FIG. 6 is a right side view thereof, the left side view being a mirror image thereof.

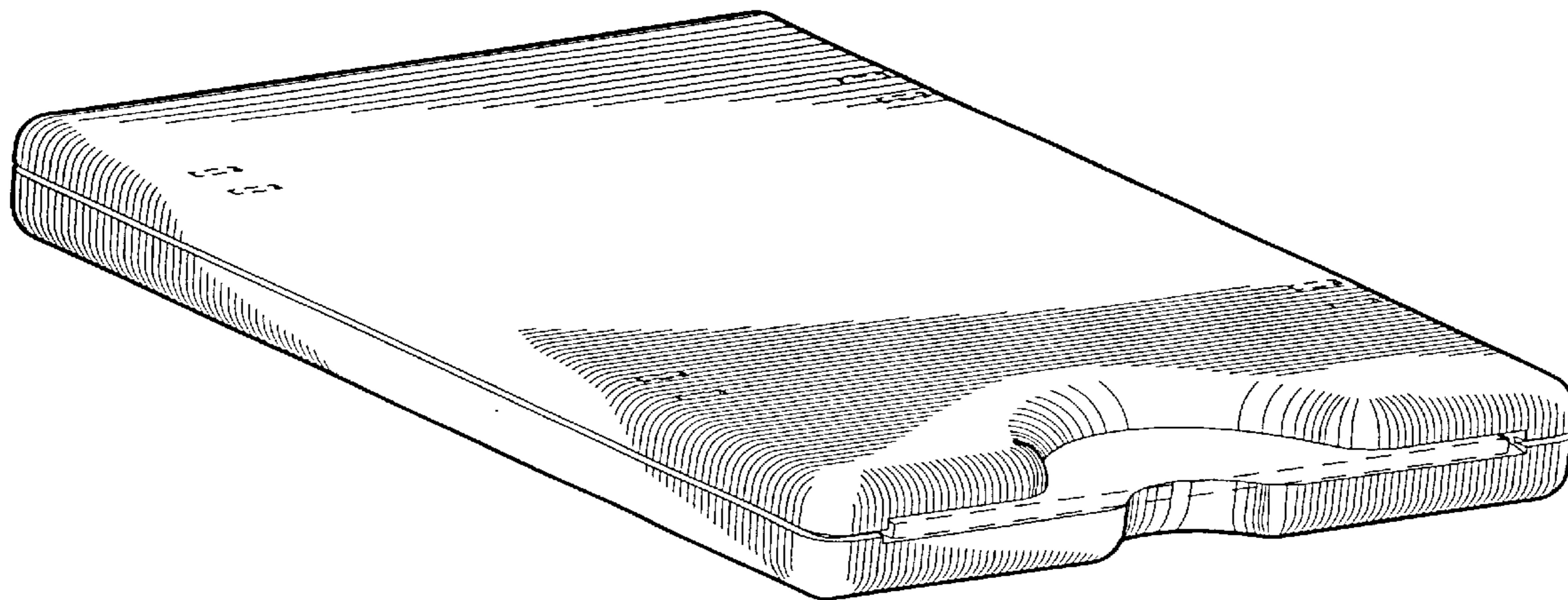
The broken lines shown in FIGS. 1–6 represent environmental subject matter and form no part of the claimed design. The rear view is omitted and forms no part of the claimed design.

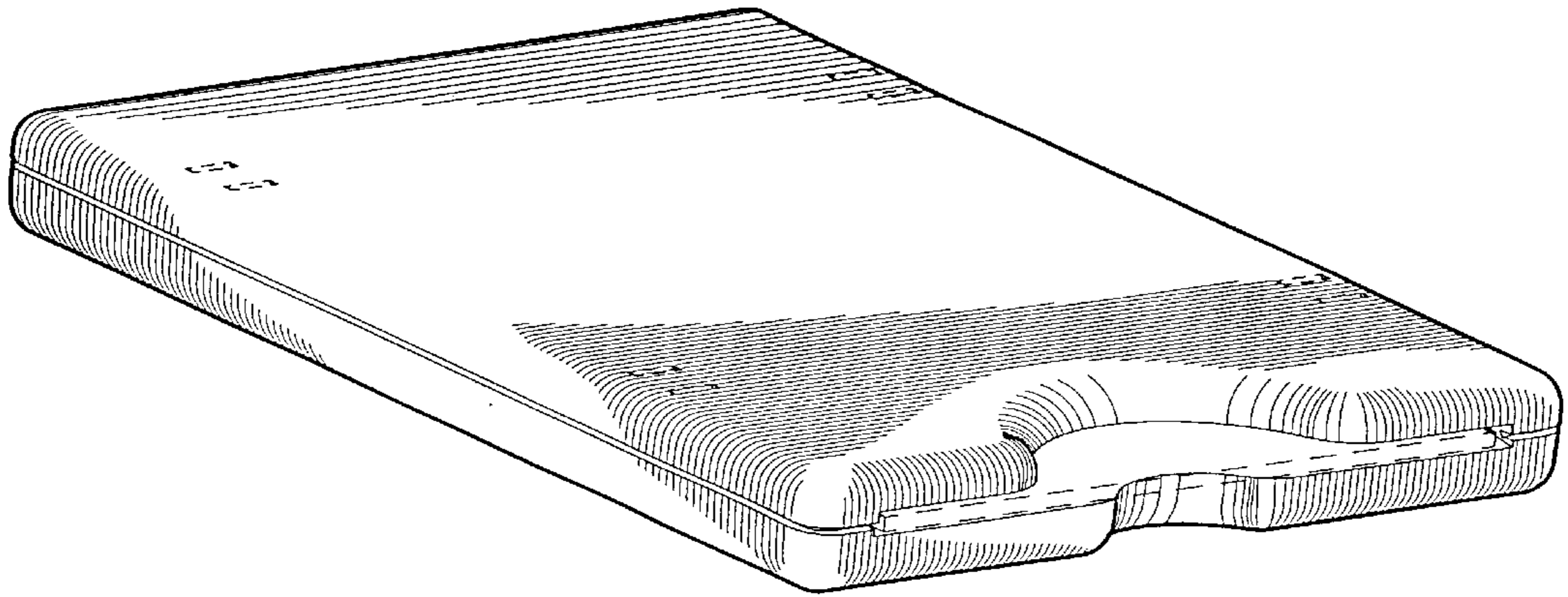

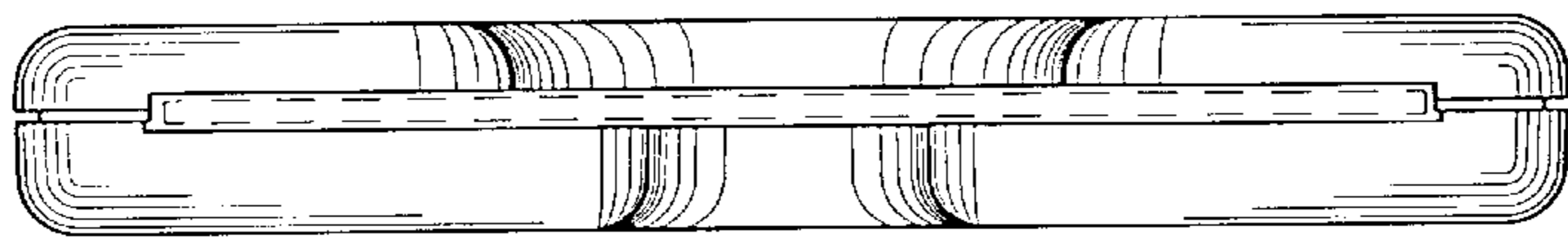

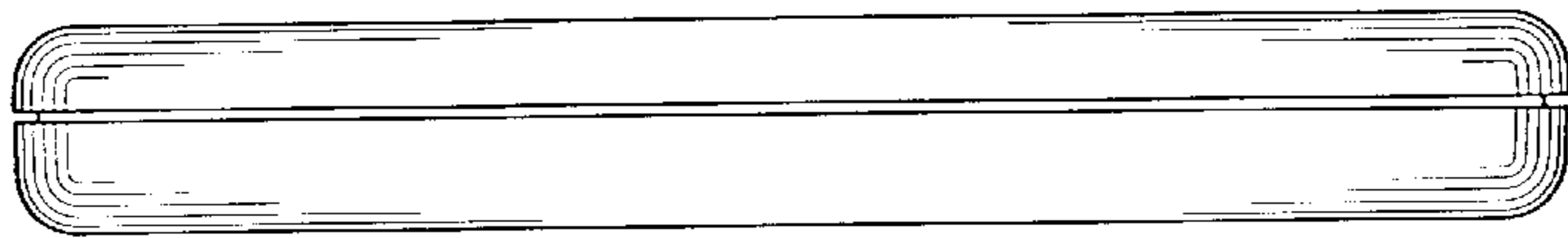

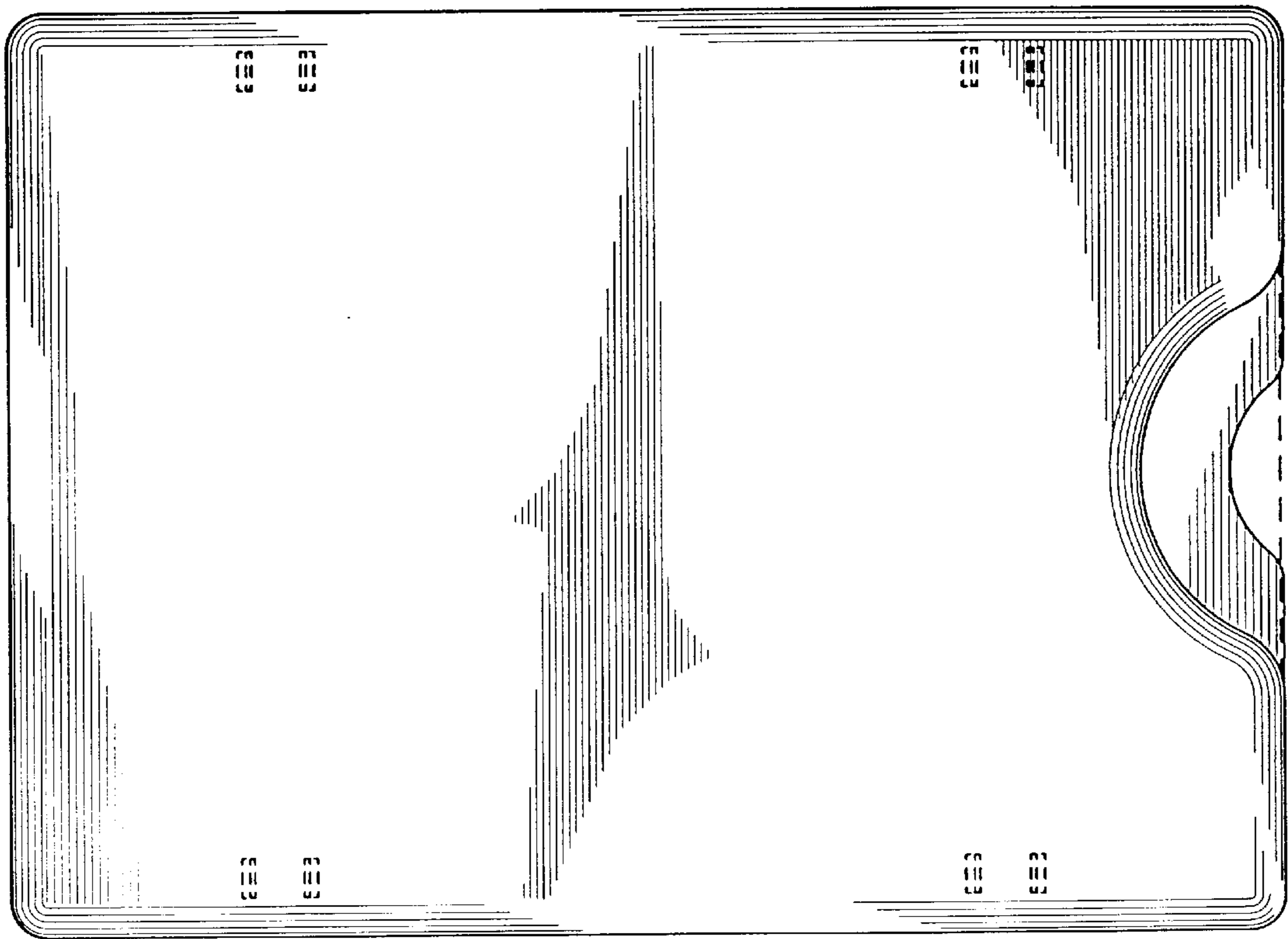

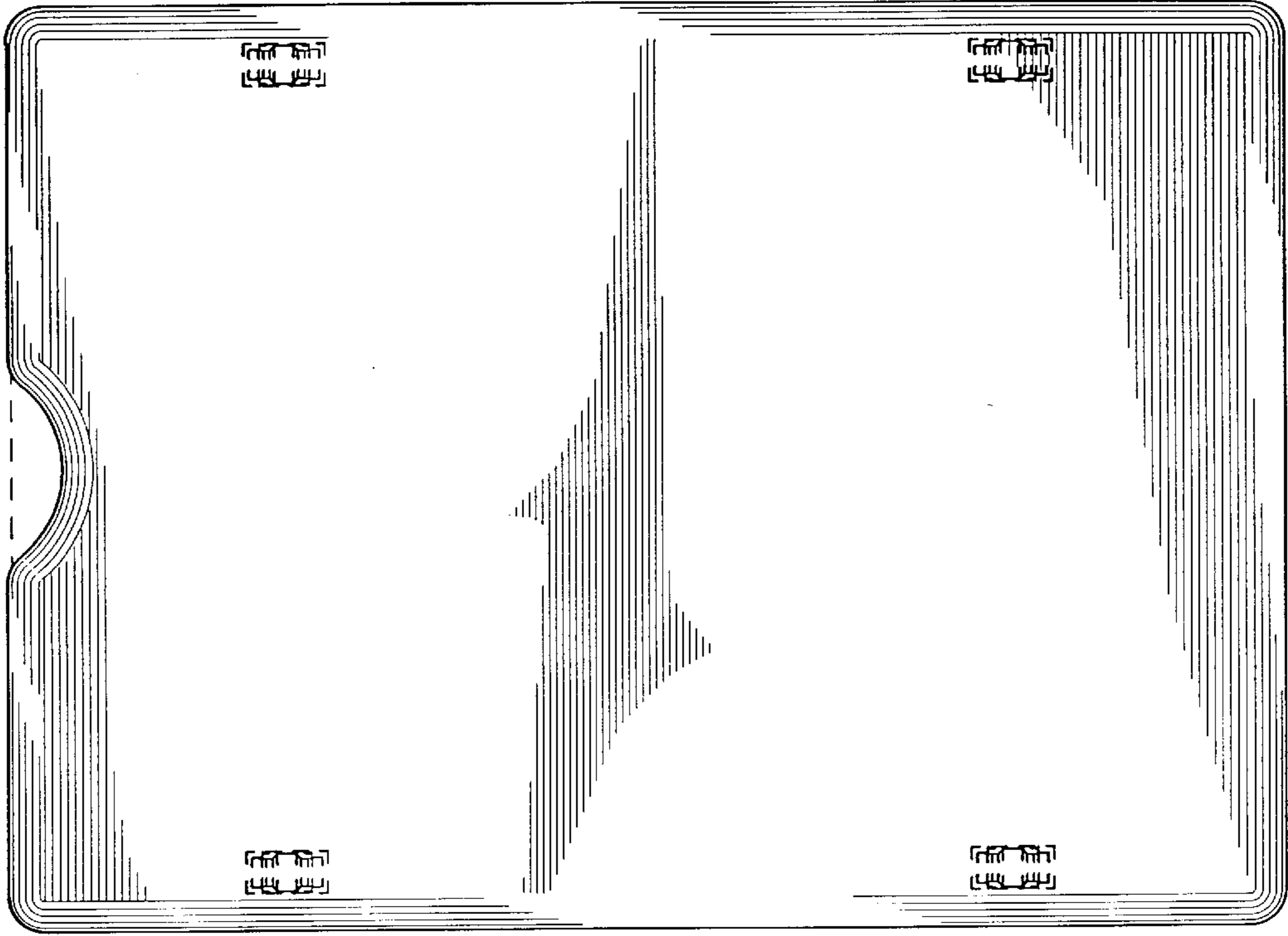

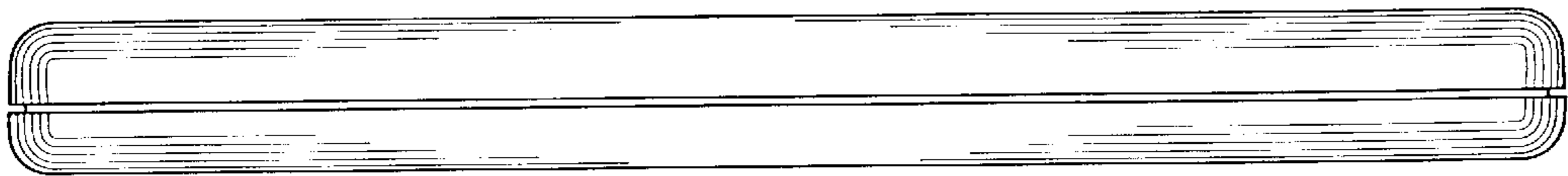
