(57) **CLAIM**

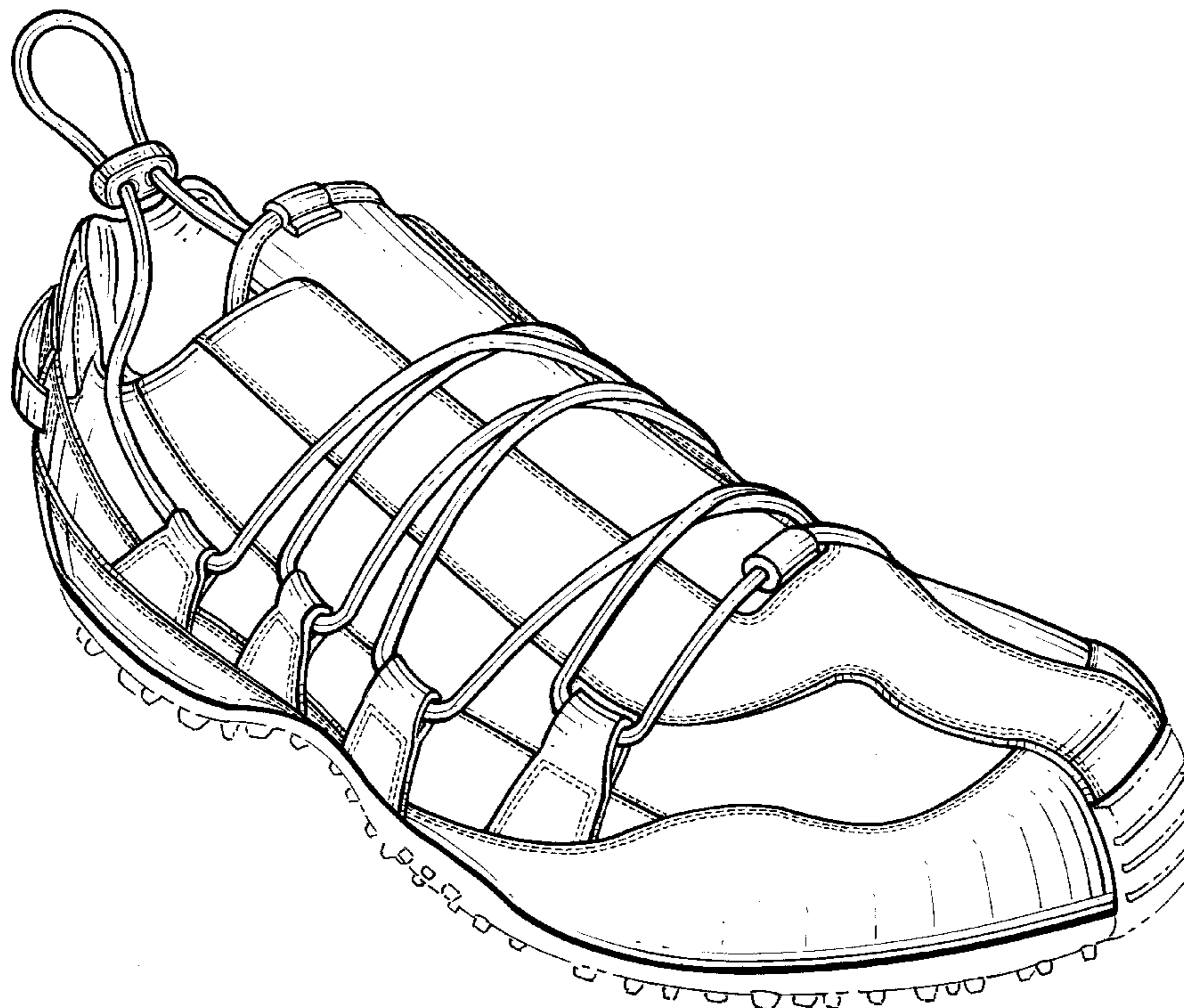
The ornamental design for a footwear upper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a preferred embodiment of a footwear upper showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

The broken line showing the upper in the figures is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

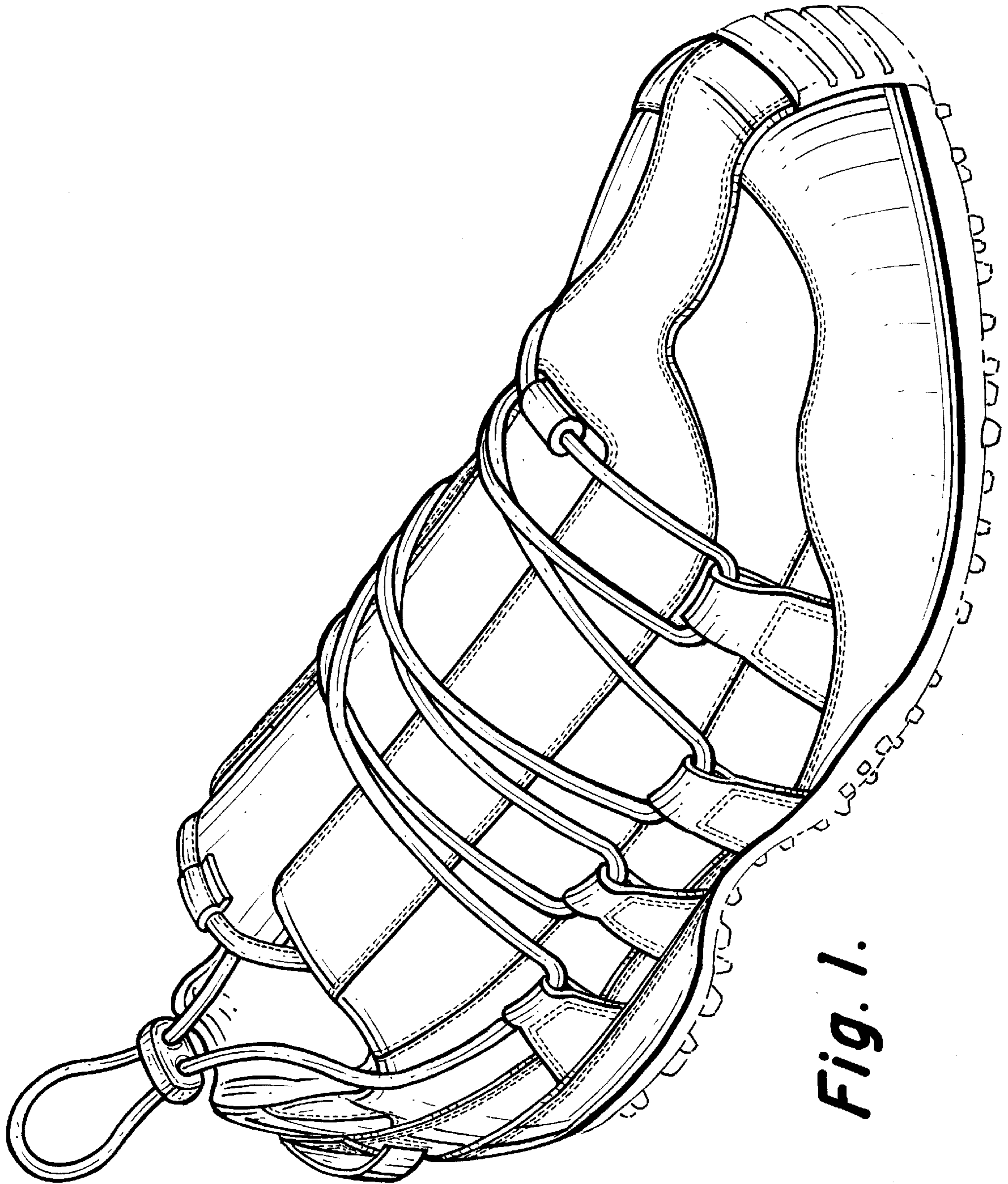

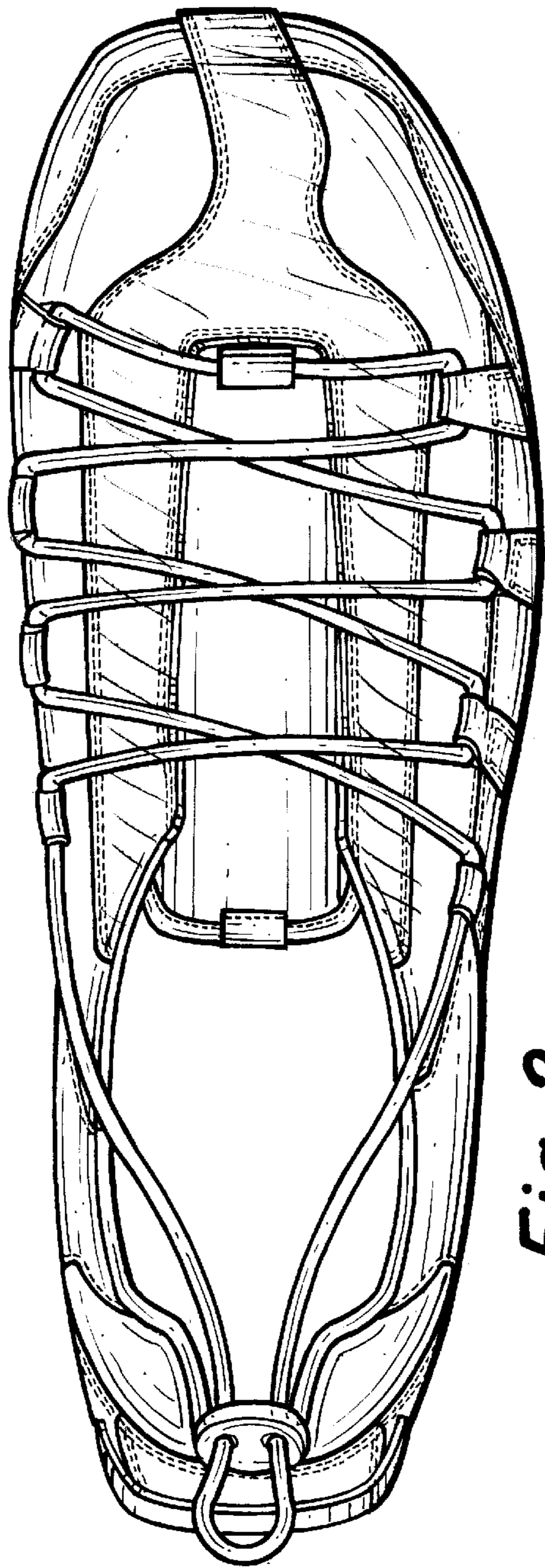

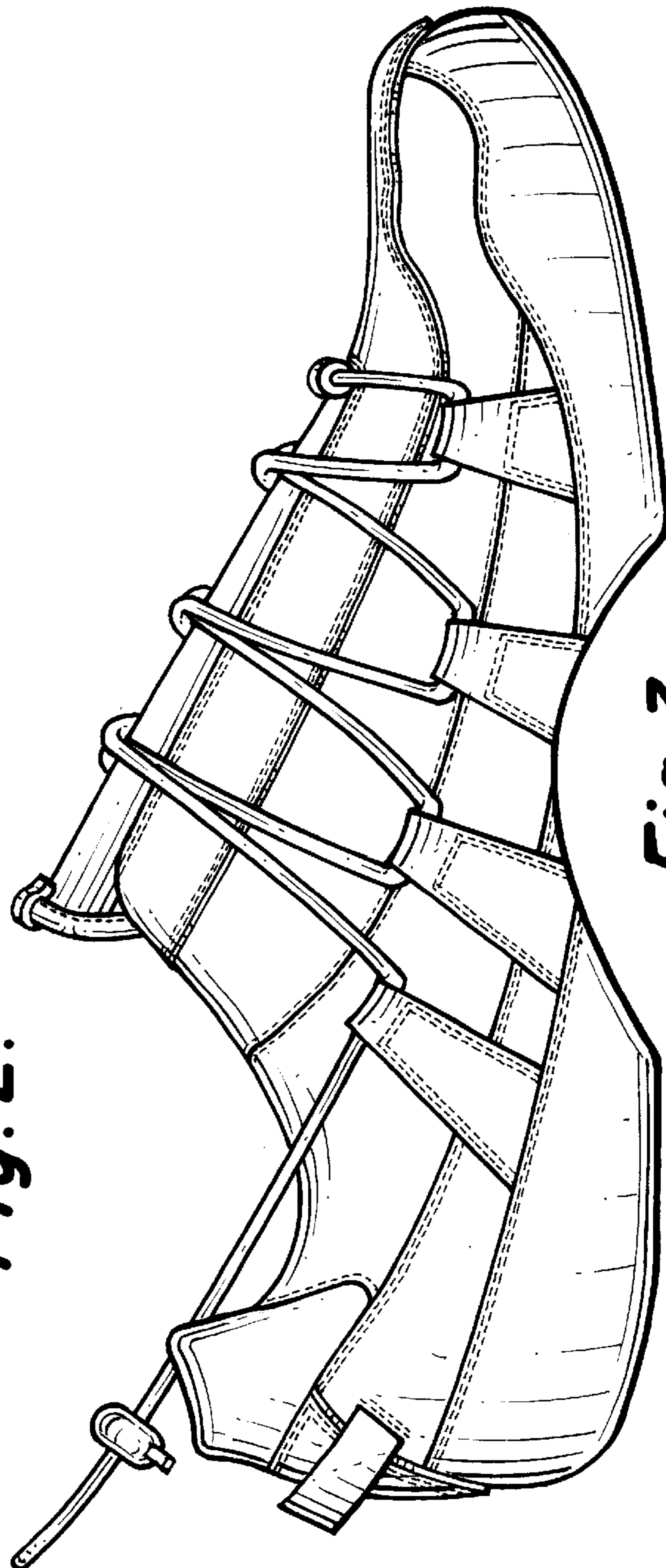

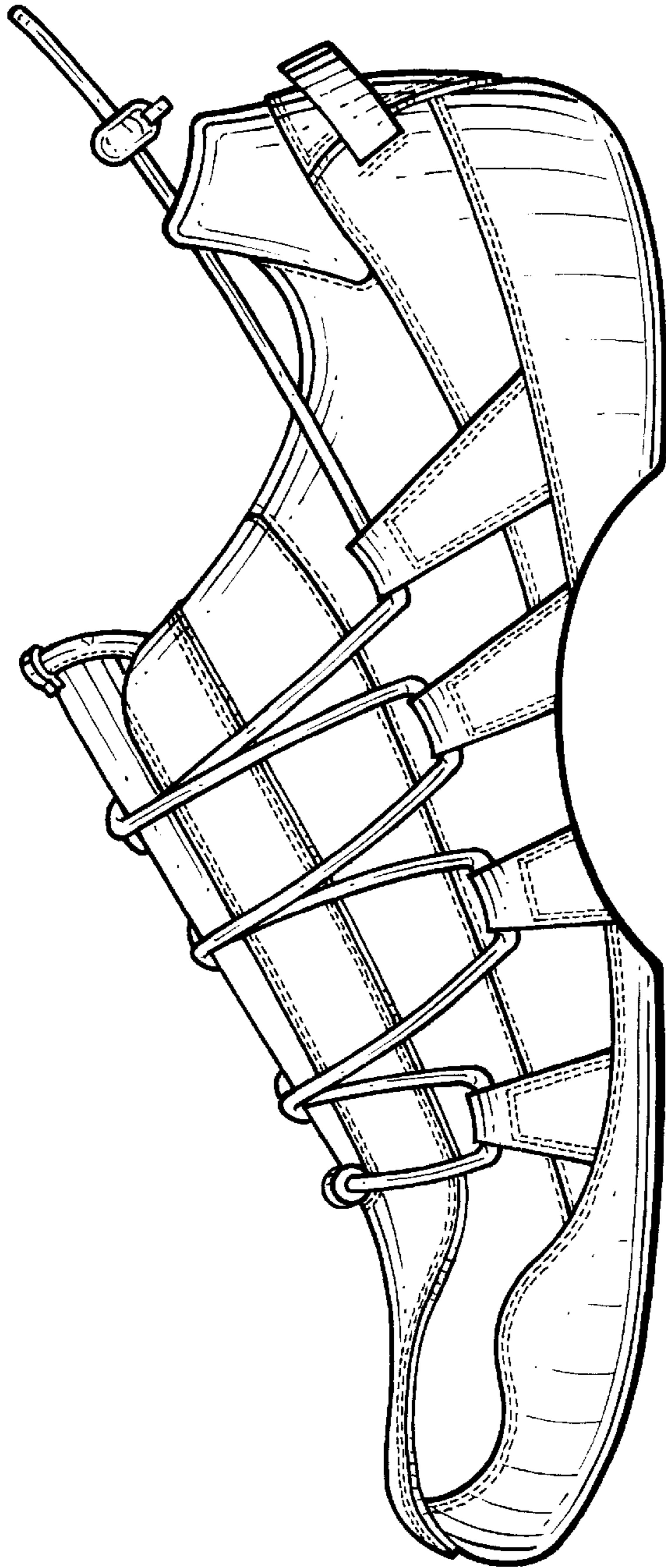

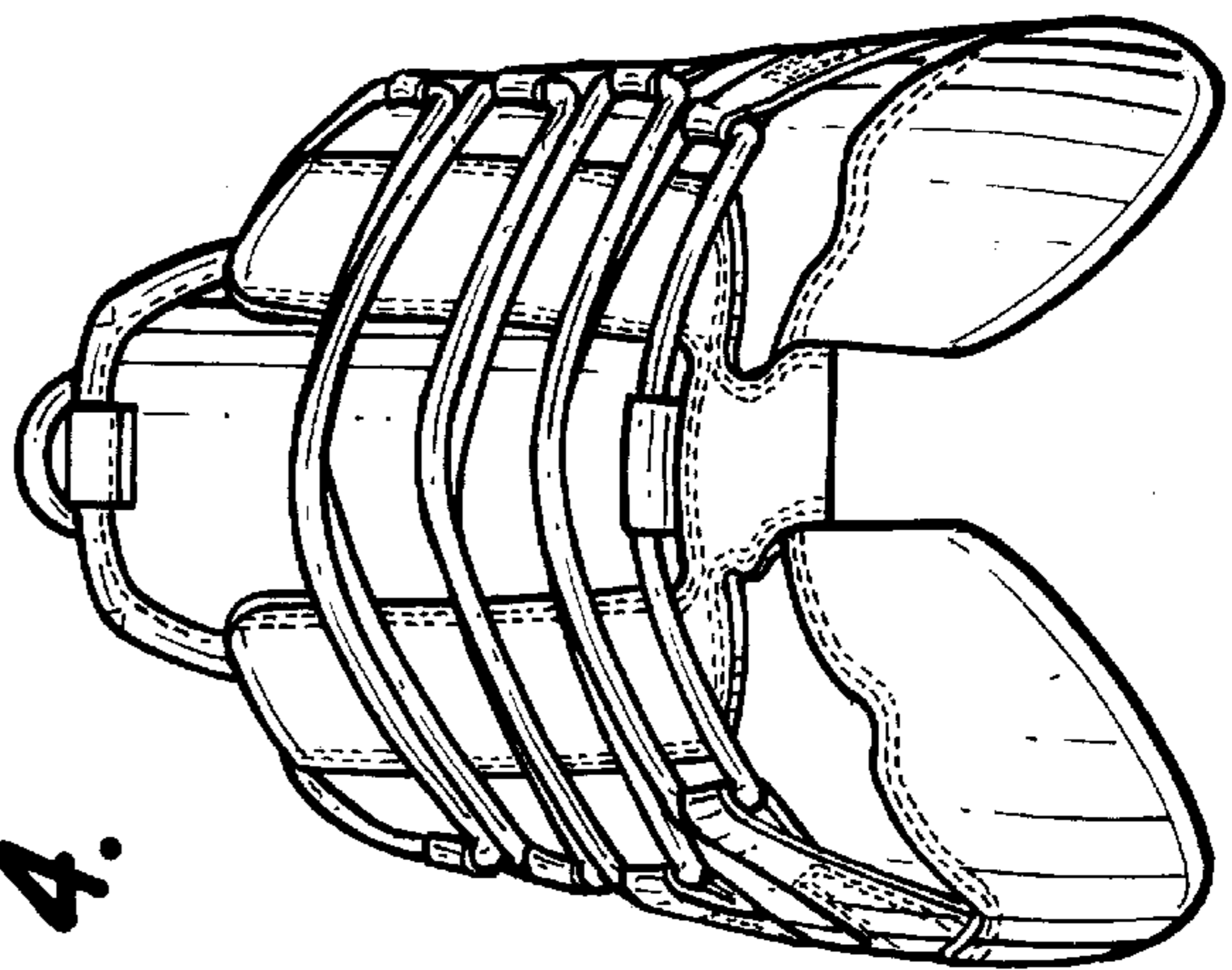

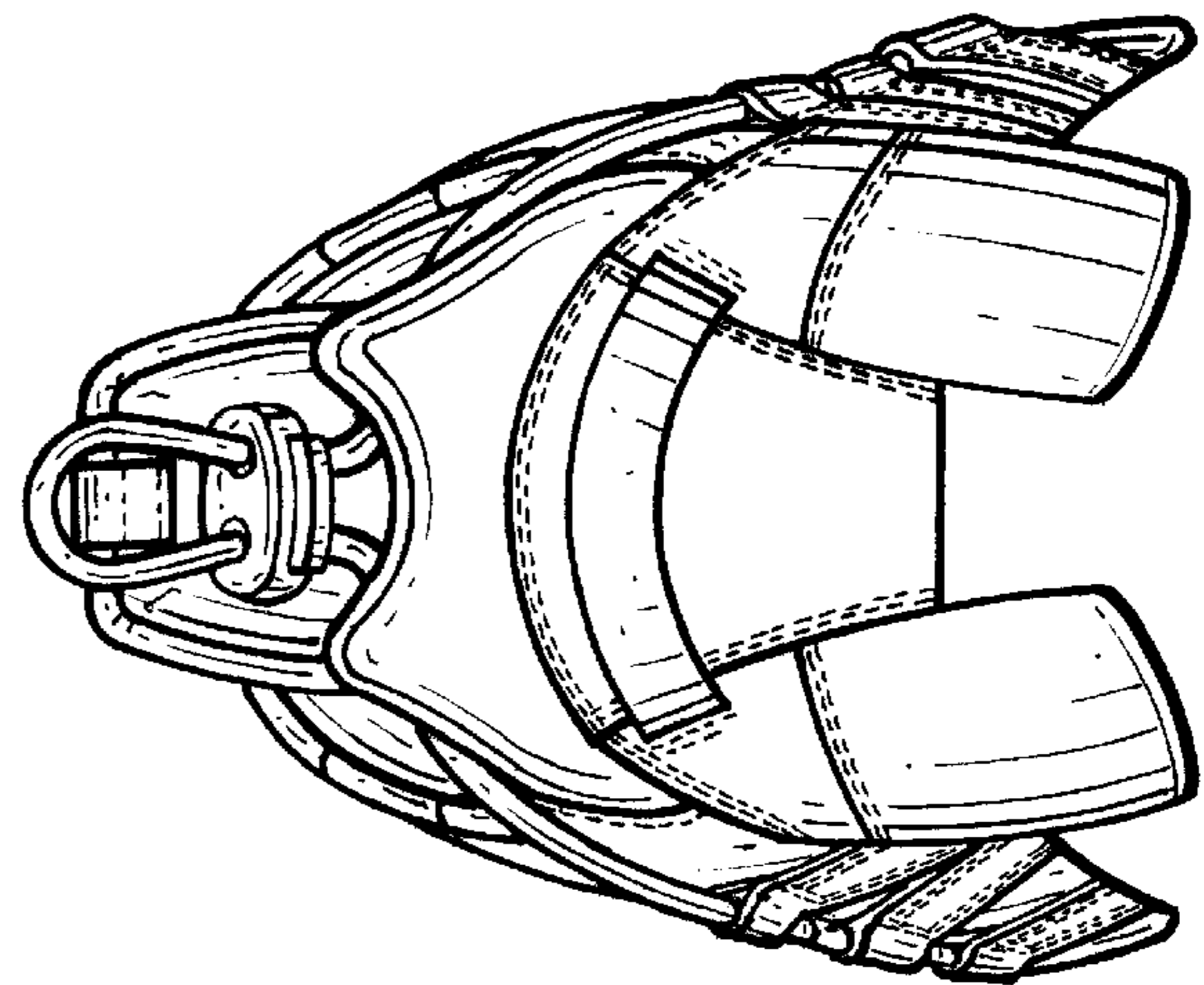
