FIG. 5 is a bottom view of our insulated food container design.

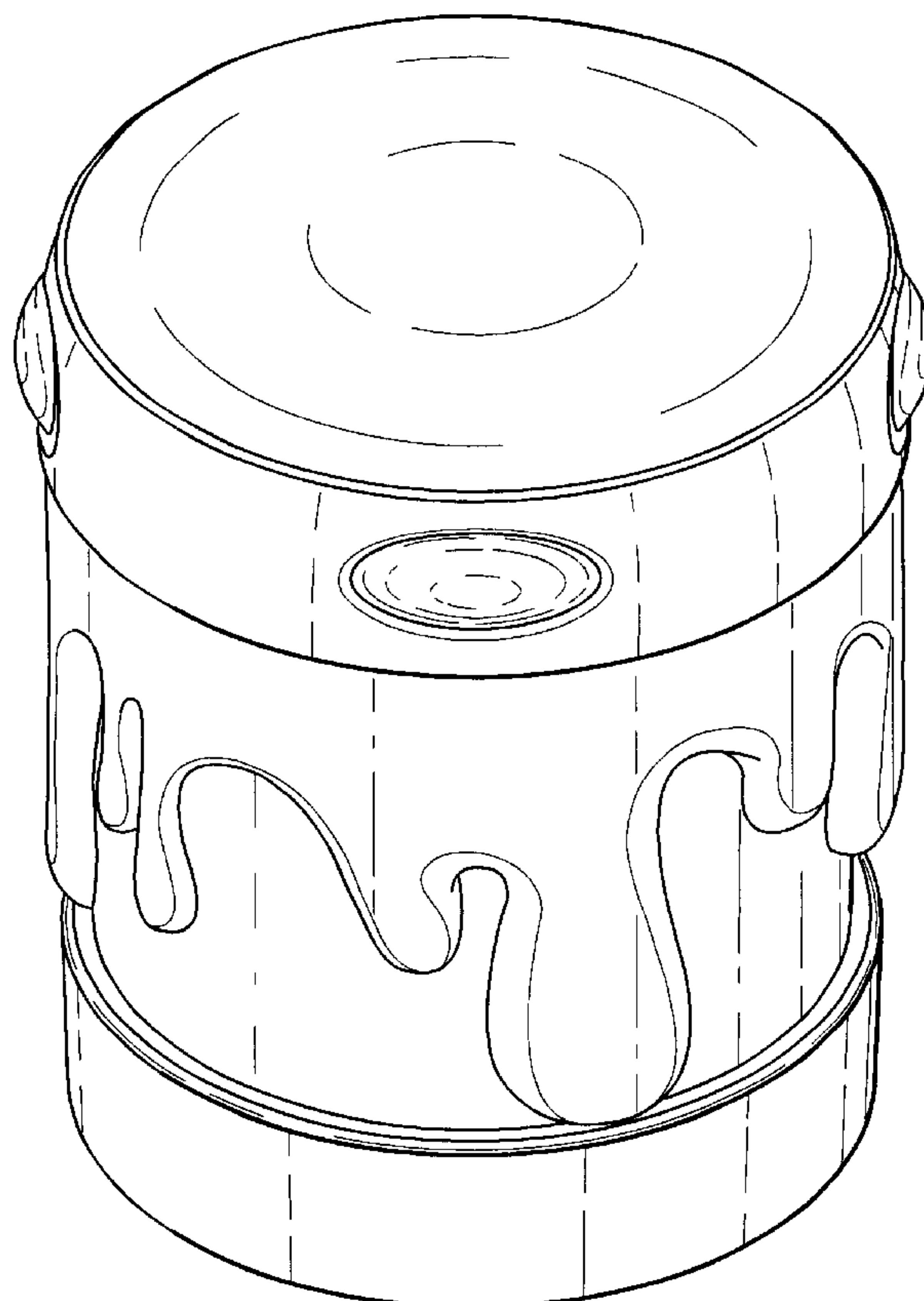

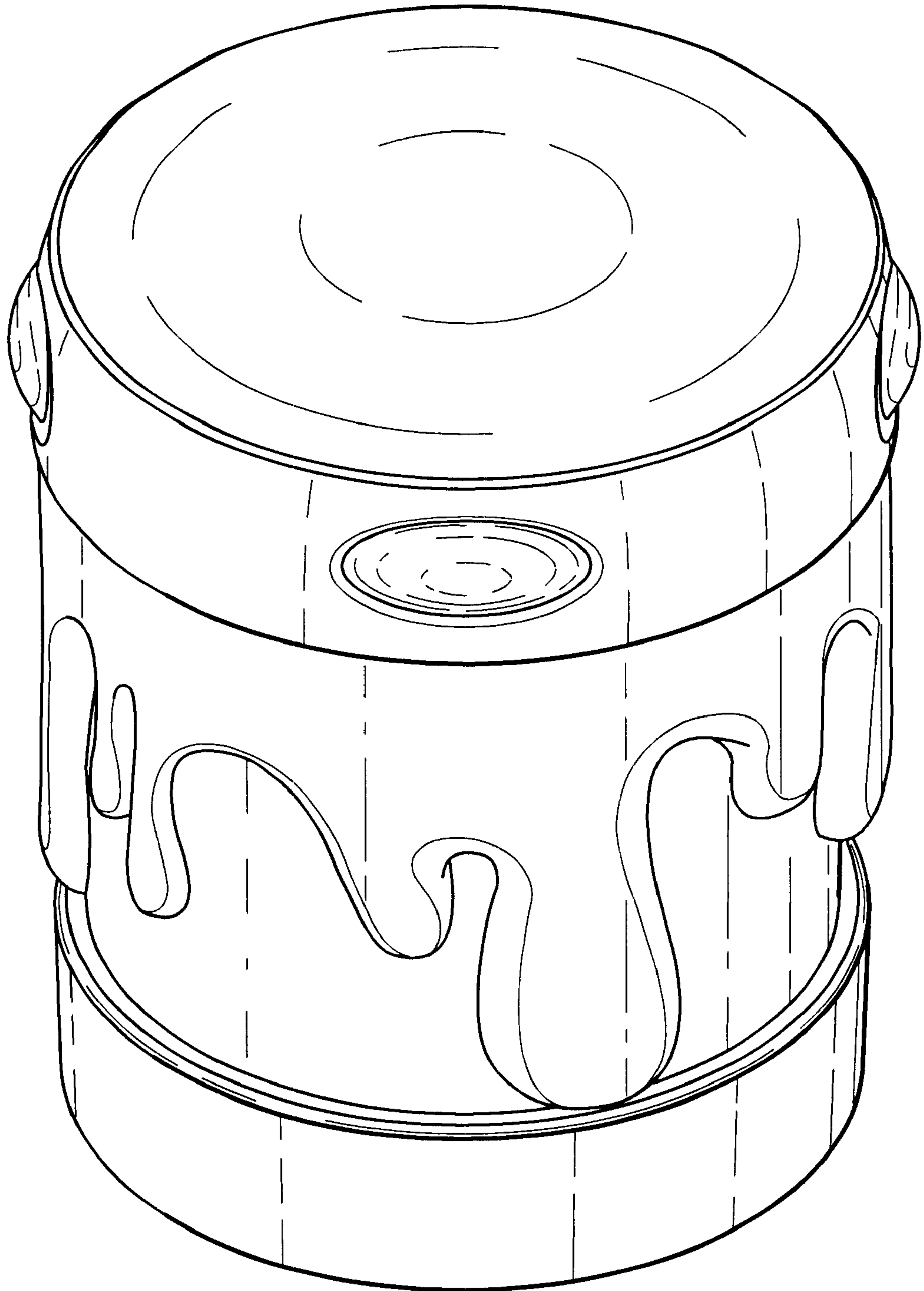

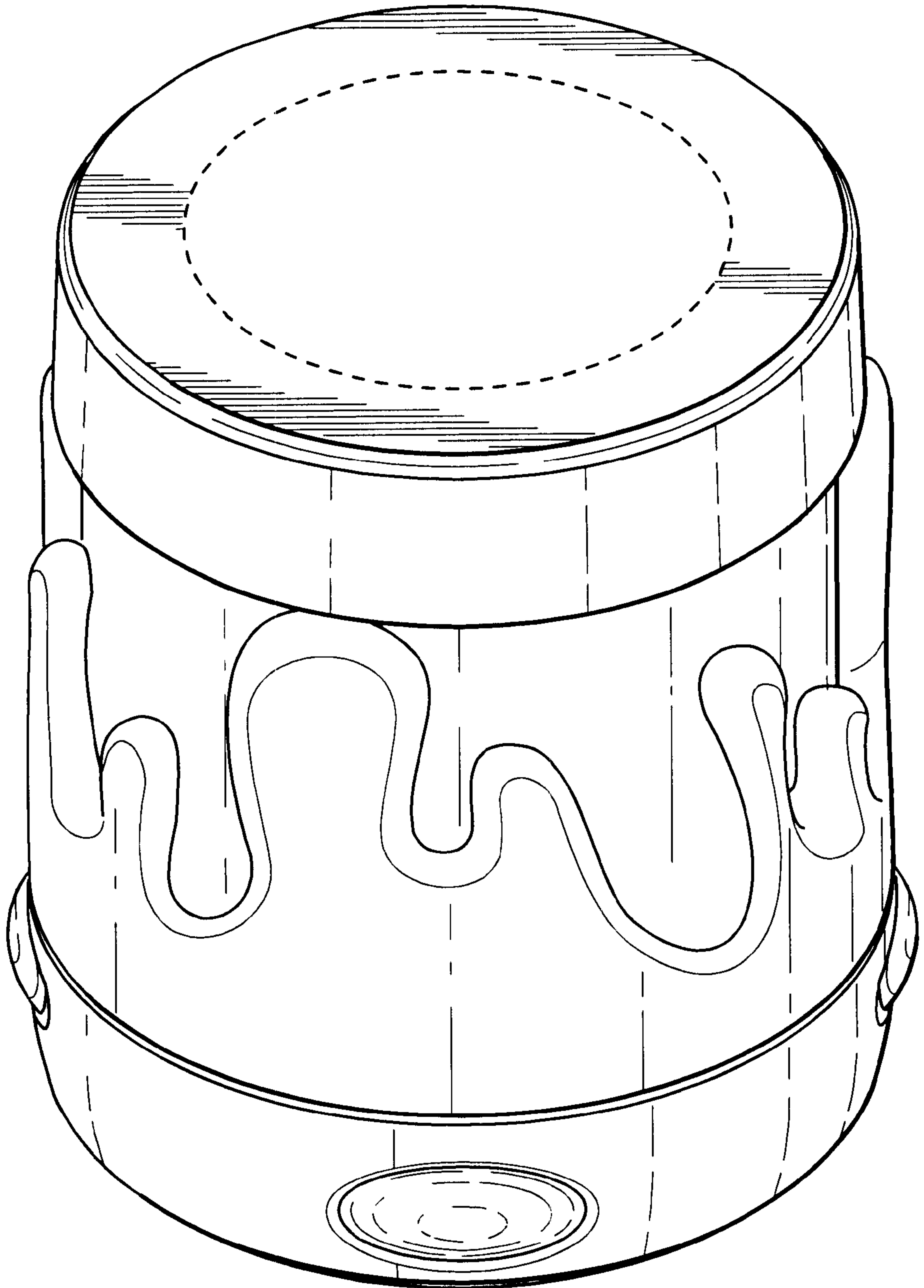

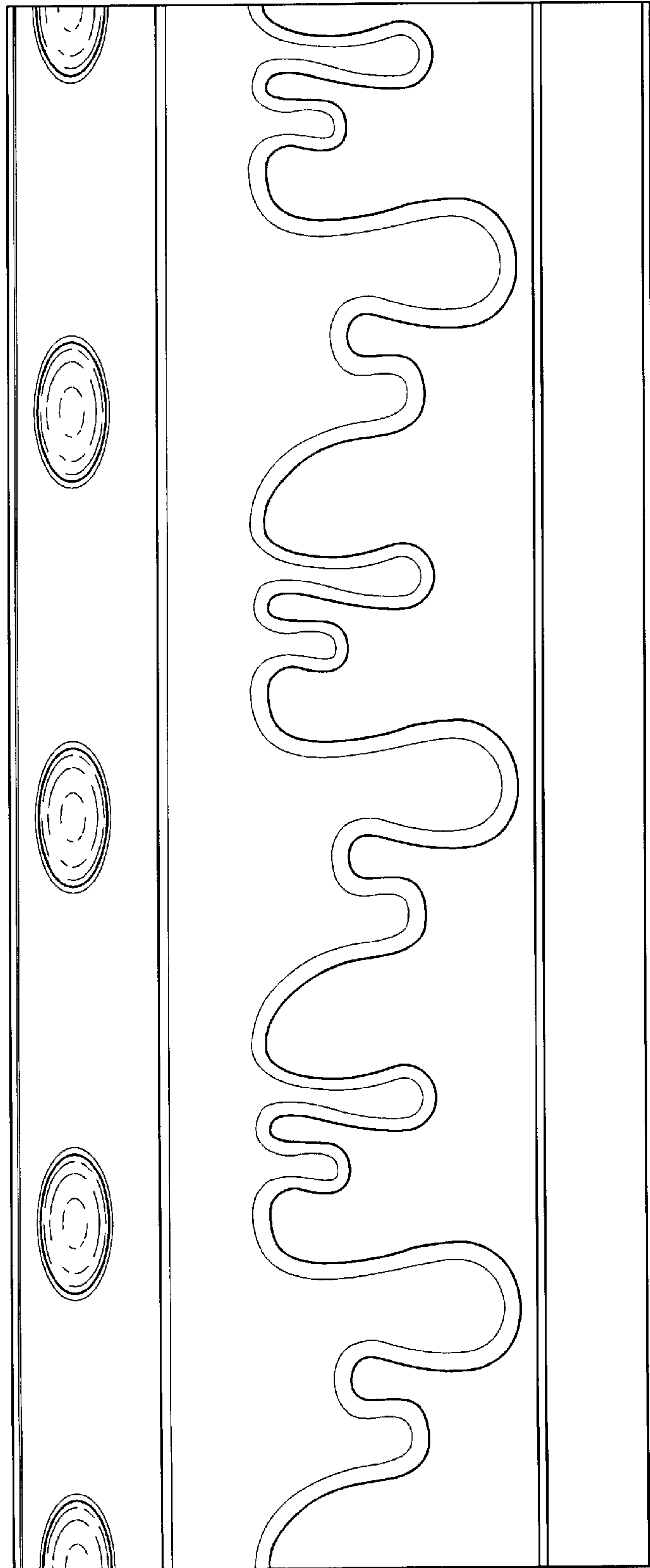

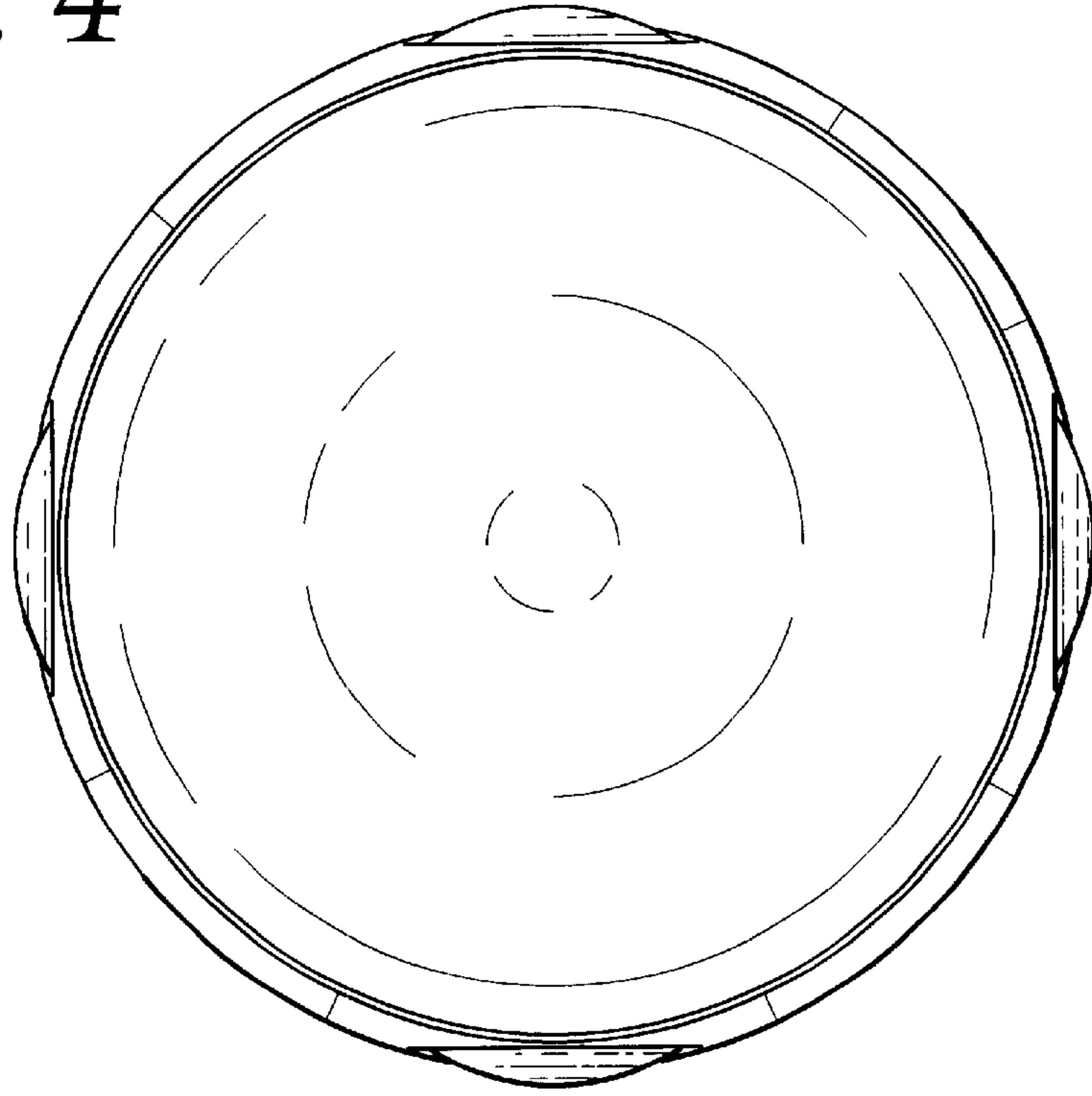
