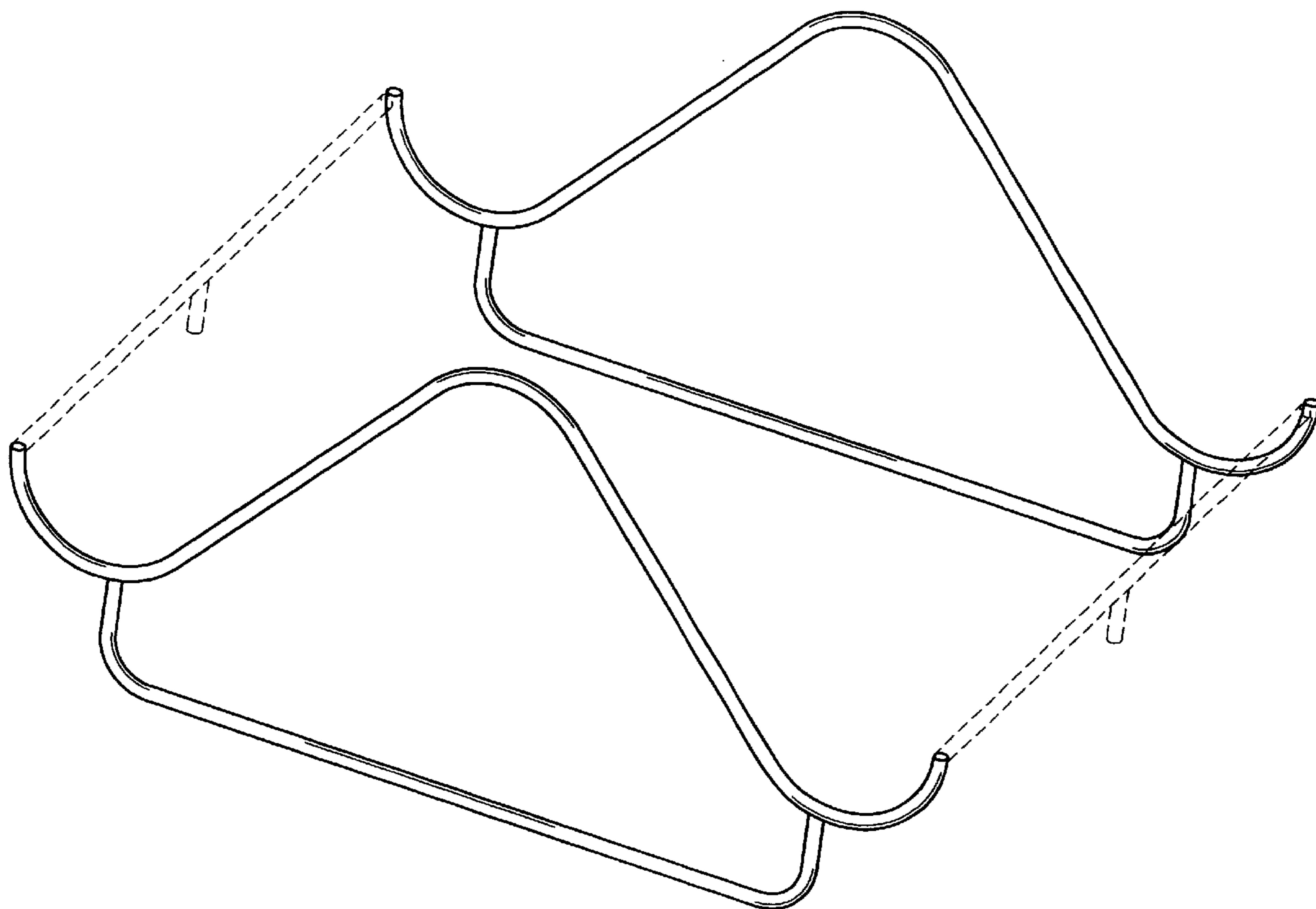
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a light watercraft rack, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a light watercraft rack of the present invention;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof, the rear elevation view being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view thereof, the right side elevation view being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and,
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.
 The broken lines shown in the FIGS. 1, 3, 4, and 5 drawing views are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

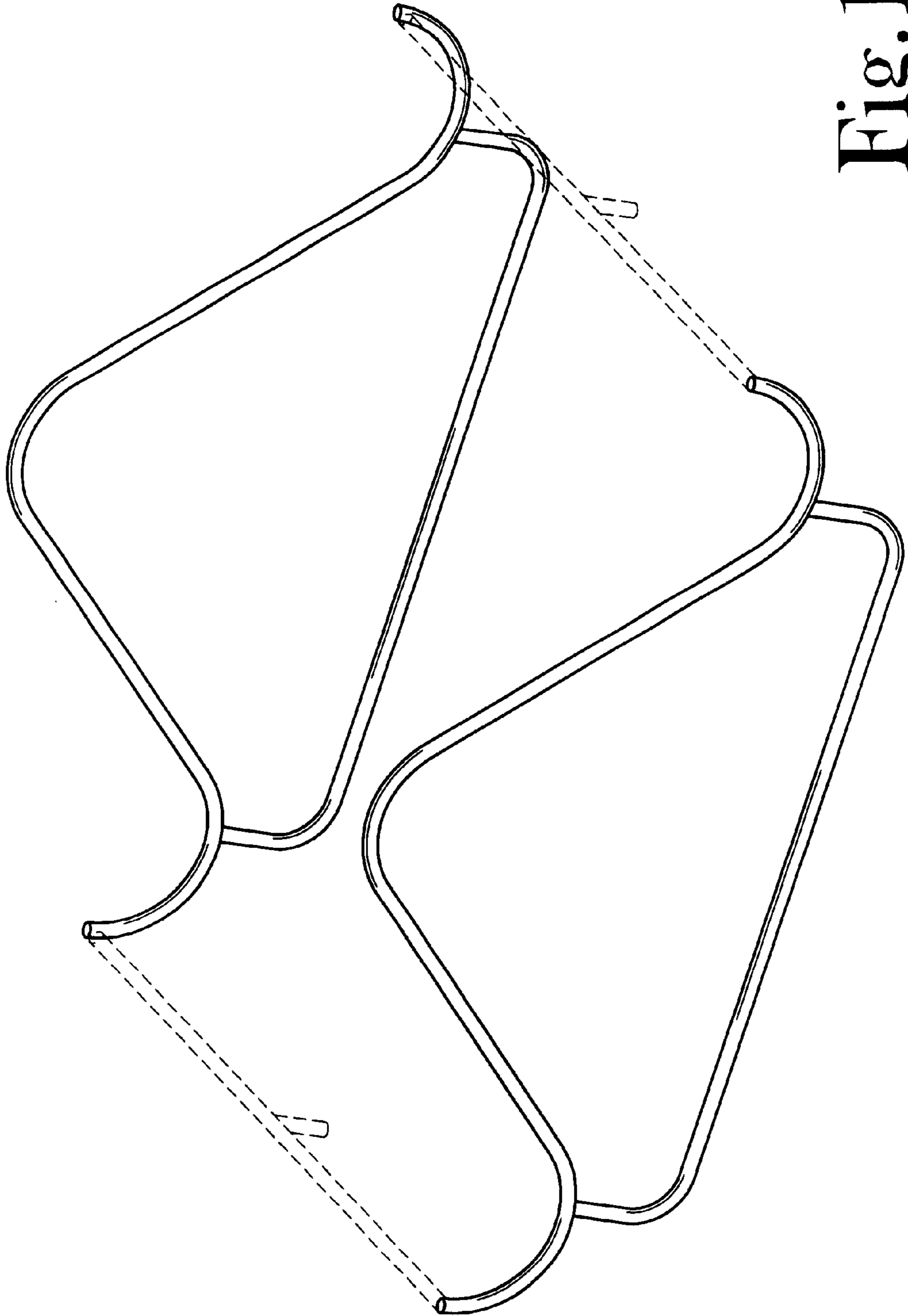

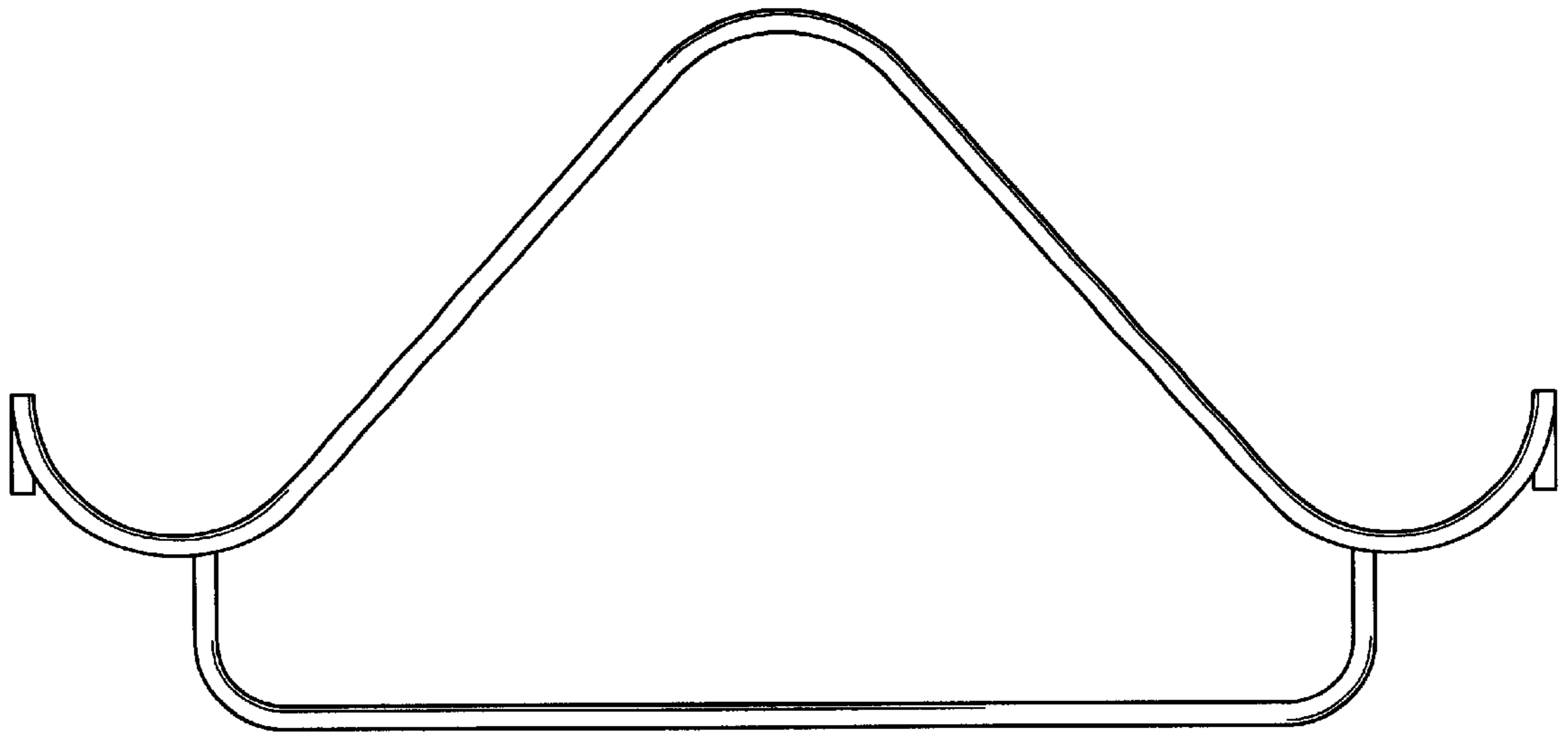

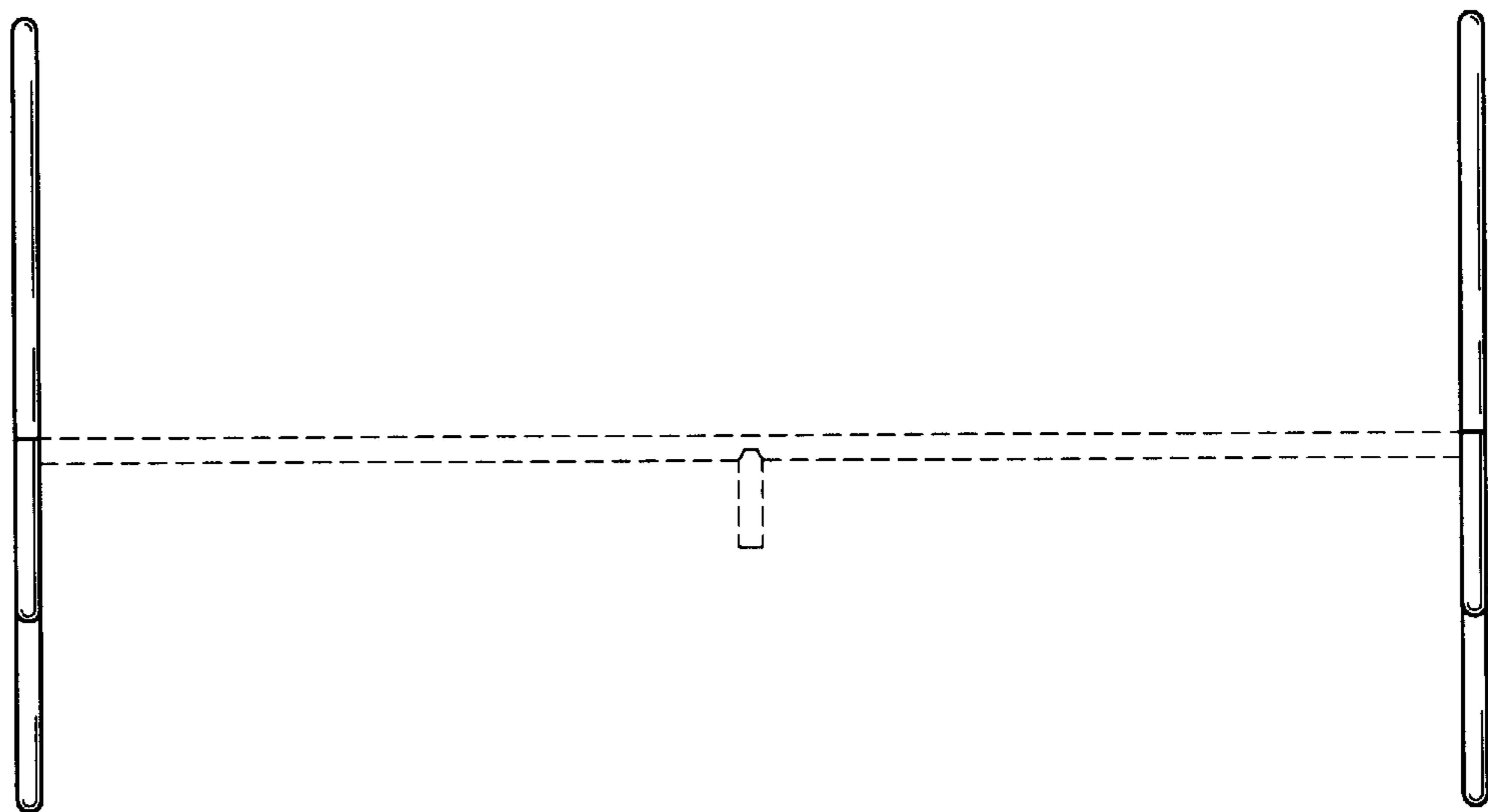

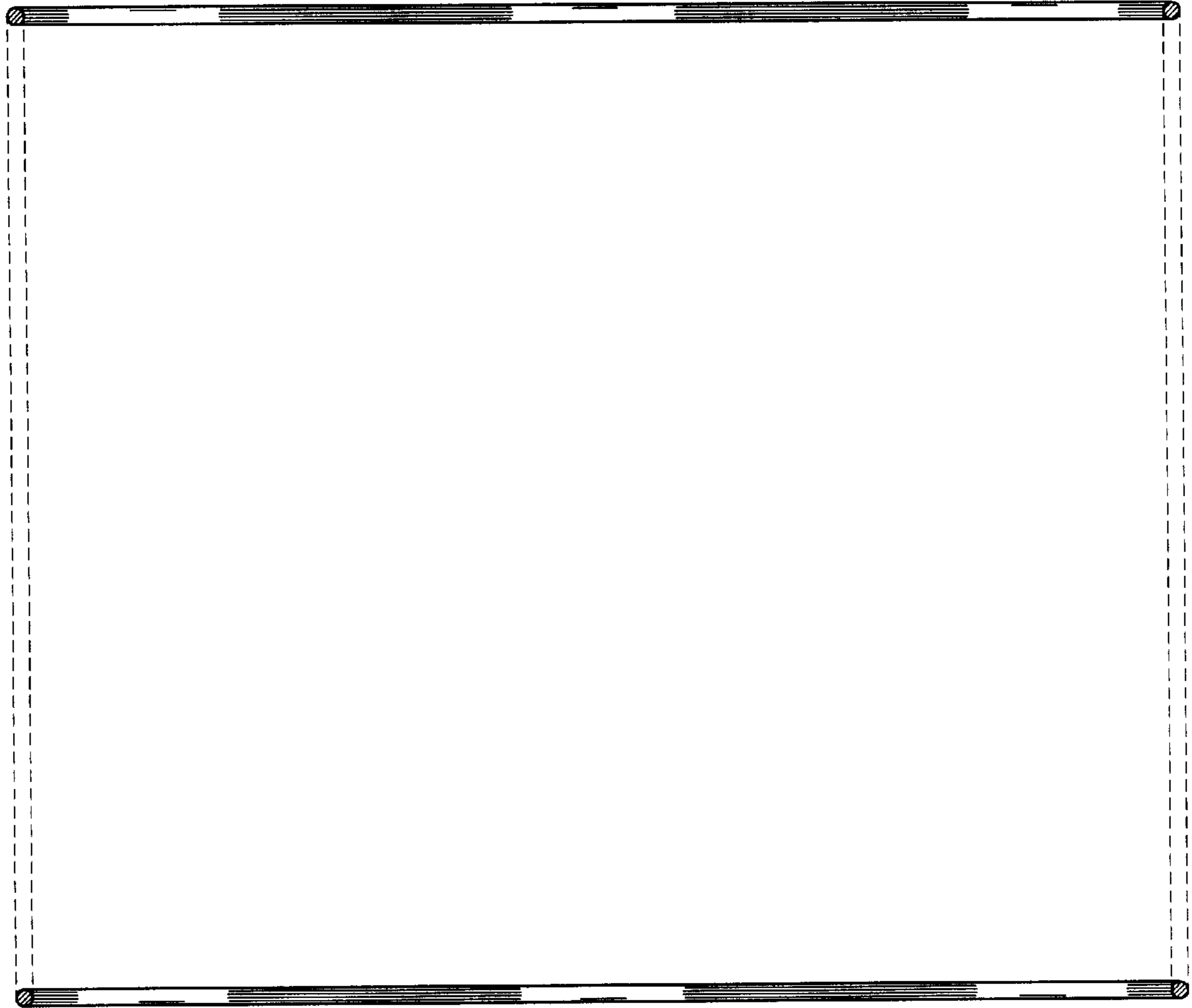

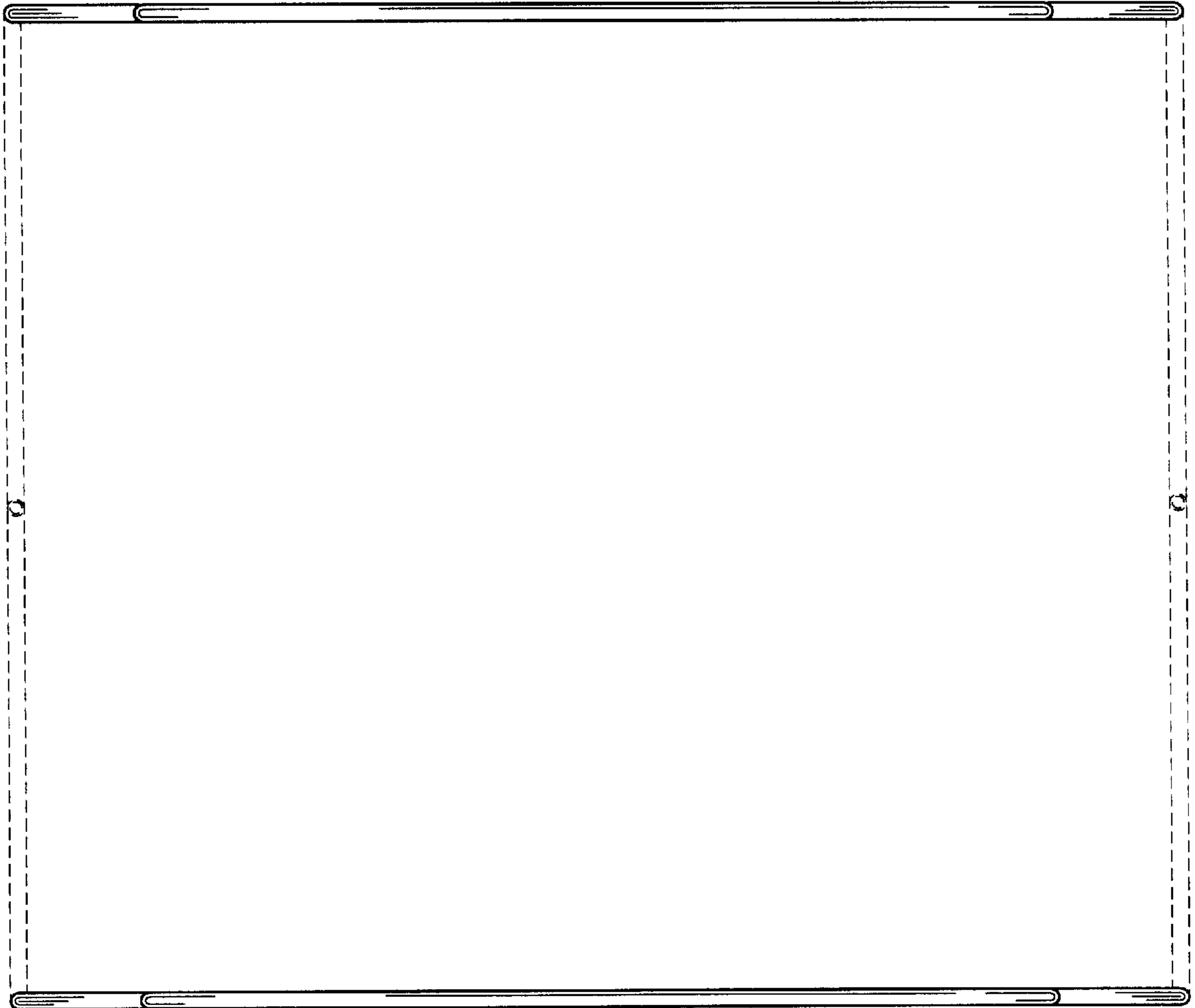
