FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the container embodying my new design;

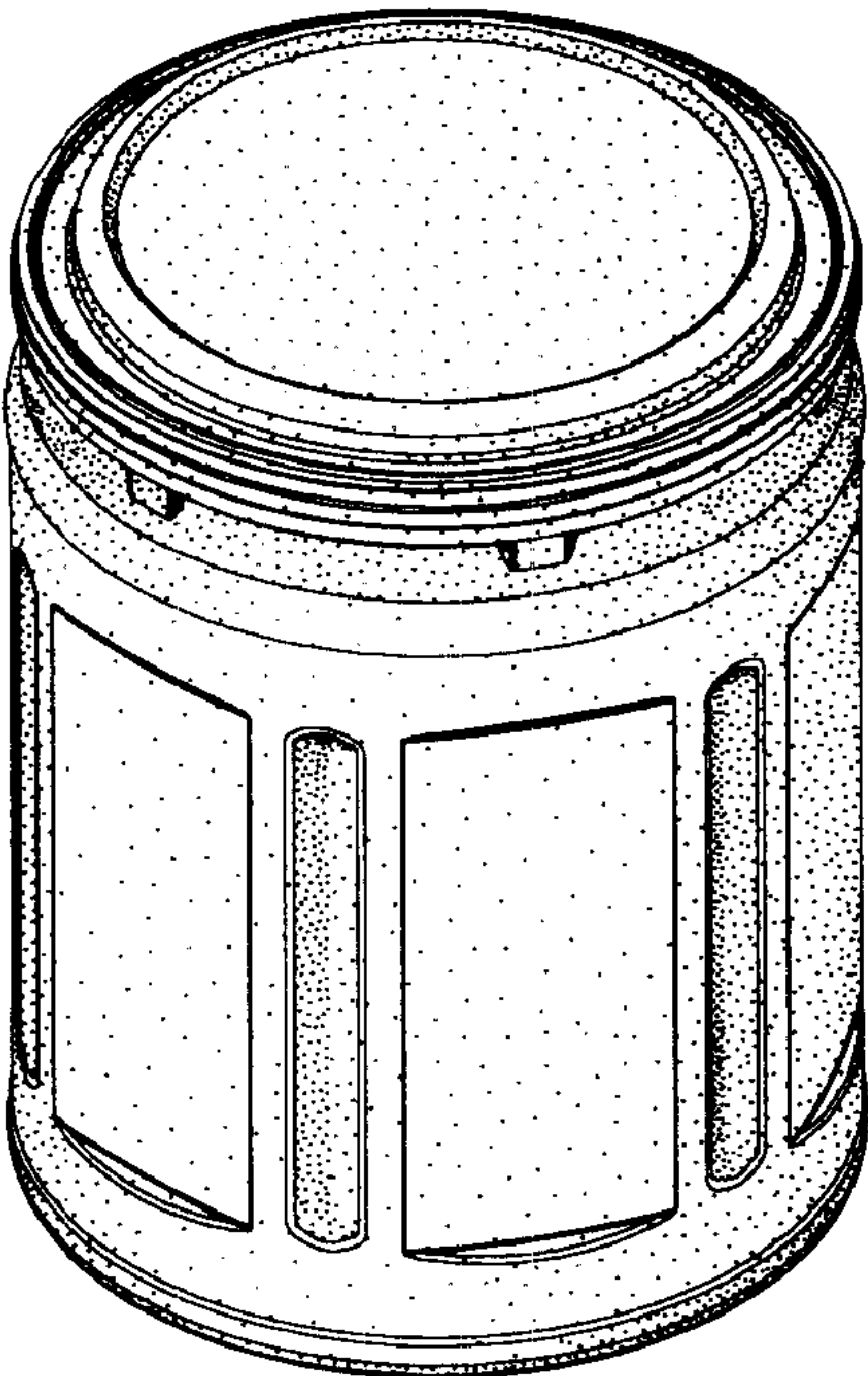
FIG. 2 is a top planar view thereof;

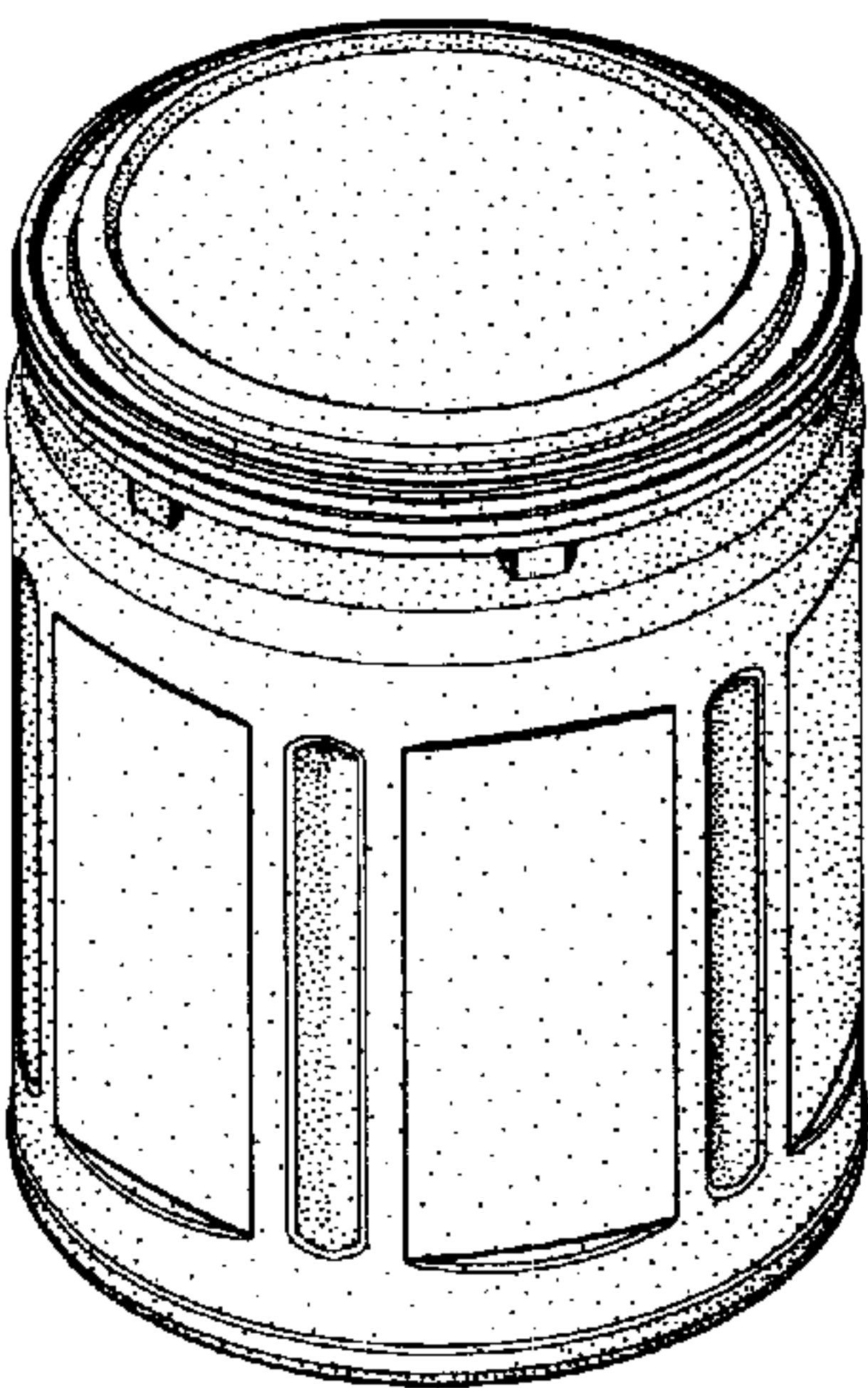

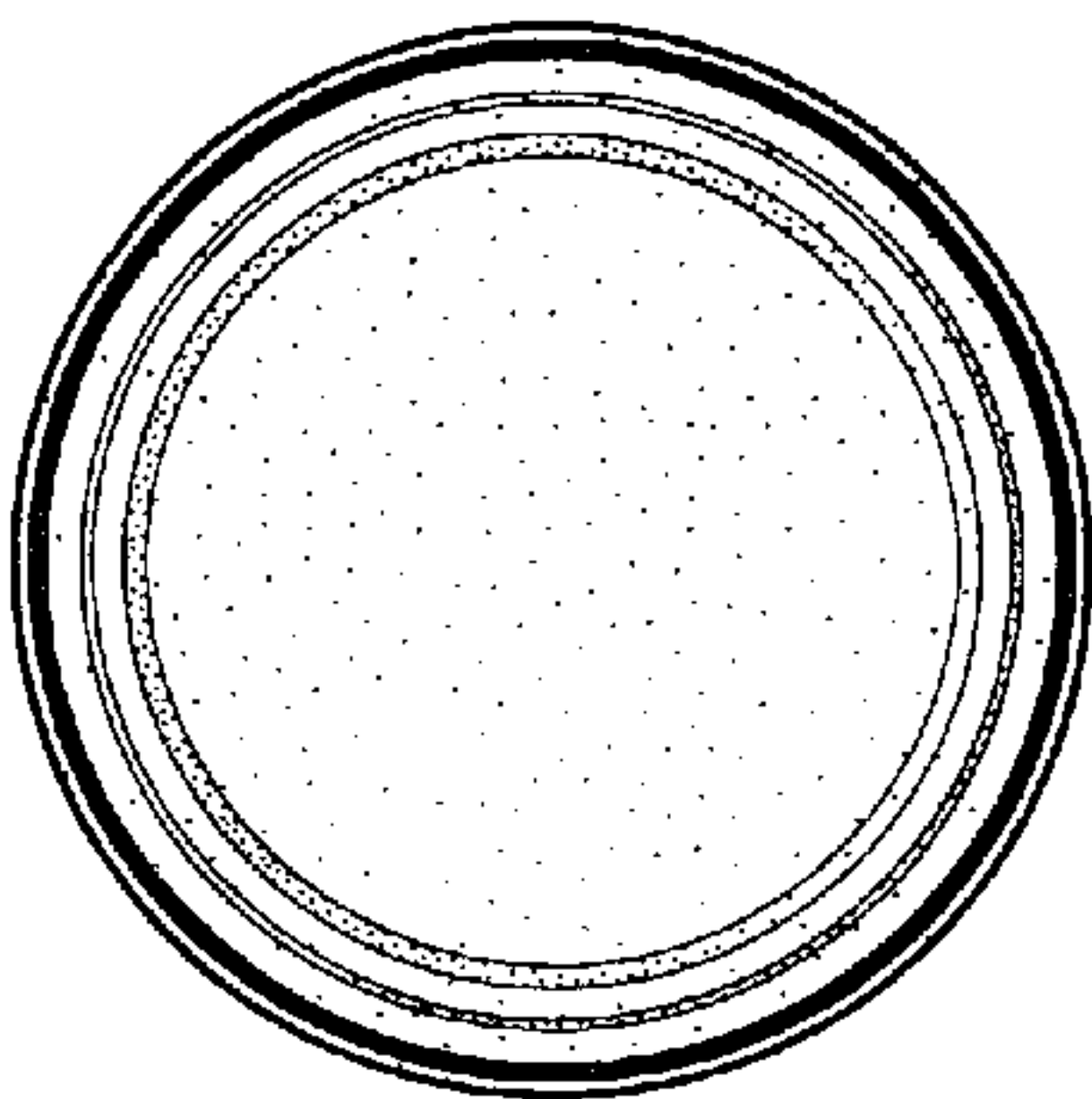

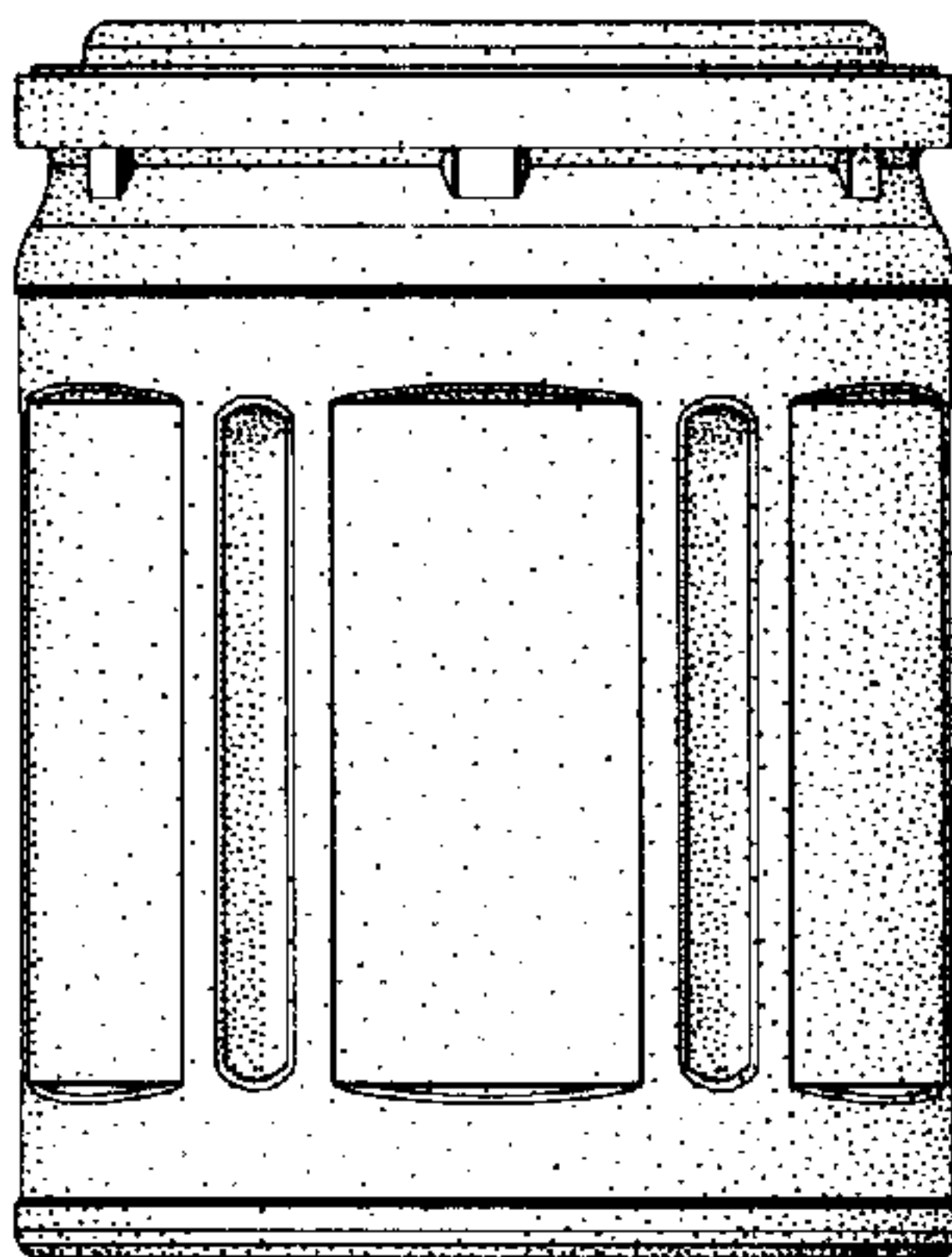

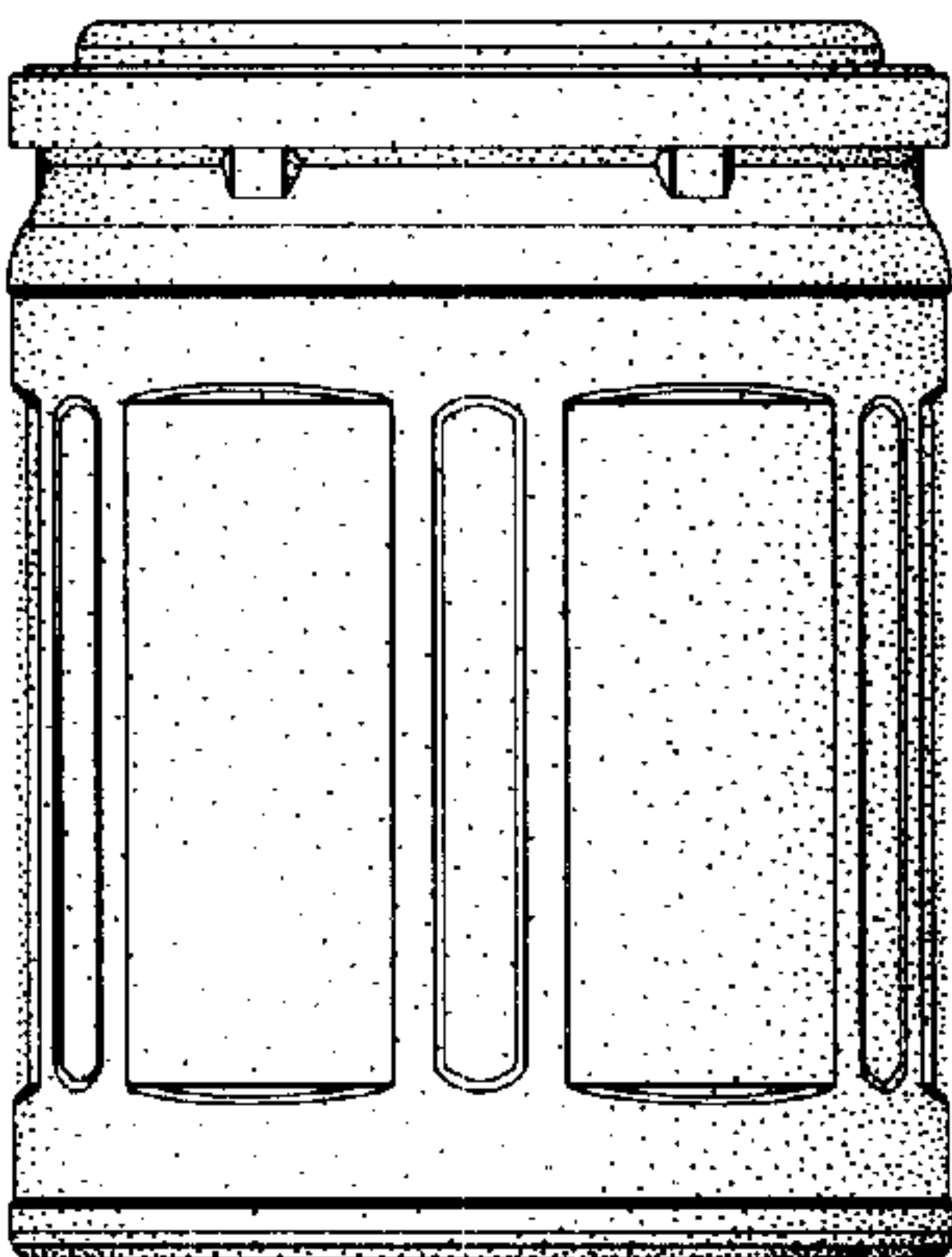

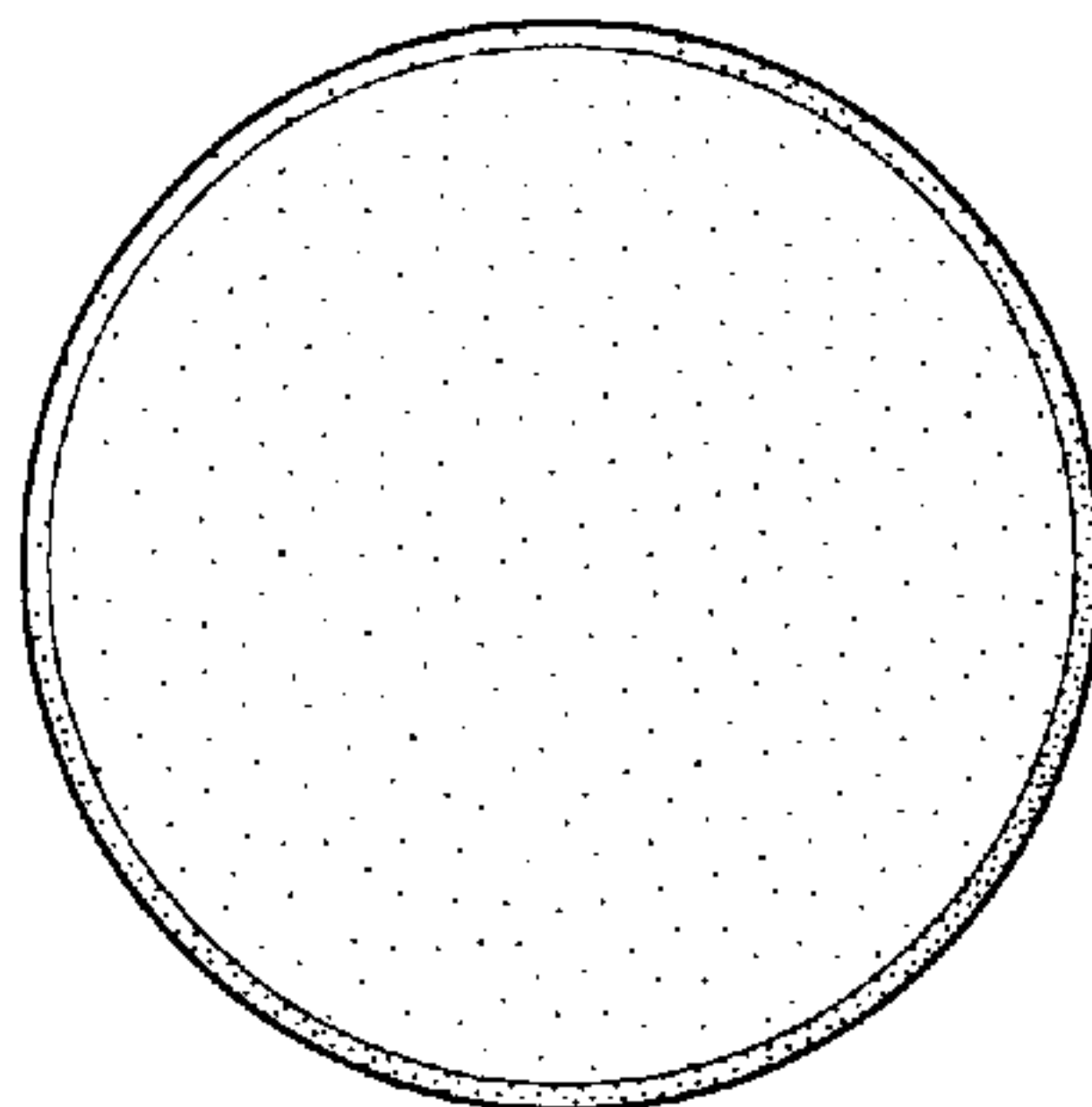
