FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a portion of a shoe showing my new design;

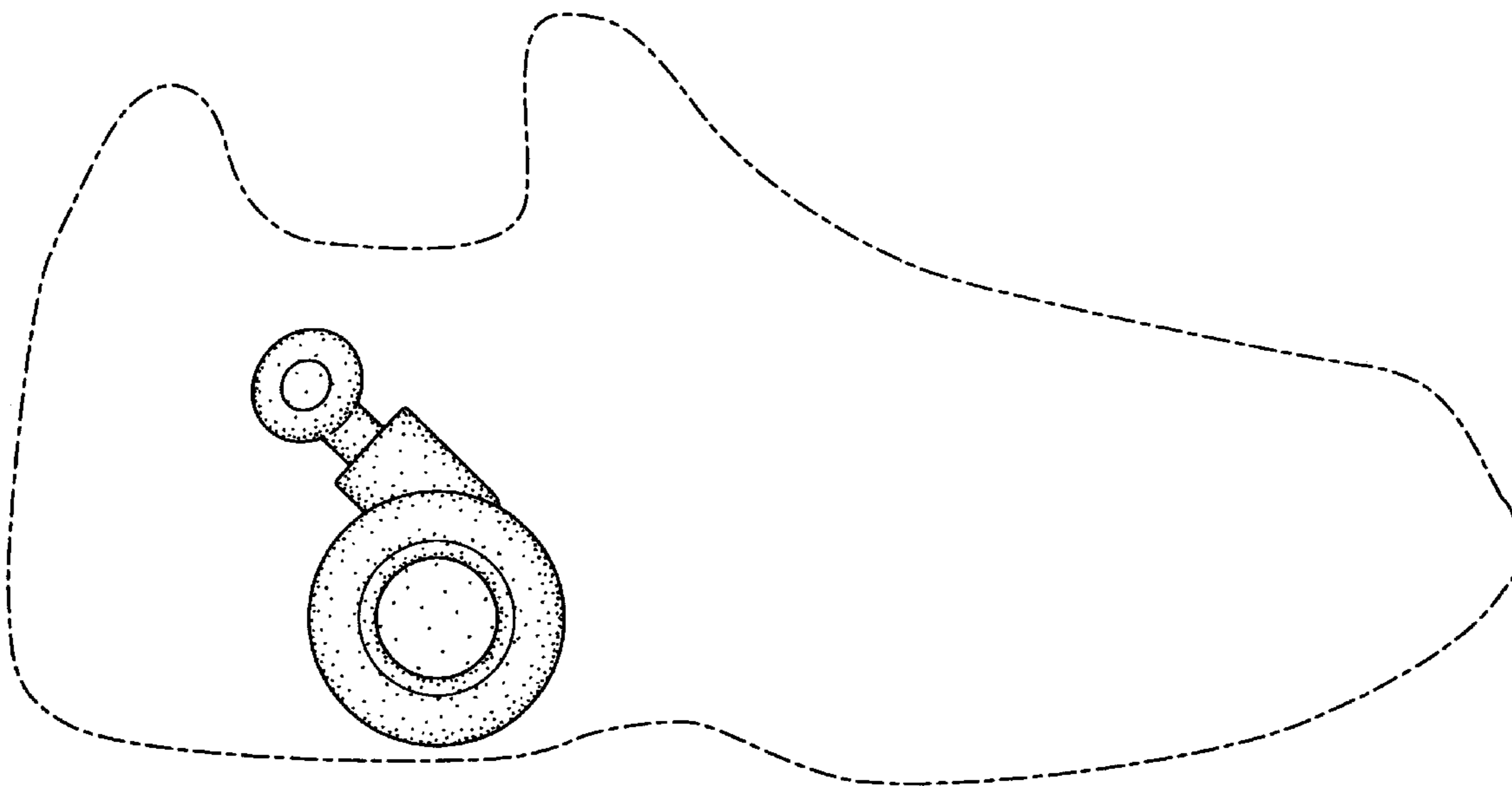
FIG. 2 is a side view thereof;

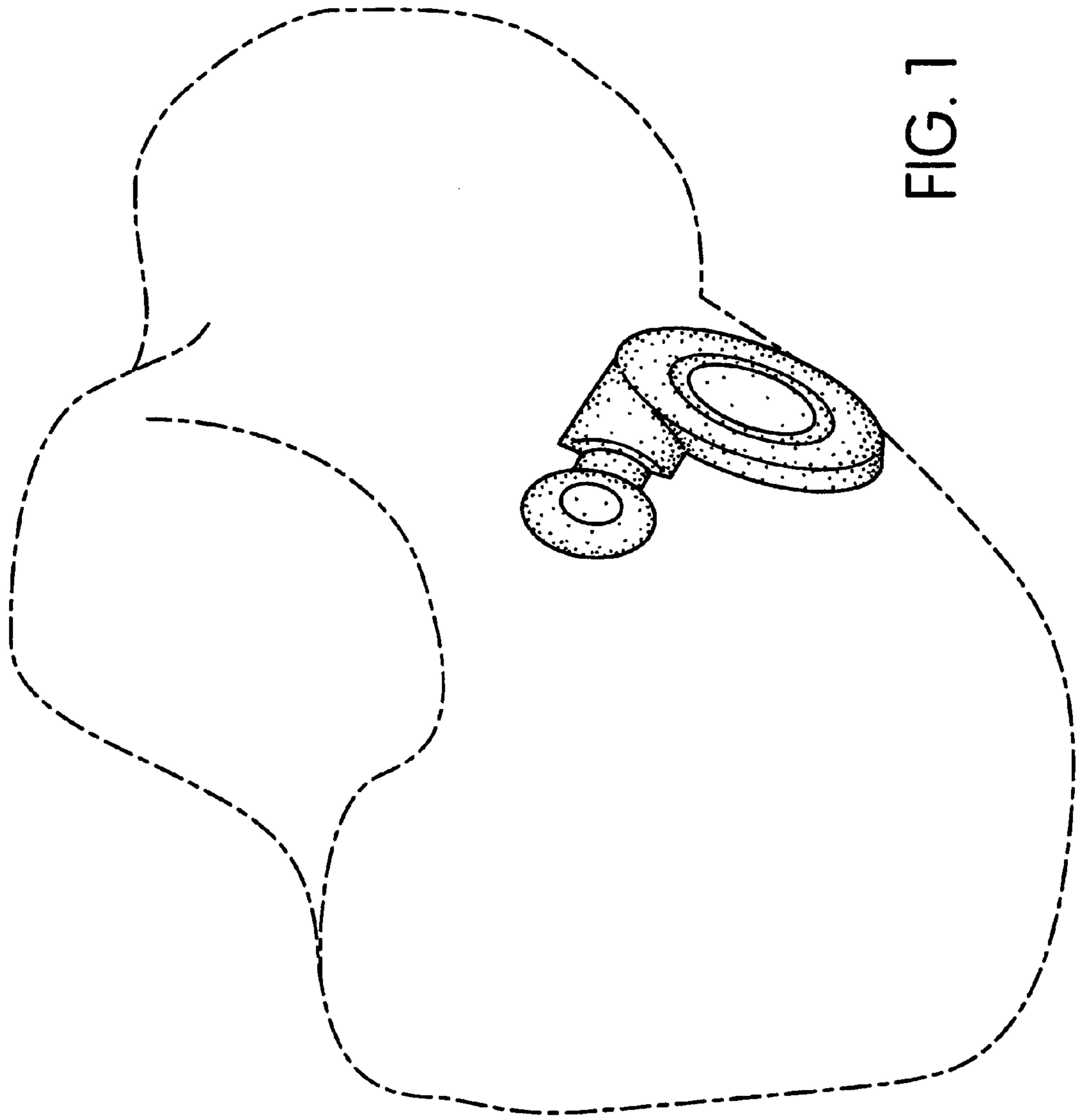

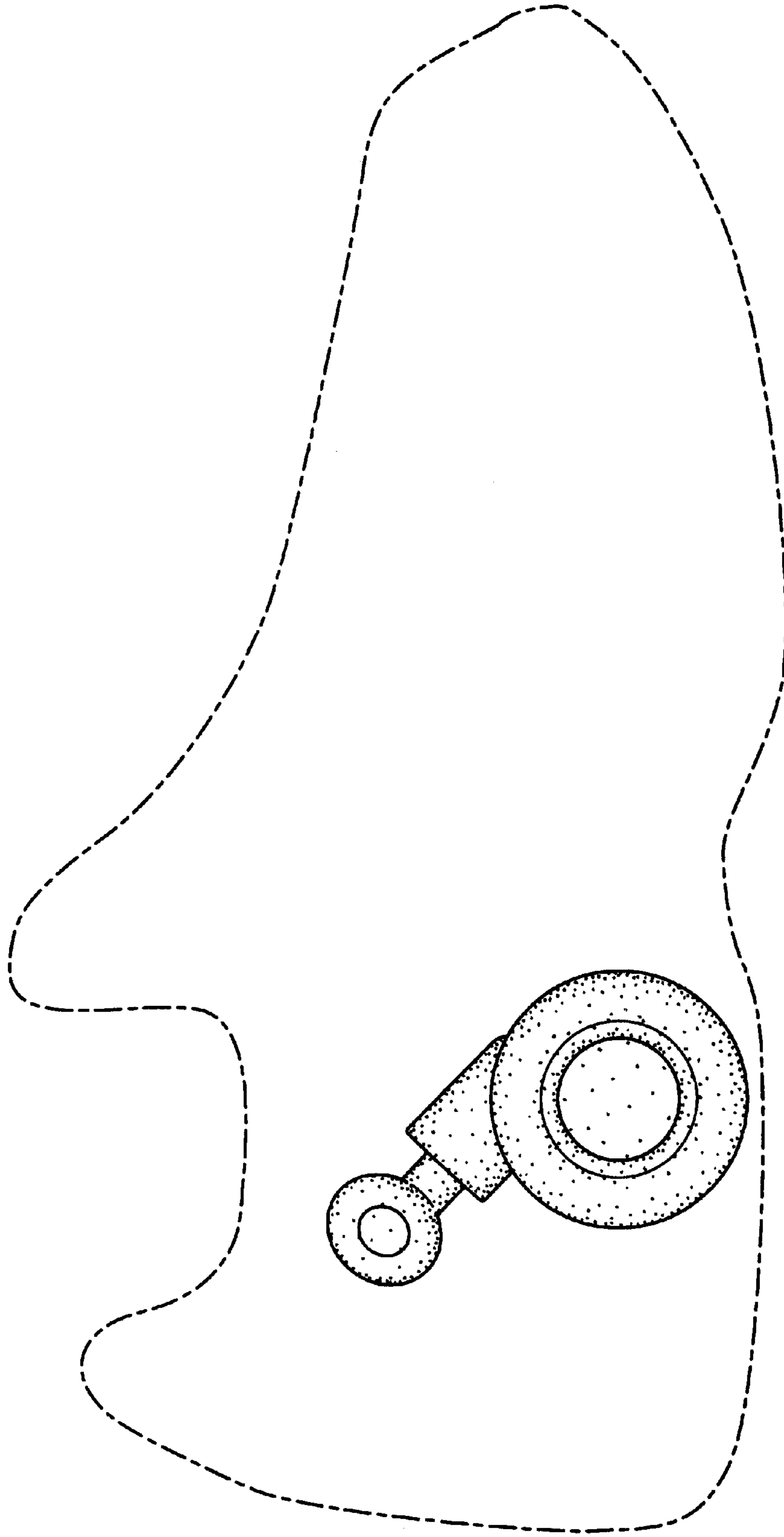

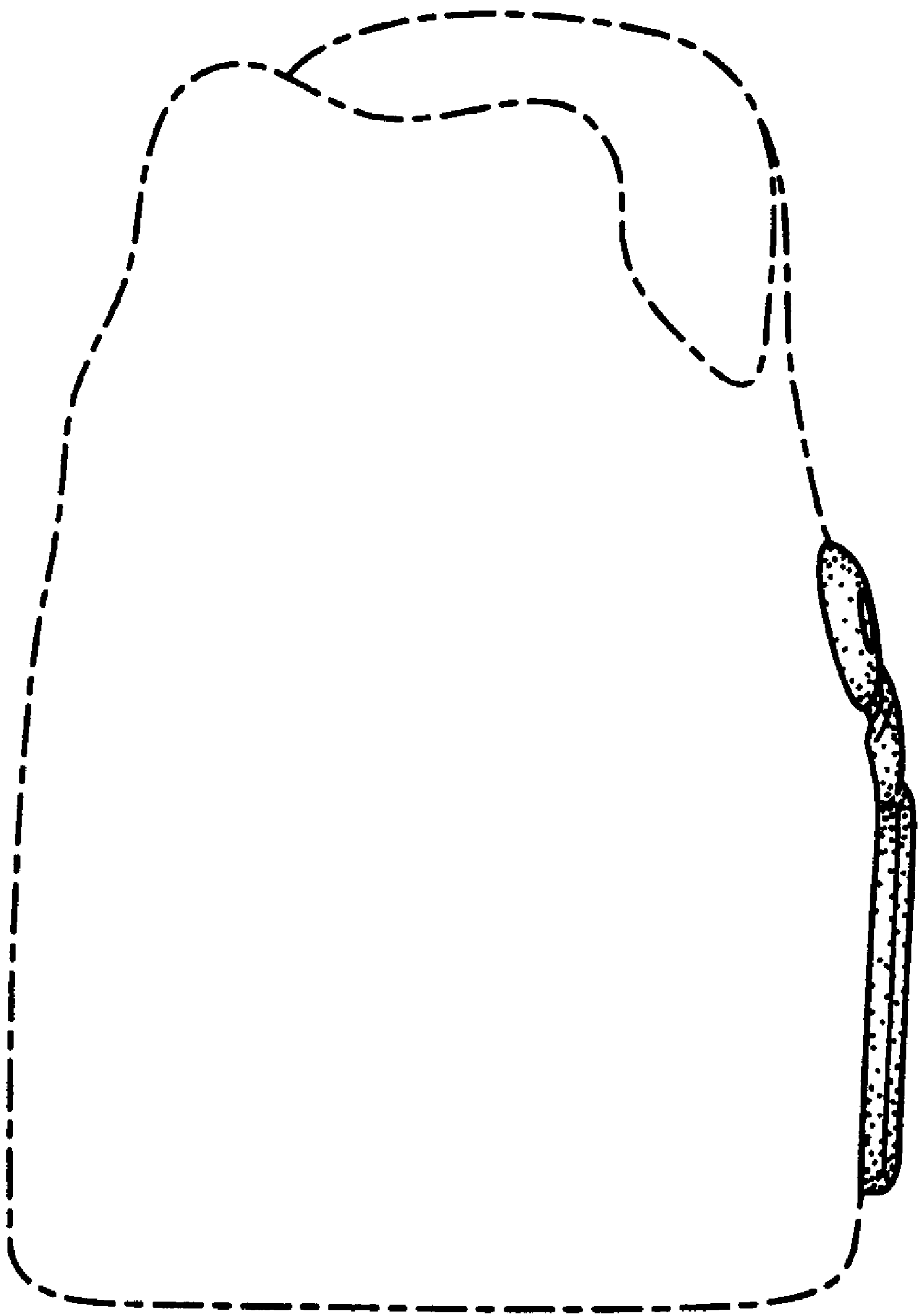

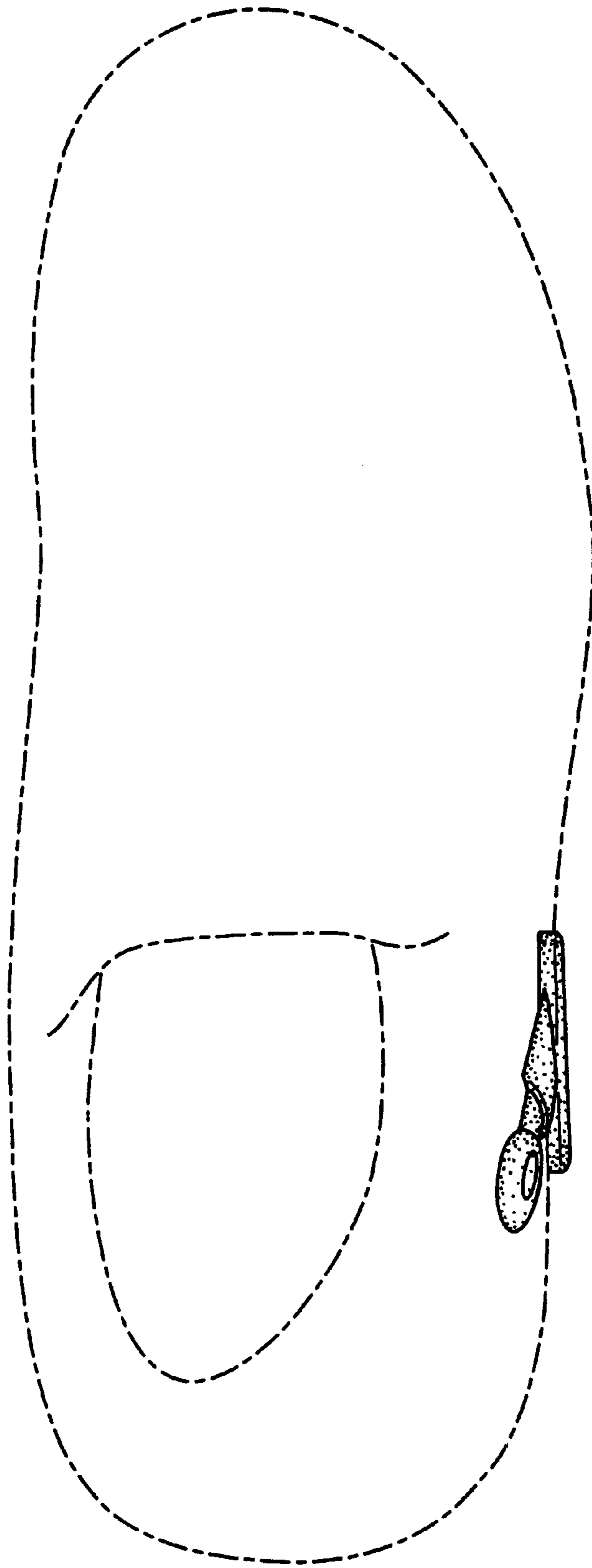
