The broken line showing of an adjustment handle in FIGS. 1 and 3 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

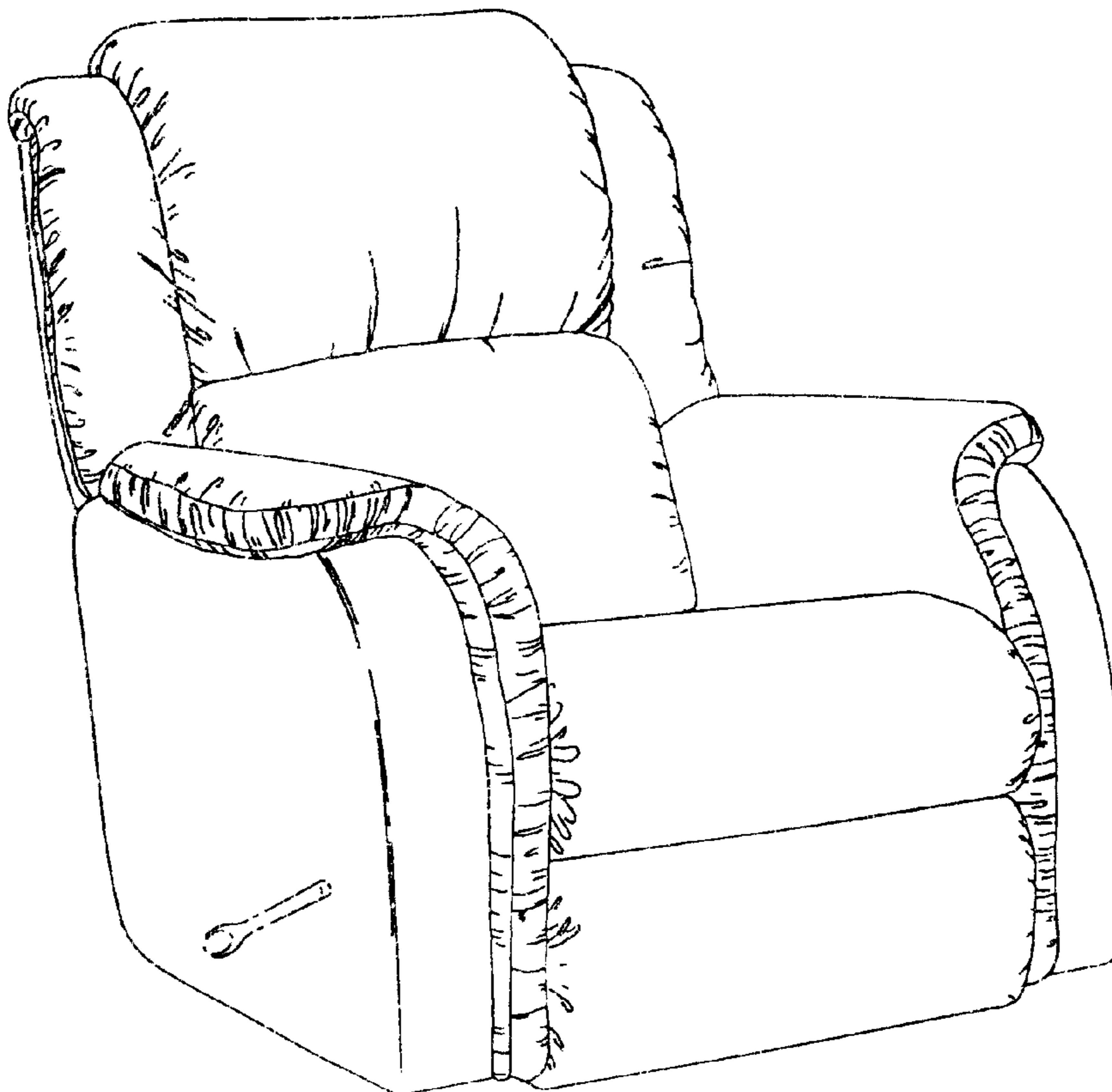

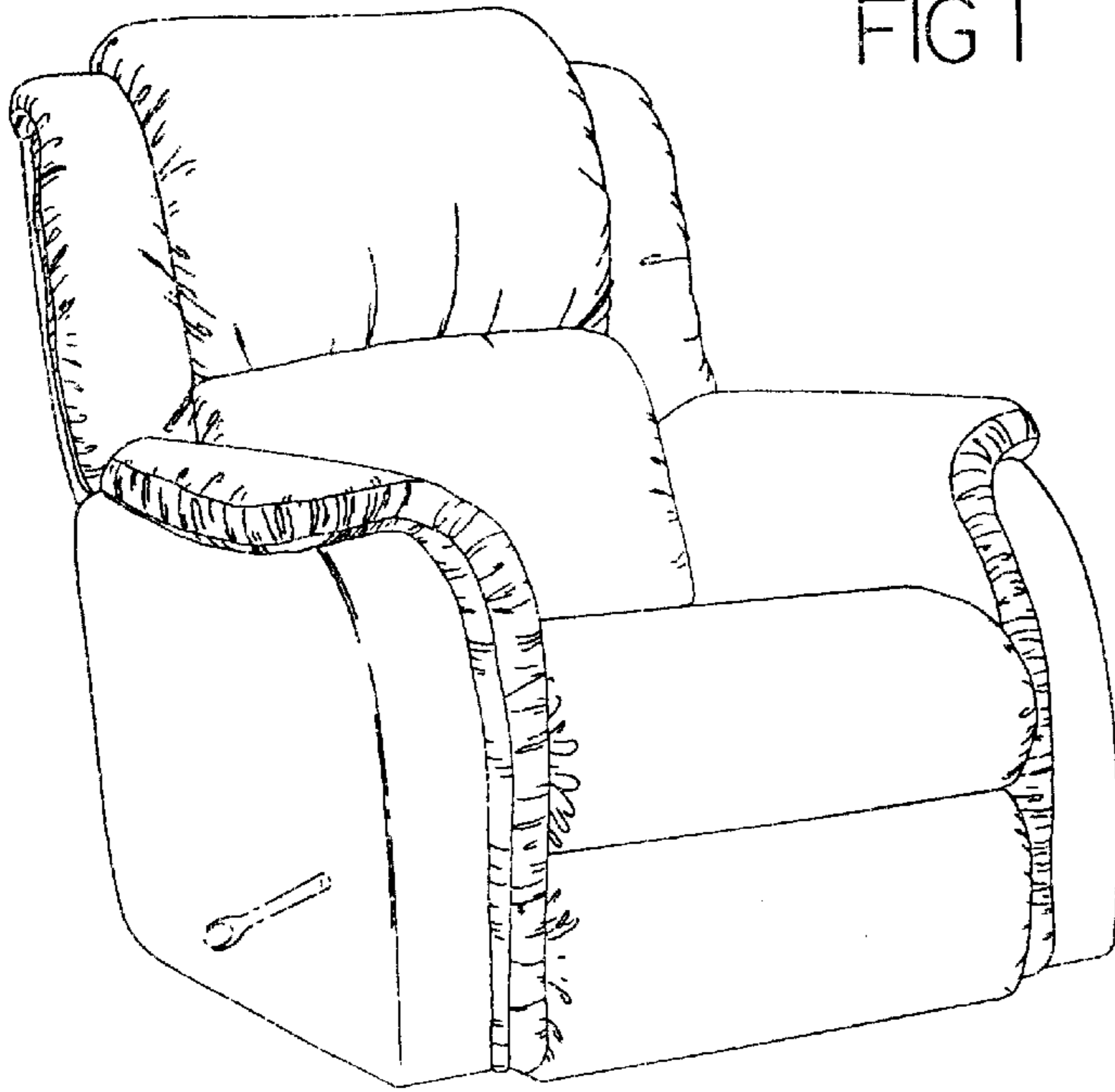
