DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a stringed instrument showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an elevational view taken along lines 4—4 in FIG. 2;

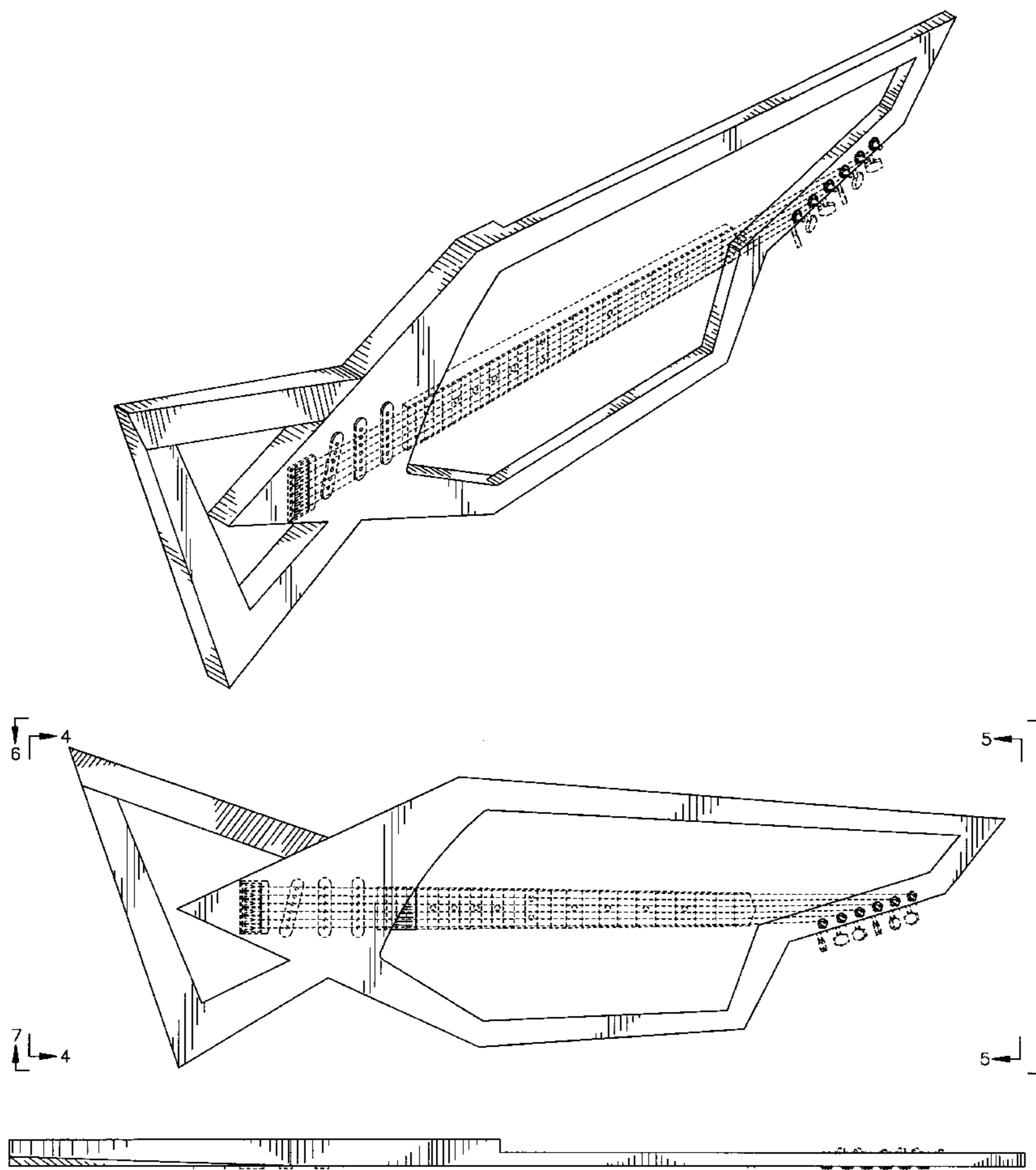
FIG. 5 is an elevational view taken along lines 5—5 in FIG. 2;

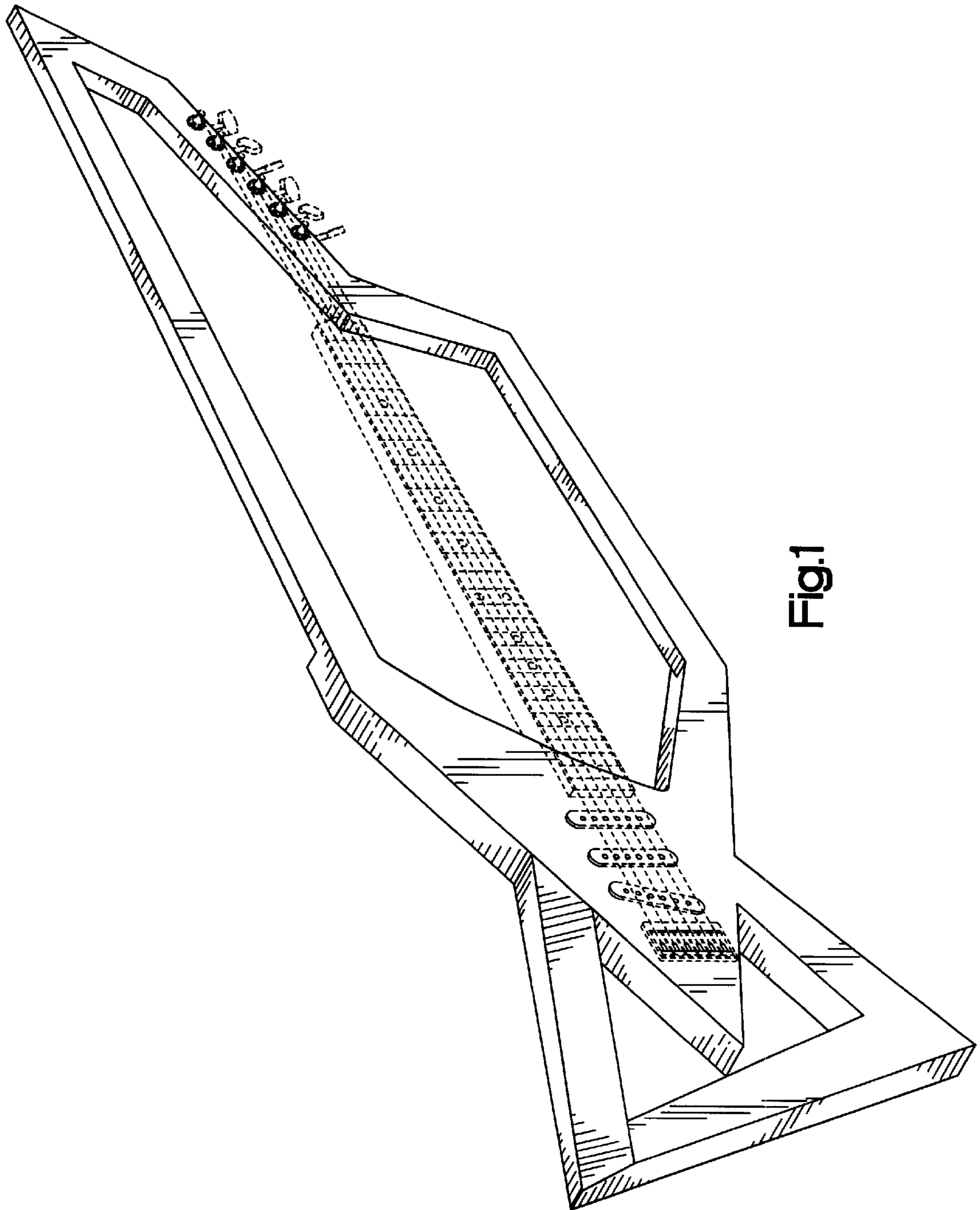

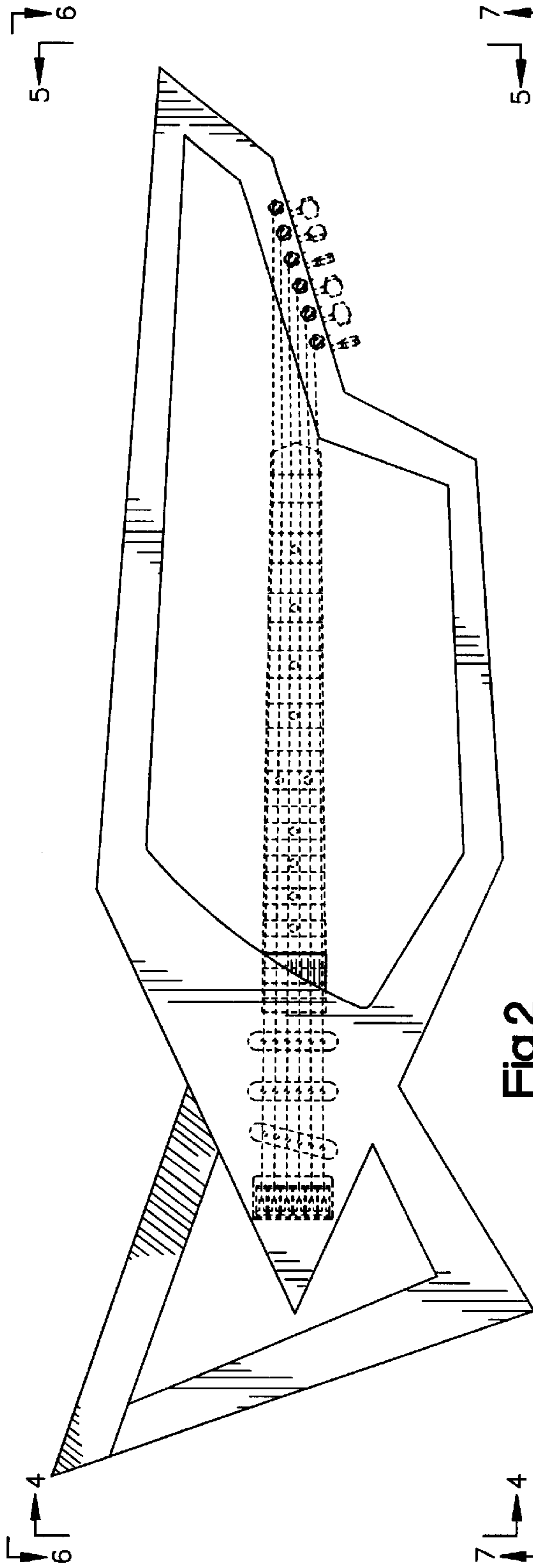

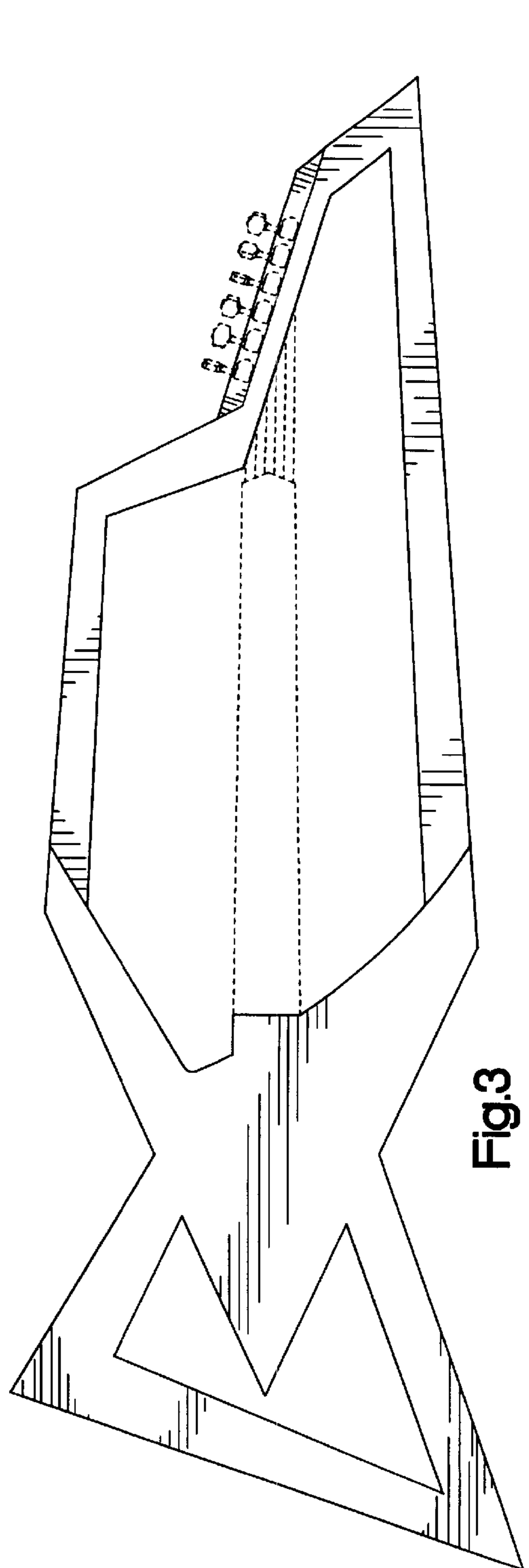

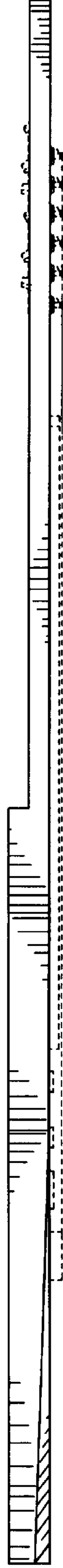

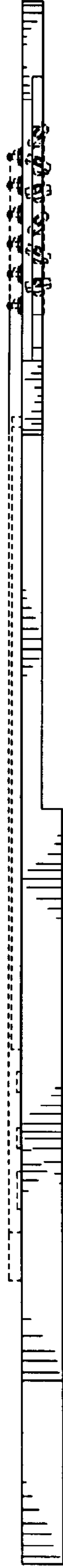
