(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a door, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a door in accordance with the present invention, the back view being either identical or unadorned;

FIG. 2 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view taken along the line 2—2 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a fragmentary elevational view illustrating the contour shown in cross section in FIG. 2; and,

FIG. 4 is an enlarged elevational view illustrating a portion of the contour shown in cross section in FIG. 2.

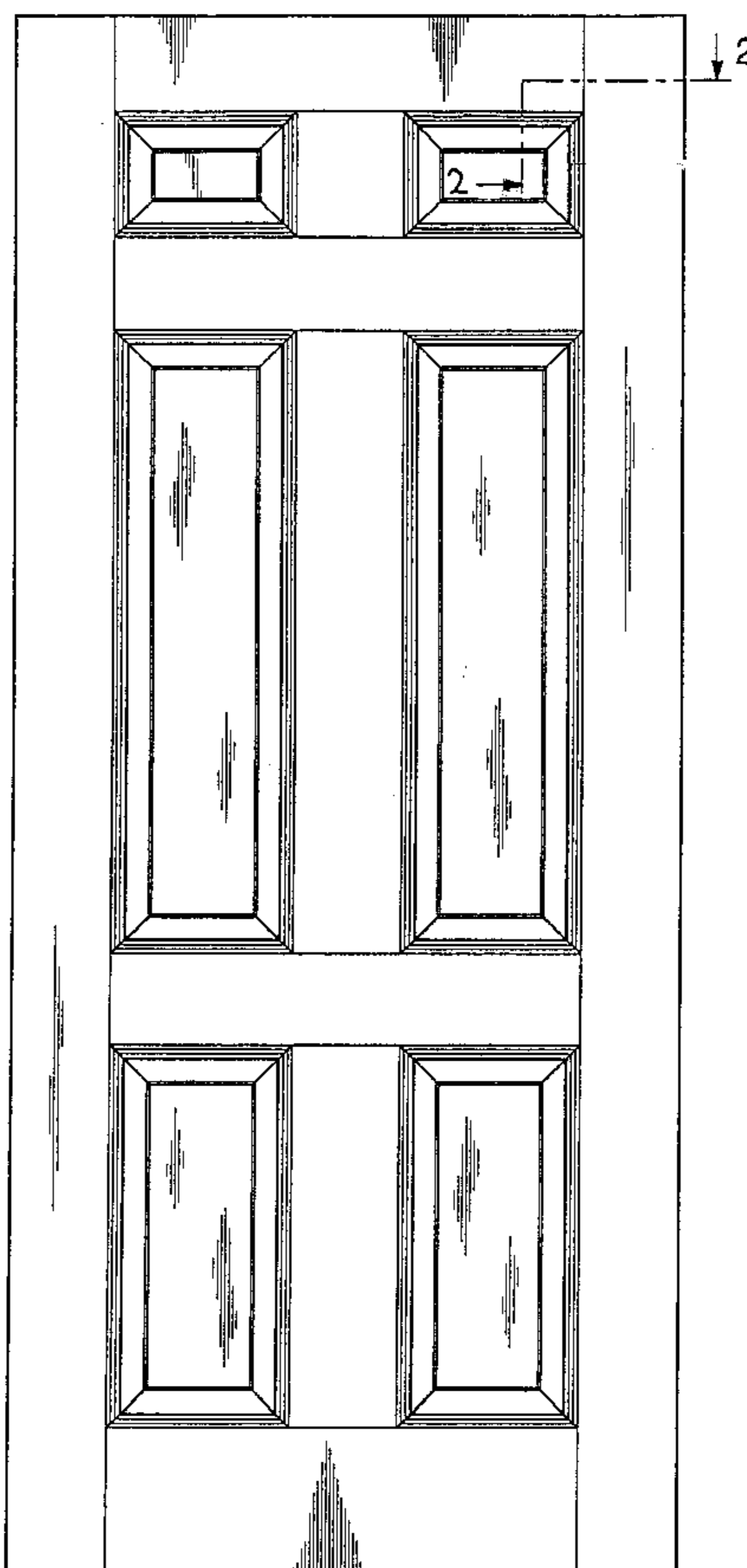

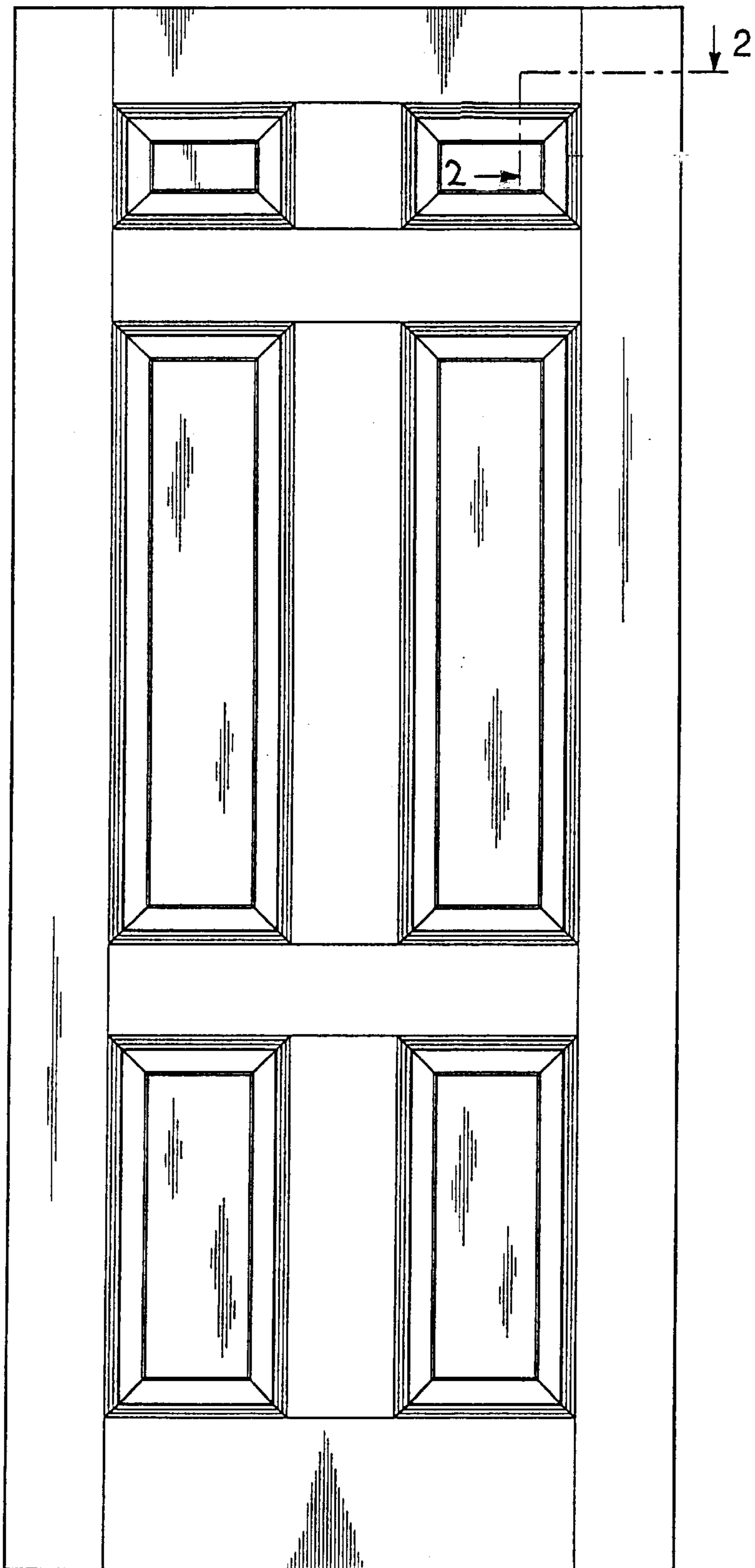

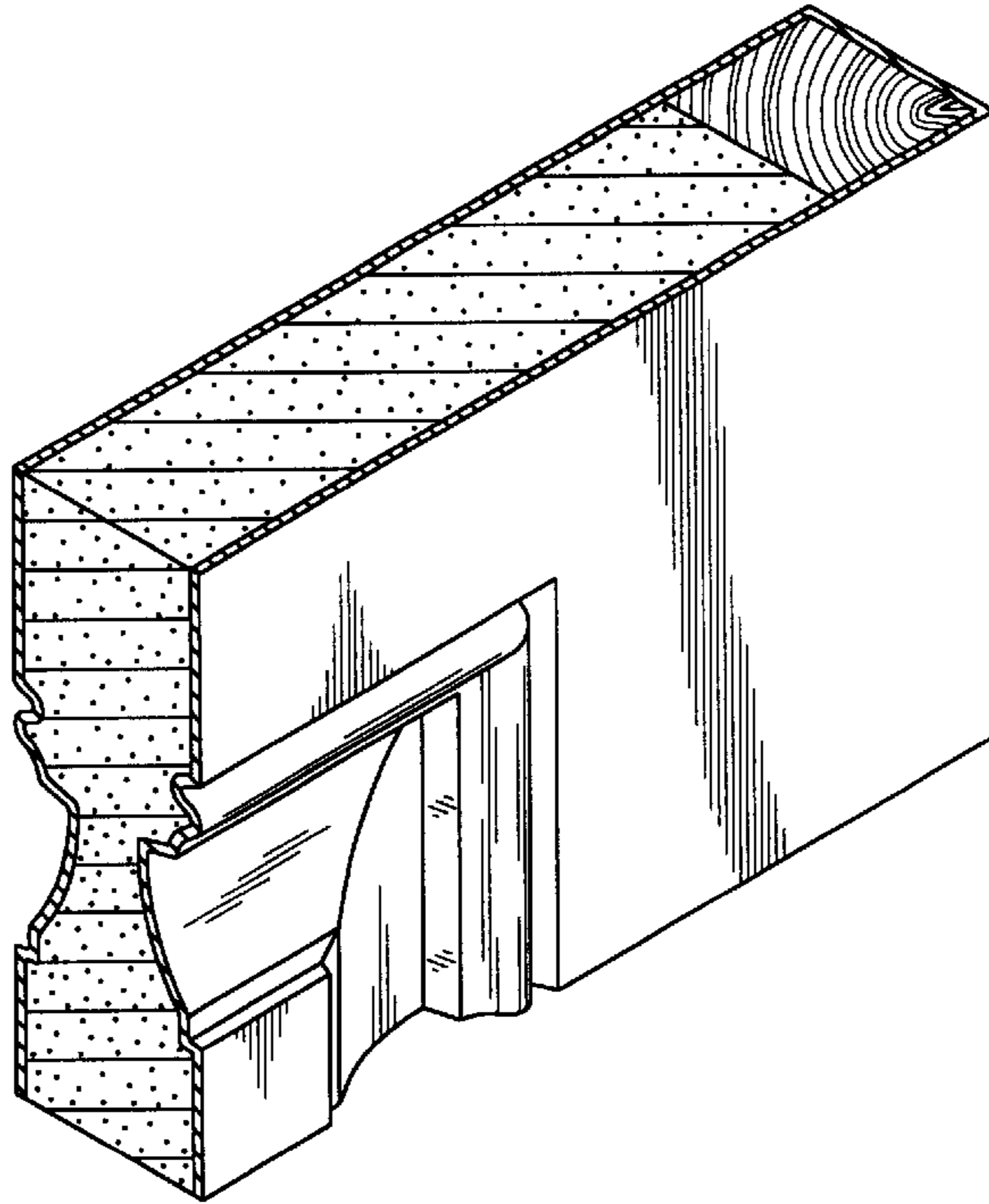

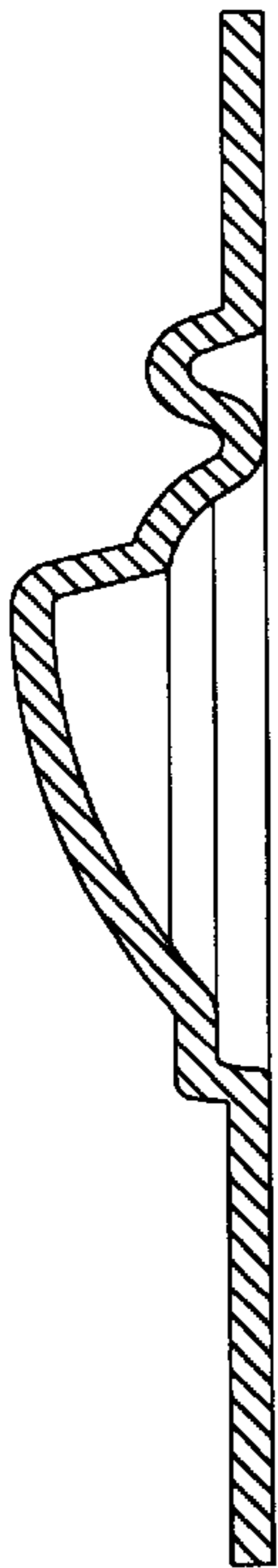
