(57)**CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a toothbrush, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a toothbrush of my new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevation view thereof, the right side elevation being a mirror image of the right side elevation as shown herein in FIG. 2;

FIG. 3 is a back elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a front perspective view thereof, as seen from the bottom left side thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom perspective view thereof, as seen from the back right side thereof;

FIG. 8 is a front elevation view of a second embodiment of the toothbrush of my new design;

FIG. 9 is a left side elevation view thereof, the right side elevation being a mirror image of the right side elevation as shown herein in FIG. 2;

FIG. 10 is a back elevation view thereof;

FIG. 11 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 12 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 13 is a front perspective view thereof, as seen from the bottom left side thereof;

FIG. 14 is a bottom perspective view thereof, as seen from the back right side thereof;

FIG. 15 is a front elevation view of a third embodiment of the toothbrush of my new design, wherein the brush handle is generally transparent;

FIG. 16 is a left side elevation view thereof, the right side elevation being a mirror image of the right side elevation as shown herein in FIG. 2;

FIG. 17 is a back elevation view thereof;

FIG. 18 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 19 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 20 is a front perspective view thereof, as seen from the bottom left side thereof;

FIG. 21 is a bottom perspective view thereof, as seen from the back right side thereof;

FIG. 22 is a front elevation view of a fourth embodiment of the toothbrush of my new design, wherein the brush handle is generally transparent;

FIG. 23 is a left side elevation view thereof, the right side elevation being substantial a mirror image of the right side elevation as shown herein in FIG. 2;

FIG. 24 is a back elevation view thereof;

FIG. 25 is a top view thereof;


FIG. 26 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 27 is a front perspective view thereof, as seen from the bottom left side thereof; and,

FIG. 28 is a bottom perspective view thereof, as seen from the back right side thereof.
