embodiment showing the new design;

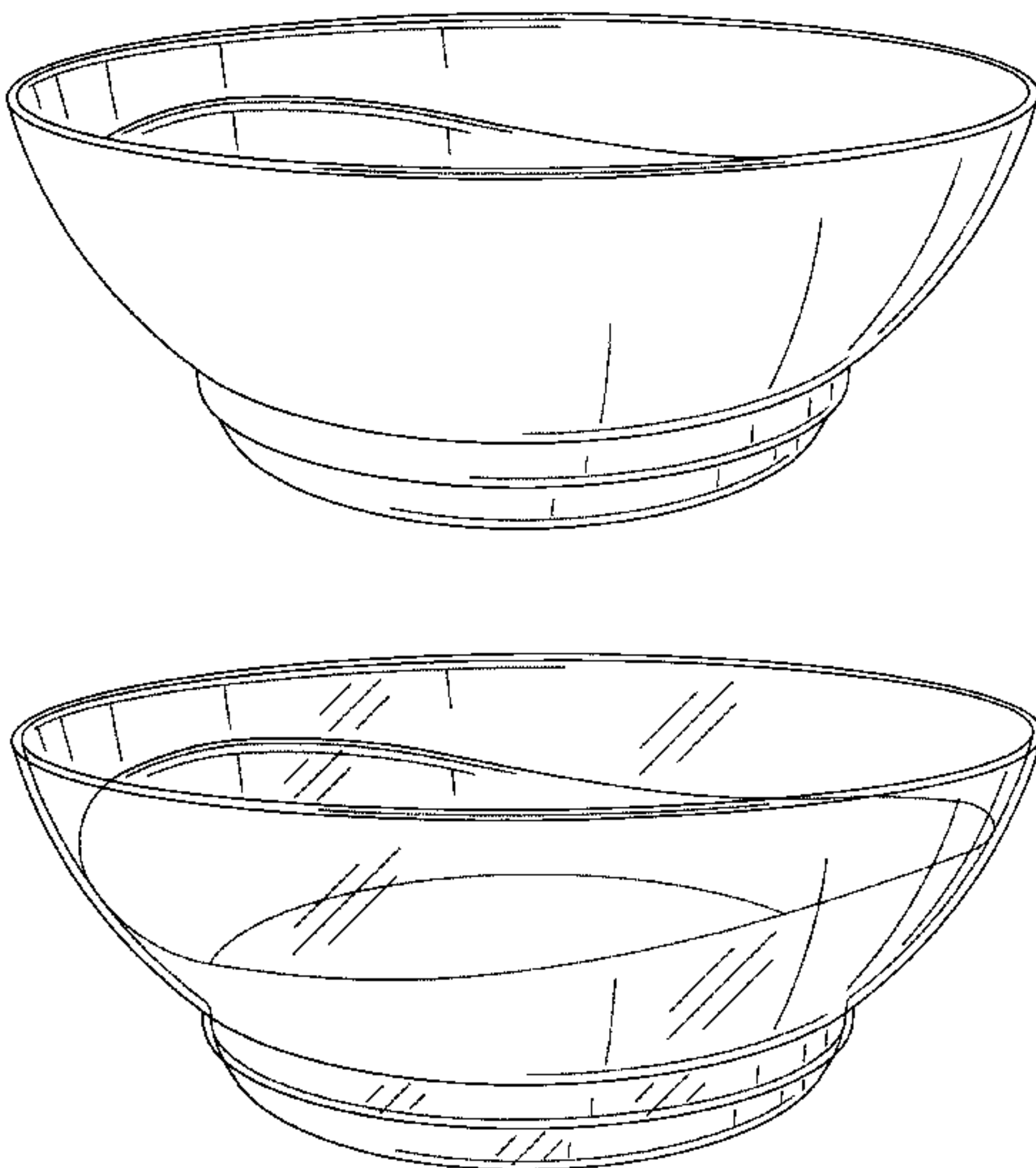
FIG. 7 is a front elevation view thereof, the rear elevation

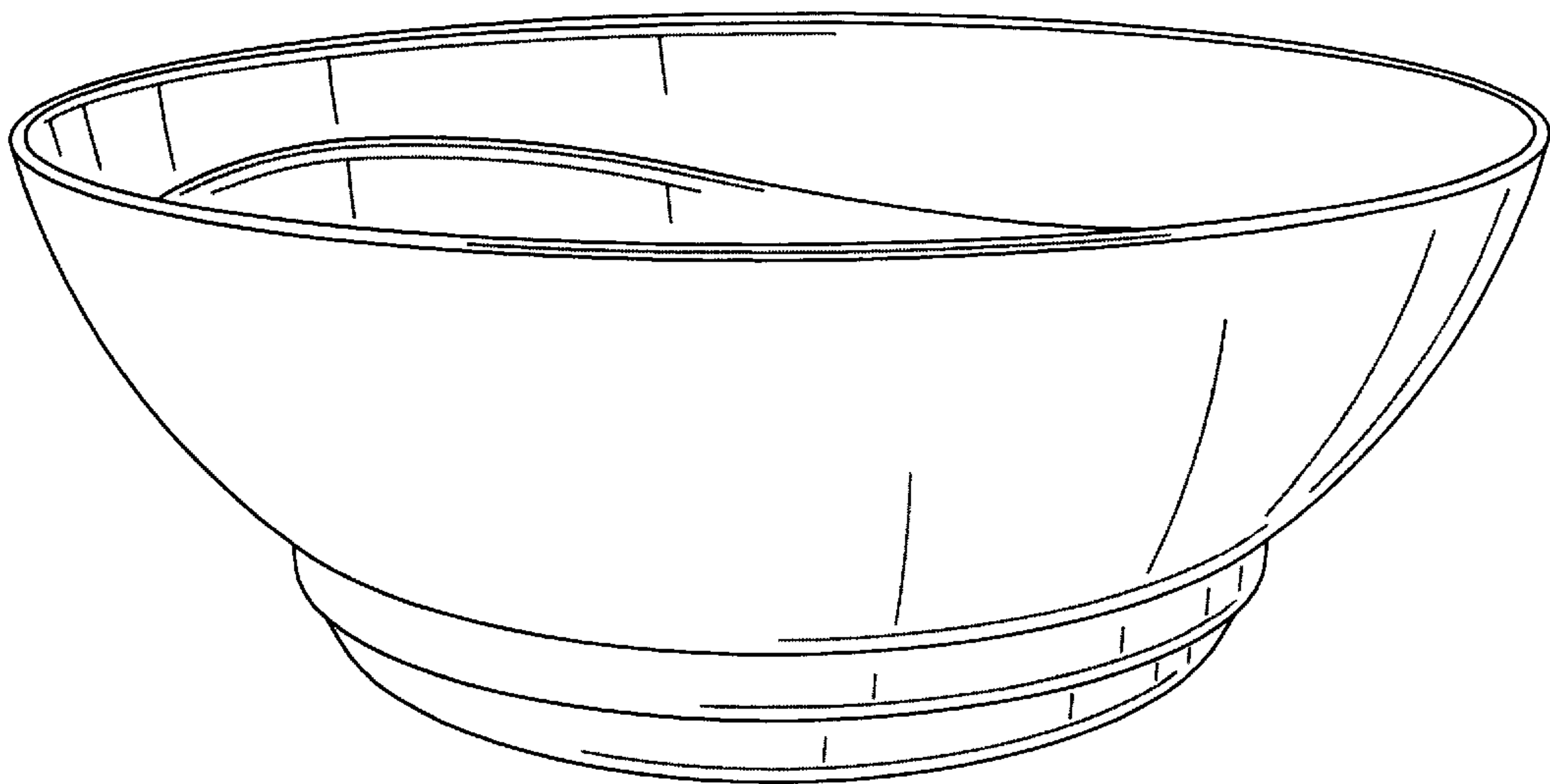

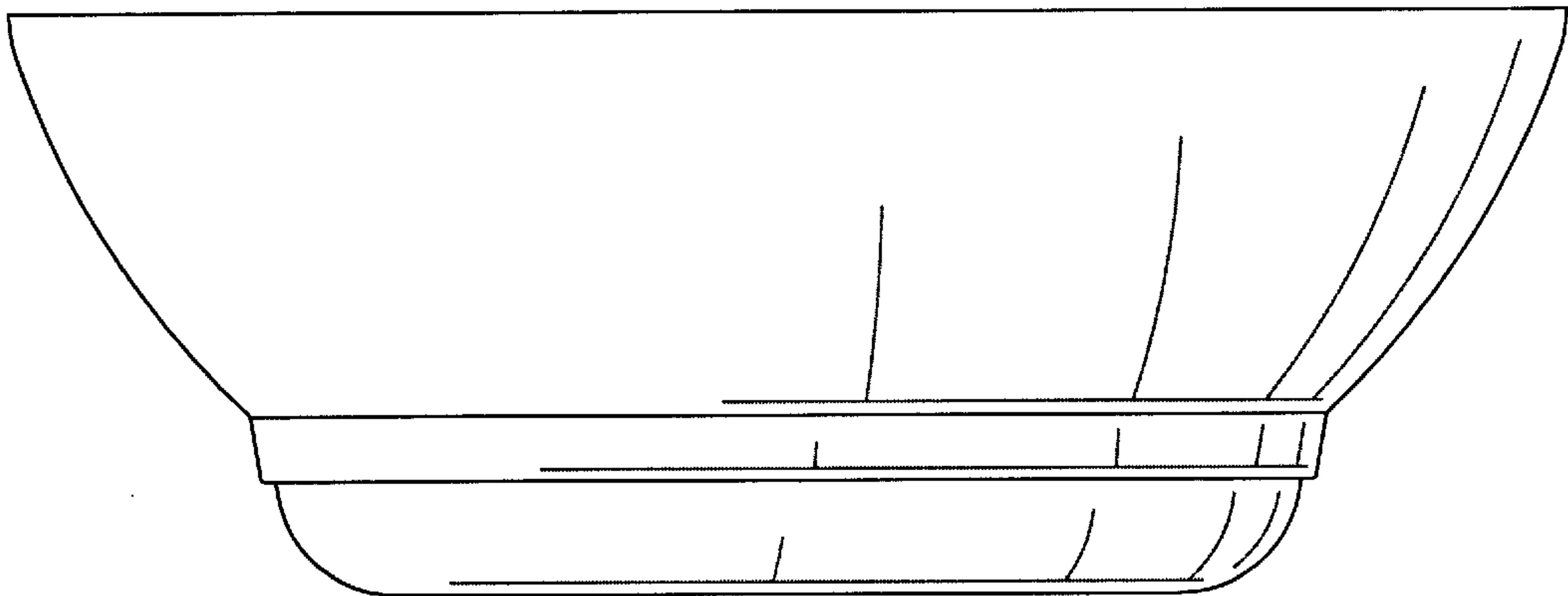

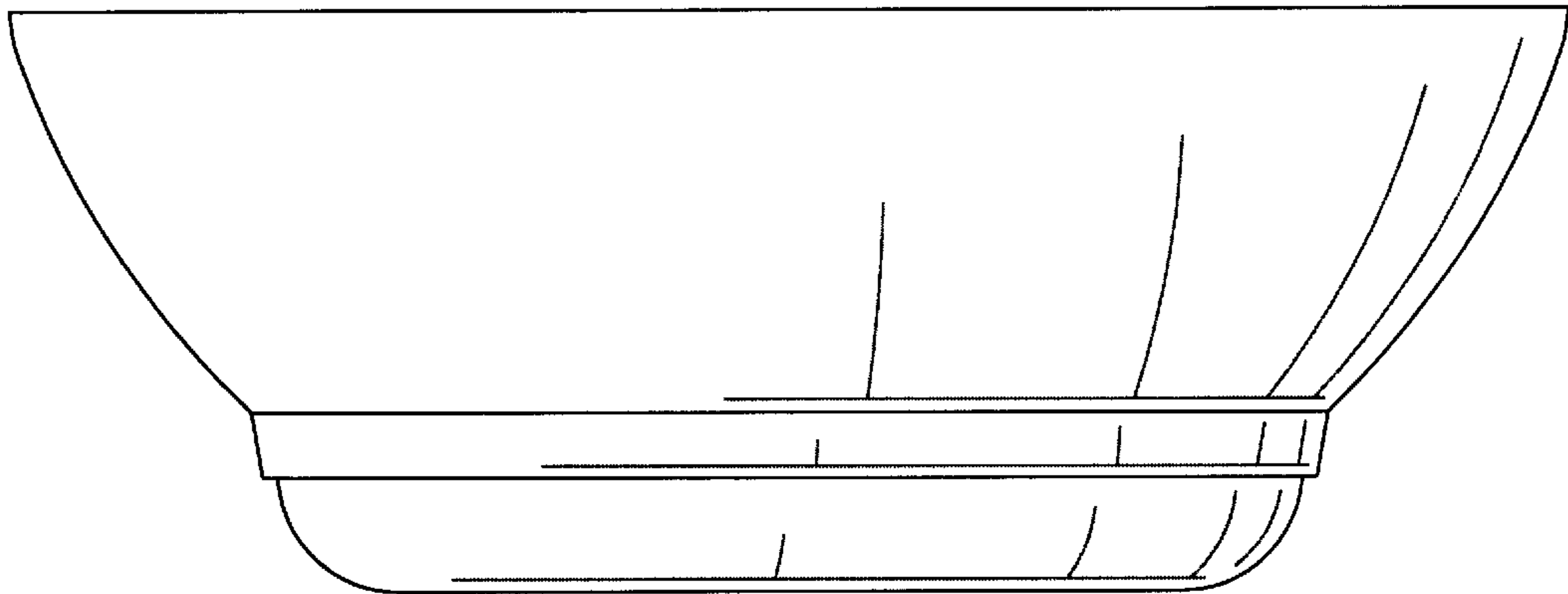

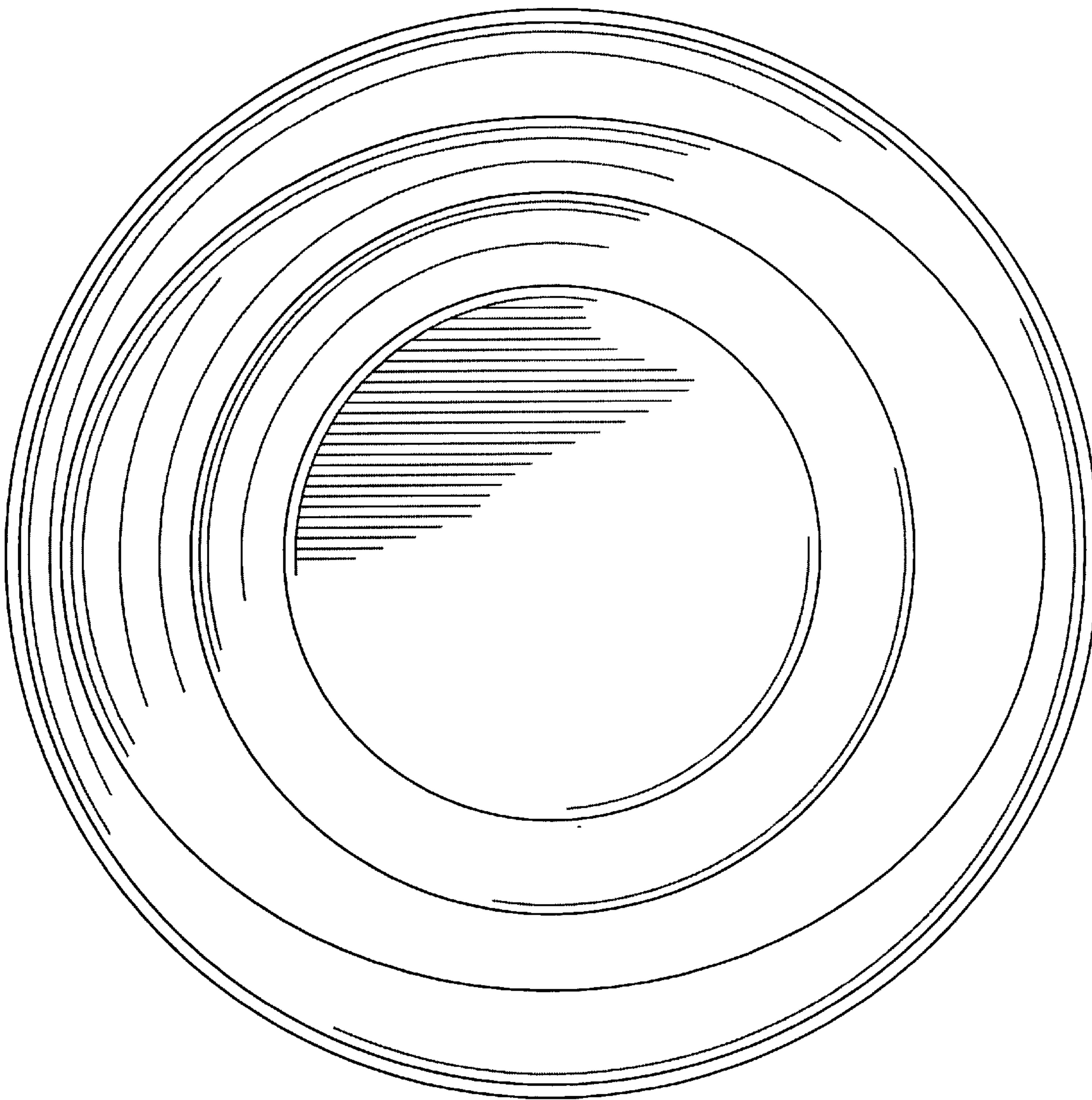

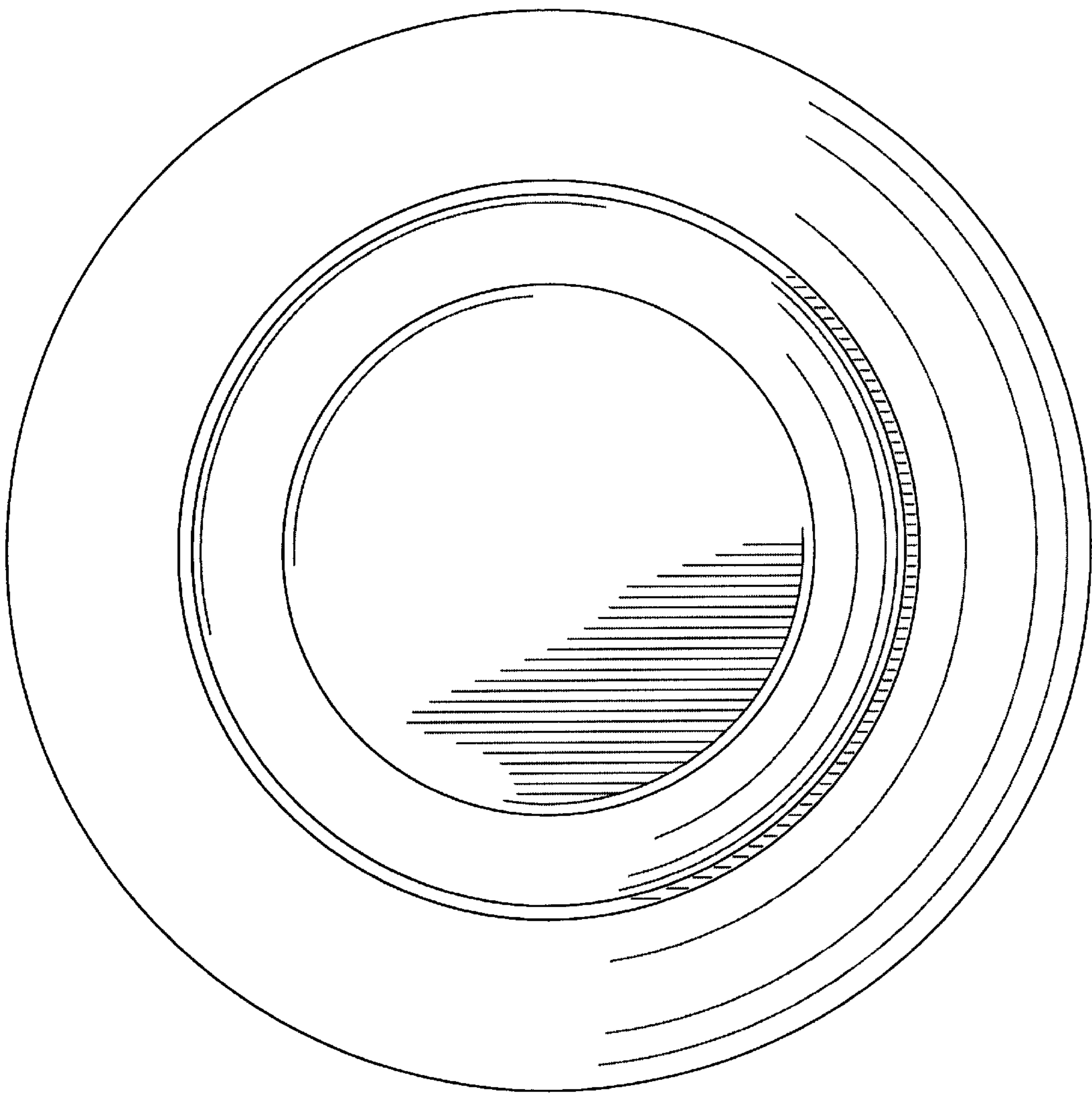

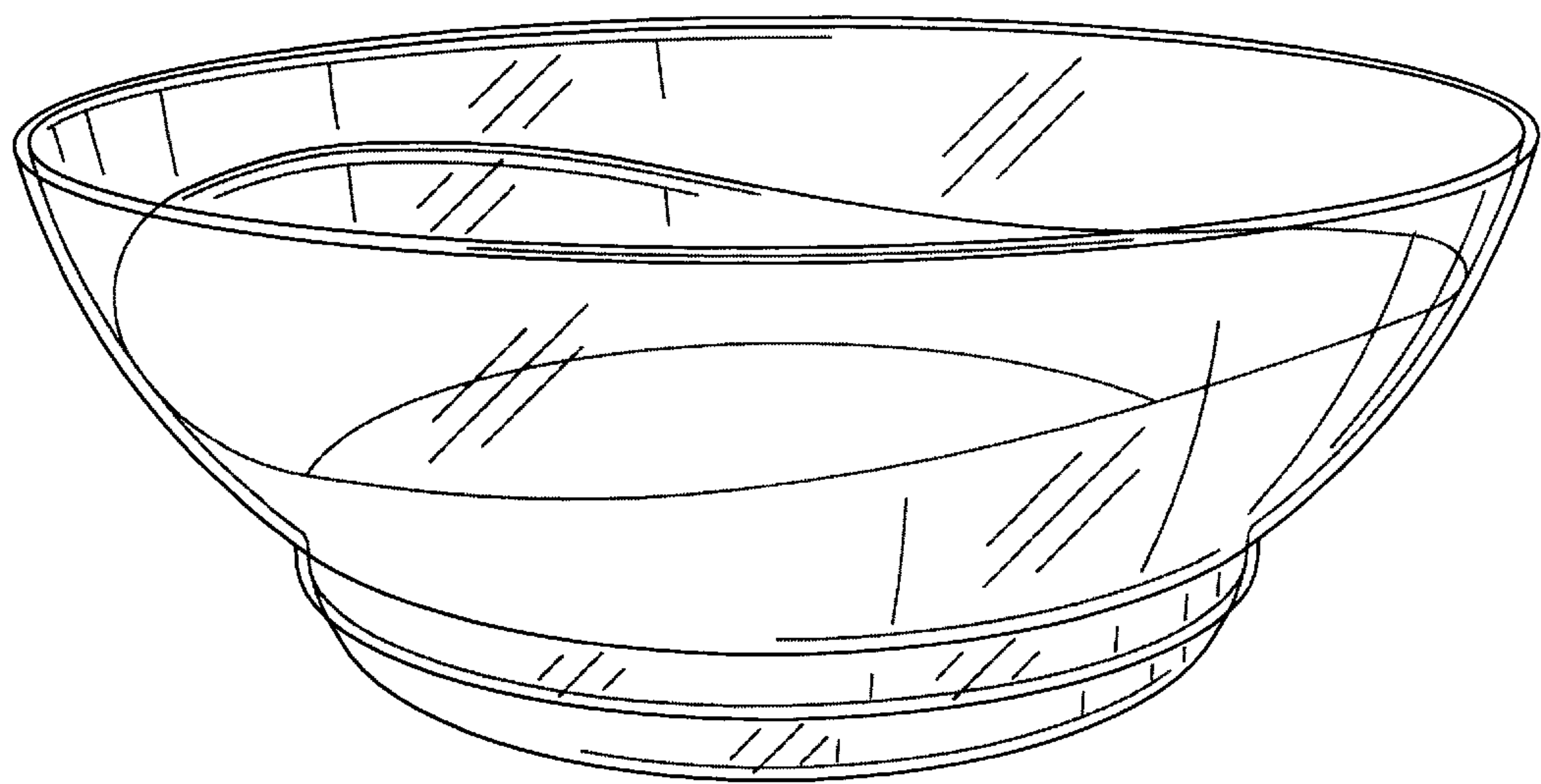

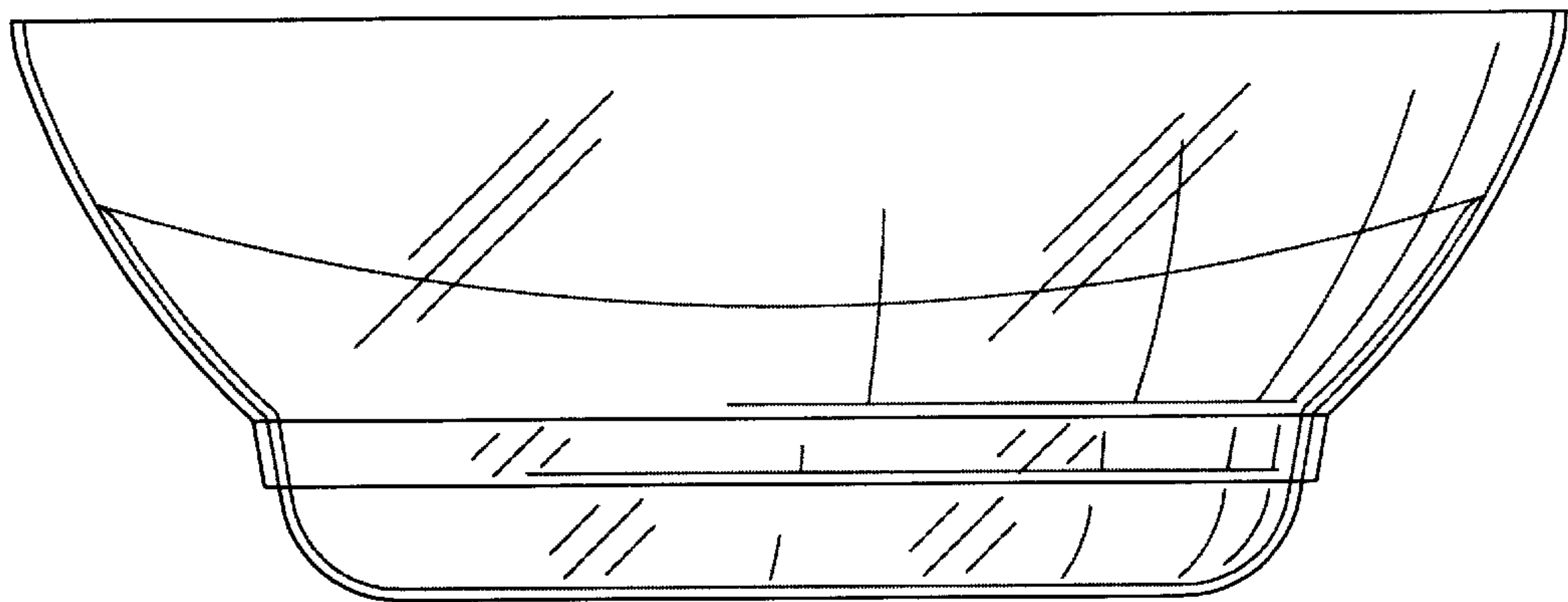

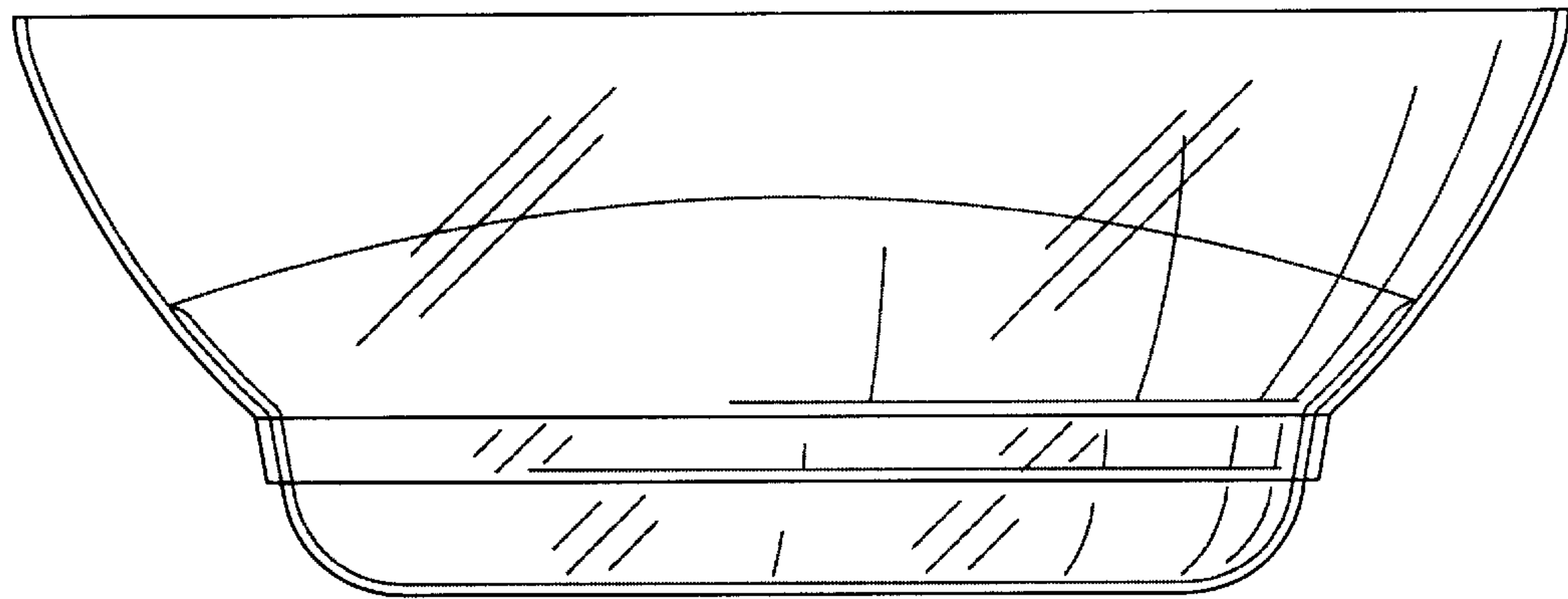

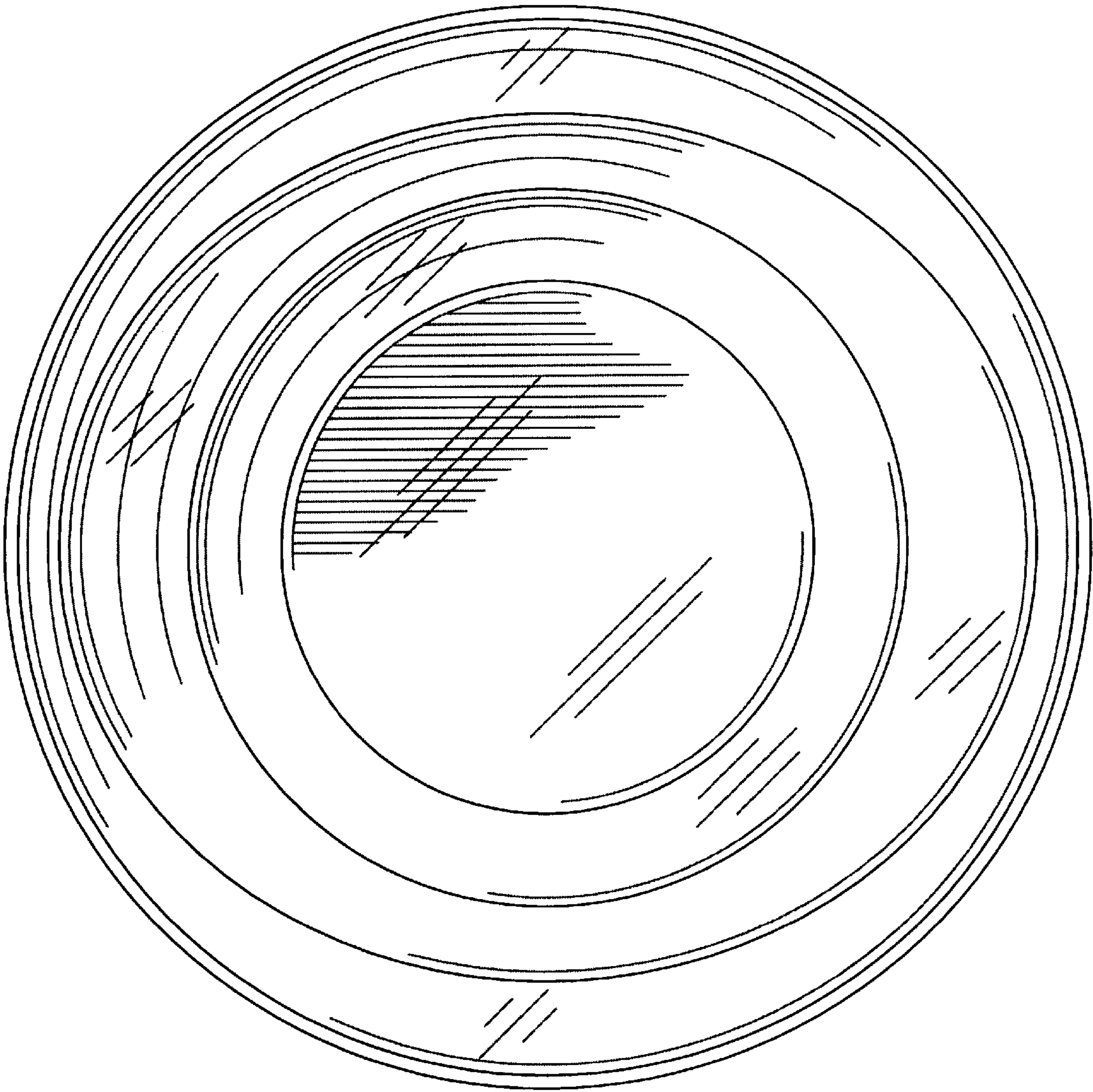

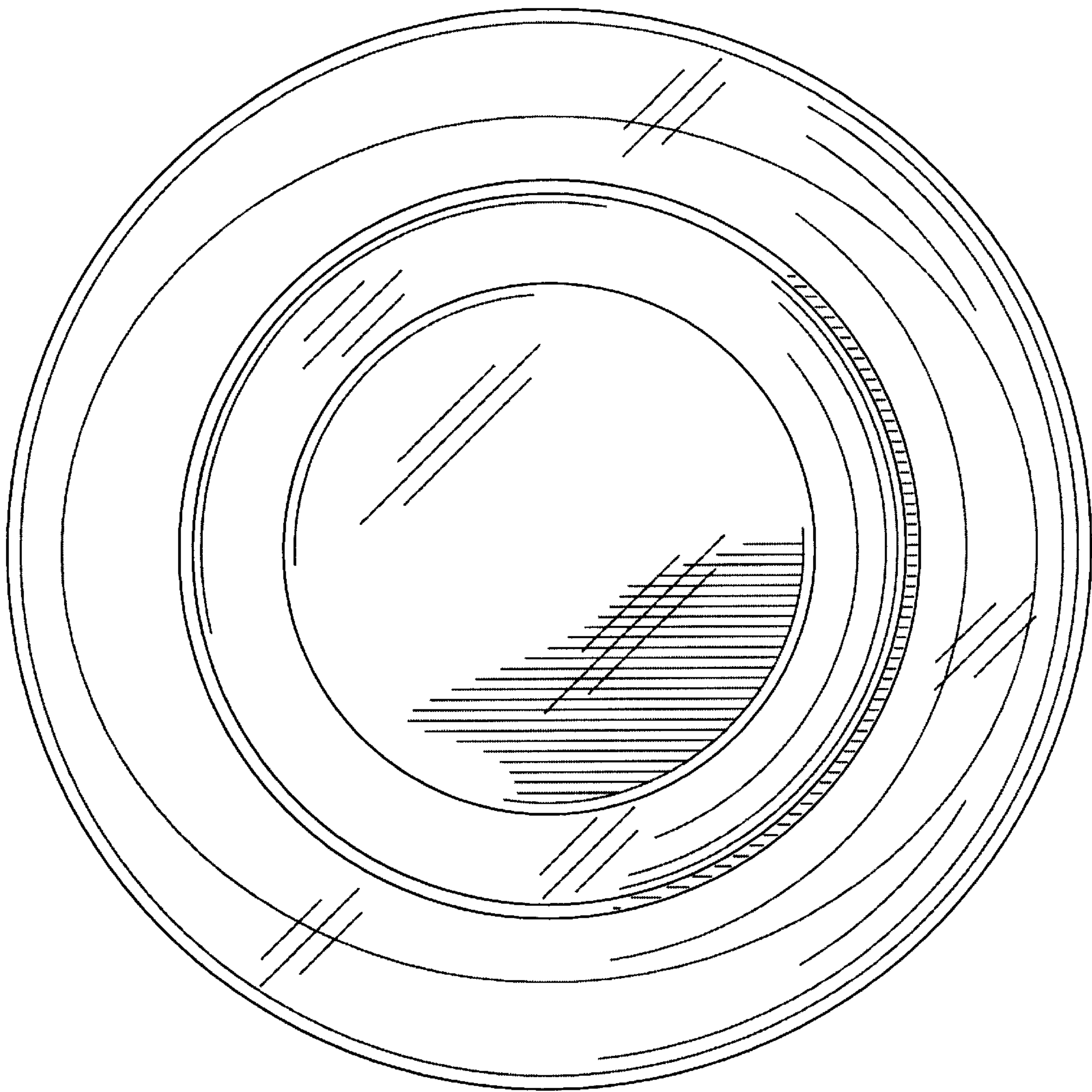
