DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a rope preening bird toy showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof, the rear elevation view being identical;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a front elevation view of a second smaller embodiment of FIG. 1, the rear elevation view thereof being identical;

FIG. 8 is a left side elevation view of FIG. 7;

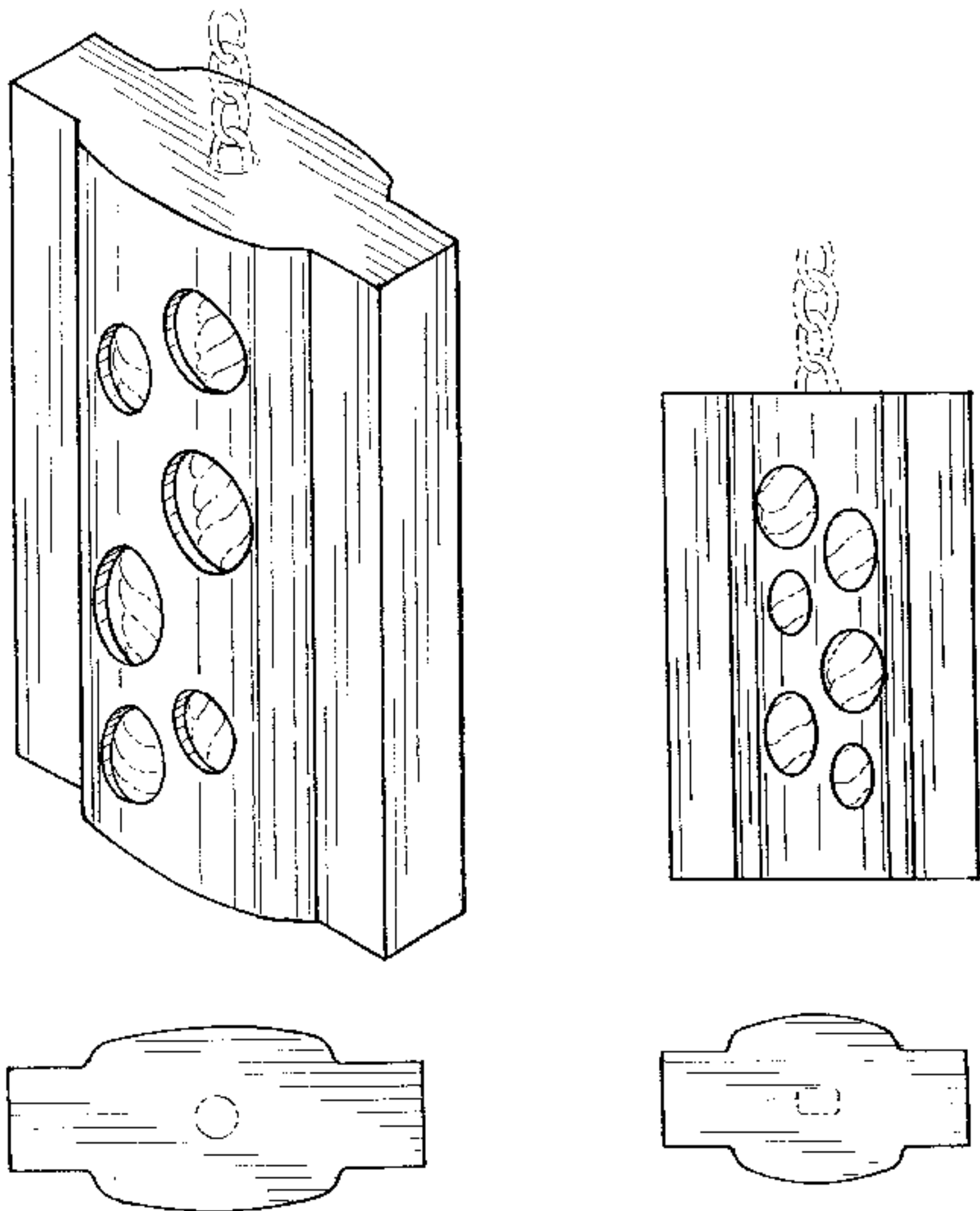
FIG. 9 is a right side elevation view of FIG. 7;

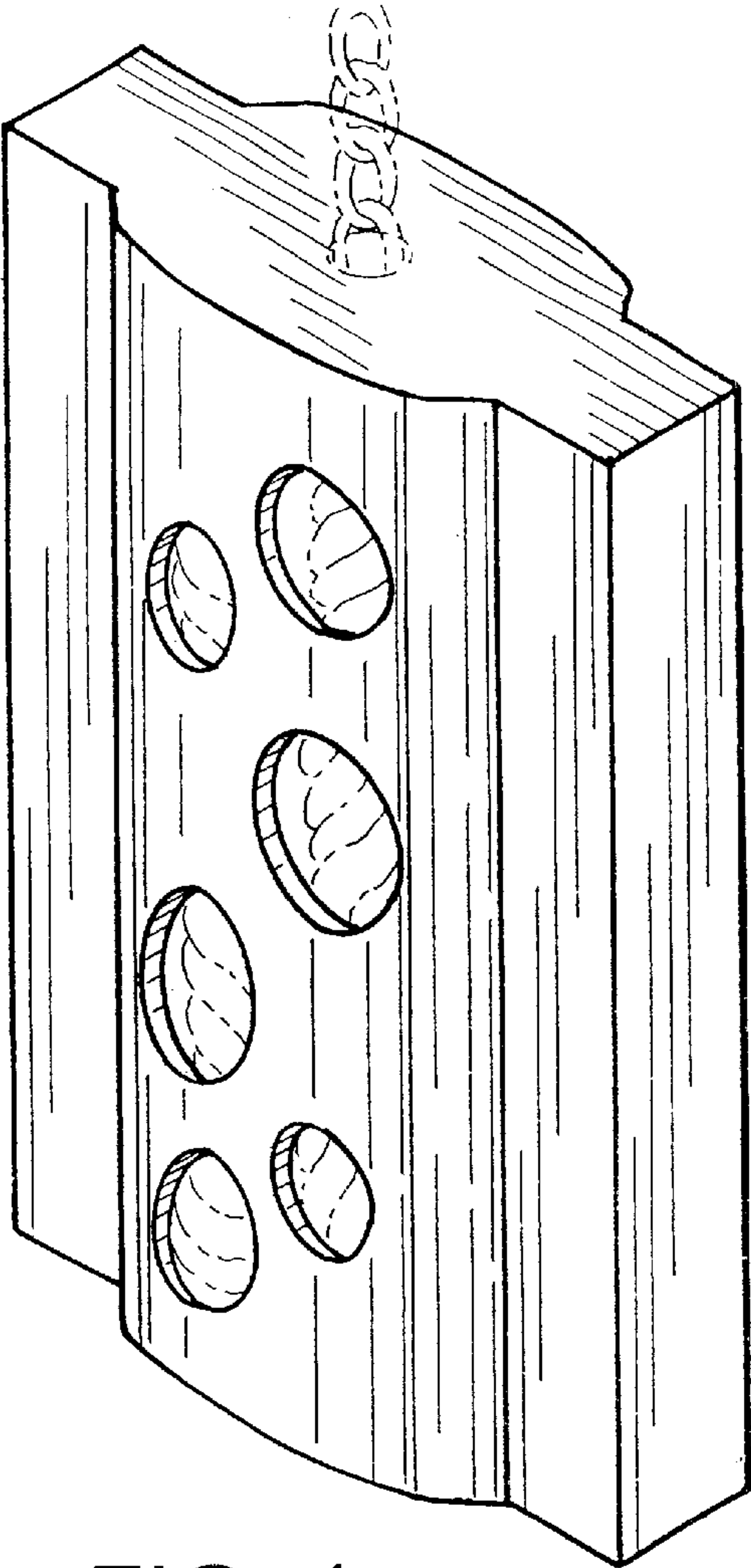

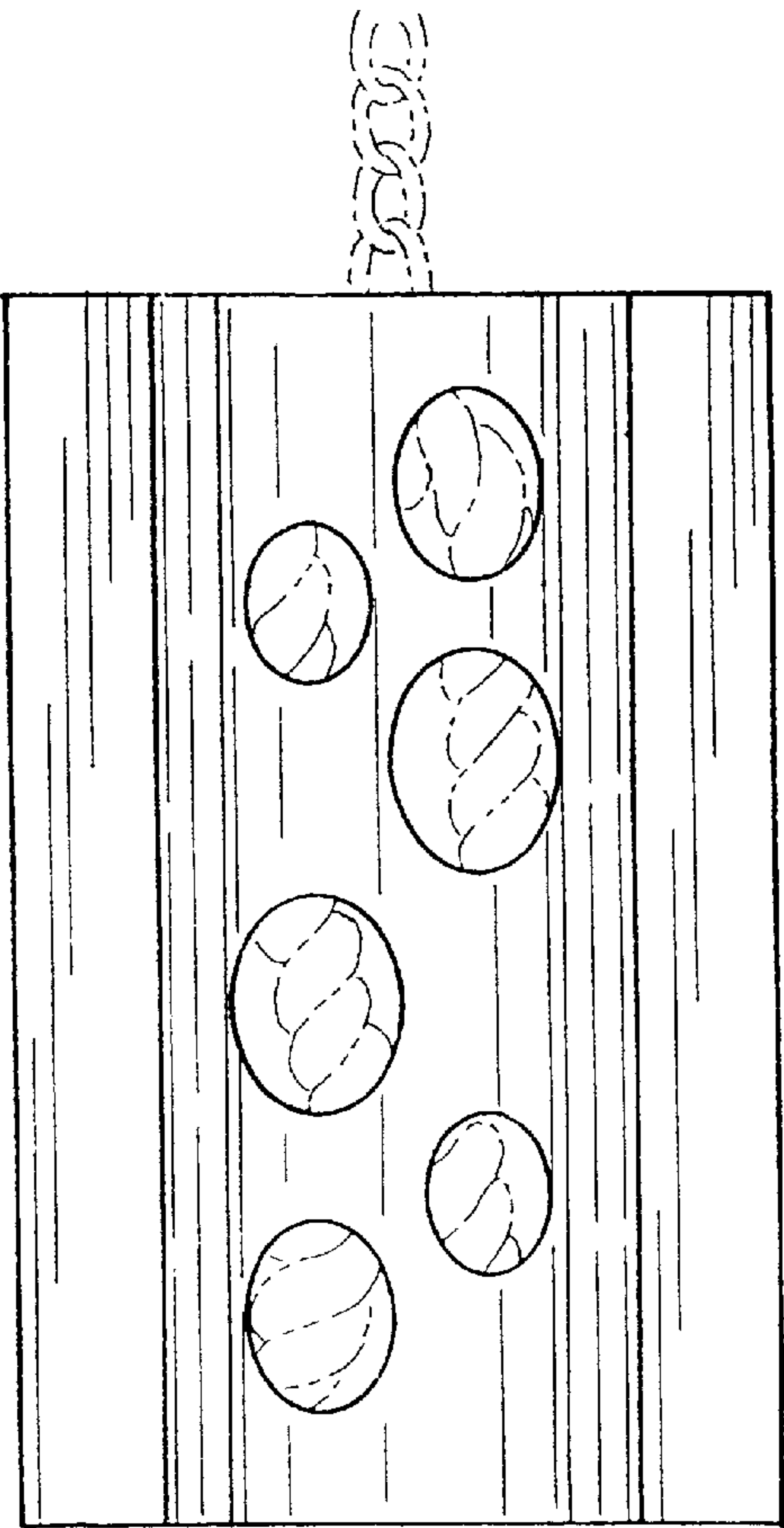

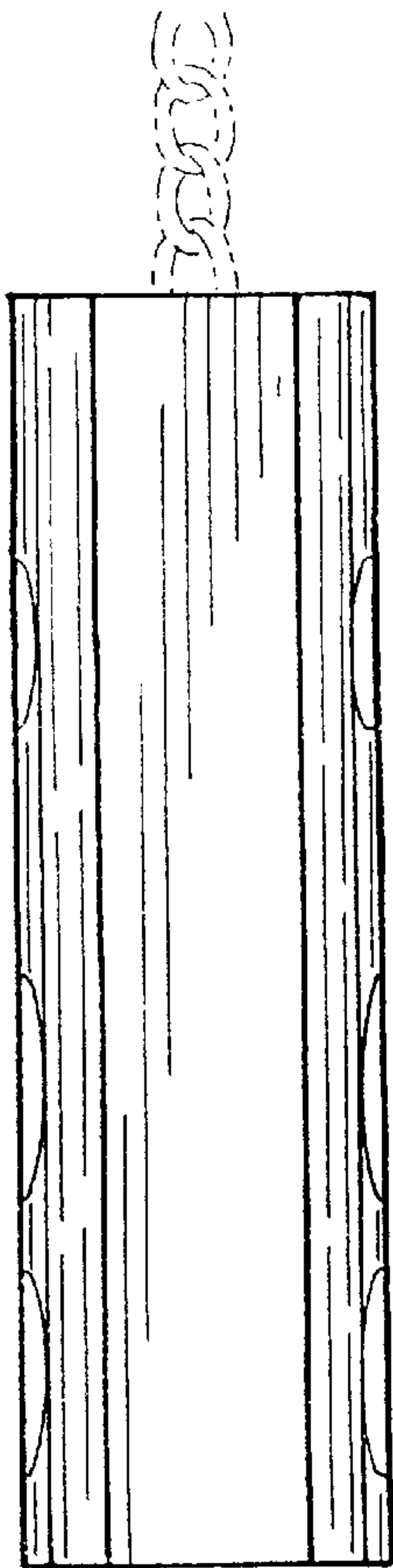

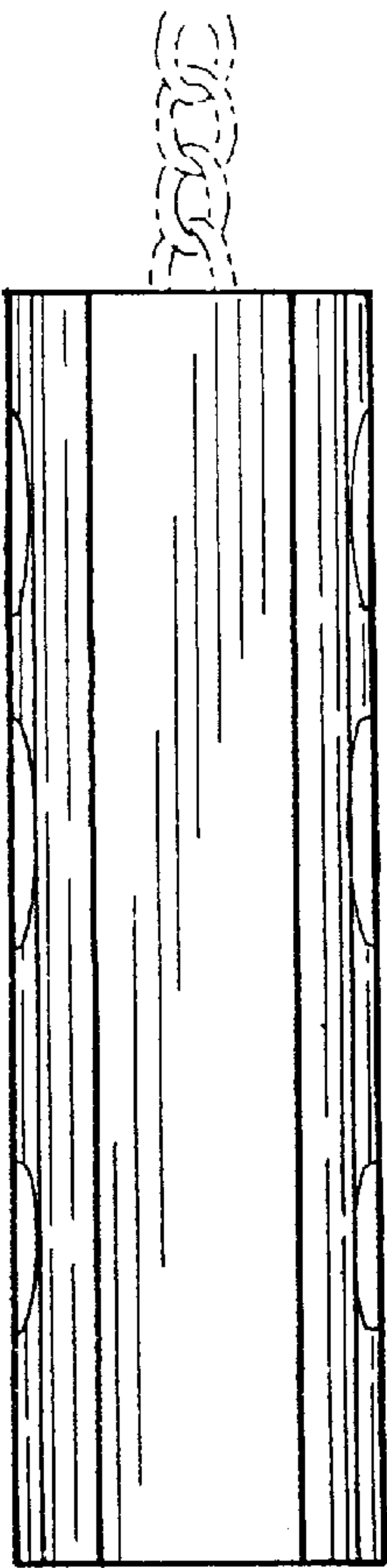

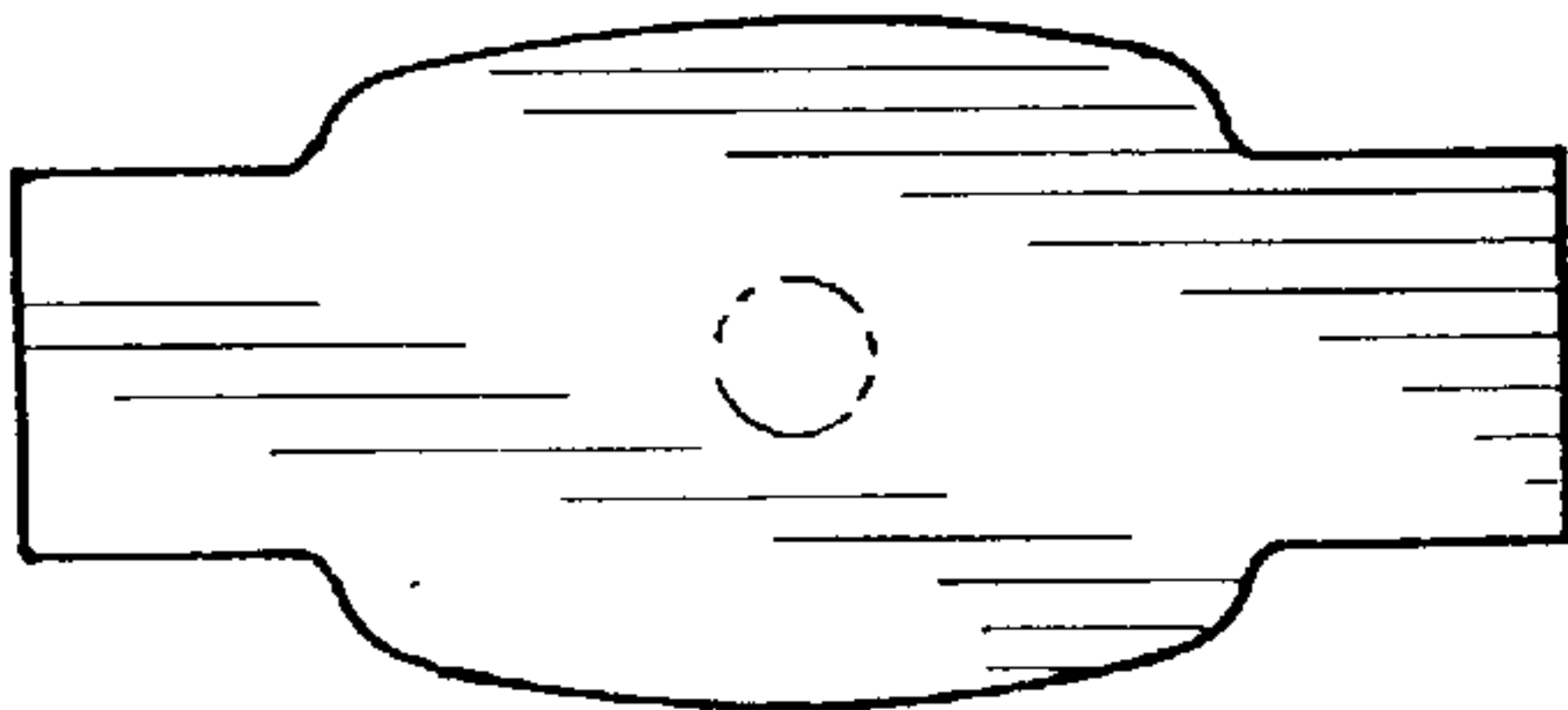

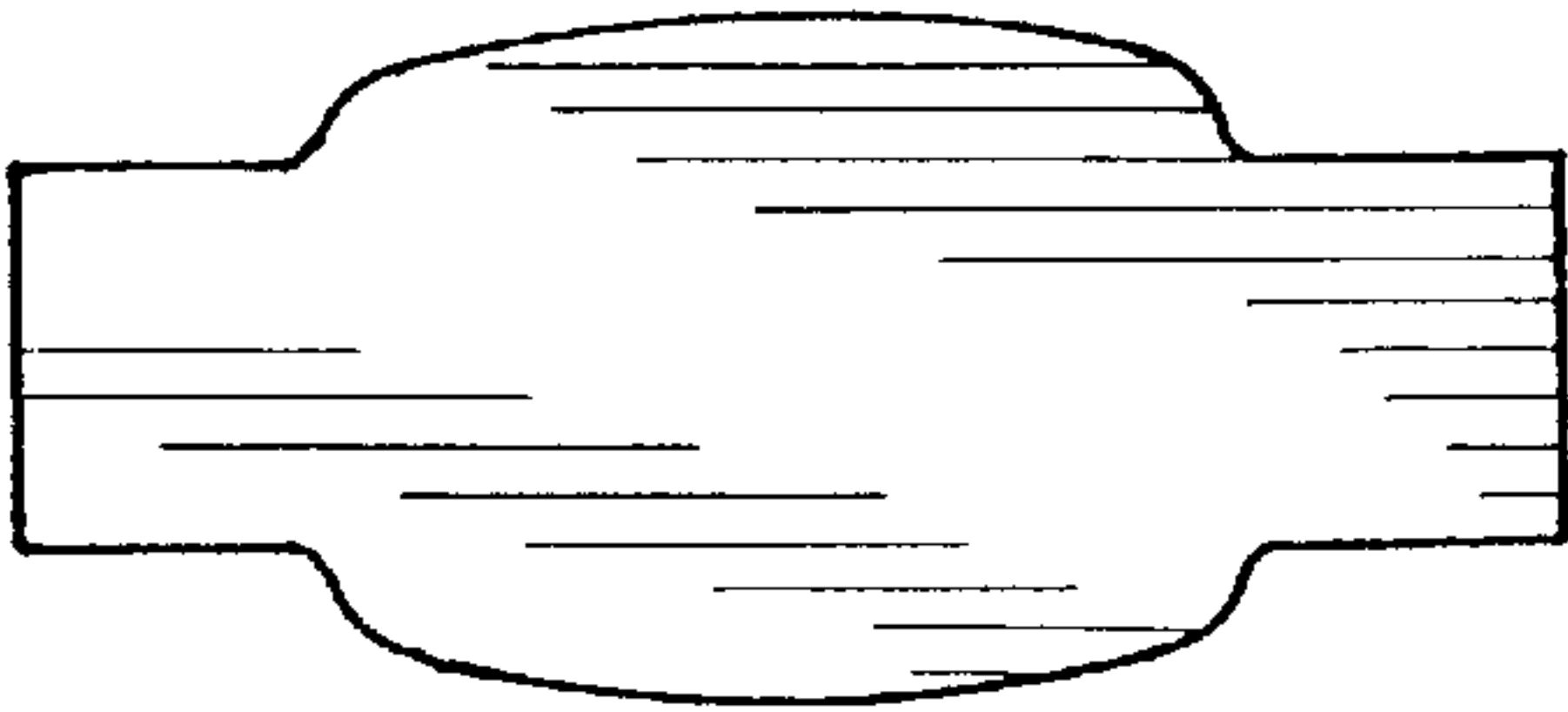

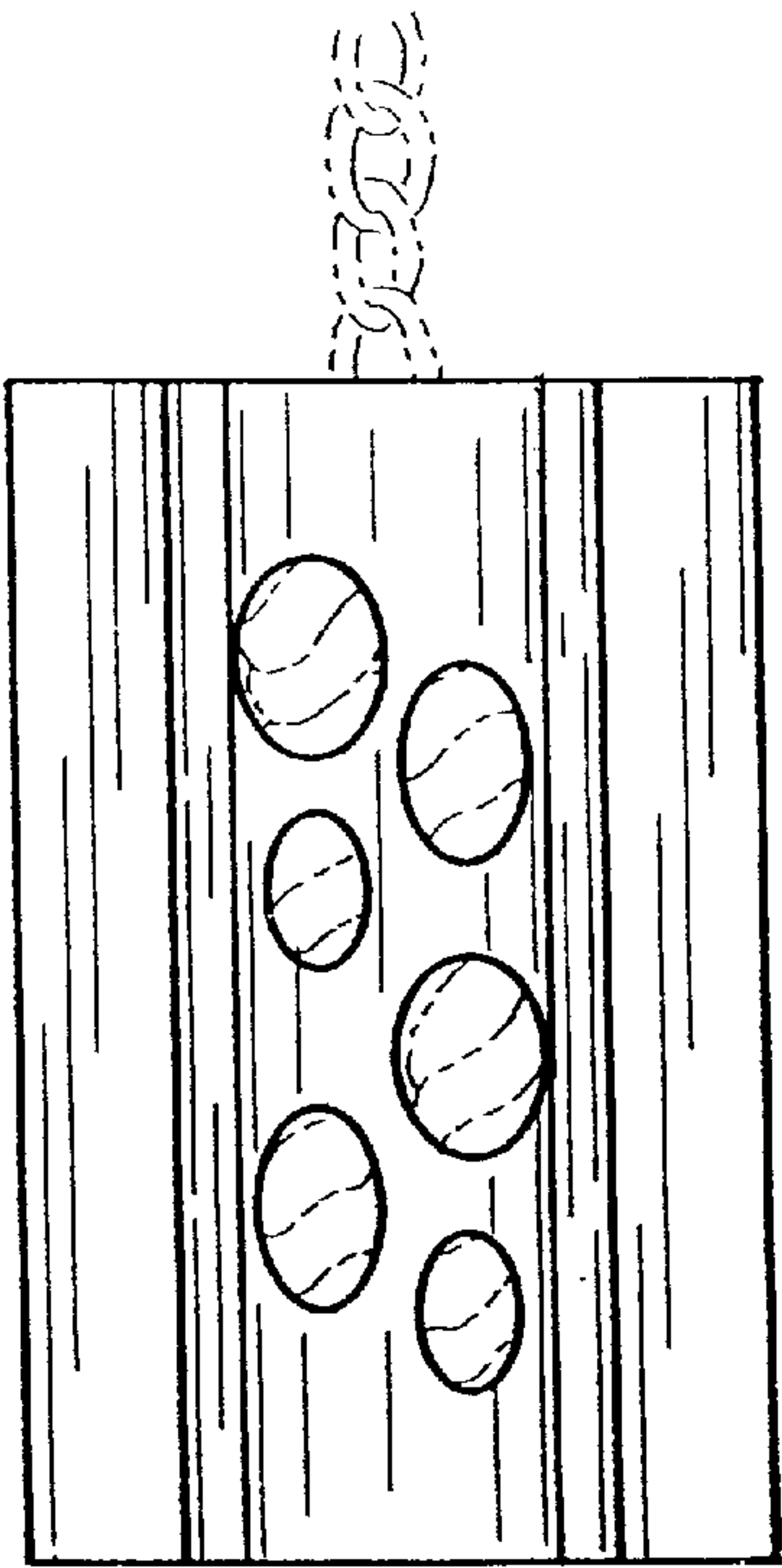

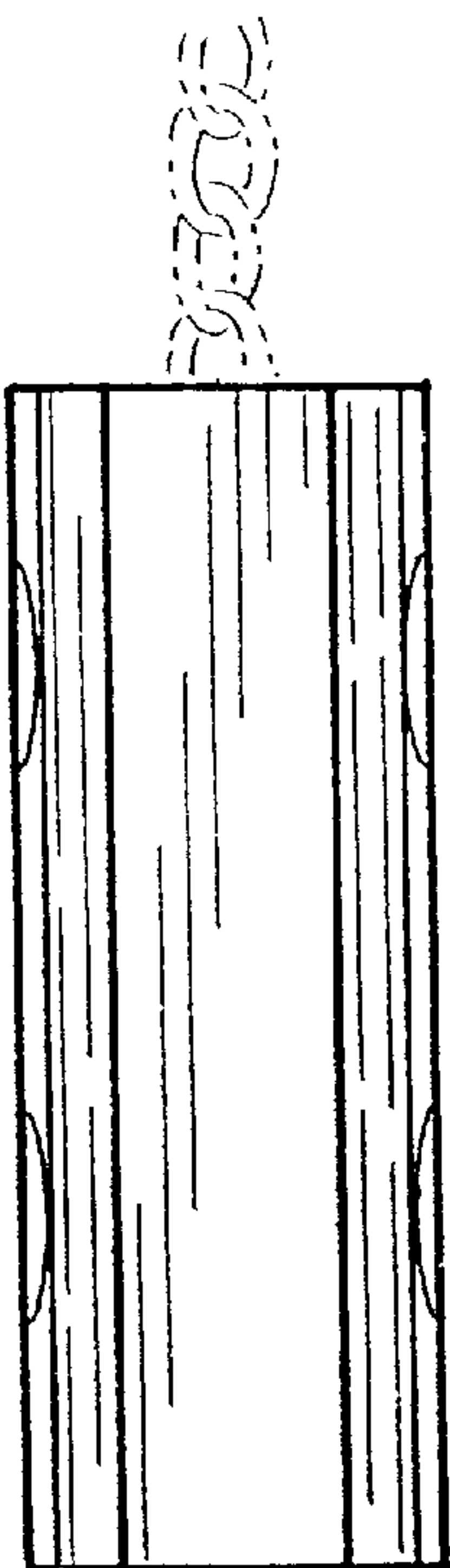

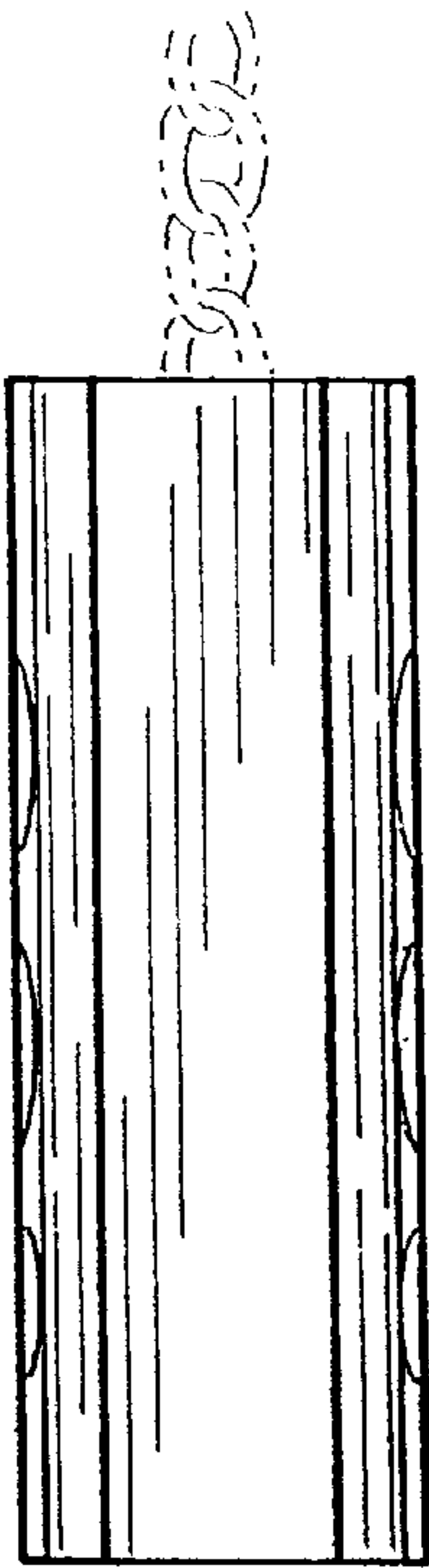

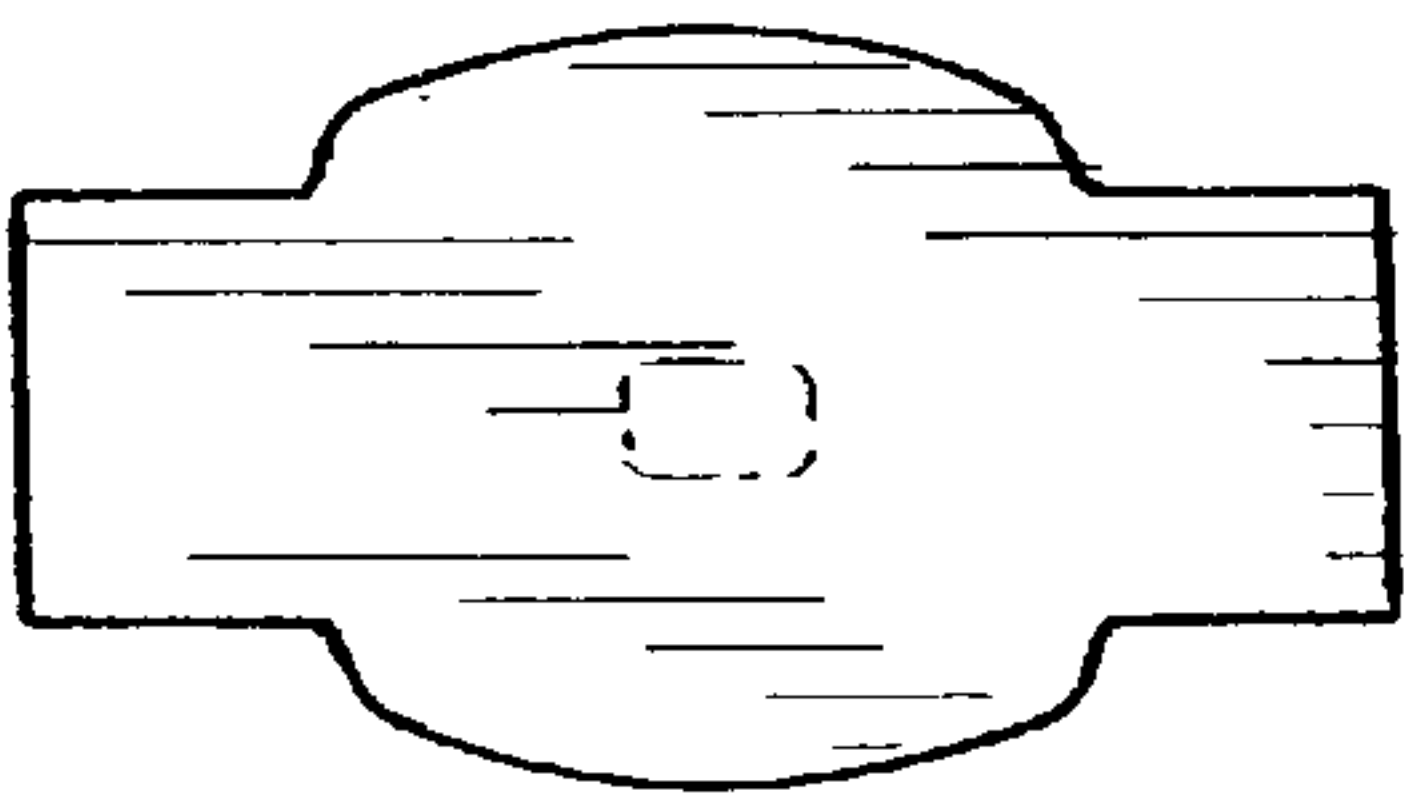

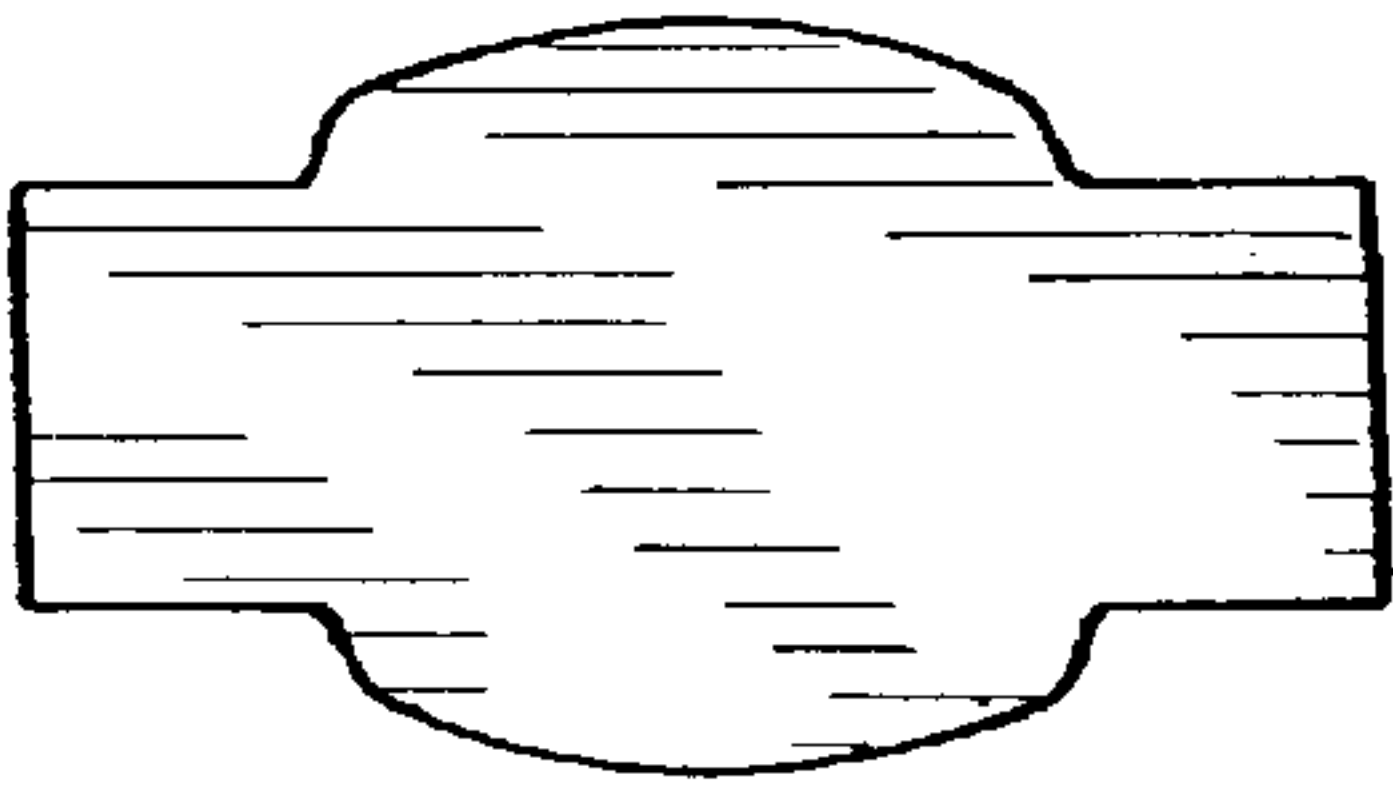
