# (57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combination chairmat and footrest, as shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a first embodiment of a combination chairmat and footrest of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a perspective view, looking at the top from the front of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a rear view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a first side elevational view of FIG. 1; the other side elevational view being a mirror image of this first side elevational view;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of a combination chairmat and footrest having a hinge joint therein;

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is a perspective view, looking at the top from the front of FIG. 7;

FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 11 is a front elevational view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 12 is a first side elevational view of FIG. 7; the other side elevational view being a mirror image of this first side elevational view;

FIG. 13 is a top plan view of a third embodiment of a combination chairmat and footrest having two hinge joints therein;

FIG. 14 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 13;

FIG. 15 is a perspective view, looking at the top from the front of FIG. 13;

FIG. 16 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 13;

FIG. 17 is a front elevational view of FIG. 14; and,

FIG. 18 is a first side elevational view of FIG. 13; the other side elevation view being a mirror image of this first side elevational view.
