fan.

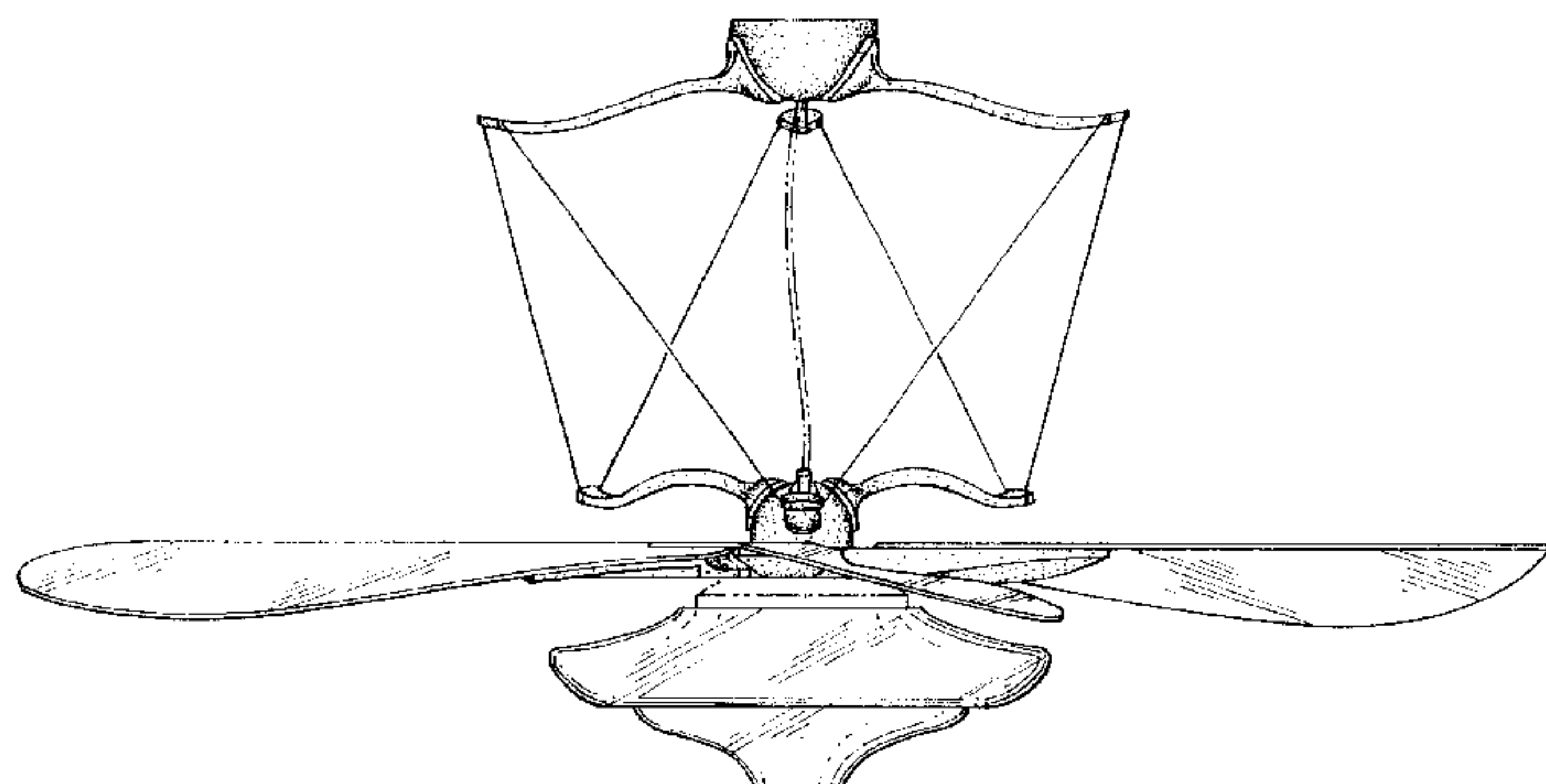
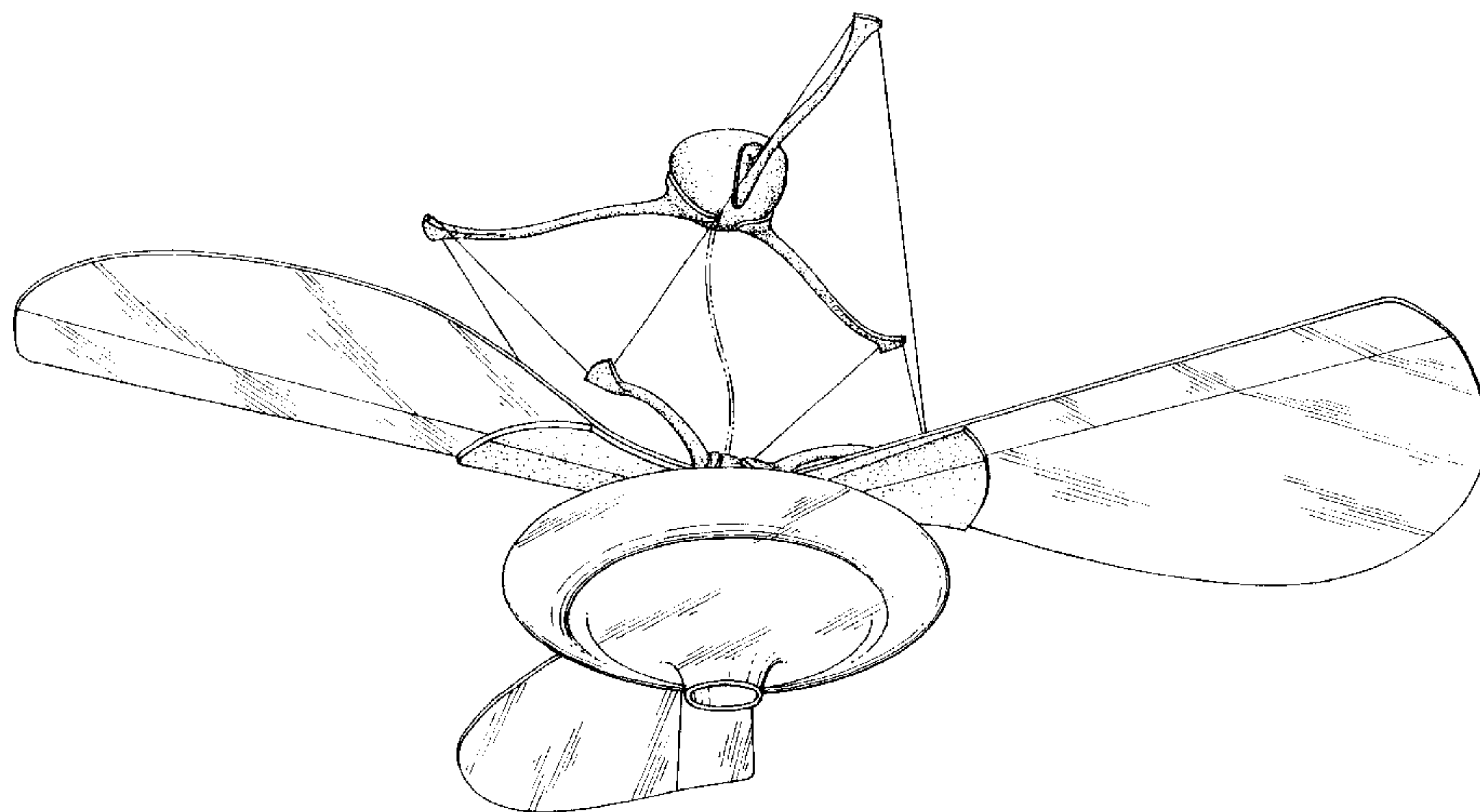
The top and bottom views of the second embodiment shown

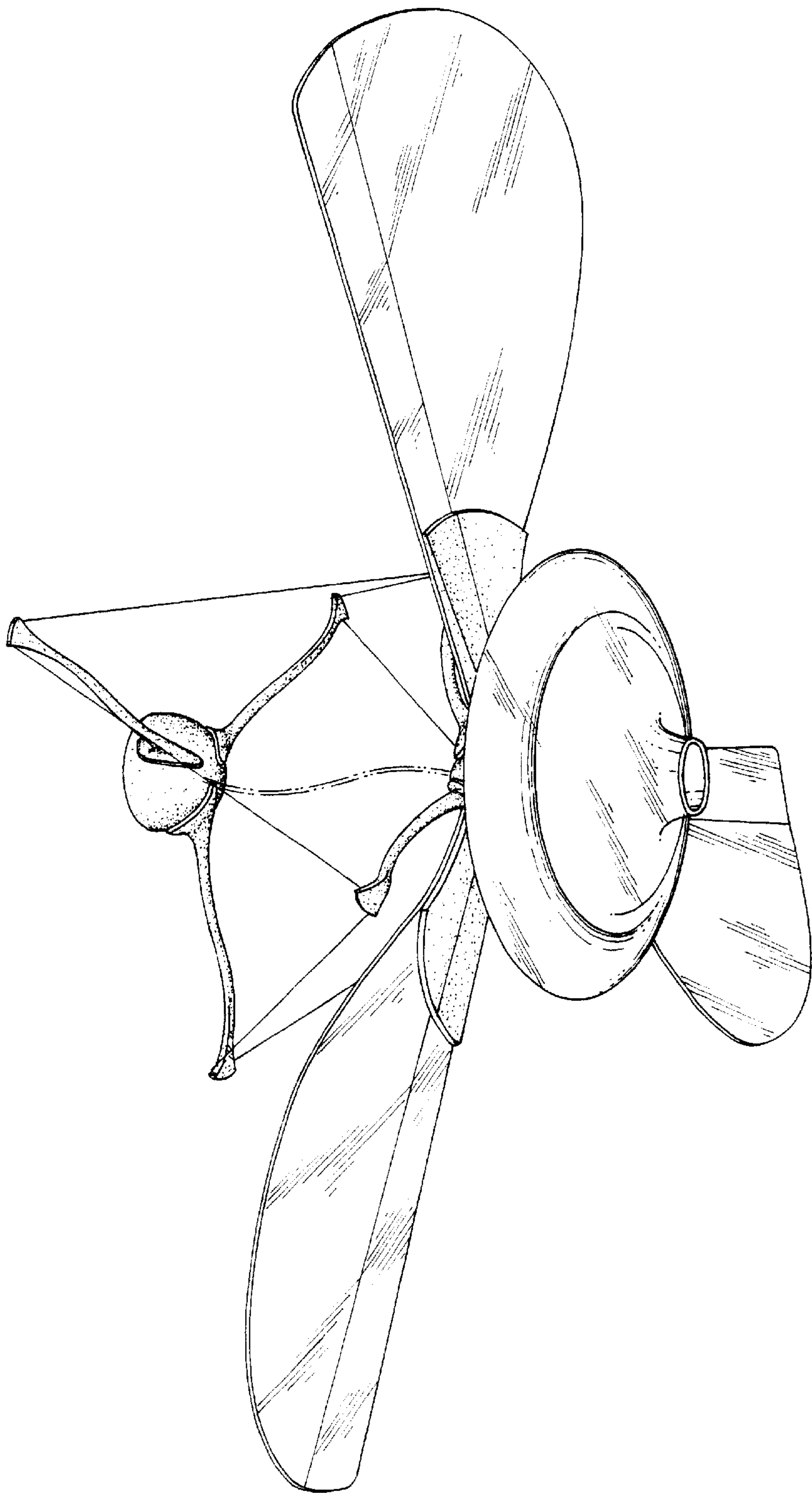

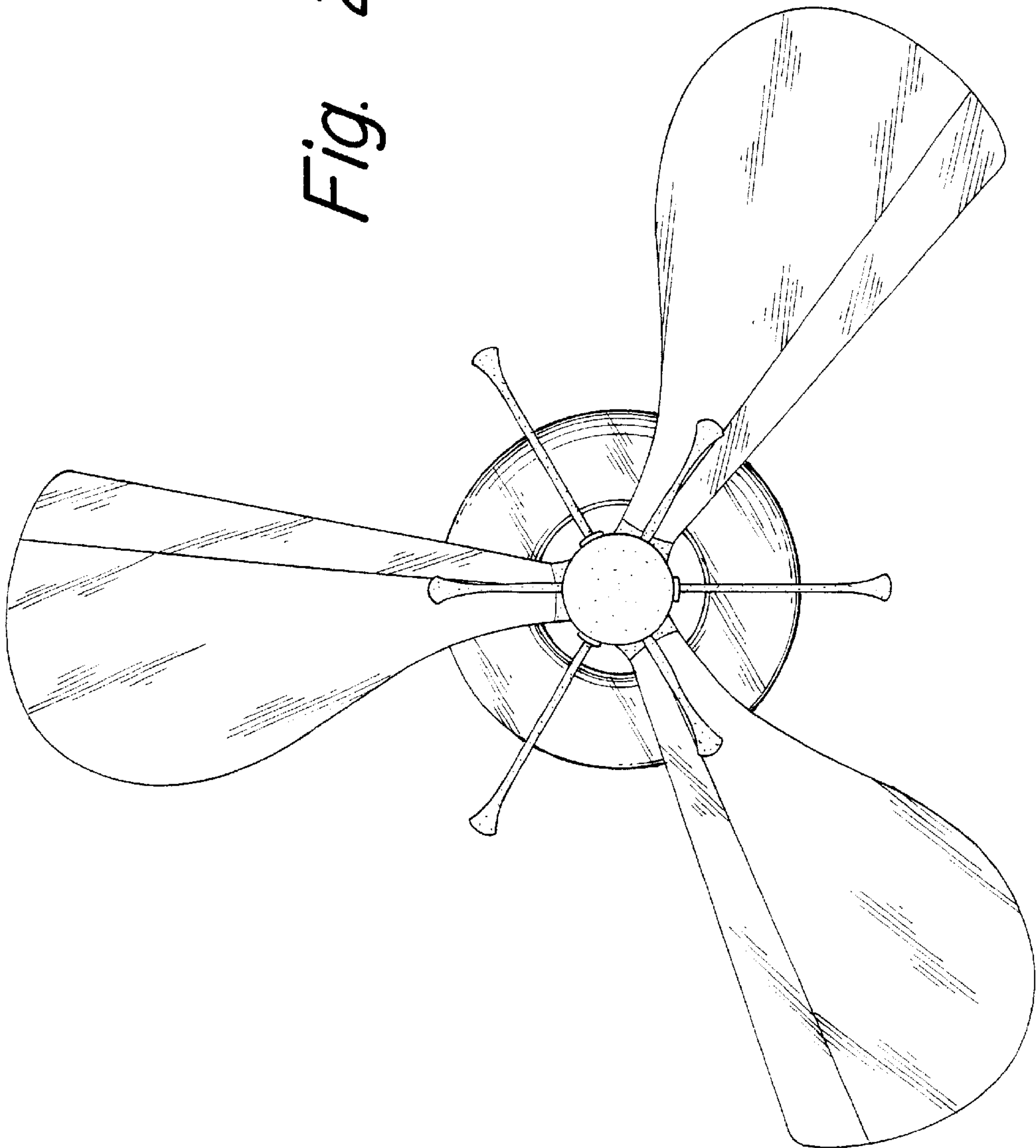
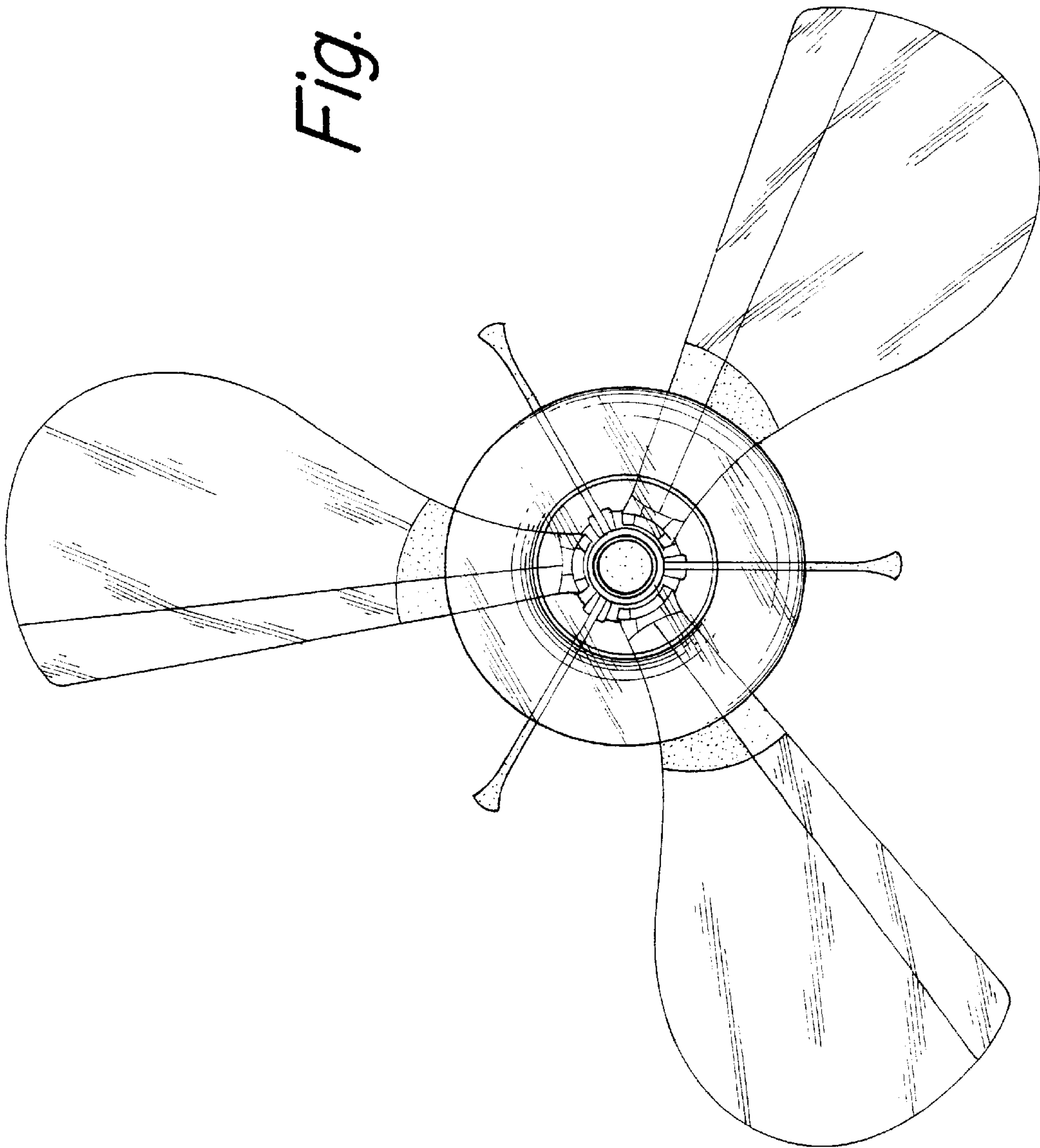

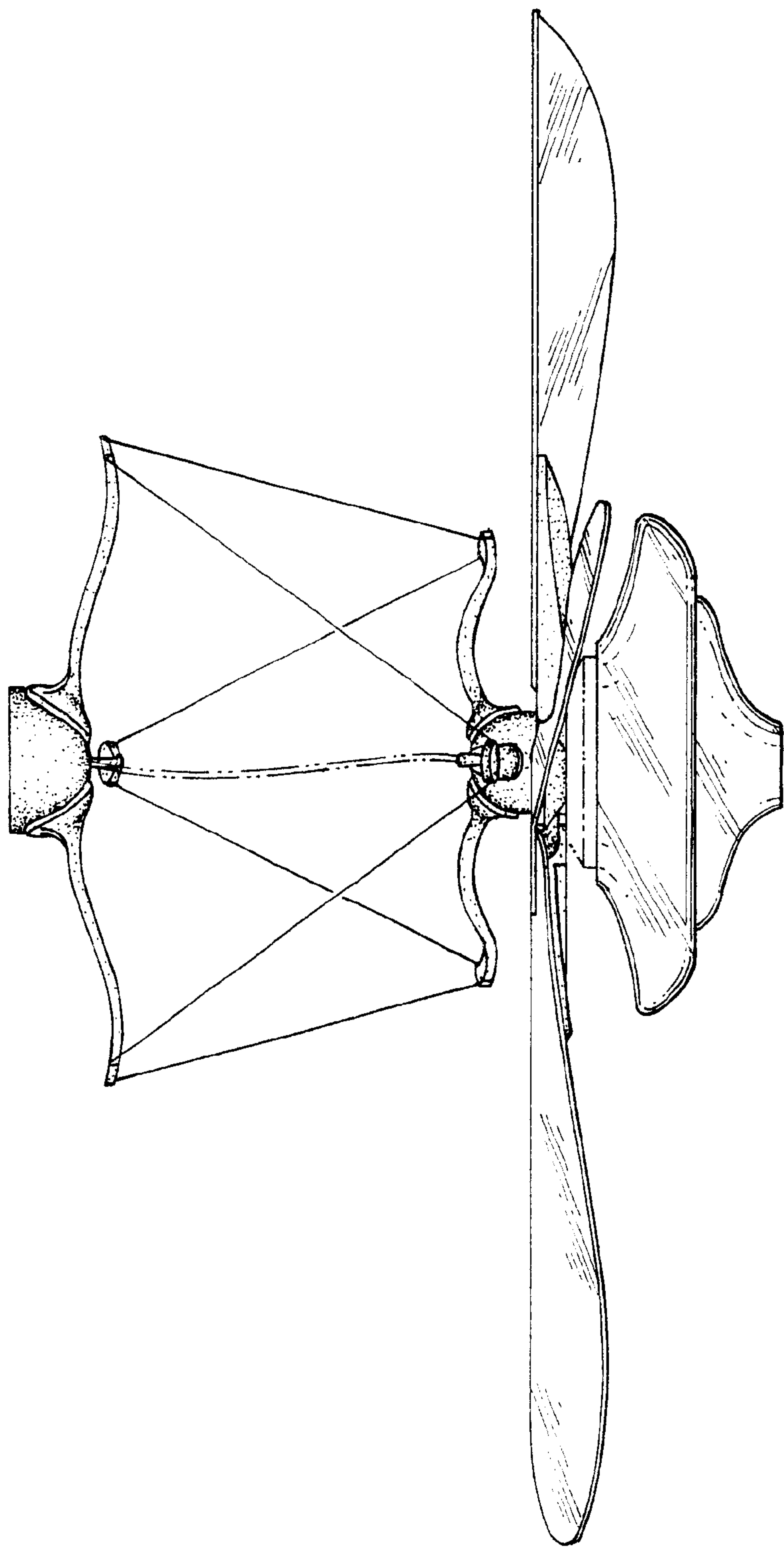

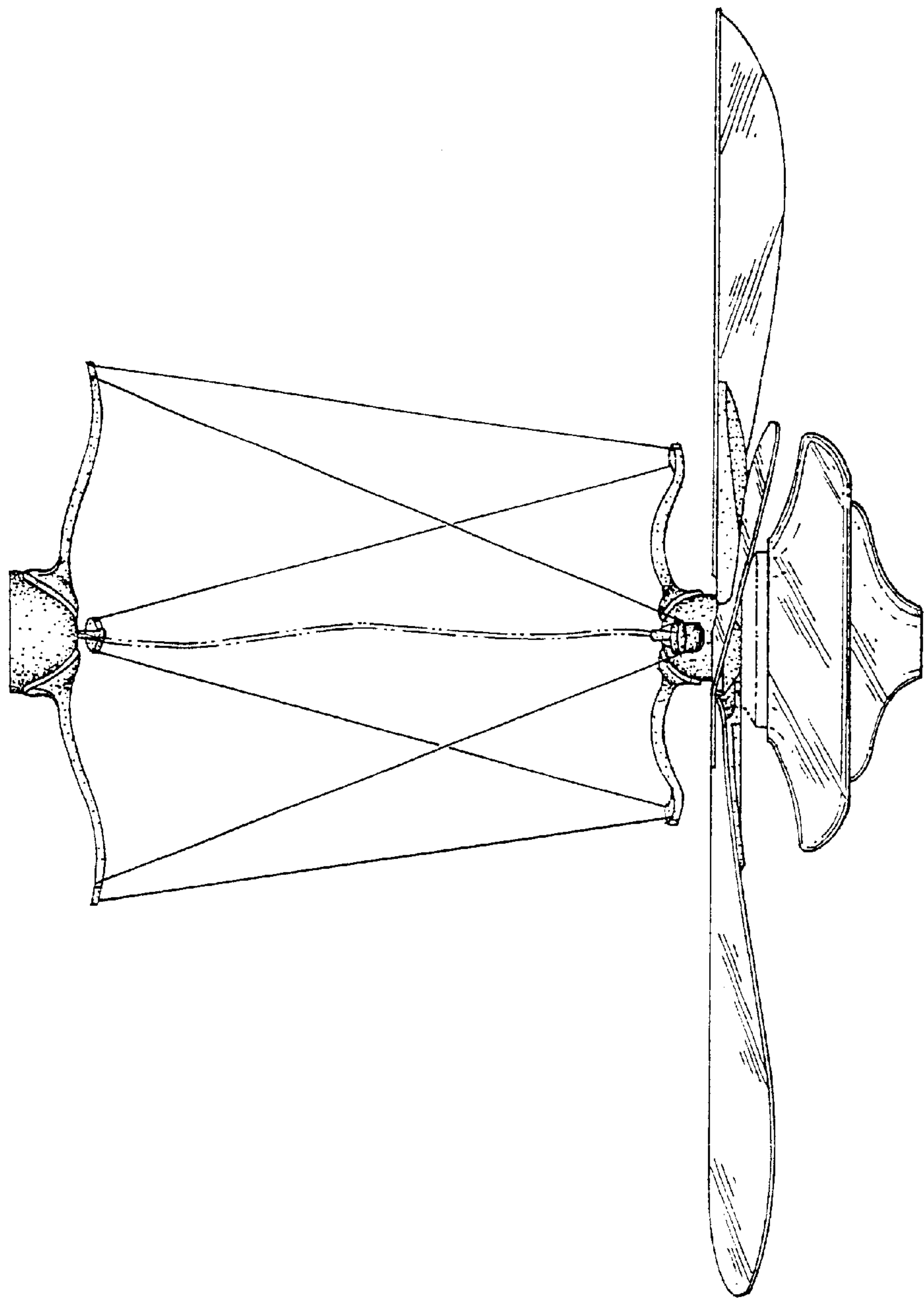
