FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof,

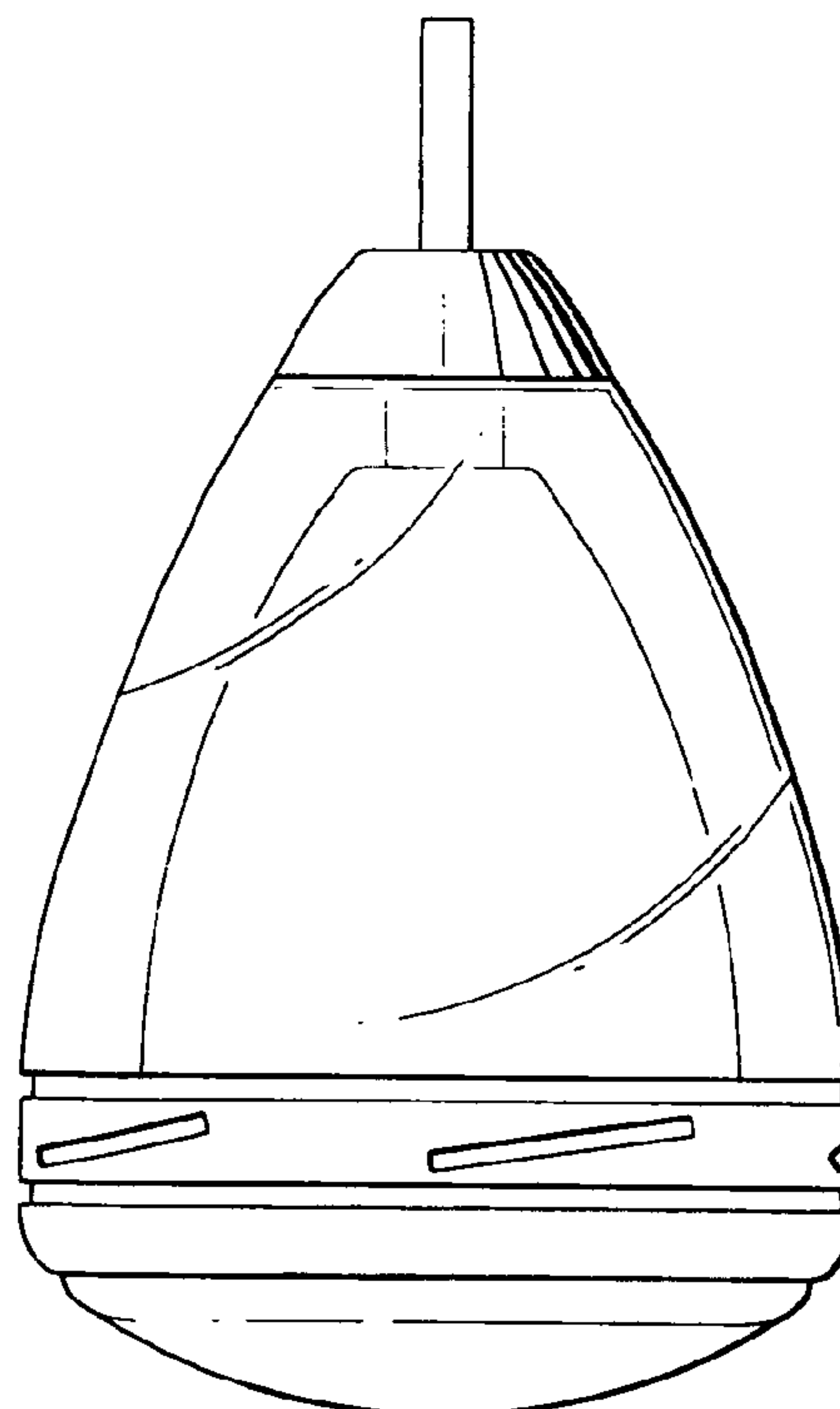
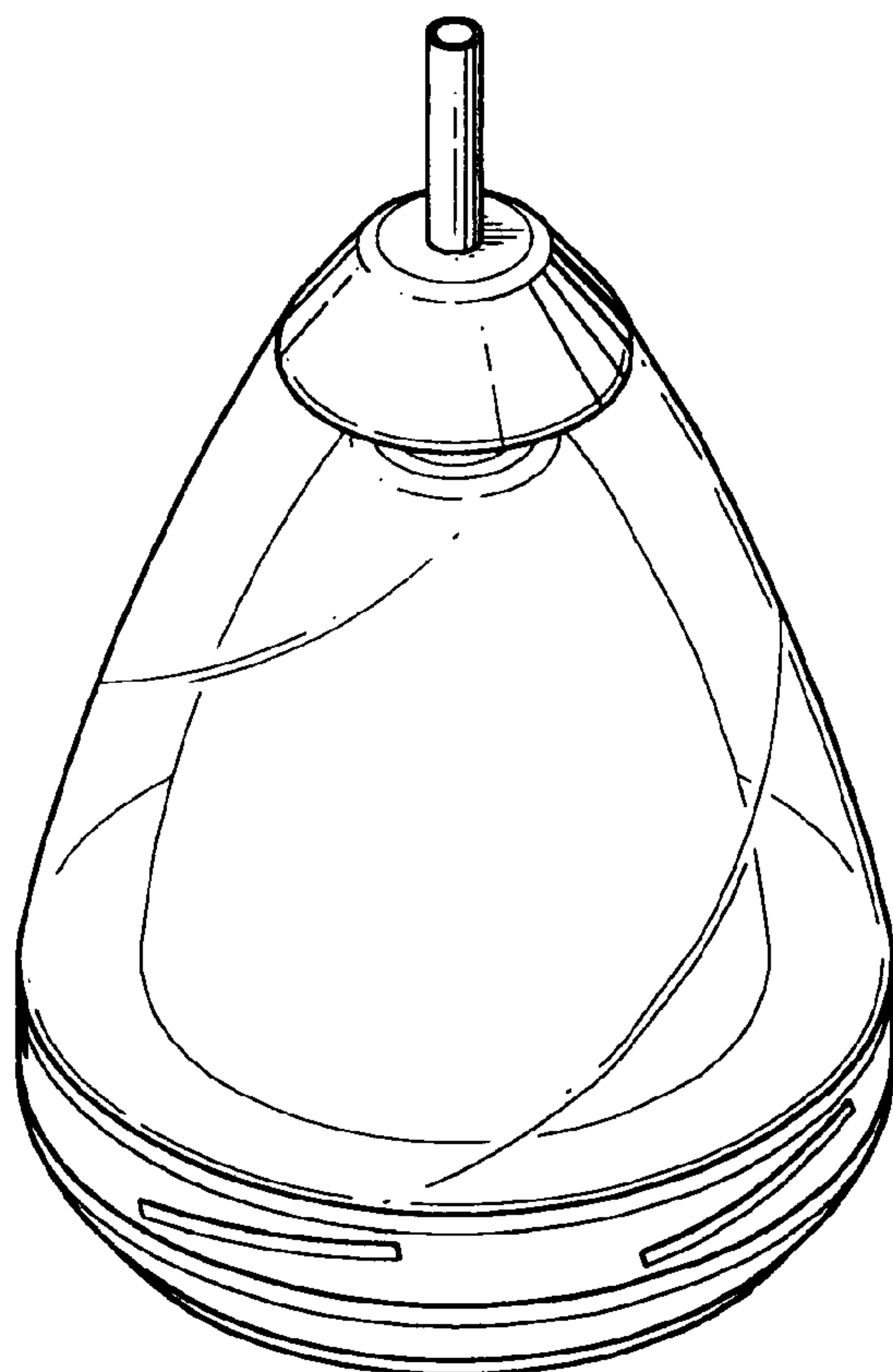
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and

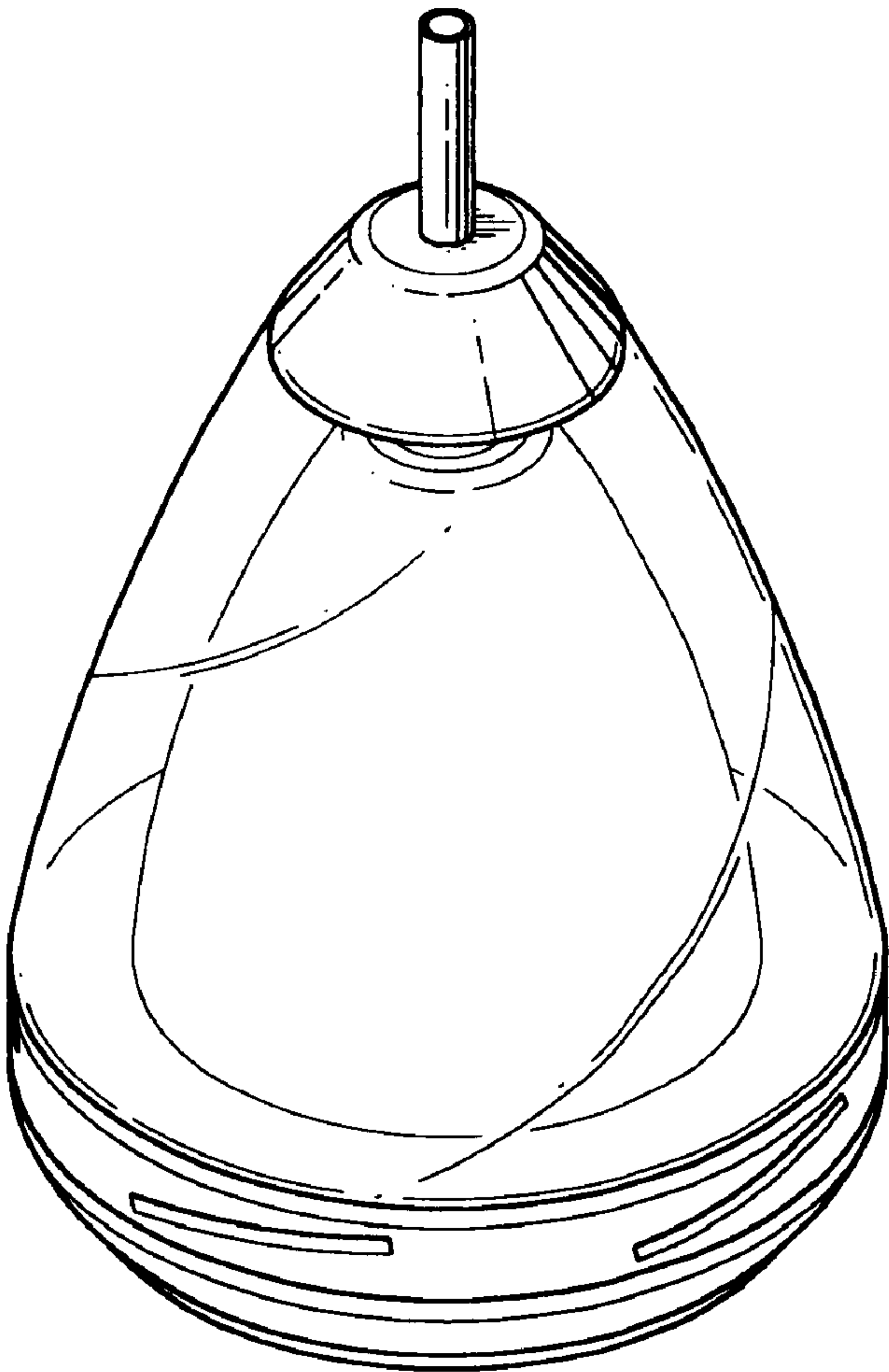
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view to that shown.

purposes only and form no part of the claimed design; and,

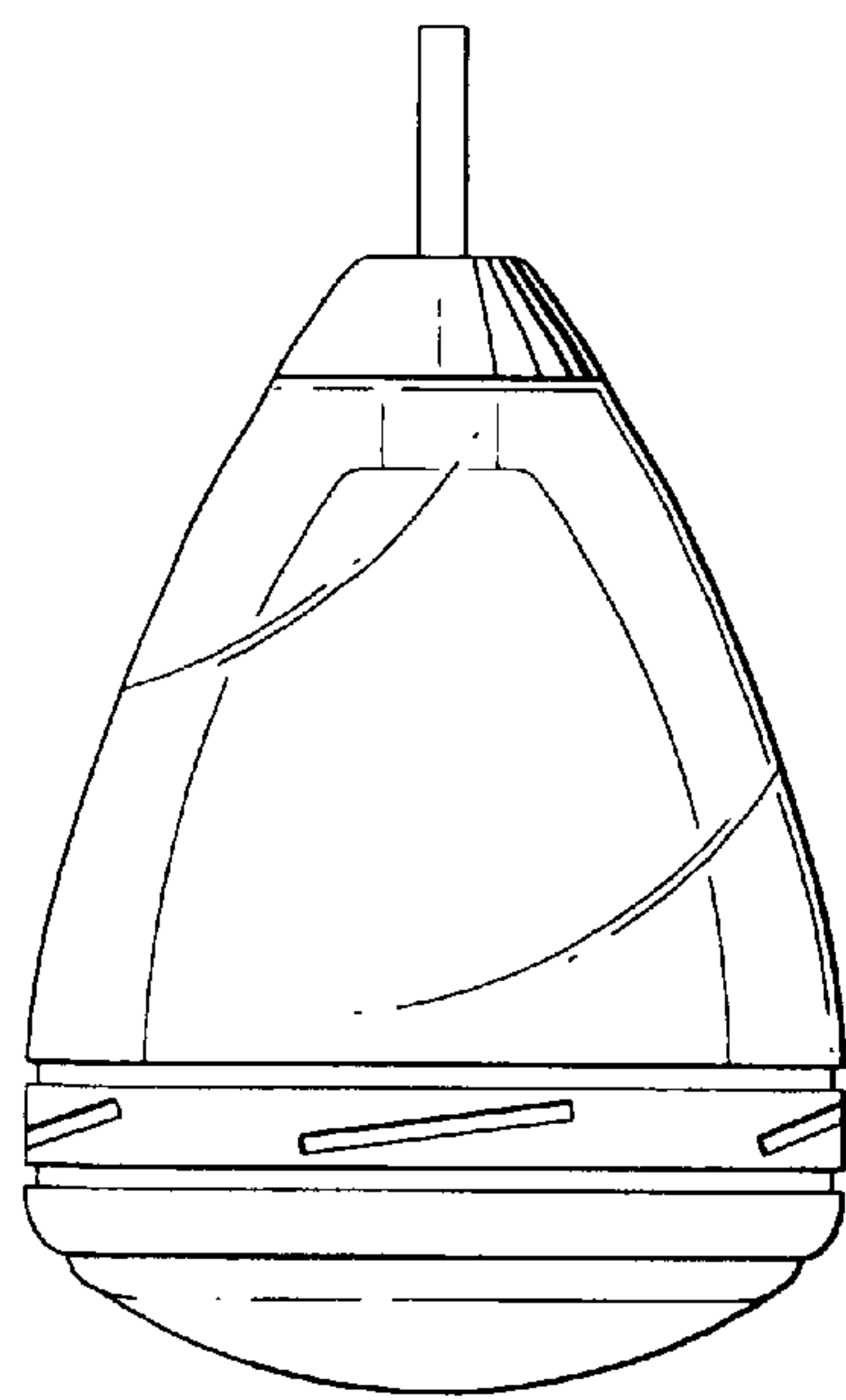
FIG. 9 is a perspective view on a reduced scale body of

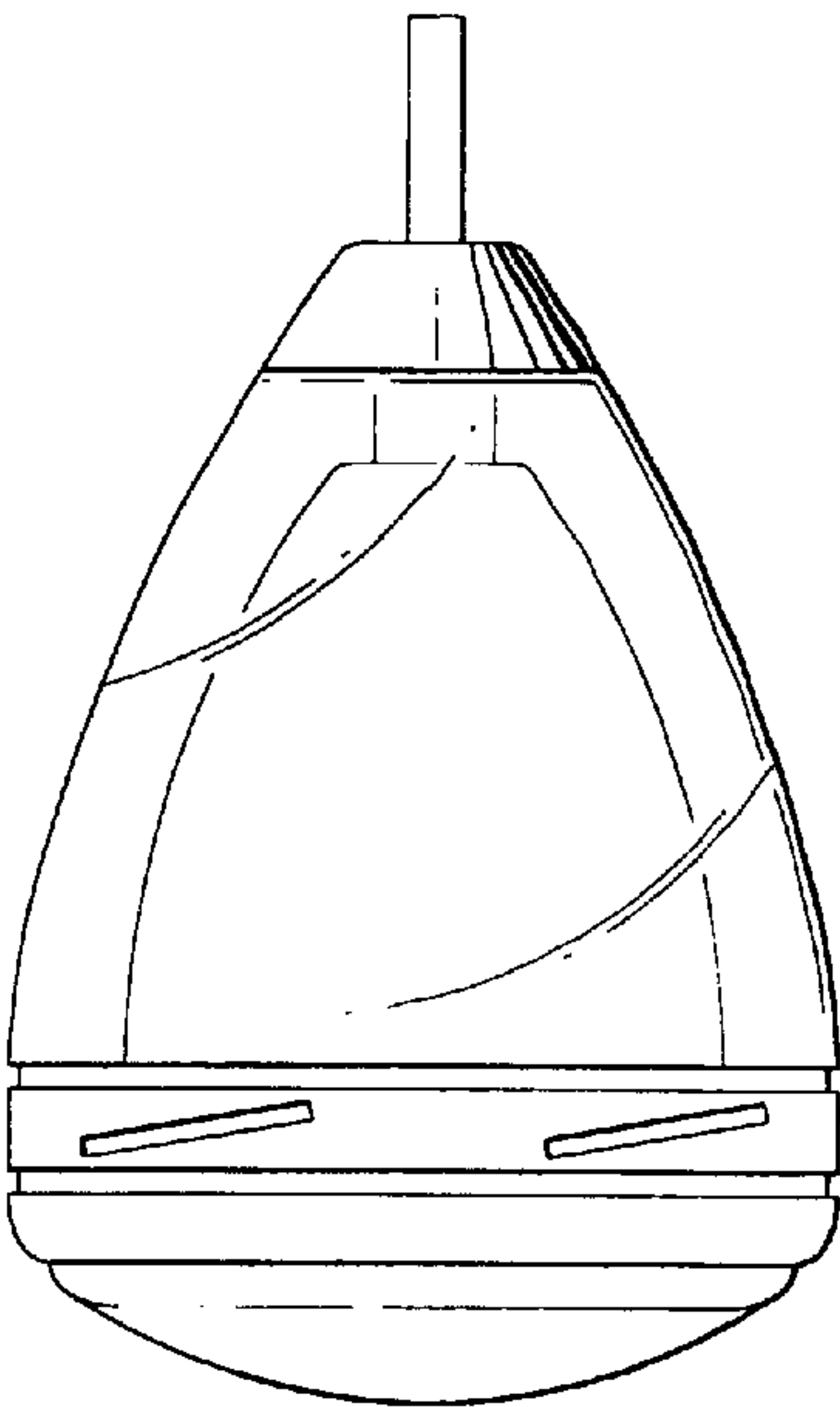




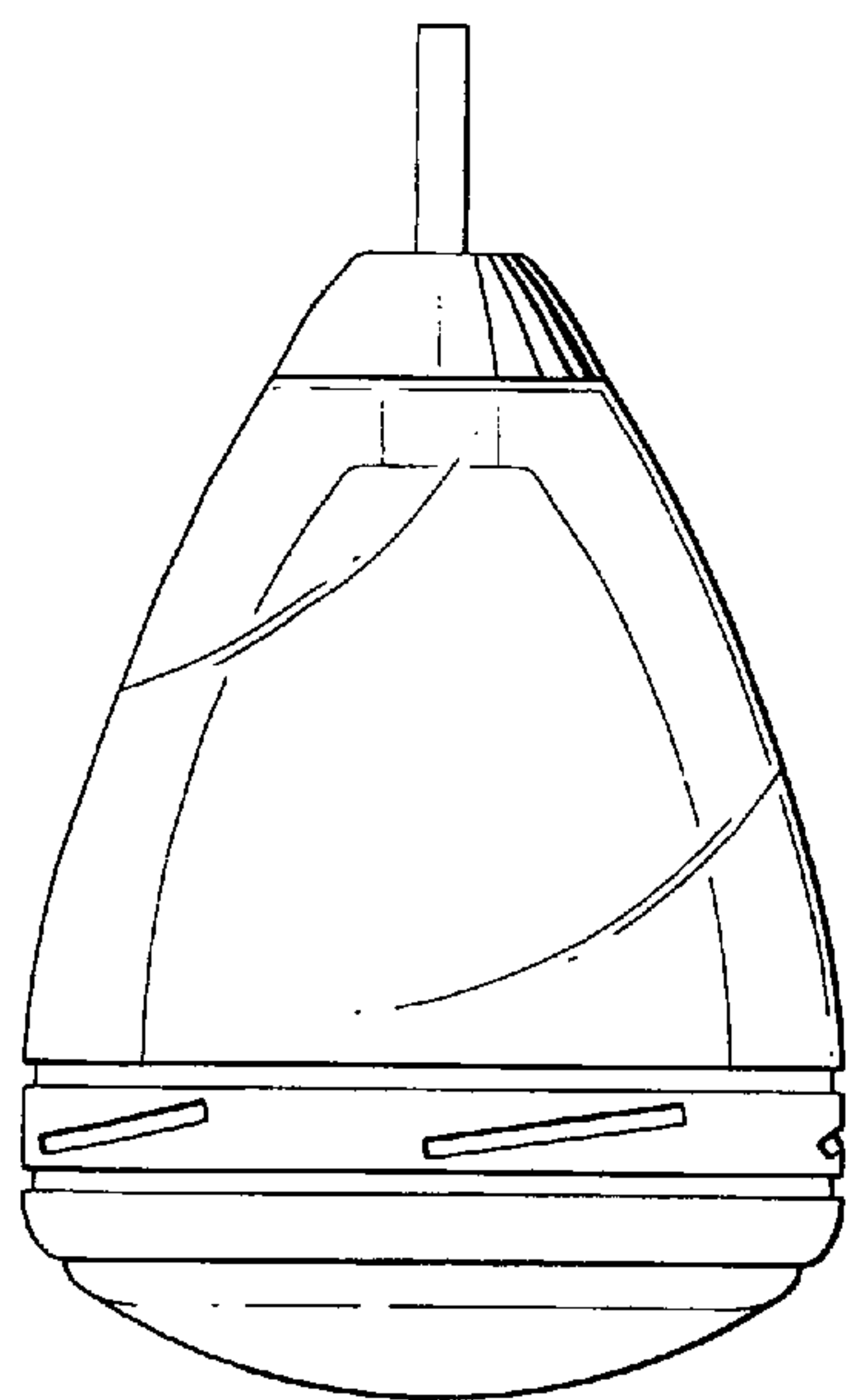

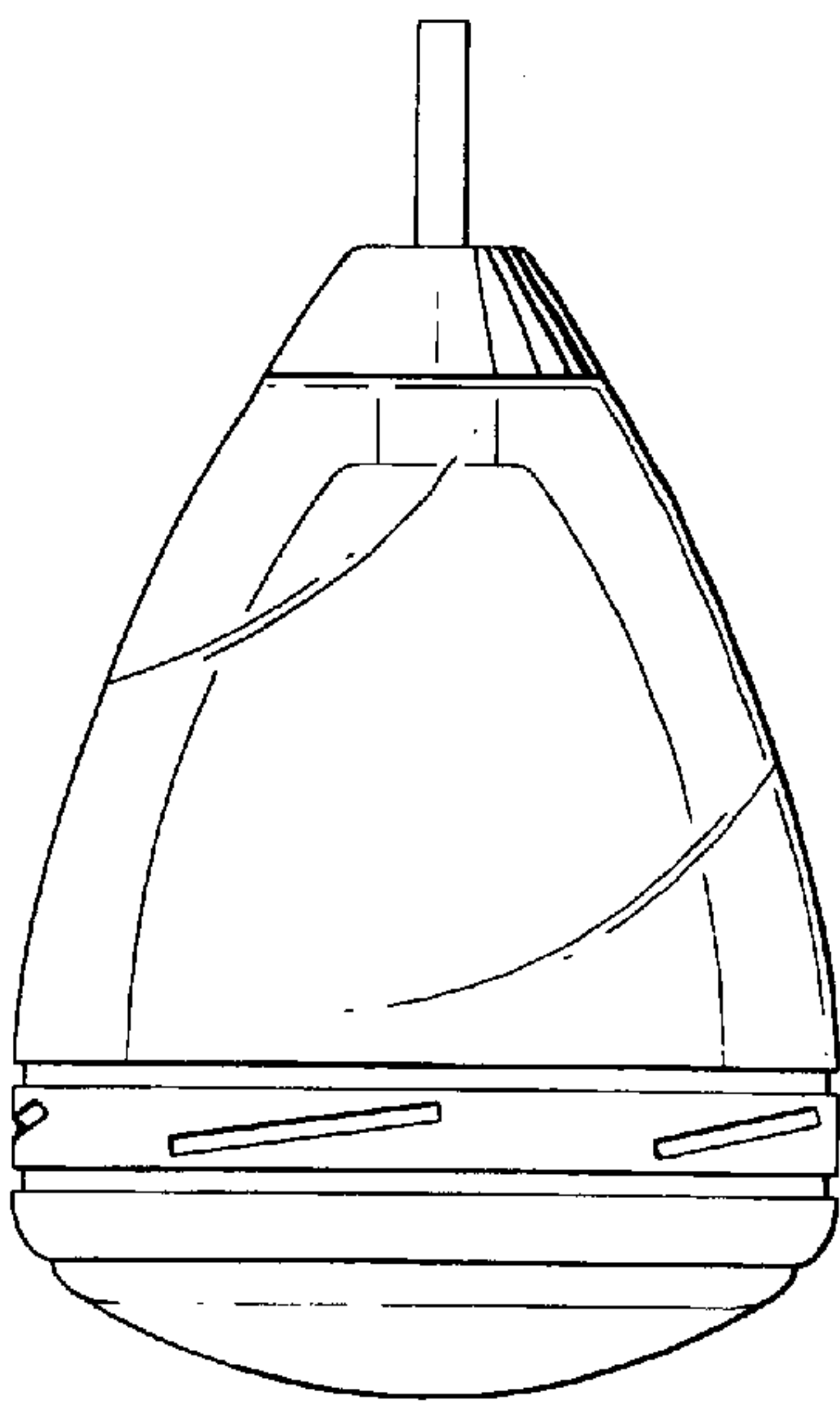

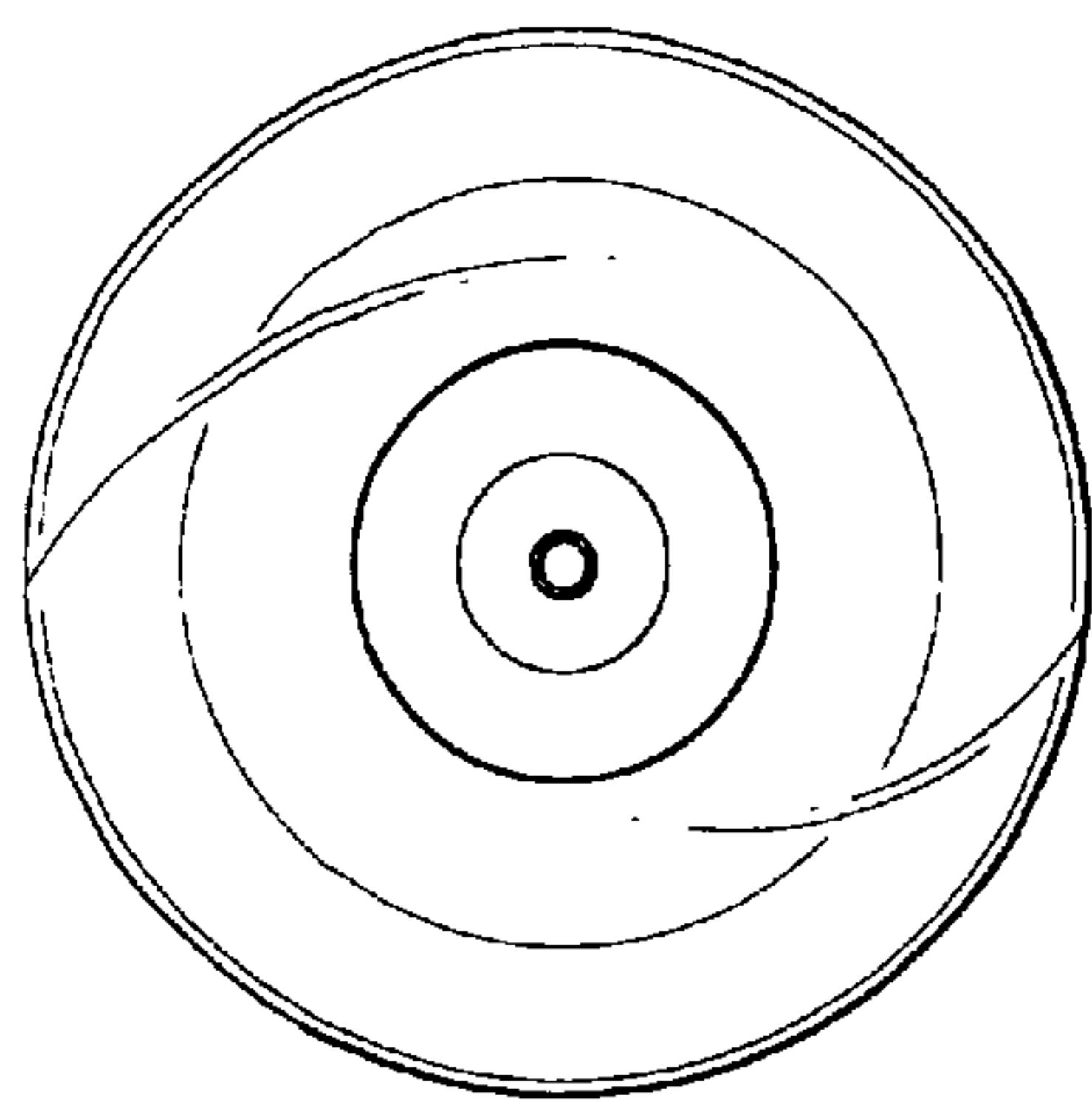

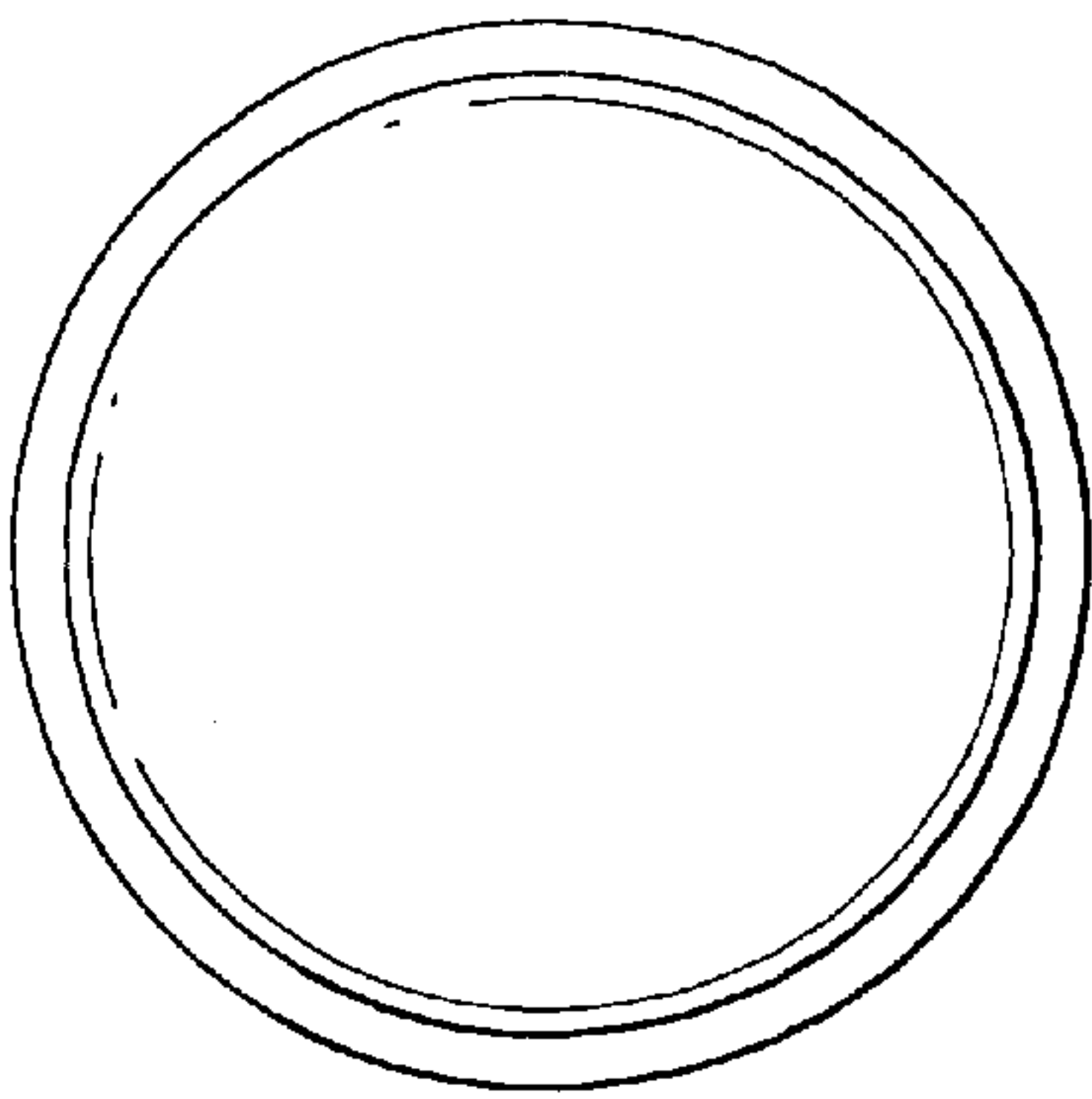

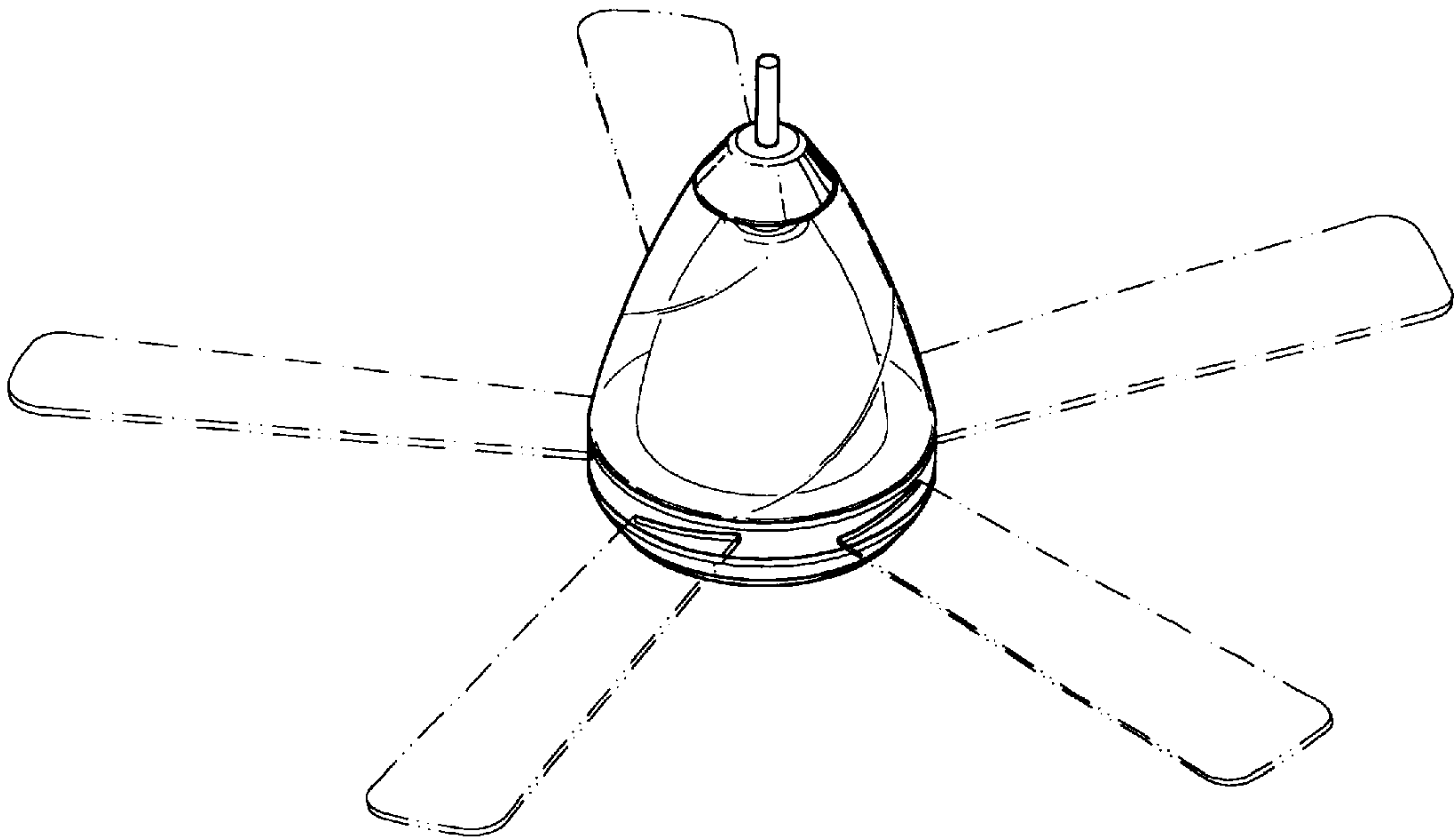

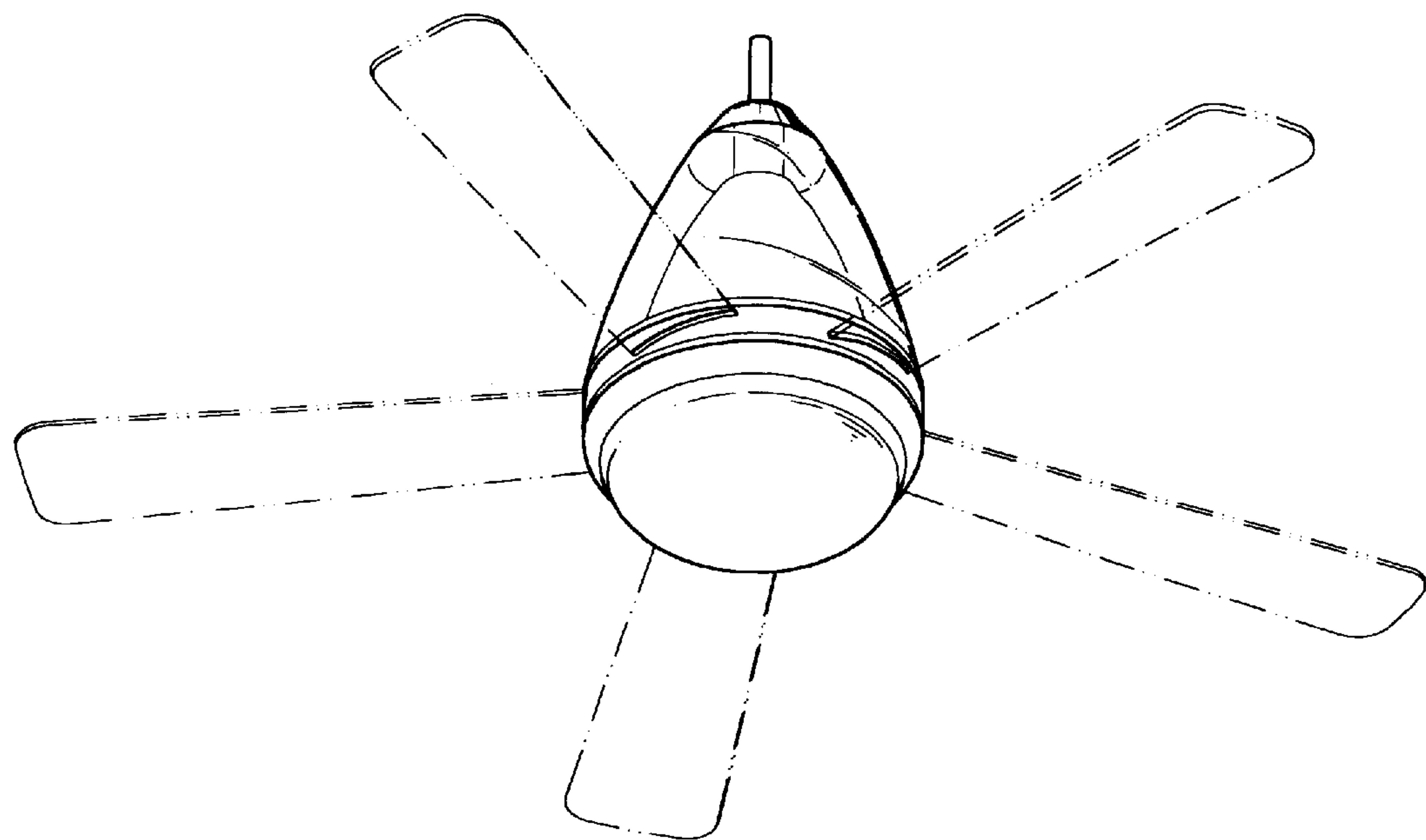
