**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a side view of the shoe shine handle according to the present invention, where the opposite side view is a mirror image thereof.

FIG. 2 is a top view thereof;

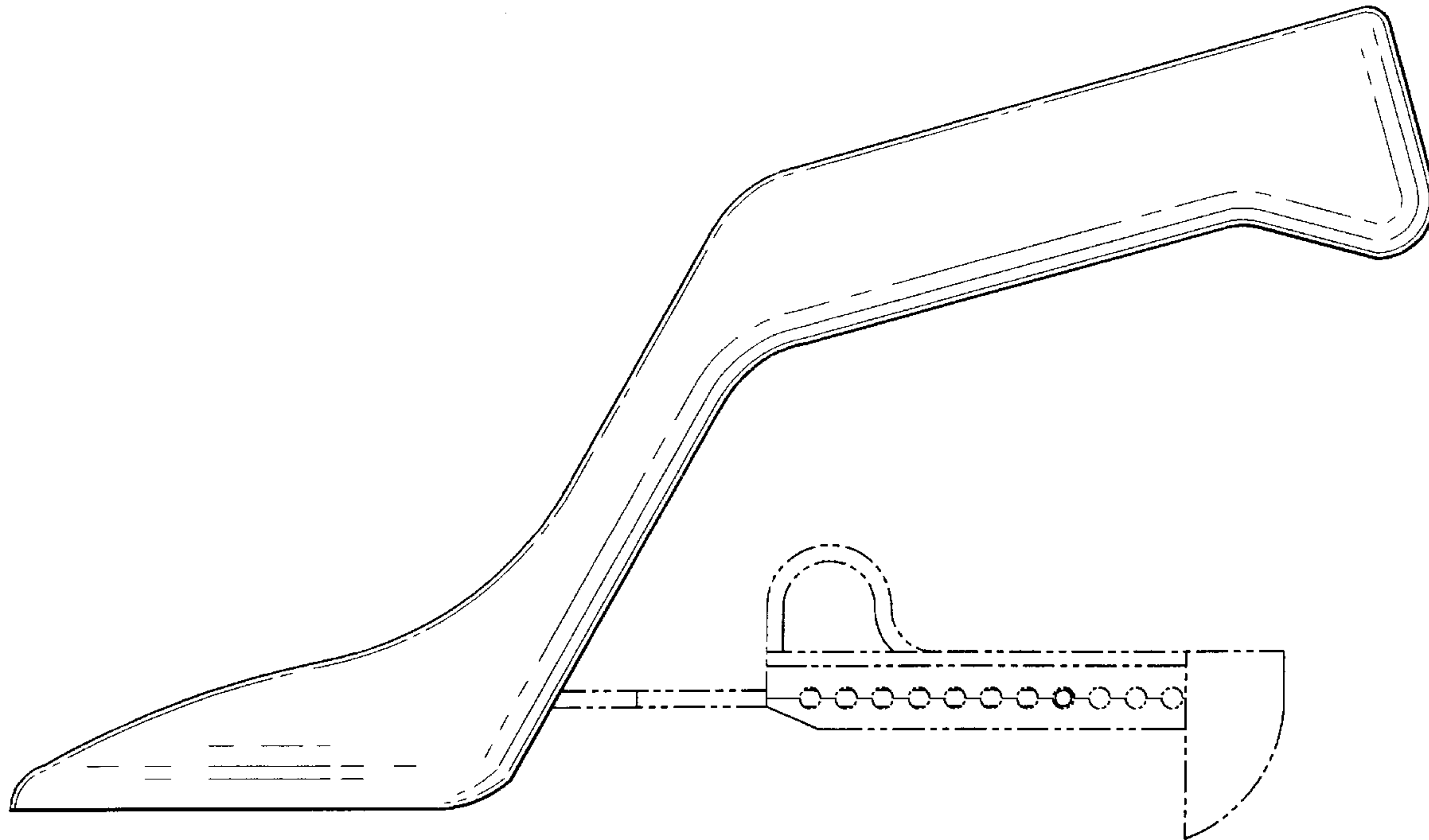
FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;

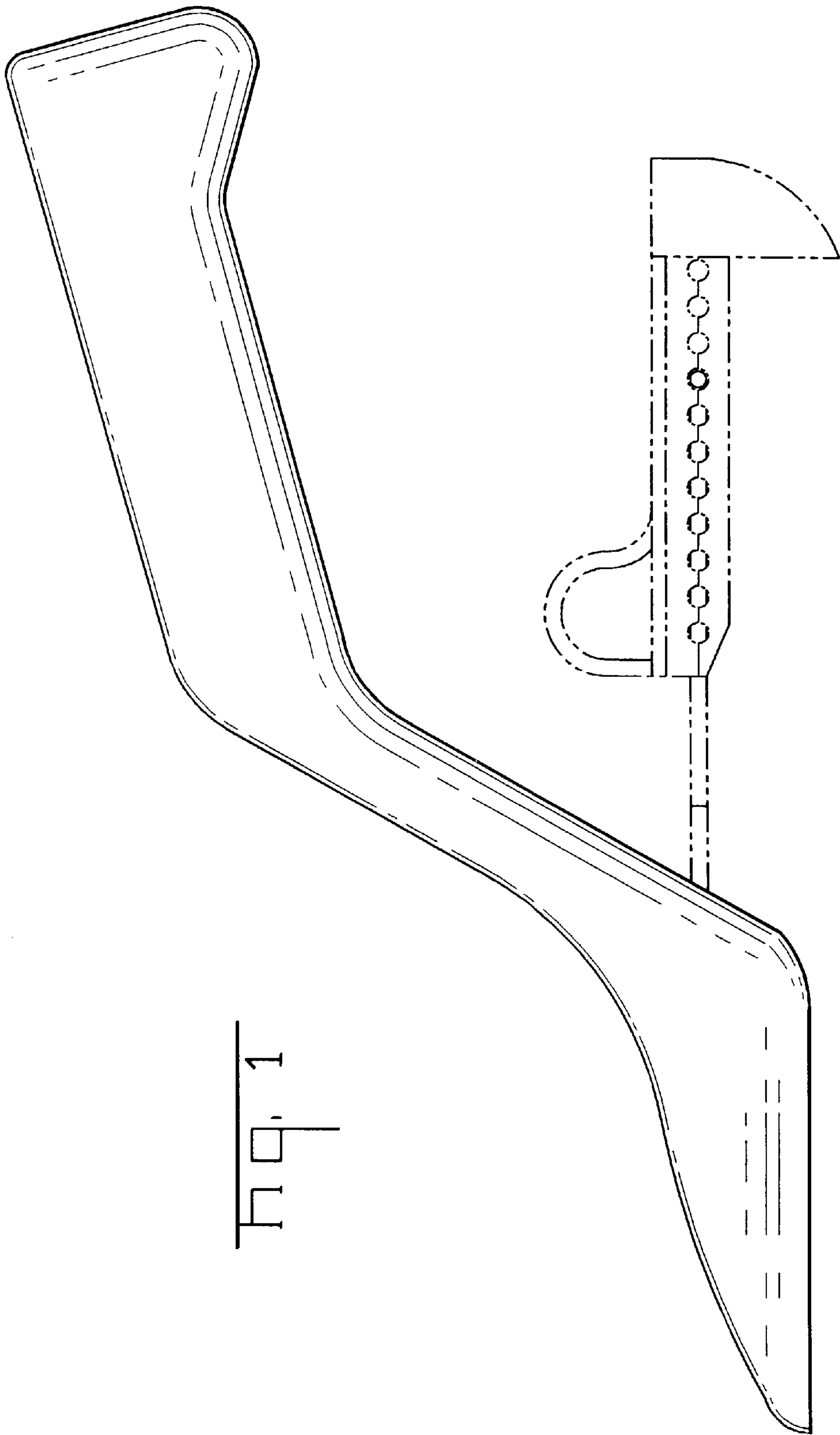
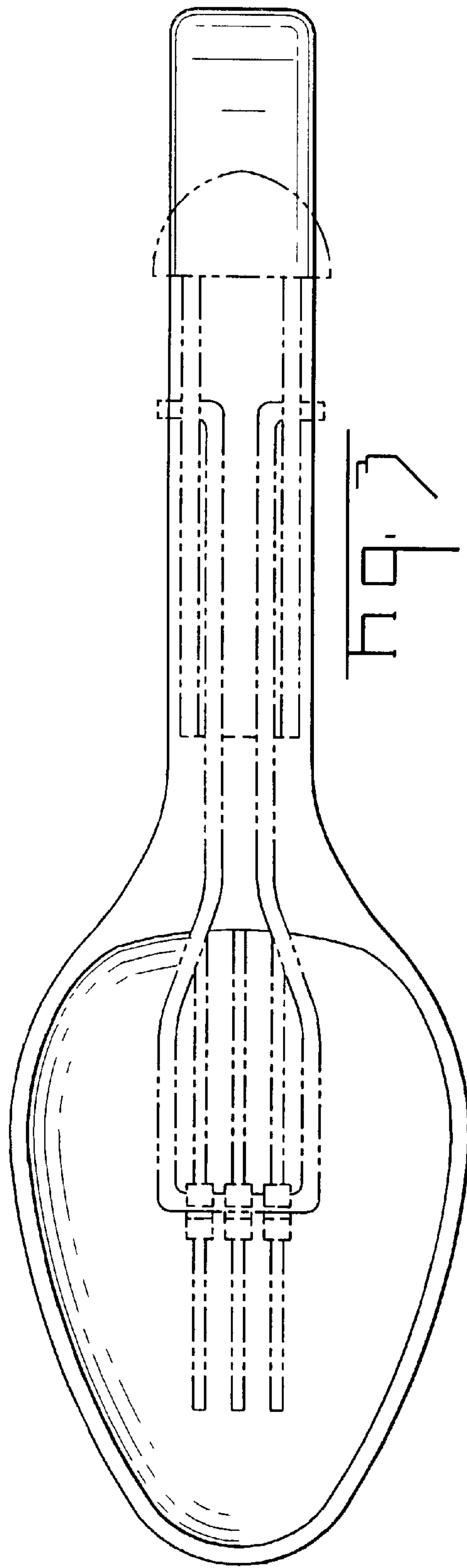
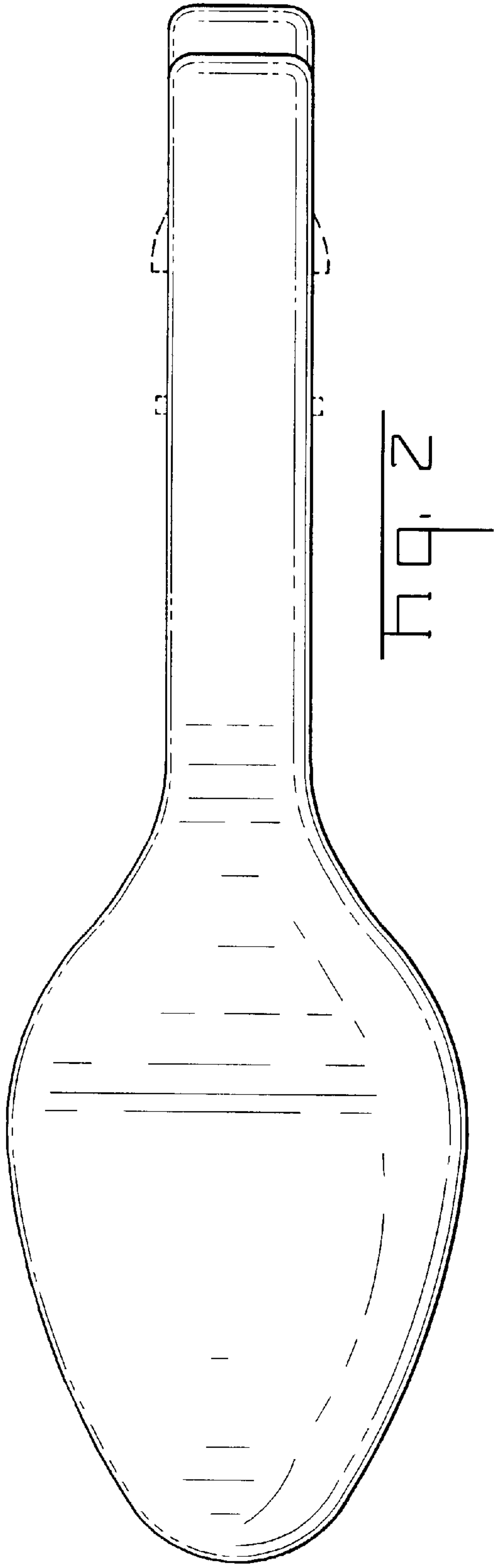

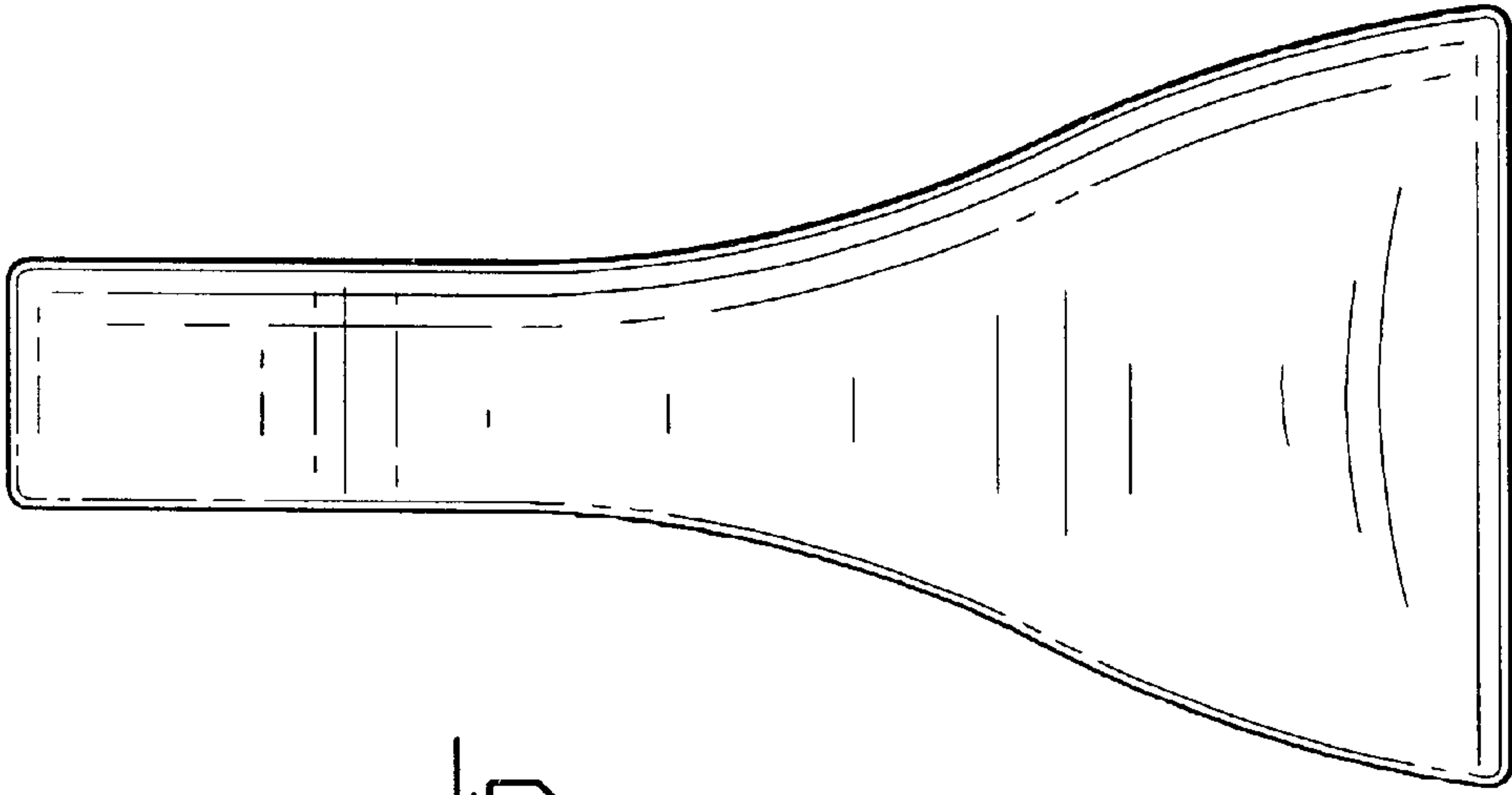

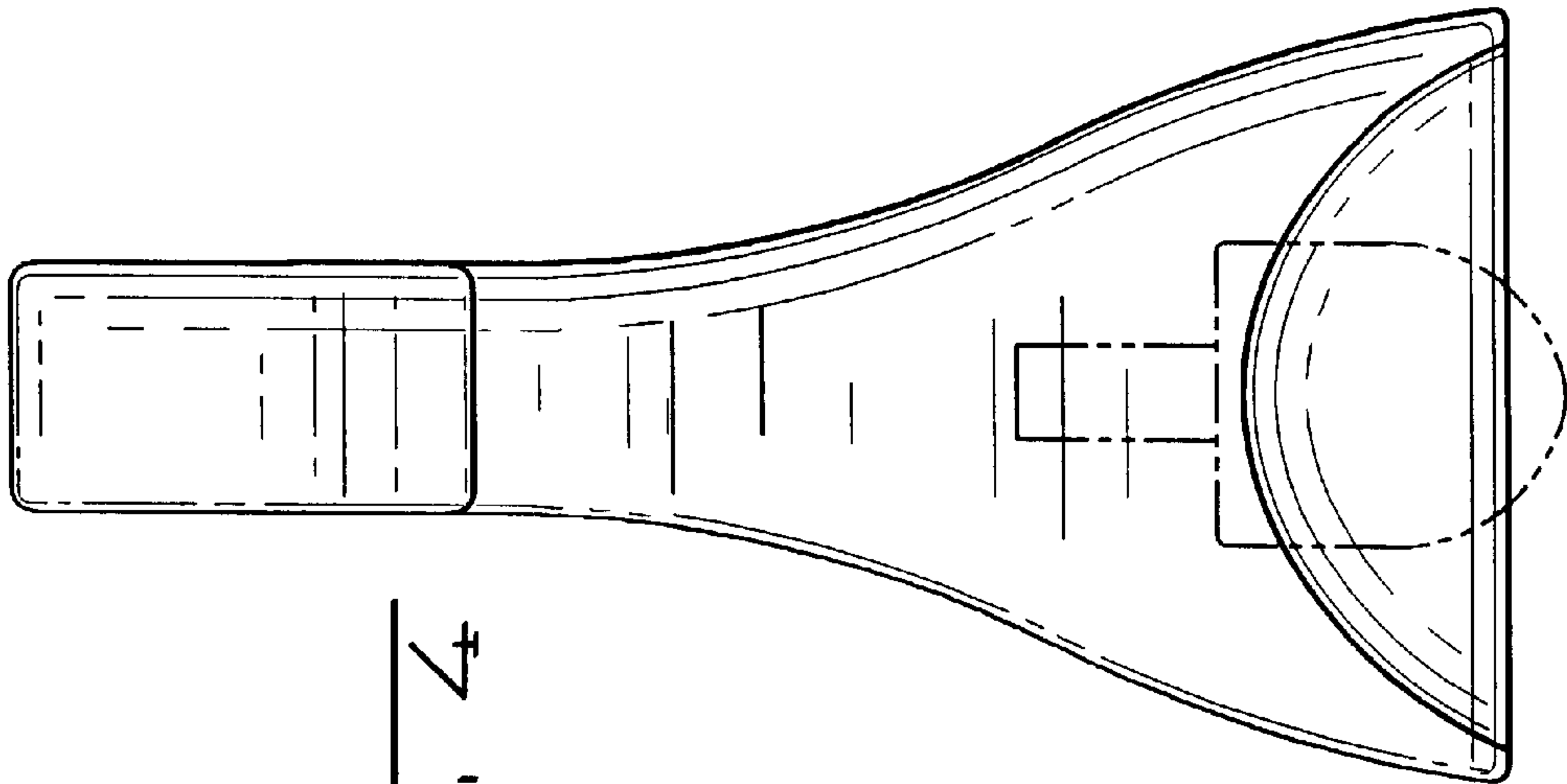
