DESCRIPTION

FIG. 9 is a bottom view of the elbow coupling shown in FIG. 7;

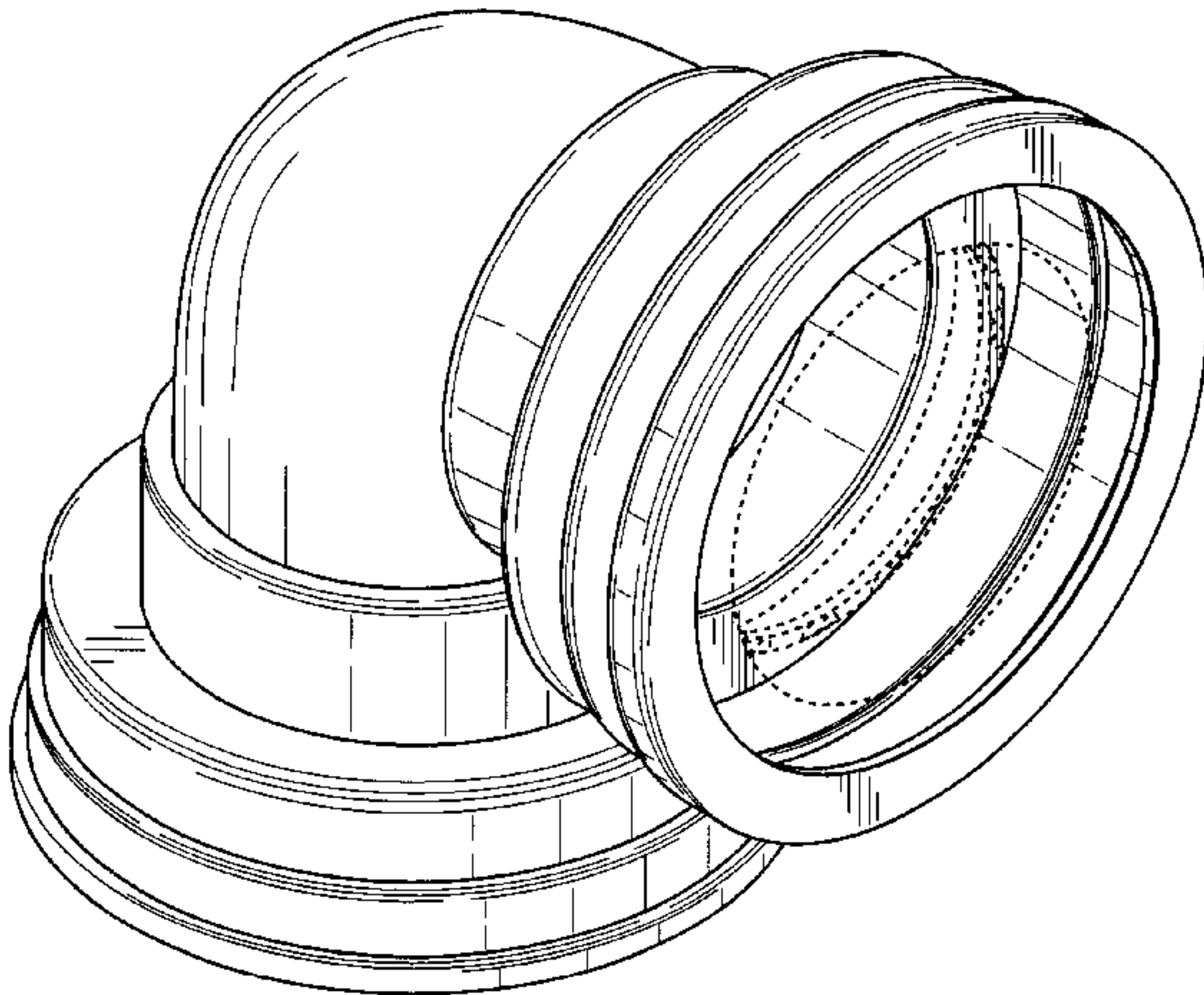
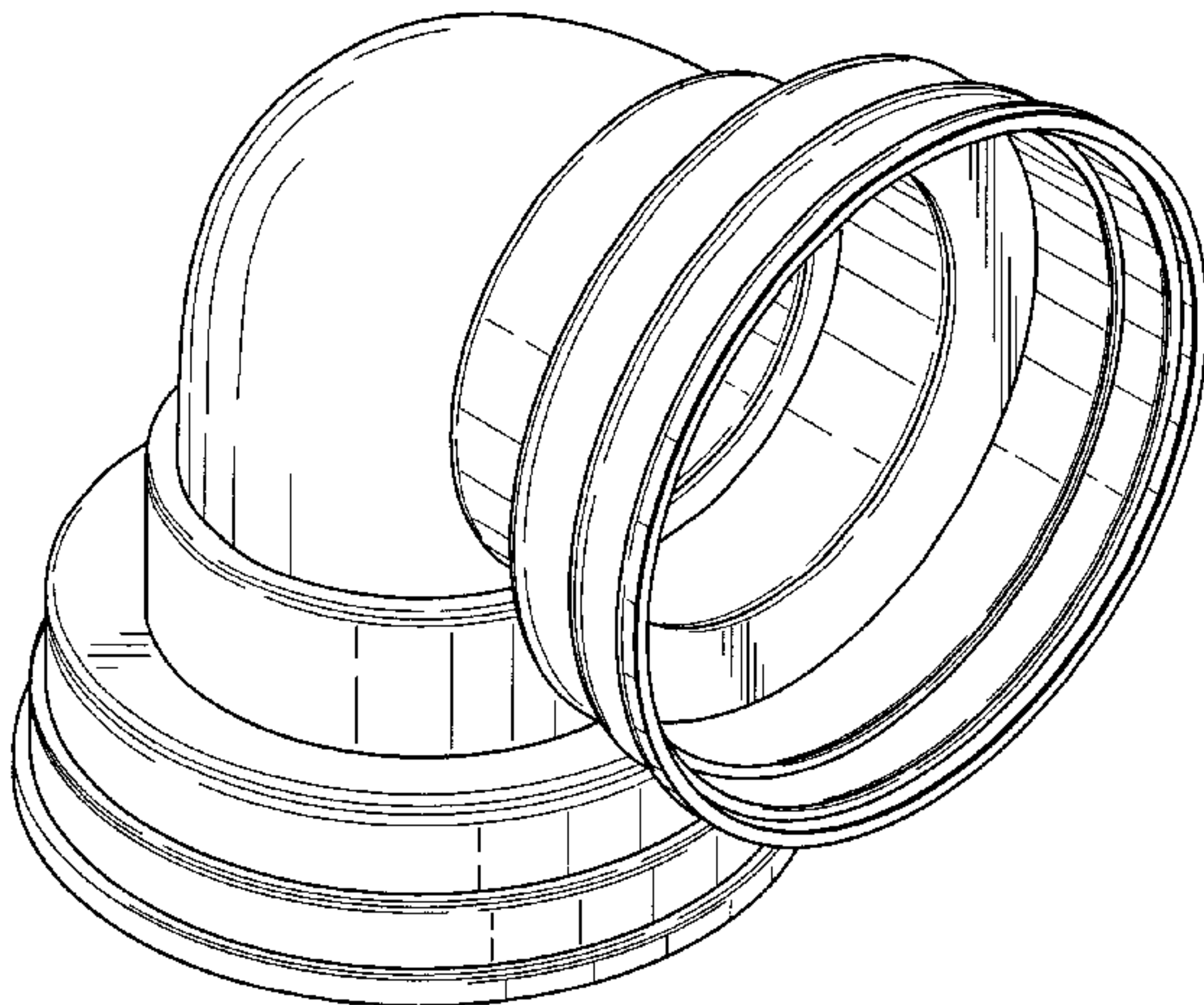
FIG. 10 is a left side view of the elbow coupling shown in FIG. 7, the right side being shown in perspective in FIG. 7;

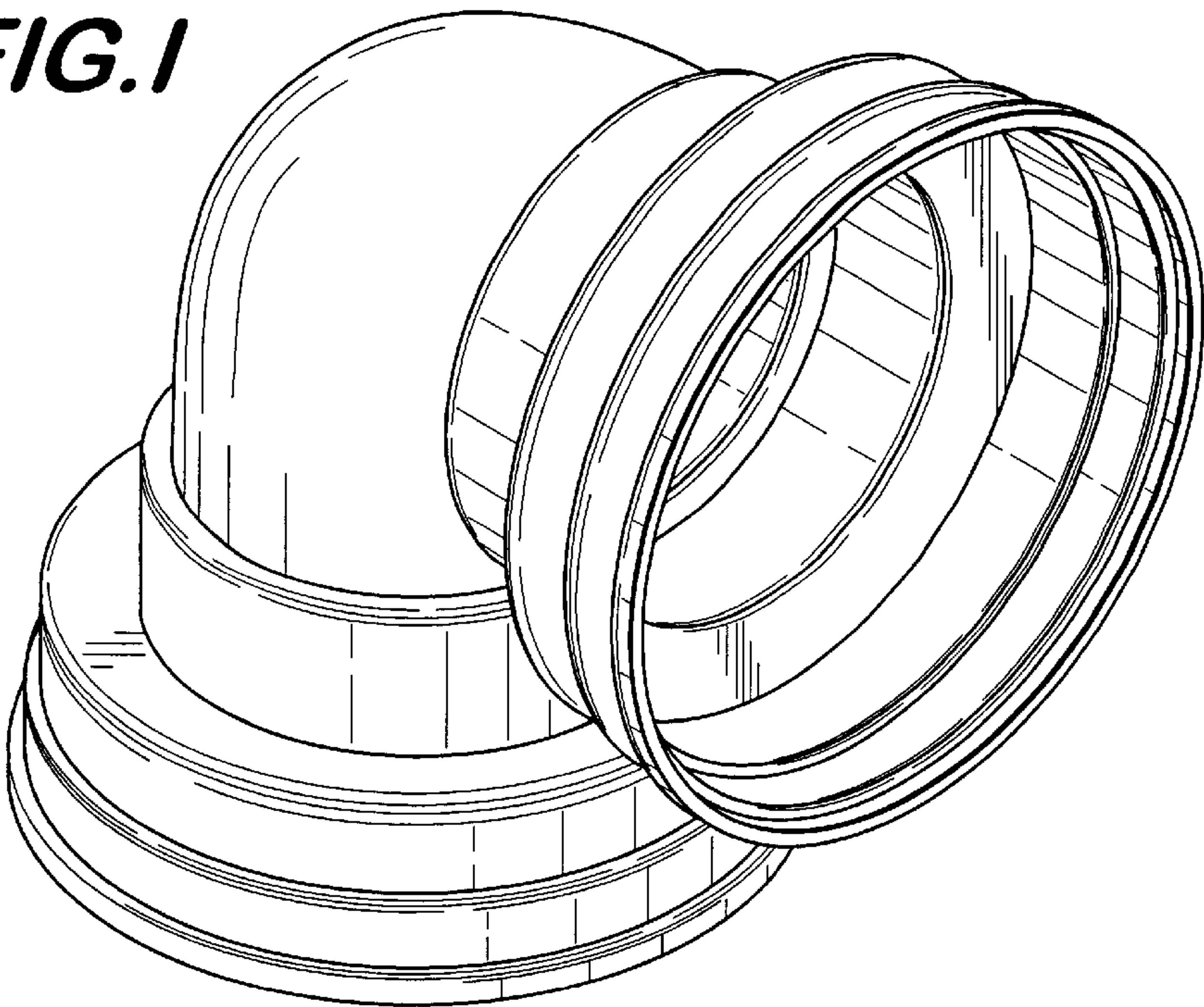

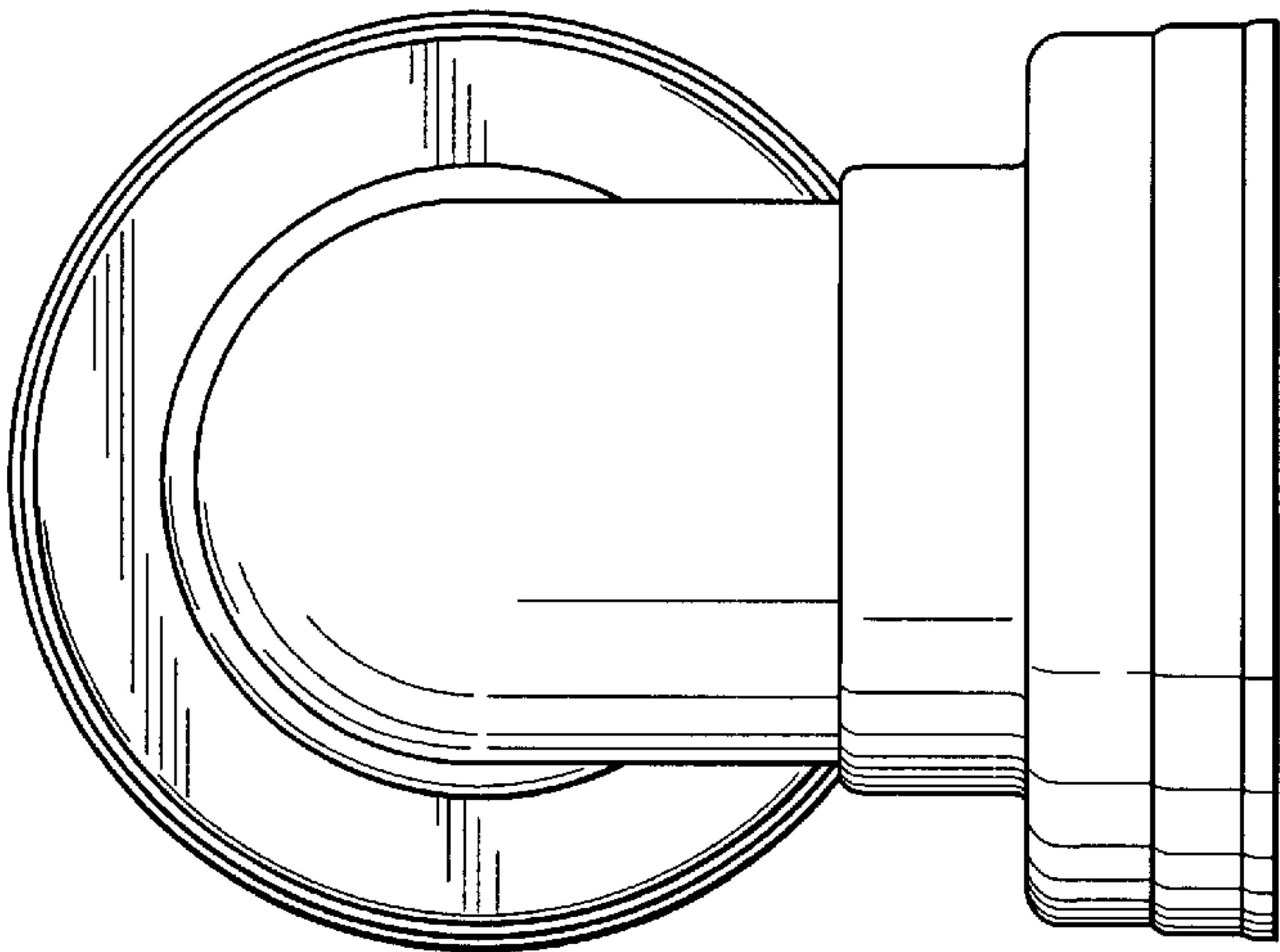
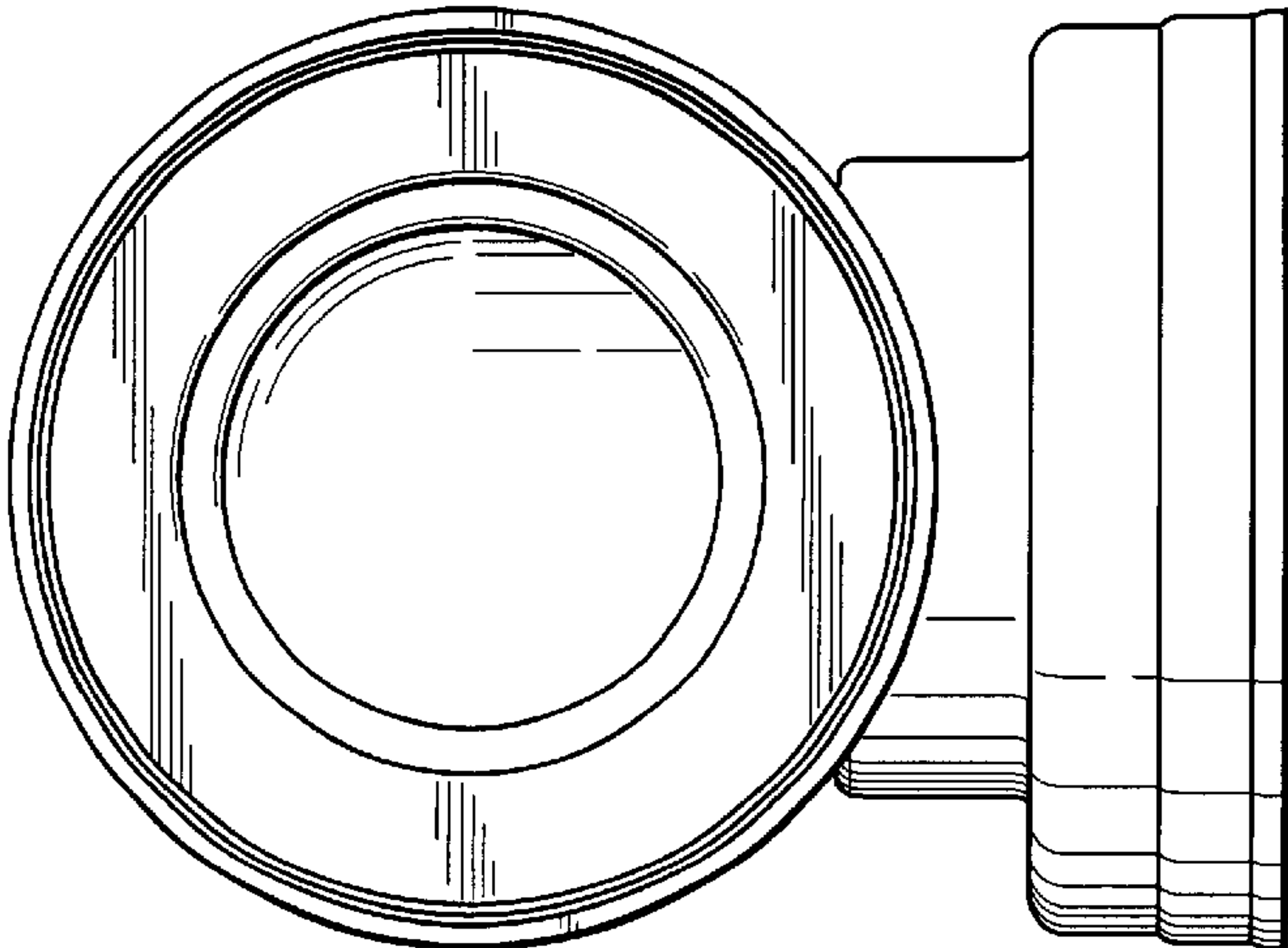

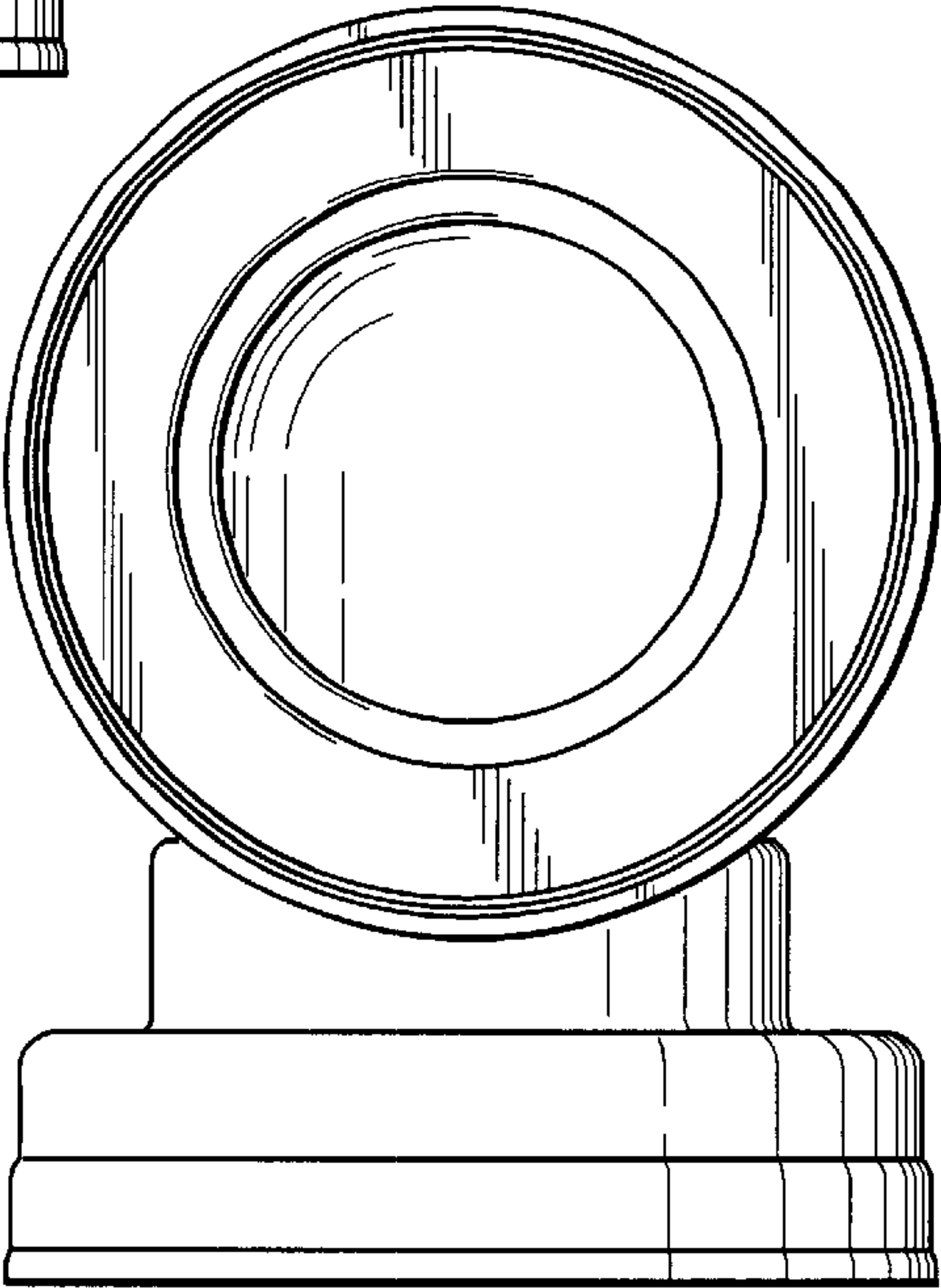
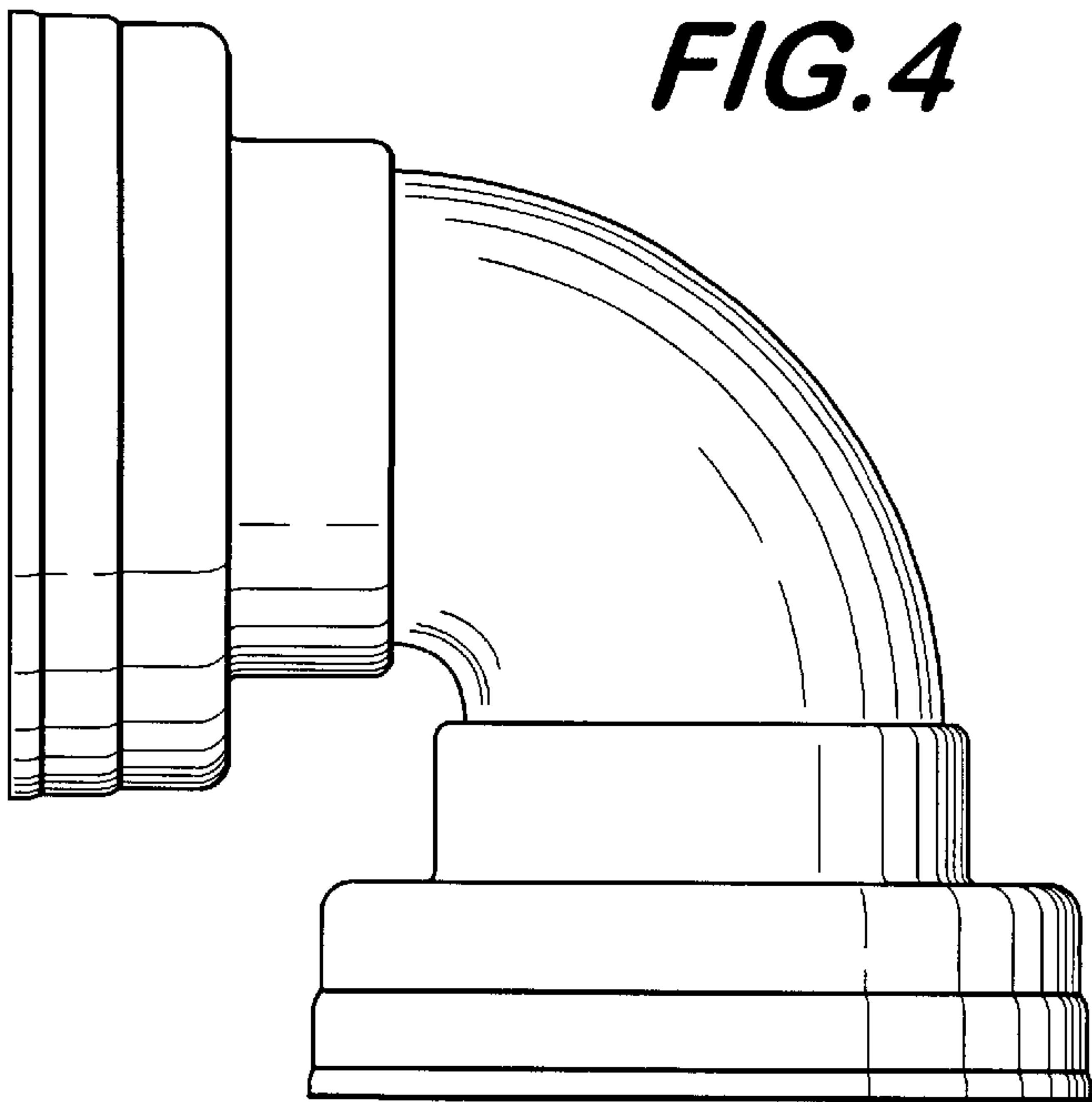

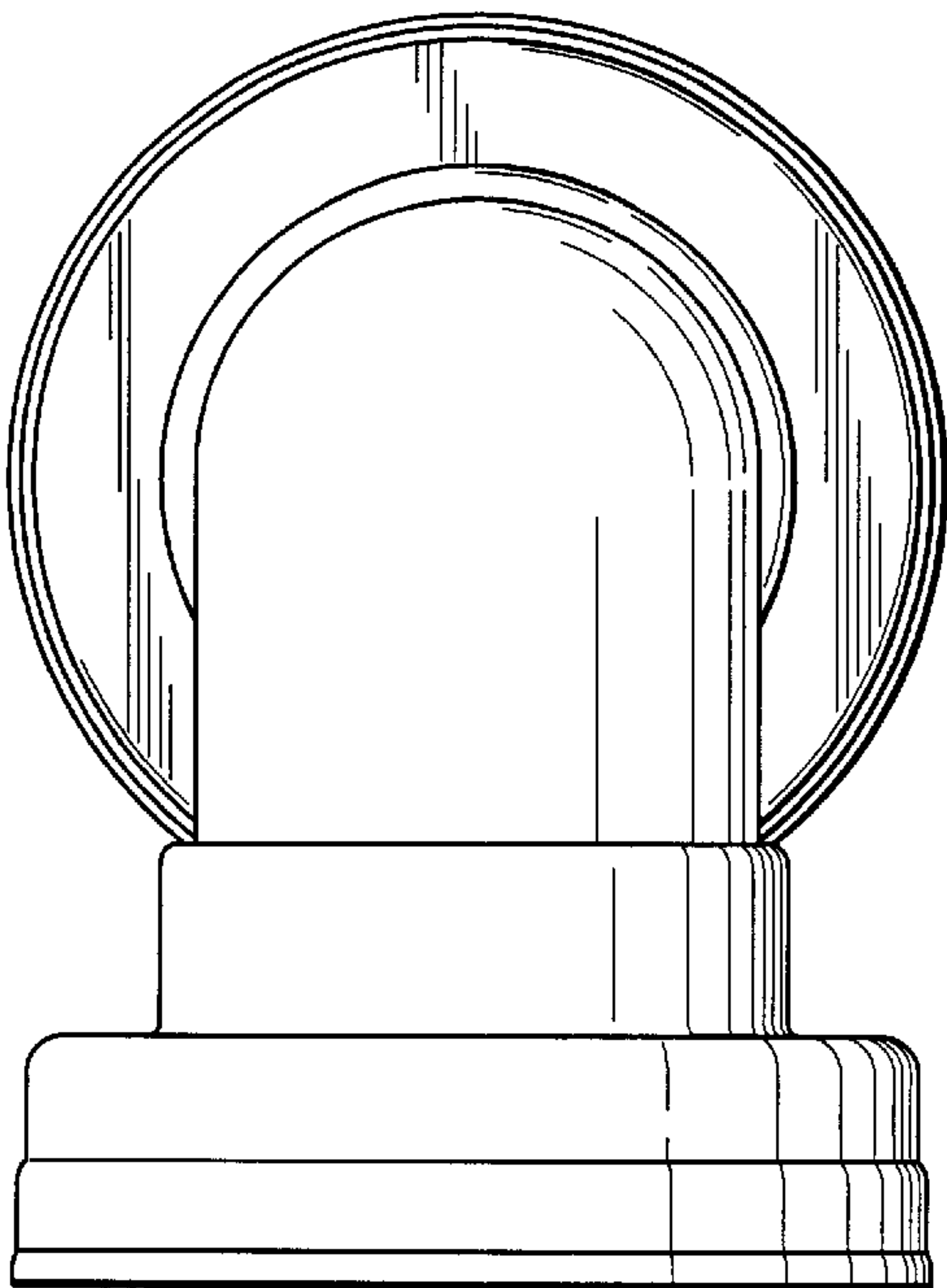

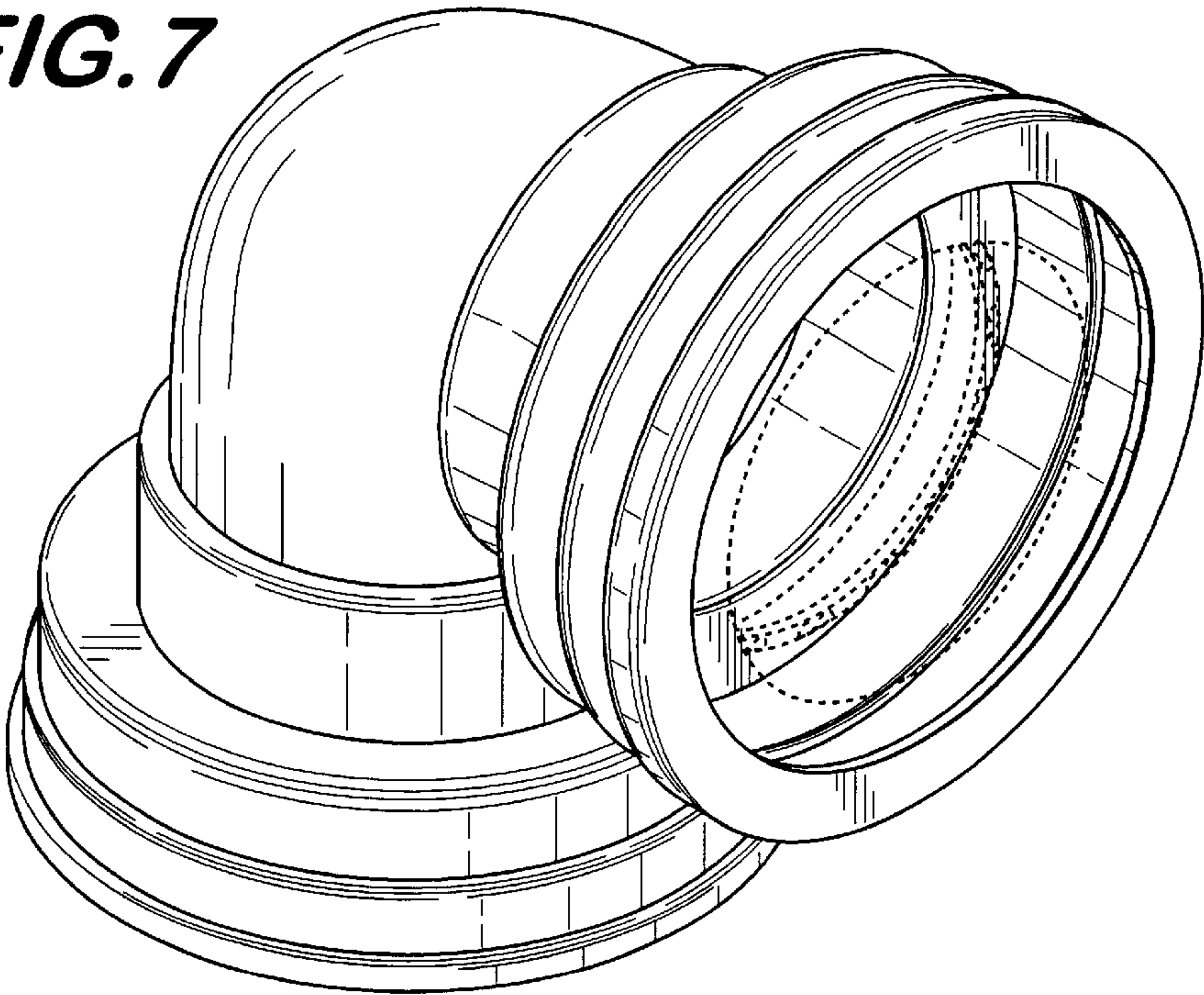

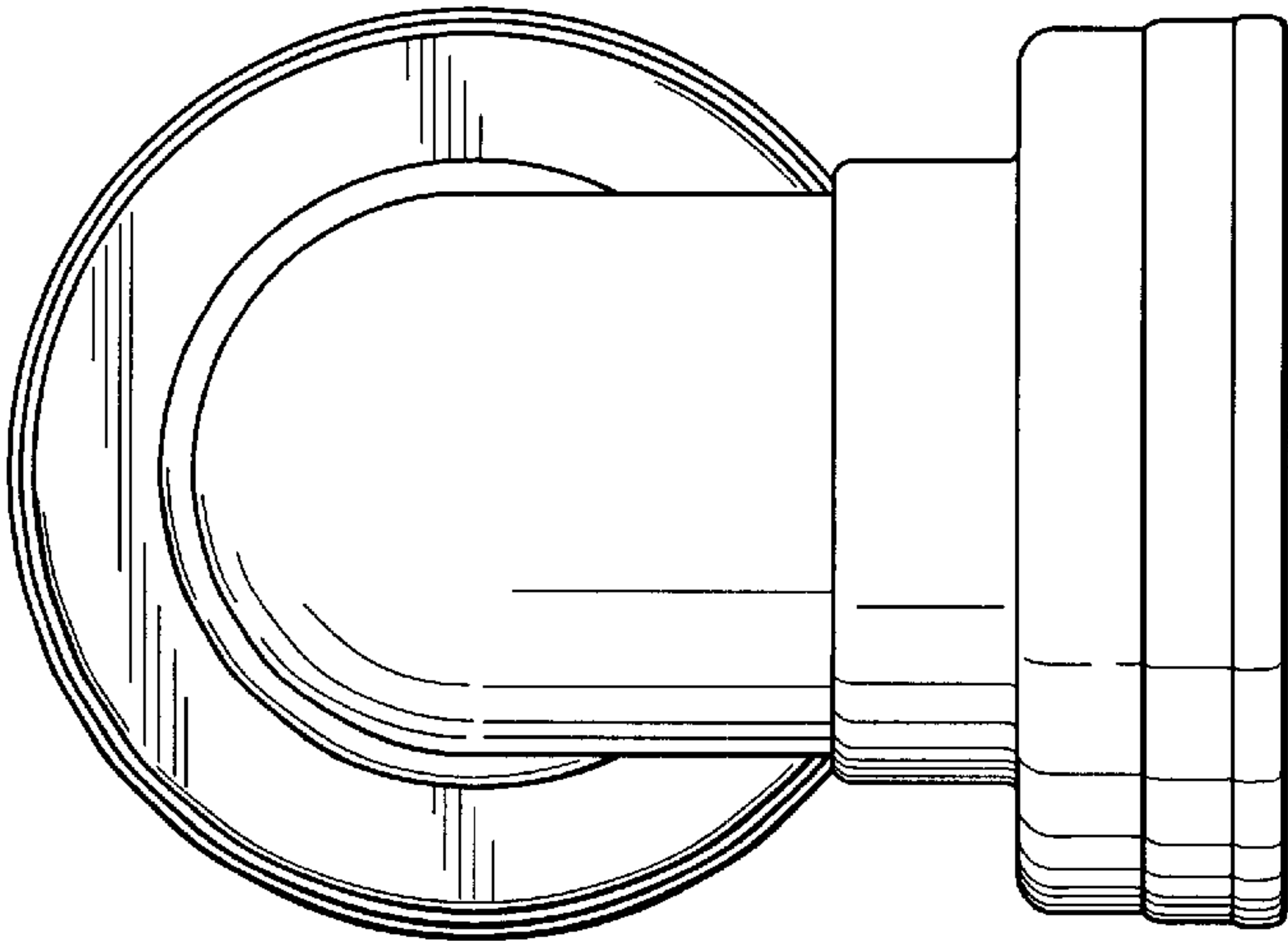
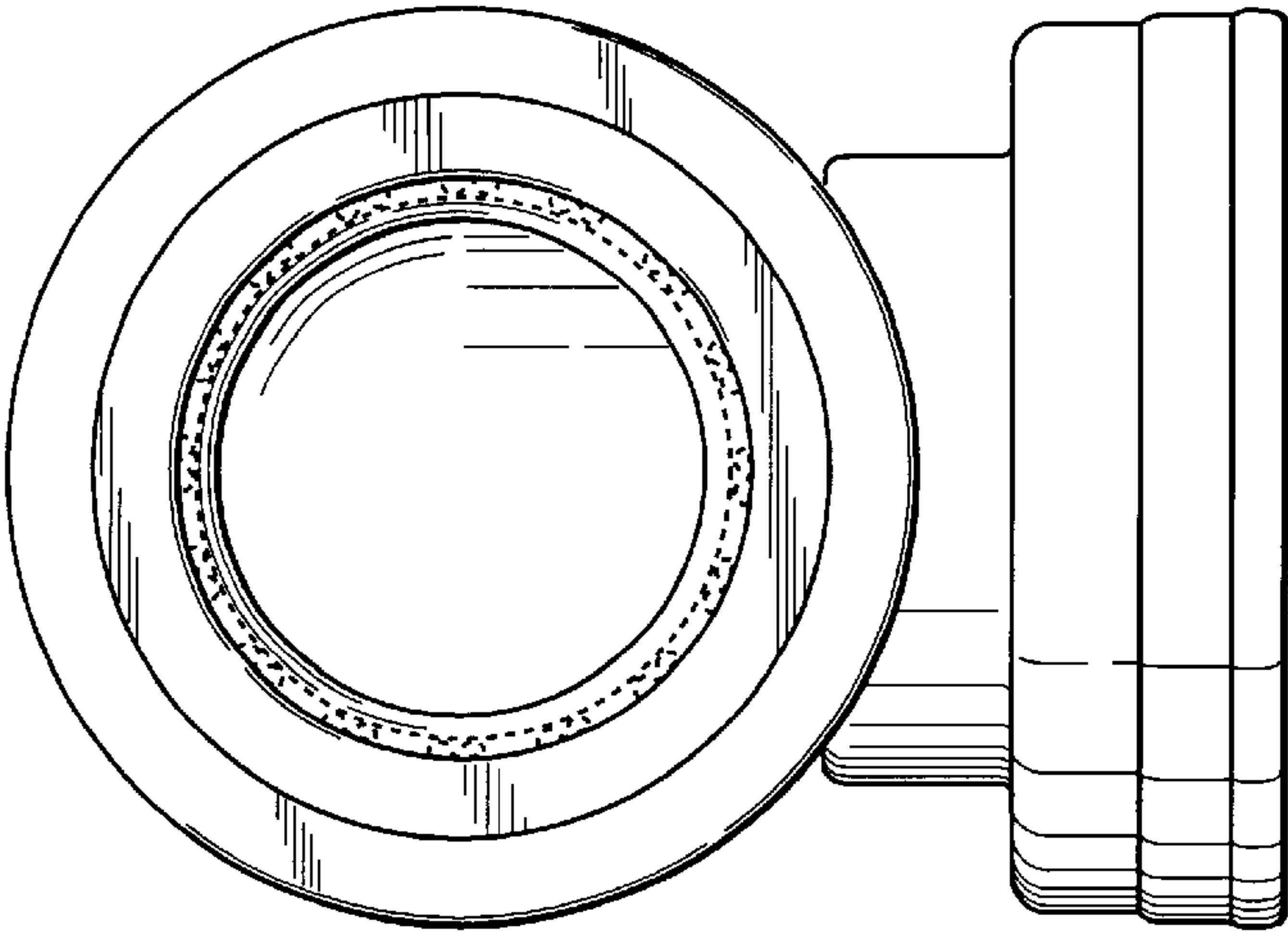

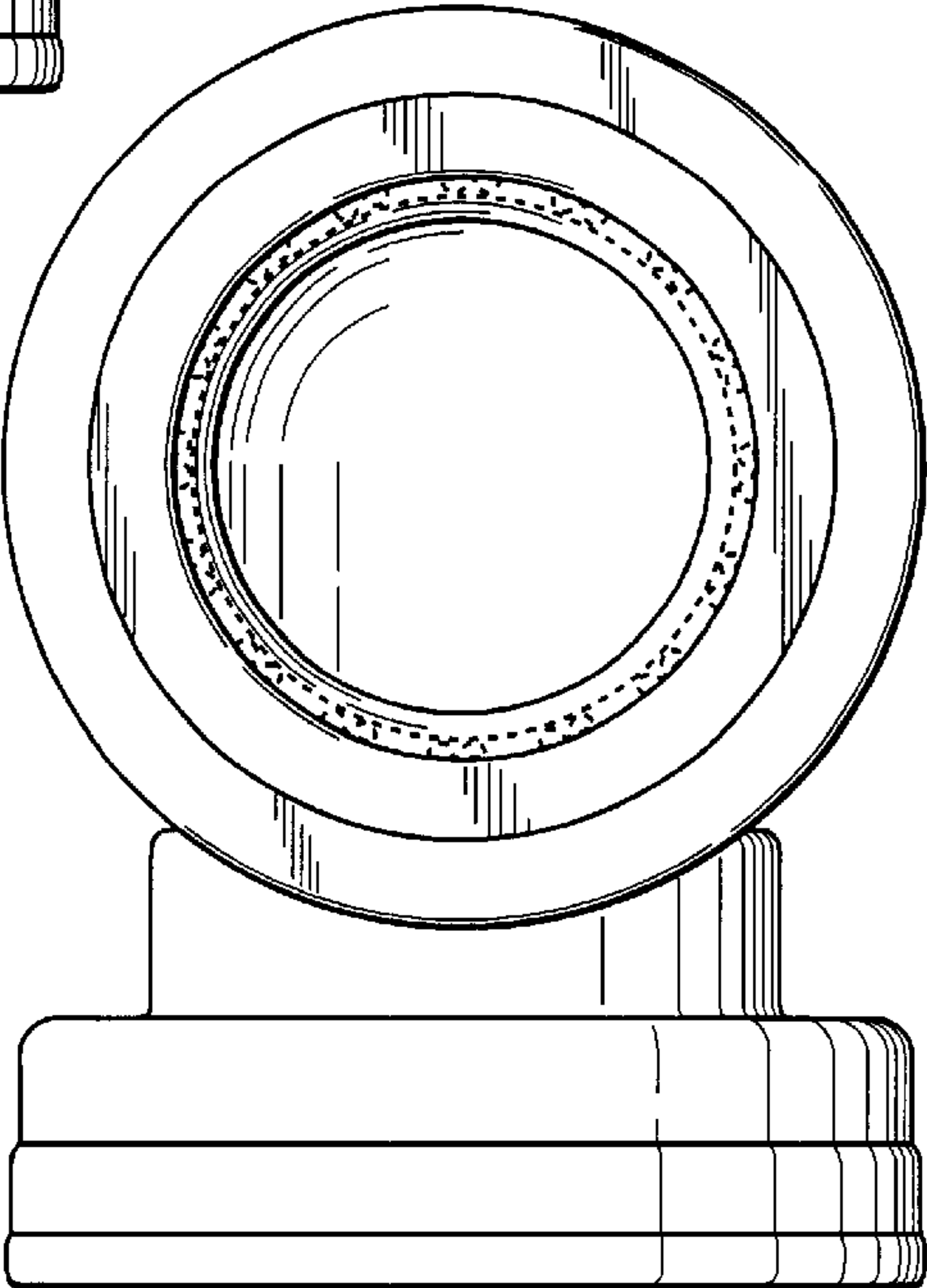
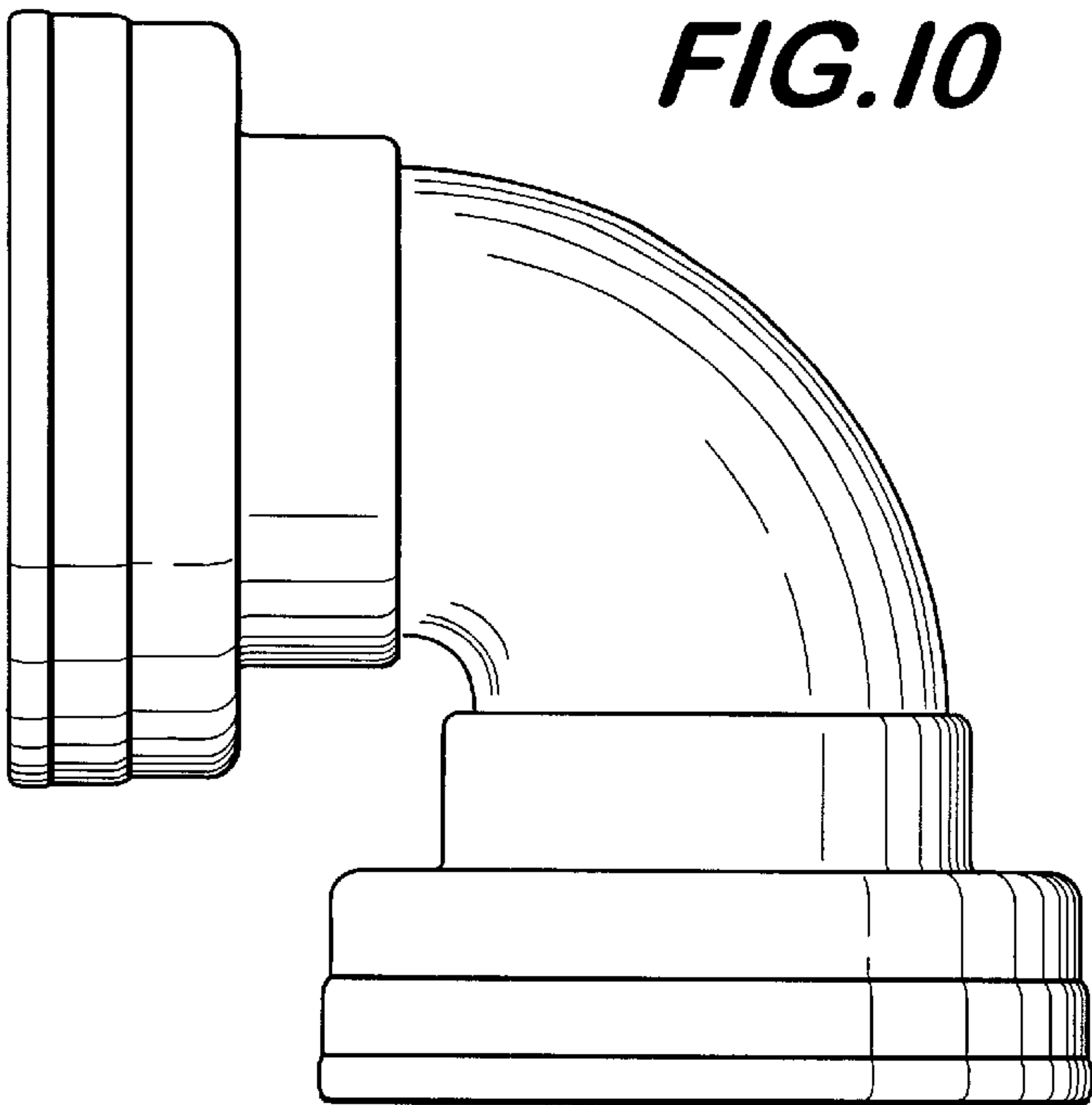

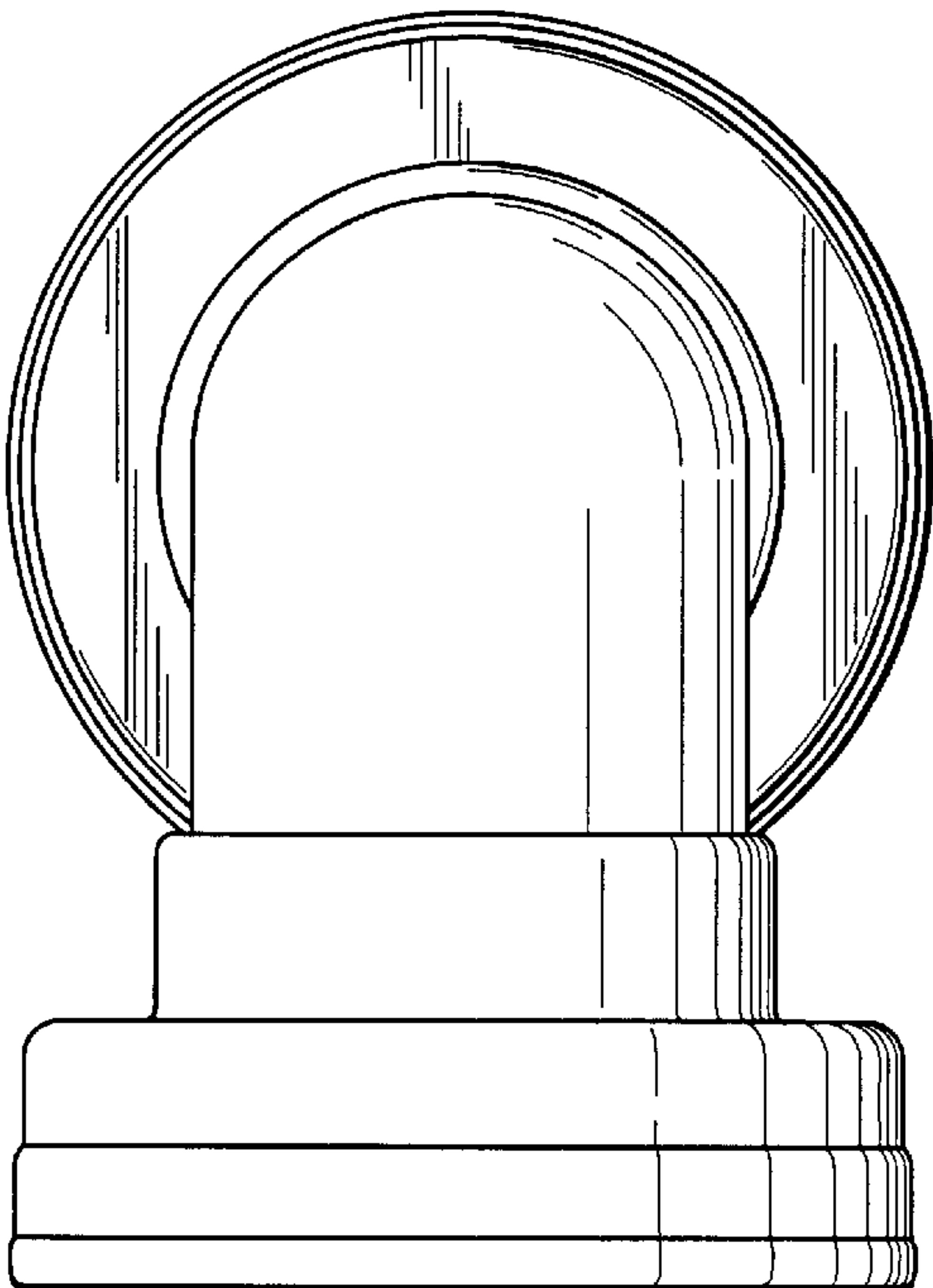
