FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view of the design.

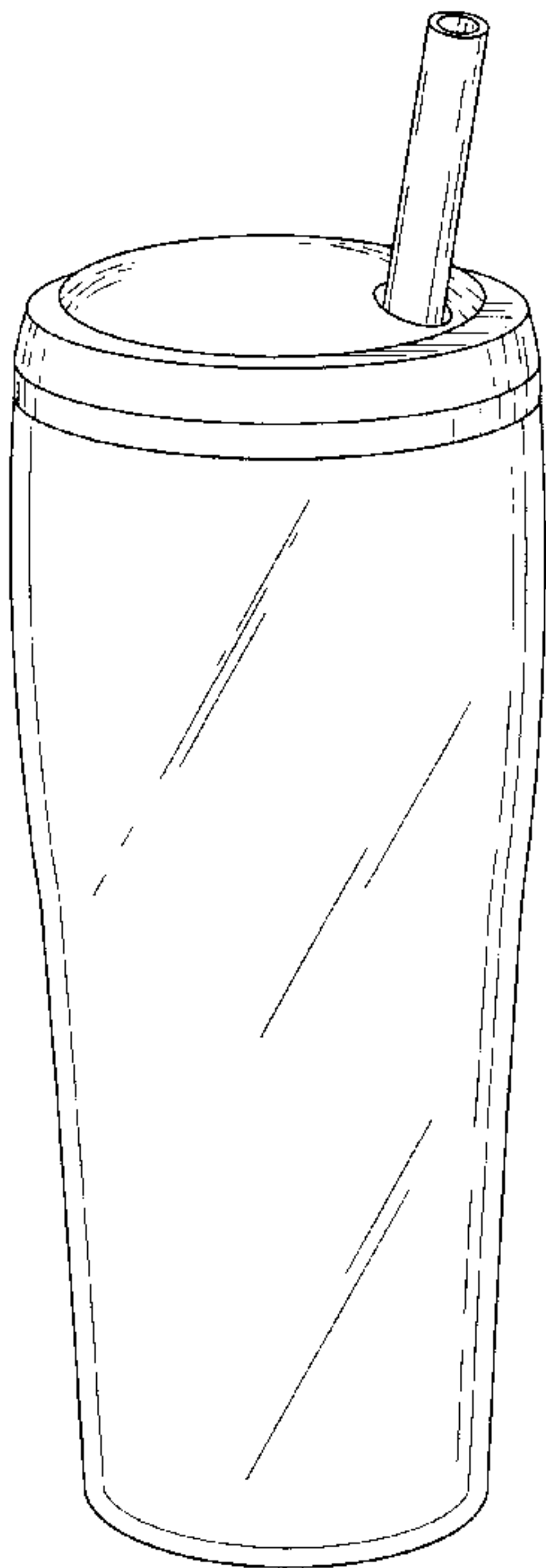
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the design.

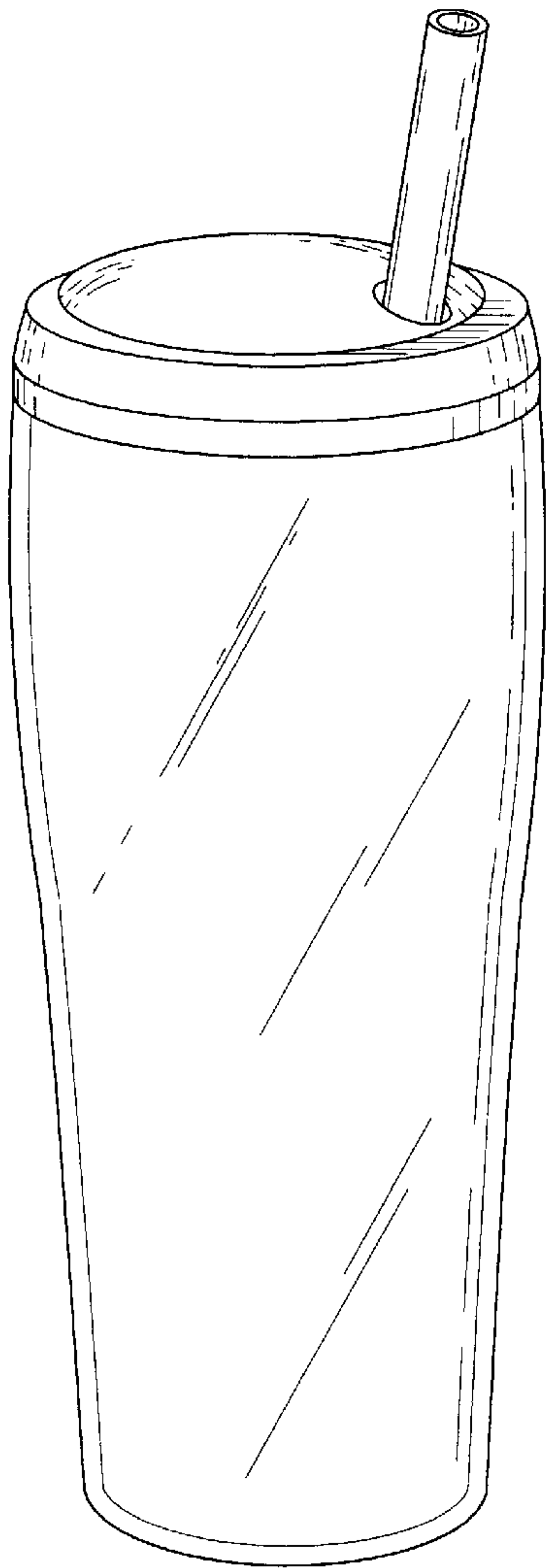

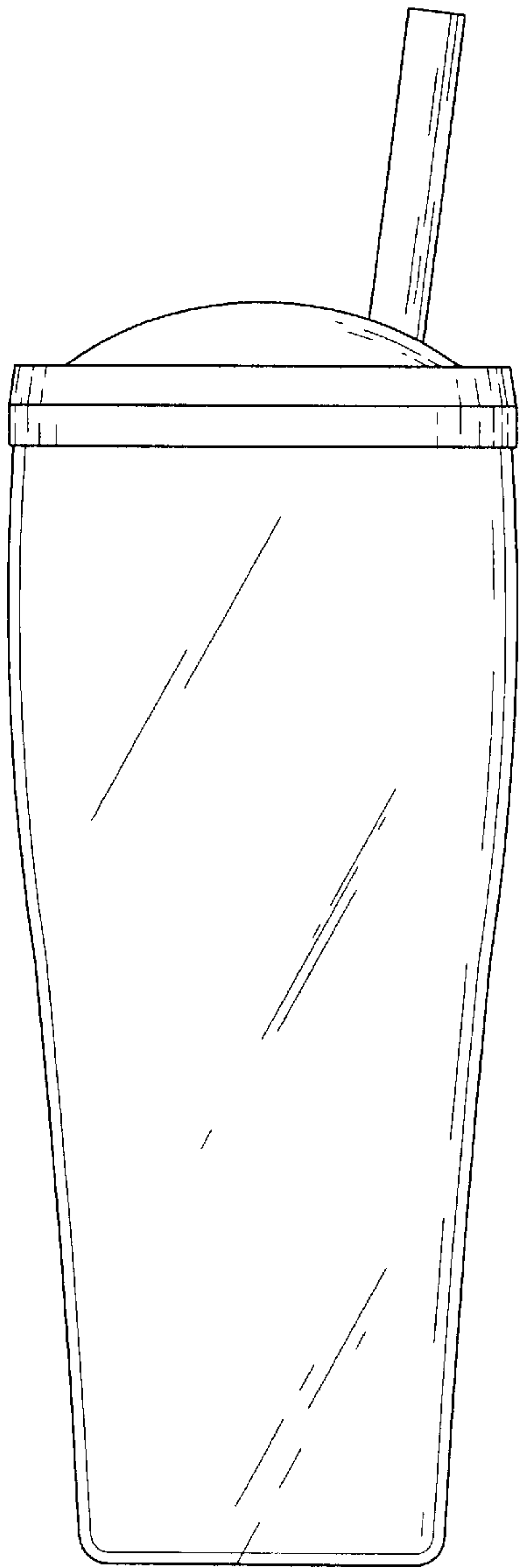

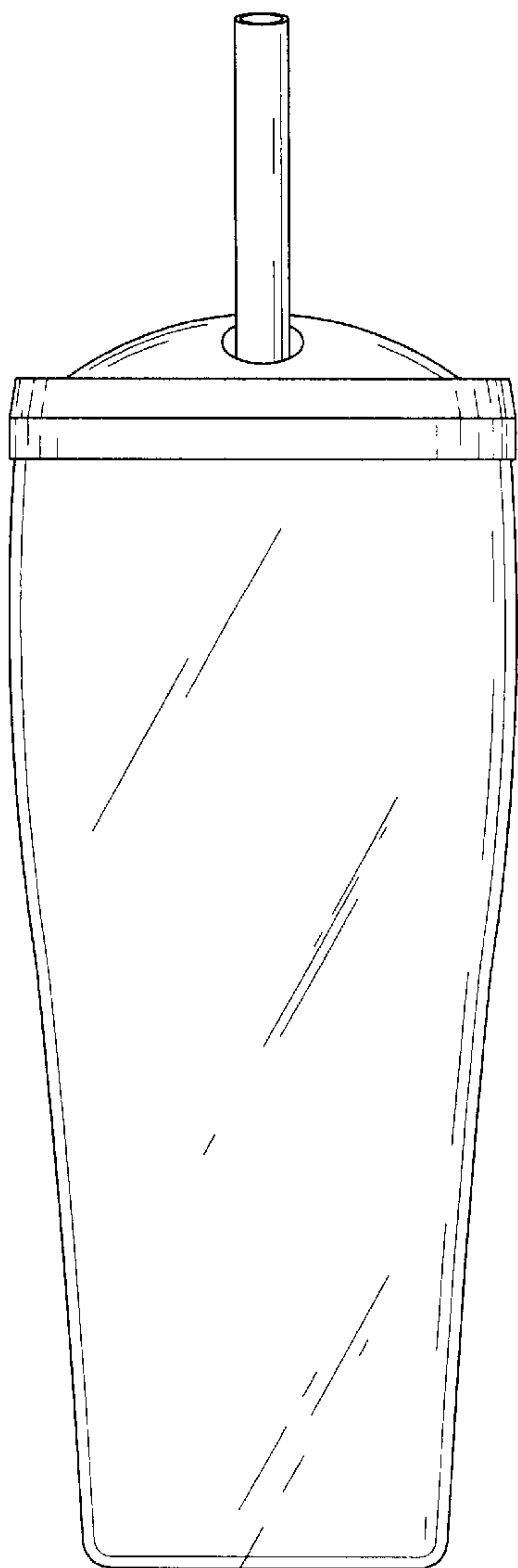

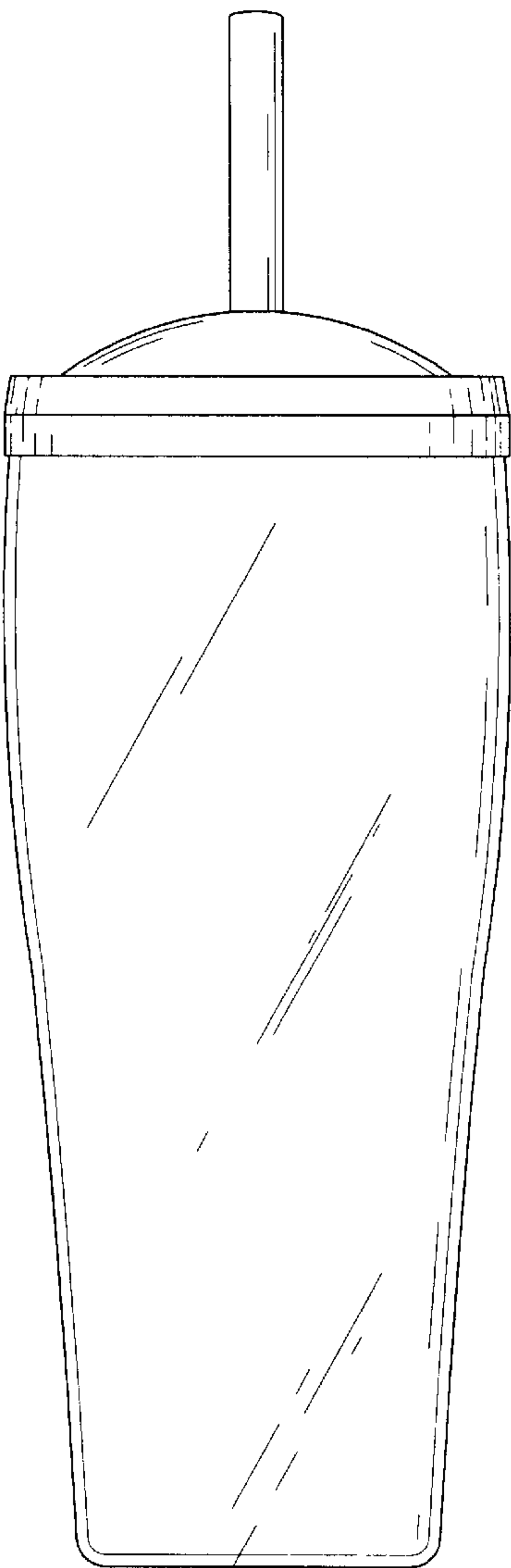

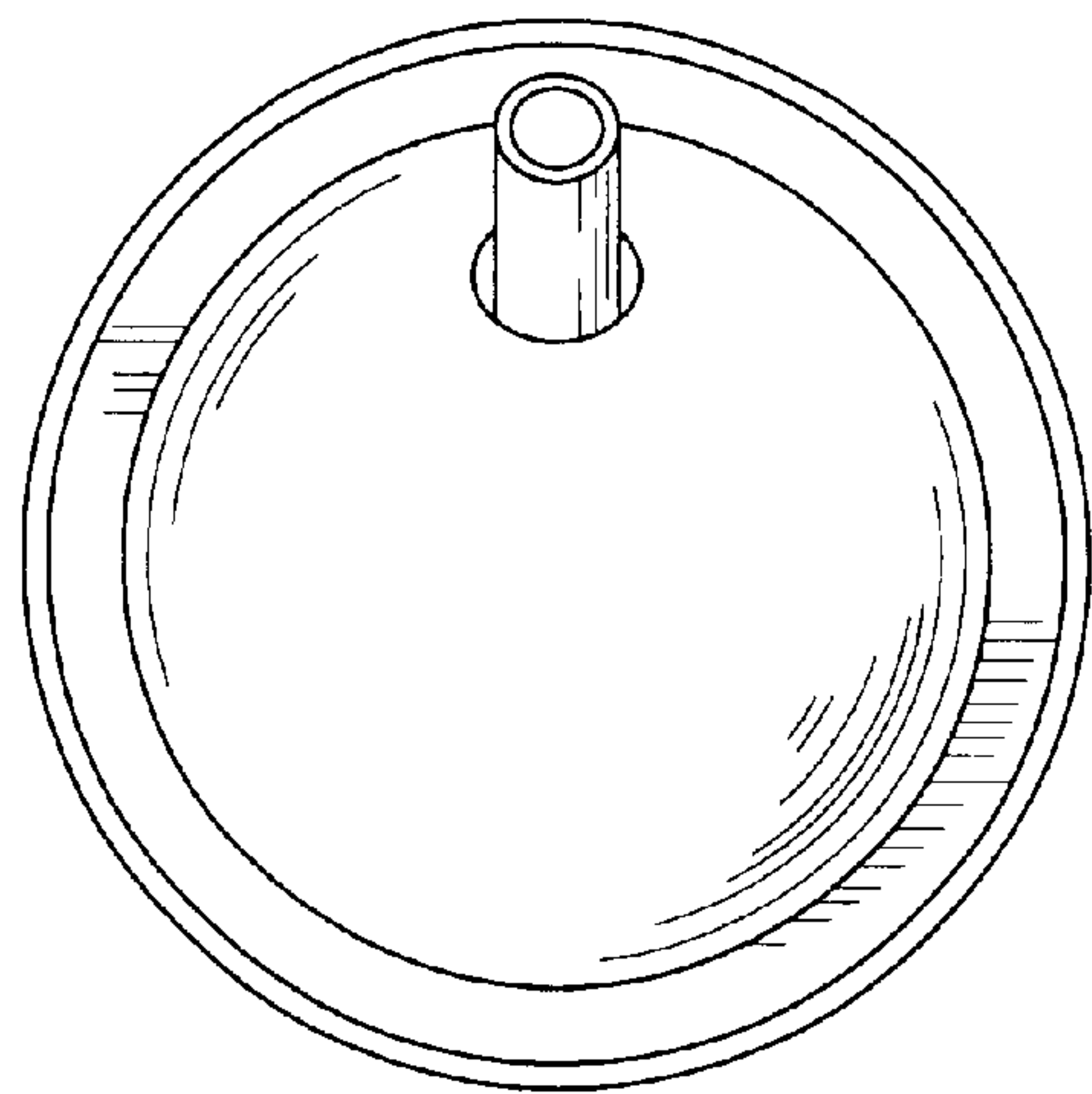

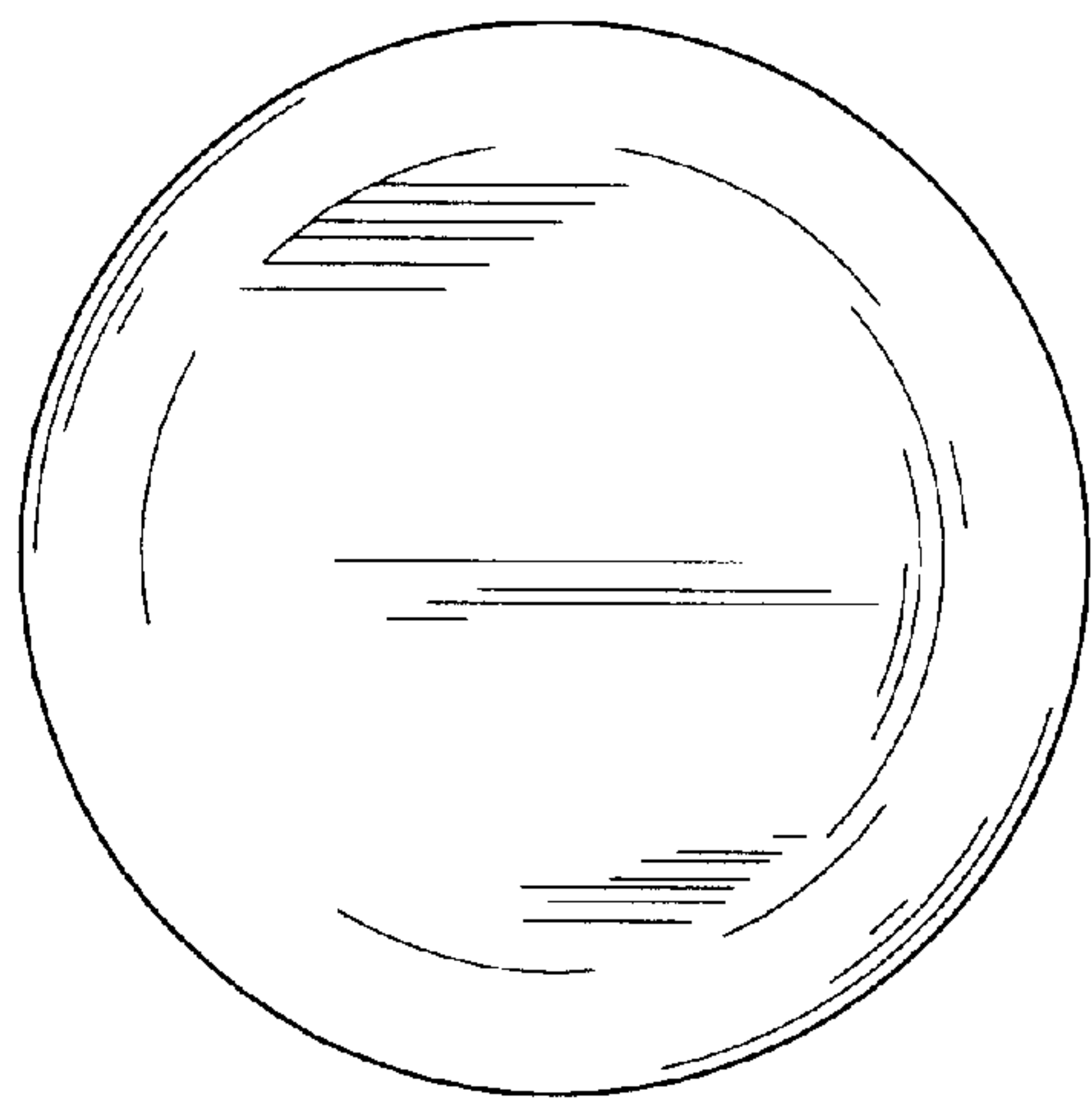
