(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a palm rest for a carpet stair tool, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The design consists of the ornamental shape of a palm rest for a carpet stair tool.

FIG. 1 is a front view of the palm rest, as mounted on a stair tool shown in phantom line.

FIG. 2 is a rear view of the palm rest, as mounted on a stair tool shown in phantom line.

FIG. 3 is a right side view of the palm rest, as mounted on a stair tool shown in phantom line.

FIG. 4 is a left side view of the palm rest, as mounted on a

stair tool shown in phantom line.

FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the palm rest, as mounted on a

stair tool shown in phantom line. FIG. 6 is a top view of the palm rest, as mounted on a stair tool shown in phantom line.

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the palm rest, as mounted on a stair tool shown in phantom line.

FIG. 8 is a rear view of the palm rest.

FIG. 9 is a top view of the palm rest.

FIG. 10 is a right side view of the palm rest.


FIG. 11 is a front view of the palm rest.

FIG. 12 is a left side view of the palm rest; and,


FIG. 13 is a bottom view of the palm rest.


The palm rest is removable from the stair tool and the stair tool is shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.





















