FIG. 1 is a top, perspective view of a bowl showing my new design;

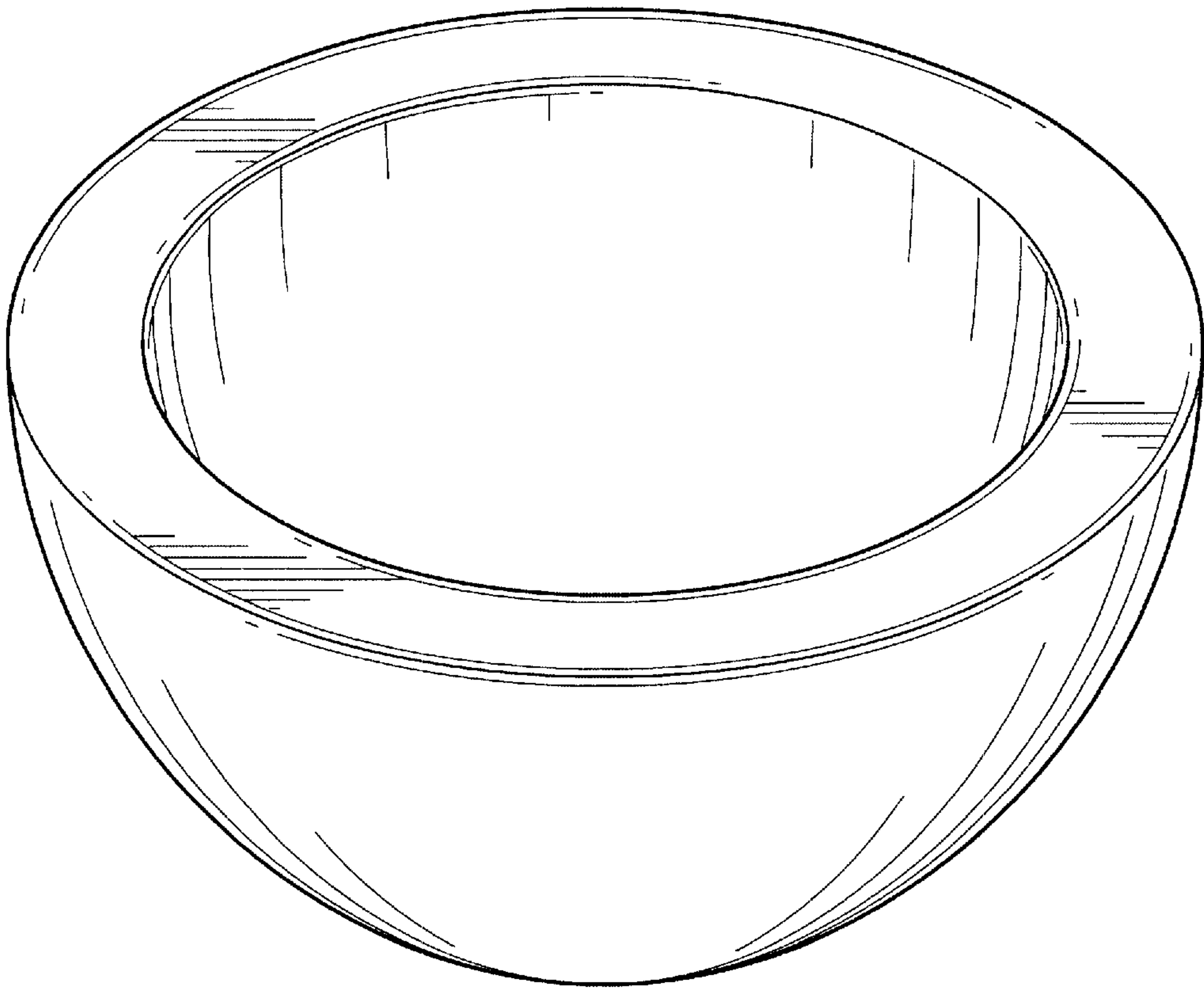
FIG. 2 is a side view thereof;

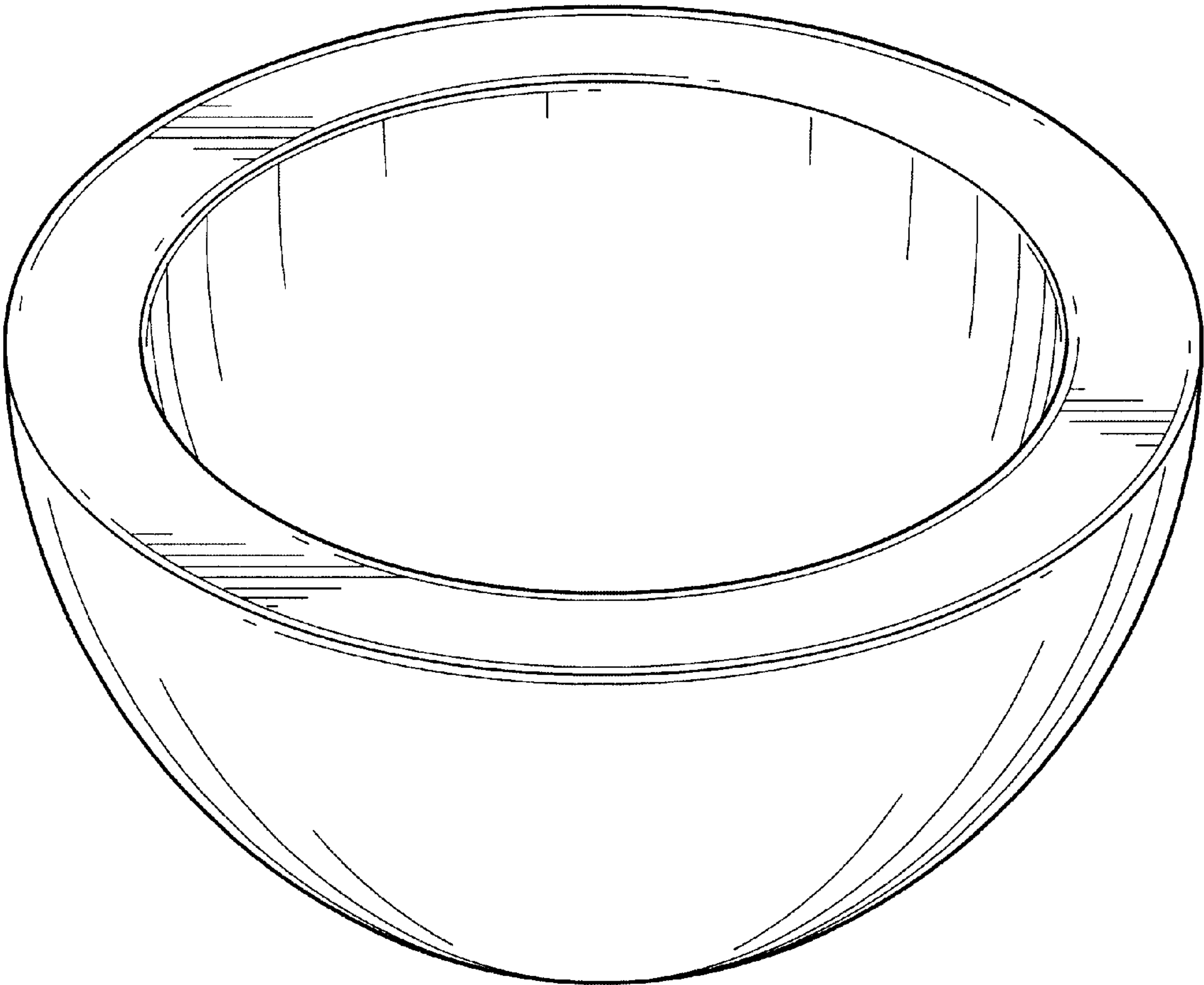

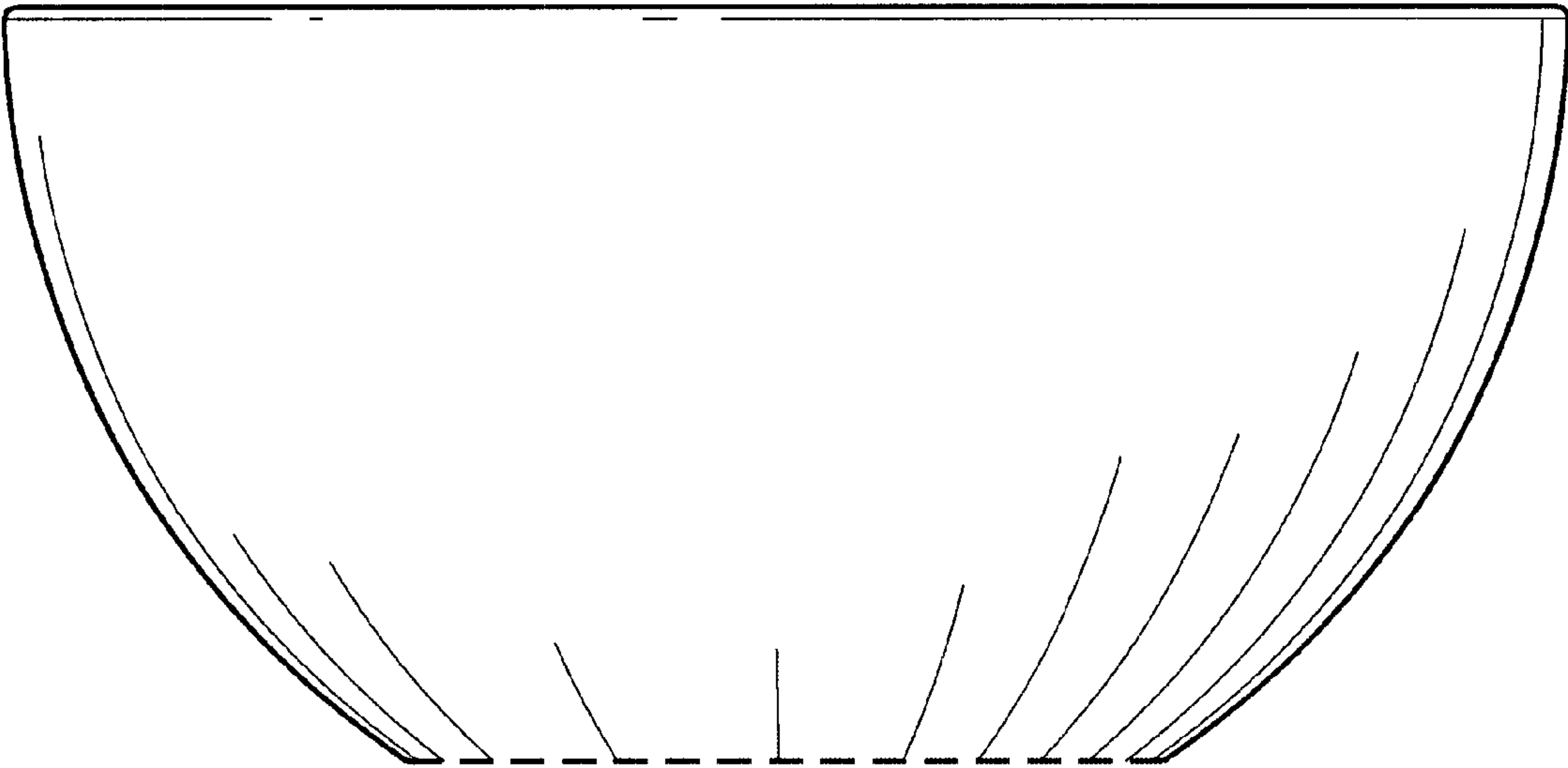

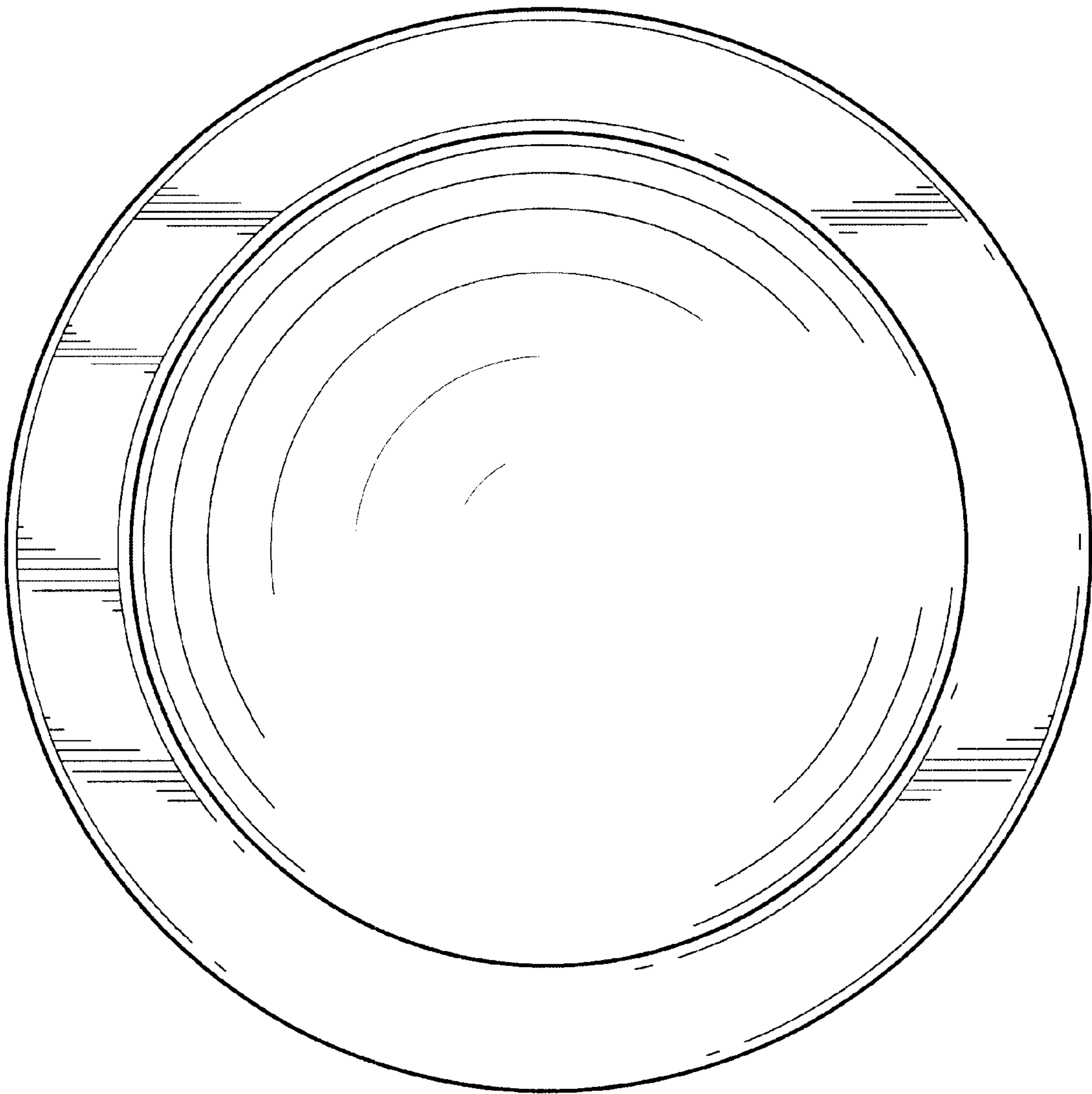

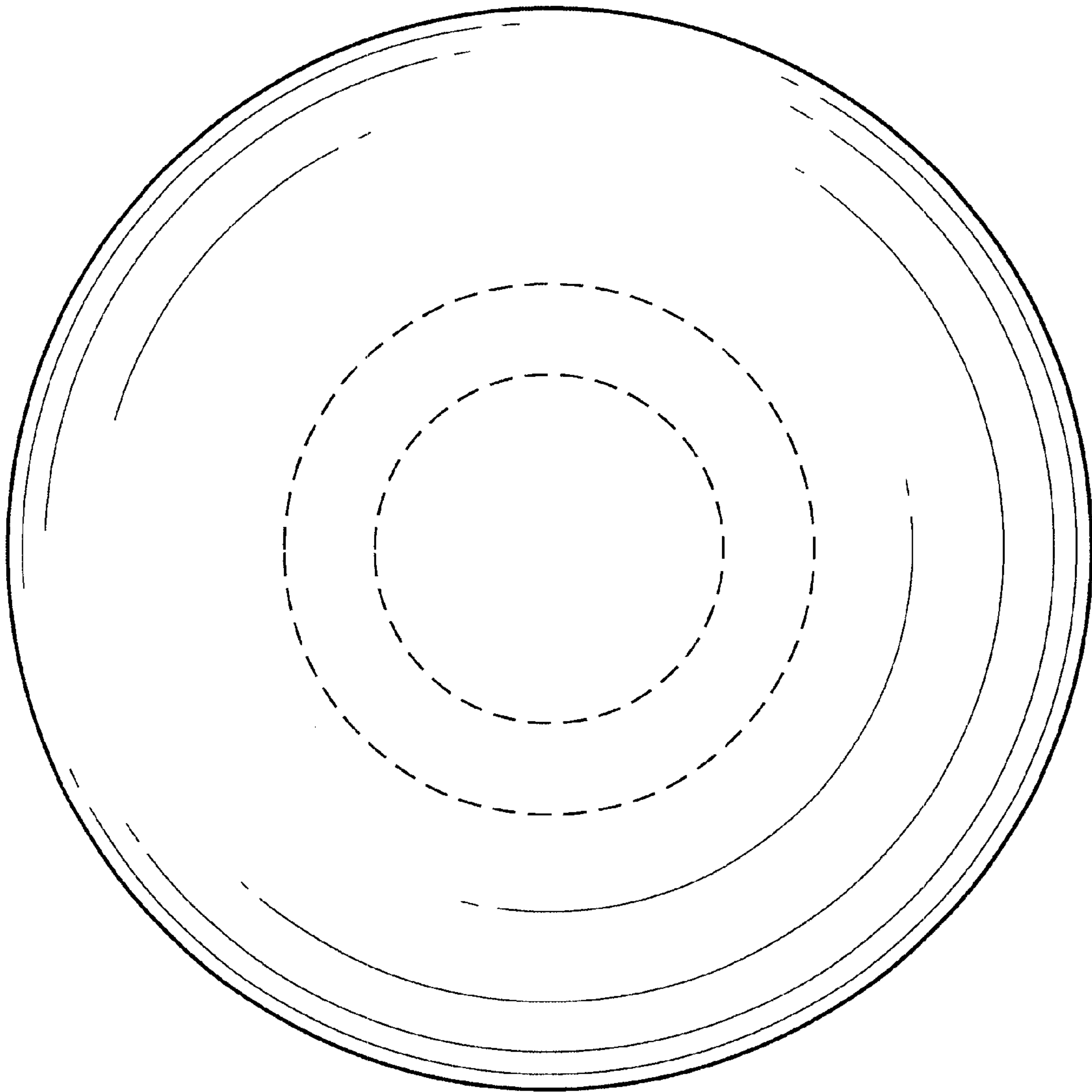
