(57) CLAIM

An ornamental design for a combined navel ring and logo portion, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a first side view of a combined navel ring and logo portion suited to the positioning of a logo or the like;


FIG. 2 is a second side view of a combined navel ring and logo portion shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front view of a combined navel ring and logo portion shown in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 4 is a rear view of a combined navel ring and logo portion shown in FIG. 1.

The dashed lines are shown in the views for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design, because they (1) represent non-statutory functional subject matter, (2) represent environment for the navel ring and/or (3) they are non-limiting, and therefore disclaimed aspects of the design. The uppermost solid line defines the upper boundary of the claimed design, and the lowermost solid line defines the lower boundary of the claimed design.
