FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the incense burner.

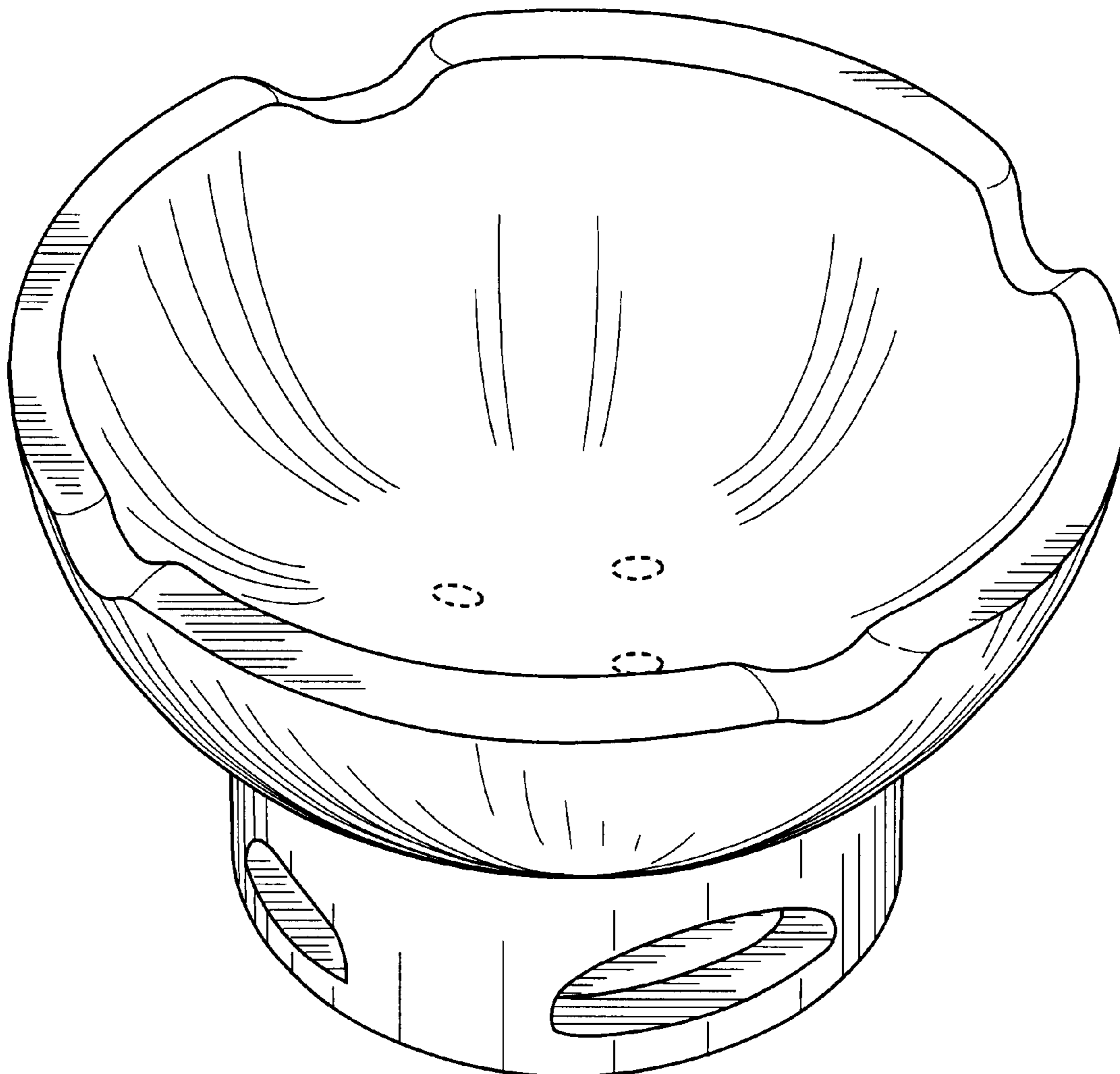
The bottom of the incense burner, defined as that surface

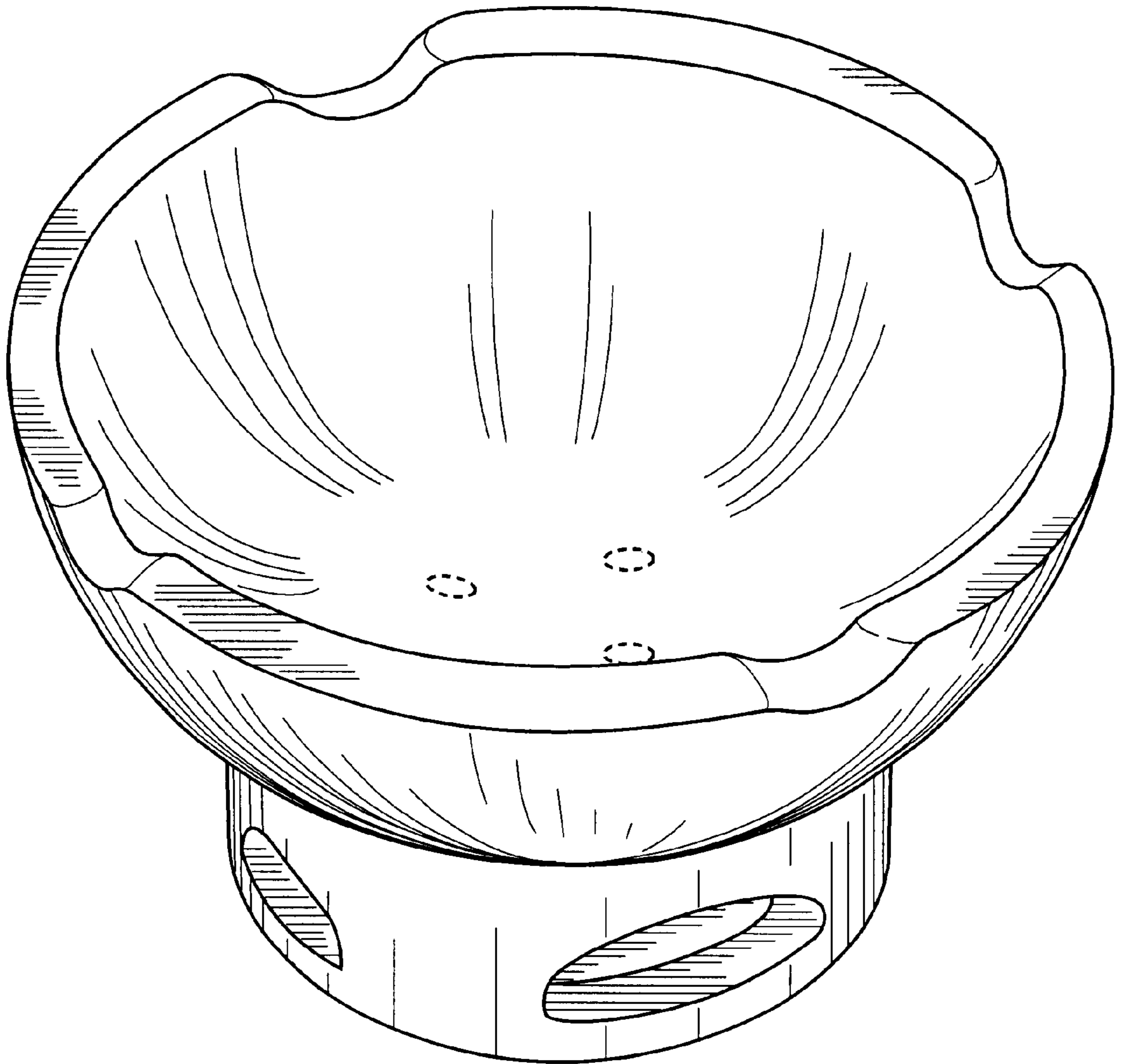

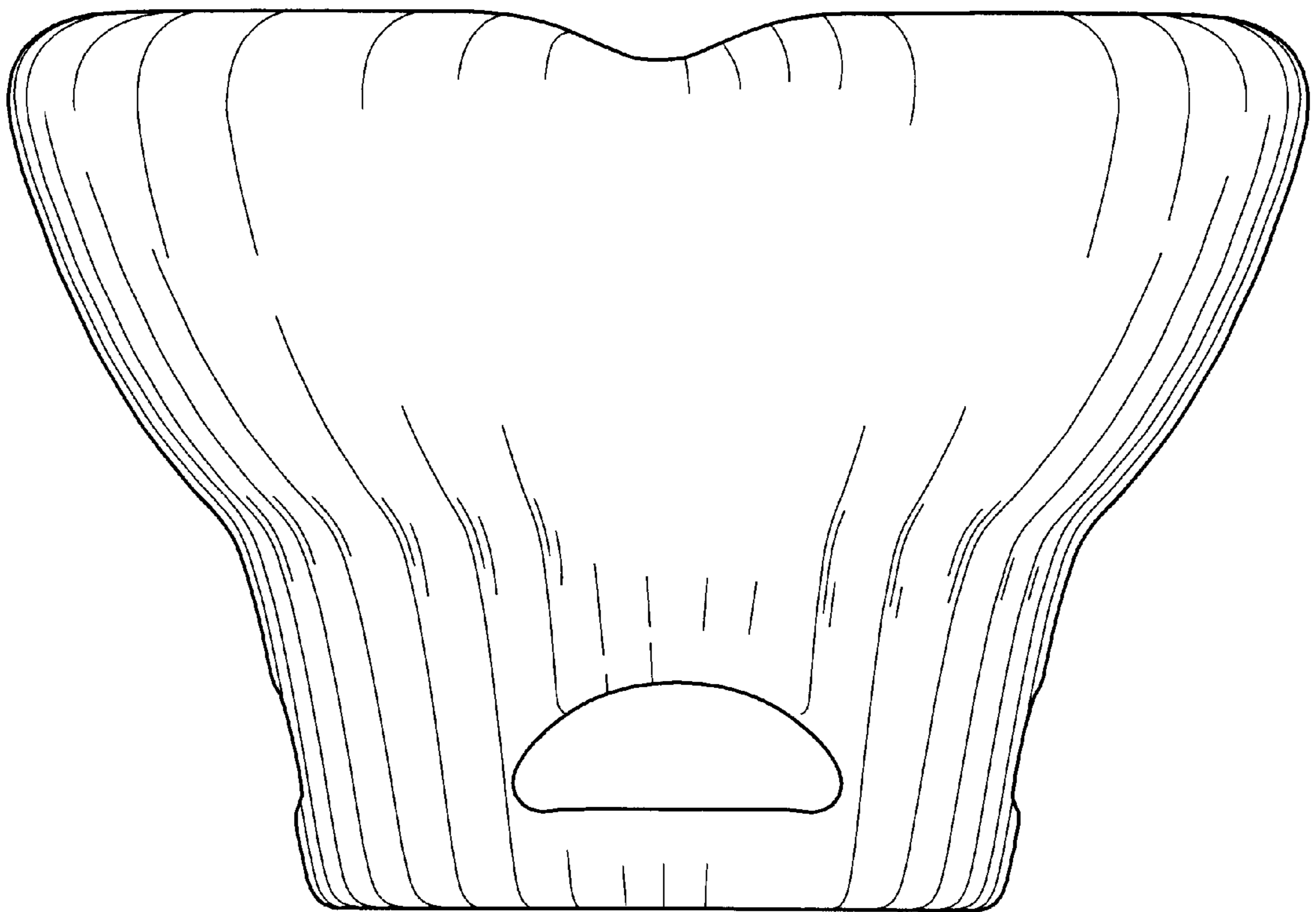

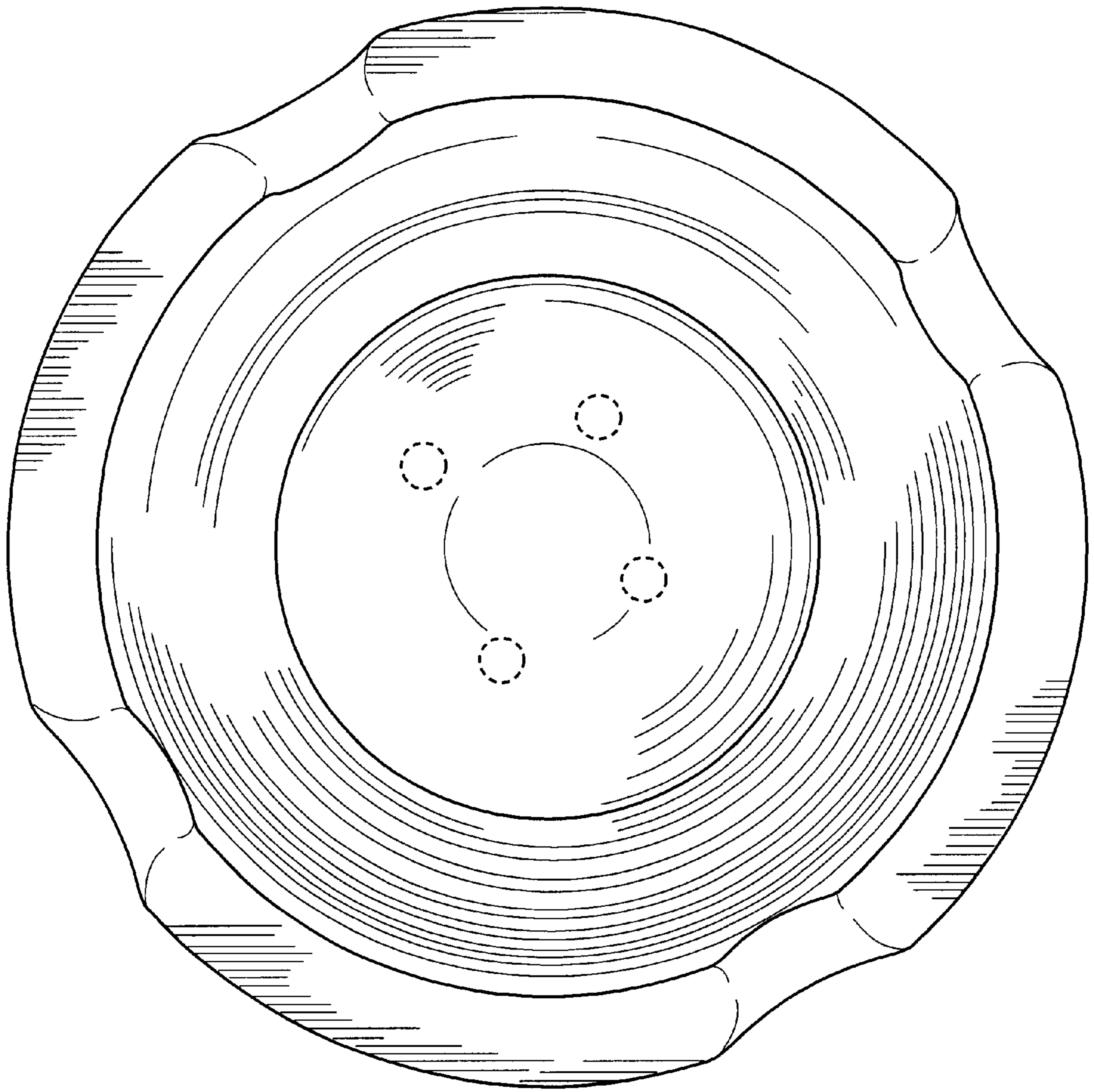

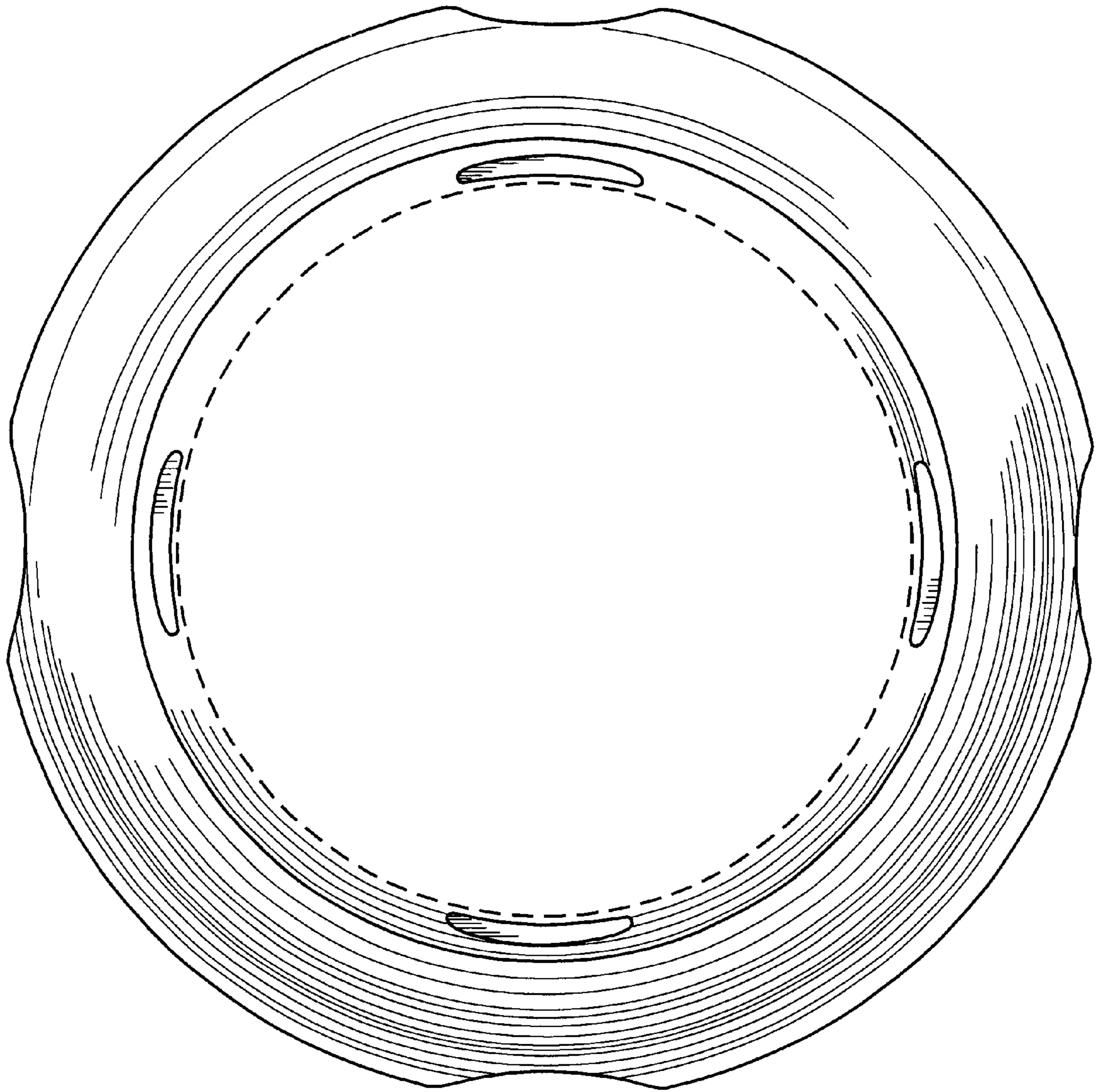
