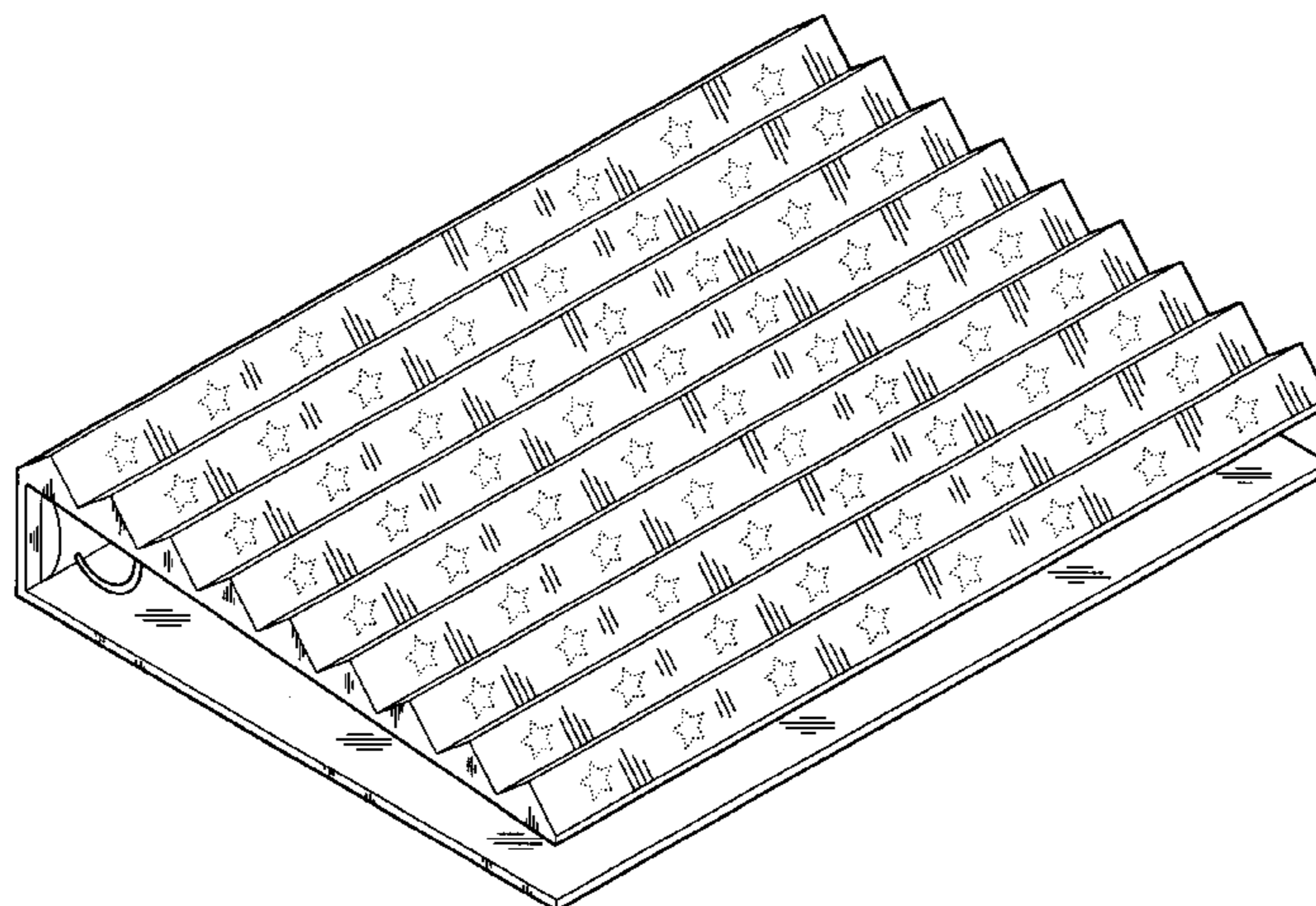

FIG. 7 is an isometric view of a modified embodiment of my new design;  
FIG. 8 is a top view thereof;  
FIG. 9 is a bottom view thereof;  
FIG. 10 is a front view thereof;  
FIG. 11 is a right-side view thereof;  
FIG. 12 is a left-side view thereof; and,  
FIG. 13 is a perspective view of another embodiment of my new design, the remaining views being the same as shown in FIGS. 2-6 except for the transparent enclosure which is clearly shown in this figure.

The patterns (of stars and moons) shown in stippled lines are for the purposes of illustrating the application of graphics or a composite image to a wavelike surface of the notebook, but do not form part of the claimed design.

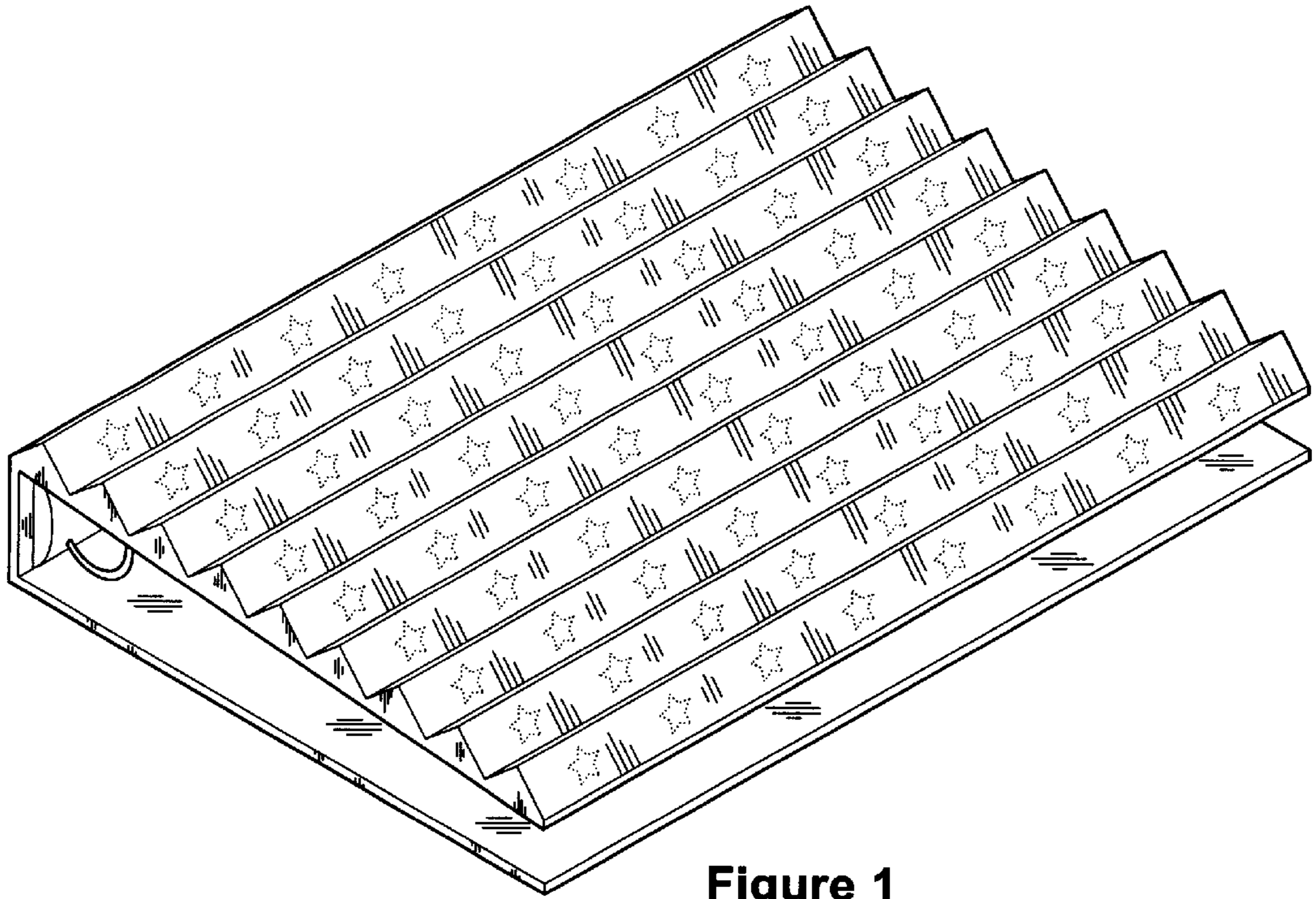

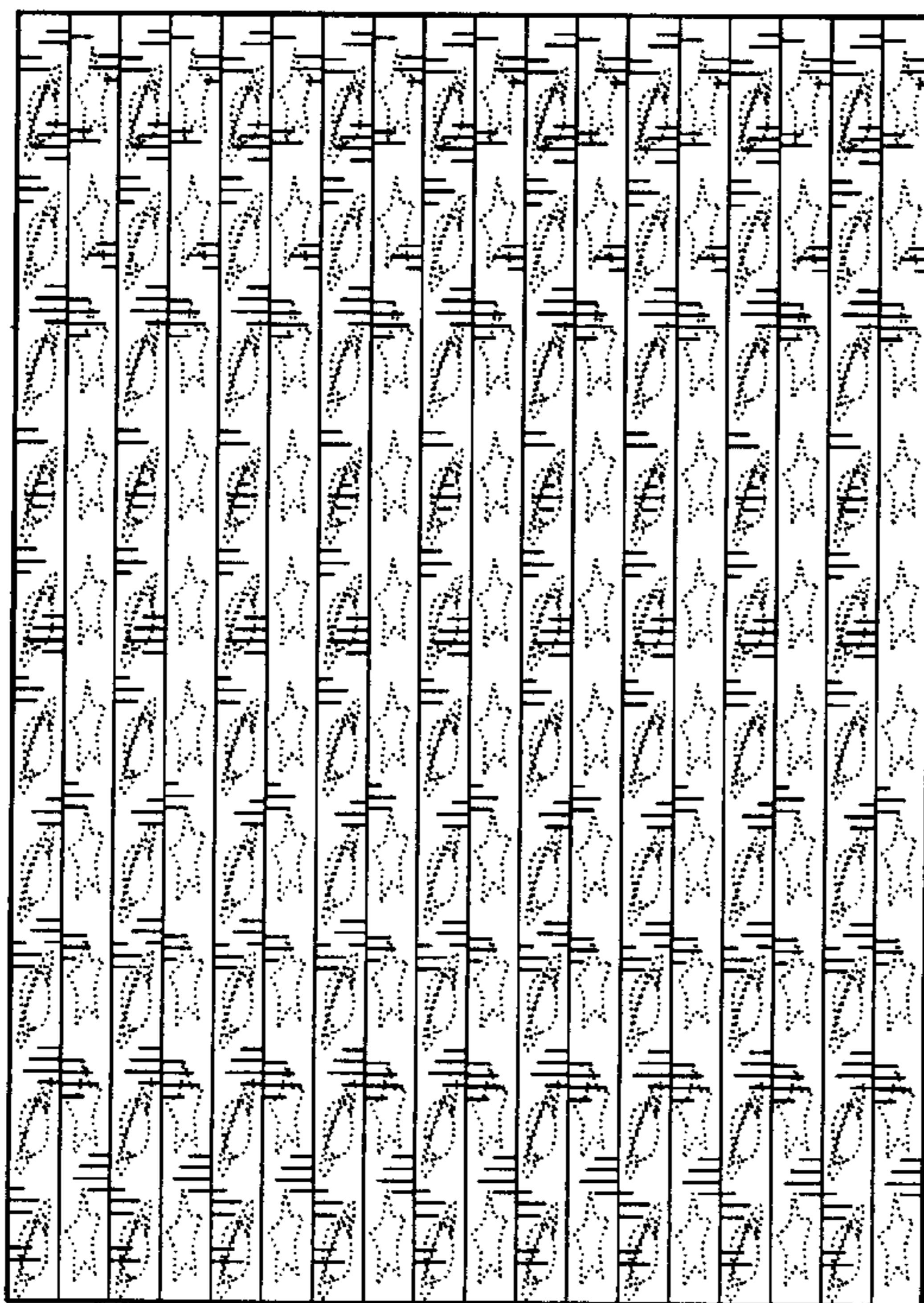

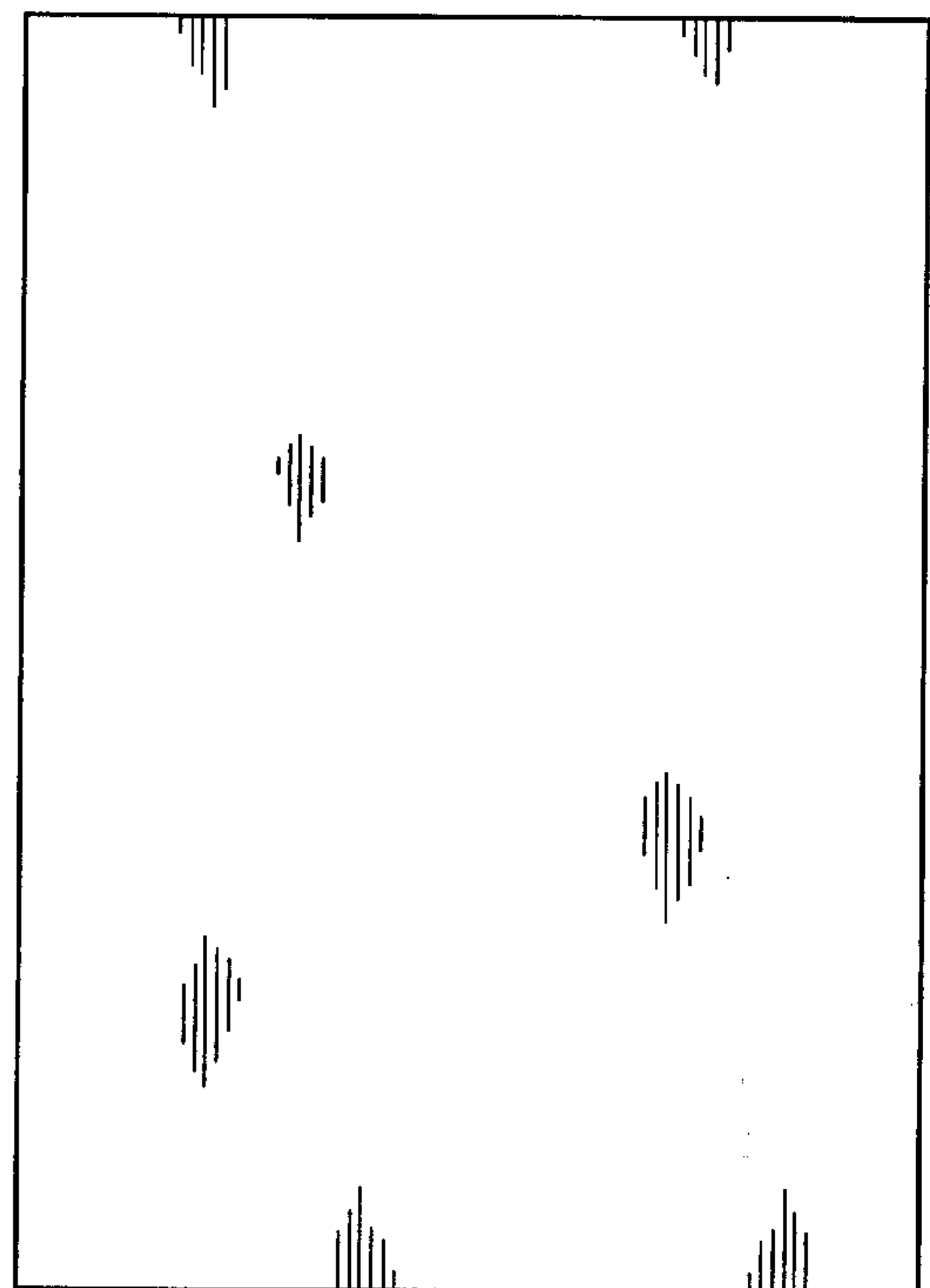

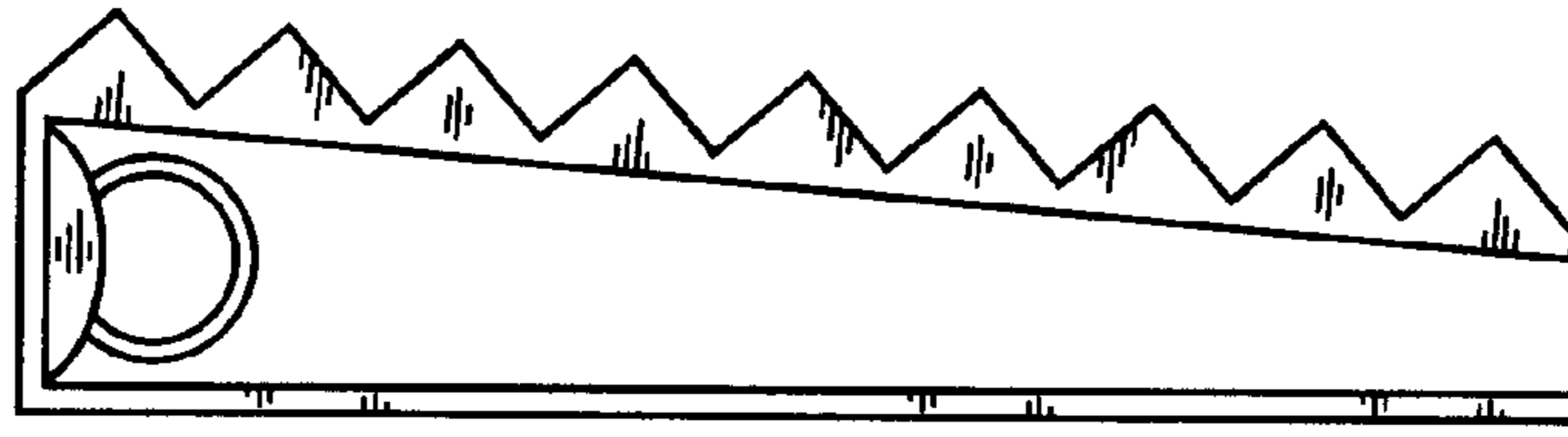

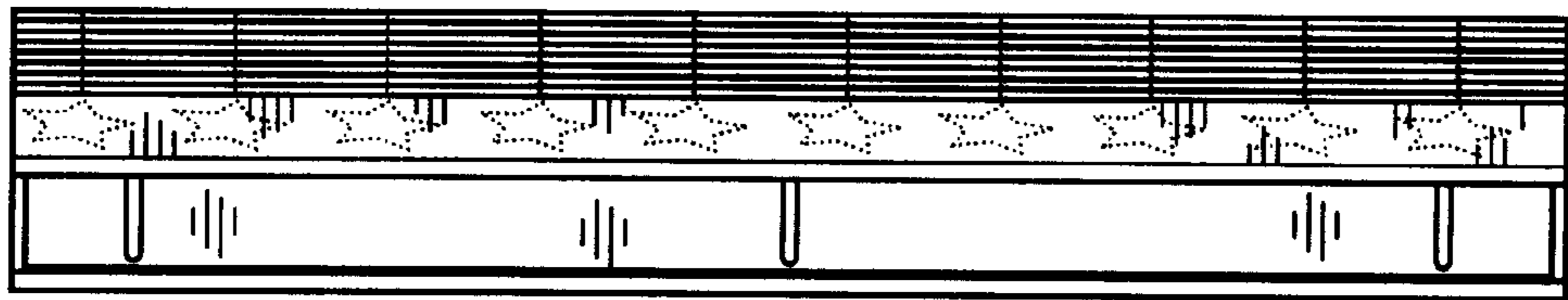

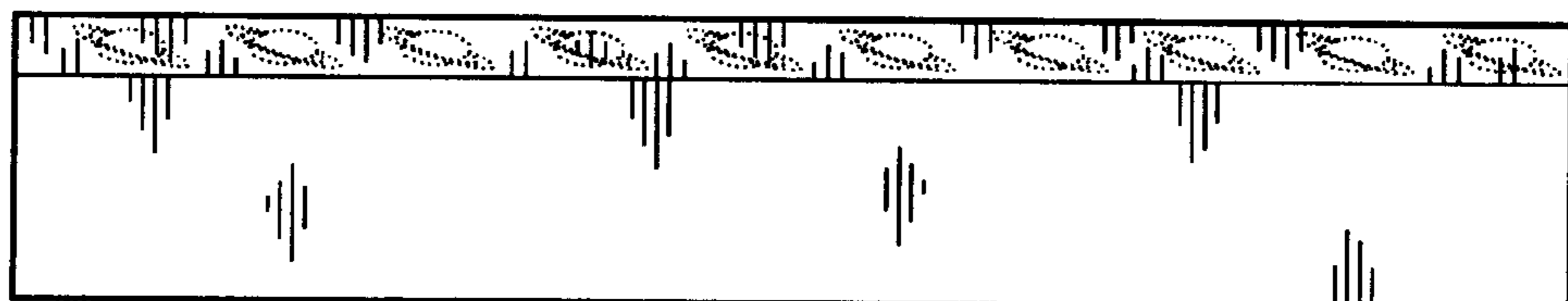

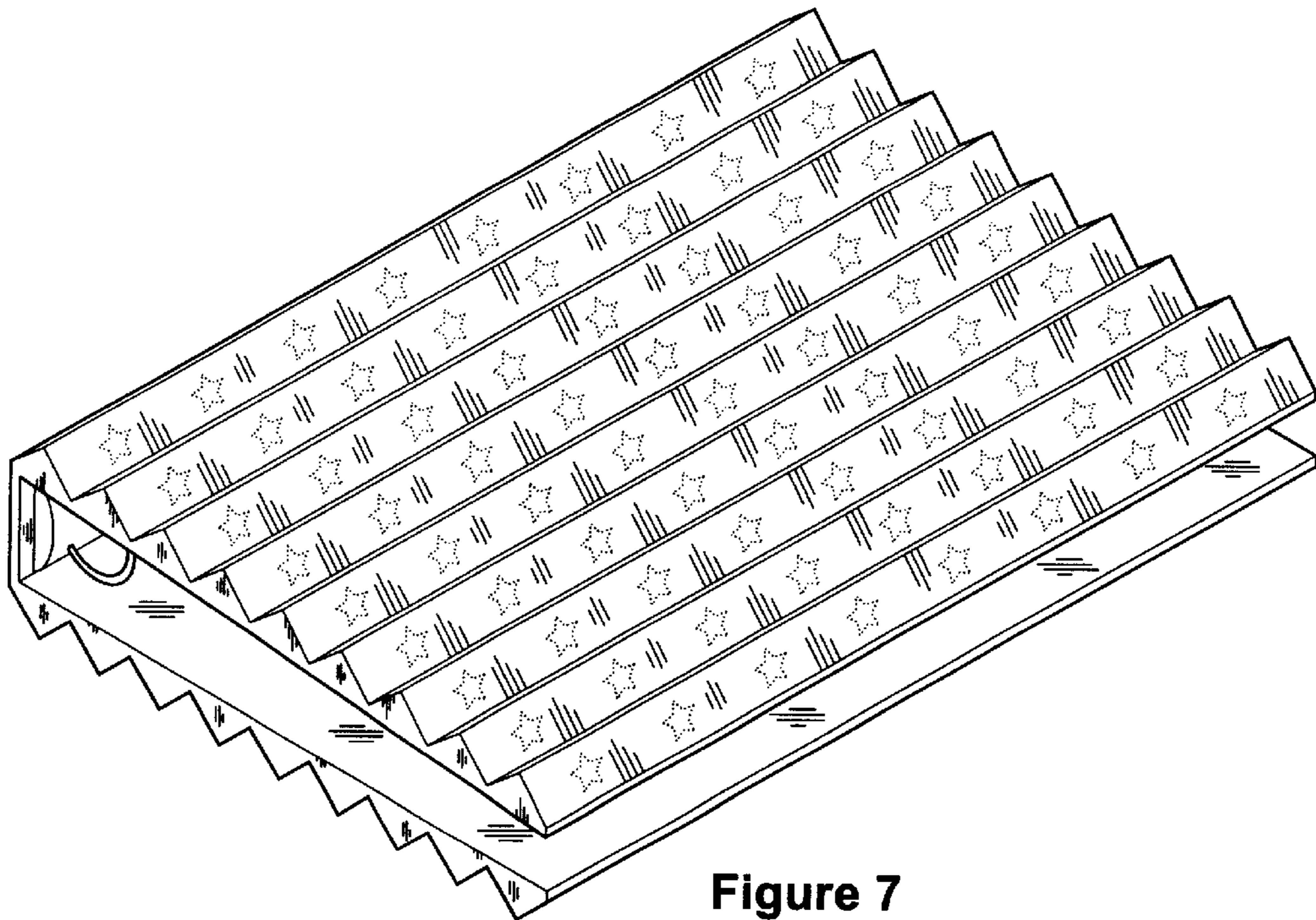

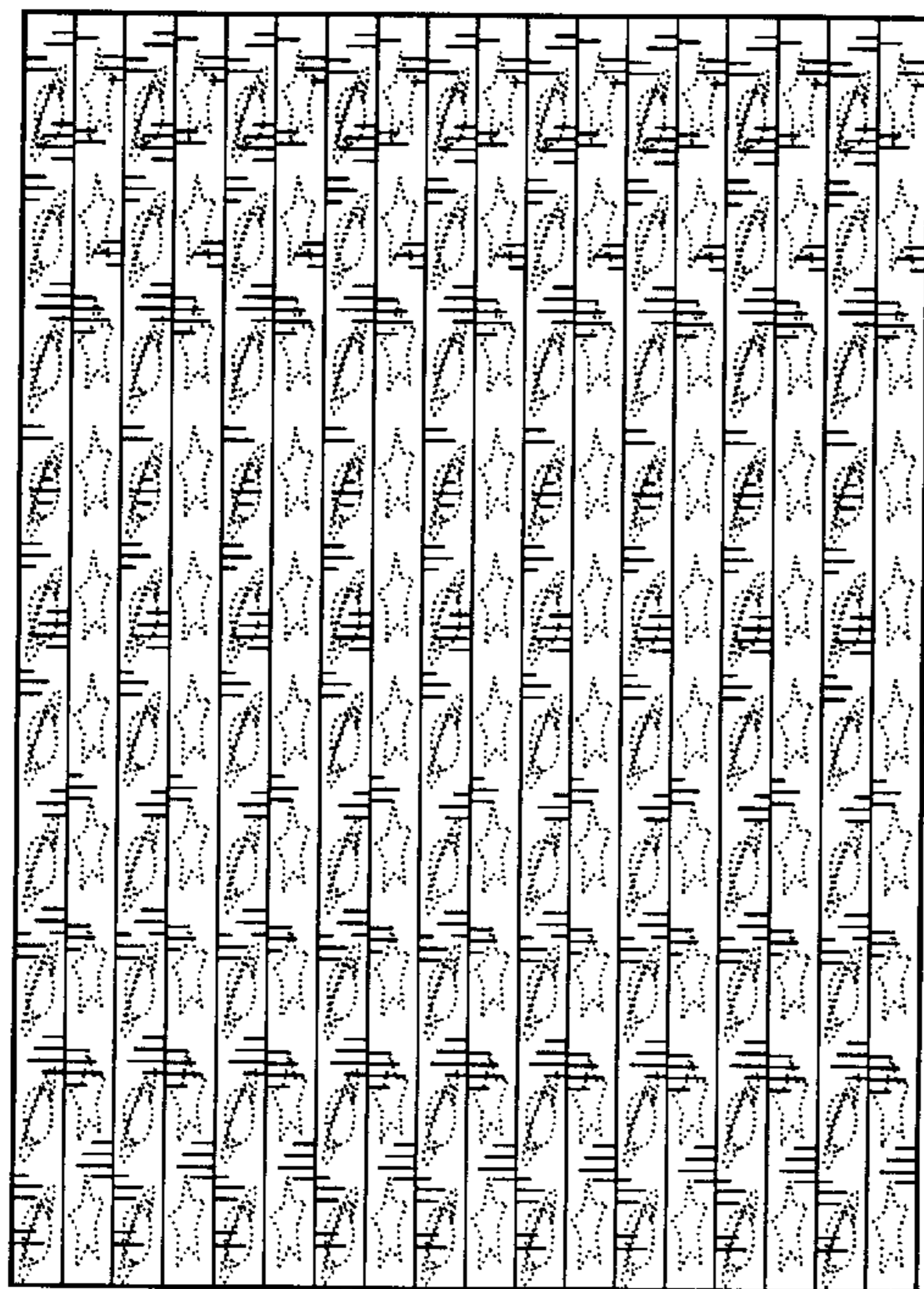

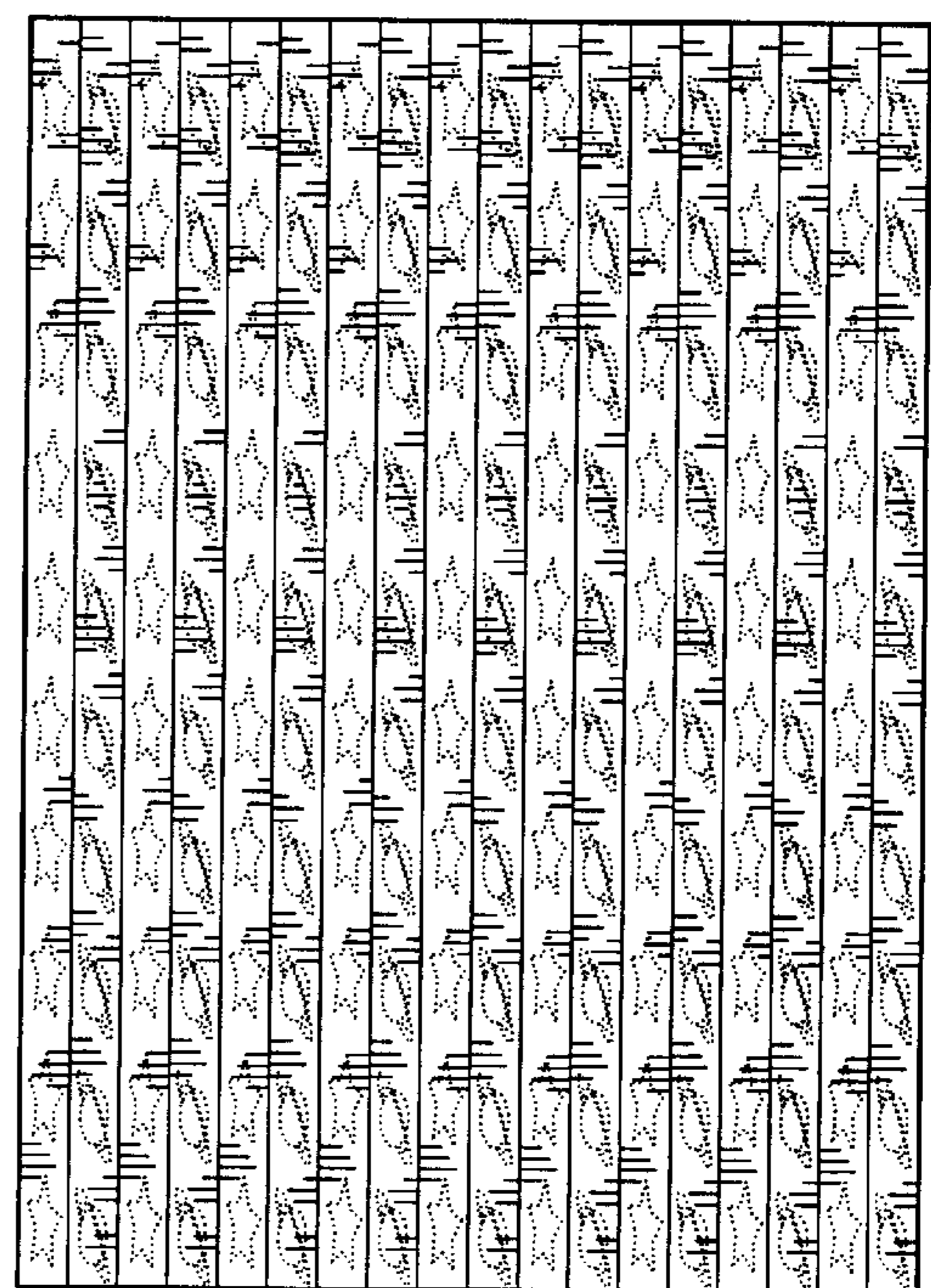

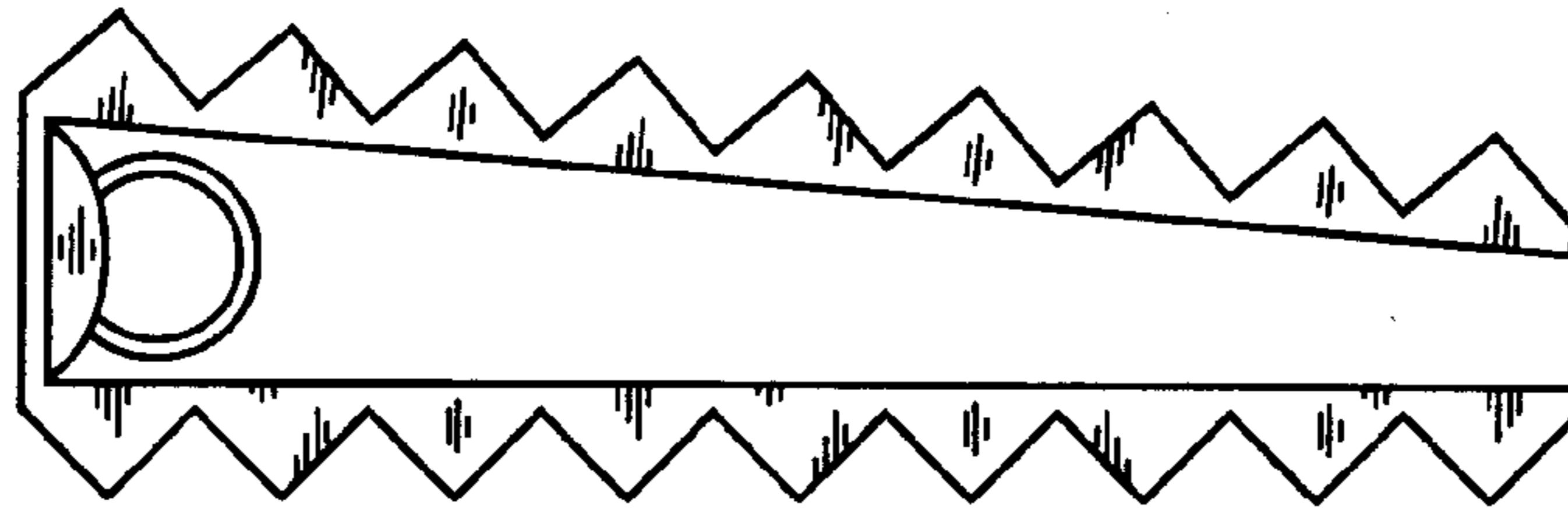

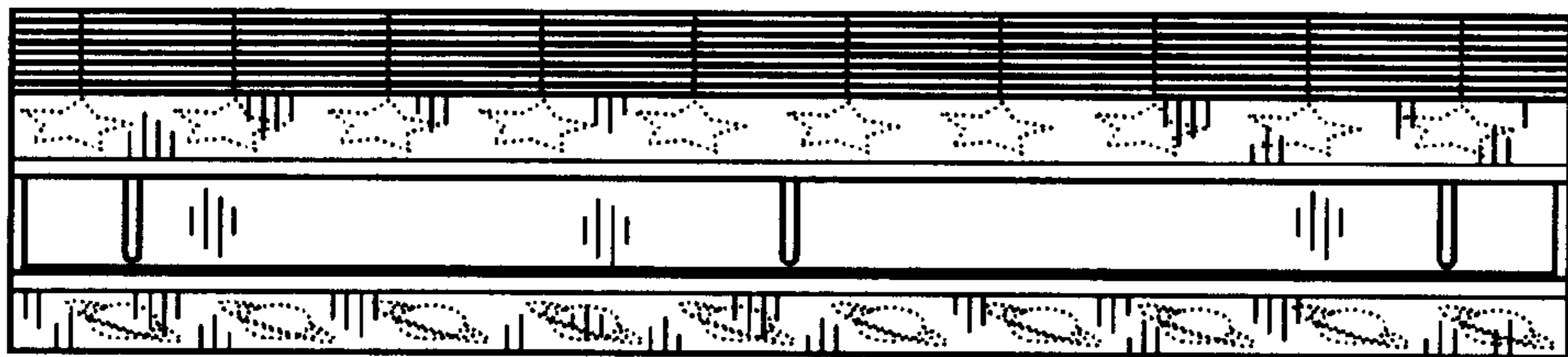

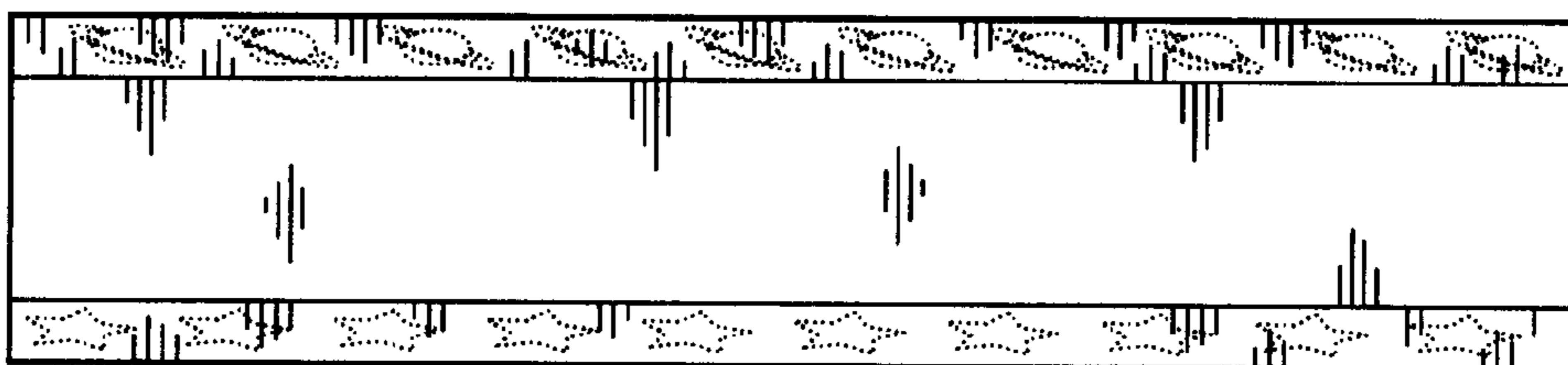

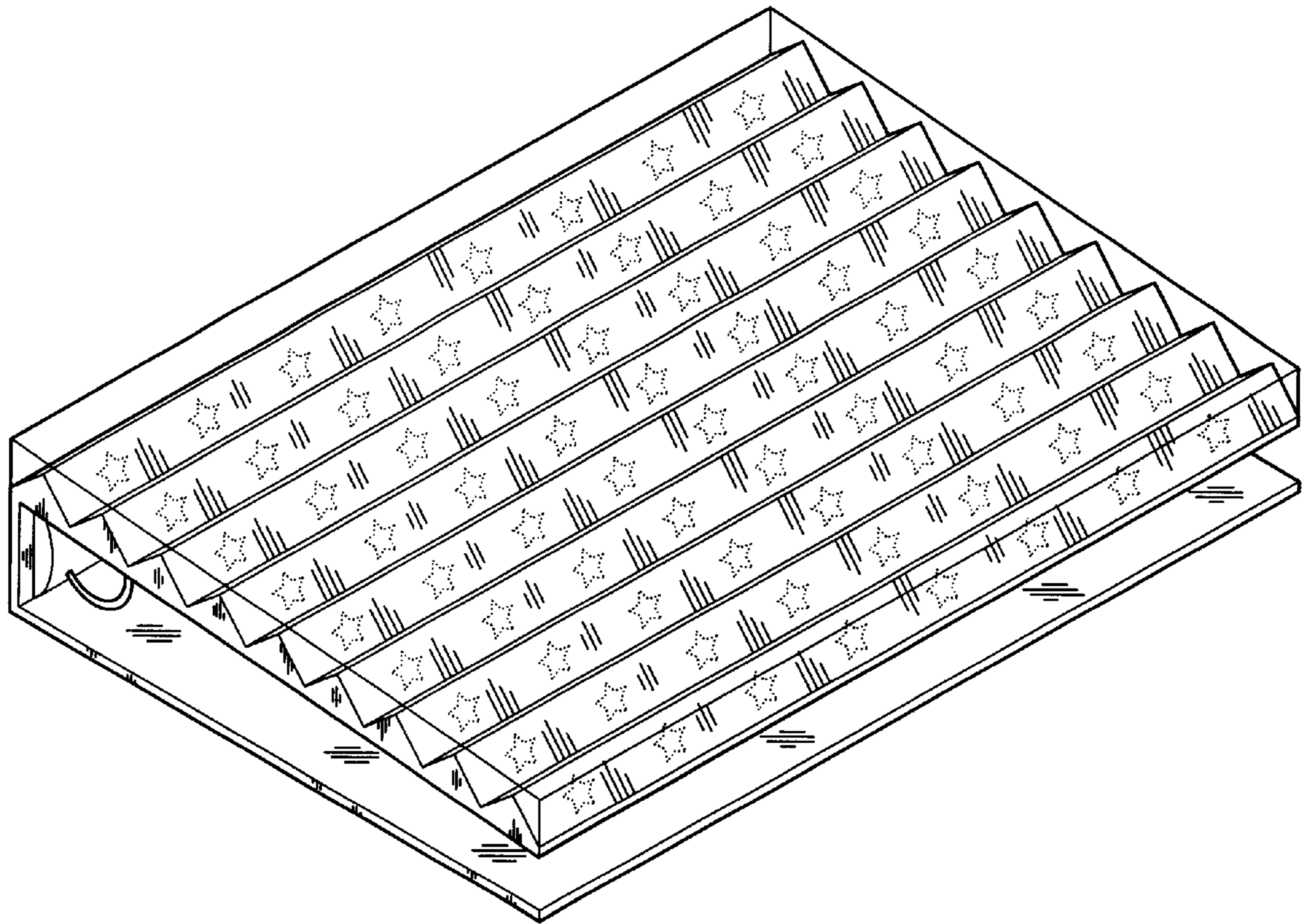
