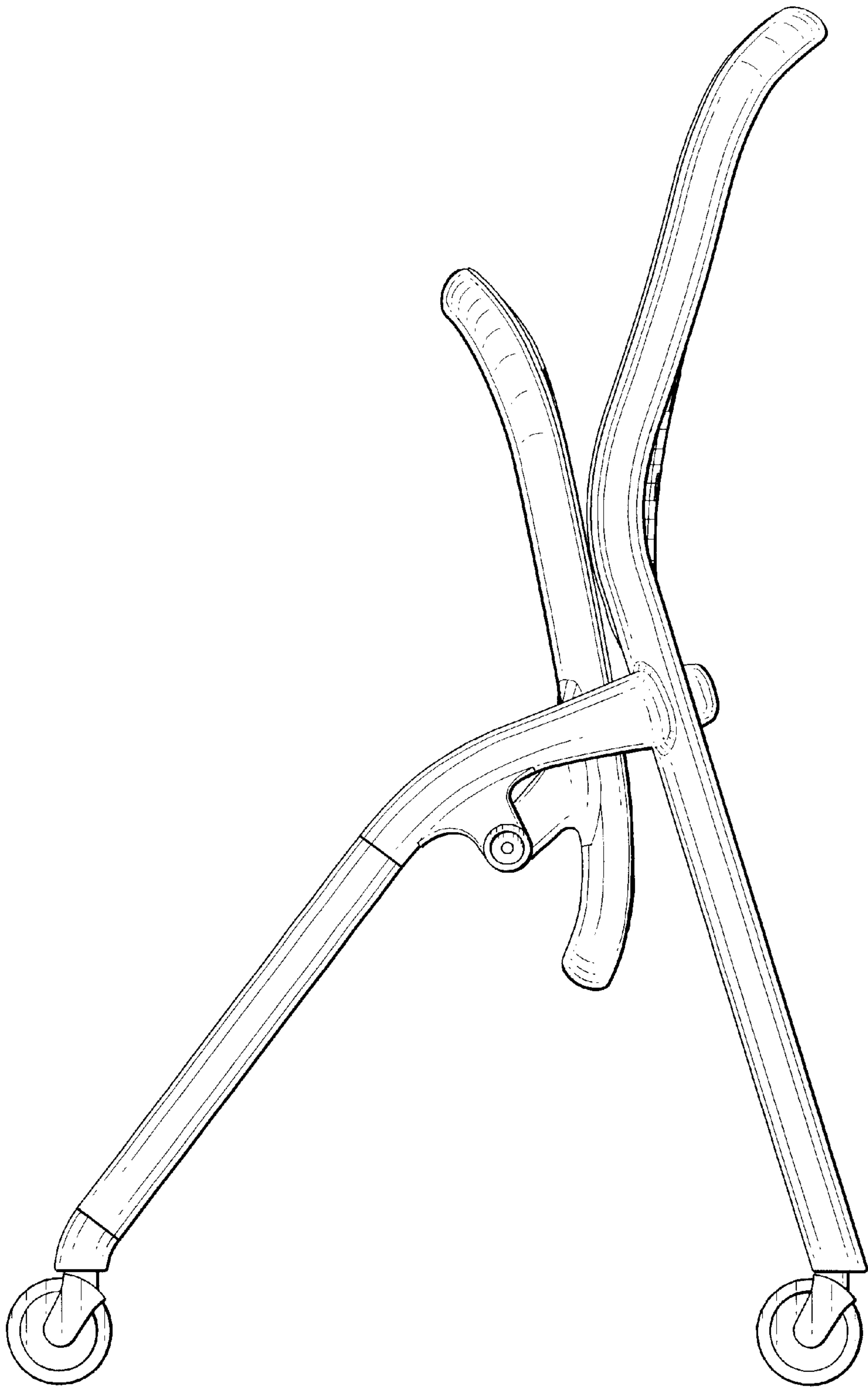

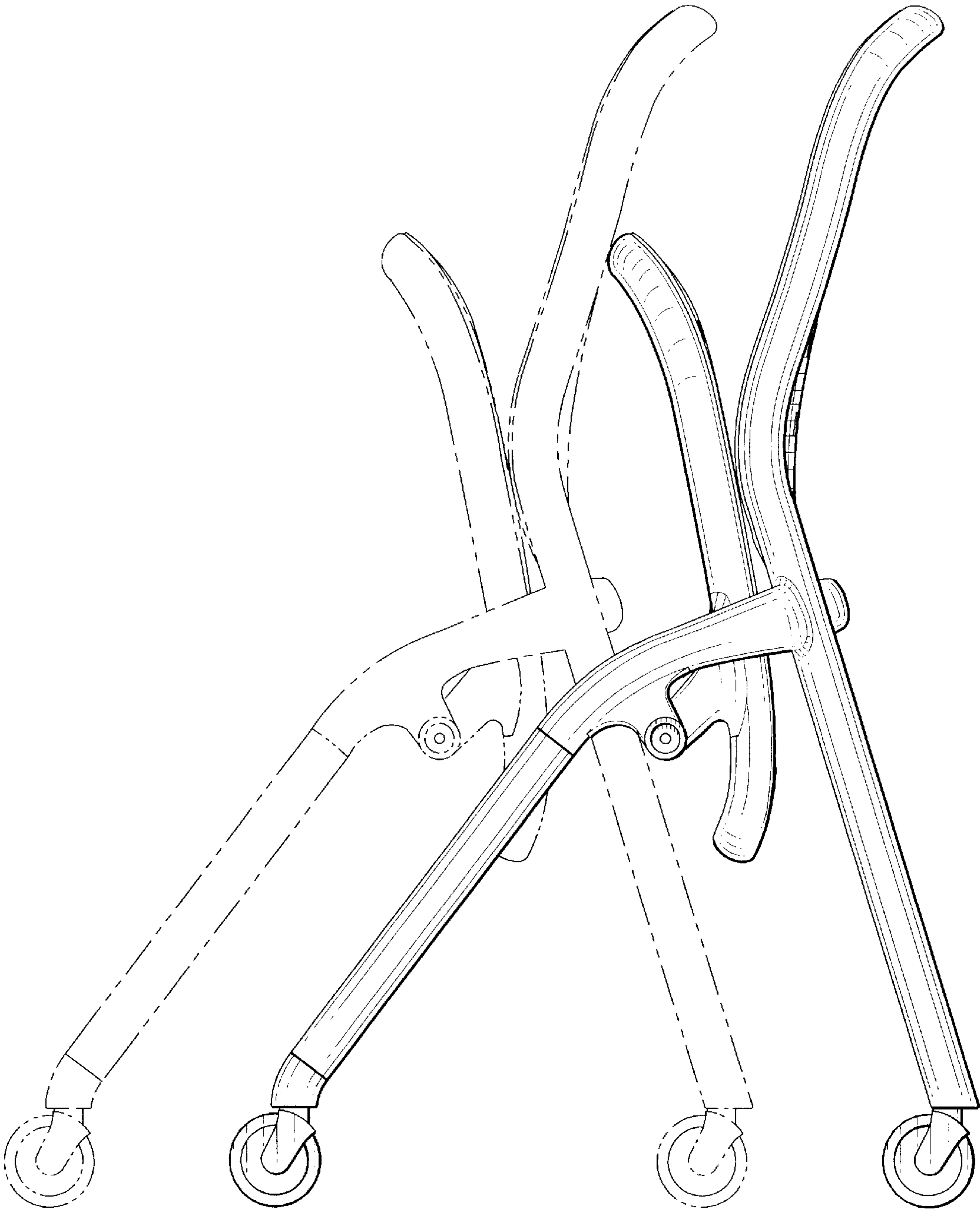
