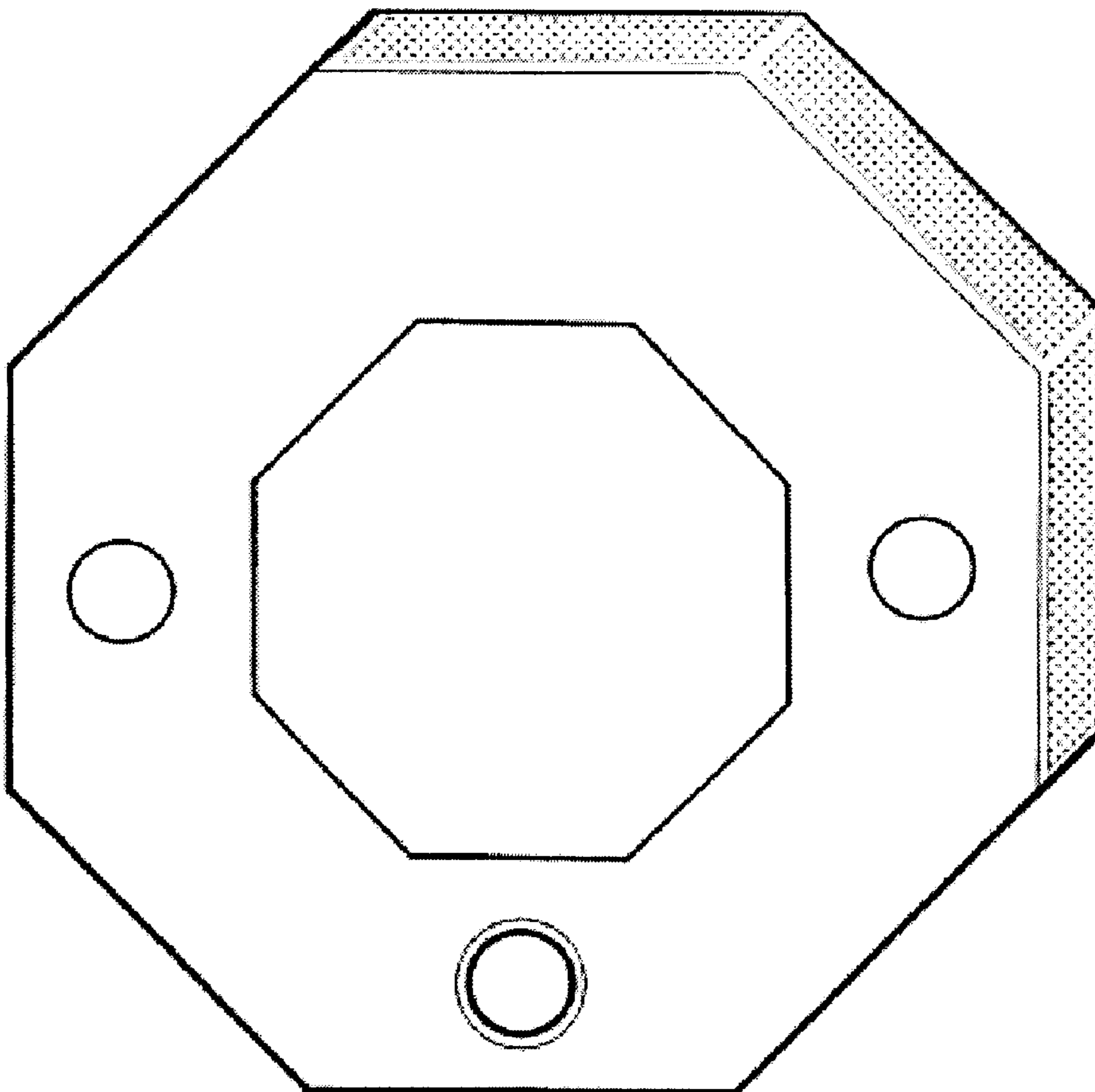
The ornamental design for a vehicle brake tester, as shown.

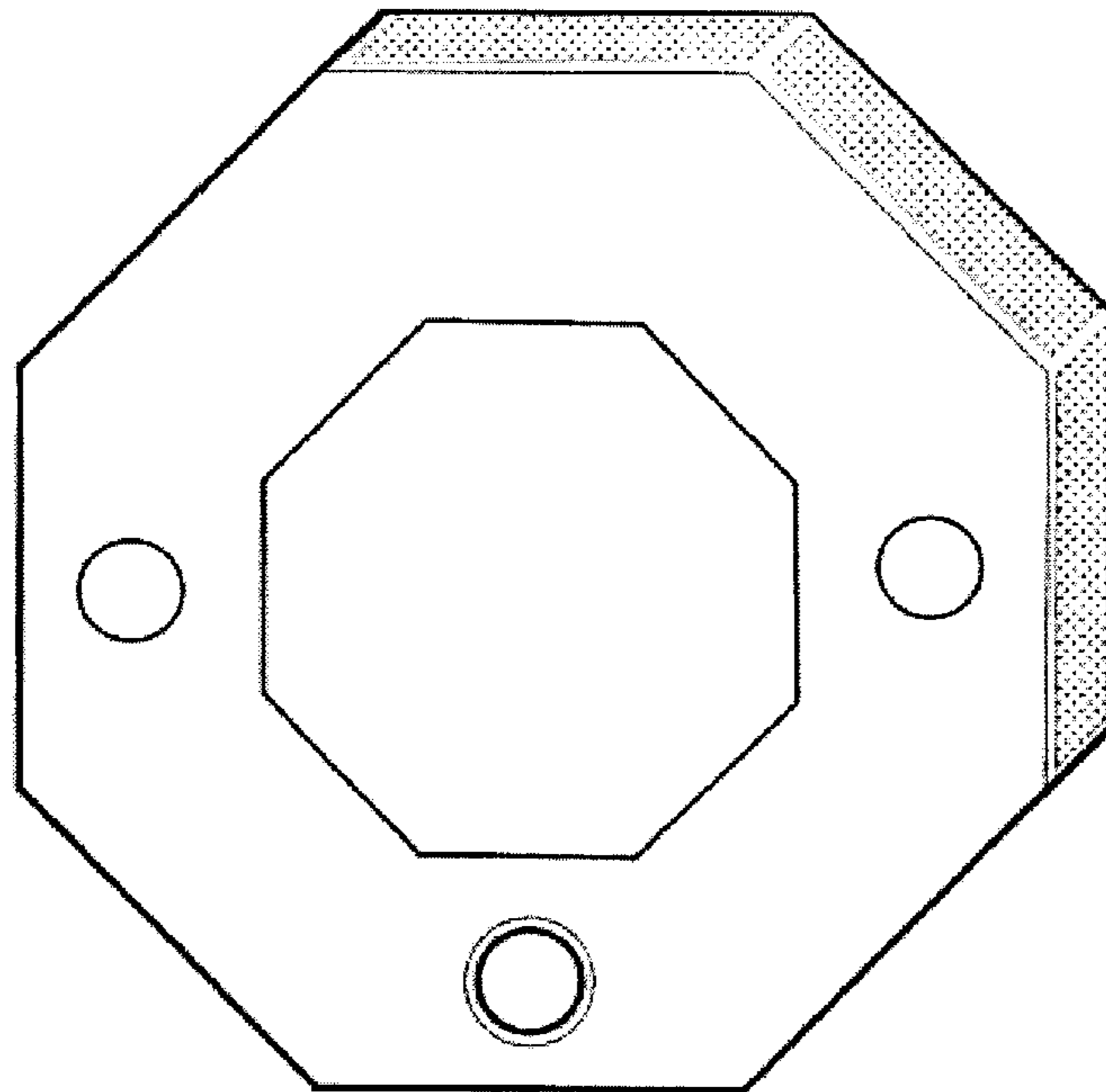
FIG. 1 is a perspective view from the front, one side and above; and,

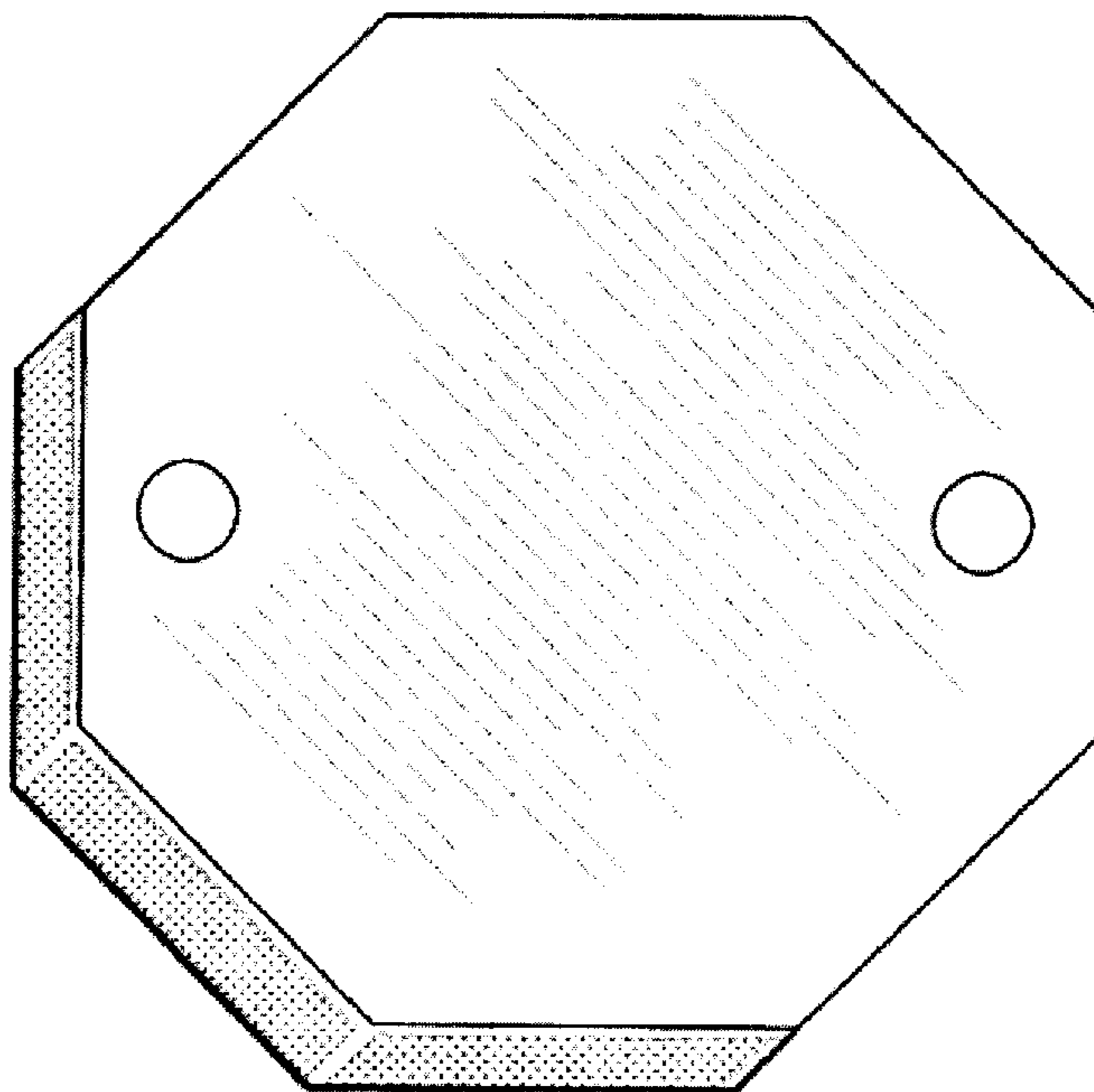


**PERSPECTIVE VIEW FROM THE FRONT, ONE SIDE AND ABOVE**
