FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

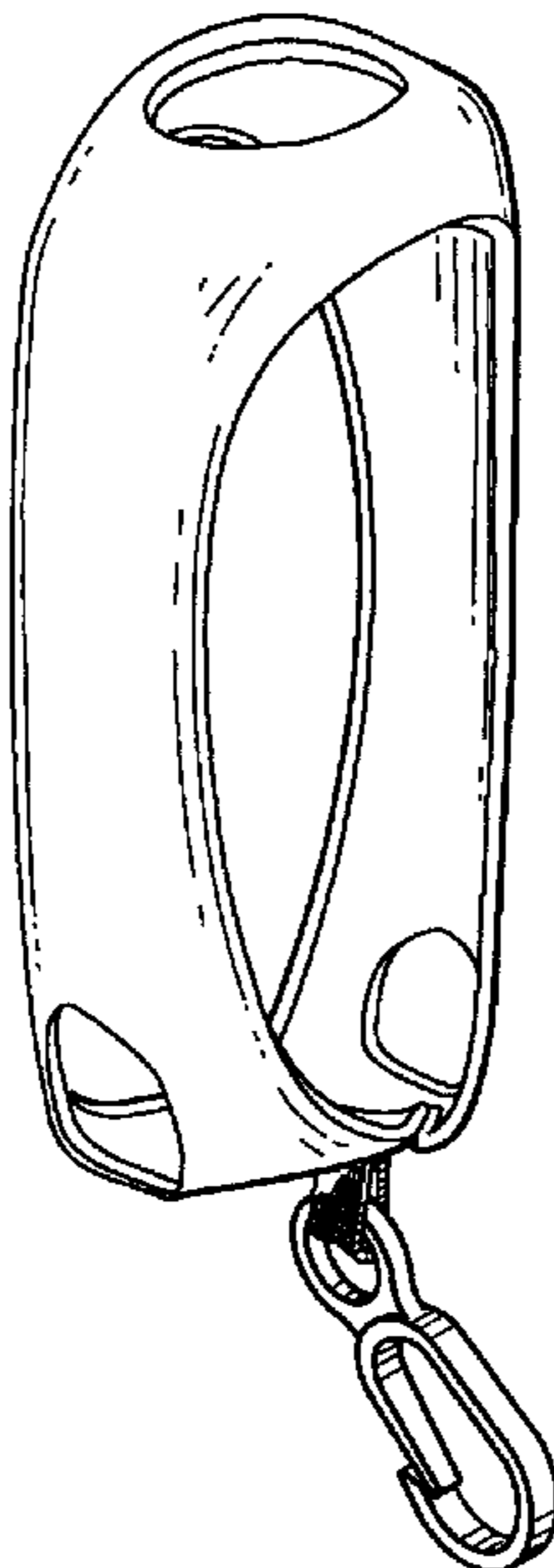
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

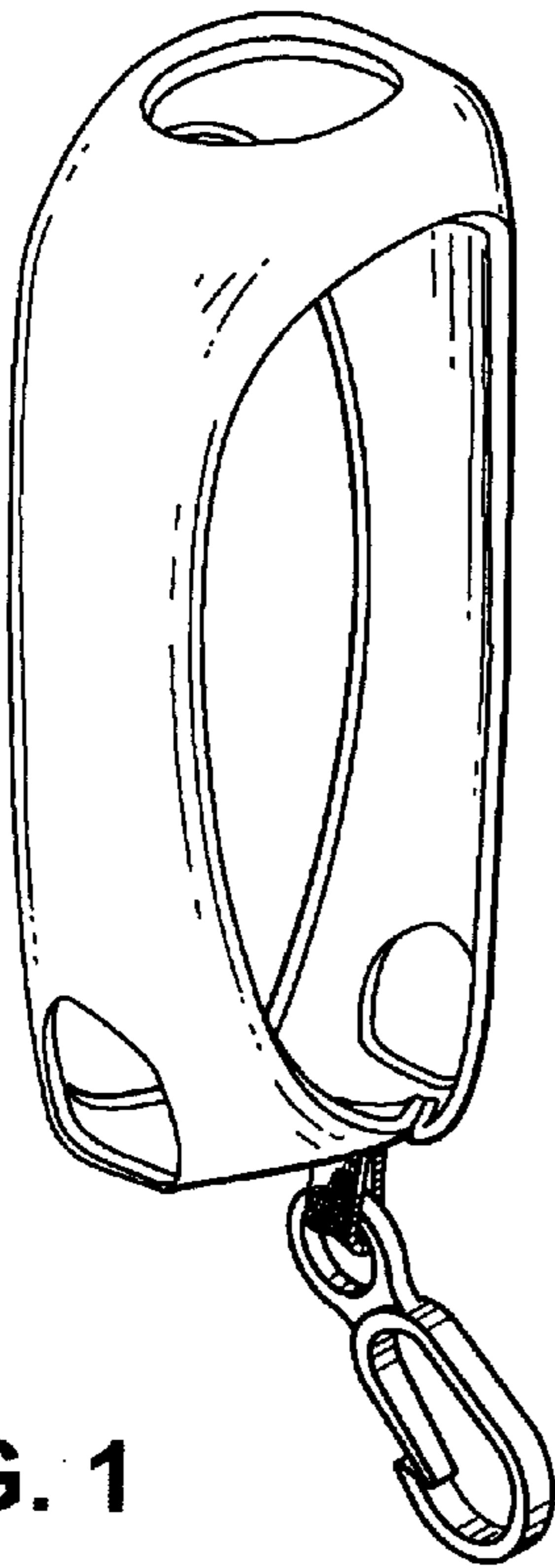

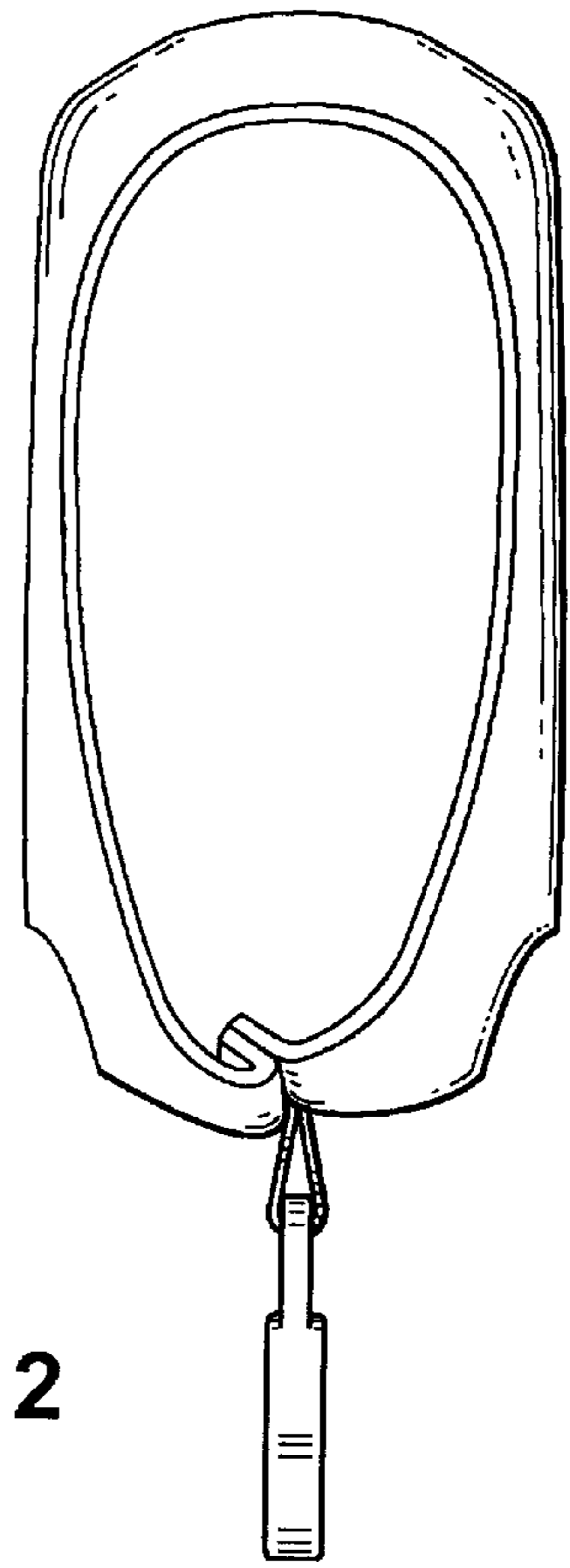

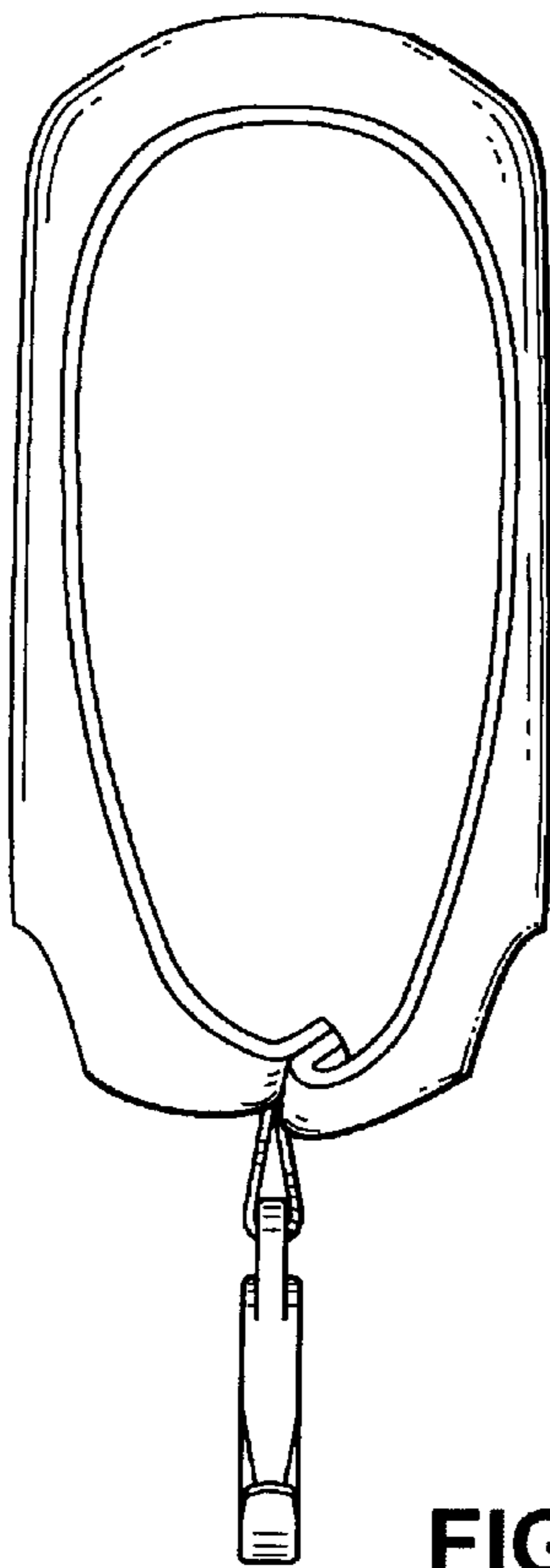

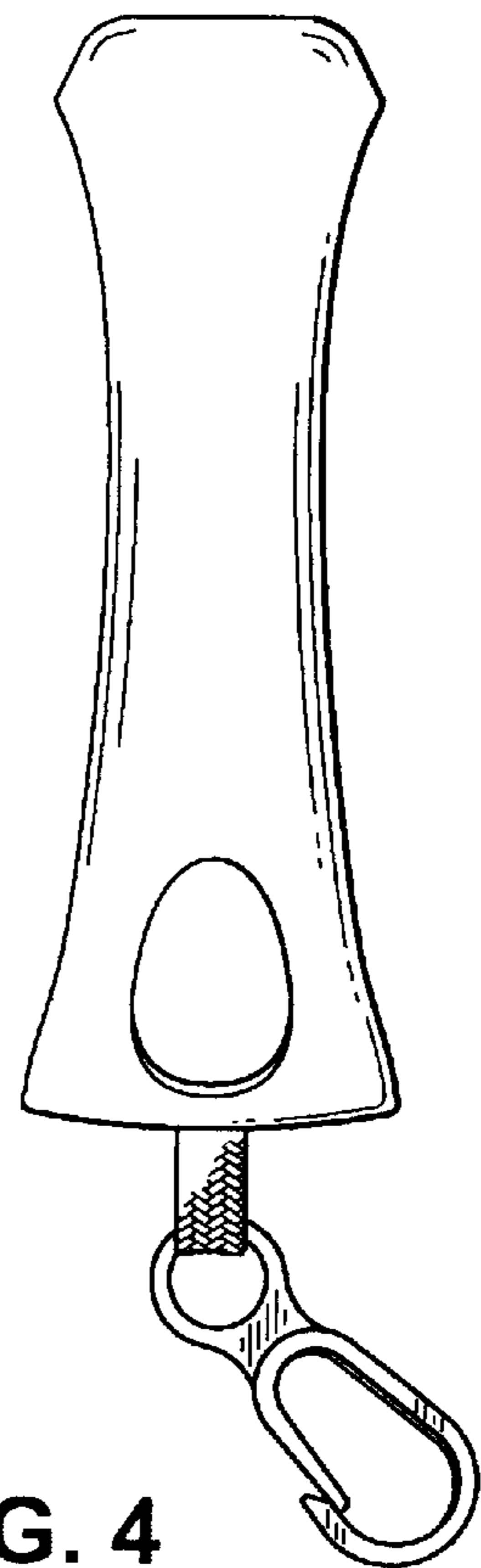

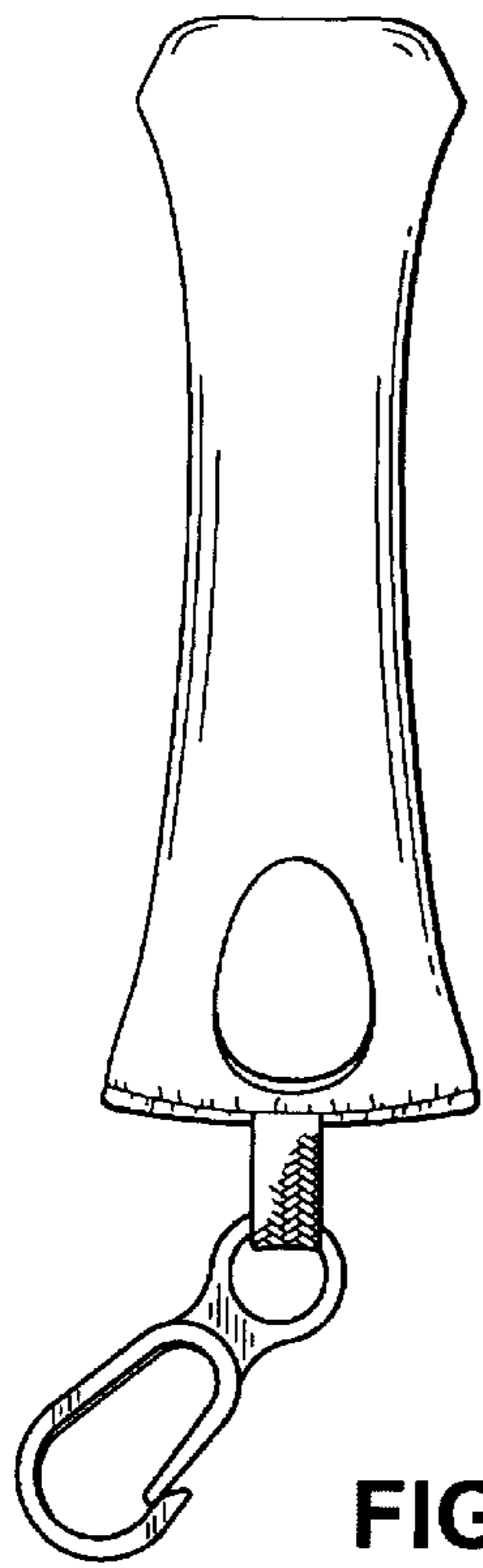

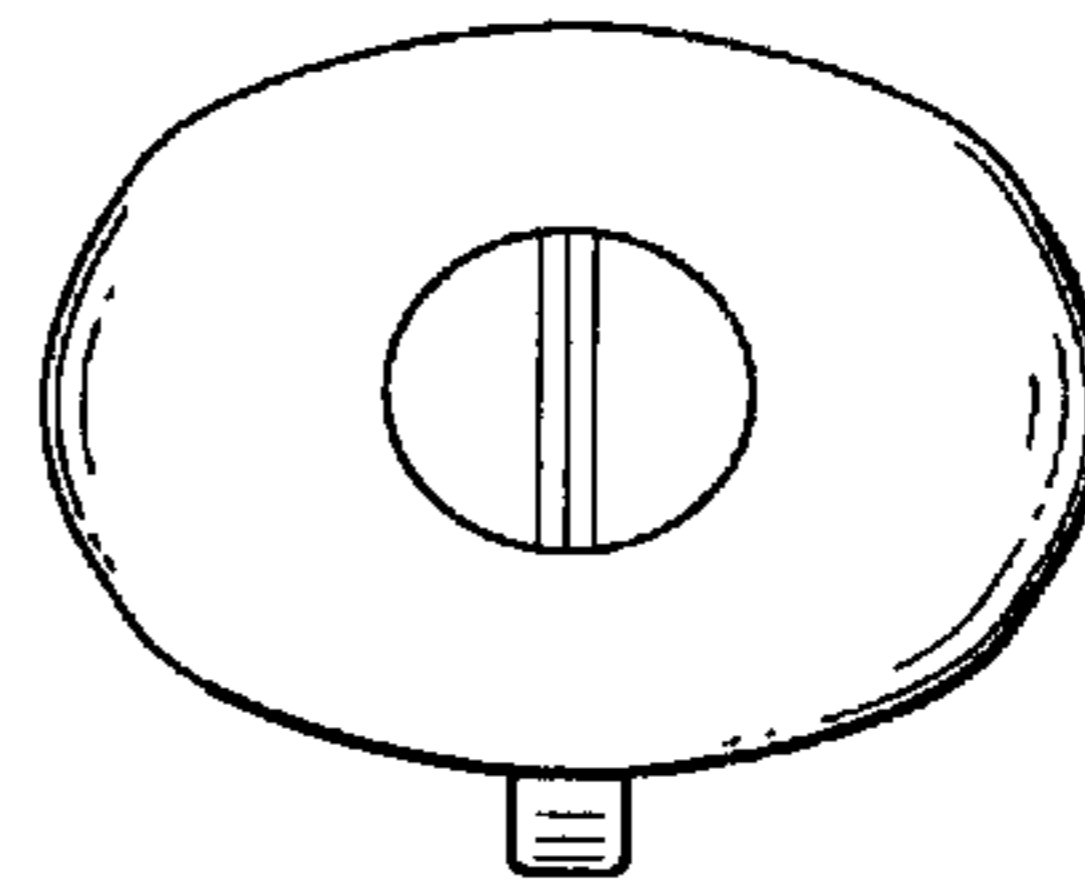

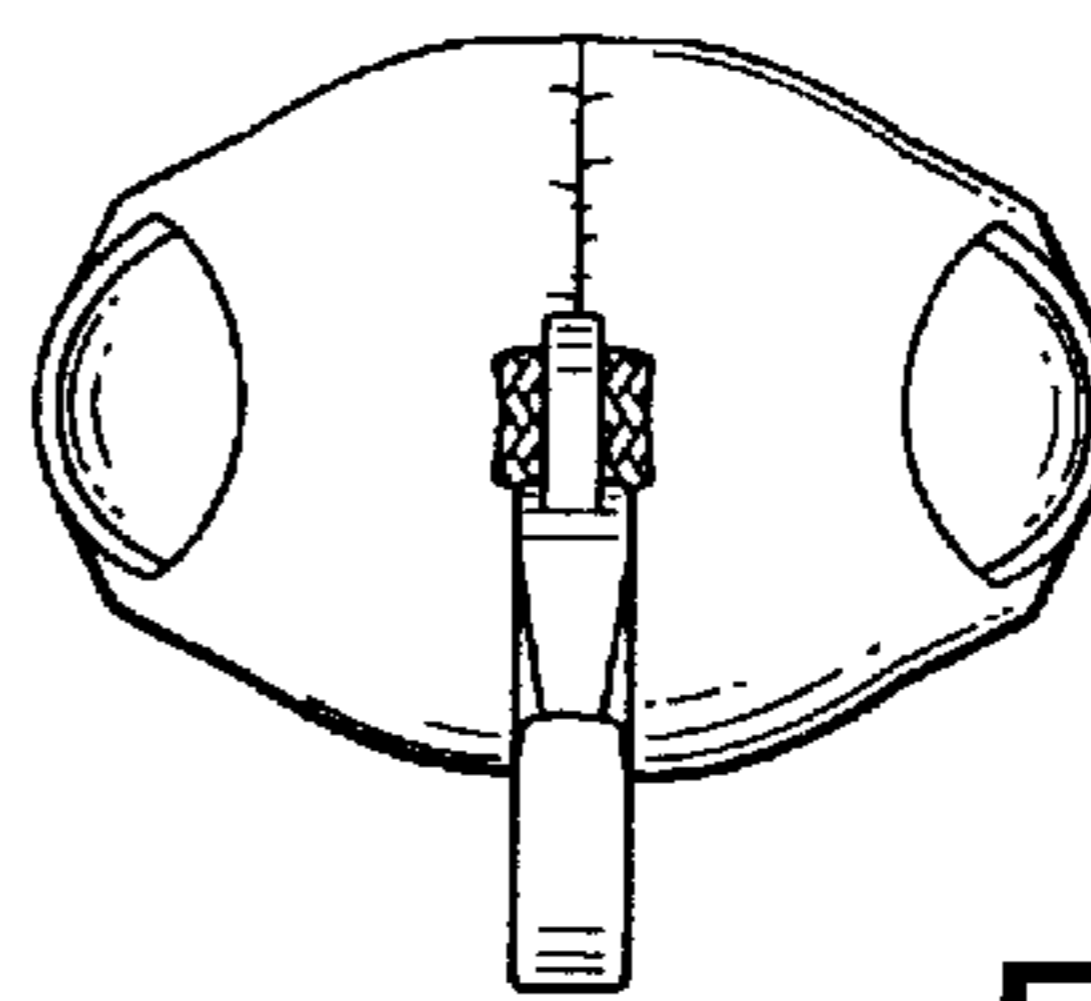

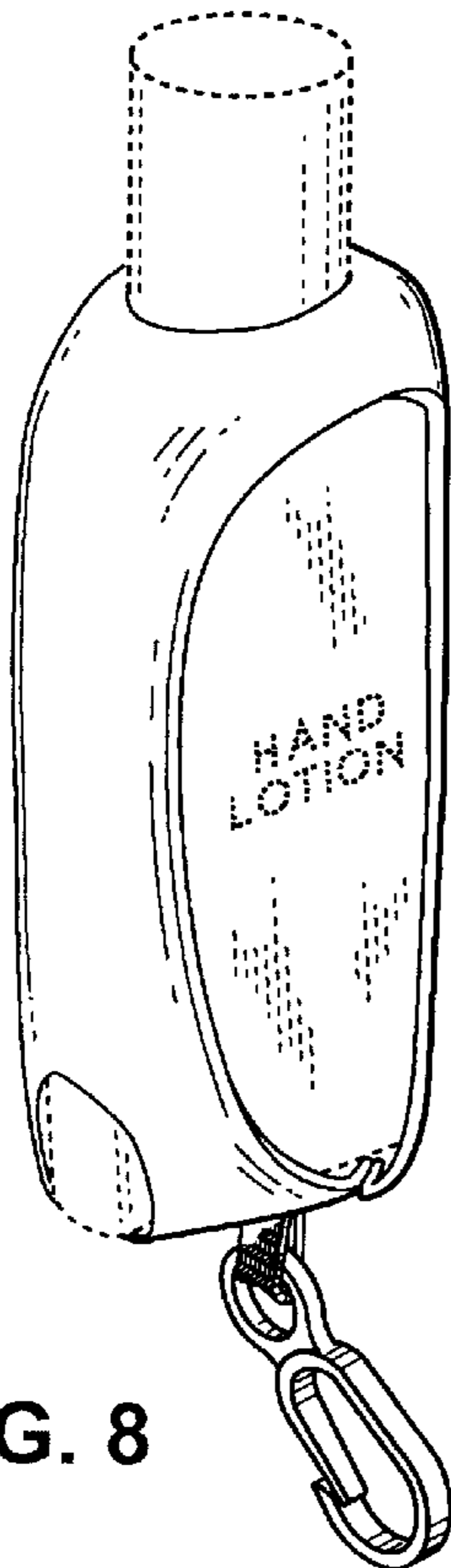

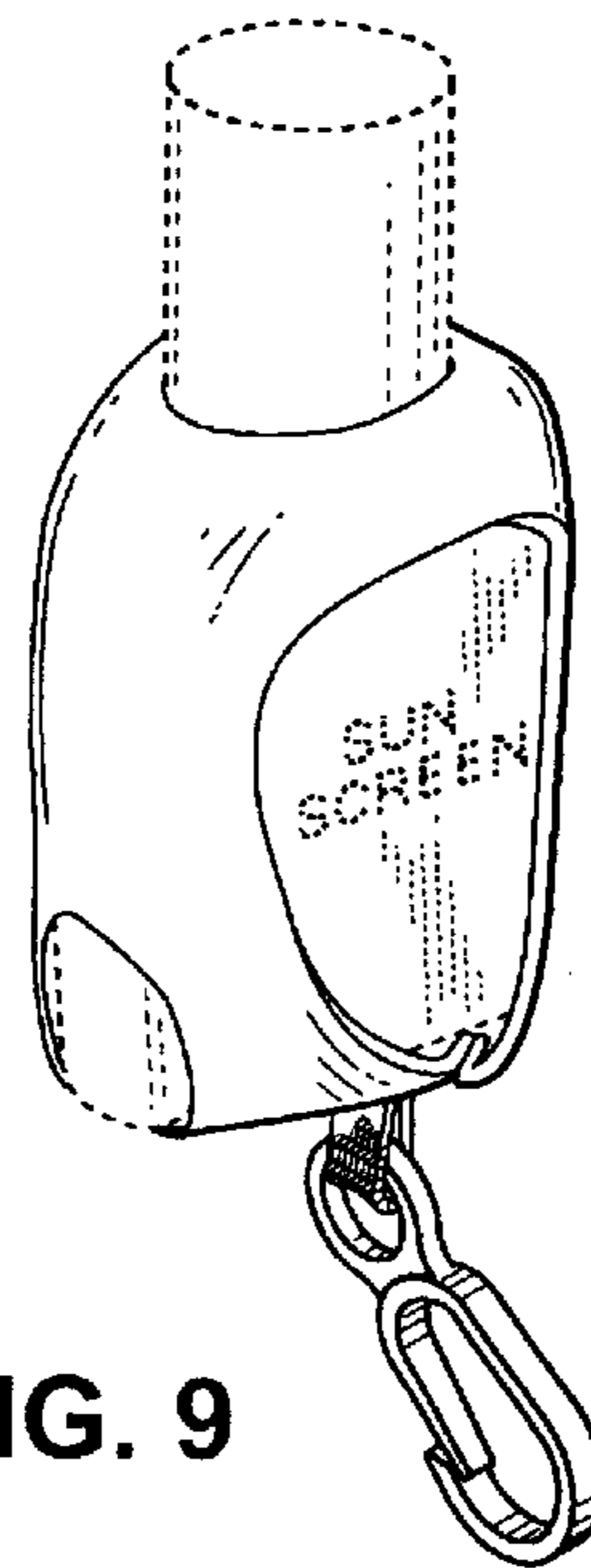
