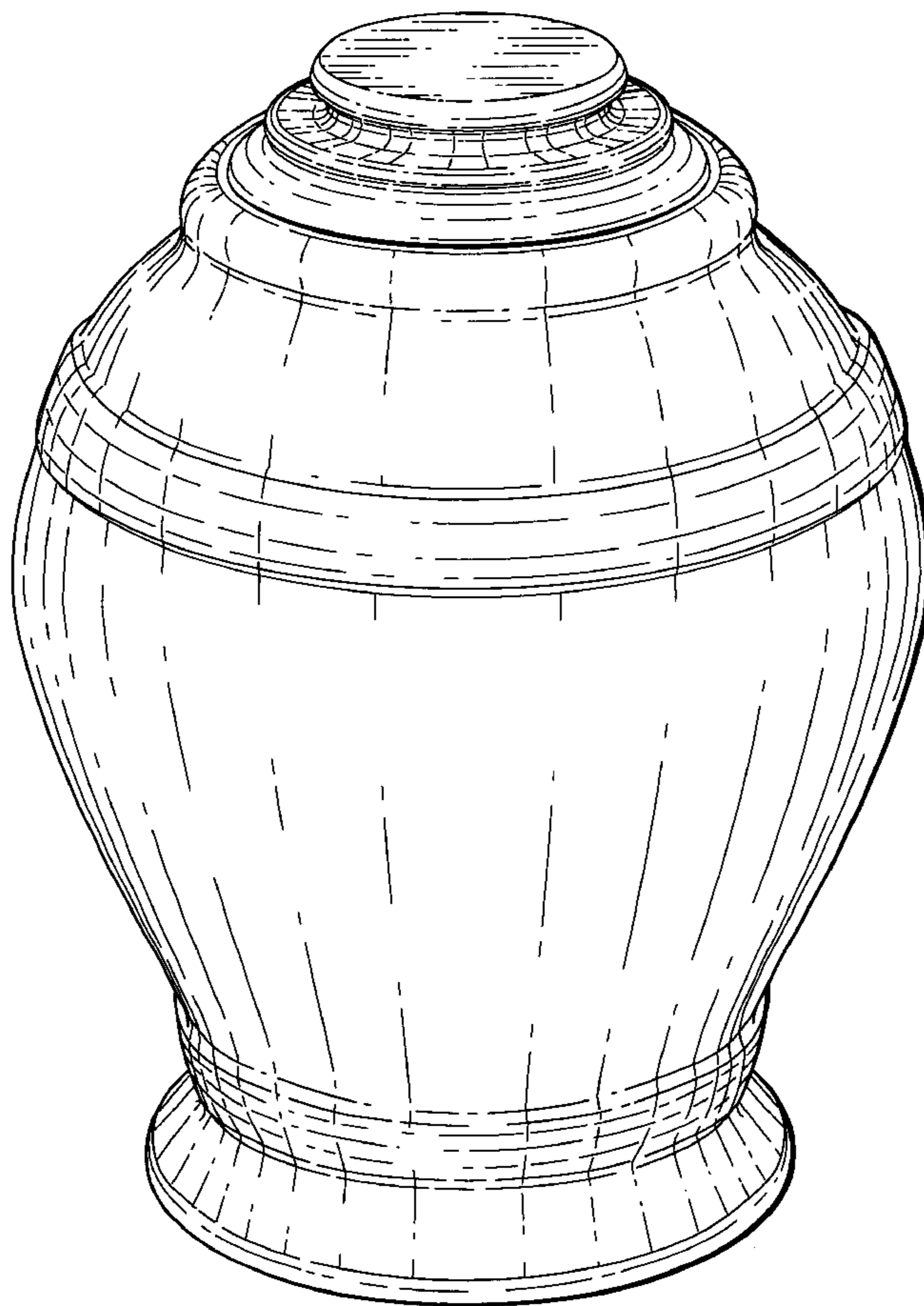

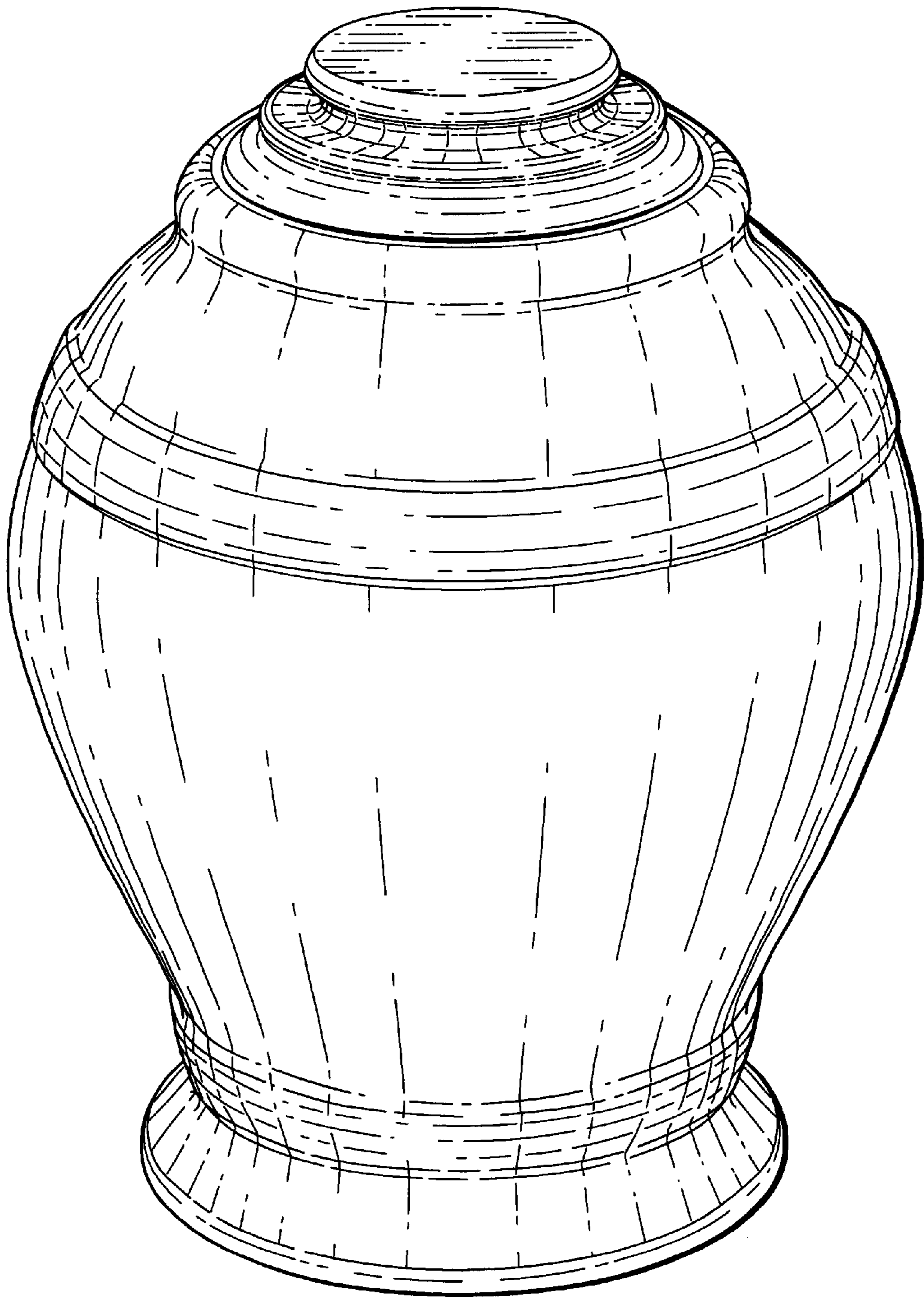
The ornamental design for an urn, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

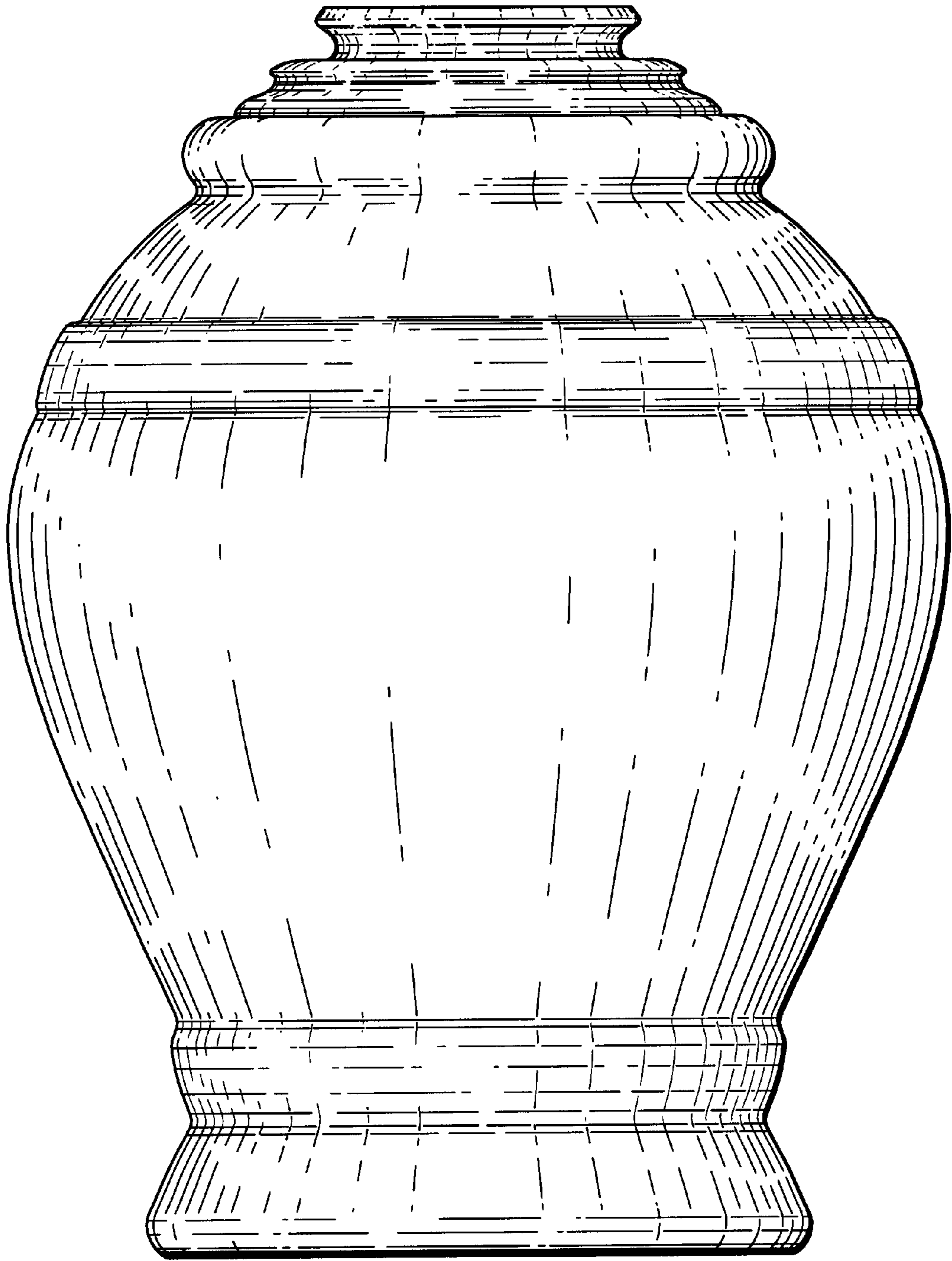
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the urn of the present invention;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevation the right side, left side and rear elevations are identical to FIG. 2;  
FIG. 3 is a top plan view;  
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view; and,  
FIG. 5 is a fragmentary vertical cross sectional view of the upper portion of the urn taken at the central axis of the urn.

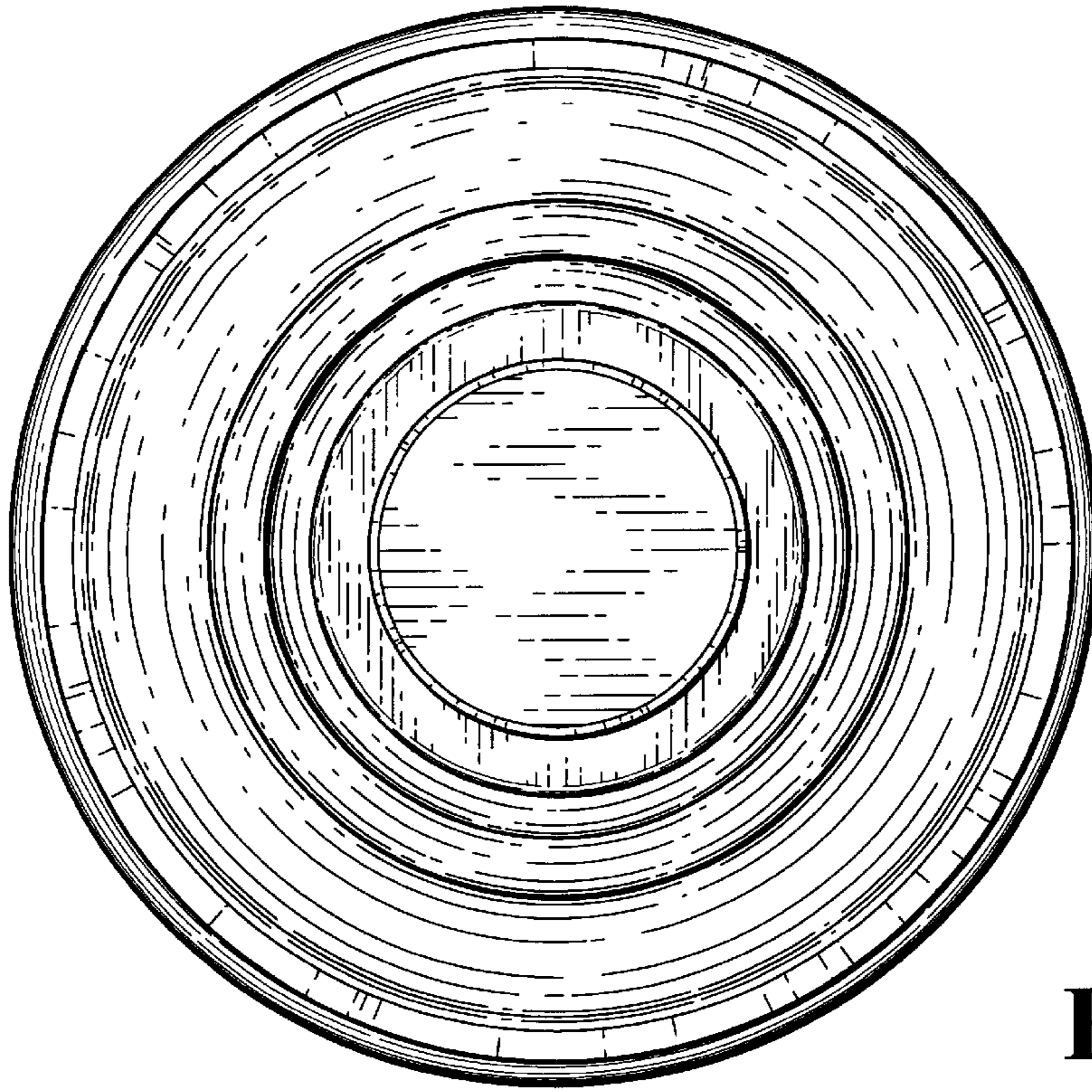




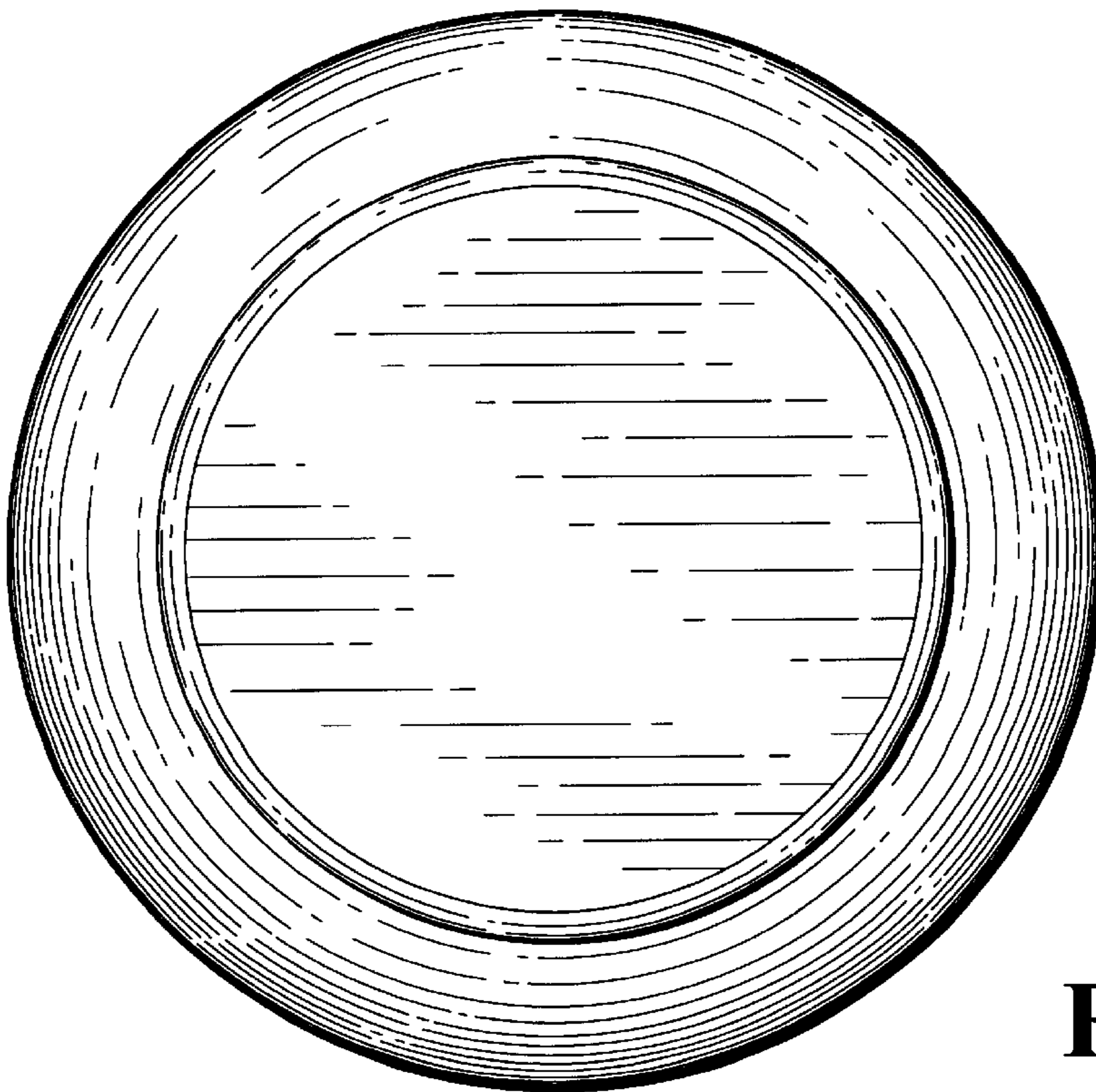

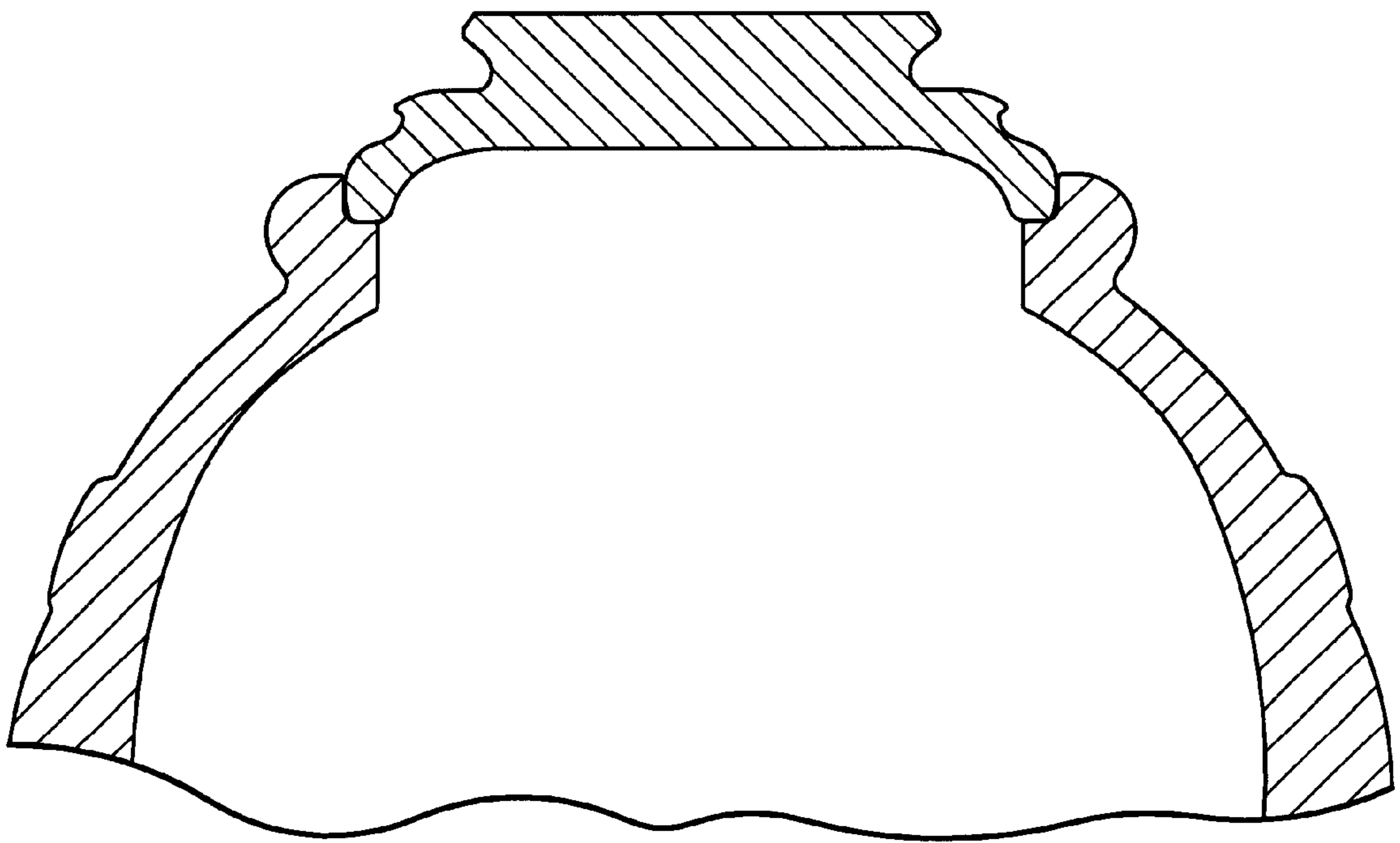
