FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the skate securing and tying stool.

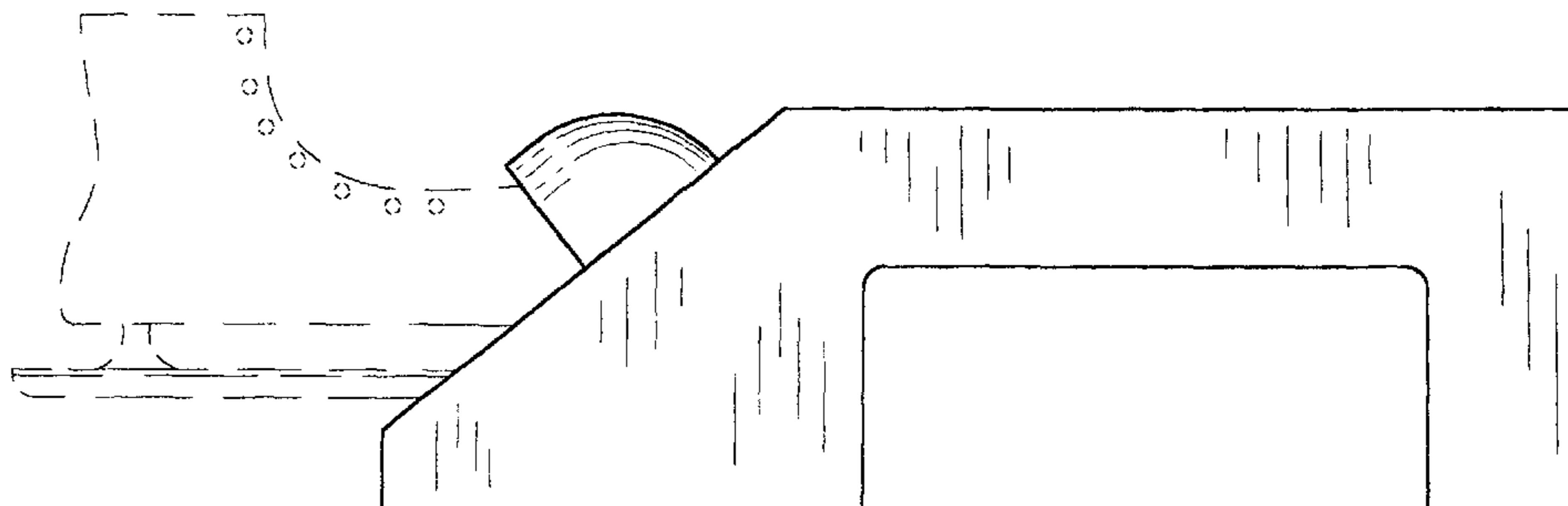
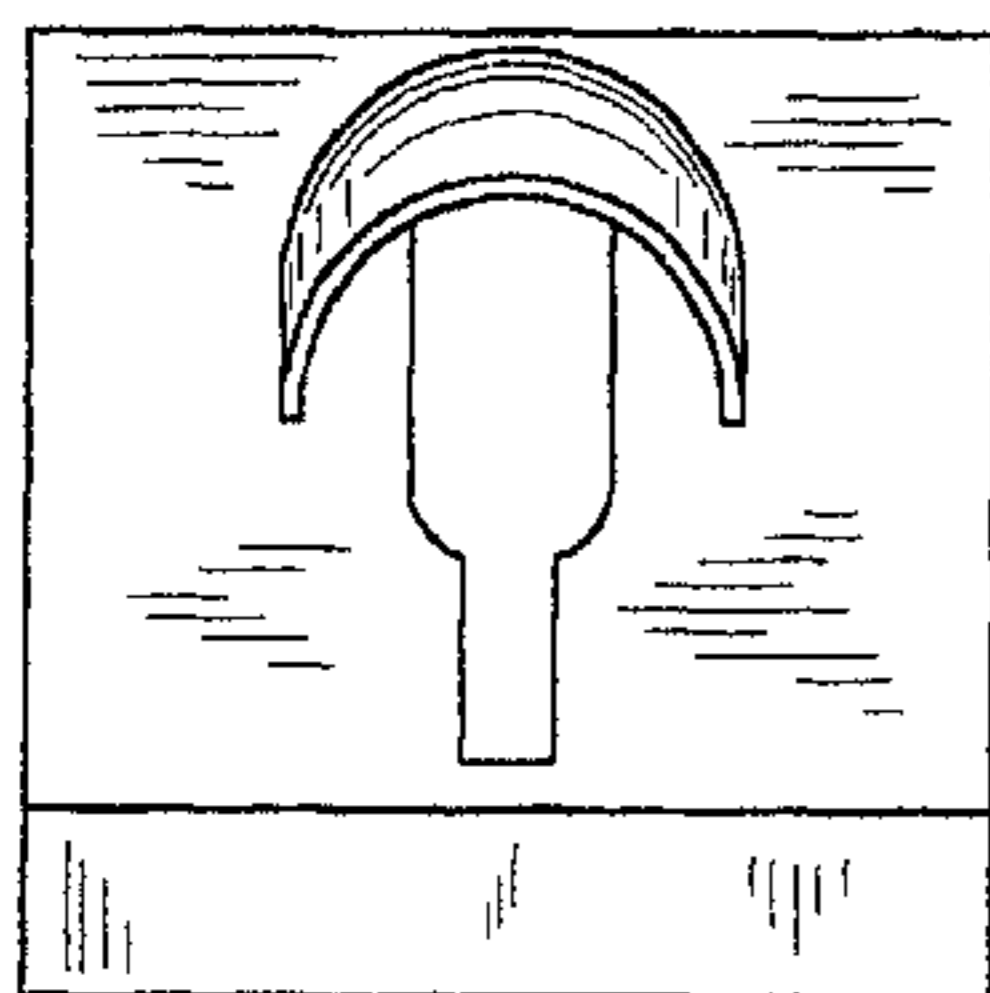
The skate depicted by means of broken lines in FIG. 3 has

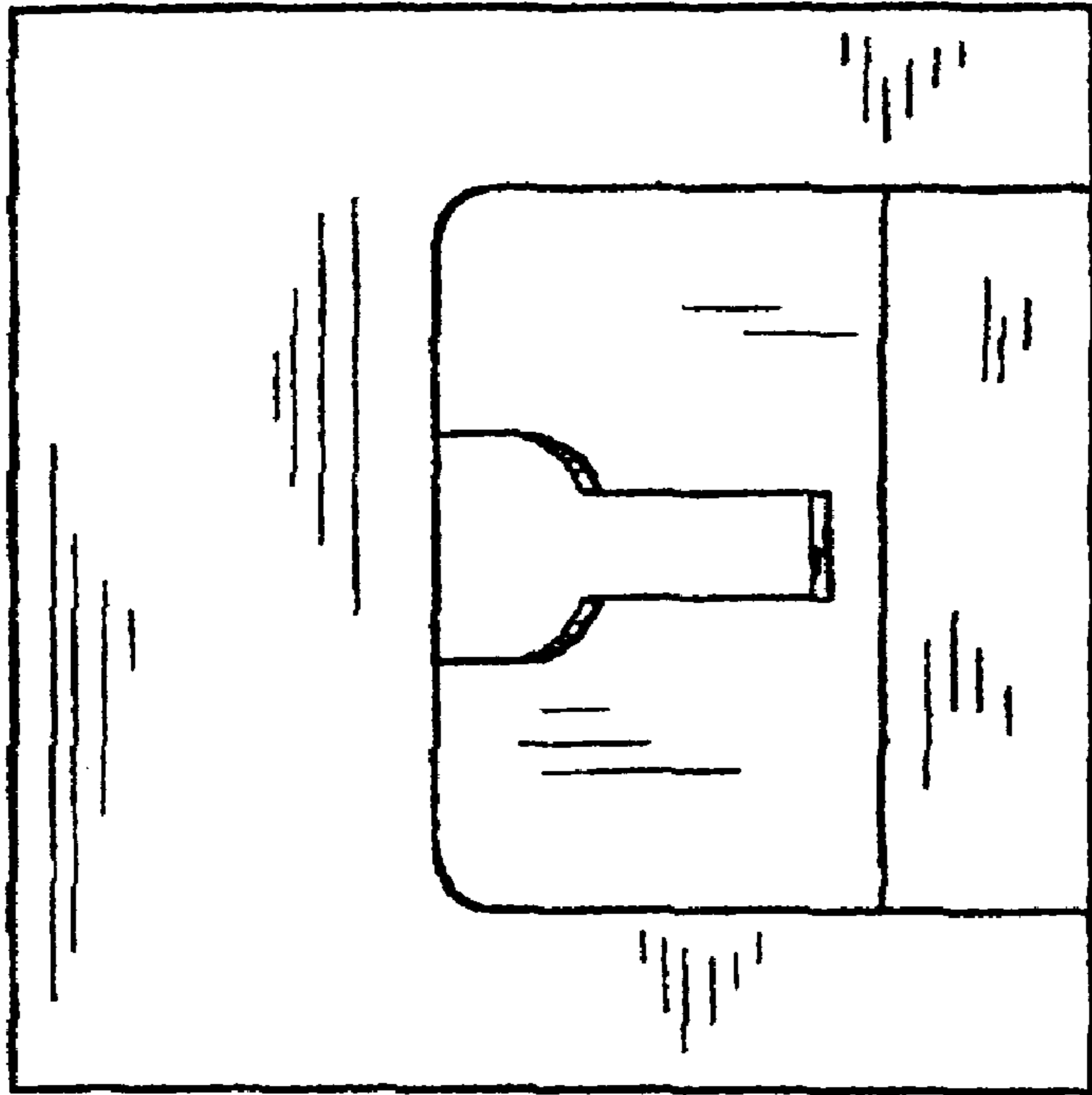

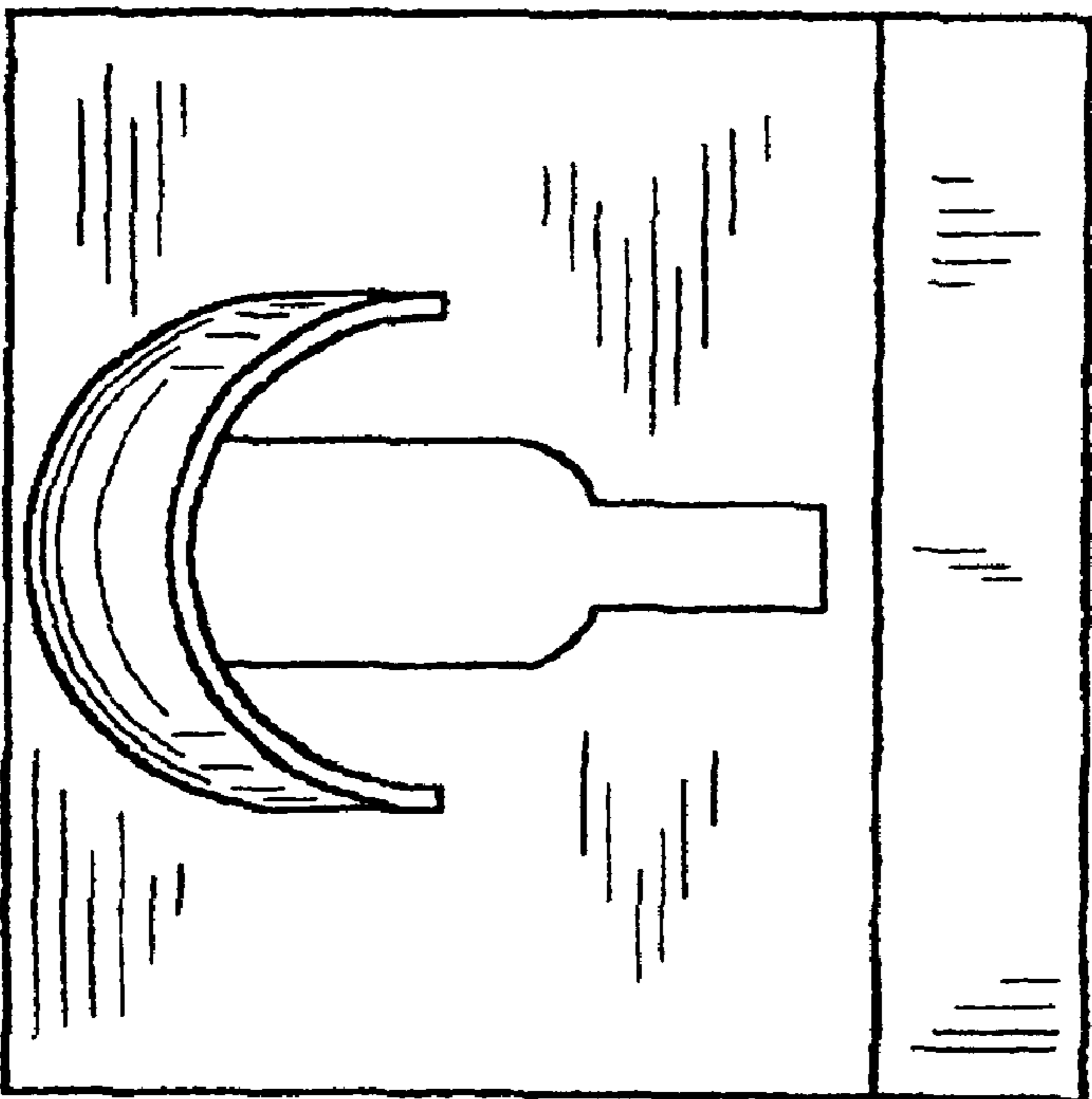

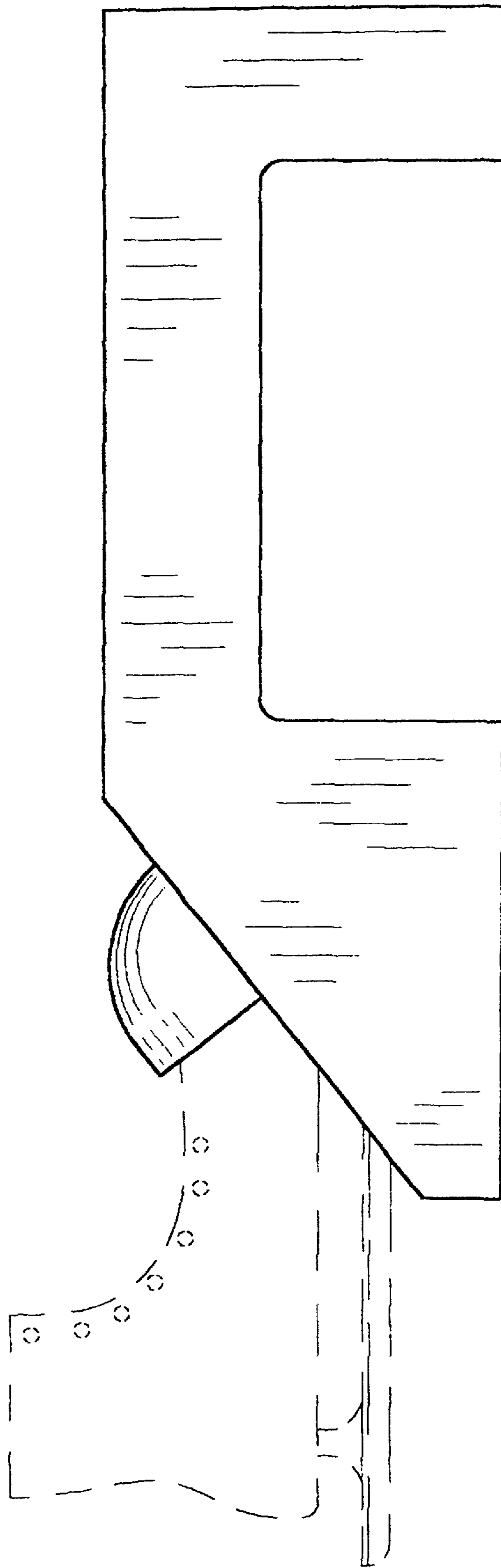

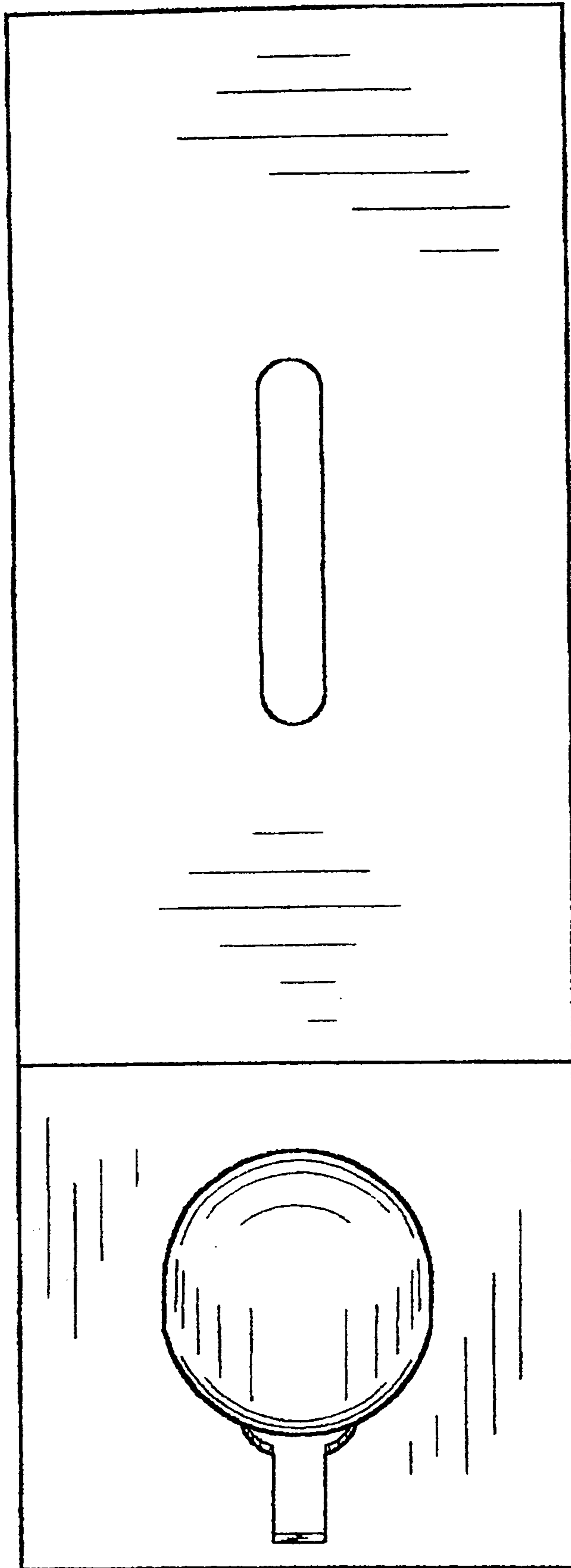

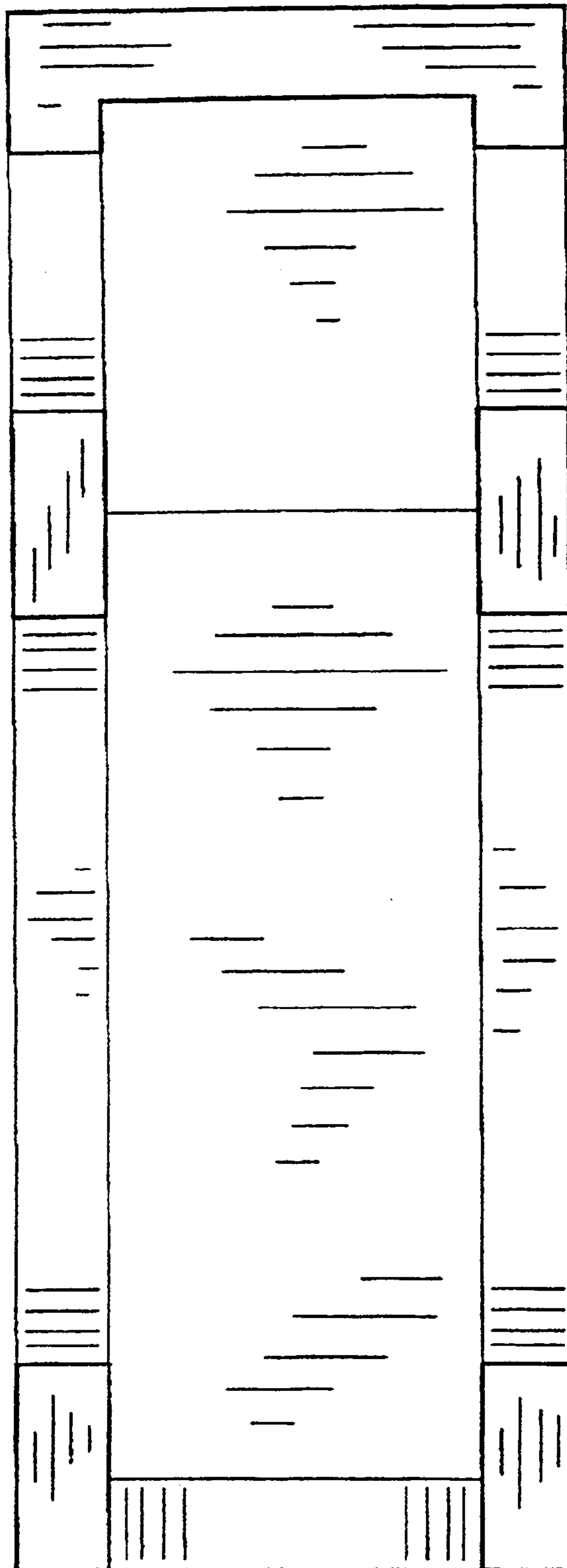
