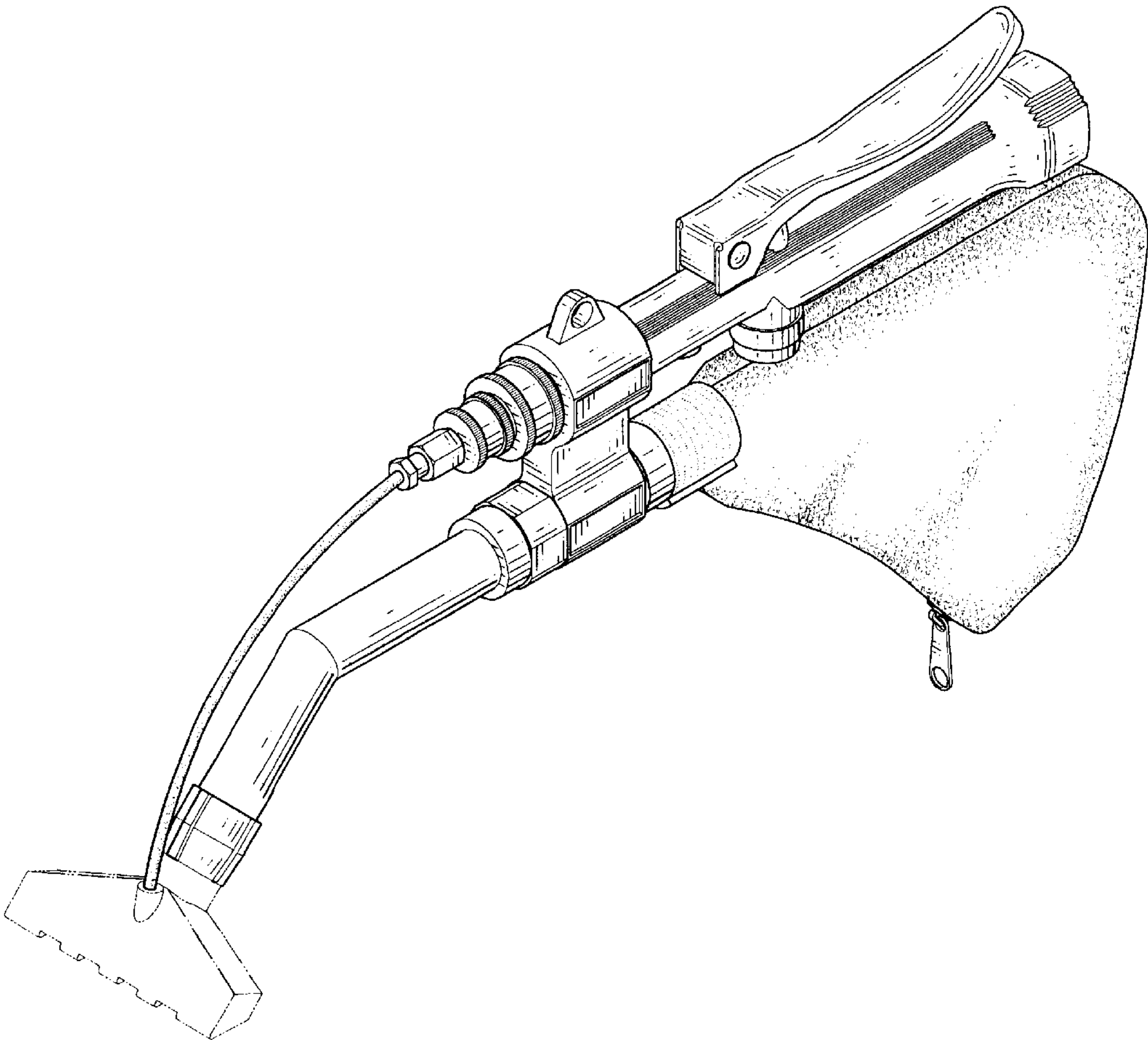
CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bi-directional compressed air gun, showing my new design;

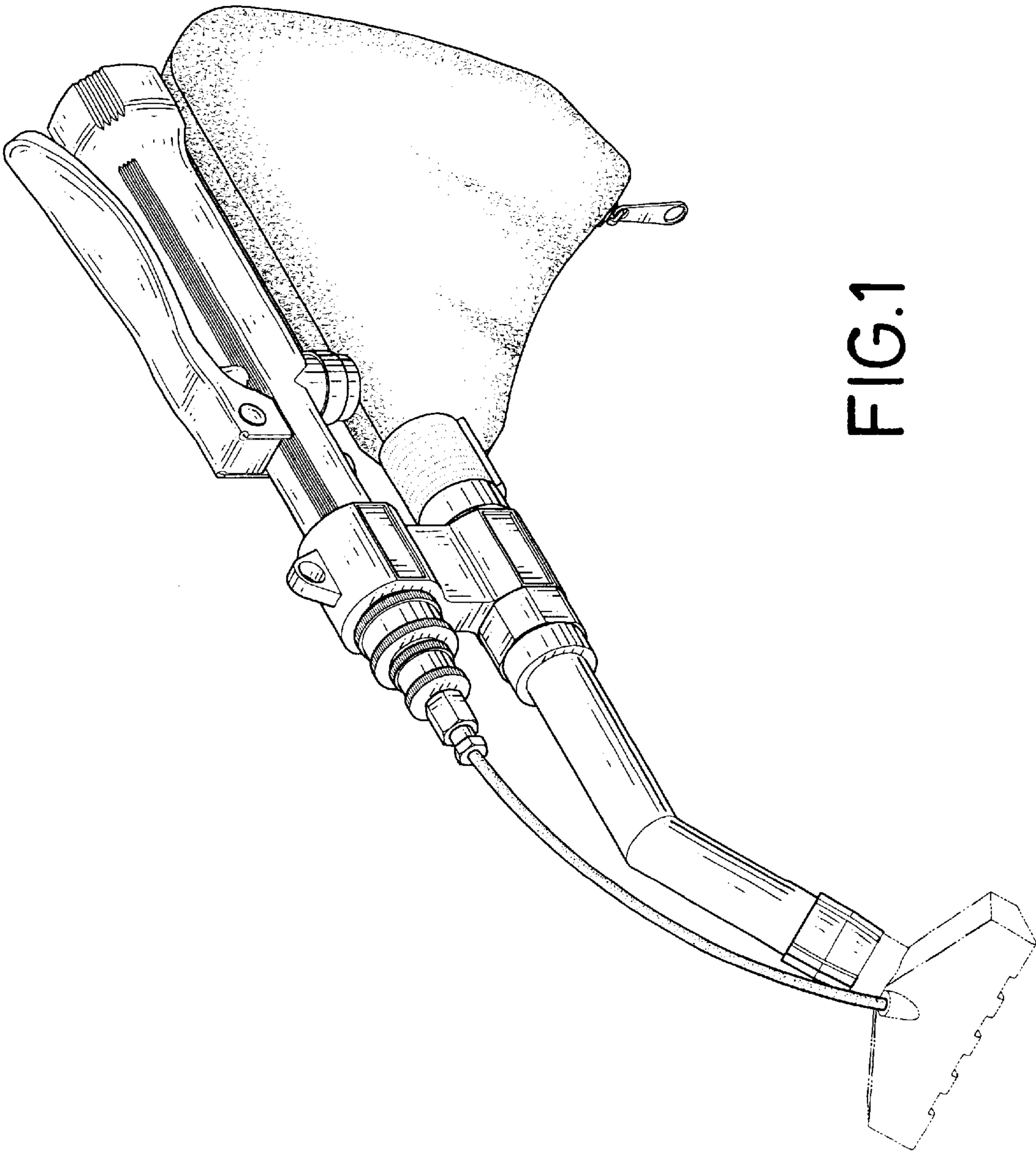

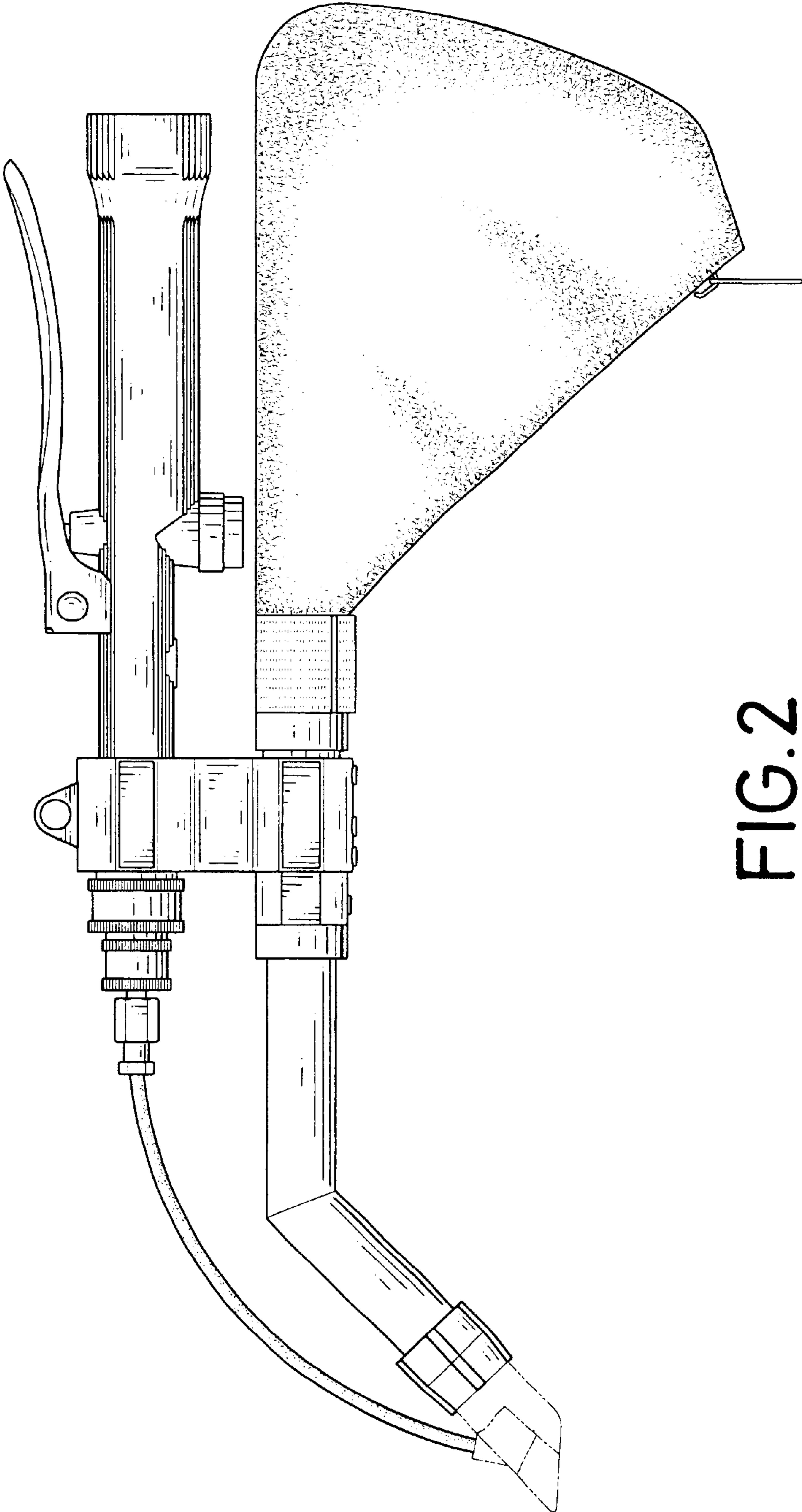

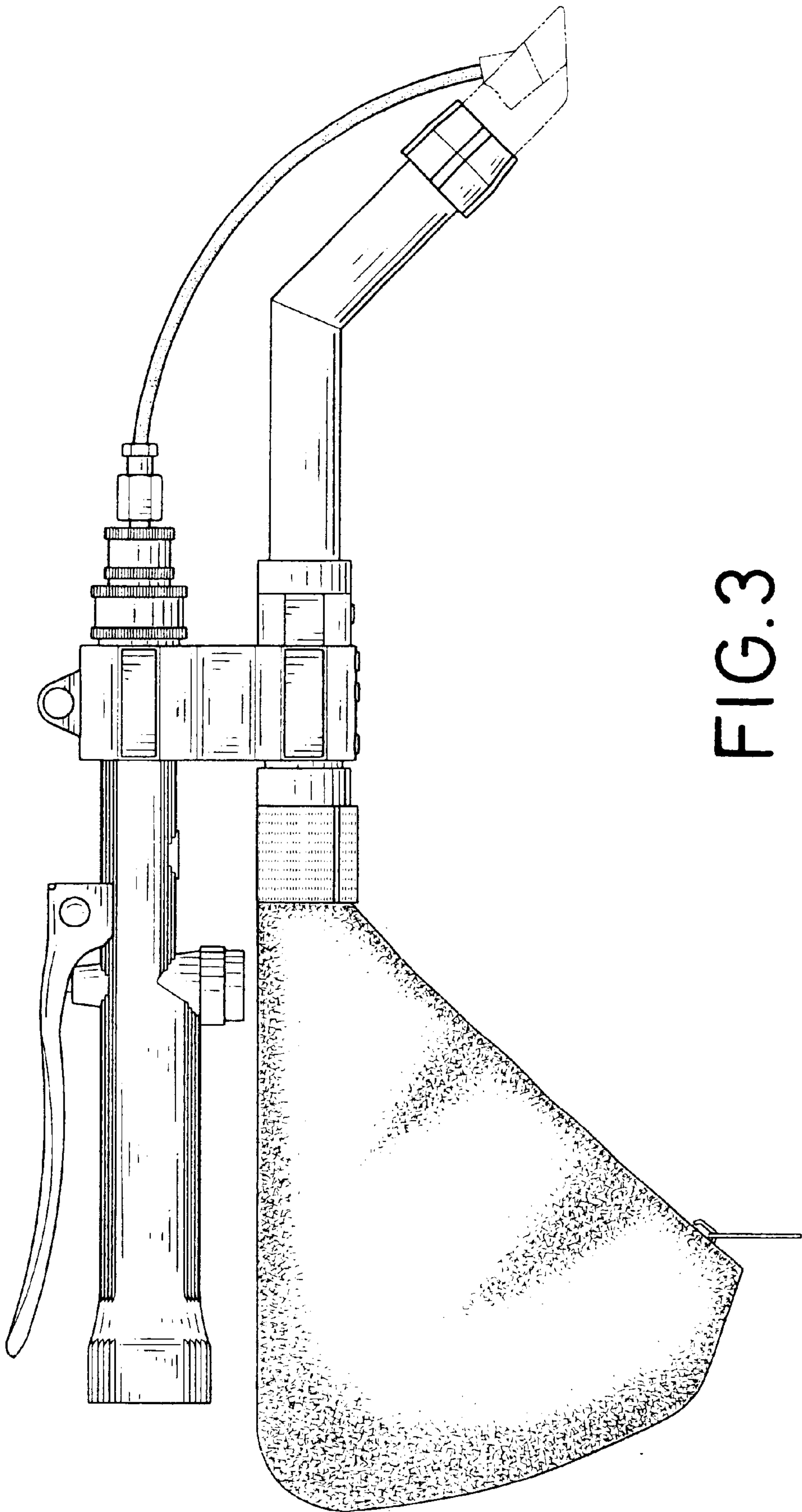

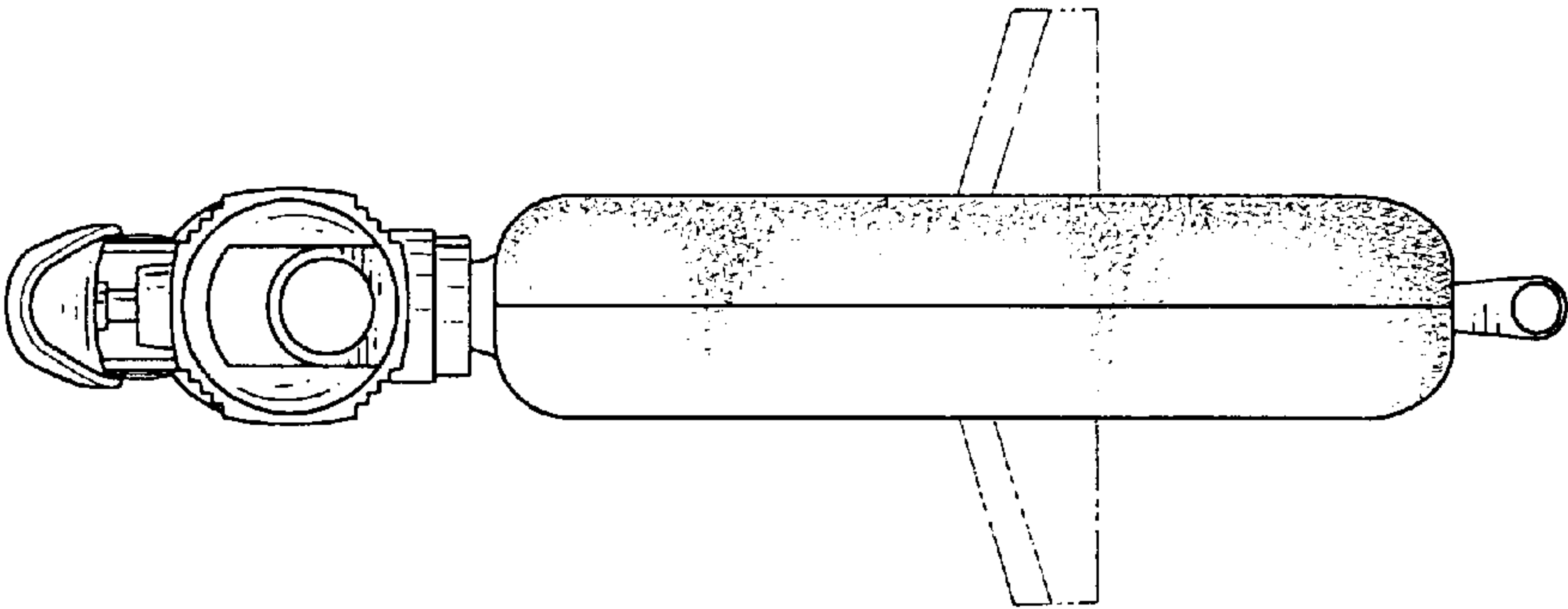

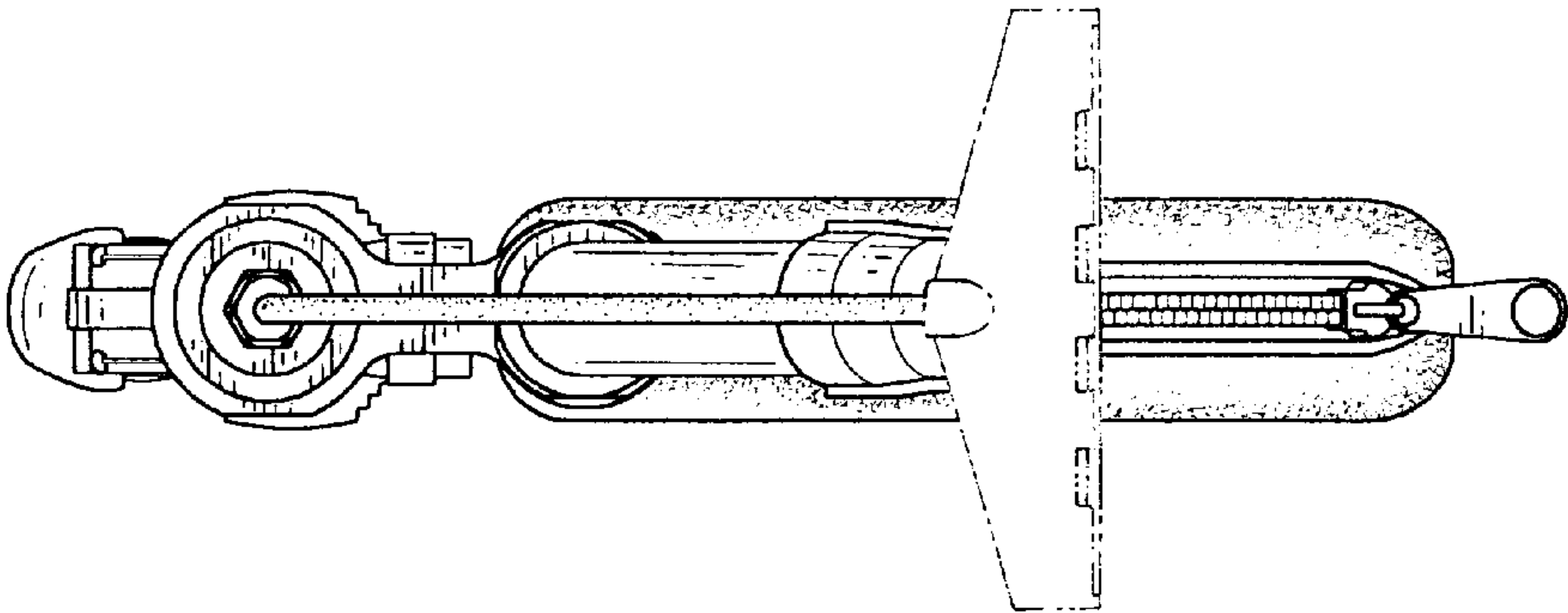

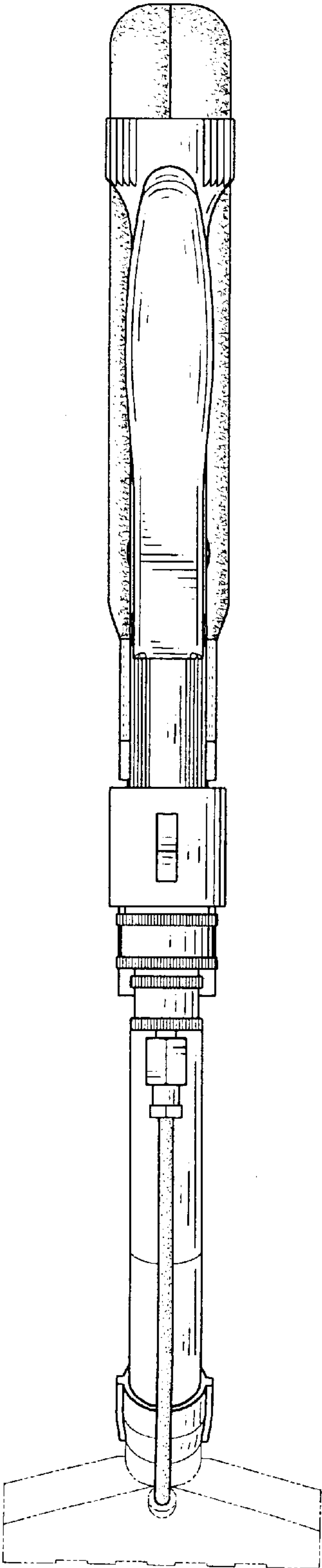

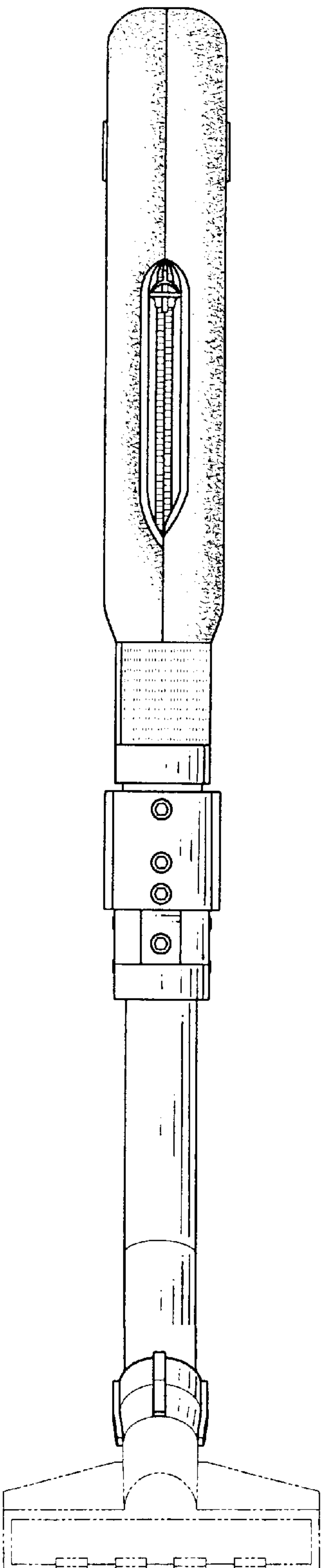

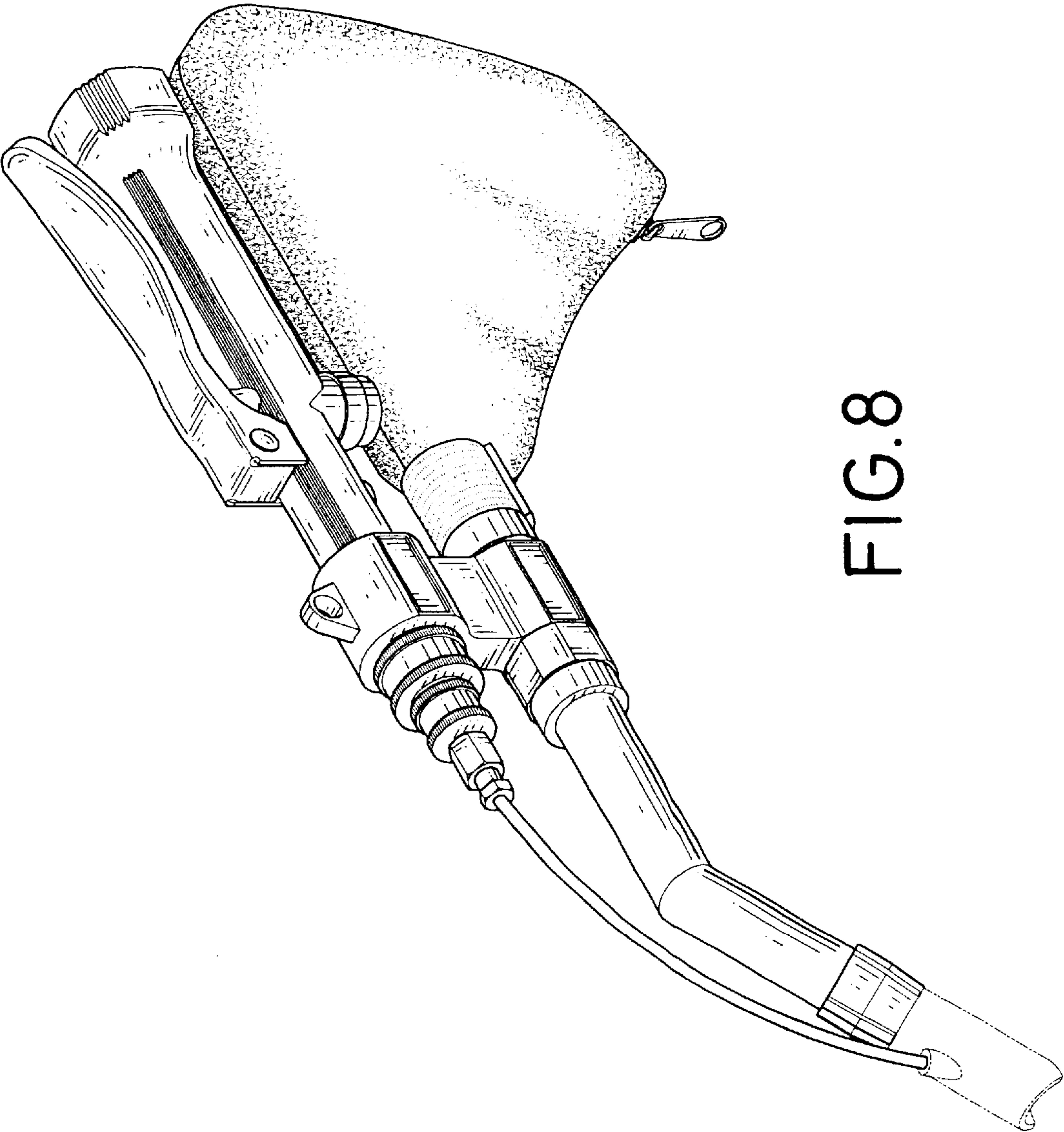
