DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, left, front perspective view of a slow cooker embodying our design, the broken lines indicating environmental structure not forming a part of our design;

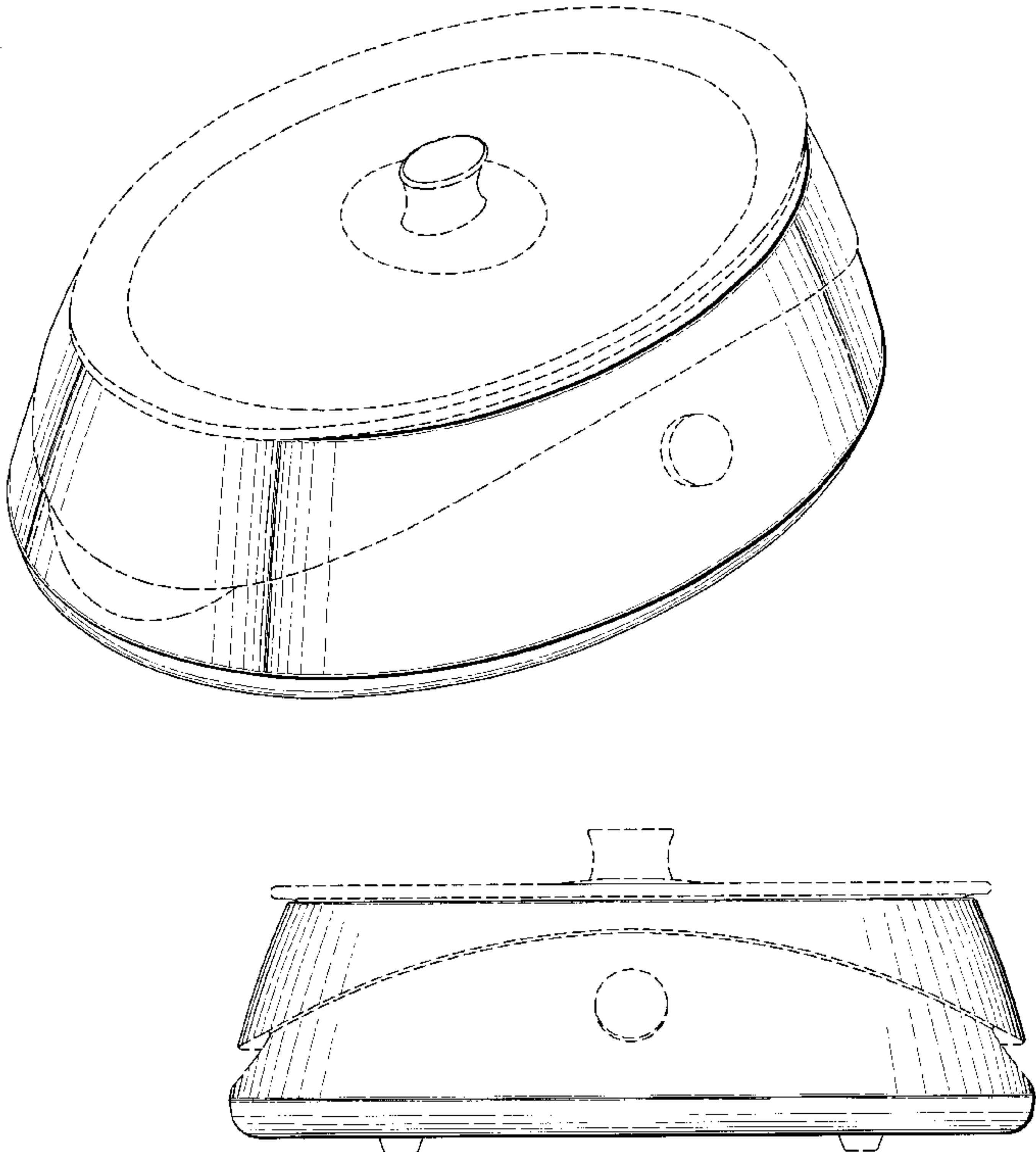
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the broken lines indicating environmental structure not forming a part of our design;

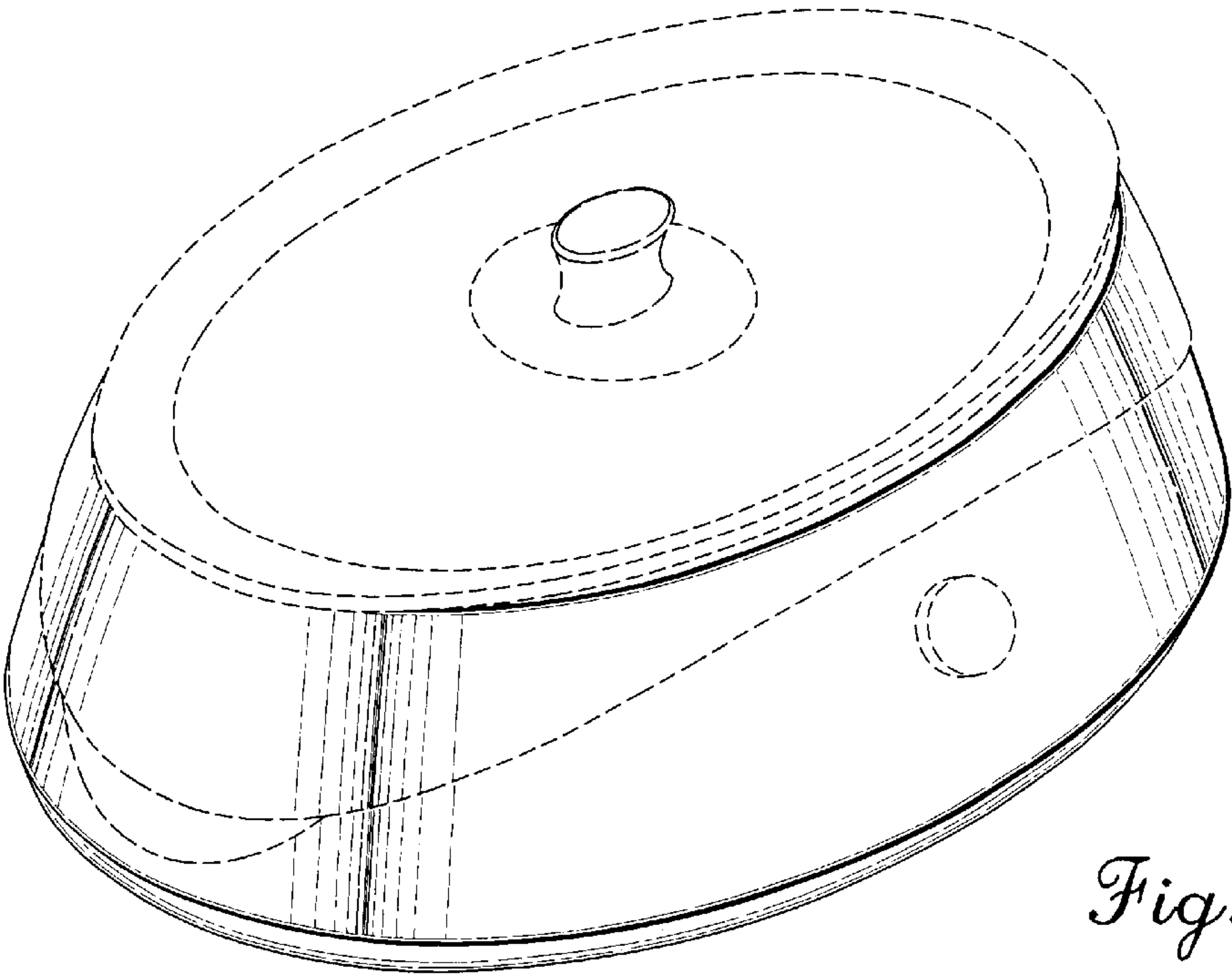

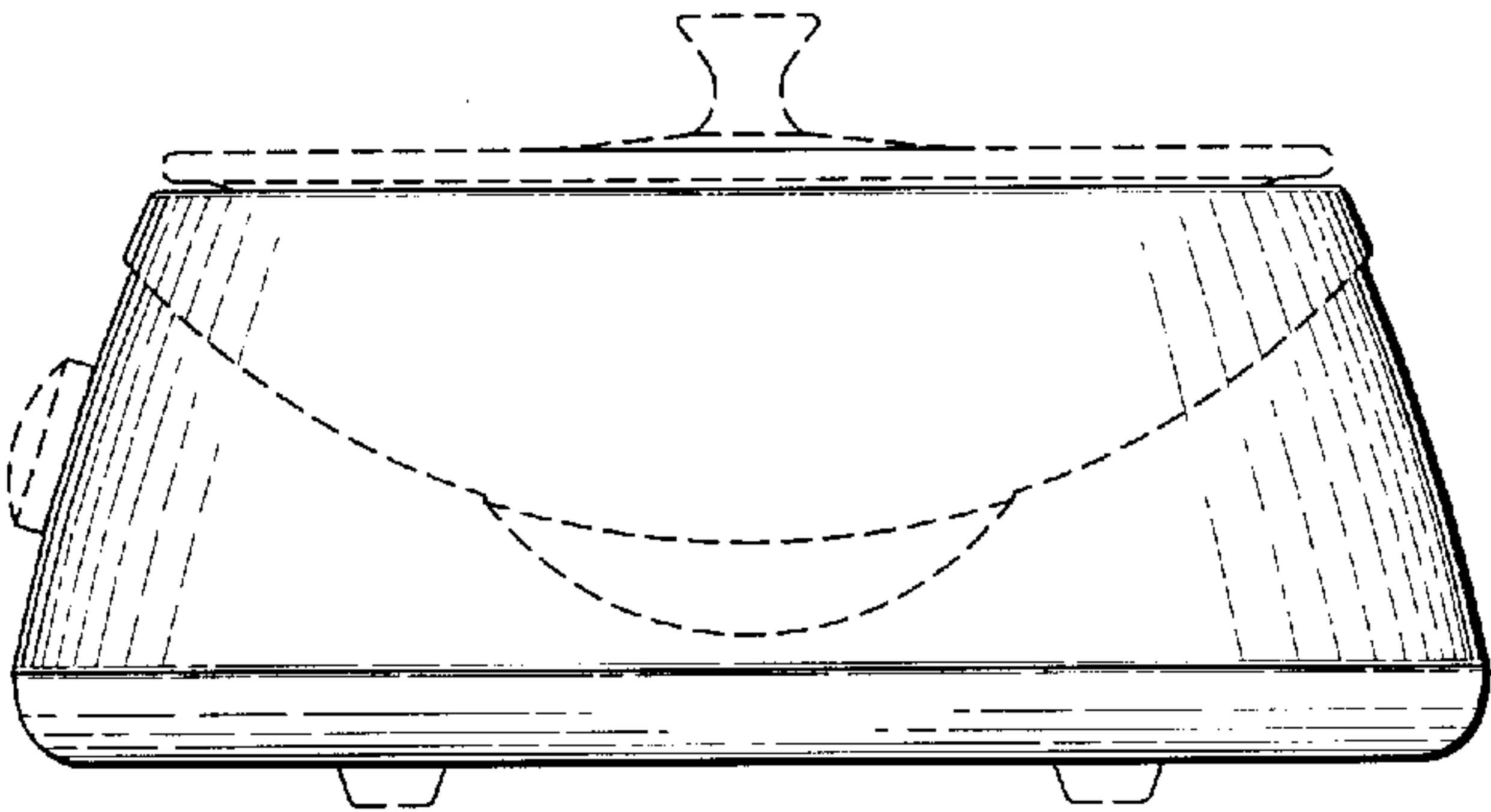
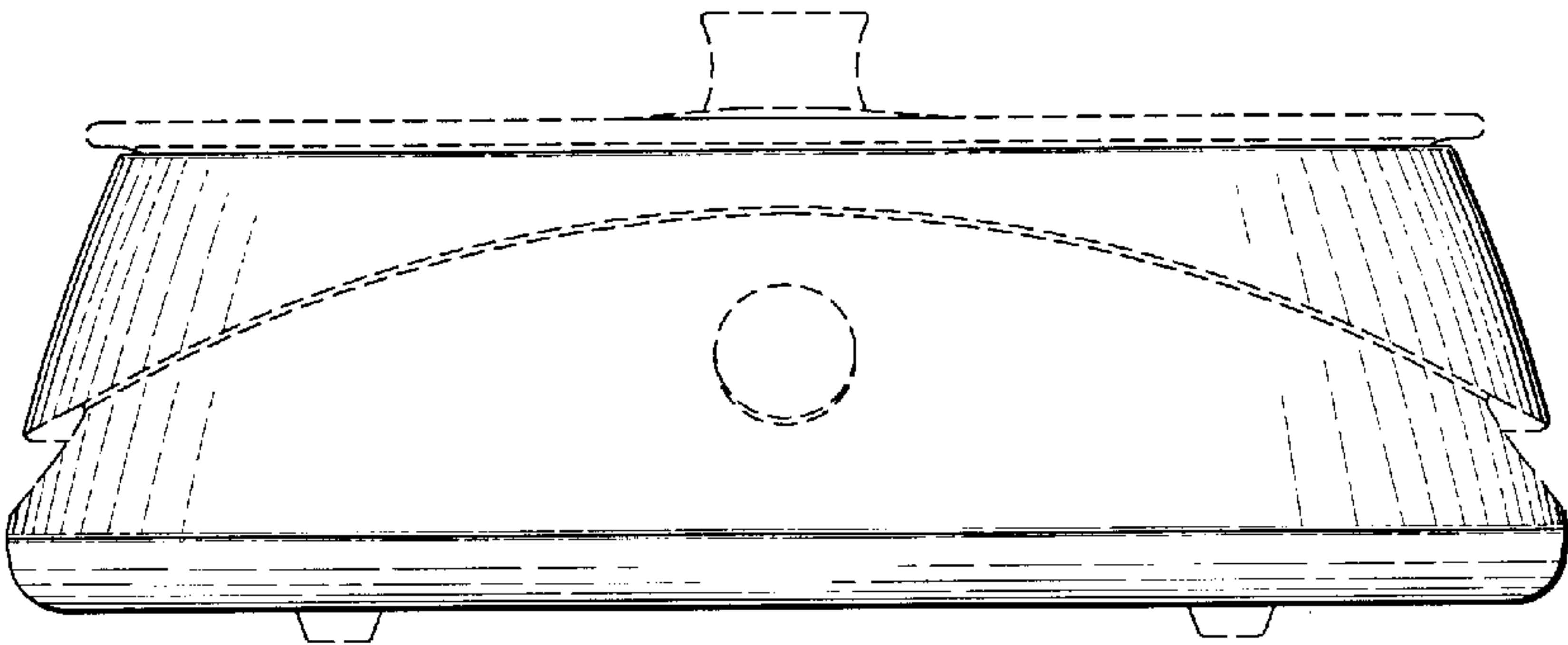

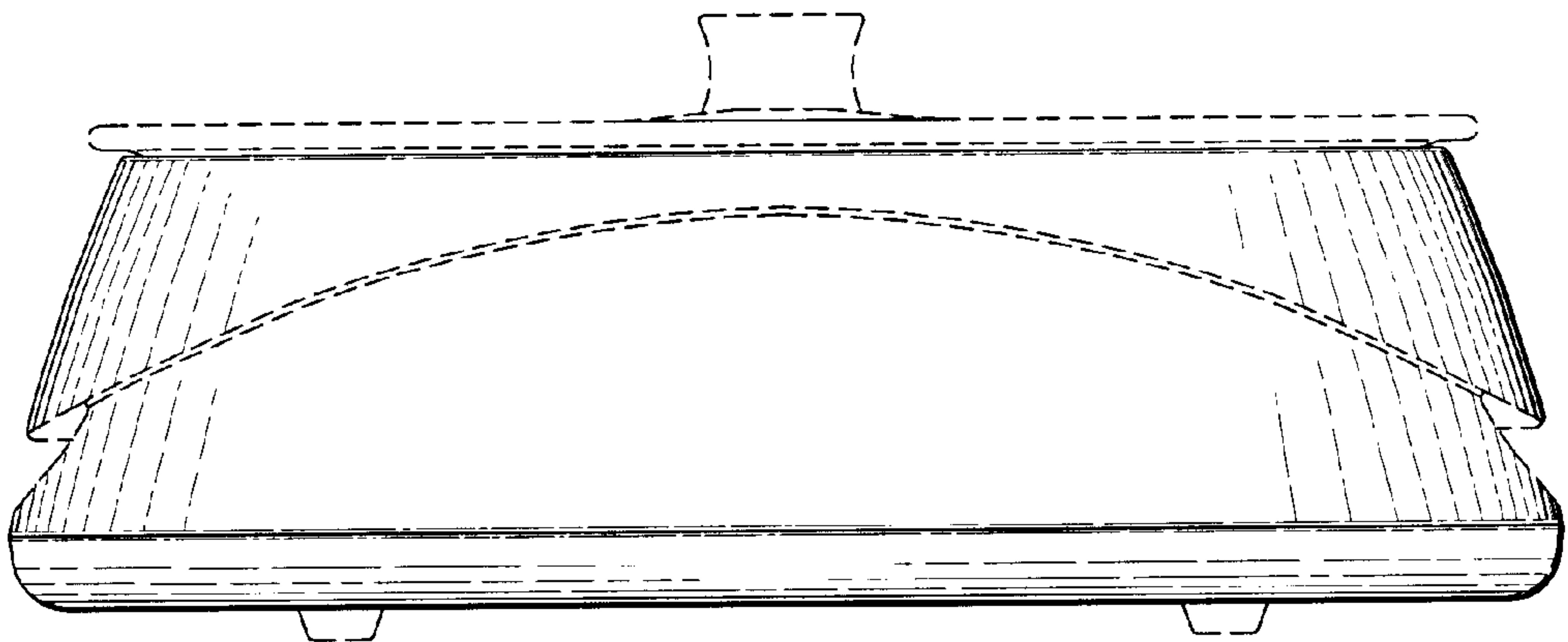

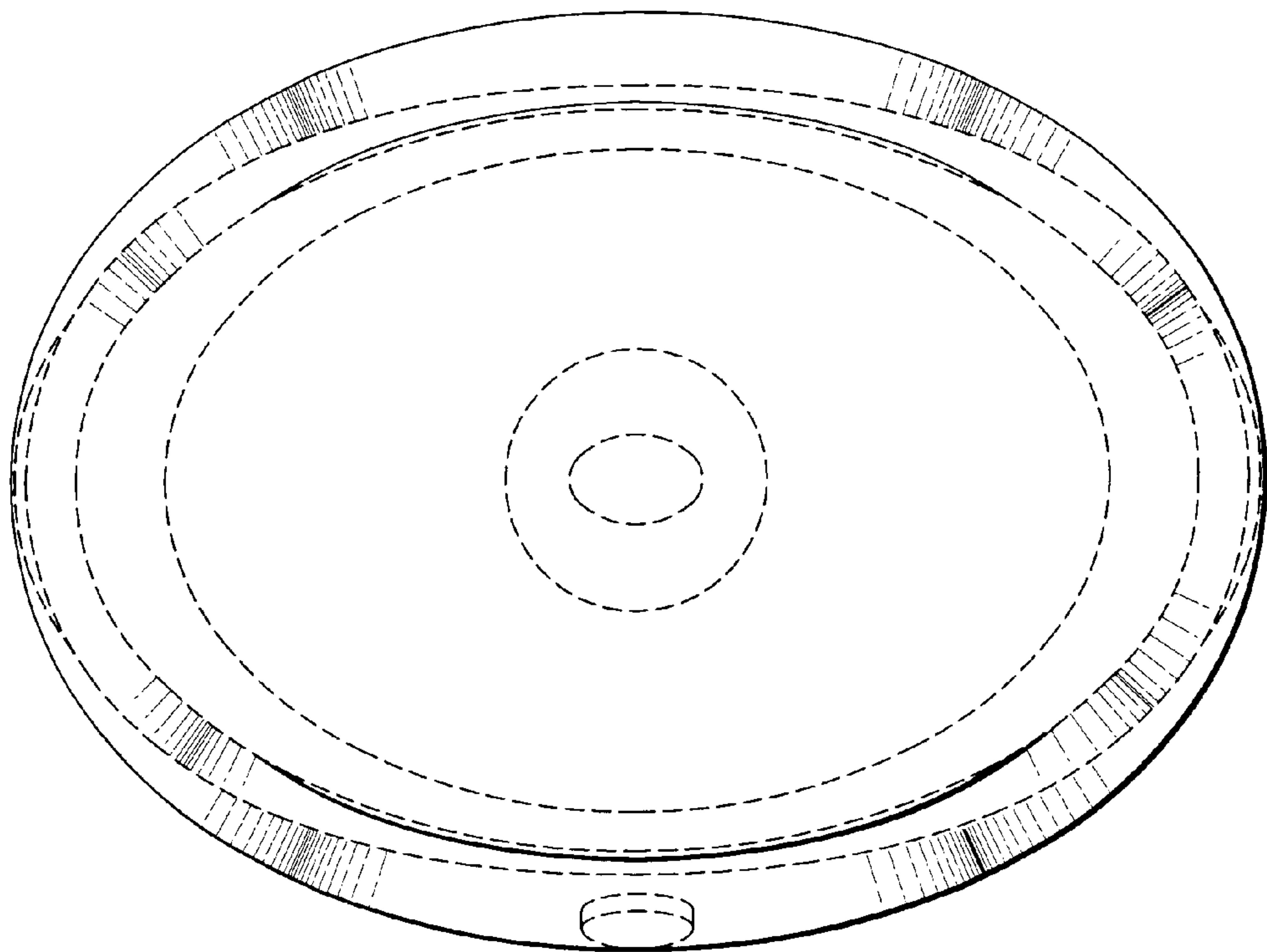
