(57) **CLAIM**

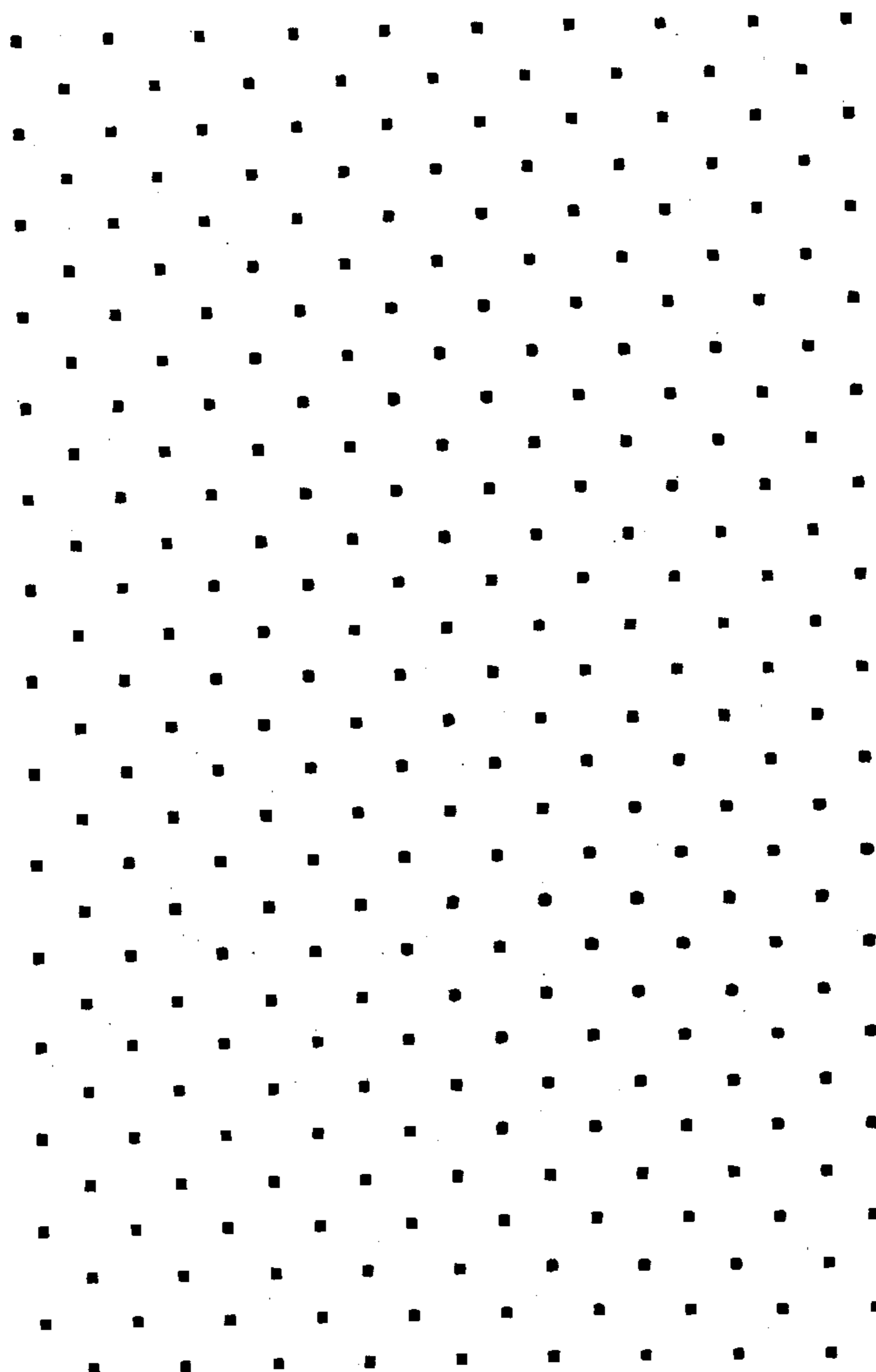
I claim the ornamental design for a glass sheet, as shown and described.

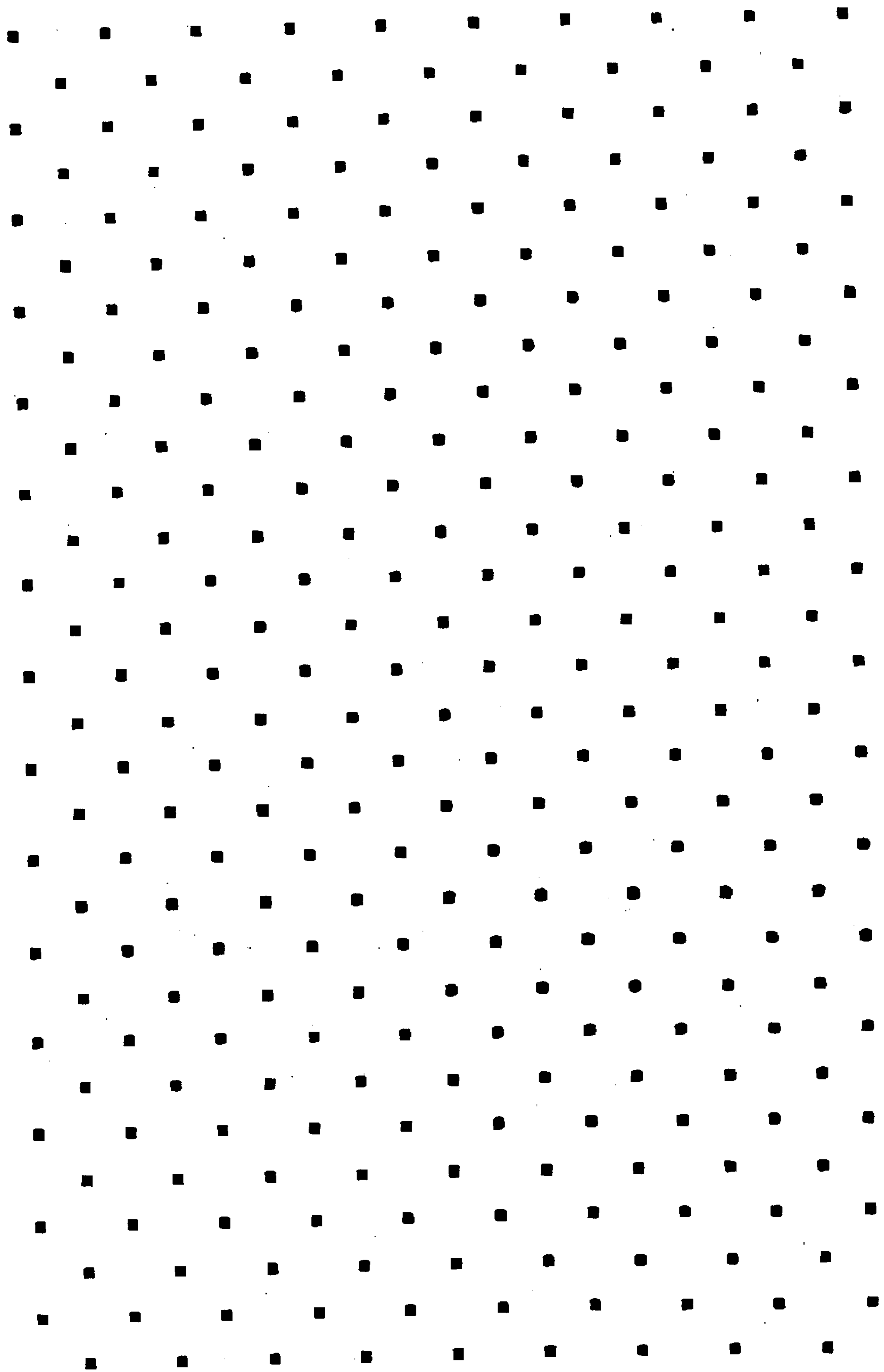
DESCRIPTION
