FIG. 2 is a rear view of the surveillance unit thereof;

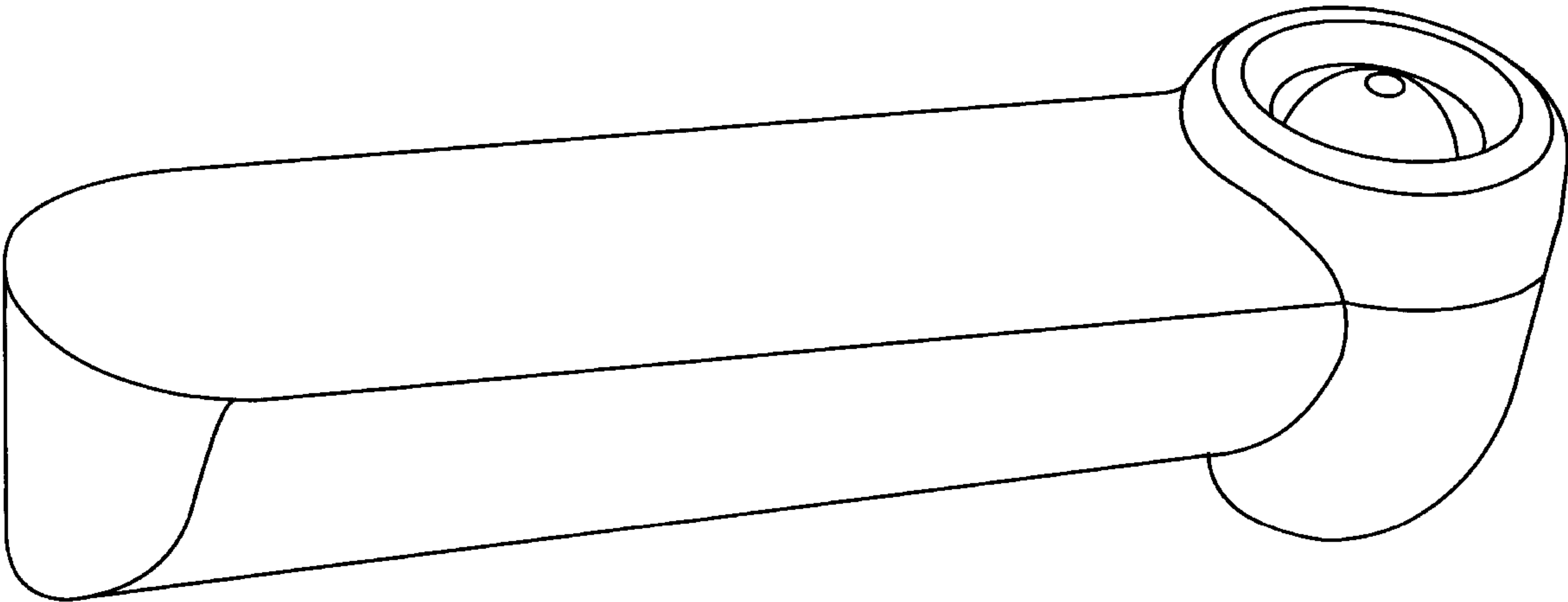
FIG. 3 is a front view of the surveillance unit thereof;

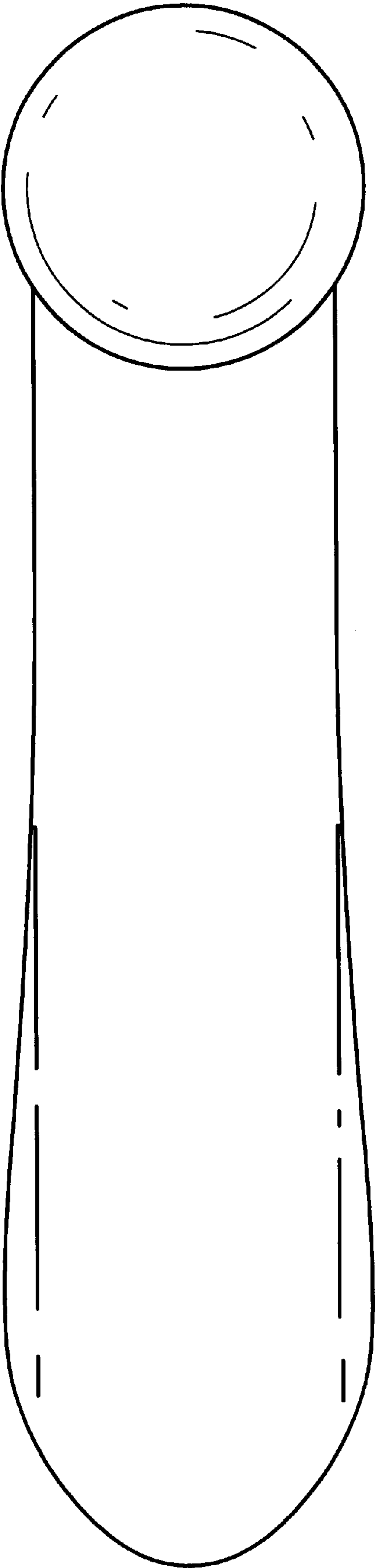

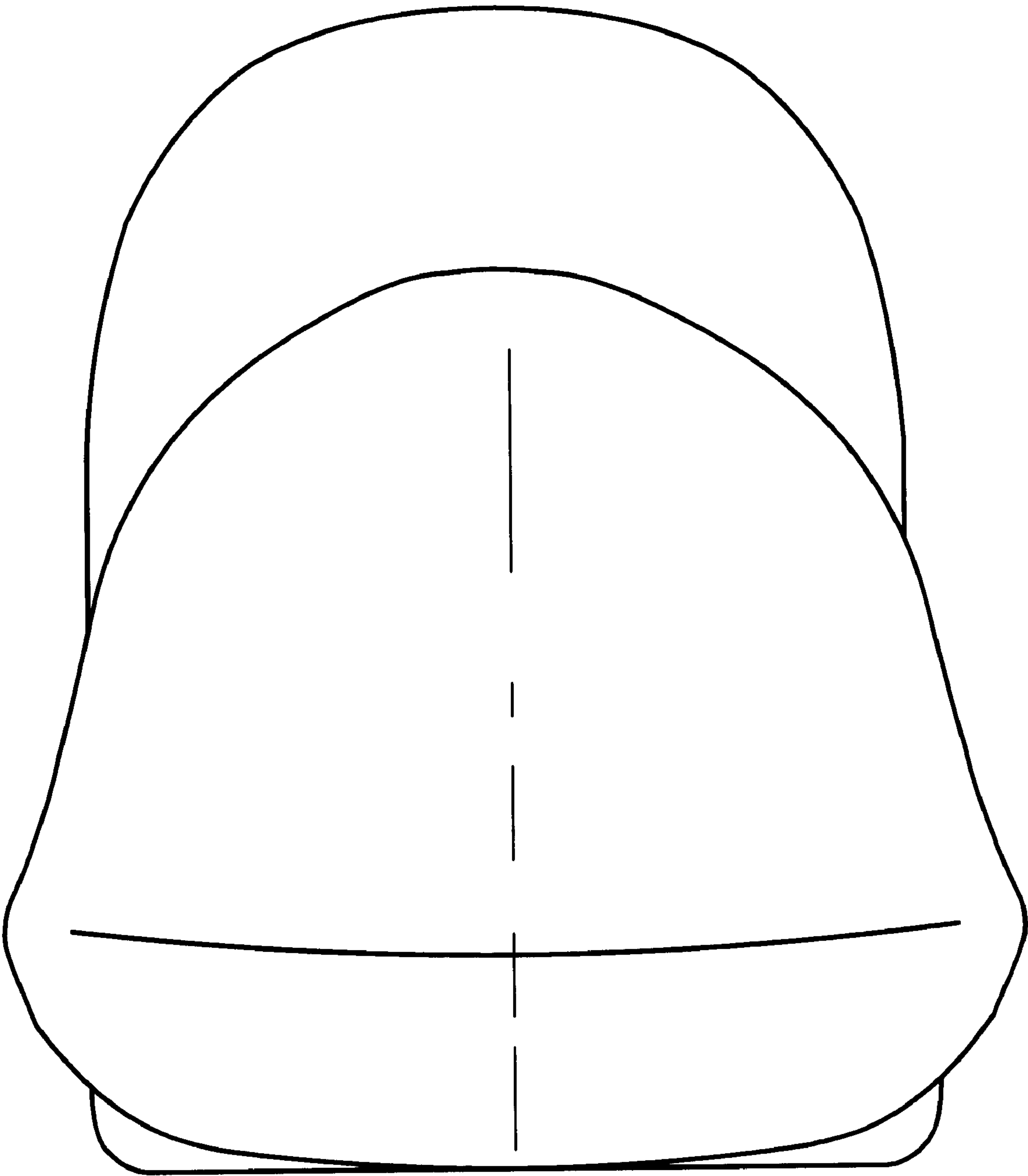

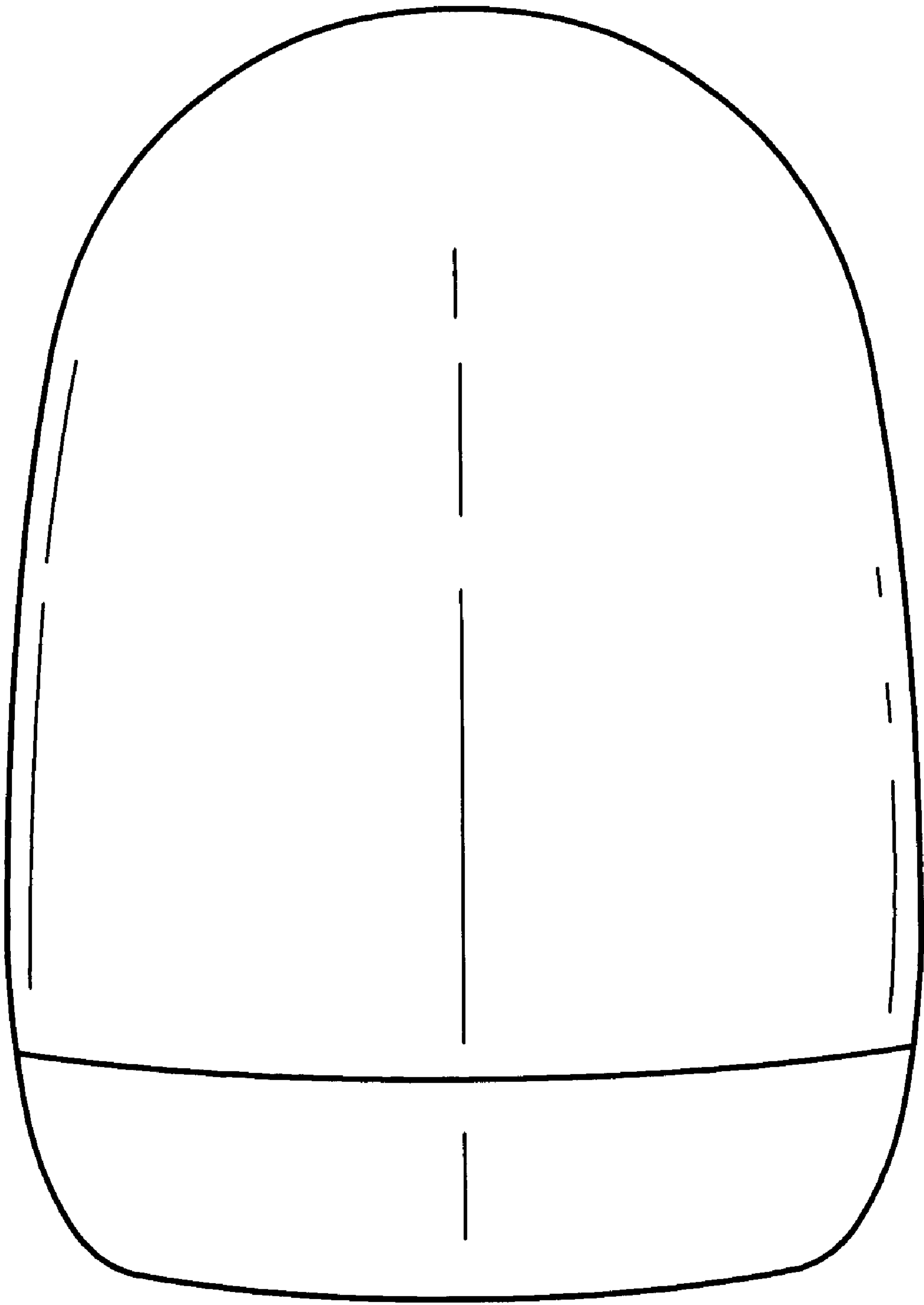

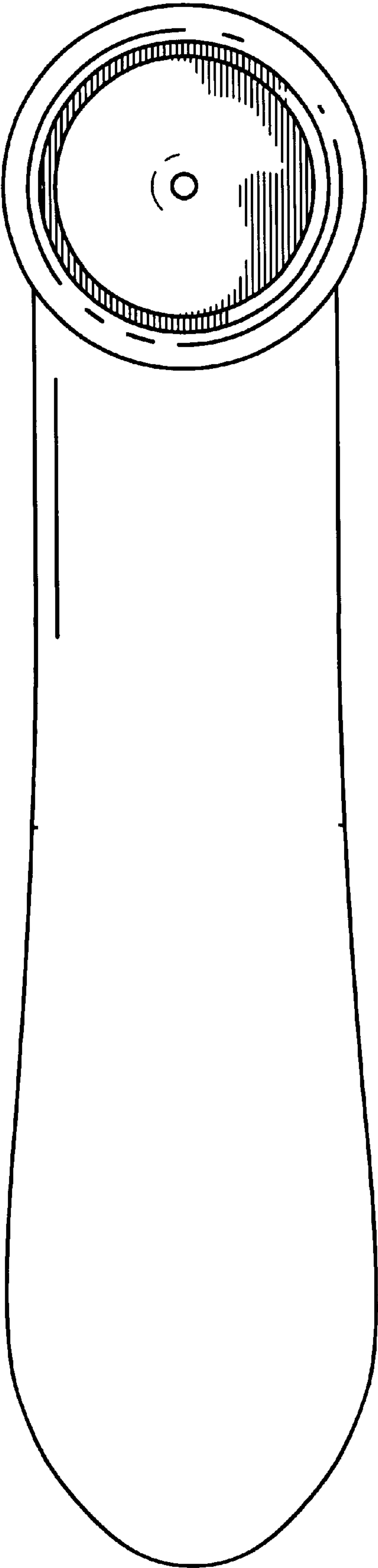

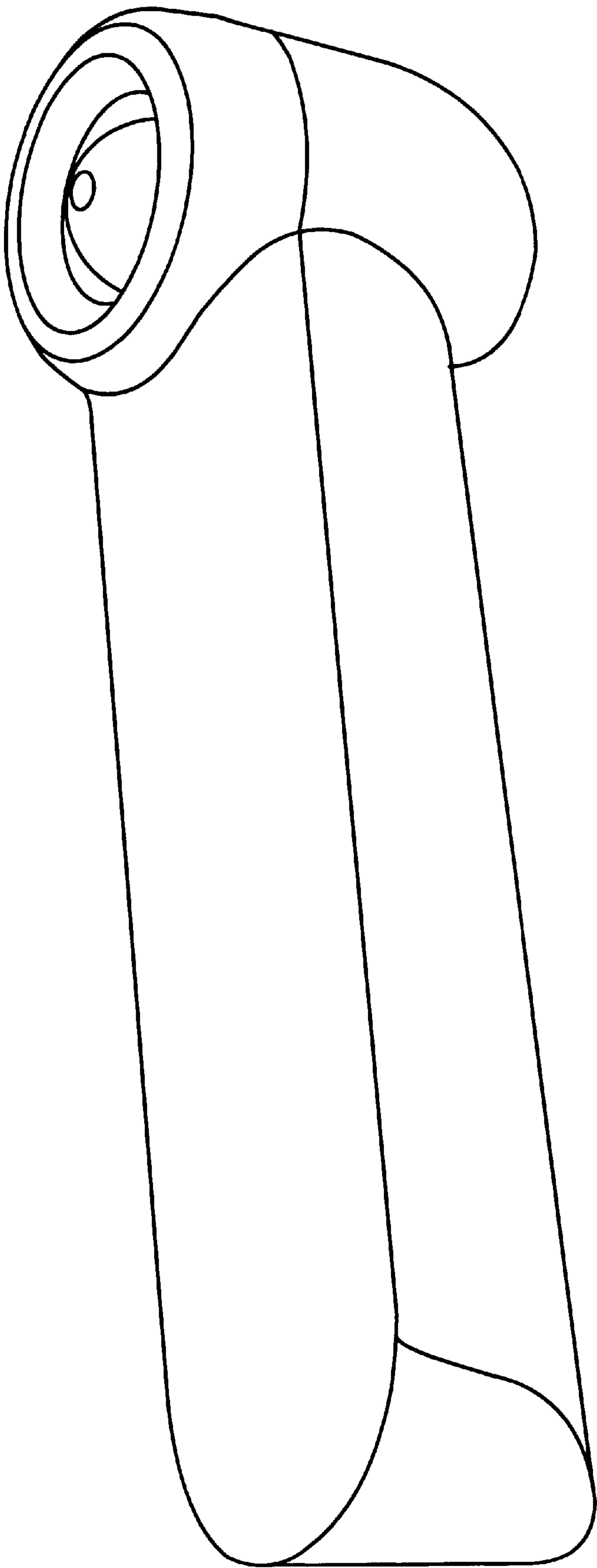
