(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a cushion, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view from the right of the cushion, the perspective view from the left being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view from the right of the cushion of FIG. 1, the side elevational view from the left being a mirror image thereof;

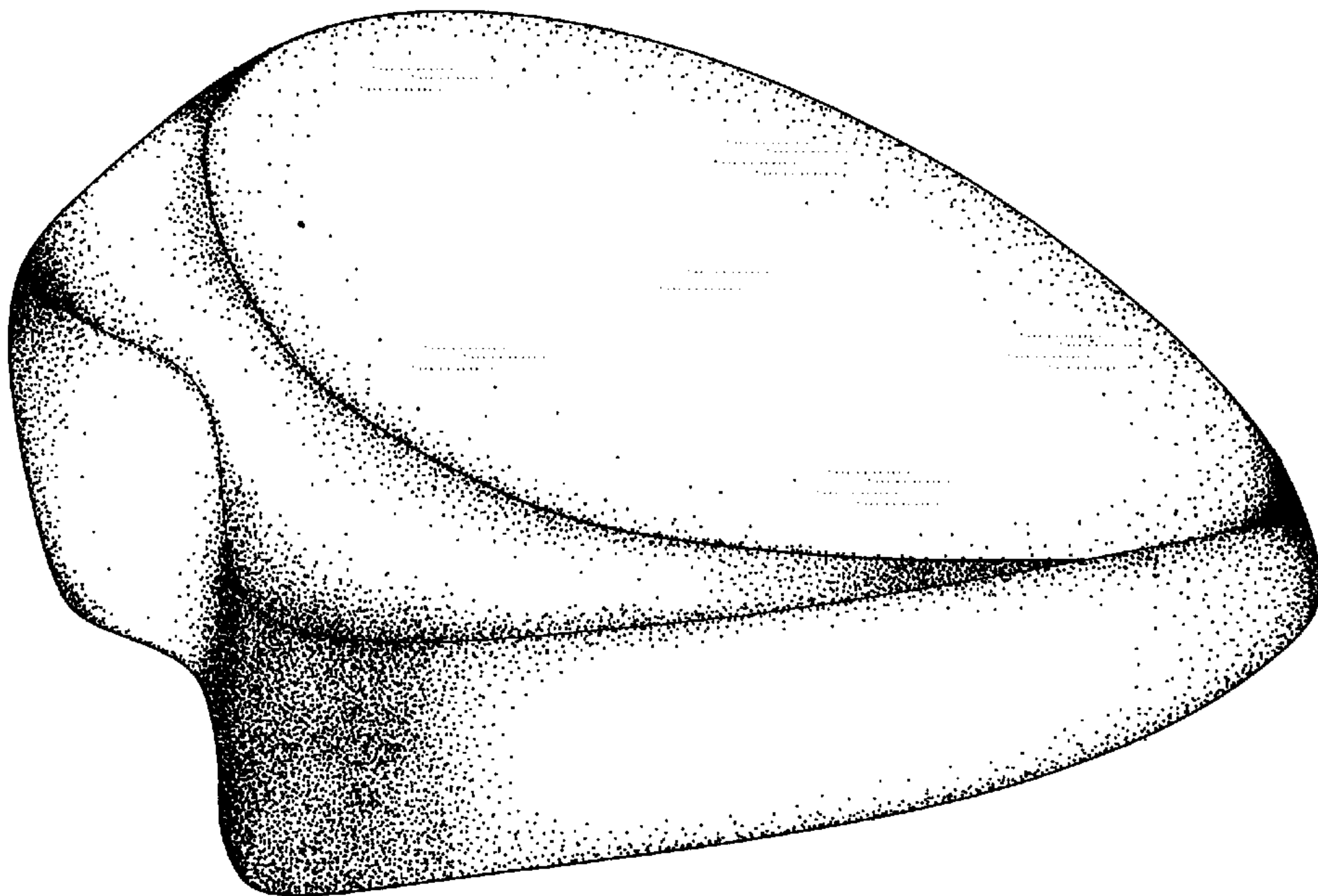
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the cushion of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the cushion of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the cushion of FIG. 1; and,

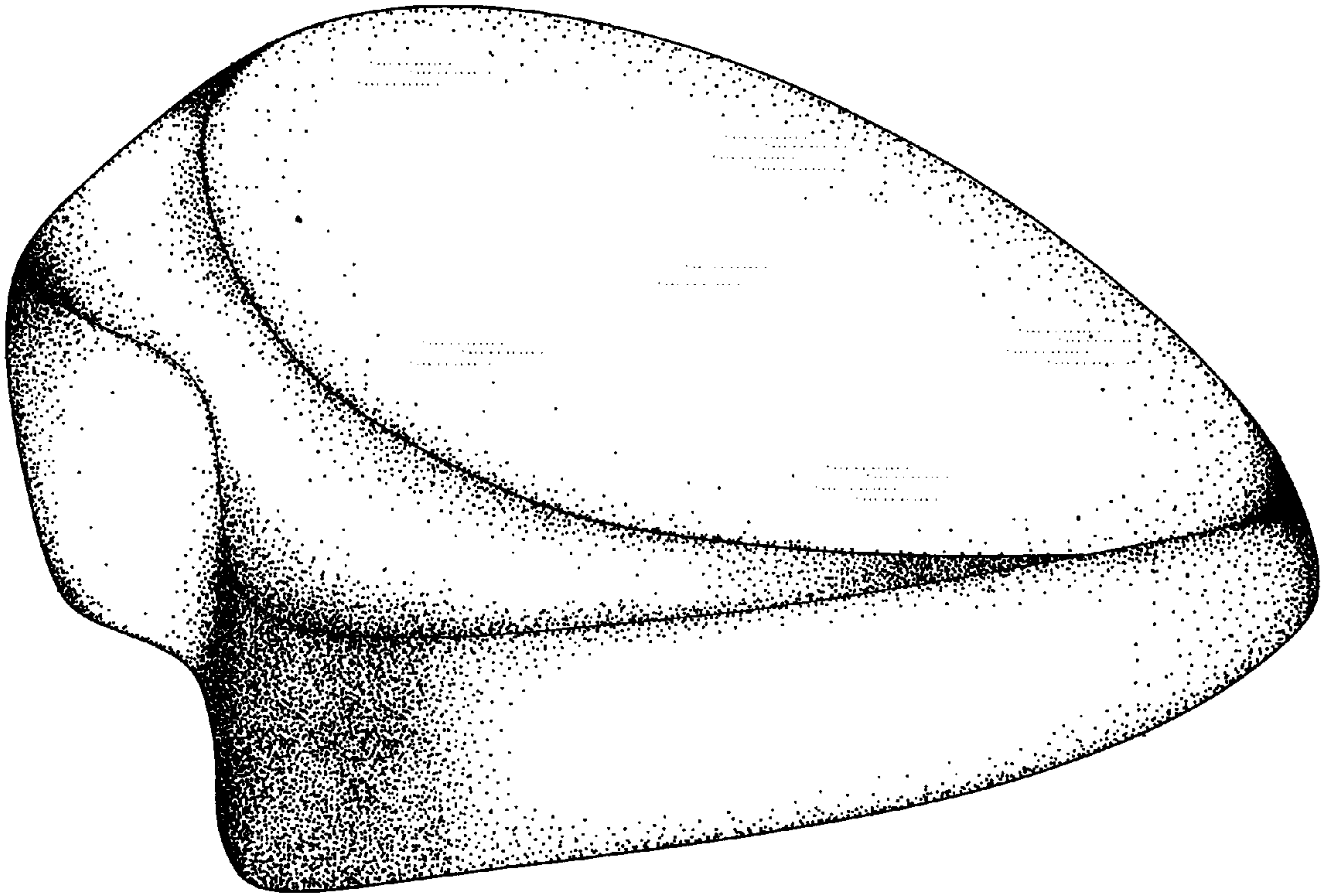

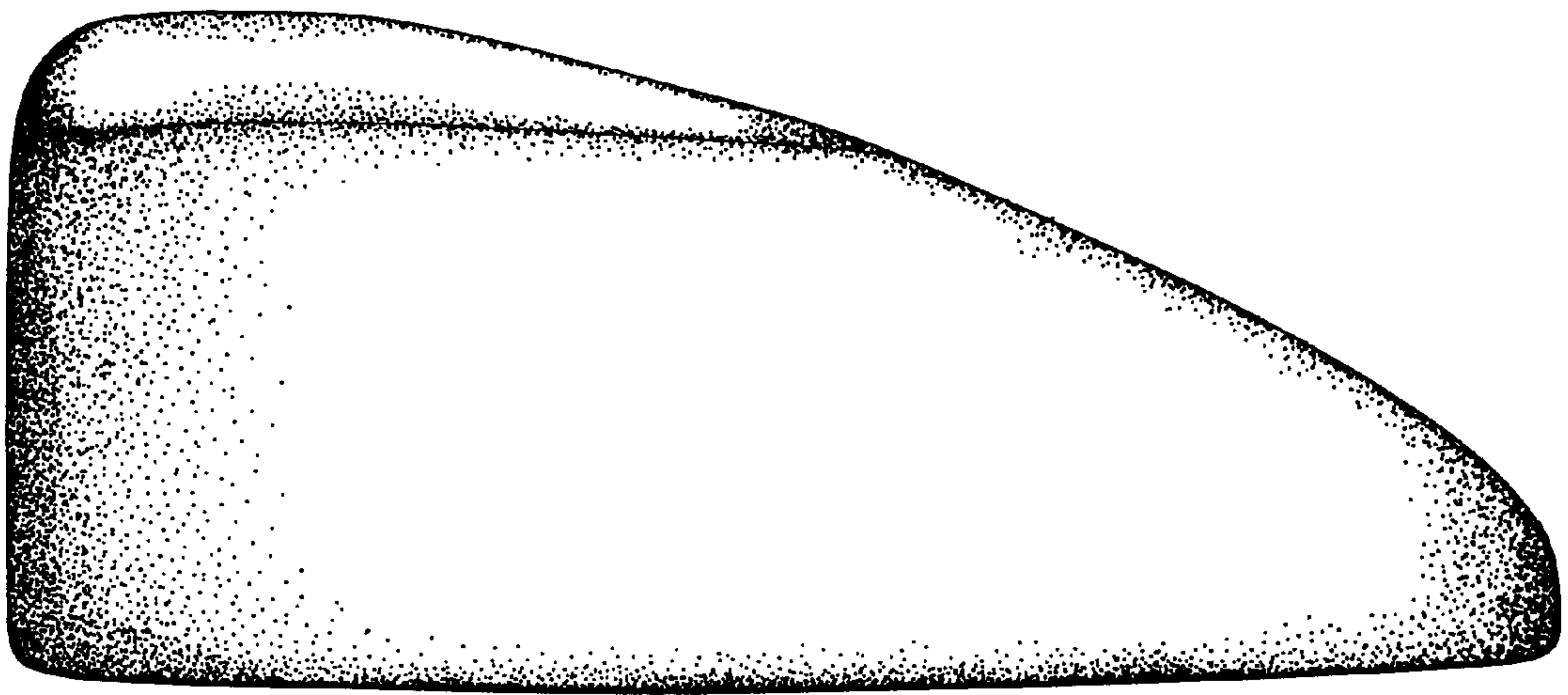

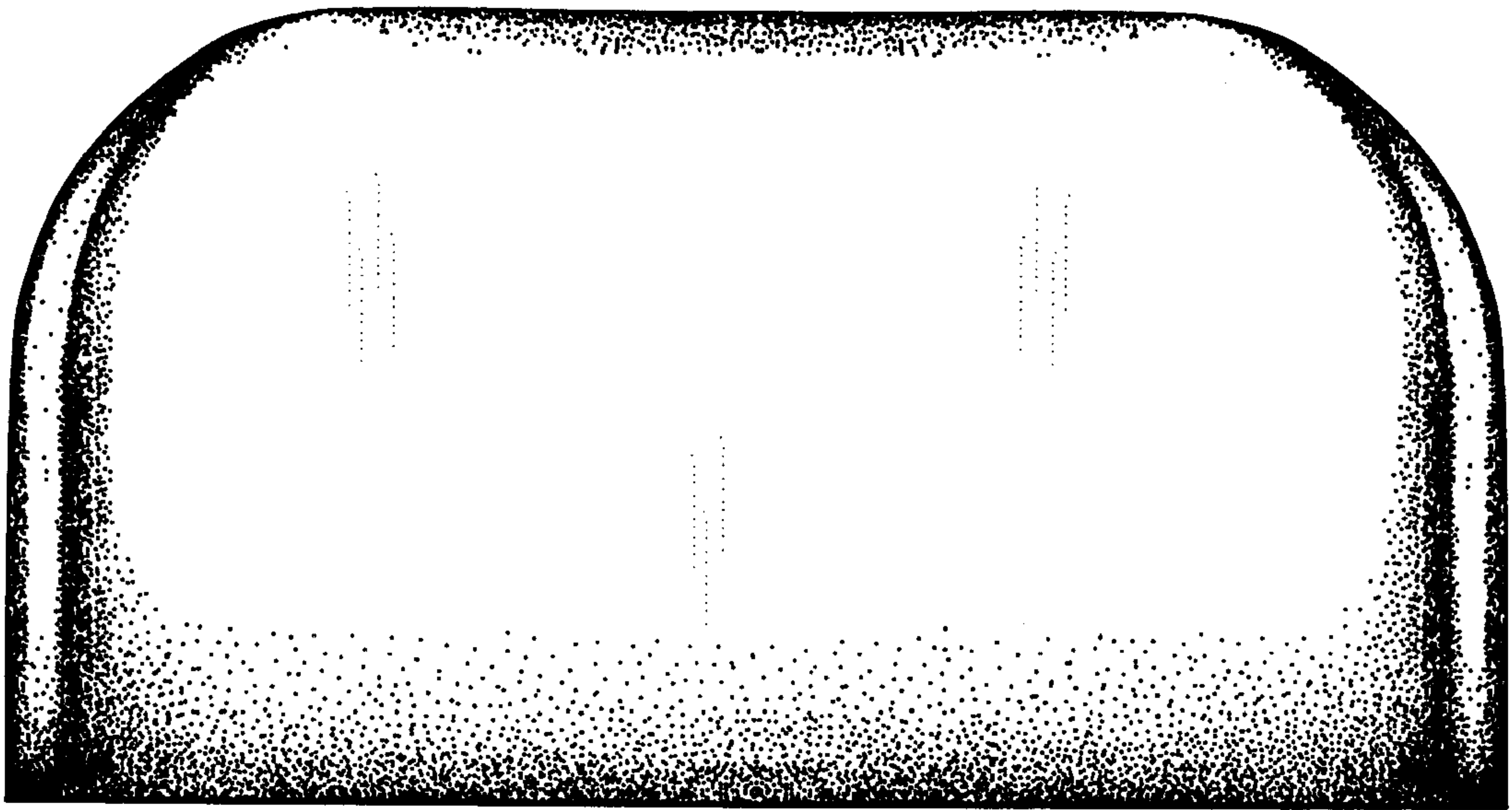

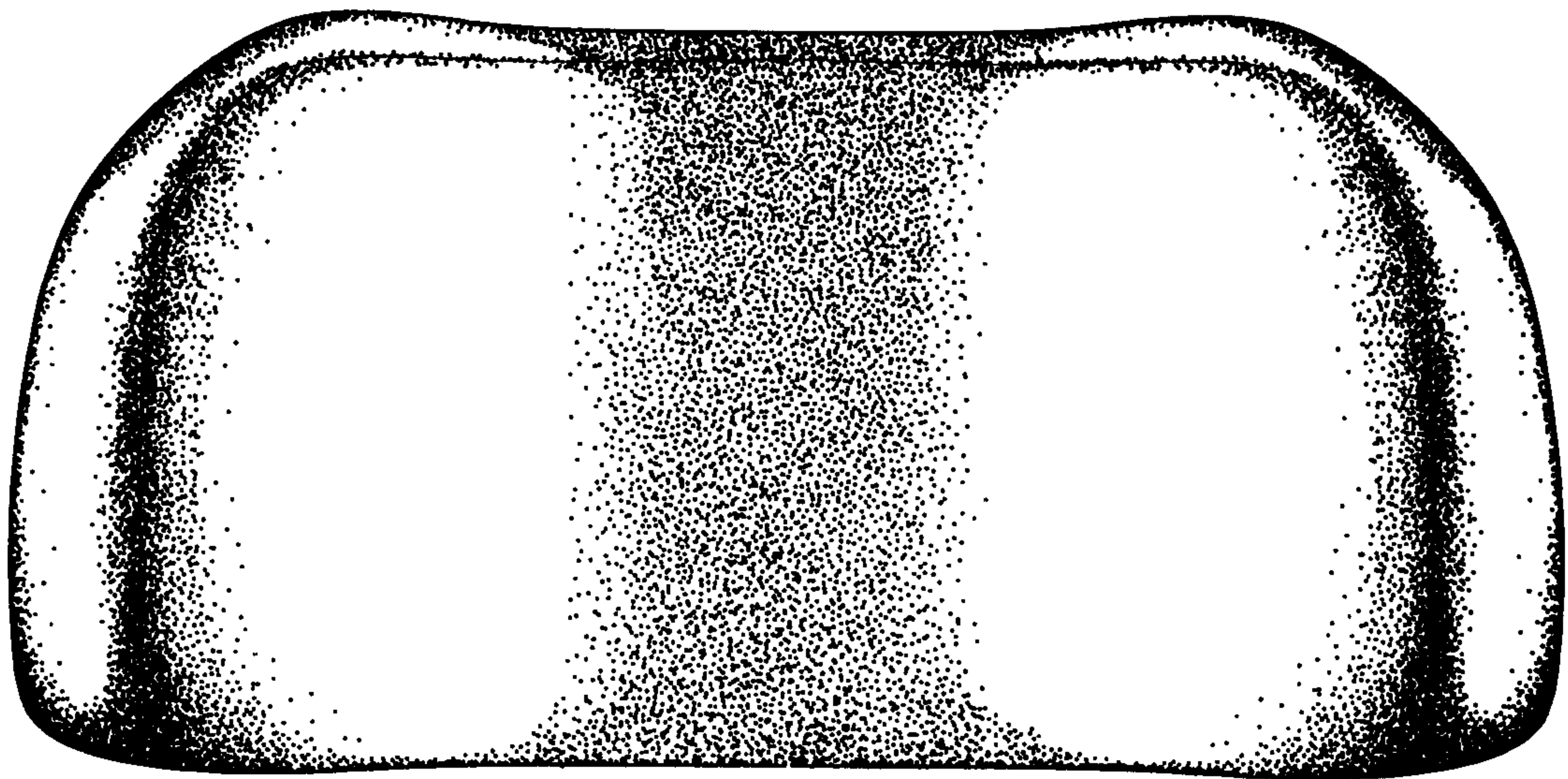

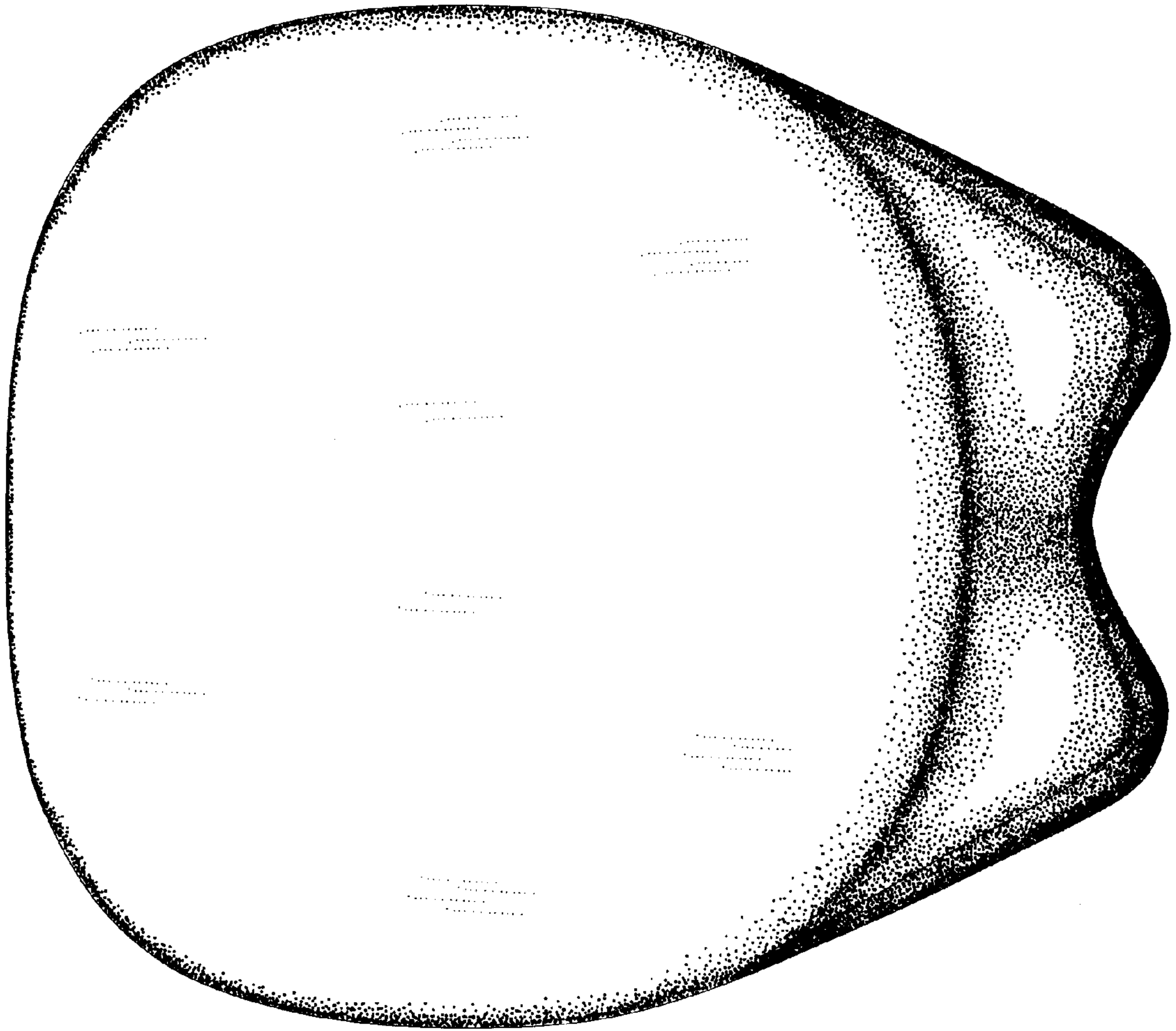

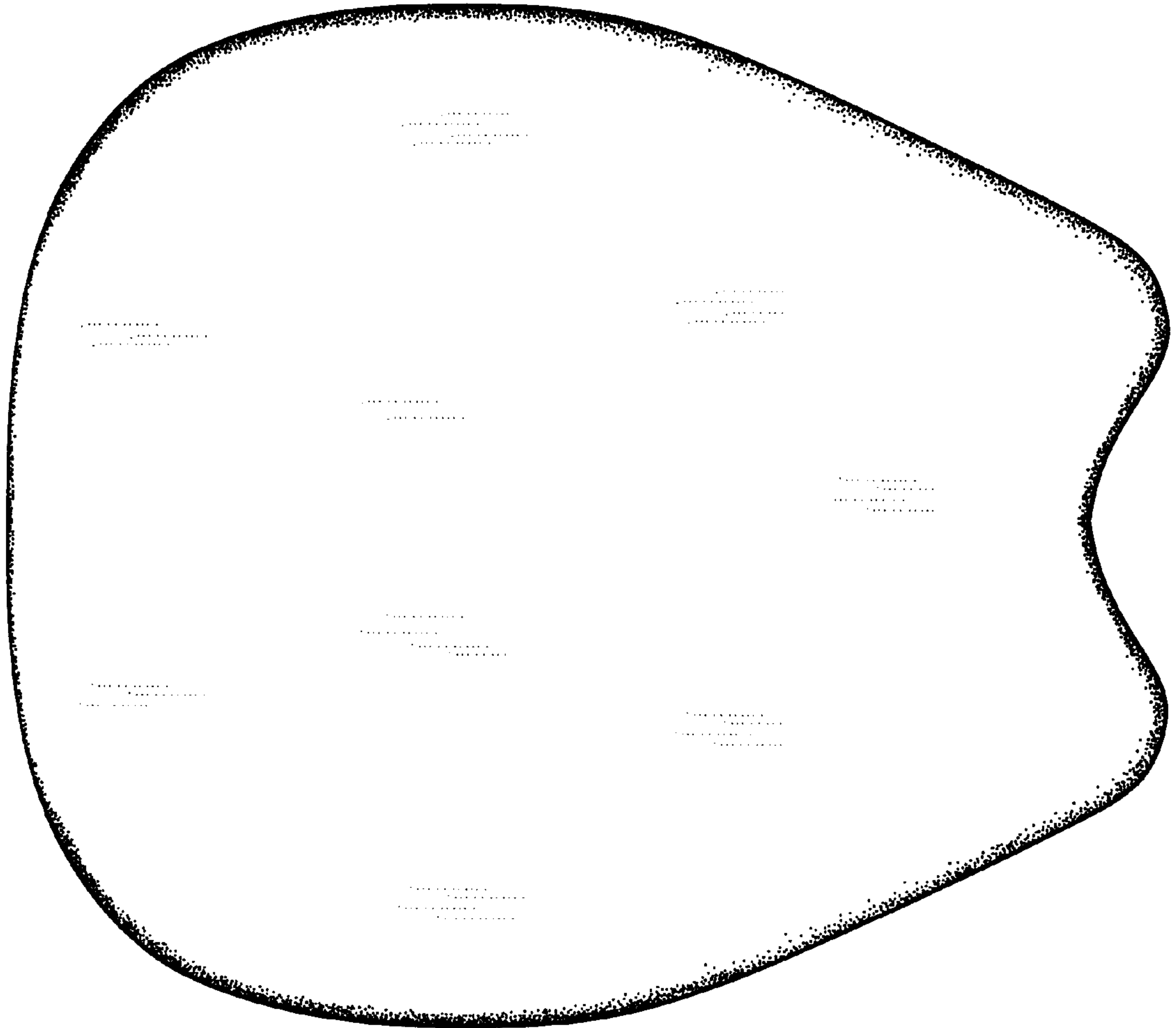
