(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a flexible maintenance-free mesh landscape edging usable with mulch filling, as shown and described herein.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of the first embodiment of the invention.

- FIG. 2 is a top view of the first embodiment.
- FIG. 3 is a left side view of the first embodiment.
- FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the first embodiment, with mulch.
- FIG. 5 is a top view of the first embodiment, with mulch.
- FIG. 6 is a right side view of the first embodiment, unsealed, with mulch.
- FIG. 7 is a right view of the first embodiment, sealed and ready for addition of mulch from opposing end.
- FIG. 8 is a front view of the second embodiment of the invention.
- FIG. 9 is a top view of the second embodiment.
- FIG. 10 is a bottom view of the second embodiment.
- FIG. 11 is a left side view of the second embodiment.
- FIG. 12 is a bottom view of the second embodiment, ready for addition of mulch; and,
- FIG. 13 is a perspective of the second embodiment of the invention, the broken lines showing additional landscape edgings, vegetation, and mulch filling are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.
