with the outer shell open; and,

FIG. 5 is a front elevation view thereof as worn by a user  
with the outer shell closed.

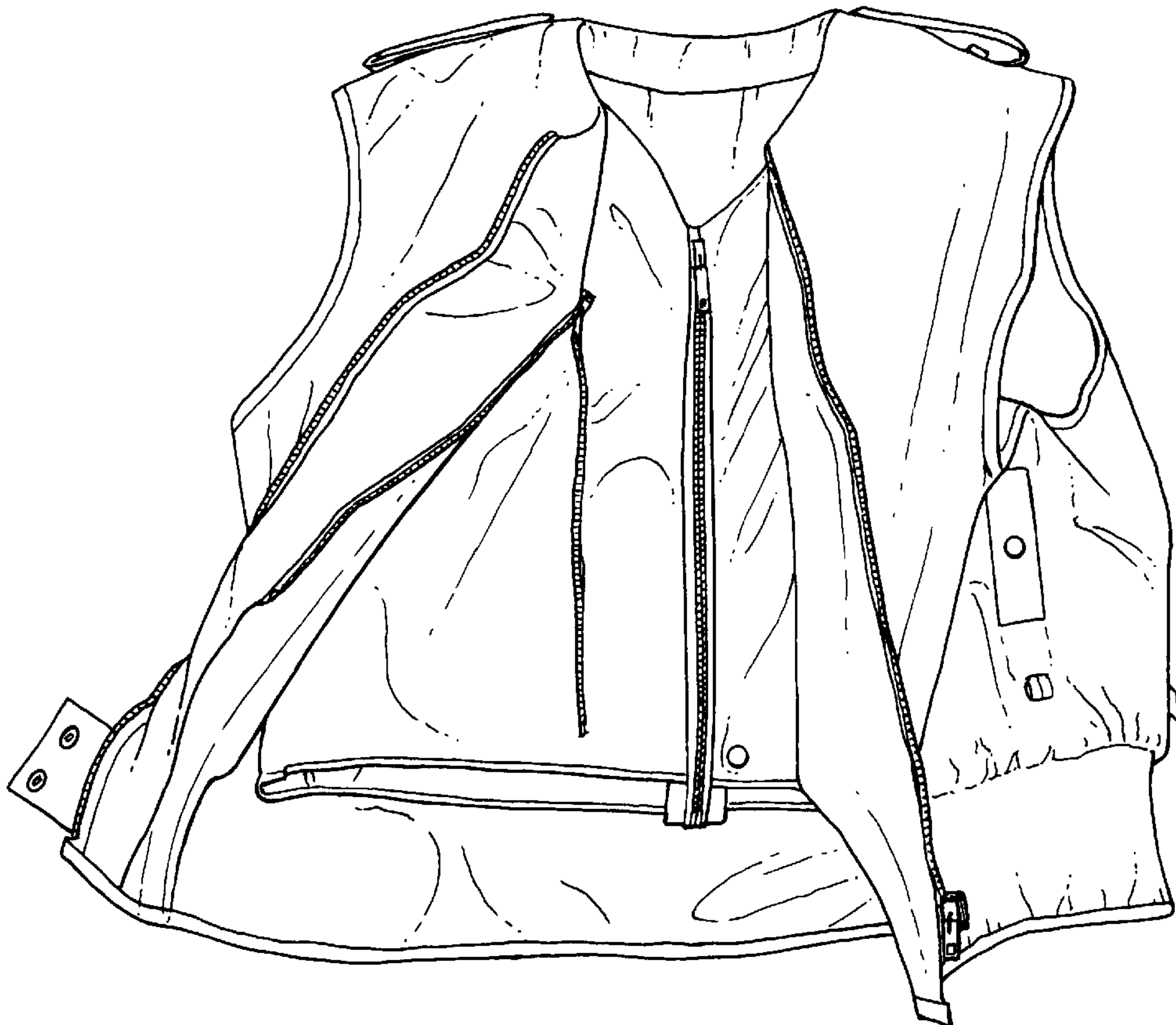

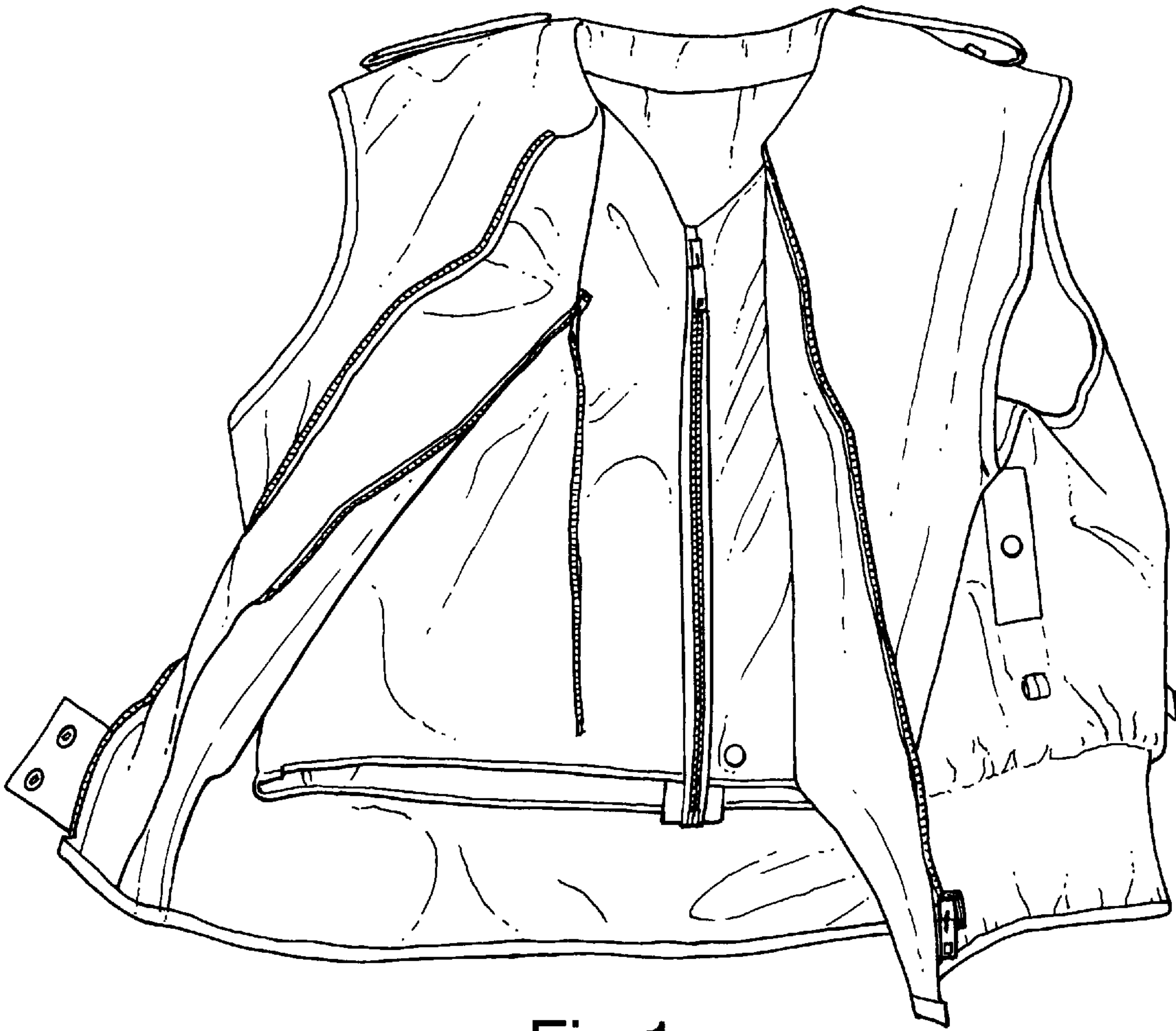

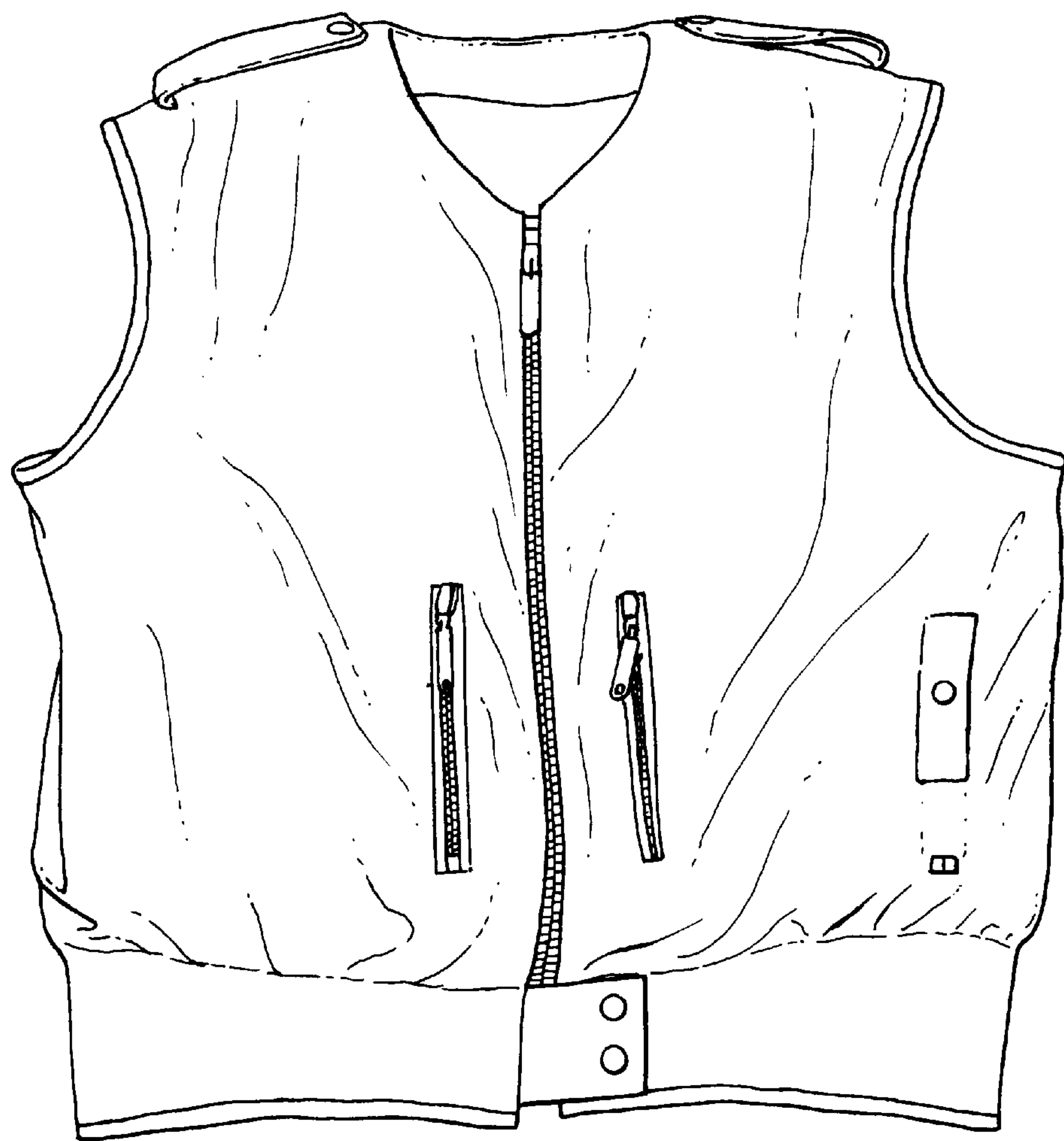

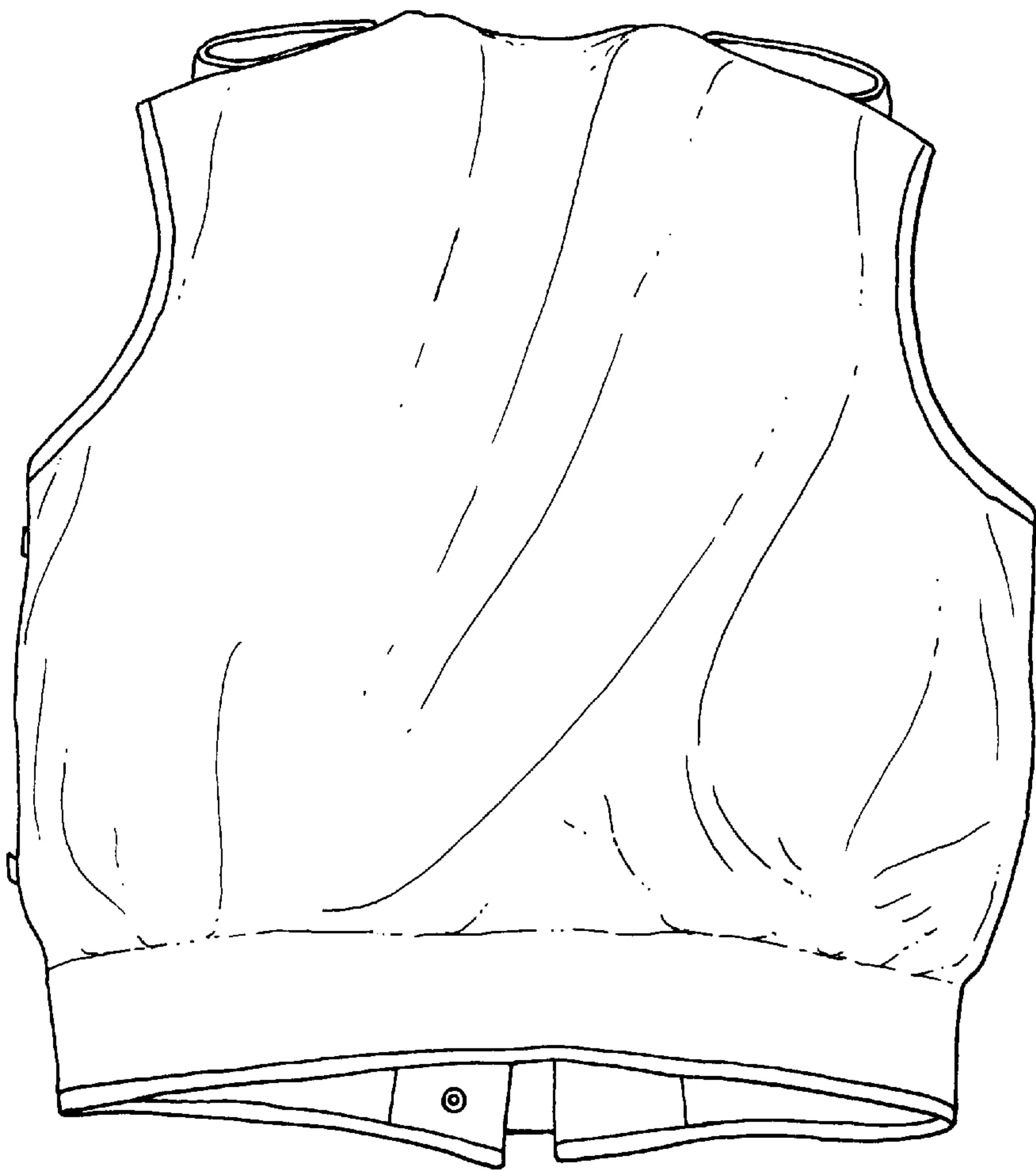

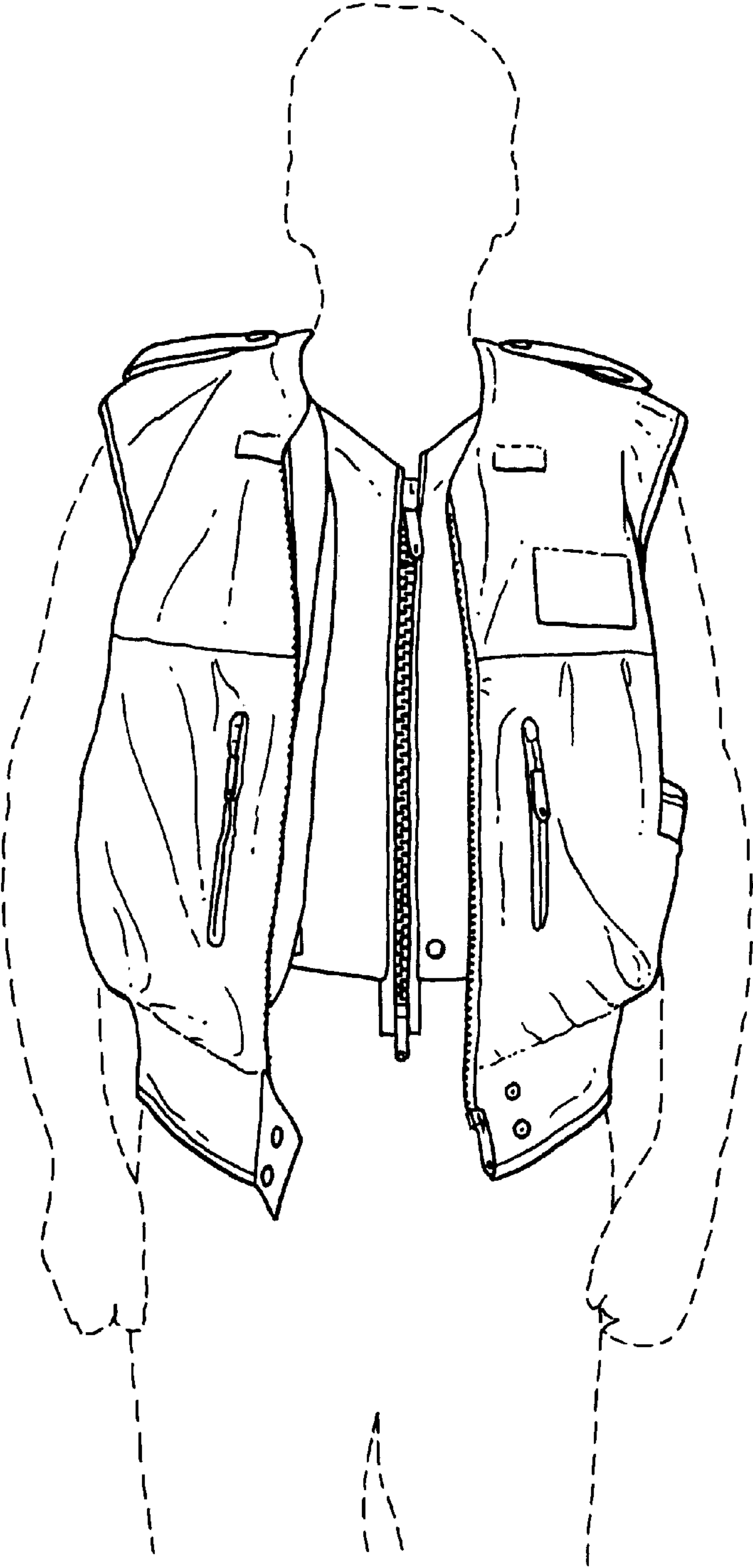

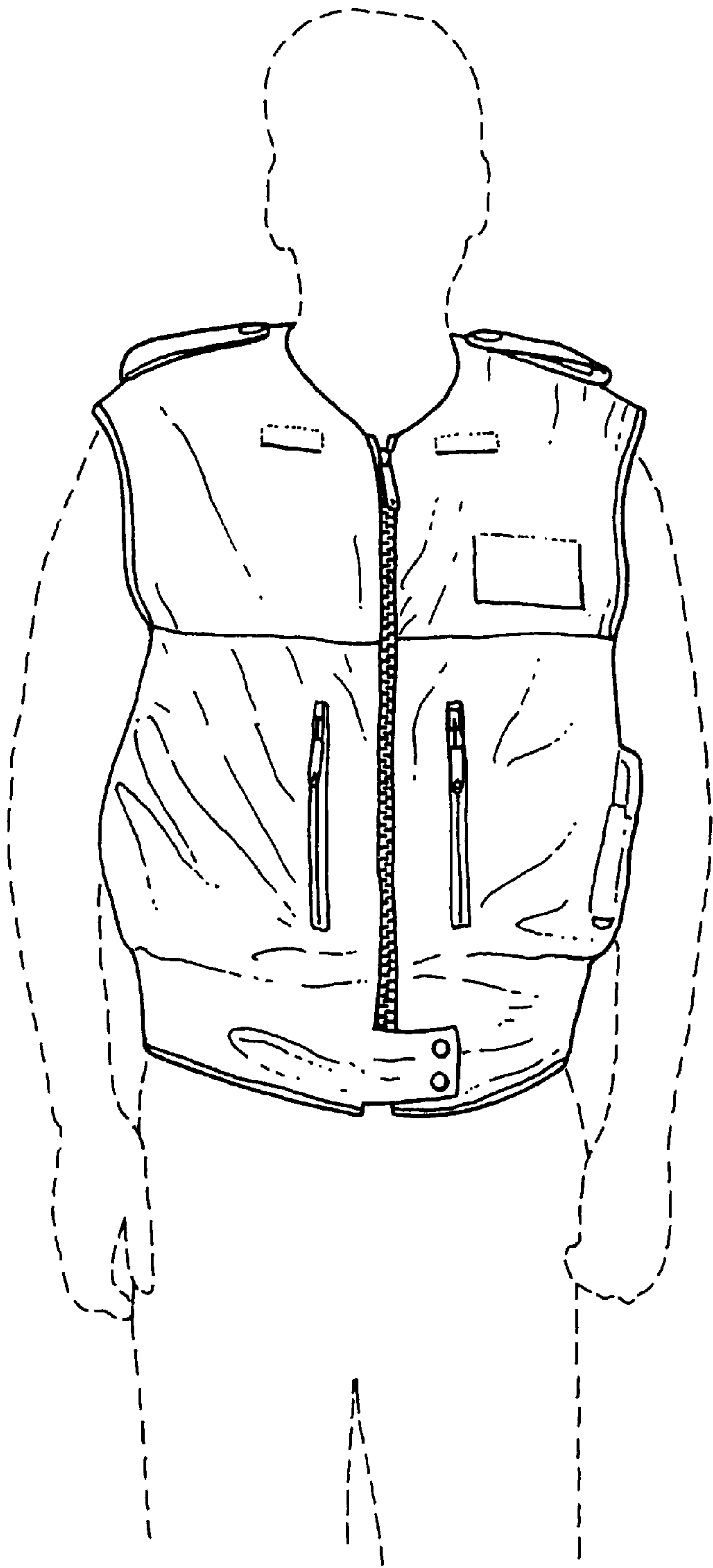
